Meager Investment, Significant Dividends

Talented Indiana Sires Stakes competitor Lil' Day Drinkin may have some bad luck, but he is the latest horse to pay off from a \$500 purchase made more than 10 years ago by Walter Haynes, Jr. and Bob Wientjes.

A \$500 purchase made more than a decade ago by the partnership of trainer Walter Haynes, Jr. and Louisville-based accountant Bob Wientjes continues to pay dividends today. Those dividends come in the form of three-year-old trotter Lil' Day Drinkin, who sports a record of 7-4-0 in 12 starts this year at Hoosier Park Racing & Casino, including last night's second-place finish in the \$20,000 final of the Ralph and Dorothy Rose series.

Lil' Day Drinkin is out of Mya Tri, one of the most dominant trotting fillies to compete in the Indiana Sires Stakes.

The story begins in late 2002 when Wientjes purchased Giant Triumph stallion Pining Fora Tri at Harrisburg. An eight-time winner at ages two and three, the colt banked over \$105,000 before being consigned to the sale. A \$6,500 purchase, Pining Fora Tri was campaigned by Haynes over four seasons, earning just shy of \$94,000 during that time and taking his mark of 1:54.4 at Indiana Downs.

While still racing, Haynes reached out to an Amish friend,

looking for a cheap broodmare for the stallion to breed to during the offseason. A mare was found and purchased for \$500. Margies First, a Crown Of Glory mare, arrived at Haynes' farm in spring of 2004. On the racetrack she had earned \$15,080 and took her 2:01.2 mark on a five-eighths at age five. Margies First didn't set the world on fire, but her first foal put together a winning streak seldom seen in Indiana, or nationally.

Foaled May 15, 2005, Mya Tri was not royally bred in any sense. Sired by a hard-hitting racehorse and a dam with very little pedigree, she would become the queen of Indiana racing during her two-plus years of competition. Born and raised at their Alexandria, IN farm, Haynes and his wife, Sara, developed the filly, and from her first trip behind the gate, she was a dominant force.

With husband handling the driving duties and wife listed as trainer, Mya Tri made her racing debut on the Indiana Sired Fair Circuit, winning at Shelbyville by open lengths in 2:09. She put in a similar effort at Converse, winning by nearly 18, then securing a win at the Indiana State Fairgrounds in 2:03.1. Stepping into Indiana Sires Stakes at Indiana Downs, Mya Tri reeled off eight straight wins, sweeping both finals of the 2007 season. She finished the season a perfect 11 for 11, earning \$124,100.

"She's one of the best I've ever had," Haynes said of the filly. "To go 11 for 11 is unbelievable. To me, for her to accomplish that, it means a lot."

Returning at three, she continued to dominate despite being plagued by foot issues. Haynes steered Mya Tri to 10 victories in as many starts, again sweeping Indiana Sires Stakes finals at Hoosier Park and Indiana Downs. Her winning streak would end at 21 after finishing sixth in a late closer at Lexington to close out her sophomore campaign.

Shoeing issues and sickness contributed to her turning in the kind of stellar effort the racing community had been accustomed to seeing. However, she had banked another \$152,800 for Wienjes and Haynes.

Making four starts as a four-year-old, Mya Tri was retired that summer and kept for breeding stock. Haynes often referred to the mare as a “freak of nature” during her racing career. Now the partnership hedged their bets that the trotter could pass the ability on to her offspring. Mya Tri was bred to Cincinnati Kid in 2010, producing a colt the following year. Rya Dawk Mya won six times and earned \$12,228. His full-sister, Naughty Nicole never made it to the races. For the 2013 breeding season they bred their champion to Earl Of Stormont. The ensuing foal was named Lil’ Day Drinkin by Haynes’ mother-in-law. As he was trained down to begin his racing career, the gelding presented his share of challenges.

“He likes to be in a group,” Haynes said. “If you train him by himself or with one horse, he would just as soon pull up or take a right or left turn.”


