# 1:46.4 – The Doctor Delivers

Dr J Hanover's victory in his Graduate division Saturday at Mohawk is the fastest mile in Canadian history and a world record for a four-year-old gelding.

Dr J Hanover broke out of his 15-race losing streak in the biggest way possible — with a 1:46.4 all-age Canadian record mile Saturday (June 3) in his Graduate division at Mohawk Racetrack that erased the previous national record of 1:47.1 set in June of 2016 by Always B Miki. The mile, orchestrated by driver Doug McNair in the \$67,230 Graduate for pacers, was also a world record for four-year-old geldings.

"He has had more than his fair share of bad luck starting back this year and I'm so happy for the partnership that owns him," said Dr. J Hanover's trainer, Tony Alagna, referring to owners Brad Grant of Milton, ON, Robert Leblanc of New York City, Steven Wienick of Delray Beach, FL and Irwin Samelman of Las Vegas NV, who topped the 2017 January Select Mixed Sale at the Meadowlands by purchasing Dr J Hanover for \$280,000. "I told them to not lose faith in him and he showed up tonight. The world record is an amazing bonus and honored to be a part of Canadian racing history."

Grant said the connections, "really believed (Dr J Hanover)

was a lot better horse than he had showed but really didn't see this type of mile coming tonight. The race set up well and with there being a lot of front-end speed Doug was able to get him in a great position coming for home and the Doctor delivered."

McNair took full advantage of wild fractions of :26.2, :53 and 1:20 to come away with the record victory.

Dr J Hanover was fired to the front by McNair in a field of six and posted an opening quarter of :26.2. Boston Red Rocks and Brett Miller swept up to take the lead entering the backstretch, but they immediately had company in the form of Lyons Snyder and Yannick Gingras. The half flashed up in :53, as Lyons Snyder powered by Boston Red Rocks and continued to set a wild pace entering the far turn. Positions went unchanged in the third-quarter, as Dr J Hanover sat third and three-lengths back, while Lyons Snyder hit three-quarters in 1:20. In the stretch, Boston Red Rocks angled out and paced by Lyons Snyder, while Dr J Hanover followed the path and eventually tipped off his back to set up a two-horse battle. Boston Red Rocks tried his best to fight off the outside pressure, but Dr J Hanover was too much to handle and powered by to win by a length at odds of 15-1.

"That was a huge mile," McNair said. "(Dr J Hanover) felt

great once he got to the lead and even when they went :53 he was still on the bit. At the top of the stretch I asked him a little and he jumped forward. It was very surprising to see the time come up. It doesn't happen very often and I'm glad I got to be the first driver to beat :47 on Canadian soil. It felt great." It was the first time McNair had driven Dr J Hanover.

Dr J Hanover now has career numbers of nine wins and \$387,961 earned. He paid \$32.90 to win.

The world record by a four-year-old gelding shaved three-fifths-of-a-second off the previous record of 1:47.2 held by Bettor Sweet and Wiggle It Jiggleit. Dr J Hanover also equaled Warrawee Needy's overall record for a four-year-old pacer.

The other \$67,230 Graduate division didn't feature any records, but did have a thrilling finish.

Dave Menary trainee Sintra battled back to edge out Western Fame in 1:49.3.

Driven by Jody Jamieson, Sintra made a second-quarter move to the lead from third to take command away from Western Fame. Jamieson's charge posted middle-half fractions of :53.3 and 1:21.

In the stretch, Western Fame was angled to the outside and got by Sintra for a moment, but the Menary trainee wouldn't quit and fought back to win by a nose. Easy Lover Hanover shot up the rail late to finish third.

"I knew he was going to have to dig deep," said Menary about his feeling at the top of the lane. "I knew he really dug back in and was by the horse after the wire. He's a good enough horse that he was passed and he dug. That's the kind of a horse he is."

A four-year-old gelded son of Mach Three—Dancing Barefoot, Sintra improved his 2017 record to four wins in five



starts with his triumph Saturday. He is now a 12-time winner with career earnings exceeding \$400,000 for owners Brad Gray, Michael Guerriero and Menary Racing Inc.

