WEG welcomes development of Mohawk property

A day after the Toronto racing company released a master plan for the development of its Woodbine property, CEO Jim Lawson said WEG would welcome a similar development project at Mohawk, which is inching toward becoming a year-round home for harness racing.

Woodbine Entertainment Group CEO Jim Lawson has ambitious plans for developing the Woodbine property.

Woodbine Entertainment Group (WEG) CEO Jim Lawson said the 440-acre parcel of land home to Mohawk Racetrack could one day be the site of the same kind of entertainment district and massive development being publicly courted for the 684-acre site of its sister track, Woodbine Racetrack.

"We think there is potential for development at Mohawk for all of the same reasons," Lawson said Thursday, a day after

WEG announced a master plan has been completed for the Woodbine Racetrack lands.

"We are committed to (Mohawk)... and we would welcome development there in the nature that we just talked about (at Woodbine) as an entertainment district," Lawson said. "We know the town of Milton is very supportive and they are a great municipality and council to work with. The zoning is there for that sort of thing. Milton is the fastest growing municipality in the country, so it lends itself to this sort of additional food and beverage, music and theatre experience. Right now, the idea is to locate the gaming within the footprint of the building, but we will be in discussion, and certainly open to, having that development go on at Mohawk."

This week's announcement is a signal to developers that the land at Woodbine, in particular, is open for development, with WEG acting as the landowner. Illustrations WEG released showing a number of entertainment options surrounding the racetrack are suggestions about what kinds of development could work well with the racetrack, not set-in-stone glimpses into the future.

"Certainly, we don't have the capital to do the development and we are risk adverse. Our main mandate is to support horse racing, so I would say that in most cases we will have a land lease and try to generate cash flow for the horse racing business," he said. "Our role really is as the landowner and

what I would call us 'stewards' of a great parcel of land to make sure that we do the right thing for the community and the right thing for the horse racing industry."

Lawson was quick to stress development at Woodbine is likely a 15-to-20-year plan and there won't be any construction until the Ontario Lottery and Gaming corporation (OLG) names the company that will operate an expanded casino at Woodbine. That announcement is expected in September of this year and the earliest a shovel could likely be in the ground on property development is the end of 2018, Lawson said.

WEG has tried for over a decade to develop its property and construction on one notable project, WoodbineLive, never started. Why does Lawson believe this latest master development plan will come to fruition?

"We've got a committed gaming partner. We don't know which gaming partner it will be, but we have a committed gaming partner that will be announced in September and, as we've said all along, the amount of development that will come with that is really a catalyst and a trigger for further opportunities to develop with the property," he said.

Beyond being the site of an expanded casino and a top-tier horse racing venue, Lawson said what should also be attractive to developers about the Woodbine property is the fact that it is the "largest undeveloped piece of land in the

Lawson said developing the property in an environmentally and socially-responsible manner is critical.

GTA (Greater Toronto Area)... we're in a unique position, really, of being a single landowner with that size of parcel of land that lets you phase it the way you want."

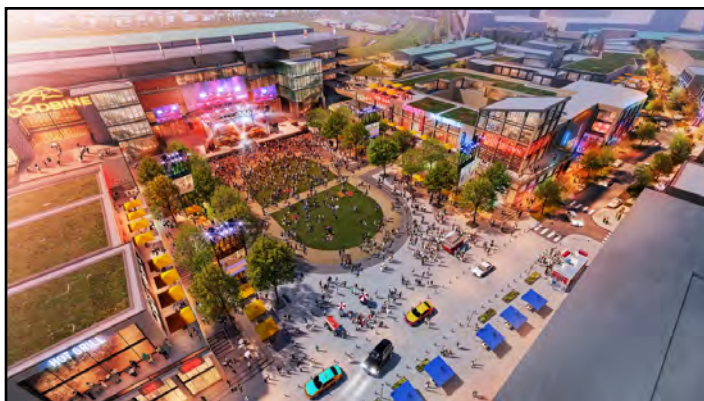
He said improved public transportation to Woodbine would be a further enticement to developers.

