Walner tops the Hambletonian chase

Trainer Linda Toscano is trying to keep karma on her side as she quietly preps Walner for his all-important sophomore campaign with trainers Ron Burke and Jimmy Takter nipping at her heels.

If you're looking for someone certain her horse is going to win the Hambletonian, don't bother contacting Linda Toscano.

"I will not go there," said the trainer of Walner, the top three-year-old colt trotter in training. "I made the mistake of doing that with Chapter Seven. A great horse, but karma got in the way. He got sick. We tried to play catch up but did not win the Hambletonian."

Karma smiled upon Toscano a year later, as her Market Share won the 2012 edition of harness racing's trotting classic. It may smile upon her yet again with Walner, who was a dominant force during his two-year-old campaign a year ago.

He started only eight times, but won seven after starting his season late, the result of not being staked to many of the

two-year-old events. He earned 83 per cent of his division-best \$484,037 by taking the Breeders Crown and Kindergarten in his last two starts.

The son of Chapter Seven—Random Destiny compiled some impressive numbers a year ago: Of his five wins on a mile track, the smallest winning margin was three lengths. He was sent off at odds of 4-5 or lower in every one of his starts. On five occasions, he was 1-5 or shorter. His lone loss came in a Kindergarten preliminary after going off stride. He came back one week later and crushed his foes by six-and-a-half lengths.

"(Driver) Timmy (Tetrick) and I had a battle of wills (before his only loss)," said Toscano. "Timmy said 'He needs a dog chain, just trust me.' After he broke, I told Tim, 'I love you, but we are going to turn the page. I live with him 24 hours a day, seven days a week and you rent him for two minutes a week. If we are going to go down, we are going to go down with me."

On Aug. 2 of last year, Walner broke stride racing in the New York Sire Stakes at Saratoga, but came back to win after spotting the field 20 lengths. "That's when I knew I had a special horse," said Toscano, who then got some help from a friend. "George Ducharme, one of my favorite people, walked over to me after the race. George has had trotters for years

(he won the 2013 Hambletonian with Royalty For Life)," said Toscano. "He handed me a package of Tums and said, 'You're going to need these more than I am.'

"He's pretty much in everything (all of the major stakes) and will make his first start in the Empire Breeders Classic in early June," said Toscano, who did admit "It's a good kind of pressure" when it comes to the expectations for her horse.

Walner is clearly the division leader as the year begins, but the usual suspects have a handful of horses who could be right there.

Ron Burke knows a thing or two about expectations. His Southwind Frank was all the rage during the early part of the 2016 stakes season, but came up just short in the Hambletonian, missing a fast-closing nose to Marion Marauder.

The trainer's approach to the 2017 season is a four-pronged one.

Snowstorm Hanover won the Valley Victory and Matron during a year that saw the Muscle Massive—Snow Angel Hanover product win six of 14 starts.

"He's a very consistent horse," said Burke. "The more I raced him, the better he got. (For the upcoming season) we changed the bit on him a little, we want to get his head down a little more."

Until Walner's late-season heroics, Burke's What The Hill was the early Hambletonian favorite after taking the Peter Haughton.

"I think What The Hill is the better horse (when compared to Snowstorm Hanover)," said Burke. "I have a horse, Southwind Woody, that can trot with any of them. He made breaks all last year, but hasn't made any this year. Southwind Cobra actually trained down the best of all four."

"He's a great horse," said Burke of Walner. "At the end of the

year last year, I had one horse who could go with him, What The Hill. David (Miller) was ripping his face off trying to find room late in the Breeders Crown. Walner is the (Southwind) Frank of this year. It's hard for everything to go perfect. We'll see. I'm not conceding any races to anybody."

It's likely that Jimmy Takter isn't, either.


He trains Rubio, King On The Hill and Victor Gio It, and all are on course for the upcoming season.

"All three are doing well," said Takter, the six-time United States Harness Writers Association Trainer of the Year. "I'm very pleased with them. They are all staked to all of the majors. It's too early to say which is best. All three are different. Gio is very, very fast while the other two are handy.

"Walner, he's a big horse and big horses normally develop from two to three," said Takter of the early Hambletonian favorite. "He'll be tough, but there could be 25 horses that are big players (in the division). Without Walner, I think it's a wide-open game."

One horse you won't see at the Hambletonian is Mass Production, and trainer Rick Zeron wishes he could turn back time and send out some checks.