Sintra paid \$3.90 to win.

Over on the trotting side, Ron Burke trainee Dayson prevailed in a photo finish over Trolley to win the \$100,845 12-horse Graduate Series Trot.

Driven by Gingras, Dayson grabbed the lead in the second-quarter, but had to deal with pressure by first-over challenger Warrawee Roo throughout the middle-half. After trotting a third-quarter in :28 to reach that station in 1:24.1, Dayson put away Warrawee Roo, but immediately had to deal with Trolley, who had been sitting second-over with driver Marcus Miller.

Dayson and Trolley went toe-to-toe down to the wire, with the leader holding on to win by a nose in 1:52.3.

"I thought maybe he got me in the last step," said Gingras post-race. "My horse had raced on the front a few weeks in a row... I really wanted tonight to race him from the back if it was a shorter field, but I was in a tough spot and if I took him back I would've got away about sixth or seventh, but my horse raced another big mile."

Broadway Donna, who had captured the opening leg of the Graduate, didn't have her usual punch in the lane and finished third.

A four-year-old gelded son of Conway Hall, Dayson was winless in three starts heading into Saturday's outing. He now has 20 career wins and earnings of over \$700,000 for owners Burke Racing Stable LLC, Our Horse Cents Stables, J And T Silva Stables LLC and Rossie Smith.

Dayson paid \$4.40 to win.

# Somebeachsomewhere divisions to Hurricane Beach, Macs Jackpot

Saturday's card also featured a pair of 11-horse \$70,000 Somebeachsomewhere Stakes divisions, as many Pepsi North America Cup eligible three-year-old pacers were putting in their final preparations ahead of next week's eliminations.

Hurricane Beach and driver Louis Philippe Roy captured the first division in 1:50.3. The Luc Blais trainee went gate-to-wire to score his second win of the season.

A gelded son of Somebeachsomewhere—Blazing Yankee and North America Cup eligible, Hurricane Beach set fractions of :26.3, :55 and 1:22.1, before scooting home in :28.3 to capture a division of the race named for his sire.

Lawrencetown Beach finished four-lengths back in second, while Sports Column was third.

Roy's victory with Hurricane Beach Saturday was the first Grand Circuit victory of his career. Following the race, he noted that some equipment adjustments made a big difference for his charge.

"We trained him with different equipment last week and he was too grabby," said Roy. "So (Blais) put back the equipment he had before cause he couldn't relax like he did tonight with the other equipment."

Hurricane Beach, who was winless in three starts as a rookie, came into Saturday's start with only \$12,180 in earnings. His bankroll now sits at \$47,180 for owner Determination.

A \$2 win ticket on Hurricane Beach returned \$14.40.

Another son of Somebeachsomewhere captured the second division to make it a perfect sweep for "The Beach" in his own race.

Despite never seeing the rail, Macs Jackpot and David Miller came from way back to score a 42-1 upset.

The Jim Campbell trainee sat eighth and on the outside throughout the majority of the mile, but was able to pick up

the pieces when leader Richard Hill tired in the lane.

Richard Hill cleared to the lead just after the opening-quarter and posted fractions of :54.3 and 1:22.1. In the stretch, Richard Hill had to fight off Frontier Seelster, but that took its toll and the backfield came to life.

Macs Jackpot followed Stealth Bomber down the lane and was able to surge by all his rivals to win by a neck in 1:51.4. Stealth Bomber edged out Richard Hill for second.

Trained by Campbell for owner Jeff Snyder, Macs Jackpot overcame post-nine to score his second victory in six starts this season.

"We had planned on trying to get him into the race, but with a big field and all, a lot of guys were taking a shot," said Miller following the race. "He ended up fourth-over and was out the whole way, but he was just kind of feeling pretty comfortable until the last turn and then he did get interested and finished it up good."

Macs Jackpot is eligible to next week's Pepsi North America Cup eliminations. He paid \$86.30 to win.

The Pepsi North America Cup eliminations will take place next Saturday (June 10).

