Ron Rocks in Confederation Cup

Rockin Ron posted a 1:50.1 Canadian record for older pacers on a half-mile track while winning the \$244,000 Confederation Cup Sunday on a chilly night at Flamboro Downs.

On an unseasonably cold night with frost warnings in effect, driver Yannick Gingras was concerned about the front-end holding up Sunday (May 15) at Flamboro Downs for Rockin Ron in the \$244,000 Confederation Cup. Trainer Ron Burke said he secretly shared similar concerns, especially since he knew the front was where Rockin Ron had to be if he had a chance to beat U.S. Horse of the Year Wiggle It Jiggleit. Yet, despite some apprehension, Burke — who had three horses in the nine-horse field — told Gingras not to worry.

“He told me, ‘the right horse hasn’t been on the front, yet. Don’t worry about it. Just race him,’” Gingras said. “He sure was right. He pumped this horse up and he went a big mile. At the wire, honestly, he was just starting to get going. If we went around again he was going to win anyway. I never touched him with the whip. I am ultra impressed by him.”

Despite less than ideal conditions, Rockin Ron, the 4-5


second choice, set a 1:50.1 Canadian half-mile track record for older pacers by defeating the 3-5 favorite Wiggle It Jiggleit and Montrell Teague by three-quarters-of-a-length with a gate-to-wire victory out of post four. Rockin Ron sprinted home in :26.3.

“Give credit to the horse that won,” said Wiggle It Jiggleit’s owner George Teague. “That horse went a big mile, 1:50.1 at night and it’s a little chilly. They sprinted home a pretty good quarter. That’s a pretty good sprint on a half at any time.”

Teague said Wiggle It Jiggleit, who started from the trailing nine hole, "was much better than last week" when the pacer came up a bit sick after finishing second at Mohawk to Nickle Bag in the \$26,180 preferred.

"I hope when we get a chance to scope him that he's better than he was the last time. That was my main concern that he healed up in eight, nine days. But he raced really well tonight," Teague said of Wiggle It Jiggleit.

Rodeo Romeo was two-and-a-half lengths back of the winner in third for trainer Chris Ryder and driver Brett Miller. Rockin In Heaven was fourth for trainer Ian Moore and driver Trevor Henry, while Ryder trainee National Seelster (Sylvain Filion) grabbed the last check.

It was the first Confederation Cup victory for Gingras and second straight for Burke, who won the 2015 edition with All Bets Off the first year the race was changed from a three-year-old event with same-day heats to a four-year-old

event with eliminations and a final a week apart.

"Since they made it an aged race, we're pretty good at it," said Burke of the race that took a two-year hiatus prior to last year's edition in the wake of the cancellation of Ontario's Slots at Racetracks Program.

This year marked the 38th edition of the Confederation Cup and the 10th straight win for Rockin Image going back to November. The son of Real Desire out of Im All A Roan has never lost for Burke, who purchased the Indiana-bred gelded pacer with Weaver BrusceMI LLC and RTC Stables Inc. of Canonsburg, PA from Rockin Ron's breeders Ron Phillips of Athens, IL and Louis Leinberger of Springfield, IL and their partner Jesse Ferge of Platterville, CO.

"The Indiana horses the last couple of years have done well everywhere," Burke said. "We're always looking to buy and at the end of the year the people finally wanted to sell... We almost had him bought at the beginning of the year and, basically, we dropped the ball on it. In the long run, maybe it was better for the horse. He didn't race as hard as if we would have had him. The people did a good job with him and (trainer Jon Anderson) taught him to be a good racehorse. We just reaped the benefits.

"We raced him once last year, he was super impressive. We turned him out and brought him back and figured we'd have

an open horse that we could race. He's just been way more than we even figured."

Rockin Ron is a perfect 10-for-10 this year for earnings exceeding \$200,000. The pacer has a career record of 19-2-4 in 40 starts and earnings of more well north of \$300,000.

"Yannick really thought he had more left, so that's just another step in the right direction and now we start trying to figure out where we go from here," Burke said, indicating the Graduate at the Meadowlands was next on the agenda.

Meanwhile, Teague said that if Wiggle It Jiggleit scopes well, he's thinking of dropping the gelded son of Mr Wiggles—Mozzi Hanover into the \$200,000 Battle of Lake Erie Saturday (May 21) at Northfield Park versus Freaky Feet Pete.