"He was a great colt last year," said Zeron. "But in March, when I had to make stakes payments, he was not training that well. He had a bit of an attitude problem, so I did not make the Hambletonian payment. It's a great regret that I

have."

Zeron recalled how his colt benefitted in a big way from a month break before winning the Ontario Sire Stakes (OSS) Gold in 1:55.3. Only 12 days later, he would win the OSS Super Final in 1:54.4 by eight-and-three-quarter lengths as the 1-2 favorite. "I put him on the lead down the backstretch after getting away fifth and could have gone a lot more with him if I wanted to," said Zeron.

Mass Production will qualify in the last week of May and still has plenty of stakes, such as the Goodtimes, Canadian Trotting Classic and Matron, on his schedule. "I have him down to race 14 times this year," said Zeron, who is looking down the road with his prized pupil. "I want to keep racing him as a four-year-old, five-year-old and six-year-old. I'd love to race in the Hambletonian Maturity next year."

Zeron spoke with his son, Scott — who guided Marion Marauder to the Hambletonian winner's circle a year ago — about Walner, whom Scott saw recently in North Carolina. "My son said to me, 'Good Lord, this horse is a creature!"

Good news for Linda Toscano. Maybe not so much for the rest of the division.

Allard horse receives positive for Codeine and Morphine at Woodbine

Canada's leading trainer is not, yet, under suspension, but has no horses entered this weekend at Woodbine a week after racing 16 at the Toronto track.

One Too Many, a horse trained by Rene Allard, has received a positive test for Codeine and Morphine both Class 1 drugs — following a March 18 race at Woodbine.

Brent Stone, director of racing for the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) confirmed the positive test and added via email that, "Mr. Allard is not under

suspension at this time, only the horse is suspended for the 90 days."

Stone said that a trainer "found guilty" for a positive test for any class of drug "may" be fined and suspended, but "Mr. Allard still has to have his judges' review on the positive. This will happen at a later date, (but) no date has (yet) been set for the judges' review."

When asked whether the Woodbine Entertainment Group (WEG) was still accepting Allard's entries, Jamie Martin, the executive vice-president of racing for WEG declined to comment.

Over four cards of racing at Woodbine from Thurs., March 30 through Mon., April 3, Allard raced 16 horses at the Toronto track, and posted a record of 6-2-2. Not a single horse trained by Allard is entered at Woodbine over the four cards from Thursday through Monday this weekend.

Allard is currently the leading trainer at WEG and in Canada overall in 2017 in wins -49 at WEG, 56 in Canada total. He is second both in the country (\$540,136) and on the WEG circuit (\$520,610) in money.

Allard-trained horse Julerica tested positive for the Class 1 drug Oxycodone in October of 2016 at Mohegan Sun at Pocono Downs. The trainer was initial handed a one-year suspension and a \$5,000 fine, but the fine and suspension has since been rescinded by the Pennsylvania Horse Racing Commission (PHRC) due to "mitigating circumstances." However, the purse money erned by Julerica in that race has been returned.

Sears: First The Masters, then back to racing

After more than four months away from the track, Hall of Fame bound driver Brian Sears will be at The Masters this weekend before returning to drive horses beginning next Thursday at Yonkers.

After more than four months away from the track, driver Brian Sears is set to return to driving next Thursday (April 13) at Yonkers, but first he's making a detour further south to take in The Masters.

The road trip to the Augusta, GA golf shrine comes less than three weeks after Sears, 49, recorded his first hole-in-one. The ace came March 19 at the Legacy Golf Links near Pinehurst, NC

"I spent my winter in Pinehurst," Sears said Wednesday. "My mother has a place down here... I'm enjoying the mild winter and playing a lot of golf. I was fortunate enough to meet someone from 'The First Tee' (https://thefirsttee.org). It's a non-profit thing that teaches kids about golf. I met this guy and went out to dinner. He invited me to play golf... Anyway, he ended up inviting me to The Masters, so I'm packing to go to The Masters as we speak."

A year ago, Sears attended the practice round at The Masters. This year, he has tickets to both the Friday and Saturday rounds.

It hasn't been all golf and relaxation in Pinehurst this winter for Sears. He said he's been helping his close friend, trainer Gates Brunet, in the barn.

"He's training a filly that I have with my dad. So I've been down here, helping him train a bit," Sears said of the homebred two-year-old Rock N Roll Heaven filly out of Native Bride that he owns with his father, Jay.