# All Bets Off wins Northfield's Battle of Lake Erie

Luck Be Withyou and Aaron Merriman tried to steal the Battle with jaw-dropping, front-end fractions, but it was All Bets Off that won the war.

All Bets Off won Saturday's \$200,000 Battle of Lake at Northfield Park, making him only the second horse to win both a Carl Milstein Memorial and a Battle of Lake Erie, two of the track's prestigious Grand Circuit events. Wiggle It Jiggleit accomplished the same feat.

All Bets Off (Bettor's Delight-Armbro Penelope – Dexter Nukes) is owned by the partnership of Burke Racing Stable, Weaver Bruscemi LLC, Frank Baldachino and Panhellenic Stable. He is trained by Ron Burke. Matt Kakaley had the winning drive.

As the gate pulled away from the stellar Battle field, Luck Be Withyou and Aaron Merriman rushed to the front, setting wicked-fast fractions of :26, :52.4 and 1:20.3.

"I figured the race would rock and roll early. I thought I

should get away mid-pack and cross my fingers," said Kakaley. "The trip worked out perfectly for us."

All Bets Off started from post four and made a three-wide bid late in the third panel to make the front and best Luck Be Withyou by two-and-a-quarter lengths, stopping the clock at 1:49.2. The time represents a new track record for five and up pacing horses. The former 1:50.4 mark was set in 2002 by Western Millennium and Walter Case, Jr.

"All Bets Off is a special horse to me and has really helped further my career to a place I'm not sure it would be without him," said Kakaley. "This win feels good."

Saturday's win marks the 25th score for All Bets Off in 86 career races and increases his bankroll to \$2,372,503.

# Is Ariana G Hambletonian bound?

Trainer Jimmy Takter said if the race was this week he'd certainly consider it after Ariana G dominated her \$100,000 NJSS final with a 1:51.1 victory Friday at the Meadowlands.

A day after sophomore trotting filly Ariana G lit up the Meadowlands teletimer with a 1:51.1 victory in her \$100,000 New Jersey Sires Stakes (NJSS) final, her trainer said it's "too early to consider" putting her in the Hambletonian against the boys — with one caveat.

"If the race was next week I would (consider it)," Jimmy Takter said Saturday evening.

If Ariana G continues to impress, it won't be the last time Takter is asked about whether the homebred daughter of Muscle Hill—Cantab It All owned by Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld of Toronto should be taking on the boys on the first Saturday in August.

For now, make Ariana G the favorite to deliver Takter's fourth straight Hambletonian Oaks triumph after Yannick Gingras drove her to a victory in the NJSS final that was just two-fifths-of-a-second off the track record.

Gingras moved the filly to the front past a :27.3 opening quarter and Ariana G just kept chugging from there through fractions of :55.3 and 1:24.1 with a last quarter in :27 to defeat Ice Attraction by three-and-a-quarter lengths.

"She's coming back scary good," Takter said in the winner's circle. "We still have 60 days to Hambletonian Day. Yannick said if he let her go she would have gone :49. Hopefully I haven't peaked her too soon. I would say at this point, she could be the most talented one I have developed."

Long Tom, Every Way Out, and Misqued also won their \$100,000 Sire Stakes finals on a warm, late spring evening.

Long Tom officially threw his hat into the Hambletonian picture with an impressive front-end score in 1:52.2 to win the \$100,000 trotting colts' division. King On The Hill won the place photo over 3-5 favorite What The Hill. Long Tom was a stakes winner last year at Lexington and is now two-for-twio as a sophomore. With stablemate Enterprise,

who is three-for-three in 2017, 25-year-old trainer Marcus Melander has a potent 1-2 punch on the road to the first Saturday in August.

"Long Tom got sore after Lexington last year and then grew a lot over the winter," said Melander, whose uncle Stefan won the Hambletonian in 2001 with Scarlet Knight. "I was only nine years old when Scarlet Knight won so I don't remember much, but hopefully I can get another Hambletonian for the family."