"Developers are keenly interested in public transportation to the site. It's something we are working on and it's gaining momentum and acceptance. The municipality and the province are committed to public transportation in a way that is unprecedented in this province right now," Lawson said, adding, there is "a big movement behind public transportation" in Toronto and, "potentially a mega hub in the Rexdale area, perhaps at the airport. Certainly, it would involve us. We have the Union-Pearson Line going right through our property and if the light rail transit goes over to Humber and has to make its way over to the airport, then Woodbine is the logical path, either down through (highway) 27 or through our property."

Lawson said WEG is continuing to move toward making Mohawk a year-round harness racing facility and leaving Woodbine to the thoroughbreds. Nothing is certain, yet, on that issue, but those concerned that standardbreds may leave Woodbine just before that site becomes home to a flashy entertainment district need to "stay tuned," Lawson said.

"Our goal is to make (Mohawk) the number one site for

harness racing in North America," Lawson said. "We are committed to it, to improving it, and I'm personally extremely excited for our contemplations for Mohawk and the way we are going to look at it. So, I don't have those concerns at all."

Lawson said a 20-year gaming lease with the OLG over the Mohawk slot hall means WEG is "committed to investing capital there and our goal is to make it – if it's not already – the premier site. If I was a horseman, I would be thrilled with the direction that we're going and you'll be hearing more about it this year."

He said he wants any development at Woodbine to be done in both a socially- and environmentally-responsible manner.

"We are reaching a whole new era in terms of urban planning and making sure that we have green space, bicycle paths and foot paths. We want to make it a nice community, which is going to take a long time."

According to the WEG press release, the "city within a city" concept is designed to unlock the value of the undeveloped land, generating long-term revenues that will sustainably support WEG's horse racing operations, and thousands of farming jobs in rural communities across Ontario... The vision for the plan is for Woodbine to continue to be the ultimate destination for horse racing and gaming, while integrating new expanded entertainment and cultural offerings, food and dining, hotel, shopping, office space, post-secondary education, recreation, health, wellness, and urban residential living."

Lawson said the key is to make sure development "complements and helps sustain racing for the next 20, 30, 40 years and Woodbine is the focus of that."

He said the initial development phase "is that the gaming expansion will be a trigger for entertainment – a music venue and entertainment venue that comes with having a gaming experience and a horse racing experience... We're trying to build the guest experience, restaurants, complementary retail, and all the rest."

The entire point is to draw people to both the Woodbine

and Mohawk sites and try to turn people on to horse racing.

"If we can get people out to Woodbine and Mohawk through these additional amenities and guest experiences, it gives us the chance over the longer term to introduce people to horse racing and introduce people to invest in horse racing and we really need to do that. We need to generate that kind of exposure and that's what this is all about," Lawson said.

BETWEEN THE LINES



Racing's maddening conundrum

When the best interest of bettors is at odds with the best interests of the drivers, punters feel violated and the handle the horsepeople used to rely on goes down.

Until the advent of slots as a means to fund harness racing, there used to be a dynamic that worked between horsepeople and the bettors. There was a mutual understanding that the two groups were dependent on one another. The owners, trainers and drivers needed bettors as a way to generate handle, which, in turn, generated the purses. In turn, the horsepeople were expected to conduct fair and honest races so that bettors would continue to generate handle, and on and on. Of late, the checks and balances that were once in place have largely been removed, and the question becomes: What does the relationship between horsepeople and bettors look like today?

In recent weeks, there have been a number of drives in races that have caught the ire of many on social media. Whenever one of these drives occurs, it's predictable what the reaction will be from both horsepeople and horseplayers alike. Bettors are often infuriated and demand that they deserve better, while horsepeople cite a need to do what's best for their horse. And these two options almost always seem mutually exclusive, though they don't have to be.

