No Battle

The much-hoped-for battle between Freaky Feet Pete and Wiggle It Jiggleit never materialized as Montrell Teague took full advantage of the rail to pilot Wiggle It Jiggleit to an easy 1:49.4 victory Saturday in Northfield Park's \$200,000 Battle of Lake Erie

Wiggle It Jiggleit and Montrell Teague used the rail to their advantage and dominated the \$200,000 Battle of Lake Erie Saturday at Northfield Park

In pre-race interviews, Wiggle It Jiggleit's owner George Teague said he wished Freaky Feet Pete wasn't in Saturday night's \$200,000 Battle of Lake Erie.

Perhaps Teague should save his wishes for more difficult assignments.

Making the most of starting from the rail post, Wiggle It Jiggleit, the 2015 Horse of the Year and winner of the Little Brown Jug, went gate-to-wire to post an easy four-and-a-quarter-length victory over longshot All Bets Off. Freaky Feet Pete, after a brief challenge leaving the half-mile pole, faded to third, another one-and-a-half lengths behind the runner-up.

Luck Be Without was fourth, followed by Santa Fe Beachboy, Foiled Again, Roland N Rock, and Ideal Cowboy.

Wiggle It Jiggleit, winning for the fifth time in eight starts this year, was timed in 1:49.4.

The victory was so easy that as he approached the finish

Though Wiggle It Jiggleit would not stay put in the winner's circle (as is his custom), there was a strong showing by his connections and fans.

line, driver Montrell Teague turned his head towards the winner's circle and smiled broadly.

"At the half, I looked over and saw Freaky Feet Pete and knew it was going to be a war," said Montrell.

The war was a short one. Soon after straightening out on the backstretch, Wiggle It Jiggleit, full of pace after a snail-like opening quarter of 28 seconds and a half in :55.4 seconds, gradually pulled away from Freaky Feet Pete.

Contributing to the soft opening quarter was Ideal Cowboy, pacing out of the No. 2 post, who broke stride before the start.

"I thought we would go fast early because my horse was ready to roll," said Teague. "I had a hard time holding him. But even if we had (gone faster), he was fine."

Wiggle It Jiggleit was ready for more racing after pulling up. He was so frisky entering the winner's circle that he was in and out of it in a matter of seconds.

"He was better tonight than he was last week (second in the Confederation Cup), and last week he was better than the week before" said owner George Teague. "He was fighting a sore foot and a bit of sickness, but he has raced through it."

The loss for Freaky Feet Pete ended his nine-race winning streak that dated back to Oct. 3.

World record appetizer

Earlier on the Battle of Lake Erie card, Muscle Up The Goal went gate-to-wire to win the open trot in world and track record time. His 1: 52.3 clocking broke the world record for a four-year-old trotter on a half-mile track by a full second. The standard was set last year by Credit Fashion at Northfield. Muscle Up The Goal also crushed Northfield's overall trot record time of 1:53.2, set by Daylon Magician and Victory Is Coming last year on the same race card.

Racing for owners Synerco Ventures Inc and trainer Christopher Beaver and driven by Aaron Merriman, Muscle Up The Goal won off by three-and-a-half lengths Saturday night. The victory was his second in as many 2016 starts. Muscle Up The Goal began the season by capturing the open trot on the five-eighths oval at Scioto Downs in the same time as his Northfield score.

Indiana Rising

Thanks to top stakes horses Wiggle It Jiggleit, Freaky Feet Pete, Always B Miki, Rockin Ron, Colors A Virgin, Natural Herbie and more, Indiana-sired horses are all the rage on the Grand Circuit.

When the trio of Colors A Virgin, Freaky Feet Pete and Always B Miki splashed to Breeders Crown victories last fall at Woodbine, their success shined the spotlight on Indiana's once-overlooked breeding program. While those breakthrough victories brought new attention to the Hoosier State, they are less the exception and more a growing trend as Indiana-sired horses show they can compete on the national stage with greater frequency.

The biggest story of 2015 was the emergence of superhorse Wiggle It Jiggleit. He excited the racing world with his stellar 22 for 26 record, \$2.18 million in seasonal earnings, and gutsy victory in the Little Brown Jug. But before he was voted Horse of the Year, he was first an Indiana-sired product from an up-and-coming program.