Every Way Out completed his sweep of the pacing colts division with a five-length win in 1:52. The If I Can Dream gelding paid \$2.10 for the third straight week. Tim Tetrick, who won four of the night's 11 races, piloted the winner for trainer Dylan Davis.

The only Sire Stakes upset came in the 3-year-old pacing filly division when 1-5 favorite Colorful Jasmine faded to finish fourth while 7-2 second choice Misqued held off the late charge of Livinginthedream. Misqued was driven by Steve Smith for trainer John Balzer.

# Blueblooded baby has people gushing on social media

In a sport where hope springs eternal at this time of year with the babies appearing for the first time on the track, barns are filled with hope, anticipation and in some cases hyperbole.

It's rare, however, for industry heavyweights like Murray Brown – a.k.a. "The Curmudgeon" – and Bob Marks to heap praise on a young racehorse this early and one two-year-old filly's performance at The Meadowlands yesterday morning had them and others taking notice and Brown was quick to get on Facebook to start the buzz.

"I saw as impressive a 2YO first time starter as I've ever seen this morning," Brown wrote. "Her name is Rainbow Room. She is by Somebeachsomewhere and out of the great Rainbow Blue. She won in 1.55, last quarter in :27.2 on cruise control. If nothing unforeseen occurs, you will hear from her."

While Rainbow Room's wire-to-wire win in her **first qualifier** was uneventful – she led through fractions of :29.4 / :59 / 1:27.2 before kicking home in :27.3 for driver David Miller – it was the way she did it that had Brown, Marks and others taking notice.

"Super Impressive," wrote Marks. "Vicious!" added Meadowlands broadcaster Gabe Prewitt. "Great pedigree," added Bob Boyd.

Indeed, Rainbow Room has the bloodlines to be a top filly. She is the product of two of the greatest racehorses in the

sport's history who, combined, won 50 of 53 starts and earned a shade under \$5 million.

Rainbow Room – when she starts for a purse – will be the sixth foal out of her Hall of Fame dam to race. To date, her most notable performer on the track has been Rainbow Room's full-sister Somewherovrarainbow. She earned more than \$1.3 million while taking 20 wins from 46 starts. Among those 20 wins were victories in the Breeders Crown at Woodbine at two and the Blue Chip Matchmaker series final at Yonkers at four. She also took her lifetime mark at four racing in the Mares Preferred at Pocono where she paced the mile in 1:48 flat.

Rainbow Room was bred in Pennsylvania by Vieux Carre Farms (of Gettysburg, PA) and Steve Jones of Montgomery, NY. She was bought for \$100,000 at Lexington by current trainer Joe Holloway and she is now owned by Crawford Farms, Val D'or Farms and Ted Gewertz.

Michelle Crawford says the acquisition of Rainbow Room fills a bit of a void after they had to retire her full-sister, Blue Beach, who went for \$270,000 at the 2015 Lexington sale. "Blue Beach had a major breathing problem that wasn't corrected after surgery, so we bred her and she is in foal to Always B Miki," Crawford said. "We are glad Joe asked us (to buy in). She's special. It's not often Joe gets giddy about anything."

Based on the reaction of several respected people from the industry based on only one baby race, it appears that Holloway has good reason to be giddy and this isn't likely to be the last buzz created by Rainbow Room.

# Hambletonian hopeful Sortie breathes easy

Colt wins fastest Currier & Ives division at The Meadows after Cornell Collar is legalized.

Hambletonian hopeful Sortie, reunited with his recently legalized Cornell Collar, made short work of his Currier & Ives division Saturday at The Meadows, winning easily in a stake-fastest 1:54. The \$118,424 event for sophomore colt and gelding trotters was contested over three divisions, with Moonshiner Hanover and Fraser Ridge taking the other splits — both for trainer Chris Beaver.

One of the most promising freshmen of 2016, Sortie began using a Cornell Collar to help him breathe after an examination revealed he has a short epiglottis. However, minutes before his May 20 seasonal debut in a Pennsylvania Sires Stake (PASS) at The Meadows, trainer Noel Daley was informed that Cornell Collars weren't legal in the Keystone State. Stripped of the device, Sortie won his PASS split handily, but his worried connections took their case to the PA Horse Racing Commission.