As for the extended winter break from driving horses that started when Brian had laser eye surgery in early December, Sears said he really appreciated the down time.

"The last time I had a break like this, it was when I had a broken wrist and had four months off. I feel really good. It was a needed break and I've enjoyed it," he said.

"Timmy (Tetrick) was also down (in Pinehurst) for a few months. It's a lot of downtime when you are used to going to work every night, but, you know, you adapt and make the best of it.

"But, you get itching to get back, there's no guestion."

Brian said one of the toughest things about being away from racing is the lack of structure.

"I'm actually looking forward to getting back into a steady routine. That's the way my life has been structured around racing five days a week and I'm actually looking forward to getting back to that," Brian said.

He's also looking forward to being officially inducted in the Harness Racing Hall of Fame on July 2 in Goshen, NY, the home of the Harness Racing Museum and Hall of Fame.

"It's quite an honor. I'm pretty excited because of the people I look up to in the business and being able to join them," he said.

"Growing up, I looked up to guys like (Bill) O'Donnell and (John) Campbell and, even closer, I was close to Joe Pavia growing up as a kid, in high school. I got to know Billy Fahy at The Meadows, when he moved back to Pennsylvania. I was able to pick Billy's brain and I always thought he did a really good job as a driver."

Brian said he also learned a lot from his dad.

"I've always had pretty good discipline. My dad taught me and I've been pretty good that way," Brian said.

Lifetime, Brian has won 9,715 races and \$176 million in purses. He ranks 14th in North American history for wins among drivers and sixth in purses. He led the sport in earnings in 2005, with a then-record \$15 million, and has finished among the top 10 in purses the past 13 years.

Brian has driven three Horse of the Year award winners — Rocknroll Hanover in 2005, Muscle Hill in 2009 and Bee A Magician in 2013. He has won the Hambletonian three times, with three different trainers, and is the only driver to twice win the Hambletonian and Hambletonian Oaks on the same day. He accomplished that feat with Muscle Hill and Broadway Schooner in 2009 and again with Royalty For Life and Bee A Magician in 2013.

Brian won 301 races last year and \$7.49 million in purses. His top wins came with Control The Moment in the Meadowlands Pace and Flanagan Memory in the Breeders Crown Open Trot.

Kihlström wins 6,000th race; Italian horses still missing

Swedish top driver Örjan Kihlström has won almost everything you can win regarding big races around the world and Friday, March 31 became another day to remember for him when he became just the sixth driver in Sweden to reach 6,000 victories — and did it at his home track, Solvalla.

Many fans consider Kihlström to be one of the best drivers in the world and his record includes three victories in the Elitlopp, one in the Prix d'Amérique and one in the Breeders Crown in the U.S. with Commander Crowe in 2014.

Jorma Kontio (from Finland), Olle Goop, Stig H Johansson, Åke Svanstedt and Björn Goop have all previously reached 6,000 victories in Sweden.

No news about kidnapped horses in Italy

It's been over a month since the two Italian horses Unicka and Vampire Dany disappeared from their home at trainer Erik Bondos' farm Scuderia Wave outside Pisa in Italy.

Unicka, by Love You, was predicted to have a great future after her victory in the Italian Derby last year, but the police has still no clue about what has happened to the horses.

"We must be sure that the horses come back to the tracks, we owe that to the owners and the Italian harness racing (industry)," the Italian investigator Edoardo Fanucci recently told the newspaper Il Tirreno.

Unicka and Vampire Dany disappeared from the farm on the night of March 7 and no one has heard a word after that. It's a mystery and very unpleasant for everyone involved.

Burgess humbled by Hall of Fame honor

Two-time Hambletonian winning trainer Blair Burgess will be inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame in August.

Trainer Blair Burgess said he often enjoys reading the plaques at the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame (CHRHOF) at Woodbine Racetrack in Toronto. He said the fact his name and bio will soon be joining some of the biggest legends in horse racing history is a bit overwhelming and humbling.

On Tuesday (April 4) it was announced that Burgess will be among the 2017 class of inductees to the CHRHOF. He will be officially inducted Aug. 9 at a gala in Mississauga, ON.

"When I do get the time to look at (the displays) at Woodbine, I enjoy doing that. I read the blurbs and it's interesting to get a sense of the history of the game when you are there," Burgess said Thursday. "I am something of a museum buff."

Burgess will join his father — lawyer, breeder and owner Bob Burgess — in the Hall of Fame. Bob was inducted as a builder in 2011.