The headlines aren't limited to these four. Natural Herbie shined in 2014 with an impressive victory in the Nat Ray and later in the \$250,000 International Trot Preview at Yonkers.

Before she was a Breeders Crown champion, Colors A Virgin carried the banner for Indiana with a win in the 2014 Jugette. Then seven-year-old Radar Contact claimed victory in the \$150,000 Betsy Ross last year, defeating top pacing mare Anndrovette. Always At My Place set a 1:47.2 world record last August at Mohegan Sun at Pocono Downs. Real Desire-sired Rockin Ron added his name to the list by virtue of his stellar 1:50.1 Confederation Cup victory, setting a Canadian record in the process. And Friday night the Indiana-sired trotter Rose Run Parker turned heads at the Meadowlands with a lightning-fast 1:50.4 in the \$25,000 Open Handicap.

"It definitely brings more attention to the program," said Jessica Barnes, director of Standardbred racing and breed development at the Indiana Horse Racing Commission. "It puts us in the same league as states that are producing top foals. For those that have never looked at Indiana, it shows we are a player in the industry."

That is a dramatic change from how the Indiana program was perceived as recently as a decade ago. The Crossroads of America was once a destination for stallions given a second chance after not succeeding in other states. The best of the program often struggled to make headway outside Indiana's borders in Grand Circuit and open competition. The perception has changed, but it has taken time and a change in the landscape. The addition of slots at Indiana's two racetracks in 2008 served as the catalyst.

When Always A Virgin retired and stood in Indiana beginning with the 2009 breeding season it signaled a new day in the program. Never before had a stallion with the credentials of this Western Ideal stud come to Indiana directly from the racetrack. Getting him to Victory Hill Farm in Lagrange, IN was not "automatic" due to slots says Maria King, who operates the farm with her husband, Jeff.

"I think the owners saw the potential in Indiana," she explained. "It took a little faith on their part, but it's really

worked out for them.”

Always A Virgin's early success helped pave the way for other top-flight stallions to call Indiana home, but again, it wasn't automatic. The arrival and instant success of stallion Rockin Image helped solidify Indiana as a player in the industry. This season, Victory Hill has received well over 250 applicants to breed to Rockin Image. Always A Virgin's book is nearly full, as is Yankee Glide stallion Guccio, whose first crop will sell at auction this fall. Swan For All, one of the top trotting sires in Indiana, also has a full book for 2016.

“To have three Breeders Crown winners in one season is just amazing. It shows that Indiana can compete on a national level and it wasn't a fluke,” King said. “It changes the mentality and shows that you can stand a stallion here and be competitive.”

Raising the standard has also changed the mentality of those breeding in Indiana. Now, breeders can't wait until after their foals drop before deciding to which stallion they will breed their mares. In order to book to the top stallions in the state, that decision has to be made much earlier. Alvin Schwartz, owner of Schwartz Boarding Farm, brought Time To Roll to Indiana for 2016. A Rocknroll Hanover brother to Rockin Image, the stud was well received in his first season.

“By January 15 his book was full or closed,” Schwartz said.

“He could have bred a book of 200 mares. I was very, very happy with the interest.”

While slots were the catalyst, interest in the Indiana program has fueled what has become a cyclical effect. More interest has produced a better yearling market. Bullish buyers have provided the capital breeders need to improve their broodmares, thus raising the quality of Indiana-sired yearlings in years to come. That strong market also encourages breeders not currently participating in the program to take another look at Indiana. And while buyers have invested in the Indiana product, a lucrative Indiana Sires Stakes program has helped draw more interest to a program that is not limited to regional status, but is producing Grand Circuit-level talent like Always B Miki, Colors A Virgin, Freaky Feet Pete and Wiggle It Jiggleit.

Steve Cross, sale manager for Hoosier Classic Sale Company, LLC, sees the improvement with each catalog he assembles. In last year's Hoosier Classic sale, a little over 16 percent of the yearlings cataloged were first foals, showing that reinvestment by breeders. When adding in those that were second foals, the number nearly doubles.