As a freshman, Lil’ Day Drinkin made five starts, winning once at Hoosier Park with a 2:00.3 performance. In three of his starts he made breaks for Haynes, taking him out of contention. For the picture of perfection that his dam was at two, this trotter did not stand out from the pack. Haynes credits his build as part of the challenge.

“He was a problem child and a bad trainer. He’s a short-coupled horse, and they have a tendency to bump themselves,” Haynes explained. “When we turned him out last year he hit his back foot with his front hoof and blew it up. He had a spot that was half the size of a golf ball and it made the boot stick out even more.”

With \$6,002 in earnings at two, Lil’ Day Drinkin was eligible to the early closing series The Cardinal at Hoosier Park this spring. In the series for non-winners of \$7,500 lifetime, Haynes steered his charge to a runner-up finish and 1:56.2 win in the first two legs before winning the \$15,000 final as the second choice. Moving on to The Expression at Hoosier Park, the gelding swept both legs and the \$18,000 final. Those victories may have looked good on paper, but events going on behind the scenes reinforced the reputation he was gaining as a bad luck horse.

Turned out at the farm between starts, the gelding somehow yanked a shoe off and stepped on it, puncturing his hoof. Haynes found the shoe with “nothing but blood on it.”

“For about three days it was really bad. We kept soaking his

foot twice a day," he said. "We only jogged him twice in seven days and he still won in 1:57."

Another time as he was scoring down before a start at Hoosier Park, Lil' Day Drinkin was jumping and diving around and managed to break his crupper. Half of the harness fell off and Haynes had to return to the paddock for an equipment change. That didn't keep the trotter from reaching the winner's circle.

"He's a big-hearted horse, but he has some issues," Haynes said. "The little stuff just adds up."

Moving into Indiana Sires Stakes action, the latest issue cropped up for Lil' Day Drinkin. After finishing second to favorite Fly Jesse Fly in his \$20,000 elimination, trotting the mile in 1:54.3, the gelding faltered in the \$75,000 final. In the stretch he broke stride and finished a disappointing seventh.

"He bled and tied up that week," said Haynes. "When he bled in the final he panicked. He fell apart at the end of the mile."

Put on Lasix for the first time in his career, Lil' Day Drinkin has rebounded nicely, winning the first two legs of The Ralph

And Dorothy Rose series for trotters at Hoosier Park before going off as the favorite in Thursday's (June 23) final and finishing one-and-a-quarter lengths behind ABC Winner.

Up next, Lil' Day Drinkin will again test the Indiana Sires Stakes ranks with another elimination attempt. In a division that includes heavyweight Bridge To Jesse's, nothing is easy.

"I think he'll be better," Haynes said. "I think he might be the third or fourth best in there, but he shows he can do it."

Lil' Day Drinkin will never match his dam in production on the track. But for Haynes and Wientjes, he fits the bill as a trotter that consistently performs and brings home checks. Finishing first or second in 10 of 11 seasonal starts, he has already earned \$47,875 for his connections, and as one of the better trotters in the division, he could earn plenty more in ISS competition before season's end. Not a bad return on a small investment all those years ago.

What Gural's cooking might not taste great, but a lot of people love it

This past week, Meadowlands Racetrack owner Jeff Gural was in the news once again; this time because of a spat with Joe Faraldo, the president of the Standardbred Owners Association of New York (HRU Sunday, June 19). When Jeff and Joe square off you have to be living under a rock to not hear about it, because they're not shy in sharing their views.

And, frankly, they're not the only ones. Virtually everyone in the sport has an opinion when Jeff Gural does something; anything. Just visit Twitter, Facebook, or message boards. You'll see.

I'm not here to defend someone in ongoing feuds, or rehash past decisions or non-decisions that Jeff Gural has made that seem to anger people. I'd simply like to take a quick look at the big picture.

