### **Legendary Levy Battle**

Wiggle It Jiggleit came from well off the pace from post seven to dead heat with Bit Of A Legend N after a terrific stretch battle in the fifth and final leg of the Levy Saturday at Yonkers.

The match-up of the night delivered one of the best finishes of the year when Horse of the Year Wiggle It Jiggleit and red-hot Bit Of A Legend N converted a gritty stretch battle into a dead-heat finish Saturday (April 16) at Yonkers in the third and final \$50,000 division in the fifth leg of the George Morton Levy Series for older pacers.

Yonkers Photo Finish

Wiggle It Jiggleit (7, Montrell Teague) and Bit Of A Legend N (4, Jordan Stratton) battled to this dead-heat finish Saturday at Yonkers in the fifth and final leg of the Levy Series.

The shared victory gave each pacer 37.5 points on the night, which was not enough for Wiggle It Jiggleit to qualify for next Saturday's \$606,000 final. Wiggle It Jiggleit did not contest the first two legs of the five-leg series. He did, however, put on a hell of a show all three weeks despite drawing the outside post position twice.

In the latest tilt, Wiggle It Jiggleit (4/5, post seven, Montrell Teague) and Bit Of A Legend N (3/5, post four, Jordan Stratton) both were left behind at the gate as the rest of the seven-horse field left quickly.

As 90-1 shot Bettorever and Jason Bartlett set the pace through opening fractions of :27 and :56, Stratton settled Bit Of A Legend N in fourth, while Teague resigned himself to sixth through the 1:24 third-quarter. That's where Teague and Wiggle It would stay until the top of the lane when they mounted a furious stretch charge reminiscent of two weeks prior when they just missed catching winner All Bets Off in their third-round Levy test.

Stratton unleashed almost as impressive a stretch drive with Bit Of A Legend N. He came from fourth at the head of the lane to storm to the photo with Wiggle It Jiggleit, the two trading haymakers to the wire reached in 1:51.2. Limelight Beach was two-and-a-half lengths back in third.

"It doesn't get any better than that, neck and neck through the wire," Stratton told Frank Drucker on the Yonkers simulcast show. "(Bit Of A Legend N) fought right to the wire. It looks like he came out of the race okay... He should be ready to go for next week's final."

It was the fifth straight victory for Bit Of A Legend N, who swept all five Levy legs. The son of Bettors Delight—Sokys Legend, bred in New Zealand, is owned by Harry Von Knoblauch of San Diego, CA and trained by Peter Tritton.

Wiggle It Jiggleit is owned by George Teague, Jr. of Harrington, DE and the Teague Racing Partnership LLC of

Boynton Beach, FL. The son of Mr. Wiggles – Mozzi Hanover is trained by Clyde Francis.

In Saturday's first Levy division, Lettucerockthem A and Brian Sears won by a half-length over P H Supercam in 1:51 for trainer Rene Allard and owners Allard Racing of Quebec and Bob Hamather and Bruce Soulsby of Ontario and Ohio, respectively.

In the second division, Mach It So qualified for the final by defeating Texican N by a neck in 1:51.3 for driver Tim Tetrick and trainer/owner Jeff Bamond. Te Kawau N was third and Foiled Again was fourth.

Yonkers announced it was double-checking the final Levy standings at press time, but the eight finalists are believed to be (in order of points):

### **Remarkable Recovery**

Even as the Classy Lane fire was still burning, trainer Ben Wallace was making plans to rebuild his stable. But even he couldn't imagine posting the incredible results he's had since losing all 17 of his horses.

The Classy Lane fire was still burning on Jan. 4 when trainer Ben Wallace said he turned his mind to starting over.

"I was trying to figure out how the hell I could regroup. I didn't want to quit. I didn't want to retire. I didn't want to call it. I didn't want a fire to define my career. I wanted horses to define my career," said 67-year-old Wallace who lost all 17 horses he had at Classy Lane when a fire gutted Barn 1, killing all 43 horses in it.

Ben Wallace has won 18 races and has posted a UTRS of .528 since losing his entire stable in the Classy Lane fire.

