Nuncio Takes Sweden

U.S.-bred trotters finished first and second in the Elitlopp final as Nuncio edged Resolve on Sunday at Solvalla.

The “dark dream” Nuncio – a five-year-old, ever-growing star from the United States – won the 2016 Elitlopp Sunday at Solvalla Racetrack near Stockholm despite sitting outside the leader without cover most of the mile.

Nuncio, driven by Örjan Kihlström, took the lead with 100 meters to go, and though severely challenged by his U.S. counterpart Resolve and trainer/driver Åke Svanstedt in the stretch, Nuncio’s win was a safe one. Resolve finished a quarter-of-a-length back in second.

During the final of the Elitlopp, Nuncio’s owner and trainer Stefan Melander stood alone on the backstretch and met up with his trotter in the winner’s circle.

“I was too tense and too much a coward to stand at the wire,” Melander said. “I knew Nuncio would be more eager in the final, but I didn’t reckon he would win outside the leader. But what can I say? Nuncio knows he’s the best... and he is.”

After Nuncio raced in the United States at ages, two and three, earning more than \$1.9 million under the tutelage of

first Jim Oscarsson and then Jimmy Takter, Melander took the son of Andover Hall—Nicole Isabelle to Sweden in 2015 and continued Nuncio's success.

Nuncio finished third in last year's Elitlopp with a breath-taking performance and was the horse on the lips of

most people Sunday at Solvalla.

"Everybody likes him, and it's a relief that I didn't disappoint them," said Kihlström. "Nuncio has a hell of an engine, and he can race fast for a long time."

It was the third Elitlopp victory for Kihlström. Resolve's driver Åke Svanstedt, who returned to Solvalla for the first

time since 2013, was denied his third Elitlopp victory by a slim margin.

His trotter Resolve got bad cover in his elimination, but came three wide on his own in the final turn, finishing second to the winner, the French star Timoko with driver Björn Goop, who afterwards said: "Timoko is better than ever, but we are going to meet a certain Nuncio."

In the final of The Elitlopp, and in the very same manner, Resolve had to do the tough work in the final turn, fighting for victory down the homestretch, getting close to Nuncio, but without time and room to claim victory.

Svanstedt appeared to be pleased with Resolve's performances and set off for a boat-trip to the archipelago Sunday evening.

"If Resolve had better cover in the elimination, he might've challenged Timoko, and got a better post in the final, and then I wonder," said Resolve's groom Lukas Wallin. "I can't say that Resolve would have beaten Nuncio, but Resolve is also a terribly good horse, which he showed today. I was surprised that he couldn't go for the lead in his elimination, but the car let them off at a lower pace here (than in the United States)."

Nuncio finished second in his elimination where he couldn't reach French star Un Mec d'Heripre. The latter got post one in the final, took the lead, and star driver Joseph Verbeeck began to look over his shoulder at Nuncio on the outside, 600 meters to go. Was he confident – or worried? They looked really strong in the lead in the final turn, but had to give in, finishing a close third.

In the final, Timoko and Goop shadowed Nuncio to the maximum, finishing fourth.

On the Elitlopp undercard, Pinkman, last year's Hambletonian winner, won The Fyraåringseliten (Elite race for four-year-olds) for trainer Jimmy Takter and driver Yannick Gingras. After a fast first quarter, they grabbed the lead, and won by a head over former U.S.-rival and Takter trainee Uncle Lasse. In the history of the Elitlopp, seven Hambletonian winners have raced at Solvalla on Elitlopp Weekend. Pinkman is the first not to be in the big race. On

Sunday, he earned \$60,240.

Both Takter and Gingras were overwhelmed by the weekend's racing feast at Solvalla.

"I've been in this for a long time and I've had a lot of successes, I'm glad to have that joyful feeling back when I'm here. To be here is an experience in a lifetime, a unique place to be. Pinkman now got the experience of being here, and another year is in favor for him – and that might take him to The Elitlopp 2017," Takter said, standing with Gingras, on a podium, and drawing applause from 28,896 devoted patrons.