"(Dad) called and I think he was (proud)," Blair said. "He wouldn't admit it to me, but he is."

Blair, a 55-year-old self-professed city kid from Toronto, said racing horses is "all I've ever done. I was raised in it, being a 'track rat' because my father was crazy enough to claim horses. I used to go to the runners just as much, watching Avelino Gomez as much as Ronnie Feagan, but then it changed over when he owned cheap claimers on the standardbred side and then we hardly went to Woodbine (to watch the thoroughbreds) anymore."

Of his Hall of Fame honor, Blair said, "It shows you don't have to be a farm kid to get in. You can be a city kid."

Blair has accumulated 1,040 wins and earnings of over \$27.6 million as a trainer, including two victories in the



Hambletonian (Amigo Hall in 2003 and Glidemaster in 2006), two in the Meadowlands Pace (Frugal Gourmet in 1987, Real Desire in 2002), plus wins in the Little Brown Jug (Tell All in 2007), the North America Cup (Tell All in 2007), the Kentucky Futurity, the Trotting Triple Crown (Glidemaster in 2006) and a Breeders Crown (Real Desire, 2001).

Blair received an O'Brien Award as Canada's Trainer of the Year in 2007. He was also named Canada's Trainer of the Year in 1987 before the O'Brien Awards were started. Blair has trained winners of seven O'Brien Awards, and nine Dan Patch Awards. Real Desire was named the Horse of the Year in Canada and the United States in 2002, Tell All shared Canada's Horse of the Year Award with Somebeachsomewhere in 2007 and Glidemaster was named the U.S. Horse of the Year and Trotter of the Year in 2006. Two of Blair's trainees have been named the U.S. Pacer of the Year — Real Desire in 2002 and Tell All in 2007.

Horses trained by Blair that earned in excess of \$1 million include Real Desire, Glidemaster, Tell All, Western Ideal, Amity Chef, Quality Western and Amigo Hall.

Blair said he owes at least half of his Hall of Fame honor to his wife, Karin Olsson-Burgess.

"If an award can ever be shared it is definitely half Karin's," Blair said. "I know everybody says that and it has become cliché, but with me it's true. She made just as many of the training and management decisions on the good horses, and cleaned a heck of a lot more stalls. Honorable mention to my two lifetime second trainers (Bill Rapson and James Carmichael).

"Plus, this wouldn't have happened at all without my father at first and my connection to Brittany Farms — George Segal, Myron Bell and Art Zubrod.

"Art (and his wife) Leah personally bred Real Desire, not Brittany. But he was raised on George's Bluegrass. In fact, my best horses all came out of same field at Brittany — Real Desire, Glidemaster and even Western Ideal was there."

Blair said he has been humbled by the number of people who have contacted him to congratulate him on his Hall of Fame honor and he wants to thank everyone that took the time to send him a message — whether it was on HRU's Facebook page, where a long list of messages were left, or elsewhere. He said he hasn't had time to respond to many of the messages, yet, but wants everyone know they are deeply appreciated.

"Some people I was surprised... some people left me messages that I barely know, plus, a lot of good friends and acquaintances sent messages, too. So I got well wishes from all over the place and, because of the world we live in, it came from everything – Twitter, Facebook, Messenger, text messages, email. A lot of different directions."

As for the reaction at home, he joked his family isn't treating him any differently.

"I'm definitely not regarded as Hall of Fame at home. I just got, 'Don't think you're any smarter," Burgess said, laughing.

"My only parting thought is that the bittersweet part of it is that the sport that I made my hay in, and was recognized in, is one that maybe my kid's kids – if they have any – won't know about. I'm a little bit concerned that it's a business now and I hope it's not a fading business."

Happy for Happy Lady

It's been a long road to try to get Happy Lady into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame, but former Standardbred Canada CEO Ted Smith said he's pleased the stellar pacing filly is finally being honored.

Her racing career was brief – just two years – but Happy Lady's impressive exploits are undoubtedly worthy of Hall of Fame recognition.

For Ted Smith, the man who started his longstanding association with the standardbred world at the Canadian Trotting Association in 1976, seeing Happy Lady's name announced as one of the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame's 2017 inductees is deeply gratifying.

Smith, a member of the Hall's nominating committee, is a big backer of the pacer who stamped herself as a superstar talent in the late 1970s.