Starting two weeks ago in the final preliminary leg of the Levy series at Yonkers, Missile J was given a just "don't get hurt" drive, as described in the Yonkers press release for races that night. Missile J was already assured a spot in the finals and with an outside post, anyone who follows harness racing knew that it was unlikely that he would ever be seriously involved.

But Missile J was somehow bet down to 5-2 odds. He wasn't the favorite, but was well supported nonetheless. As expected, he never had a shot in the race being always well behind; he could have been Albatross heading into the stretch and it still wouldn't have mattered. It's one of those

things where if you follow this sport day in and day out you know what to expect, but what if you're just a casual player?

Last Friday at the Meadowlands the betting faithful were thrown again for a loop on the no-shot drive on the 70 cents on the favorite, Penpal. In this race, the 4-year-old mare driven and trained by Pat Lachance never showed any desire to try and was about 15 lengths behind the top pair of horses when entering the stretch before coming on for a third-place finish. Granted, that in Penpal's first two starts of the year she also came from off the pace (in which she won both in sweeping monstrous fashion), but in those races she was put into motion far earlier than she was on Friday.

Again, anyone who knows racing knows that this isn't the first or last time that Pat Lachance has driven a horse like this. But bettors hate it because he often drives decent stock and you just have to guess with him. Lachance gets many accolades from fellow horsepeople and owners for being someone who is always looking out for the horse's best interest, and it shows the consistent rate in which his horses earn money and enjoy longevity.

As a horseplayer myself, what am I realistically supposed to expect from a driver? I'd like an honest effort every time, but these drivers have trainers to answer to, who, in turn, have owners to answer to, and the reality is that protecting a horse's best interest is going to take priority over extending a horse too much to nail down fourth place to complete a \$0.20 superfecta ticket for a guy sitting in an OTB somewhere hundreds of miles away.

It's perhaps a jaded view I carry, but those are the times we are in. No longer do horsepeople need bettors to supply the purses. Just how bad is it for bettors? On Tuesday night it was reported that a race at Yonkers with a \$35,000 purse did a grand total for the race of a measly \$22,000 in handle. It's almost inconceivable.

At the heart of this is the question, is harness racing today still considered a gambling game, first and foremost? It obviously used to be, but the answer isn't so clear today.

Horseplayers still feel it is, which is why they get vocal and question drives, but then there are drivers who realize that their income is derived from the handle of a slot machine and not racing handle.

Regardless of what racing is considered, judges are still put in place to ensure the integrity of the races. Very rarely these days do you ever see or hear of a driver getting days for a lack of effort. This continues to happen with much frequency in other parts of the world, but not here. Is there anything judges or track management can do to give the betting public a fair shake before a questionable drive occurs? In the case of Missile J, is there any protection or "heads up" that could have been given out to alert those less suspecting casual people that in all likelihood they would be wasting their money by supporting this horse? Something similar could go for drivers such as Lachance that have a history of racing conservatively, often not giving bettors the best run for their money.

Part of handicapping harness racing has always been handicapping the drivers. While it's relatively easy to predict horses form from week to week (especially if in the same barn), it's difficult to guess on a driver's strategy or the mood of a driver for any particular race. Most of the time as bettor's we're willing to accept some deviation of strategy from a driver as to what we might expect and we all know that racing luck plays a large part as well, but it's these examples of lackluster drives that can be maddening to a bettor.

This isn't the way the sport wants to model itself under, but when it comes to wagering in today's world of slot racing, it truly is the principle of caveat emptor for the bettors; let the buyer beware. Horses race for more money today than ever while wagering on races is in decline, and many seem okay with it. Until the horsepeople have a need to give further thought to bettors' regards they probably won't. And based on the current structure that they race under, horsepeople would also be correct for taking that approach.