This year's Elitlopp was broadcasted to 20 countries.

Faith rewarded by Nuncio's success

The Elitlopp-winning trotter bred by Russell Williams has extensive ties to Hanover Shoe Farms.

Everyone who knows Russell Williams rejoiced when Nuncio won the Elitlopp on Sunday in Sweden.

Trainer Stefan Melander and driver Orjan Kihlstrom were saluted, too, but Russell Williams certainly celebrated as the breeder of Nuncio.

Russell Williams is one of the most respected and admired individuals in harness racing and he's achieved that status despite keeping a low profile in the sport. Williams has been a faithful, albeit low-profile supporter, in making sure that horses beyond their racing or breeding days have a comfortable retirement. For his efforts in this area, everyone in harness racing should be grateful.

He comes to his affinity for harness racing legitimately as his grandfather Lawrence B. Sheppard was the mastermind behind the creation of Hanover Shoe Farms, and was responsible for guiding it to a dominant position in harness racing since its inception 90 years ago. It's only natural that Russell is a major principal — officially he serves as the chairman — of Hanover Shoe Farms.

Williams also maintains a select broodmare band of his own, separate from his interests in the sprawling Hanover bevy of matrons.

Let's quickly trace the pedigree of Nuncio, starting with his fifth dam Mimi Hanover. She was a 1945 daughter of Dean Hanover, the all-time favorite horse of Lawrence Sheppard. Dean Hanover earned that status by trotting to a world record for three-year-olds of 1:58.1/2 in 1937 with Sheppard's 11-year-old daughter driving in a time trial.

(That feat still boggles the imagination. Can you imagine an 11-year-old girl today climbing in the sulky and time-trialing Southwind Frank in 1:50 or faster?)

From Hanover to Stockholm with love. Nuncio, bred by Russell Williams of Hanover Shoe Farms fame, was the toast of Solvalla Sunday after winning the Elitlopp.

Mimi Hanover had two colts by Rodney that would leave an impact on trotting. Her 1954 foal was Speedster, a colt whose juvenile mark of 2:17.4h seems laughable now. But he improved with age and finished 3-3 in his division of the '57 Hambletonian. One of the most memorable traits of Speedster is that he raced with any hind shin protection — boots or bandages — whatsoever.

Mimi Hanover's 1961 foal was Speedy Rodney, gifted with high speed, but certainly not with a flawless gait. But when he was good, he was very, very good. He was 4-8 in his Hambletonian behind Ayres but later became a terror at

times on the twice-arounds such as Yonkers and Historic in New York state, setting a 1:58.3h world record for trotters.

Speedster hit a home run in his first crop by siring the behemoth Speedy Scot and that male line was carried forth by Speedy Crown and Valley Victory.

Speedy Rodney sired a speedball Hambletonian winner in Green Speed, but this branch went no further.

Sandwiched between Speedster and Speedy Rodney, Mimi Hanover had a filly named Candid by Lusty Song, the brilliantly fast 1950 Hambletonian winner plagued by bad feet and a proclivity for pacing.

Candid's first two foals were daughters by Rodney. The first, Candid Rodney, was one of the best of her era, earning over \$100,000 in the mid-1960s.

Her younger sister, Crystal Rodney, never earned a penny but became a reliable broodmare at Hanover Shoe Farms. Her initial offering was Crain Hanover, a darn good gelding in his day. He was among those who chased Lindy's Pride without luck in the 1968-69 stakes.

Crystal Rodney's penultimate foal, arriving when she was 21 in 1983, was Cristi Hanover. She was sired by Florida Pro, a stallion that certainly didn't step up many Hanover broodmares. Cristi Hanover was no exception. She earned \$112 on the track.

Cristi Hanover didn't date the most successful boys on the block, having foals by Prakas, Giant Victory, and later Dancer's Victory. She had two daughters by other stallions, however, that made an impact.