"There wasn't one 'Why me?' moment or 'What am I going to do now?' It was, 'How are we going to pick the pieces up and start back again?""

But even a trainer as consistently successful as Wallace couldn't imagine he would be having the year he's had, so far, with 18 wins in 42 starts — counting a victory in race one at Mohawk Saturday night (April 16) — earnings of just more than \$150,000 and an off-the-charts UTRS of .528.

"To say that I'd have as much racing luck as we've had in the last two months, that was not in the picture at all. We've just done great. That's just so reassuring to know that you can still get horses to win races," Wallace said.

The trainer said he's tremendously grateful to owner Brad Grant who traveled to New Jersey in mid-January and purchased three top racehorses at the January Mixed Sale at

the Meadowlands to give to Wallace despite paying a premium for those horses given a low Canadian dollar. Grant not only topped the sale by purchasing six-year-old trotting horse Lindy's Tru Grit for \$125,000, he also purchased four-year-old pacing mare A Plus for \$80,000 and three-year-old pacing colt Easy Lover Hanover for \$70,000.

All three have proven to be top overnight horses for Wallace on the Woodbine Entertainment Group (WEG) circuit.

Easy Lover Hanover won his first six starts for Wallace before finishing second last Saturday in the \$30,646 final of the Youthful Series at Mohawk. The son of Somebeachsomewhere out of Easy Go Go has earned over \$46,000 for Grant under Wallace's tutelage this year.

Lindy's Tru Grit has won twice in seven starts in WEG's preferred class, earning nearly \$30,000, so far.

A Plus has cashed a check in eight of nine starts for Wallace and Grant, earning over \$20,000.

Fellow trainer and owner Larry Ainsworth recently sent Wallace a four-year-old gelded pacer named Newbie that has won his last two starts.

"I've got to thank Larry Ainsworth and certainly Brad

(Grant). Right away, January 5th, they were on the phone lining up horses for me. I didn't have any place to go at the time. It took me two or three weeks before I could get up and running and get equipment gathered up," Wallace said.

"It's nice to know that you're taking horses into the city that can win races, not just fill the card."

That said, the trainer does have concerns about what the stakes season will bring.

"My summer is going to be pretty dry because I don't have any young ones," Wallace said, adding he has room in his barn if any U.S. outfits need somewhere to send young horses to race in Ontario this summer. "As far as young horses, we just don't have any... I lost eight two-year-olds."

Wallace will soon have a new barn for his entire stable. Classy Lane is nearing completion of a new barn on the site of the one destroyed by fire.

"They're talking May 1st," Wallace said of the projected opening of the structure being called Barn 6 in deference to those lost in Barn 1. "But I think they might be a little bit delayed because, apparently, they couldn't lay the floor because it's been too cold.

"The shell's up, it's covered, the roof's on, the ceiling's on. The washrooms are getting prepared. They're a couple of weeks, maybe a month, maximum, away from full up and running... and then we're in business."

Wallace said he's training 15 horses now and would like to have as many as 20. But considering virtually his entire stable was wiped out in the fire, he said he's blessed to have the horses he does and said the Central Ontario Standardbred Association (COSA) that started a GoFundMe campaign that raised over \$700,000 to help fire victims deserves tremendous gratitude.

"Everybody's back going with my crew," Wallace said. "Not one of my caretakers — or anybody's caretaker, for that matter — was financially challenged due to the fire. They got paid right through.

"We lost some horses that people were attached to, and that's an issue, but the way to confront that is to get up and go to work and find some new ones. That's what we were able to do.

"A lot of my people weren't prepared to go back to work at first. They had to take a deep breath for a second or two until we started back again, we, Wallace Standardbreds, started back again. Then it was the team back going again. They didn't want to splinter. I was lucky enough that we slowly, very gradually, picked up our numbers... I can confidently say a couple of months after the fact that we're about as back to normal as you'd ever want to be, other than they're not the same horses."

Through it all, the early success has been a great for the entire stable's psyche, said Wallace, a career winner of more than 1,800 races and nearly \$34 million.

"I'll be honest, where I am career-wise, if I had to pick up the pieces again like I did and we were 0 for 20 instead of 12 for 20, it would be a pretty tough nut to crack." Wallace said. "I've been very lucky that way. For some reason, the Harness Racing Gods have been pretty good to us."