PRESCOTTS HOPE finally got a win last out against lesser and maybe that can be the start of better things for him again; can certainly compete with these if he's over his breaking woes. RISE UP NOW returns to WEG off a crushing score at Flamboro; an obvious short priced contender with these connections from the inside. PROVEN DESIRE showed speed last out and held well; potential longshot play. COOL ROCK was too far out of position last week and McClure will have to do something different to avoid a similar situation. I'll bank on WAZZUP WAZZUP needing one although that was a good return Q by the veteran as he makes his first start for Marfisi.

The sport's busiest driver didn't start out that way

Cat Manzi, the only man in history who drove in more than 90,000 races, had a methodical start to his career in 1968 – the year he turned 18 – and for the next couple of seasons. You could almost say, then anyway, he was just another Manzi in the bike. (Oops, that was meant for John Manzi).

Here's Cat's first five years in the game:

1968 – 6 0-1-1 \$362

1969 – 45 2-11-8 \$5,084

1970 – 60 10-8-5 \$11,066

1971 – 186 22-23-30 \$29,2021

1972 – 329 63-45-52 \$82,243

By 1973 he was the leading drive at the Mighty M, Monticello Raceway. By 1976, he made his way to the Meadowlands and by 2002 he made it to the Hall Of Fame.

Down Under record setters

Paul Jessop was the first trainer to have a sub-1:50 sophomore gelding (1996 – Gee Gee Digger, 1:49.4)

Brett Pelling was the first trainer to win the North America Cup and the Meadowlands Pace in the same year, with the same horse and both wins under 1:50 (1999 – The Panderosa.) Pelling was also the first trainer to send out a sub-1:50 winning freshman (2004 – Rocknroll Hanover, Metro 1:49.4) and the first trainer to send out a sub-1:50 winning three-year-old pacing filly (June 27, 1998 – Armbr Romance in the Ladyship Stakes, 1:49.4).

Nifty Norman was the first trainer to have an undefeated trotter be named Horse of the Year with as many as 17 starts (2013 – Bee A Magician, 17-for-17).

Kelvin Harrison was the first trainer to win in sub-1:49 with a pacing mare (2002 – Frightening P, 1:48.4)

Chris Ryder set the filly combined money record at two and

three (2012-2013 – I Luv The Nitelife, \$1,943,287) breaking the record of his other outstanding pacing filly Put ON A Show.

Mark Harder won the Meadowlands Pace in 2004 with Holborn Hanover at 58-1, the highest price in that race in 41 editions.

Charlie Hunter was the first trainer in Meadowlands history to win a race in 1:55 (Sept. 25, 1976 – Young Quinn, 1:55 with Joe Marsh, Jr. driving).

The two in the \$2 million two-time club

Driver Brian Sears is the only driver to have a \$2.2 million single season with both a trotter and a pacer: 2005 – Rocknroll Hanover (\$2,223,257) and then in 2009 with trotter Muscle Hill (\$2,456,041).

Driver Tim Tetrick is the only driver to do this back-to-back with a \$2 million single-season earner: 2012 – Market Share (\$2,001,403) and 2013 – Captaintreacherous (\$2,005,053).

Before-during-after

This exclusive club of five horsemen made history by capturing a milestone race for the sport and all made the Hall Of Fame. Note that one was already in, one went in that year, and another waited 48 years.

In 1953, in the first \$100,000 event, Harry Harvey won the Hambletonian with Helicopter 48 years before Harvey became a Hall of Famer.

In 1978, in the first \$500,000 event, William Haughton and Falcon Almahurst won the Meadowlands Pace 10 years after Haughton became a Hall of Famer.

In 1979, in the first \$750,000 event, Sonsam won the Meadowlands Pace with George Sholty, who became a Hall of Famer in 1984.

In 1980, in the first \$1 million event, Niatross won the Meadowlands Pace with Clint Galbraith, who became a Hall of Famer in 1989.

In 1980, in the first \$2 million event, Land Grant won the Woodrow Wilson with Del Insko, who went into the Hall of Fame a month prior.