Flip open a program for any racetrack in harness racing and, at times, you'll see some pretty strange looking racelines. You'll see complete and drastic form reversals; horses winning off the claim in certain barns which seem to have the Midas touch. You'll roll over to a chatboard and notice insiders talking about Joe Blow (who is a beard for John Doe), winning at a 0.545 UTRS clip the last two months.

When you open a program for the Meadowlands however, you don't see much of this at all.

I play the Big M each race day and I honestly can't remember the last bizarre race result; I can't really remember anything that left me scratching my head as a betting customer. I don't remember John Does popping up in the entry box, where I need to hire Perry Mason to do a background check. Everything seems to be normal. When I visit chatboards or look at Twitter or Facebook, I don't see many such complaints about the Meadowlands, either.

When you watch a race at The Meadows or some other tracks you might see some strange things during a race, too. 'Feet out of stirrups' is something that has been often complained about in the sport, and at some tracks you might think you've stumbled into some Dodge City anachronism. You may wonder if this track even has rules.

When you tune into the races at the Meadowlands, though, a funny thing happens: The only time you see a driver's feet leave their proper resting place is when they're pulling the ear plugs.

When you flip on the races at most tracks you will see many overnights with big purses and some solid claimers. When you flip on the races at the Meadowlands you'll likely see races where the older pacers are center stage. You'll see a TVG final, a solid group of horses in a FFA, or a Graduate leg. It's like night and day.

The above hasn't happened by accident. Jeff Gural takes stands on issues, and these stands — although sometimes curious, or less consistent than many would like — do have an effect on the sport of harness racing.

The reason you don't see strange form reversals, beard trainers, or trainers with suspect records race at the Meadowlands is because Jeff Gural told them they are not welcome at the Meadowlands.

The reason you don't see wild west style cowboy kicking at the Meadowlands is because Jeff Gural told the drivers it is not tolerated at the Meadowlands.

The reason you see races for older pacers at the Meadowlands is because Jeff Gural offers rich races for older pacers at the Meadowlands. He believes that showing races with horses the public knows will increase interest and handle. He's right; just look at the wagering a Wiggle It Jiggleit race handles, compared to others so far this season.

Gural has (for lack of a better term) 'fixed' many of the things people complain about. For that reason, he's their commissioner of harness racing, and that's why he has such great support in so many quarters.

What is also apparent is Jeff Gural is doing many of the things folks want, without a slots parlor, and that's worth high marks to some people. He's also doing it without star drivers, deep fields of quality pacers and trotters; he's doing it without the bread and butter of what makes the sport of harness racing run.

How has it been working out? Well, the proof is probably in the pudding.

Handle at the Meadowlands is consistently over \$2 million per night. It's easily the number one track in harness racing from a customer perspective and nothing else is really close. In fact, at some other tracks in harness that are flush with slot money, the purse of a race sometimes does not even equal the amount bet on the race. Don't for a second think this is easy. Before Gural took over the Big M, handle was cratering.

Despite these small purses, trainers have been supporting the Meadowlands, while many could easily go race at other nearby venues with double the slot purses. Some of the trainers who have been choosing to race their horses at the Big M have clearly done so because they feel they can compete. They darn well know they won't get their head handed to them from a barn winning at impossible hit rates at the Big M. They have a chance.

Jeff Gural might be polarizing, and he might rub people the wrong way. Some of his decisions certainly do not sit well with many. But what gets lost in the sideshow, in my view, is that over and over again, Gural is more right than wrong. His willingness to take a stand and be proven correct on some of the tough issues he's laid claim to, sits well with a whole lot of people. That's why, despite head-scratching headlines and public feuds, he has, and will continue to have a great deal of support.

Horse racing fantasy games banned in New York

(Editor's note: The following story originally appeared last week in [Thoroughbred Daily News](#)). The story has been updated to indicate the bill's passage.)