### JL Cruze remains perfect

The older trotter won his third race in 2016 in as many starts on a night his driver, John Campbell, won four races at the Meadowlands.

JL Cruze stayed perfect in three seasonal starts Friday night (April 15), taking the featured \$25,000 open handicap trot at the Meadowlands by one-and-a-half lengths over Shake It Cerry. Opulent Yankee was third.

A 1:52.2 victory on Friday in the open trot handicap at the Meadowlands gave JL Cruze (John Campbell) his third win of the year.

A five-year-old gelded son of Crazed—Topcat Hall, JL Cruze used a change in tactic from his first two victories of the season and was hustled to the top by driver John Campbell before hitting the quarter in :27.1.

Campbell was allowed to rate the Eric Ell trainee through a half in :56.4 and three-quarters in 1:25.3, leaving plenty of gas in the tank. At the top of the stretch, Rose Run Parker was a non-threatening presence alongside the eventual winner, but did provide live cover for Shake It Cerry, the lifetime earner of \$2.4 million who was making her 2016 debut. Shake It Cerry closed well in a solid try for the Jimmy Takter barn.

JL Cruze, who is pointing toward the May 8 Mack Lobell Elitlopp Playoff at the Big M, hit the wire in 1:52.2 after a final quarter in :26.4. He paid \$3 to win as the 1-2 favorite.

Campbell, the all-time leader in wins and earnings at the Big M, scored four times on the card. In addition to JL Cruze in the sixth race, Campbell won with Massive Clout (\$6.80 to win) in the first, Kiss Me Onthebeach (\$8.60) in the third and longshot I C Caviar (\$33.00) in the eighth.

### 10 Killer "Did You Knows"

Did you know....

... That Gene Riegle was the only driver to appear in the sport's first million-dollar event (finishing fourth with Fundamentalist) and then never drove again in a seven-figure race?

... That New Lew (April 20 and April 24 of 1978) became the first and only horse ever to win two maiden races at the Meadowlands? He did so winning on Thursday night and was "Also eligible at the time of entry" for Monday.

... That when Freaky Feet Pete, Always B Miki and Wiggle It

Jiggleit meet for the very first time it will indeed be a proud moment for the Hoosier State's breeding program? Their respective sires, Rockin Image, Always a Virgin and Mr Wiggles, all stood on Indiana soil when those pacing stars were conceived.

... That two sets of brothers have now each driven at least one Breeders Crown winner? It had never happened going into 2015, but Trace Tetrick joined brother Tim and Johnny Takter joined brother Jimmy as driving brothers who have completed the Crown Daily Double. Creatine for Johnny Takter and Freaky Feet Pete for Trace Tetrick.

... That Jimmy Takter has had three Horses of the Year from 1997 to 1999 with Malabar Man winning and then Moni Maker doubling up, but since then he has had three runners up for the Horse of the Year, too? He was second in 2002 to Real Desire with Kadabra, second in 2009 with Passionate Glide to Triple Crown winner Glidemaster and then again last year when Pinkman was a distant second to Wiggle It Jiggleit.

... That 43 of the 72 horses to qualify at the Meadowlands Saturday morning (April 16) were conditioned by a trainer born outside the United States?



### **Harness Racing Update**

... That Chuck Sylvester trained the first ever Meadowlands trotter to win in 1:55 and it wasn't Mack Lobell? You have to back to the 1983 season when Sylvester's prized pupil, a \$6,000 yearling named Diamond Exchange, did it on Independence Day.

... That Brett Pelling became the first trainer to win \$1 million in a single day without winning a million-dollar race? On Aug. 10, 1996, Pelling won the Adios with Electric Yankee and that night won the Woodrow Wilson with Jeremys Gambit and the Mistletoe Shalee with Mystical Maddy. Jimmy Takter became the first trainer to ever have a \$2 million day when, in October of 2015 at Woodbine, he won six Breeders Crown winners and had multiple on-the-board finishes.