Name this horse

Q. He never started more than 19 times in any season, yet made over \$3.5 million lifetime. Who was this trotter supreme?

A. Magician. He earned \$3.57 million and, three times, had 19 tries in a season, 18 once and 17 once – the latter producing his lone \$1.2 million season (2000).

Common number

What do Niatross, Matts Scooter and Artsplace have in common?

All had 37 career wins. Niatross was 37-for-39, Matts Scotter was 37-for-61 and Artsplace was 37-for-49. All were named Horse of the Year in their last year of racing, with Niatross doubling up at both two and three.

Hey, Buddy

Look at all these Gilmours!

December 20, 1972 at Monticello, four Gilmour brothers competed on the card.

Buddy was 6 2-0-1 (Won the late daily double); George was 4 0-0-1; Lloyd was 3 0-1-1 and John was 6 1-1-3.

In race one, they went 2-3-4, race three 2-3, race five 3-4, and six of the 16 drivers in the 9th and 10th races had the same last name – Gilmour.

Supplements, sometimes they work....

... Sometimes they don't.

In the 2000 Meadowlands Pace, \$150,000 was ponied up by the connections of P B Bullville – who unfortunately didn't make it to the final. Here's the slate for P B Bullville on the year 27 6-3-1, \$124,100 – or \$25,900 less than the supplemental fee. The consolation was that he did set the world sophomore mark of 1:48 at The Red Mile on Sept. 30, 2000, lowering Jennas Beach Boy's mark by four-fifths-of-a-second.

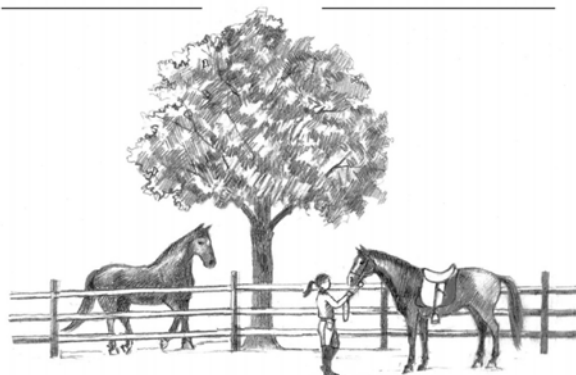

Mr Yokassippi changes barns, drops mark almost two seconds

It was 8-year-old pacing gelding Mr Yokassippi that had the crowd at Flamboro Downs and a few people on social media buzzing last night, with his lifetime-best score in race three.

The modestly-bred LH Stryker gelding out of the Wannamaker mare Township Sharky – the lone winner from the dam from two foals that raced – was making his first start off a Colin Johnson claim, having been taken from a winning effort in a \$6,500 conditioned claimer from trainer Amy Macdonald's barn five days earlier.

Mr Yokassippi certainly knows where the winner's circle is, having won 20 of 72 races prior to the claim last Sunday. Despite stepping up in class and moving up from the \$6,500 conditioned claimer level to a \$8,500 claiming handicap, he was taking plenty of action as the 5-2 second choice. Driver Scott Coulter had designs on racing near the front, but he wisely took back at the start when it appeared a three-pronged battle might materialize soon after the start.

Leader Art Again carved out a serious opening quarter of :26.4 with Mr. Yokassippi biding his time in third. Following a :56 half, the eventual winner made his move first up while the 1-2 favorite Warrawee Phoenix gapped his cover.

With a powerful brush passing the three-quarters in 1:25, Mr Yokassippi easily put away a game but overmatched Art Again and in pacing a :28.4 kicker, the 8-year-old beat his previous lifetime-best mark by one-and-four-fifths seconds. That mark was taken at The Raceway at Western Fair in London in November of 2015 during his 6-year old campaign.

Mr Yokassippi's 1:53.4 clocking was the fastest time of the evening's card by nearly three seconds, a performance that certainly made the veteran buzzworthy.