New York lawmakers have reached an agreement that will allow residents of the state to legally play the popular Daily Fantasy Sports games such as FanDuel and DraftKings. The fantasy websites had been shut down in New York in March due to an on-going dispute with Attorney General Eric Schneiderman, who was concerned that they were illegal.

The bill was approved by both houses and signed into law by Governor Andrew Cuomo.

While the bill may be good news for sports fans who like to play fantasy games involving the major sports, the bill bans fantasy games involving horse racing, a bizarre twist considering that betting on horses is already legal. The bill specifically prohibits fantasy games involving collegiate and high school athletic events and horse racing. It does not provide an explanation why fantasy racing would be banned.

Mark Midland, who operates Derby Wars, the leading horse racing fantasy site, said prior to the bill's passage that if it did pass, his company would still have contests involving races held in New York, but New York residents would no longer be allowed to have Derby Wars accounts.

"With over 50 million Americans playing fantasy sports, we continue to believe that fantasy horse racing contests are an excellent opportunity to bring new fans into horse racing," Midland said. "Horse racing is currently in decline, and only new innovation is going to create growth in the industry."

The book on David Miller

In honor of David Miller's first Pepsi North America Cup victory last Saturday (with Betting Line), here is the book on the Hall of Fame driver.

FIRSTS

- Miller's first drive came at age 12 at the Mansfield Ohio County Fair in 1977. He finished fourth with Hasty Beat
- A graduate of Reynoldsburg High School, Miller's first win came while still in high school with Ellens Tar Baby in 1981.
- Miller's first eight-winner day came at The Meadows on Nov. 13, 1993.
- His first nine-winner day was at Northfield Park on Jan. 10, 1998.
- His first 10-winner day on one card came in the 2003 Jug Day card highlighted by No Pan Intended capturing the Little Brown Jug.
- His first Horse of the Year was No Pan Intended in 2003.
- Miller's first Driver Championship win was at Freehold in 1996 where he won four of the six races contested.
- His first winner at the Meadowlands was Falcons Future.
- His first drive in the Meadowlands Pace was in 1995 when he was fifth, at 12-1 with Cinder Lane Sam.
- Miller's first million-dollar winner was Falcons Future, who earned \$1,057,761.
- In Miller's first full season at the Meadowlands (1999), he won his biggest ever race with Magician in the Nat Ray (now called the Cashman) for \$424,000. He also won the \$125,000 Oliver Wendell Holmes with Space Shuttle.
- His first \$10 million season came in 2001. Miller holds the record for the most \$10 million seasons with 13.

One and only

Miller is the only driver to...

- win five Breeders Crowns in one night or a single season (2015).
- win with a female racehorse in 1:47 (Shebestingin in 2013).
- have driven a Breeders Crown and Triple Crown winner (No Pan Intended, 2003). No other horse has won both.

- win a Triple Crown race in as fast as 1:47.3 (Dealt A Winner in 2015). This marked the first time the Cane Pace was contested at the Meadowlands.
- reach \$175 million in earnings in the 21st century.
- win in 1:47 three times in the last four seasons. He also posted the fastest time this year on NA Cup night with a 1:47.1

scorcher with Always B Miki.

- win a million-dollar race 16 years apart (Magician in the 2000 Breeders Crown open trot and Betting Line in the 2016 North America Cup).
- have the North America Cup favorite 21 years apart. In 1995, Cinder Lane Sam was 2.10-1 and finished third. Betting Line was 1.10-1.
- win the first seven-figure event in the history of the Breeders Crown when Magician defeated Moni Maker in the 2000 open trot at the Meadowlands.
- record 14 straight driver titles at Scioto Downs (1990s).
- post the fastest mile for any three-year-old (1:47.3, Dealt A Winner) and the fastest mile for any horse (1:47 for State Treasurer) in the same year.