... That Scott Zeron is trying to do what John Campbell last accomplished by winning the Meadowlands driving title prior to his 30th birthday (He's 27)? Campbell was 29 in 1984 when he won the title, one of 16 for Campbell in East Rutherford, NJ.

... That Meadowlands Pace runnerups have out-earned the Meadowlands Pace winners by better than a 2.5-1 ratio in the breeding shed (based solely on progeny earnings)? Names such as Abercrombie (1978 runnerup to Falcon Almahurst), No Nukes (1982 runnerup to Hilarion), Artsplace (1991 runnerup to Precious Bunny) and Somebeachsomehwere (2008 runnerup to Art Offical) have made the difference.

### Stars come out for Meadowlands qualifiers

Two sure signs of spring, tax day has passed and the good horses begin to show up for qualifiers at The Meadowlands in anticipation of stakes season. The sky was cloudless, the wind negligible and the temperature hovered around 50 degrees when a group of three-year-old filly trotters stepped onto the track Saturday morning (April 16) to open the card.

Predictably, a Takter horse won the first race — Sunset Glider a Cantab Hall filly that won the Kentuckiana Sales stake at Hoosier last summer. She led all the way through slow numbers then sprinted home in :27.1 on the end of the 1:57.2 mile for Dave Miller. Wildflower, winner of the Kindergarten final last year, was second for Ake Svanstedt and Kathy Parker came third. Brittany Farms, Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld are the owners.

Svanstedt took revenge in the second, cutting the mile to win in 1:57.4 with the Credit Winner filly New Sheriff In Town over a fast-closing Miss Tezsla (Takter) and Brett Miller. Mellby Gard owns her.

Ron Burke unveiled new purchase Dayson in the third qualifier. He led all the way through well-rated fractions then edged away to a clear 1:55.2 / :27.3 score with driver Yannick Gingras motionless in the sulky. Honor Above All and Granite State followed him in. Burke Racing, Our Horse Cents, J&T Silva and Rossie Smith are now the owners of Dayson.

The fifth qualifier contained a few of the finest trotters in the land. Trainer Nifty Norman was recently quoted as saying Bee A Magician might be better than ever and off her pair of qualifiers the consensus is a resounding "You might by right, Nifty!"

She drafted along behind older Breeders Crown winner Creatine who clicked through fractions of :29, :58 and 1:26.4 before Brian Sears tipped her and sat up. Bee edged past Creatine, who held well in his first outing, in a :27 conclusion to the 1:53.4 mile. Resolve sat mid pack early and gained some ground to be a controlled third. Mel Hartman, Herb Liverman and David McDuffee own Bee A Magician.

Pacers started up after the break and sophomore fillies went a mile in 1:54.3 with JK Fannie and John Campbell holding off the late bid of last year's Three Diamonds winner Yankee Moonshine. She is owned by 3 Brothers Stables.

The seventh race pit last season's winners of the NJ, PA and NY Sires Stakes two-year-old filly finals and they finished right across the track in that order. Blue Moon Stride and

Andy McCarthy set fractions of :29.1, :57.4, 1:26.4 with Dime A Dozen in the pocket and Dan Patch champ from last year Pure Country third. They fanned across the track in the stretch and Blue Moon Stride held off the late rally of Pure Country by an inch with Dime A Dozen another head back third in 1:54.1. Emillio and Maria Rosati own the winning filly. Mark Harder trains.

JK Will Power looked sharp this morning dragging Gingras around the oval in 1:53.1 / :27.1 in a winning effort over Carlos Danger and Sapient Hanover. The three-year-old pacing colt is trained by the Burke stable for 3 Brothers.

Burke sent out Check Six next and he looked sharp today winning for Gingras in 1:52. Settling third through the first three quarters, Check Six took off when shown racetrack and drew off over Love Tap Hanover and Western Dynasty with the 26.3 final stanza. He owned by Burke, Weaver Bruscemi, Switala and Martin.

Always B Miki made a good appearance in his first qualifier, setting slow fractions then sprinting home in :26.3 (and he didn't really start pacing until inside the final eighth) to close the 1:52 mile well in hand. Moore is aiming State Treasurer for the \$150,000 Molson Pace at The Raceway at The Western Fair District in London, ON on May 27. A victory in that race would make State Treasurer the first four-time winner of the Molson Pace.