“Our breeders have really stepped up to the plate with the quality of mares they have purchased,” Cross noted. “No question, the quality of the pedigrees has improved. We've

got mares that I would stack up against any of the better regional programs.”

Cross has seen many new faces at the Hoosier Classic sale purchasing yearlings as of late. Last fall there were 63 new buyers. The year before the sale produced similar results. It shows that interest in the program continues to increase and Indiana-sired horses are marketable, something that is also reflected in the trends Barnes is seeing. According to USTA statistics, 2,824 Indiana-sired horses started in North America in 2015, earning a cumulative \$49.3 million in purses. Of that total, more than half – \$26 million to be exact – was earned outside Indiana. Last year a total of 29 Indiana-sired horses earned \$100,000 or more competing in the state. A group of 90 horses earned at least \$50,000 racing in Indiana last season.

“I’ve gotten a lot of calls from people that want to know

how the program works or are first-time Indiana-sired owners,” added Barnes. “I’ve heard from people a few days before the Blooded Horse Sale or shortly after that have purchased an Indiana-sired horse or intend to that have never participated in the Indiana program. It further sends the message that we have a valuable program in Indiana that shouldn’t be overlooked.”

**HANOVER WILL SELL YEARLINGS AT
GOSHEN, OHIO AND HARRISBURG**

John Campbell has driven a long list of the greatest horses to ever pull a sulky. But the horse that changed his life was a more modest standardbred that came along at a time that was fortuitous in more ways than one.

Argyel Chester was foaled on the Campbell family's farm near Ailsa Craig, ON on April 8, 1966. It was the night of Campbell's 11th birthday and Argyel Chester arrived while the family was out for dinner to celebrate.

"We went to London and came back and he was there," Campbell said. "He was a sharp-looking colt. He was a pretty chestnut horse and I just fell in love with him."

The foal was a Newport Duke colt out of Argyel Margaret, a mare owned by John's grandmother, Bernice.

"My grandmother gave me half of him for a birthday present. It was really great," Campbell said.

Argyel Chester went on to win \$91,323 and set a mark of 2:00.2 racing mostly in the top classes at Western Fair Raceway in London.

More importantly, Argyel Chester gave John Campbell some status at North Middlesex District High School in Parkhill, ON; status that went beyond the fact that Argyel Chester's racing exploits were regularly chronicled in the *London Free Press*.

"I had money in high school," Campbell said. Enough money to buy a brand new Oldsmobile Cutlass. "It was a nice car."

While that status — and the connection to his grandmother — was important, Campbell said another horse was more responsible for setting him on a course to becoming the most successful money-winning driver in the sport's history (\$296 million and counting).

"The one that I raced against the top horses at a young age was Derbys Gent... Derbys Gent was the first time I went to Roosevelt. I was 20 or 21 years old, I think," Campbell said. "We were racing at Monticello and he had won his way out of Monticello and they invited us down for just a special free-for-all. Then he raced against Rambling Willie and Handle With Care in the Provincial Cup at Windsor. He gave me a chance to see racing at the highest level."

Iron Mine Bucky overcomes tough start, sloppy surface in Currier & Ives

Iron Mine Bucky survived a miserable first quarter in the slop and went on to capture the faster division of Saturday's (May 21) \$116,304 Currier & Ives at The Meadows. Cufflink Hanover took the other division in the stake for three-year-old colt and gelding trotters.

Iron Mine Bucky hadn't raced since winning an Oct. 2 Keystone Classic split at The Meadows, and he got just the sort of journey — stuck outside — winning driver George Dennis didn't want.

"I wasn't expecting to get that rough a trip," Dennis said. "They didn't go that much early, and he got a little excited — first time out, first time in the mud. I didn't want to wrestle him back to last."

But the Hambletonian-eligible son of Explosive Matter—My Foolish Dream persevered on the outside and overpowered the leader, 2-5 favorite Hititoutofthepark. Iron Mine Bucky prevailed in 1:55.2, one-and-a-half lengths better than Steed, while Hititoutofthepark saved show.

"He really trotted strong up the backside and turned in a big mile," Dennis said. "I'm very, very pleased."

Greg Haverstick trains Iron Mine Bucky, who extended his career bankroll to \$132,023, for Iron Mine Branch LLC.