"We got hold of one of the representatives on the board," Daley said. "She said we were lucky, since they were having a meeting in two days. They brought it up, and they were very quick in getting it done. The horse obviously was good last week, but I don't want to be worried about (his breathing)."

Legal at last, Sortie quarter-poled to the front for Andrew McCarthy and won geared down, defeating early leader Dover Dan by one-and-three-quarter lengths. Always a Good Time completed the ticket.

Sortie pushed his lifetime bankroll to \$166,397 for Patricia

Stable, Joe Sbrocco, Mario Mazza and Sortie Stable. Daley indicated the son of Explosive Matter—Win B would race next in a PASS at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono.

Moonshiner Hanover also enjoyed a successful freshman campaign, banking \$263,101. But after off-season surgery to remove OCDs delayed his return to the track, Beaver opted to ease him back in a soft spot, a PA Stallion Series event. He not only won that race, but the strategy also brought dividends Saturday when the son of Andover Hall—Madam Hootch outduled the 2-5 favorite, Giveitgasandgo, in the lane to prevail by a head in 1:54.3, with Lars Perry third.

"What a decision Chris made to put him in the stallion series where he didn't have to go against the big dogs his first race," said winning driver Aaron Merriman. "That was probably what got us the win today. He was even better than last start."

Synerco Ventures, Bill Manes and Beaver own the Hambletonian-eligible Moonshiner Hanover, a \$27,000 yearling acquisition.

Fraser Ridge's sire, Triumphant Caviar, won a Currier & Ives split in 2009 for Beaver. On Saturday, Fraser Ridge upheld the family honor by pulling the pocket down the backside for Jim Pantaleano, opening a daylight lead and coasting home in 1:55.1. Meme Hanover was second, four lengths in arrears, while Muay Hanover rallied for show.

"I hoped he could follow cover as much as possible, but I don't think the horse on the front was very good today, and he had to get out," said Beaver, who owns the \$29,000 yearling purchase with Donald Robinson, Robert Mondillo and R.B.H. Ventures. "As soon as he's out, he's fighting the driver. He wants to just go. Luckily, he cleared down the backside, and it worked out."

# Look for some Horse Play this season at Scioto Downs

Fractional ownership group enjoys fun and wins.

It was just an average Thursday night crowd at Scioto Downs, the sixth race field was heading for home. A large roar came from the crowd as Odds On Serpens and Josh Sutton rallied from fifth at the top of stretch to score a one-length victory in 1:54.3.

Why such excitement for a \$5,000 claiming event? A large contingent of the HorsePlay Racing Stable, a fractional ownership group, was in attendance and experienced the thrill of winning for the first time. Included in the crowded winner's circle photo was long-time Scioto track photographer, Brad Conrad, a member of the HorsePlay Racing Stable since 2014.

"It's always fun to get your picture taken," said Conrad. "I am here nearly every night working, and I enjoy race nights even more when a stable horse races."

The 2017 version of the HorsePlay Stable was one-for-one, but the victory celebration was short lived as track announcer Barry Vicroy announced that the gelded son of Somebeachsomewhere—Odds On Charmaine was reclaimed by his previous owner.

The HorsePlay Stable currently has 25 members (with room for up to 45) and is led by Jessica Schroeder. The stable originally started in 2013 under the banner of Drinkin The Shade Racing.

"Down the street from Scioto in Shadyville is a local bar called the E & R Grille, where a lot of horsemen go after the races," explained Schroeder. "I wanted to offer the patrons that have met the horsemen a way to buy in to a horse, without shelling out a lot of cash. The slogan for E & R Grille is 'Drinking in the Shade,' so the Drinkin The Shade Racing stable was born."

With some eager clients and a catchy name secured, Schroder hired Scioto's 20+ time leading trainer and future hall of famer, Virgil Morgan, Jr. The pair was on the hunt for an affordable claimer and they settled on a \$5,000 claimer by the name of Mike's Hope.