### Saftic elected to hometown's Hall of Fame

He's won over 5,100 races and steered his mounts to more than \$96 million in purse earnings. Mike Saftic's driving peers have long had respect for the man in blue, white and red, and now Saftic's hometown is officially giving him some love, as well.

The Sudbury Star announced Saftic will be inducted into the Sudbury Sports Hall of Fame this summer as part of the class of 2016. The induction will take place during the 48th annual House of Kin Sports Celebrity Dinner and Awards, which will be held on June 8 at Sudbury's Caruso Club.

Saftic is one of three athletes that will be inducted into the hall this year. He will be inducted alongside former NHL

forward Al Secord and former Laurentian Voyageurs basketball player and coach John McKibbon.

Saftic has been a mainstay on the Woodbine Entertainment Group circuit for decades now. The 1989 campaign was the first time that he drove his mounts to over \$1 million in earnings, and he has continued to do so each year since then. He has consistently put up productive seasons on Canada's toughest harness racing circuit. Saftic drove his mounts to over \$6 million in purses in both the 2001 and 2002 campaigns. He topped \$5 million in earnings each year from 2003 to 2005, and eclipsed the \$4 million mark every year from 2006 through 2009.

Saftic has reduced his amount of drives in recent years, but has still been getting the job done for his connections, as his win totals and purse earnings reflect. Additionally, one cannot think of O'Brien Award winners Sir Luck, Luck Of Michelle, Ellamony or top open trotter Corn Cob Conch without thinking of Saftic.

### Gural on charging for HD subscription

I feel it is important to respond to our customers' questions and concerns, so I'd like to address the upcoming change to paid subscription viewing for The Meadowlands live races in High Definition (HD) on the Racetrack Television Network (RTN).

Before long, all horse racing will be broadcast in HD to meet the high standards demanded by today's customer. We made a significant investment when the new grandstand was constructed in 2013 to upgrade all equipment to HD capable, making The Meadowlands one of just a handful of tracks, both harness and thoroughbred, to broadcast in HD. The equipment and amount of bandwidth necessary to broadcast in HD are very costly.

It is not our intention to offend or discourage anyone wanting to watch Meadowlands racing. It was even suggested by the operators of RTN that the majority of horseplayers wagering remotely on Meadowlands races are watching the races on the Advance Deposit Wagering (ADW) platform they use to make those wagers. In fact, one option to consider is to open an account with one of the ADW's available in your state of residence.

For our fans that like to watch the big stakes days, the RTN has agreed to stream the entire Hambletonian Day card and Breeders Crown cards on The Meadowlands website for free.

We think that this significant improvement in quality of the broadcast signal will prove to be worth the cost to our customers. The best way to do that, in our opinion, was to provide an experience of how HD broadcasts will improve the race watching experience so we have offered the free 60-day trial which goes until Friday, May 13. The Meadowlands a la carte package is being offered by RTN for \$5 per month.

Live streaming and race replays of qualifiers and 2-year-old races will remain available on The Meadowlands website free of charge. The Meadowlands website will also

continue to provide fans race replays in Standard Definition (SD) on the track website at the end of each racing day at no charge once the 60-day trial is over.

I hope you will continue to support us with both your wagering and at the entry box now that all of the tracks in PA are racing. A healthy, productive Meadowlands increases our chances to get the referendum passed in November and resurrect racing in New Jersey.

The casino business is so lucrative that many organizations are willing to operate at a loss on the racing side to earn a huge profit on the casino side. The fact is, the Meadowlands has been doing more with less, and the fact their handle is outperforming last year's even with fewer races speaks to that. The purses at the surrounding tracks can dwarf the Meadowlands on any given night with the exception of their marquee days, but (the Meadowlands) crush them in handle. I personally believe that this is due to the Meadowlands being a mile track compared to the circus that is half-mile tracks with their passing lanes, but that is beside the point.

I applaud the Meadowlands and their management for simply trying as hard as they do. They take the initiative to offer guaranteed pools with low takeout as well as insightful on track promotions and alternative gaming entertainment