"She was nominated in 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017," said Smith, who was responsible for the management and administration of the amalgamation of the Canadian Trotting Association and Canadian Standardbred Horse Society and became Standardbred Canada's first president and CEO in 1998. "She made the ballot from 2014-17 and finally got in. I spoke very highly of her to the committee. She was the horse that time forgot. But, she was a great horse."

A daughter of Most Happy Fella, Happy Lady's two years on the racetrack – 1977 and 1978 – for owners Myra Masterson of St. Catharines, ON and Linda Lockey of Ridgeville, ON, were defined by consistency and championship-caliber performances.

Bred by J William Masterson of St. Catharines, the bay won \$528,825 in purse earnings and attained a life's best mark of 1:55.3. Trained and driven by the late Jim Rankin, she fell one race shy of a perfect record in her juvenile campaign, one that yielded 15 victories from 16 starts.

Happy Lady was named the two-year-old pacing filly of the year by both the Canadian Trotting Association (CTA) and the United States Trotting Association (USTA).

There was no sophomore jinx, as she won 19 of her 24 three-year-old starts.

"She was very feisty," said Smith, who retired from his Standardbred Canada post in 2010. "She never gave in and used every ounce of strength she had in her whenever she competed. And she didn't duck and dive. She took them all on."

Happy Lady holds the distinction of being one of only two fillies to ever win the Monticello OTB Classic. Her 1:58.4 triumph in the Lady Maud at Roosevelt Raceway was a stakes and track record.

Said Rankin after the three-length Monticello score, "They say the best horses race in front and that's where she raced. I wanted to race her in front. In a 10-horse field there is a lot of traffic, and I wanted to be up front controlling it.

"She won 15 of 16 races as a 2-year-old by margins of anywhere between one and eight lengths. Her only defeat was she broke stride, and that wasn't her fault. She is the kind of filly that you can race from behind or in front. You can do most anything you want with her."

Happy Lady's year-end hardware haul included three-year-old pacing filly of the year for the Canadian Trotting Association, United States Trotting Association and Harness Tracks of America, as well as Horse of the Year for the CTA.

Her life was cut short on January 10, 1981, when she died – along with 13 other mares – in a barn fire at Castleton Farms in Kentucky, while in foal to Bret Hanover.

Smith hopes when visitors to the Hall read her plaque, they realize the significance of her short, but spectacular racing career, and also acknowledge the man who was very much a driving force behind her success.

"I hope people would appreciate what she was in her given period of time," he offered. "Jim Rankin was a natural for that filly. He was a very astute young man and an intelligent horseman. He made her."

Now, the trotting filly trained by Brad Maxwell is part of the 2017 class of Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame inductees.

Elegantimage, a winner in 20 of her 41 career starts, added another first to her impressive resume by becoming the first horse inducted to the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame for both owner Doug Millard and co-breeder Harry Rutherford.

"It's very exciting," said Rutherford who has fond memories of a young Elegantimage. "She was a nice-sized filly, not huge, and she had a long rail on her. She was long through the legs."

The Balanced Image bay, out of Éclair Hanover, always managed to stand out from the crowd.

"She wasn't a bossy filly in the paddock, but she didn't take any crap off the other ones. She had that same attitude on the track, she hated to have a horse go by her," recalled Rutherford.

Her Hall of Fame credentials are plentiful. She posted a race record of 20-7-3 and lifetime earnings of \$955,368 in 41 races for owners Hyatt Holdings, Doug Millard, Jerry Van Boekel and Steve Condren Stable.

Millard eventually bought out his co-owners and enjoyed continued success with Elegantimage as a broodmare.

A \$53,000 yearling purchase at the Canadian Classic Sale in 1995, Elegantimage was an overnight success winning three Ontario Sires Stakes events in five starts along with the Oakville Trot, Robert Stewart Memorial Final, two Trillium Series events and the Canadian Breeders Championship.

Trained throughout her career by Brad Maxwell and driven mainly by Condren, Elegantimage was named Canada's Two-Year-Old Trotting Filly of the Year for her efforts.

"She was a class filly right from the word go," said Millard.

"By the spring of her two-year-old year you could tell she was going to be a nice racehorse. Brad told me right up front that she was going to be a good mare and he doesn't say much."

She went to post as the prohibitive favourite in 20 starts and rarely let her backers down.

"This horse wanted to win and had a chance to win every

time she raced. She was a top filly for sure but you weren't going to make a lot of money betting her," said Millard, laughing.