Cufflink Hanover has won three of four starts since adding hobbles, and he again looked useful and professional. He worked out a pocket trip behind Truemass Volo, then blew by him in the lane to triumph in 1:55.4. Hollywood Highway found late room for second, two lengths back, with Truemass Volo third.

"He's been getting lucky with his trips, and he's been racing good," said winning driver David Miller, who owns the Andover Hall—CR Savoie Faire gelding with the Enzed Racing Stable of the colt's trainer, Nifty Norman. "He seemed way sharper today than he did last week. He's coming along really nice."

Saturday's rain-soaked program also featured the filly division of the Currier & Ives, with Goodtogo Hanover rolling

to her seventh consecutive victory. Lookin Sharp erased a sizable deficit to take the other split.

Goodtogo Hanover was away second for Brian Zendt, who moved her to the point before the quarter. The daughter of Explosive Matter—Grammy Hall held off the late challenge of the pocket-sitting Witness the princess by three-quarters of a length in 1:56.4. Moots completed the ticket.

Goodtogo Hanover, who vaulted over \$100,000 in career earnings, is undefeated in seven outings this year, but she showed again that she can be a handful until the gate folds.

"She was a little wild behind the gate — oh my gosh," Zendt said. "She had her head hung up on the gate for a minute. She was so mad I don't know how she didn't run. She makes you worry, but as long as you don't have her doubled up and mad, she'll be okay. She doesn't want to run. All she wants to do is get out of there."

Bill Zendt conditions Goodtogo Hanover and owns with Gary Saul.

Lookin Sharp, the 4-5 favorite, trailed the leader, Sunset Glider, by three lengths at the three-quarters when Matt Kakaley suggested it was time to get busy. She tracked down Sunset Glider and downed her by a neck in 1:57, with My Pink Bike third.

"Of all the horses we sent to Florida (for the winter), she's probably one of the horses who grew up and matured the most," said Tyler Butenschoen, assistant to winning trainer John Butenschoen. "I saw a big difference in her. She showed late in the year she could go with the best fillies. The more the year went on, the more she learned and the better she got."

William Wiswell and M & L of Delaware campaign the daughter of Andover Hall—Warrawee Krisp, who soared over \$200,000 in career earnings.

George Napolitano, Jr. wins nine Saturday races

George Napolitano Jr. wound up with five wins on Saturday evening's card at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono. Added to his four wins at Harrah's Philadelphia in the afternoon, he had a nine-winner day.

Napolitano's final victory, in race 13 of the 14-race card, was by a nose with the trotter Mandela Blue Chip, who earned a new mark of 1:53.4 in edging Upfront Billy – driven by Napolitano's brother, Anthony.

For the day, George had a record of 24 9-5-6.

L A Delight and Caprice Hill among SBOA elim winners

O'Brien Award winner L A Delight (Randy Waples) won her 2016 debut Saturday at Mohawk.

A crowd of thousands packed Mohawk Racetrack Saturday (May 21) night for Fireworks and Family Fun Night and got to enjoy an action-packed 10-race card.

The eliminations for the S.B.O.A Stakes for Ontario-sired three-year-old fillies highlighted the card and featured the return of a pair of divisional champions.

A total of 21 three-year-old pacing fillies were split into two \$25,000 eliminations.

The second pacing elimination featured the return of O'Brien Award winner L A Delight and she did not disappoint.

The Bob McIntosh trained filly left from post-nine and dropped in fifth in the early stages. Driven by Randy Waples, L A Delight came to the outside entering the far turn and was situated second-over at the three-quarter pole.

In the stretch, L A Delight ripped off cover and marched by her rivals to win by a three-quarters of a length in 1:52.2. Thatsoveryverynice, who was third-over around the final turn, finished second, while Lady Marina battled hard after leading throughout the middle-half to finish third.

Free Show and Noone To Depend On finished fourth and fifth to qualify for next week's final.

A daughter of Bettors Delight—West Of L A, L A Delight was making her season debut Saturday after winning 11 of 12 starts as a rookie. The McIntosh trainee won the Shes A Great Lady and OSS Super Final last season and finished with earnings of over \$704,000.

L A Delight paid \$2.40 to win.