The first was Cynara Hanover by Super Bowl, owned by Russell Williams. She won the Review Stake for sophomore trotting fillies in 1995 for trainer/driver Bob Roberts, getting a 1:57.2 mark that day. She was a solid if not spectacular Grand Circuit filly.

With the exception of HR's Millers Gold, a Donerail gelding with earnings of \$221,724, the foals of Cynara Hanover have not been exceptional. Her sixth foal Nicole Isabelle certainly fits that description. She raced only as a three-year-old in 2008, won once in 18 starts and banked \$11,547. Her mark was 2:01.1f.

The family wasn't producing champions, but Williams had not lost faith. He wanted to keep Nicole Isabelle as a broodmare. His first stallion selection was Andover Hall, which made sense since Williams had experienced success in breeding his Lindy Lane mare Weather Bird to Andover Hall and getting the \$800,000 Clerk Magistrate.

(Before we get to Nuncio himself, let's go back to the second daughter of Crystal Rodney that made a major impact on harness racing. She was a 1998 filly named Cressida Hanover by Mr Lavec and her first foal was the 2006 Triple Crown winner Glidemaster.)

Yet, Williams retained Nicole Isabelle as broodmare and was rewarded when her first foal was Nuncio. Williams wasn't exactly rewarded financially when he sold Nuncio because the youngster went for just \$7,000. We suspect that Williams will be rewarded far more generously this year when her yearling colt by Cantab Hall sells.

Williams must surely take pride in the fact that Nuncio has a true Hanover Shoe Farms pedigree. His sire Andover Hall stands at the Pennsylvania farm and the sires of his first three dams — Lindy Lane, Super Bowl, and Florida Pro — were also Hanover stallions.

Nuncio was a model of consistency during his two seasons at the races in North America. He made 27 starts over two seasons with 16 wins, 10 seconds and a third. Any trainer or owner would feel blessed to have such a horse.

Nuncio beat the champion Father Patrick in their first encounter in July, 2013 but Father Patrick usually had the upper hand. Trainer Jim Oscarsson paired Nuncio with driver John Campbell and no trotter could possibly ask for more.

The Andover Hall colt seemed to have a little hitch in his gitalong when trotting, but he was foolproof on the track.

Moved to trainer Jimmy Takter as a three-year-old, Nuncio came up a bit short to stablemate Trixton in the Hambletonian as favorite Father Patrick jumped at the gate.

But Nuncio got wound up winning two legs of the Triple Crown that year, first by powering past Father Patrick in the stretch at Lexington and then by winning the Yonkers Trot.

As a four-year-old last season in the hands of Swedish trainer/photographer Stefan Melander, Nuncio became a superstar and earned the highest honor on Sunday winning Sweden's greatest race. And breeder Russell Williams was at Solvalla on Sunday cheering his baby to victory.

Jaw-dropper in Philly

Wiggle It Jiggle set the new track standard at Harrah's Philadelphia with a 1:47.3 record in the \$200,000 Dorothy Mullin Invitational.

Wiggle It Jiggleit (Montrell Teague) shaved a fifth-of-a-second off Harrah's Philadelphia's track record with a 1:47.3 victory in the \$200,000 Dorothy Mullin Invitational.

Most people might be unhappy to see clouds block out the sun on their Memorial Day weekend, but Montrell Teague couldn't have been more overjoyed.

Teague drives Wiggle It Jiggleit, a horse who has a penchant for jumping shadows on the racetrack. So when Teague saw the clouds roll in moments before heading onto the track for Wiggle It Jiggleit's start in Sunday's \$200,000 Dorothy Mullin Invitational for older male pacers at Harrah's Philadelphia, he was relieved.

And under the cover of those clouds, Wiggle It Jiggleit went out and paced the fastest mile in the 11-year history of Harrah's Philadelphia, stopping the timer in 1:47.3 as he captured the Mullin Invitational by one-and-three-quarter lengths over early pacesetter Rockin Ron. Rockeyed Optimist finished third.