Blue Moon Stride makes her seasonal debut tonight at the Meadowlands.

Elite group of pacing mares set to battle

One of the top contenders, Blue Moon Stride, will kick off her season tonight at the Meadowlands.

Mention this year's group of older female pacers to Mark Harder and the long-time trainer can only shake his head in amazement.

The division is led by returning Dan Patch Award winner Lady Shadow and bolstered by the arrival of a gifted class of 4-year-olds that includes two-time Dan Patch Award recipient Pure Country and numerous stakes champions, such as Harder's Blue Moon Stride.

"Oh my God, those are good mares," Harder said after watching Blue Moon Stride win a qualifier Saturday at the Meadowlands in her final prep for this season. "Real good mares out there. They'll beat each other up all year, I'm sure."

"I love my mare. I'm not saying that I'm stepping out and beating those other mares by any means, but I'll tell you what, she'll give them a shake."

"We just have to go race now."

Blue Moon Stride will make her seasonal debut tonight in a conditioned race at the Meadowlands. Darlinonthebeach, another of last year's talented 3-year-olds, also is in the eight-horse field.

Of last year's top eight money-winning 3-year-old filly pacers, seven are staked to at least one of this season's most lucrative races for pacing mares. The list features the entire top six — Pure Country, Call Me Queen Be, L A Delight, Darlinonthebeach, Seventimesavirgin, and Blue Moon Stride — as well as number eight I Said Diamonds.

Put those mares in the mix with Lady Shadow as well as returning millionaires Sassa Hanover, Solar Sister, and Venus Delight — as well as stakes-winner Bedroomconfessions and New Zealand-bred newcomer Nike Franco — and it might be the best group of older female pacers since the early 2000s when Eternal Camnation, Bunny Lake, Worldly Beauty, Burning Point, Loyal Opposition, Carolina Sunshine, and Always Cam were among the prominent players.

Blue Moon Stride will start her first test of the year from post four with Andy McCarthy driving for Harder and owners Emilio and Maria Rosati.

She heads to the race off a 1:51.4 qualifier win over Pure Country and Darlinonthebeach last weekend. It was Blue Moon Stride's second qualifier; she finished fourth the first time out.

"I was very disappointed in her (first qualifier)," Harder said. "I just think she fooled me. Even though she trained well, I don't think she was quite as fit as I thought she was. I'm much happier this week."

Last year, Blue Moon Stride won six of 17 races and earned \$407,222 in purses. Her victories included the Mistletoe Shalee, New Jersey Sire Stakes championship, and a division of the Bluegrass Stakes.

Blue Moon Stride was purchased as a weanling for \$27,000 as part of the Perretti Farms dispersal sale at the 2013 Standardbred Mixed Sale. She is a daughter of Rocknroll Hanover out of the mare Classic Star. Her dam is a full sister to Dan Patch Award winners Bettor's Delight and Roll With Joe and a half-sister to 2003 Horse of the Year No Pan Intended.

"As a filly, she was big all along," Harder said of Blue Moon Stride. "She's just continued to grow and fill out. Even muscle wise and weight wise, she's just a bigger mare this year."

"She's pretty much in everything this year but the Graduate. Canada, all around, wherever we can go."

Darlinonthebeach will start Friday's race from post eight with David Miller driving for trainer Nancy Johansson.

The field also includes Prairie Sweetheart, who was undefeated in a total of 14 races at ages two and three before finishing third in her 4-year-old debut two weeks ago. The two-time Florida Breeders Stakes champion defeated older rivals, including Lady Shadow, in last year's Allager Farms Fillies and Mares Pace at Lexington's Red Mile.

Prairie Sweetheart, with John Campbell driving for trainer Ross Croghan, starts from post three tonight.

Rutherford is a harness racing “lifer”

The horsewoman from the Midwest said she loves getting behind the starting gate.