One of Millard's favourite moments of that initial campaign came from a call courtesy of the dulcet tones of track announcer Frank Salive.

"She must have been 10 lengths ahead and Frank said, 'Ladies and gentlemen, you're looking at the making of a world champion trotting filly!' That was a quite a call," Millard said.

Elegantimage continued to dominate as a sophomore winning eight of 10 OSS starts setting a lifetime mark of 1:55.4, and winning the 1997 Canadian Breeders Championship final en route to receiving the O'Brien Award in the three-year-old trotting filly division.

She was retired following a brief four-year-old campaign and quickly became a successful broodmare with progeny earnings of \$986,223 and an average earnings per starter of \$140,889.

"She produced a pair of pretty good racehorses in Body Balance, who we lost in the fire, and Elegant Serenity who we just retired," said Millard.

Elegant Serenity, a winner of over \$500,000 with a mark of 1:53.2, is the top earner of her offspring while Body Balance, who perished tragically in the fire at Classy Lane, banked just shy of \$200,000 in a hard-knocking career.

At the age of 23, Elegantimage is now retired, for the most part, and enjoying life at Spring Haven Farm in Ohio.

"The last couple yearlings out of her were the best she had. Elegant Serenity is now retired and in foal to Muscle Hill," said Millard who will enjoy seeing the family line continue.

For Rutherford, he'll always look back fondly to Elegantimage as the start of a production line for their small breeding outfit that would go on to make such stars as Pure Ivory (\$1,442,888) and Casual Breeze (\$1,347,330).

"We were small breeders at the time and to come out with a winner like her it was a great thing. Elegantimage made just under a million, but it was a different era. She was the best horse we had bred at that time, that's for sure," said Rutherford.

The making of Elegantimage required some savvy negotiating on the part of Rutherford when trying to purchase her dam, Éclair Hanover, from Bill Wellwood.

"Bill had two mares at the time and the other one, as far as we were concerned, wasn't worth a nickel," said Rutherford.
"We negotiated for hours and ended up offering him a pretty good price and Bill said, 'Okay, you can take her then. In fact, you can take the both of them!' The other mare didn't turn out, but Éclair Hanover became quite a mare."

The proud breeder found a poignant way to convey just how dominant a racehorse Elegantimage was in her sophomore season.

"I remember her winning the Simcoe in a field of six," said Rutherford. "There were two Grand Circuit races at the time about a week apart and the good horses came up from the States but they didn't stick around for the Simcoe because they knew they couldn't beat her.

"Quite often they'd go in two heats for the Simcoe. But, with so few horses around, they didn't have to and she got the whole purse. At the time it was the highest Simcoe purse (\$160,000)."

Both Millard and Rutherford remain in awe of the accomplishments of their great trotting filly.

"Any time they name a race after your horse you know she's something special," said Millard of the Elegantimage Stakes.

A race made extra special by the fact that it was the Rutherford-bred Casual Breeze who took the inaugural running in 2000.

"That was a nice feeling to have one of your own horses win a race like that. It was quite a thing," said Rutherford.
"We've been very fortunate to have some good broodmares, and some good winners from them, and when you get a good one like Elegantimage you want to go see all of their races. She was a great competitor and she had a lot of heart."





Bittersweet honor for Mach Three

Two months after Mach Three was euthanized after a paddock accident in New Zealand, it was announced that the Ontario stallion will be among the 2017 class of inductees to the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame.

David Heffering said his first reaction upon hearing the news that late pacing stallion Mach Three was a first-ballot Canadian Hall of Famer was incredible joy for the Muscara family that owned the horse that died tragically in January.

"They've been in the business for a long time and have loved the horse business," said Heffering, owner of Tara Hills Stud in Port Perry, ON where Mach Three stood for 14 straight years during the northern hemisphere breeding season. "The (late) father loved the horse business. He just ate and slept the business for all of the years that I knew Joe Muscara, Sr. So it's nice that this will add to the legacy for the boys, for Bob and Joe, Jr."

Mach Three — the sire of the legendary Hall of Fame racehorse and stallion Somebeachsomewhere (\$3.2 million, 1:46.4 world record) — died Jan. 20 at Alabar Farms in Waiau Pa, New Zealand following a paddock accident. He had just turned 18. Mach Three suffered a broken leg in his paddock and had to be put down.

The stallion will be officially inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame on Aug. 9 in a gala banquet in Mississauga, ON.