Pocono gearing up for huge stakes card

What will be one of the best collections of harness racing talent assembled for one card so far in 2016 will gather at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono this Saturday night (June 25), as the eliminations for the \$2 million+ Sun Stakes Saturday Championships will be held, seven days before the Championship events.

The Ben Franklin FFA Pace has attracted an overflow field of 22 entrants, including such superstars as Wiggle It Jiggle It, Always B Miki, Freaky Feet Pete, Rockin Ron, and \$30,000 supplement Mel Mara, and will be raced in three eliminations, with the top three finishers from each elim coming back for the \$500,000 Championship event.

The races for the three-year-olds – the Earl Beal three-year-old trot, the Max C. Hempt three-year-old pace, and the James Lynch three-year-old filly pace, number their entrants in the teens, which means there will be two eliminations for all three sophomore events, with the top four finishers in each elim joining the faster of the fifth-placed finishers going into their rich Championships, the Beal and Hempt racing for \$500,000, the Lynch for \$300,000.

The Franklin boasts the defending divisional champion in State Treasurer, plus it has the defending Horse of the Year Wiggle It Jiggle It. Also, defending champion Luck Be Withyou, is in the field.

Each of the events for three-year-olds sees its defending champion from two coming to Pocono: Southwind Frank (3TC), Boston Red Rocks (3PC), and Pure Country (3PC).

First post for this Saturday extravaganza of trotting and pacing prowess is listed at 6:30 p.m.

Wilder wins 7,000th race

Mike Wilder collected career win 7,000 on Tuesday (June 21) at The Meadows when he piloted 13-1 longshot Step Closer to victory in the 13th race.

“This means a lot to me,” Wilder said. “There are a lot of guys with more wins, but 7,000 is a good number. The way I look at it, it represents a lot of hard work and dedication. I’m very thankful and blessed to have people give me great horses to drive. I get a lot of work and a lot of chances, so I’m very fortunate.”

A native of Springfield, OH, Wilder began jogging horses when he was eight under the tutelage of his stepfather, David Ritter, who trained standardbreds at the Shelby County Fairgrounds. Wilder was a phenomenon at Lebanon Raceway, where he won 13 driving titles, and he captured two driving championships at Scioto Downs before moving his tack to The Meadows in 2001.

He’s never worked anywhere but the racetrack — except for a brief stint as an electrician.

“My biological father is an electrician, so I tried that out for about three months,” he said. “I never got shocked, and I never set anything on fire, so I must have done a good job. It didn’t take me long to see that harness racing was what I wanted to do.”

For Wilder, harness racing is a family affair. He works with, and drives all the horses for, his father-in-law, veteran trainer Dan Altmeyer. Wilder’s wife, Heather, handles marketing and public relations for the Meadows Standardbred Owners

Association (MSOA) and received the 2013 Lew Barasch Breakthrough Award. Their children, Scarlett, 14, and Lauren, 13, often can be found in the paddock; Scarlett coordinates jog cart rides for patrons during MSOA “Family Fun Nights.”

Wilder regards that family involvement as a considerable asset.

“There are a lot of positive vibes,” he said. “Our hearts are all in this sport. They’re in different parts of this sport, but it’s all for harness racing. It’s quite an honor to go to the barn and sit with Dan every day. He’s a great trainer — look at the great horses he’s developed.”

At 44, Wilder intends to keep driving but can see a day when he might shift to another role.

“You’d love to do this forever,” he said. “Obviously, you’re dreaming if you think you can. You can’t put a number on it, but I would love to drive until I’m 50. When I see the time has come to slow it down, I’ll try to be a trainer. Dan said anytime I would want to pursue that, he would help me get started.

“Who wouldn’t want to follow in Dan’s footsteps? My kids will be in college, so I can do the Florida thing in the winter and get away from the snow. If I’m financially able to do that, it would be a great lifestyle.”