Good Will Hanover delivered an impressive performance to win the first elimination in a career-best 1:51.1.

The Dr. Ian Moore trainee left hard to grab the early lead, but was overtaken in the second quarter by Mayhem Seelster. Good Will Hanover stalked behind the leader and made her move in the stretch to surge by for driver Chris Christoforou to score the victory by a length and a quarter.

Mayhem Seelster finished second, while Lay Lady Lay was third. The final two horses to qualify for the final were Tonightimlovingyou and Divas Image.

A daughter of Big Jim—Go For Best, Good Will Hanover is trained by Moore for owners GLB Stable. Saturday's victory was her first win in two starts this season and fifth overall.

Good Will Hanover pushed her career earnings to over \$177,000 with the victory. She paid \$12 to win.

A group of 22 sophomore trotting fillies were split into two \$25,000 eliminations.

O'Brien Award winner Caprice Hill looked impressive in winning the first elimination in 1:53.1. The Tony Alagna trainee got away fifth from post-nine and was sent first-up by driver Randy Waples heading into the first turn.

Danish Darby held a length-advantage over the first-up challenger at the three-quarter pole in 1:25. In the stretch, Caprice Hill cruised home in :28 to overtake the lead and secure the victory by a length and three-quarters in 1:53.1.

Danish Darby finished second, while Tymal Tempest was third. P L Jill and Moonlight Cocktail rounded out the top-five to qualify for next week's final.

A daughter of Kadabra—Bramasole, Caprice Hill is trained by Alagna for owner Tom Hill. The sophomore trotting filly was making her season debut after a stellar seven wins in 10 starts as a rookie.

Caprice Hill pushed her career earnings over \$600,000 with Saturday's victory. She paid \$3 to win.

Celebrity Eventsy was an easy winner in the second elimination. The Staffan Lind trainee took the lead in the second-quarter and never looked back en route to a 1:54.1 victory.

Sylvain Filion guided Celebrity Eventsy to the three-and-a-half length victory Saturday. She finished off her mile in :28.2 to secure the victory over runner-up Flowers N Songs.

Jangone finished third, while Dottie and Major Muscle rounded out the top-five.

A daughter of Manofmanymissions—Little Ms Queenie, Celebrity Eventsy was making her season debut Saturday after posting four wins in 10 starts last season. She is trained by Lind for owners Celebrity Farms LLC.

Celebrity Eventsy has earned over \$239,000 in 11 career starts. She paid \$2.80 to win.

Also on Saturday, the popular older pacer Shamballa not only posted his first victory of 2016, but also the nation's fastest mile of the year.

The Rick Zeron trainee took the lead on the way to half and posted fractions of :54.1 and 1:21.1 before sizzling home in :27 to win by six-lengths in 1:48.1. Shamballa was making his second start of the season and competing in a \$25,000 conditioned event.

A six-year-old gelded son of Somebeachsomewhere—Bolero Takara, Shamballa has become a popular horse on the WEG circuit due to his signature closing speed. The Zeron trainee opted to do all the work on the front-end Saturday and picked up his 21st career win.

Shamballa pushed his career earnings over \$500,000 with his first win of 2016. He banked over \$358,000 last season.

Southwind Frank dominant in 2016 debut

All systems appear to be go for early Hambletonian favorite Southwind Frank, who marched to an easy two-and-a-half-length win in his first start as a three-year-old in a division of the New Jersey Sire Stakes for trotting colts and geldings Friday (May 20) night at the Meadowlands.

"He was Frank," said winning trainer Ron Burke. "He couldn't have been any better. It's what we expect from him."

The son of Muscle Hill—Flawless Lindy was unhurried early, and made his way to the top shortly after vacating the four hole at the three-eighths after an initial quarter of :27.4.

Meeting little in the way of resistance, driver Yannick Gingras was able to relax his colt and cut moderate fractions of :57 and 1:25 before kicking home in :27.1 to win going away in a lifetime-best 1:52.1. Brooklyn Hill was second while Bar Hopping finished third.

As the 1-9 public choice, Southwind Frank, who is now 12-for-13 lifetime, returned \$2.20 to win for owners Southwind Frank Partners.