Mach Three, a son of Matts Scooter out of All Included, has produced 1,297 offspring to date, with total progeny earnings of nearly \$103 million by Standardbred Canada accounting and \$97.5 million by USTA records. Standardbred Canada has Mach Three's progeny's average earnings per starter at \$112,034 (\$103,126 by USTA records). The stallion produced 298 horses that earned \$100,000 or more and 105 that made more than \$250,000, by SC records. He produced 437 horses than had a 1:55 mile, 274 that had a 1:53 mark and 30 that had a sub-1:50 mile.

"He's been a big part of the Canadian breeding scene and the North American breeding scene," Heffering said. "He made racehorses. That's what everybody tells us. You can breed to him and you'll get a racehorse."

Mach Three's six richest offspring are: Somebeachsomewhere (\$3.2 million), Monkey On My Wheel

(\$1.7 million), Mach It So (\$1.68 million), Solar Sister (\$1 million) and Camaes Fellow (\$985,000) and Down Under wonder Auckland Reactor N (\$966,000).

The late Joe Muscara, Sr. of Huntingdon Valley, PA purchased Mach Three in May of the pacer's sophomore season from Linda Magid of Cambridge, ON, the widow of the pacer's breeder, Karl Magid. Karl was perhaps best known for founding the famed Lulu's Roadhouse in Kitchener, ON in 1984. Lulu's, which Karl owned until 1987, was a mammoth nightclub that occupied the site of a former K-Mart and once was home to the world's longest bar. It was also a frequent stop for some of the world's most successful music acts.

Mach Three posted a record of 7-2-0 in nine starts at two in 2001 and won the \$1.1 million Metro Pace at Woodbine in 1:51.4 while under the tutelage of Brett, Shawn and Bill Robinson, along with Monte Gelrod. The Metro victory came

seven months after Karl Magid died of cancer.

The following year, Mach Three won the \$1 million Meadowlands Pace in a career best 1:49. At three, Mach Three had a record of 11-2-2 in 18 starts to give him a career record of 18-4-2 in 27 starts and earnings of \$2,376,700. Mach Three was predominantly driven by Randy Waples at two and John Campbell at three.

Mach Three stood his entire career at Tara Hills Stud in the northern hemisphere and Alabar in the southern hemisphere. His first foals hit the ground in 2004.

"My staff is happy, too (with the Hall of Fame honor)," Heffering said. "They loved (Mach Three). We've had different staff members who have worked with this horse all the way through his career. And it's great for our clientele, too. We couldn't have done it without the great support from our clientele, too."

Heffering said Mach Three is the fourth Hall of Fame horse tied to Tara Hills Stud, including his late father, Peter

Heffering, the Tara Hills founder that was inducted as a builder in 2010. Tara Hills now has had three stallions inducted, counting Mach Three. Kadabra was enshrined in 2012 and Precious Bunny was inducted in 2004.

"We've had three (stallions) in our fairly short life span at Tara Hills," Heffering said. "I'm very happy about that."

As for having the good fortune to land Mach Three as a stallion in the first place, Heffering gives the credit to Alabar's John Curtin.

"I think John Curtin was instrumental in getting the horse to come to Ontario and come to our place. We were pretty young when we got this horse and it was a big deal for us and a big stepping stone for us."

A stepping stone that led to the Hall of Fame.

Quick Hitch inventor Dr. Gordon Gilbertson finally honored

Sadly, induction to the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame comes after the veterinarian's death.

Trainer Blair Burgess has long championed the late Dr. Gordon Gilbertson for induction into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame, so it's fitting the two men will be enshrined in the same class later this year.

Gilbertson invented the Quick Hitch sulky shaft fitting and revolutionized the harness racing industry.

"I've always been an advocate (of him being inducted) because just the universality of his invention made him a Hall of Famer, I thought," Burgess said Thursday.

Originally from Hagersville, ON, Gilbertson used his extensive experience treating horses as a veterinarian, and his hands-on experience in training and driving harness horses to fuel his idea to eliminate the use of a "thimble" placed over the shaft ends and wrapping straps around the straight portion of the shaft to secure the horse in the sulky.

In 1980, Dr.Gilbertson secured Canadian and U.S. patents on his new "Quick Hitch" eventually named the "Rondeau Quick Hitch", in homage to the area where he lived in Kent County. After much hard work, and several slight modifications, top horsemen in Canada and the U.S. became converts to the new invention to the point where it became the standard used at racetracks and training centres around the world and is still used today.

