







from respiratory distress at age 77. It lost a figure that was larger than life.

"Herve was always so popular. He was like Elvis Presley," said Herve's younger brother Yves, 70. "He could have been the President of the United States. He had a nice way of talking and he wasn't shy. Wherever he went to race, there was a line of people waiting for his autograph. He was a very social man, very sharp. He knew how to talk and he would talk to anybody."

The brothers did a good job of keeping in touch of late, even with Yves in Ontario and Herve on Long Island. "We've been very close," said Yves. "For the last three or four years, I've been talking to him every week. He's been sick for a while. For a couple of years, he's had to use an oxygen tank. After that, he got pneumonia. I knew when he went to the hospital, he wouldn't get out."

Like Babe Ruth's half-century stranglehold atop the all-time home run list in Major League Baseball until Hank Aaron came along, Herve became the leader in lifetime dash wins in 1971. It wasn't until 41 years later, in July of 2012, that Dave Palone wrestled the top spot away.

"It was very natural for him to drive a horse," said Yves. "It was like he was sitting in a chair."

When it came to winning, Herve went to places no driver ever had before. He came to the United States from Canada in the early 1960s and became the first ever to pilot 400 horses to victory lane in a year when he scored 408 times in 1968 on the way to taking his first of 16 North American dash-win crowns.

"There were more trainers driving back then," said Yves.

"Herve was one of the first ones to catch drive. Everyone was trying to get him to drive their horses."

He pushed the record past 500 – then 600 – wins during the 1970s, and after Mike Lachance set a new mark with 770 victories in 1986, Herve jumped ahead again one year later (with 798) before surpassing the 800-win plateau (814) in 1989.

Herve compiled big numbers as his career hit warp speed while grinding away during the '70s driving afternoons at Freehold and evenings at Yonkers and Roosevelt, but he did experience some Grand Circuit success. Among his stakes wins, Herve twice won the Little Brown Jug, with Nansemond (in 1971) and Hot Hitter (1979). Die-hard harness fans will recall the famous photo with Herve standing up in the sulky while on the way to the winner's circle with Hot Hitter in front of a crowd of better than 40,000 at the fairgrounds in Delaware, Ohio.

"When he won with Nansemond, when he beat Albatross, I was there," Yves said. "That was something."

Herve and his seven brothers and two sisters came from humble beginnings. "We grew up on a farm in Angers, Quebec, in a small village," said Yves. "It was a cow farm but my father got rid of the cows and brought horses in. My father raced horses in the '50s."

For years, railbirds marvelled at how Herve could keep horses alive who raced first-over. "He was the only driver

who could go parked the whole way and win," said Yves. "He could do that because he was relaxing the horse while racing parked. He would keep the horse alive and still win the race."

Even as he turned 70 and raced sparingly, Herve remained one of the most popular drivers in the game. No one received a bigger ovation than Herve did during the post parade when he drove in his last race in America, the Hall of Fame Invitational Trot at Goshen Historic Track on July 1 of 2012.

In typical Herve fashion, at the very end of his career, he provided one final show-stopping encore.

He drove in six races at Rideau Carlton in October of 2012 and was victorious in three, pushing his lifetime win total to 15,179. His next drive, on August 18, 2013 at Legends Day at Clinton Raceway, would be his last.

"Right away, as soon as he'd sit behind a horse," said Yves, "he could see the character the horse had. He always was aware of the equipment the horse used. He knew everything about every horse he drove."

Herve, a member of the Harness Racing Hall of Fame as well as Canada's Horse Racing Hall of Fame and Canada's Sports Hall of Fame, is a member of the Order of Canada and is the only person or horse from the standardbred industry to earn the Lou Marsh Trophy given annually to Canada's top athlete. He earned that honor in 1971.

Anyone in the media who has interviewed Herve has heard him say the following after a big win:

"I'm just a passenger."

"But he was more than just a passenger," said Yves.
Indeed.

BETWEEN THE LINES



For entertainment purposes only

There's a growing mindset of late among industry executives that the real trick in attracting new interest to the sport is to sell harness racing as a form of entertainment more-so than a product that can be bet on. That entertainment-first group will get its wish this weekend on Sun Stakes Saturday at Pocono Downs, as the evening will be long on star power but short on remotely anything that would appeal to someone wagering on the card.

There are three main factors converging together on Saturday that may make the races watchable, but not bet-able. Those factors being: elimination races, short fields, and that continuously pesky high takeout rate throughout Pennsylvania tracks.