Cathy Rutherford is a harness racing “lifer.” She drove in her first race in 1981, at the age of 14, and has competed as a driver in each of the 36 years since then. She has never started more than 138 races in a season, averaging roughly 65 races per year, but delights in every moment she spends with her small stable of horses.

“I love getting behind the starting gate,” said Rutherford, who is racing this month at Thunder Ridge Raceway in eastern Kentucky. “It’s the greatest feeling in the world; win, lose or draw. I love the traveling, the people, the horses; all of it. I’m always up for a new adventure.”

Rutherford has won 201 races as a driver and 100 races as a trainer. “They all mean something,” she said about the victories. In many cases, the size of the purse is not what was most meaningful.

“They were minor moments when a horse that had a lot of problems made their way to the winner’s circle,” Rutherford said. “I tend to buy problem children that need a little extra TLC or have had bad luck or a bad rap. That I could win a race with one that overcame some great obstacles to get there, I’ve had that a few times.

“It might have been little races for nothing, but those are the big moments.”

One such horse was a female trotter named Fort Riley. She took several years to get to the winner’s circle, but eventually enjoyed a 32-race stretch in which she hit the board 19 times and won four races.

“She was one of my favorites,” Rutherford said. “She went from not wanting to race to being the horse everybody watched on the circuit I raced. She wasn’t a great horse, but she was a special horse.”

Rutherford was born in Michigan and now lives in Illinois. Her father, Ken Rutherford, was a trainer and driver, best known for developing successful Illinois-bred trotters. Cathy jogged her first horse at the age of six and was helping train by the age of nine. Her first race, a matinee, was with a 2-year-old trotter named Cardinal Brandon, who went on to earn \$206,974 in his career.

“I was pretty much born into it,” Rutherford said. “I was the kid you couldn’t keep out of the barn. It was just a given that I was going to racehorses. It was going to happen.

“I’m a lifer.”

Rutherford has worked with horses both on a full-time and part-time basis. She has three horses now, two trotters and one pacer, and spent the offseason doing home construction and remodeling.

“The last few years I don’t race in the winter,” Rutherford said, adding with a laugh, “I’ve become a fair-weather trainer. I’ve cut my stable way back. I used to travel by myself with eight or nine horses. I worked myself into the ground.

“I don’t do it fulltime with a big stable because, like a typical woman, I’m a control freak. I never wanted a big stable because I’ve got to have my hands on everything. That’s why I drive most of my horses, especially my trotters. And the fact I’m a really lousy spectator. I’ve worked too hard to get them to race to have someone else screw it up. If anybody is going to screw it up it’s going to be me.”

Rutherford, following in her father’s footsteps, focuses her efforts on trotters.

“Pacers are like a necessary evil in my barn,” she said, laughing again. “We made millions of dollars with trotters when I was a child. My dad had a knack. I prefer them. They’re more of a challenge. They can be very challenging.

“That’s why I have to color my hair very regularly.”

Rutherford plans to race at several tracks this year, including Bluegrass Downs, Shenandoah Downs, The Red Mile, Hawthorne, and possibly Hoosier Park. She also recently got her license to work in the paddock as an identifier.

For now, though, she is enjoying her return to action at Thunder Ridge.

“We don’t race for any money down here, but I wouldn’t change coming here for anything in the world,” Rutherford said. “It’s beautiful country and the horsemen are nice to each other, they’re supportive of each other. We get some enjoyment out of it.

“It’s a good place to get your horses prepped. We just hope to get ready for bigger and better later in the season.”

As for Rutherford’s greatest thrill in racing? Time will tell.

“I don’t know if I’ve had it yet,” Rutherford said. “I’ve had a lot of fun with my family and a lot of good horses, but I’m going to say my biggest thrill hasn’t happened yet.

“We’ve got something to look forward to.”