The six-year-old provided the new stable with a lifetime of memories in his only start for the new owners. The Cam's Card Shark—Lasting Memory gelding left from post 10, took the lead before the three-quarter mile pole and cruised to a 17-length victory in a lifetime best 1:51.3. Mike's Hope was reclaimed by his previous owner and the stable was on the look for another winner.

The inaugural season ended with Catalina Kid, who made 10 starts for Drinkin The Shade Racing. The Damien Seelster gelding won 3 times, including a conditioned event on Jugette day at the Delaware County Fair.

In 2014, Schroder changed the stable's name to the current HorsePlay Racing Stable. Along with the new name, the stable also had a new trainer, veteran conditioner Mike Medors. The stables' three horses earned four checks in just eight starts in 2014.

The 2015 and 2016 seasons provided both highs and lows. A 0-for-10 streak, followed by three straight wins in 2015 and a 0-for-10 season last year.

Last fall, Schroeder partnered with trainer Hugh "Sandy" Beatty on Mary Mag Delene, a yearling trotting filly. The Dejarmbro-Marigot Express lass was purchased for \$21,000 at the Ohio Select Sale.

"We wanted a yearling for those interested in following a horse in training all winter and the possibility of a stakes horse this summer," said Schroeder. "Ohio has such a great state-bred program, so we are excited for the summer."

Schroeder keeps the stable members informed of activities with regular emails and through their HorsePlay Racing Facebook page (@HorsePlayRacingStable).

Two weeks after losing Odds On Serpens after his only start for the HorsePlay Stable. Schroeder and Morgan claimed the gelding back for his original \$5,000 tag. Now sporting a four-race win streak, "Serpens" has been entered in-to-go Wednesday (June 7) in the eighth race at Scioto Downs. He has been installed as the 5-2 morning line choice.

## Rockin BB Rocks in Indiana Sires Stakes final at Hoosier

Staging a big rally late in the lane, Rockin BB and Ricky Macomber Jr. pulled the slight upset in Saturday's (June 3) featured event, the \$75,000 Indiana Sires Stakes final for three-year-old pacing fillies, at Hoosier Park Racing & Casino. On a beautiful Saturday evening, Rockin BB used the long Hoosier Park stretch to her advantage to stop the timer in 1:52.2 and establish a new lifetime best in the process. With the win, Rockin BB snapped a six-race win streak for the heavily favored, Rockin Racer and Jared Finn.

Rockin Racer used her customary front-running tactics to fly

from the wings of the gate to set fast, first half fractions of :25.4 and :54.3. Always About Farah and Andy Shetler protected their rail position and grabbed a pocket seat behind the early pace-setter while Firstup and Ross Leonard were next in line third. Rockin BB was uninvolved through the early stages of the race and set eighth along the rail for much of the mile.

Leonard gave Firstup the green light and she was out and firing to grab command as the field reached the three-quarter clocking in 1:22.2. Firstup continued to call the shots turning for home but the rest of the field was closing in.

As the quick pace began to take its toll on the leader, Macomber Jr. tipped Rockin BB wide to the outside and she utilized a :28.3 final quarter to prevail in a tight photo over Pretty Image and Dale Hiteman. Rockin Serena and Peter Wrenn also rallied well late in the mile to get up for third place honors. Slightly dismissed at the betting windows, Rockin BB returned \$23.20 to her backers at the betting windows.

Trained by Ron Burke, Rockin BB notched her third win from eight seasonal starts. The daughter of Rockin Image—Yankee Pankee BB has now amassed \$87,730 in lifetime purse earnings for owners Burke Racing Stable, Frank Baldachino, and Weaver Bruscemi. The victory with Rockin BB was one of four winners on the program for driver Ricky Macomber Jr. Macomber Jr. also scored with JD's Chancey Gal in the \$25,000 Indiana Sires Stakes consolation for three-year-old pacing fillies in 1:52 for trainer Pasko Vucinaj.

MIKE

What are you playing?

RICK

New game, been playing for a few months. It's real time, real money, a real sport — horse racing.