“When I warmed him up, he jumped over a couple (shadows); that would have been another obstacle to overcome,” Teague said. “The shadows were out pretty good until we went out, so it worked out perfect. The clouds worked out in our favor.”

The previous fastest mile at Harrah's Philadelphia was 1:48, a mark shared by Artistic Fella and Mister Big.

“He’s done so many races and all of them are spectacular, it’s hard to pick one that stands out,” Teague said after the four-year-old Wiggle It Jiggleit won for the 29th time in 36 career races and increased his lifetime earnings to \$2.57 million. “This is right up there with all the big ones. I think.

“I thought I could have gone faster, but if I’m already in front I just want to look back and see where they are and start celebrating.”

Also on Sunday's card at Harrah's Philadelphia, Obrigado won the \$200,000 Maxie Lee Memorial for older trotters by a neck over Il Sogno Dream in 1:52 and Venus Delight won the \$200,000 Betsy Ross Invitational for older female pacers by two-and-a-half lengths over Katie Said in 1:50.4.

Wiggle It Jiggleit, harness racing's 2015 Horse of the Year, has won six of nine races this season and finished no worse than second in any start. He entered the Mullin Invitational off a track-record win in the Battle of Lake Erie on May 21 at Northfield Park.

In the Mullin, Wiggle It Jiggleit found himself in second place behind Confederation Cup champion Rockin Ron. Teague and the 1-2 favorite made their move to challenge Rockin Ron just after reaching the race's midpoint and battled side-by-side around the final turn. From there, Wiggle It Jiggleit paced away from his rivals to post the victory for owners George Teague Jr. (Montrell's father) and the Teague Racing Partnership. Wiggle It Jiggleit is trained by Clyde Francis.

"It was unbelievable," Montrell said. "I thought there might be a few more horses leave and I'd have to take back a little further, but when you've got a two hole you've got to take advantage of it. I saw a horse coming on the outside of me and I didn't want to get locked in. I was just playing my part and seeing what was going to go on and trying to be out before anyone got outside of me."

Wiggle It Jiggleit's next start is expected to be Saturday at Mohawk Racetrack in the second round of the Graduate Series for four-year-old pacers.

In the Maxie Lee, Obrigado held off Il Sogno Dream after

even-money favorite JL Cruze went off stride in the final turn. Also going off stride in the race were Shake It Cerry and Gural Hanover. Morning line favorite Bee A Magician was scratched earlier in the day because of an unspecified injury.

It was Obrigado's second win in four races this year. The six-year-old gelding has won 36 of 66 career starts and earned \$891,229.

Obrigado is owned by the Paul Kelley Racing Stable, SRF Stable, Linwood Higgins, and Stable 45. He is trained by Kelley and was driven by Mark MacDonald.

"I thought his effort was great," Kelley said. "I don't think he ever got ahold of the racetrack, to my liking anyway, but he's a game horse and he just gives 110 per cent every time you put him on the track. All the horses that race at this level are just tremendous athletes, and he overcame it."

"His year has been really good. We dealt with some issues last year with his front feet stinging him and I think we have a better handle on what he likes and what he doesn't like. Hopefully he's going to have a really good year."

Then with a laugh, Kelley added, "I need a retirement plan and I don't have one right now; not a good enough one. So this could be it."

In the Betsy Ross, Venus Delight and driver Tim Tetrick rallied from midpack to overtake Katie Said in the stretch and post her first win in nine races this year. The six-year-old mare was the Dan Patch Award winner for best older female pacer in 2015.

"If you're going to get a first win of the year, this is a good one to get," winning trainer Jeff Bamond Jr. said. "I think she just came back a little slowly. She had a long year last year; she raced hard and just needed to get her legs under her a little bit. This definitely worked out today."

"Timmy made a great move and she just exploded today. I was very happy with the way it worked out."

Venus Delight, sent off at 9-1 odds in the Betsy Ross, has won 26 of 71 career races and earned \$993,523. She is owned by Bamond Racing.