Beginning with eliminations, these types of races are always a risky proposition just by their very nature. One could make the argument that there is at least some incentive for connections to win elimination races where the elimination winners get to pick their post position for the final. But in all other elimination events, the overarching goal is to qualify for the final in good order with something in reserve for when the big money is on the line. All else after that in an elimination is secondary, including winning.

With not having to necessarily win an elimination in order to advance on to better things, the style of the racing is compromised when compared to how a typical race could play out. You almost never see drivers playing hardball with one another because there is no point in taking any risk when the main goal is to only finish in the top half of the field, which is the case in two of three Lynch eliminations. Similarly, drivers are even more willing than usual to create holes for other drivers and the races often lack any type of flow because who wants to take the unnecessary chance of pulling first over when riding the rail would be just as well.

As if elimination races don't present enough difficulty on their own for anyone trying to wager on them, the issue is compounded Saturday by the fact that no elimination race has more than eight horses in it, with six of the races having seven horses and then three races being contested by just six horses. At least in cases of elimination races with full fields of nine or 10 horses there is still an actual race that develops and drivers must drive with some sort of purpose if they are to compete for a spot in the final, but a much more laid back approach can be taken when half of the field will qualify for a final.

From a betting perspective, everyone knows that larger fields generate more handle than smaller fields. In general, smaller fields are less appealing to wager on because there is a little chance of a high-priced horse winning. It becomes a matter of choosing between two horses whose odds are 6-5 and 7-5 respectively, and for many people trying to



decide between those two isn't worth the effort and payout.

In two of the stakes that contain at least one six-horse elimination – the Lynch and Hempt – it should be considered as to why these three eliminations couldn't have been combined into two. Instead of having three elims where the number of horses are seven, seven and six in the Lynch, why not have two eliminations where one race would have nine horses and the other would have 10?

Ten horses may seem like a lot at Pocono, but Scioto Downs in Ohio is also a five-eighths mile track and they put 10 horses to a race daily. Pocono currently caps their overnight fields at nine horses, so all they would need to do in order to accommodate one more horse would be to assign the 10th horse as a trailer that would start behind the number one horse. The same scenario would hold true in the Hempt eliminations, where a total of 20 entrants could have been split into two divisions of ten each, instead of three divisions of seven, six and seven.

For owners that feel their horses nose must be on the starting gate in a stakes race and not in a trailing position, it must be noted that in other parts of the world such as Sweden and France, where harness racing's popularity dwarfs North America, it's not uncommon to see close to 20 horses in races on track sizes comparable to the five-eighths variety that we see here.

Last but not least, the notoriously high takeout rates at Pocono continue to deter any serious bettors from paying any mind to the track from a wagering perspective. With takeout rates at 30 per cent for trifecta and superfecta exotic wagers, a bettor is always going to be at a disadvantage from the start. A Jackpot Pick-5 was recently added to the Pocono wagering menu, but with short fields throughout the Saturday sequence it's virtually impossible that the \$0.20 bet would be hit by only a single person, thus making the effective takeout rate for the wager an astronomical percentage, as discussed here previously.

Despite the drawbacks from a wagering standpoint there are still many compelling storylines to follow as the races unfold. And I intend to watch it all, but strictly as a form of entertainment.

Sun stakes horses to watch

Trainer Jimmy Takter has decided to give standout filly **Ariana G** a shot against in the boys in the Earl Beal and if all goes well, the Hambletonian would look like an increasing probability. She exits a 1:51:1 last time out in the NJSS final at the Meadowlands, and only five sophomore trotting fillies have ever gone faster in the history of the sport. She leaves from post six as the 2-1 favorite in the final of three Beal eliminations. Absent from the Earl Beal is 2-year-old champion Walner who qualified last week in 1:51:2 in a monsoon. Beal-eligible, he will be qualifying on Saturday instead at the Meadowlands.

Just one week following his thrilling NA Cup win, **Fear The Dragon** is back in action in the second of three Hempt eliminations. That was a hard-fought win in a race where him and others were all-out towards the end; will be interesting to see how he comes right back.

Brian Sears has retained the drive on **Downbytheseaside**, at least for the time being. Sears was quoted prior to last week's NA Cup final as stating he would "wake up" Downbytheseaside if necessary, and Sears did just that as he had the horse buzzing through a three-quarter fraction of 1:19:3. Looks to shine against seemingly overmatched rivals in the third of three Hempt eliminations.