Burgess said the only shame is Gilbertson was not inducted while he was still alive.

"I feel sorry for Doc Gilbertson because that would have been a thrill to finally be recognized," Burgess said.

Gilbertson will be inducted as a builder on Aug. 9 in a gala dinner in Mississauga, ON.

Merriman gets career win 9,000 at The Meadows

Aaron Merriman, harness racing's "winningest" driver in 2015 and 2016, collected career win 9,000 Tuesday (April 4) at The Meadows when he piloted DD's Comet to victory in the fourth race.

A native of Cuyahoga Falls, OH, Merriman, 38, has been driving at both The Meadows and Northfield Park for the past few years and has been rolling up wins at a rapid pace. He notched career win 6,000 in October 2013, meaning he has amassed 3,000 victories in the last 42 months. Why has he been so successful?

"I think just showing up every day and trying to do your best is part of it," he said. "I'm not a guy who calls off. I show up. When you do that and win a few races, you build your confidence."

Driving regularly at two tracks can be grueling, but Merriman says he expects to maintain his hectic schedule.

"As long as the quality of racing is as it is or better, I can see myself doing it," he said. "Yeah, there are four tough days of doubleheaders, but that leaves three days to do things I need to do or relax. It's not the size of the purses so much that motivates me as the quality of the horses. There are such nice horses at both tracks now."

Even when he gets the opportunity for a few days off, he doesn't take it.

"One of my fears is I would lose my drives if I took a couple days off. That's not necessarily lack of confidence, but someone's always there to step up and drive your horses. Some days, I want to stay in bed and sleep, but I can't do it

for fear I'd lose my horses. I know that sounds horrible; imagine what it's like to feel it."

Merriman indicated he has no long-range plans — for harness racing or anything else.

"I'm a day-to-day guy," he said. "I don't look ahead at all, although I should. I just hope my kids find something they can get as attached to as I have."

Henry The Dragon took the early lead and never was headed in his third win in a-row and eighth in nine lifetime appearances. The Clyde Francis trainee has now banked \$141,600 for owner George Teague who bred the Custer The Dragon—Surveille Hanover colt with Elmer Fannin. Montrell Teague drove runner-up Daiymir also owned by George Teague with Art Of Fire (Vic Kirby) the show horse.

Dan Keeler's James Isaac and Tony Morgan were much the best in the second \$20,000 DSBF section winning in 1:53.3. Jim King conditions the Roddy's Bags Again—Slide Home colt who drew off for an easy victory. River's Crest (Art Stafford Jr.) and Whispering Witch (Teague) were second and third respectively.

Bags To Riches romped to a 1:53.4 decision in the third DSBF prelim. Tim Tetrick guided the Only Money Inc. and trainer Jason Skinner colt to his third win in four starts this year and seventh triumph in 12 career races. The Roddy's Bags Again-Paint The Sky Blue colt is a \$115,062 lifetime winner. Hallie's Comet (Pat Lachance) was second with Olivias Grand Slam (Morand) closing fast for third.

Meet leader Corey Callahan piloted Wake Up And Go home

in 1:53.1 to win the final prelim for Jimmy Lunn and Charles Winbrow. Also by Roddy's Bags Again from his dam, Early Riser, it was his second win in three outings this year. Automatic Dragon (Kirby) was next with Stay In Your Place (Teague) a close third.

Next Thursday the top eight colt and gelding pacing point-getters after two prelim divisions return for the \$100,000 DSBF Championship Final.

Cobalt threshold to be lowered in Canada

A release issued Thursday by The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency (CPMA) indicates that the federal agency will be lowering the quantitative threshold for cobalt testing starting May 1.

The CPMA said that as of Feb. 22, 2017, cobalt was officially added to Section 2 of the Schedule to the Pari-Mutuel Betting Supervision Regulations. It should be noted that cobalt testing in Canada will move from provincial oversight to the CPMA under its official Equine Drug Control Program as of May 1, 2017.


The CPMA would also like to advise the horse racing industry that the quantitative threshold for cobalt testing will decrease from 50 ng/mL to 25 ng/mL in blood and that a new threshold of 100 ng/mL will be implemented in urine. These thresholds are published in the Pari-Mutuel Betting Supervision Regulations.

The CPMA would like to remind industry participants to take care and to read the list of ingredients when choosing products that are administered to horses. As with all medications and supplements, owners and trainers should discuss the use of cobalt supplements with their veterinarian.