Quebec finals on tap Sunday

The fields are set for the \$120,000 Quebec-Bred Series Finals on Sunday (June 26) at the Hippodrome 3R with four \$30,000 finals for four and five-year-old trotters and pacers.

The third race is the first final for trotting horses and despite only six entering the race, three of them could be neck and neck at the finish wire.

Maximuscle (post 2) is the morning line favorite and rightly so. He is seeking to become the first horse ever to win all four series finals. He was victorious at age two, three and four and this is his last race in the series. Trained by Maxime Velaye and driven through the series all four years by Mario Charron, Maximuscle won two of the three preliminary rounds of the series this season for owner/breeder Ecurie Provoquante of Mirabel, QC. In his last series win he showed a sharp :28.2 last quarter mile, winning in 1:58.2, the fastest winning time this year for the gelded son of Angus Hall—Iceberg Angus.

Next in the race is track record holder and series champion from last year, Seeyou Men. This son of Muscle Mass—Seeyouinthecirce, now age four, was all the rage last year, sweeping the series and setting the track record with his 1:58.4 triumph for driver Robert Shepherd and trainer Isabelle Darveau. Owned by Catheline Pelletier with breeder

Chantal Gravel of Quebec, Seeyou Men won the second round of the series over Maximuscle by a head.

The trotting mares do battle in the sixth race with four of the eight finalists having won preliminary rounds, and any of them have the chance to wear the championship crown once the dust settles in their final.

The eighth race is for the pacing mares and Chaleurs Fantasy from post two is the big favorite for trainer/driver Carl Duguay. She has won three of the four preliminary rounds and was second in the other. She has the fastest win record in the series, 1:57.1 and will be tough once again.

Her main rival will be Miss Bro from the rail for driver Pascal Berube. They beat Chaleurs Fantasy two starts back with a very impressive first-over grind it out triumph.

The ninth race final division for pacing horses will be perhaps the fastest and most competitive.

Track record holder Atomic Million AM looms as the toughest foe in the race from post one for driver Sylvain Lacaille. After finishing first and second in the opening rounds he went back to Rideau Carleton for trainer Alain Martin was second by a head in back-to-back starts in 1:53.1.

Last week Sugarsam showed he is has returned to winning form, grinding out a very impressive win in 1:55.3 and will start from post three for driver Denis St Pierre. Sugarsam still holds the track record at 3R at age two and was last year's series champion at age three.

Both Electric Western (post 2) and Mach On The Beach (post 8) won divisions of the series too while Half A Billion (post five), whose best outing in the series was only a third place finish, came back last week at 3R in an overnight event and cut loose for driver Louis-Philippe Roy with a six and one-half length romp in 1:53.2, the fastest mile this year at 3R.

Non Stick vaulted to the lead upon cornering and subsequently parried Swinging Royalty's stout late bid, prevailing by a head in 1:54. Earn Your Wings (Jason Bartlett) stalked live cover and rallied belatedly for third.

Svanstedt co-owns Non Stick with Little E, LLC.

The \$222,975 Classic for colts and geldings likewise saw the victor sprint clear, yield, and retake off the far turn, as Svanstedt sent Dexter Cup winner Dante to the fore from post nine through a :26.2 initial quarter before stablemate The Royal Harry (Mark MacDonald) charged up from third to control the terms with five-eighths of the mile remaining. Dante angled off the pegs after a :57 middle half to once again take charge from his stablemate, vaulting clear by three in head-stretch. Just For Today (Bartlett) mounted good belated gains from the second flight, working into a clear second but missing Dante's 1:52.3 mile by one-and-a-half lengths. That's a Bad Boy (Tyler Freese) likewise emerged from off the pace to claim third.

Courant AB owns Dante, a three-year-old son of Credit Winner—Michelle's Angel.

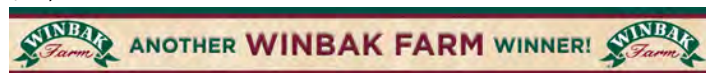