"I hope in mid-season he's still pounding away like he started out the season," Teague said of Wiggle It Jiggleit, who has lost back-to-back starts, but still sports a 4-3-0 record in seven starts good for seasonal earnings of some \$200,000.

Freaky Feet Pete extends winning streak to three

Undefeated Freaky Feet Pete continued his winning ways Saturday (May 14) in the featured event, a \$21,000 invitational pace at Hoosier Park Racing & Casino. Racing fans turned out on a chilly night and the hometown hero did not disappoint, scoring in 1:50 by five lengths.

Starting from post six, Freaky Feet Pete was unhurried from the gate this week by regular pilot Trace Tetrack and settled along the rail in fourth. Fearless Diablo and LeWayne Miller got the first call through an opening quarter in :26.4 but their lead would be short lived. Tetrack gave Freaky Feet Pete the green light and the duo surged up to take command at the second station in :55.1.

Reaching the three-quarters in 1:23, Freaky Feet Pete was on top by three and never seriously challenged en route to his third straight victory. Using a :27 final quarter and under no urging from Tetrack, Freaky Feet Pete finished five lengths in front of Nitro and John Delong. Shooter's Dream and Jason Dillander rallied for third place honors. As the heavy betting favorite, Freaky Feet Pete returned \$2.10 to his backers at the windows.

"He (Freaky Feet Pete) was very good tonight," Tetrack said after the win. "I raced him off the gate tonight, it wasn't necessarily the plan but that's just how it looked when the wings folded. You can do anything you want with him. He's very sharp right now."

With the win, Freaky Feet Pete notched the third win of his four-year-old campaign and 27th career victory from 30 lifetime outings for trainer Larry Rheinheimer. The homebred son of Rockin Image—Skyway Lori has now earned \$1,147,224 lifetime for his owners Mary Jo Rheinheimer and

Marty Rheinheimer.

Rheinheimer's star pupil will head to Northfield Park for his first major stakes engagement of the season, the \$200,000 Battle of Lake Erie at Northfield Park on May 21. When Freaky Feet Pete lines up behind the gate it will be the first time he has raced over a half-mile track.

"He trains on a half-mile track at home," Rheinheimer said after the win. "I'm really not worried at all about him getting around the track; I think he will take to it just fine. I think the post position will matter but I'm not worried about how he will get around the smaller track.

"He's definitely matured some this year. It's hard to tell if he's the best he's ever been, but he's happy and seems good. We will know more next after his race but this was a good race for him tonight, I think he's ready to go."

As Promised to Counter Strike

Counter Strike added another stakes title to his resume and pushed his win streak into the double-digits with a victory in the \$30,000 final of the As Promised Stakes on Sunday (May 15) at Century Downs near Calgary, AB.

Trainer/driver Travis Cullen and Jerry Hagenaaers co-own the four-year-old son of Camystic—Cai Hanover, who now boasts back-to-back stakes titles after sweeping his eliminations and the finals of the Prairie Boys in April and As Promised this month.

In the As Promised final, Counter Strike took back to seventh early on from his outer post while Royal Renegade (Mike Hennessy) got off to a quick start with Man Of Many Arts (Phil Giesbrecht) driving up to find a spot in the pocket.

Royal Renegade posted a 28-second opening panel and began to back down the pace to the half in :58.1. Meanwhile, Cullen made his move with Counter Strike and they began to pick off rivals.

Counter Strike worked to clear Royal Renegade before the final turn as the pace picked up to three-quarters in 1:25.1 and then opened up two lengths on top en route to the 1:55.1 victory. Royal Renegade chased the roan gelding home, finishing nearly four lengths behind, while Man Of Many Arts (Phil Giesbrecht) tried to improve his position as he rallied outside down the stretch, but stayed for third.

Counter Strike was the 3-5 favorite and paid \$3.40 to win.

The As Promised Stakes was for three and four-year-old male pacers that are non-winners of \$35,000 lifetime as of December 31, 2015. Counter Strike has prospered in his four-year-old campaign, winning 11 of his 12 races this year and adding over \$65,000 to his bankroll.