Freaky Feet Pete makes his seasonal debut in race 7, an elimination for the Ben Franklin. He catches a couple of sharp foes and we'll see how good he is at first asking this year. Rock N' Roll World goes in an other Franklin elimination in race 11 and he recently dusted off Freaky Feet Pete in a qualifier at Hoosier; picks up Sears and is likely to attract much more attention than his 5-1 programmed line would suggest.

Devious Man earned his right to contest Pocono open stakes

Julie and Andy Miller's sophomore trotting colt is headed for Saturday's eliminations for the Earl Beal Jr. Memorial, part of a card packed with stakes eliminations.

Less than a week ago, trainer Julie Miller was uncertain whether she would send Devious Man to the Earl Beal Jr. Memorial. Devious Man's performance in last Sunday's Empire Breeders Classic made the decision easier.

Devious Man won the EBC championship by four lengths over Bill's Man in 1:52.2, prompting Team Miller - Julie and husband Andy — to enter the colt in the Beal. The event for 3-year-old trotters attracted 23 horses, including award-winning filly Ariana G, so three eliminations will be contested Saturday at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono. Devious Man is the 5-2 morning line favorite in the second division.

Giveitgasandgo, coming off a win in a division of the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes, is the 5-2 favorite in the first elimination and New Jersey Sire Stakes filly champion Ariana G is the 2-1 choice in the third. The top three finishers from each elimination advance to the July 1 \$500,000 final.

Eliminations for the Ben Franklin for older male pacers, Max C. Hempt Memorial for 3-year-old male pacers, and James M. Lynch Memorial for 3-year-old female pacers are also on the Saturday card at Pocono.

Devious Man, owned by Stroy Inc. and the Andy Miller Stable, is undefeated in three races this year. For his career, he has won 10 of 15 starts and earned \$455,393.

"We were on the fence about going to the Earl Beal, but that last start solidified that he deserved a chance," Julie said. "We were really happy with that start. You couldn't have mapped it out any better; when Andy (came off cover from second over) he just scooted down the lane.

"He didn't have to over-exert himself in his last couple

starts, so we should have a nice fresh horse going to the Earl Beal. These starts this year have been confidence boosters. I'm really pleased with that."

Of Devious Man's 10 lifetime wins, nine have come in races restricted to New York-bred horses. But the colt did win on the Grand Circuit last season, capturing a division of the International Stallion Stakes in 1:53.2 at Lexington's Red Mile. The clocking was the sixth-fastest win time of 2016 for a 2-year-old trotter.

"He was solid last year and he won in Lexington so I thought he could maybe step up to the Grand Circuit level, but you don't want to put that kind of pressure on them," Miller said. "You don't want to over-stake them or over-train them trying to work on a schedule. We pretty much let him decide how he was going.

"He trained down good this year. He gave me every indication we could enter him in these kinds of stakes races. I know he's only faced New York company so far this year, but he's raced really well. I think he deserves a chance against open company in the Earl Beal."

Devious Man is among a group of 19 Beal participants eligible to the \$1 million Hambletonian Stakes on Aug. 5 at the Meadowlands. Devious Man, a son of Credit Winner out of the mare Miss Garland, is a half-brother to 2005 Hambletonian winner Vivid Photo.

"If my horse can work it out, that's great for us," Miller said. "I think he's a smart horse and a very versatile horse. No matter the size of the track Andy can drive him the way the race develops for him. We don't always have to be on the front, we don't always have to have cover.

"There are three (Beal) divisions, which shows there are a lot of nice horses. No one is bowing out. But I feel confident in our chances. He's given us no reason not to give him a chance."

Ariana G, who received the 2016 Dan Patch and O'Brien awards for best 2-year-old female trotter in the U.S. and Canada, is bidding to become the first filly to win the Beal in its seven-year history. She is this year's fastest 3-year-old trotter, with a mark of 1:51.1. Her trainer, Jimmy Takter, has won the Beal three times.

Retirement of Martin, Clarke not a great sign for racing's future

With the proliferation of racinos and casino companies that run them, the dearth of racing people running racetracks

not only becomes more glaring by the year it is also another troubling sign for the sport's future.

This year, the sport will lose two of its better racetrack executives with the retirement of Jamie Martin and Dr. Ted Clarke in Ontario. We've known for awhile that Martin will retire from his post as executive vice-president of racing at the Woodbine Entertainment Group (WEG) at the end of 2017.

This week, it was announced Clarke, the general manager of Grand River Raceway in Elora, ON, will retire at the end of September at the conclusion of the track's live racing season.