Earlier on the card, All The Time (\$2.10), a major Hambletonian Oaks contender, crushed seven overmatched foes by seven-and-a-quarter lengths in a division of the NJSS for three-year-old trotting fillies in 1:53.2, a lifetime mark. Hilosophical was second with Southwind Pearl third.

Once again, it was Gingras calling the shots, but this time it was with a Jimmy Takter trainee. The 2015 Breeders Crown champion has now won eight of 13 lifetime starts for owners Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld.

The 12th race 20 cent Jackpot Super High Five, which has not been hit the entire meeting, failed to have a single-ticket

Favorites vanquished in Vernon NYSS

Neither favorite prevailed in New York Sire Stakes action at Vernon Downs on Saturday (May 21) evening, with three-year-old trotting colts Smalltownthrowdown (\$8.70) and Sir Royson (\$42.00) winning their respective \$61,300 events.

In the first division, carded as race six, Smalltownthrowdown yielded to even-money choice Allerage Echo (Jim Morrill, Jr.) upon reaching the backstretch, vacating the pegs and dueling to a one-and-a-quarter length victory after enjoying a clear tracking journey. Trainer Dan Daley drove the Cash Hall—Ann's Promise colt to a 1:56 score over sloppy going, defeating Allerage Echo by one-and-a-quarter lengths. Third-place finisher A Jersey Contract (Jeff Gregory) was two-and-three-quarter lengths farther back.

Ann-Mari Daley, James Crawford, IV, Donald Renner, and Richard Lombardo own Smalltownthrowdown.

The complexion of the eighth-race second division changed entirely when 2-5 favorite Dayson (Morrill) broke stride at race's midpoint. Jim Marohn, Jr. worked Sir Royson out of traffic on the far turn, drawing off to a three-and-a-quarter length victory in 1:56 after reeling in pacesetter Sweet Royalty (Gregory) in upper stretch. The Crazy—Leibovitz Hanover colt sprinted off through a :27.4 final quarter mile to defeat Dexter Cup winner Dante (Oskar Florhed) and Reve Royale (Chris Lems) for trainer Linda Toscano and owner R-and-I Farms, LLC.

Marohn led all drivers with three wins on the 12-race program, also teaming up with Southern Palms (\$15.60, 1:57.2) and Uncle Mack (\$21.40, 1:58.1) in \$15,000 Excelsior A events.

Gerries Sport posts first sub-1:50 mile by a sophomore in 2016

Just a week away from the start of the Ontario Sires Stakes season, three-year-old pacing colt Gerries Sport put his rivals on notice with a sizzling 1:49.2 performance Friday (May 20) night at Mohawk Racetrack.

The Richard Moreau trained colt competed in a non-winners of three-races or \$75,000 lifetime event Friday night, which featured three Pepsi North America Cup eligibles, Arsenic, Bettor Memories and Nocturnal Bluechip.

Gerries Sport entered Friday's race with two victories in three starts this season. His only defeat was a gritty fourth-place effort on May 7 in The Diplomat Series final.

Driven by Sylvain Filion, Gerries Sport left from post-five and found a spot in third, while four-year-old Asap Hanover blasted to the front just ahead of Arsenic. There was little movement early on, as Asap Hanover posted solid fractions of :26.3 and :54.2.

Approaching the three-quarter pole, Filion pulled on the right line to send Gerries Sport after the leader. The challenger pulled to within less than two-lengths of the lead at the third-marker, as Asap Hanover reached that station in 1:22.1.

In the stretch, Gerries Sport powered by Asap Hanover to grab clear command with an eighth of a mile to go. The Moreau trainee cruised home confidently in :26.4 to win by two-lengths in 1:49.2.

Asap Hanover finished second, while Arsenic was third in his season debut. Pepsi North America Cup eligibles Bettor Memories and Nocturnal Bluechip finished fifth and seventh, respectively.

A son of Mach Three—Perfect Sport, Gerries Sport competed primarily in the Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Grassroots as a two-year-old, but appears more than ready to tackle the Gold level this season. Moreau trains the sophomore pacing colt for owner Gerrie Tucker of Montreal.