US Pacing Championship renamed Sam McKee Memorial

The US Pacing Championship, long one of the signature events on Hambletonian Day, will be renamed The Sam McKee Memorial beginning this August in honor of the track's Hall of Fame announcer and broadcaster who passed away March 8 at the age of 54.

The Meadowlands will also attach McKee's name to its broadcast center that McKee designed when the new grandstand opened in 2013. It will now be called The Sam McKee SNY Broadcast Center. The official dedication is scheduled for Aug. 4, the night before the Hambletonian.

"Sam was a true professional at his job as evidenced by his Hall of Fame status, but his larger than life smile, and gracious attitude is what made him stand tall among his peers," said Jason Settlemoir, Meadowlands GM/COO. "Honoring Sam's legacy with one of our major races only seems fitting and honoring him with the dedication of the SNY Broadcast Center that he worked very hard to put together in the new building only seems fitting as well."

"Sam would never believed himself to be worthy of this, but we know that he would be honored," said Sam's wife, Chris McKee. "Hambletonian Day was always so important to him. It's always a special day and he worked tirelessly along with the rest of the staff to prepare for it and make sure

things went smoothly. We're so proud of Sam and all of his accomplishments and are once again humbled by this memorial race. We're grateful to have been at the Meadowlands for last year's Hambo where we got to see Sam interview one of his favorite NASCAR drivers. While it will never be the same, we look forward to being there on Hambo Day to support the sport that he loved so dearly and to keep his memory alive."

This year's \$225,000 Sam McKee Memorial is Aug. 5 as part of the super stakes Hambletonian Day program. The US Pacing Championship was first held in 1982 and has been won by such legends as Cam Fella, Matt's Scooter, and Artsplace and in more recent years, Won The West, Sweet Lou, and last year in an upset by Shamballa over Horses of the Year Wiggle It Jiggleit and Always B Miki.

The U.S. Harness Writers Association Breakthrough Award recipient in 2015 is widely respected for his deep understanding of handicapping, wagering, and horsemen's issues.

Top homebred trotting mare Allerage Star (5,M) has been retired due to a fractured pelvis. Allerage Star, a daughter of Angus Hall out of the trotting mare Starry Eyed (Muscles Yankee), owned by Jeff Gural's Little E LLC, David Stolz, Arthur Geiger and Jason Settlemaier, earned more than \$415,000 in 62 career starts. The "quick footed" mare won 17 of those 62 starts, while finishing first, second or third 36 times. Allerage Star took a lifetime mark last year of 1:52.3 at Mohegan Sun at Pocono Downs.

Allerage Star made her last career start at Harrah's Philadelphia where she finished fourth and was immediately sent to New Bolton Veterinarian Clinic where the x-rays revealed a fractured pelvis. Allerage Star was immediately retired and sent home to Jeff and Paula Gural's Allerage Farm in Stanfordville, NY where she will be bred to Father Patrick.

Jeff Gural noted, "We had a lot of fun with Allerage Star. We thought she was ready for another big year and we staked her pretty heavily, but that's horse racing. I look forward to seeing her babies racing on the track as she had a big heart with plenty of go. Hopefully that will translate into fast offspring."

Allerage Farm has been in the standardbred breeding industry since the late 1980s. Currently, they have two breeding facilities, one in Stanfordville, NY and one in Sayre, PA. Allerage Farm has over 100 horses between the two locations.

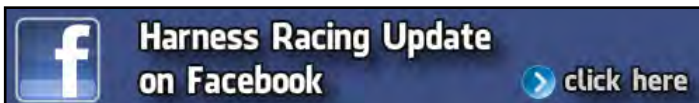

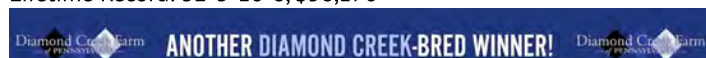

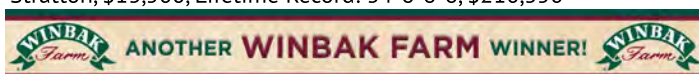