Clarke, who was inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame as a builder in 2014, is one of the sport's true gems. He is a man blessed with intelligence, modesty and the respect and admiration of his colleagues both on the racetrack and in the boardroom — which is a damn rare thing these days.

He is a true champion of both the smaller tracks and common sense — another rarity in the racing game — was the driving force behind saving Elmira Raceway from bankruptcy, the creation of the Industry Day card that gave birth to the Battle of Waterloo and Battle of the Belles stakes races, the building of Grand River Raceway and the growth of the sport overall in Ontario. Clarke was also key in helping rebuild when the Slots at Racetracks Program (SARP) was killed by the provincial government.

The retired veterinarian will turn 70 in July, and deserves a break, but he will be impossible to fully replace and will be deeply missed. Let's hope the board of the Grand River Agricultural Society that operates Grand River Raceway chooses his successor very wisely.

Martin, who went from running Western Fair Raceway to the top racing job in Canada at WEG, is a rarity. He is standardbred man in charge of the racing at a dual-breed facility. As WEG has taken on more people with a corporate — not racing — background, Martin has represented the sport with quiet aplomb and helped WEG retain its status as one of the top racing outfits in North America, especially on the harness side.

My fear is once Martin retires it will mean: 1. His position as the dual-breed racing man will be eliminated with the breeds going back to their respective silos in an era when those breeds are physically being separated between Mohawk and Woodbine and the standardbreds out of the Greater Toronto Area entirely. 2. He will be replaced by someone without any real experience in the standardbred game. 3. He will be replaced by someone corporate without any racing experience at all. All of which would likely mean standardbreds could lose equality and influence in the WEG boardroom.

It's too bad WEG parted ways with Bruce Murray many years ago. He had the makings of an obvious successor — a person with the skills, passion and lifelong experience in the game.

Which brings me to another concern.

Racing often bemoans the lack of young people on the track and in the stands and what that portends for the game's future. Yet, as big a concern is the lack of talented younger racetrack executives.

Sure, there is Jason Settlemoir at the Meadowlands and Greg Blanchard at Martin's old stomping ground — The Raceway at The Western Fair District — and a few others. But we're not exactly tripping over bright, young racetrack executives that have experience with the subtleties and challenges of the harness game.

I don't think it's a matter of racing overlooking bright, younger candidates. I don't think all that many exist that have the tools to either run a racetrack outright like Dr. Ted Clarke or the racing side of a major outfit such as WEG.

Their retirements create yet another cause for concern about racing's future.

State lawmakers adjourned for the year in Albany, NY shortly before 11:30 Wednesday night without passing the tax relief bill that Vernon Downs owner Jeff Gural wanted (full story here).

The measure cleared the State Senate, but it did not clear the Assembly. Gural has said publicly more than once that if the Assembly were to adjourn for the year without passing the tax relief bill, he would close the racino property later this year.

The legislature also did not approve the sales tax extension for every county in the state that it's required to consider every other year.

For the second consecutive year, Hannah Miller has been named the Harness Racing Museum & Hall of Fame Amateur Driving Champion.

Amateur drivers from driving clubs throughout the U.S. and

Canada compete for the Museum's Amateur Driving Championship. It is won each year by the amateur driver donating the most driver's commissions to the Museum. Previous winners are Edward B. Rudner (1995), Bud Hatfield (1996, 1999 & 2000), Joe Pennacchio (1997), Lella McIlmurray (1998), Alan Schwartz (2001), Robert Krivelin (2002 & 2004), Gene Miller (2003), Scott Woogen (2005), Dein Spriggs (2006), Tony Verruso (2008), Todd Whitney (2010), Bob Hechkoff (2013), Steve Oldford (2009, 2011, 2012, 2014 & 2015) and Hannah Miller (2016).

In 2015, Hannah Miller drove at 21 different racetracks in the United States and Canada and represented the U.S. in an international amateur driving competition in Majorca, Spain. Her 32 driving victories are the most ever in a single season in recorded amateur racing.

In 2016, Miller repeated her stellar season, again scoring 32 wins. Her margins of victory ranged from a nose to 18 lengths. In September, Miller represented the U.S. in the international amateur World Cup in Budapest, Hungary, and finished second by only one point. She dominated in the 2016 C.K.G. Billings Series, finishing as the combined points champion and winning the East Region Final at Pocono Downs and the \$25,000 Billings Series Final at Harrah's Philadelphia.

The Harness Racing Museum will recognize Miller with a perpetual trophy naming her 2017 Museum Amateur Champion and a portrait that will be presented to her at the Hall of Fame induction ceremony July 2, 2017.