Gerries Sport's third win in four starts this season brings his career record to six wins in 16 starts for earnings of \$71,453. He is now North America's fastest three-year-old of 2016. His clocking of 1:49.2 lowered the previous mark of 1:50.2 set by War N Munn in The Diplomat Final on May 7 at Mohawk.

Gerries Sport paid \$5.90 to win.

Critique of Gural response

I just finished reading the Jeff Gural response to the criticisms of The Meadowlands that have been published in HRU and my thoughts went to the old movie, The Good The Bad and The Ugly, because I would title his response, The Very Good, The I Don't Know and The Very Ugly.

The Very Good — I think it's great that he takes the time to respond to the criticisms with comprehensive explanations. While some may gloss over his responses because those folks have fixed mindsets that things will always be awful, others are learning, while still more are reading the explanations for the first time. I know how frustrating it has been for him and the bettors to be unable to stop the courtesy tucks that diminish the quality of racing. We really need a real racing commission. As for the lack of quality of the horses, I would like to add my humble opinion that management at Pocono Downs cards quality races on Saturday night with malice towards The Meadowlands. Their handle on Saturday is atrocious and they lose money by racing then. The only thing it accomplishes is keeping the top drivers and better horses from racing in New Jersey. Oh, if we only had a real racing commission. Most of the industry and the bettors appreciate what Mr. Gural has done for harness racing. We did note that he added \$6 million of his own money to purses. Harness racing should be concerned about the future of the sport if Mr. Gural gets overwhelmed by the frustration and bails.

Three I Don't Knows:

IDK 1 — I am skeptical about the success of the referendum to add northern casinos. Mr. Gural is correct to save his bullets until we get closer to Election Day, but I believe the people in southern New Jersey will overwhelmingly vote against it and casino owners from neighboring states will pool their resources to match the positive marketing with stronger negative marketing. We shall see.

IDK 2 — As for the criticism against the lack of consistency, the criticism should continue. Bettors never know how a judge will react to a pylon infraction. It appears that horses are not considered off the course if they leave the course after one pylon, then return to the course before reaching the next pylon even though the head on shot proves they left the course. In addition, has any horse ever been disqualified for leaving the course on the first turn? I have never seen one DQed. It is not that uncommon and it certainly is an unfair advantage when the end result is a photo finish. I have many other examples, but I think somebody raised the issue of needing a real racing commission. Maybe not.

IDK 3 — I get frustrated when I hear about the time zone differential as being a road block to comingling international bettors to make for mega pools. There are ways to make this happen. This is so doable.

The Very Ugly — Mr. Gural has every right to label people's criticisms as idiotic and insult their intelligence by saying their lack of understanding is not rocket science and regard others lightly because their opinions are lunacy. While many may reject that style, I thought his usage of those terms in regards to the issues is the American way. Well, one of the American ways anyway. But what is not the American way is to request that HRU refrains from publishing any letters that are deemed inappropriate. This should make everyone angry. There are many opinions I have seen offered in letters that I, too, have found off the mark. But to tell people they cannot voice their opinions, or to tell a publication what they can or cannot print is The Very Ugly.

The order of the races (and the tracks featuring these races) are logistical problems that would have to be ironed out for the greater good. My plan would be something like this:

1. Triple Crown Race Program 1 (sometime in August):

Trotting Triple Crown Race - Hambletonian

Pacing Triple Crown Race - Cane Pace

2. Triple Crown Race Program 2 (sometime in September):

Trotting Triple Crown Race - Kentucky Futurity

Pacing Triple Crown Race - Little Brown Jug

3. Triple Crown Race Program 3 (sometime in October):


Trotting Triple Crown Race - Yonkers Trot

Pacing Triple Crown Race - Messenger


It would be nice if both races could be held at the same track for each of the three race days (three tracks in total), but this would probably mean some rearranging of races and cooperation of race tracks. Again, these problems would need to be solved from a practical standpoint.

Wouldn't it be great if some day in the future both the trotting and pacing Triple Crowns were up for grabs, resulting in two Triple Crown winners being crowned in one day — at the same track and on national TV? We can only dream.

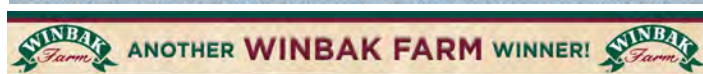