MIKE

(Points at phone screen)

I saw that kind of racing once, with the carts.

Meadowlands, Race Triplet, Races 4-5-6. Race 4 begins in THREE minutes. Click horseshoe icon to select number.



#### RICK

Harness racing, it's fun. This game is Race Triplet. It's a simple way to bet on real races.

MIKE

No kidding.

RICK

Want to see a game?

MIKE

Sure

(RICK taps a button on the screen and points to a list of racetracks)

#### RICK

You just pick a racetrack and click on it. I'll click on the Meadowlands, it's a track in New Jersey. See how the screen reads,

Meadowlands, Race Triplet,

Races 4-5-6.

Race 4 begins in THREE minutes.

Click horseshoe icon to select number.

MIKE

So, it's just random selection?

RICK

Kind of, the number you get for the first race is randomly selected after you click on a horseshoe, and you are stuck with the same number for all three legs. After the first race you have decisions to make, basically you cash out or let it ride. Here, watch. I get my number by touching one of these eight horseshoes. When I touch one, it turns into a number.

(RICK taps a horseshoe on the screen and the horseshoe morphs into a large yellow flashing number 6)

MIKE

I see. So now you have number 6, for all three races. What does it cost you? How much can you win?

RICK

\$5 per play. The first race goes off in less than two minutes, see the countdown clock over here. If number 6 wins I will win \$25. If any other horse wins the race, I lose my \$5. Let's watch it and see how I do.

(RICK and MIKE watch the live-stream broadcast of the horserace. The number 6 horse wins! Mike and Rick

exchange high fives.

#### RICK

Now, I have a decision to make, and this is where it takes some skill and thought. I have two options at this point; leave my \$25 in winnings or quit. If I wager my \$25 on the next race, if horse number 6 wins the next race, my earnings rise to \$250. This decision-making is important for legal reasons; it keeps the wager as a game of skill.

#### MIKE

What are you gonna do?

#### RICK

I always let it ride on the second level. Most of us who are not serious horse experts let it ride at this point. But, if you really, really know about racing and picking horses, if you believe the number 6 horse does not have a prayer, you might cash out. It's a statistical thing.

#### MIKE

Backup, let me see if I have this correct. If the number 6 horse win this race, you win \$250?

#### RICK

Yes, and I just looked something up on a link. The 6 horse in this race is one of the top choices, in racing they say the "odds are good." Plus get this, the name of this horse is HIGH FLYING, so that might be a good omen.

(RICK and MIKE excitedly watch the horses warm up. Rick explains some of the details of horse racing like post position and racing strategy. The race goes off! Mike and Rick find themselves cheering aloud for HIGH FLYING. HIGH FLYING wins by several lengths.

#### MIKE

Dude, you just won \$250. Now what are you gonna do? What are your choices? Did you ever get this far before? How much can you win if you play the next round?

#### RICK

Whoa, whoa, slow down. Let me answer one thing at a time in reverse order. If I let my wager go to level three, in racing that's called "letting it ride." If horse number 6 wins again, I will win \$1,000. Yes, I have reached this point twice. Both of those times, I cashed out because the horse that I had in the last leg was a real longshot — longshots rarely win and I would lose everything. In both of those races, the longshot did not come close to winning and I was wise to have banked my money.

#### MIKE

What does the horse number 6 look like in the final race this time? Is it worth the bet?

#### RICK

Well, let's see, horse number 6 is listed at 6-1. That means professional horse gamblers think the horse has a decent chance. The name of the horse is BOTTLENECK, it's not a favorite, but it's not a longshot either. If I let it ride, I would win \$1,000. If BOTTLENECK doesn't win — I would lose it all. We have less than two minutes to decide, what do you think?


#### MIKE

# Commercials great, but have strange message

But, is THAT REALLY the message you want to send to prospective new fans — disappointment and a few frames of fans getting bummed out, while watching a race?

I remember when we first got in the business, in the '80s, that drivers got what the owner wanted to give them and trainers didn't get anything extra, I guess, unless they had a generous owner.
