

The Campbell women have been crucial in making John a big deal.

Tonight, in the sixth race at the Meadowlands, John's driving career will come to an end at the track where he made his name. With it, a major part of Paula's life will come to an end, as well.

Considering how instrumental Paula has been to John's career, it is poetic they will go out together like this — him touring the famed East Rutherford, NJ oval one final time in his crisp white, maroon and blue colors; her watching from her usual perch at her table in the clubhouse.

"It's going to be different, just really different for me," Paula said of John's retirement from the sulky. "It's all I've known since we got married... but I think it's going to be different in a good way."

She said there will be less stress and worry about John being injured, for one. But, more importantly, Paula is as much a competitor as her husband — which is saying something. As his number one fan, it's been tough watching him drive less powerful stock after a stellar 45-year career spent almost entirely at the top.

"It's not fun watching him drive 50-1 shots," she said. "He doesn't really get the chances, and he still can drive so well... He will feel bad that he didn't do this or that, and I'll say 'You didn't have a chance. That horse was 70-1."

John said Paula's incredible support has been instrumental in his \$299.9 million in purses, 10,665 wins, a career UDRS of .299 and his recovery from several racing accidents.

"I can't stress enough how supportive, understanding and patient she has been. And when I went through my injuries, I

can't tell you what she meant to me... getting the proper care, making sure I was looked after in the hospital. It was just amazing," John said. "You have to be such a giving person. I've told her so many times that I hope she doesn't get in the position that I was in. I'd love to give back to her the things she did for me, but I don't think I have it in me to be as giving and knowledgeable about the proper medical care."

Paula's love of the game is a huge asset, John said.

"One thing that has been huge for me is that she's such a fan of harness racing. She's more of a fan, as far as sitting at the races and watching the races than I am," John said. "The time between races drives me crazy. It doesn't drive her crazy. She loves to watch races and she understands the game, so anything that I came home with about what was going on, she understood."

Paula grew up in the Detroit area and her parents owned horses. When her parents divorced, her mother married a trainer.

"I was watching races from the time I was seven or eight years old in the back paddock. We had one horse and if the horse happened to win we'd run all the way across the infield. It's just something I grew up with," Paula said.

Her knowledge of the industry — and the sometimes-crazy

schedule that comes with it for top catch-drivers — worked particularly well in a relationship in which John and Paula were also in sync about how to raise their three daughters.

"All of that was a big factor in why it's worked so well for us," John said. "I was able to thrive in my home life and I think that carried over and was instrumental in a lot of the success I had for so long in my career."

John said Paula has been great for his mental well-being and excels at helping him decompress after a bad night on the track.

"If you've had a bad night or a good night, she understands both so well... Basically, if it's a good night, we'll discuss it. And if it's been a bad night, she just knows to leave it alone and we'll be talking about something totally different, whether it's hockey, baseball, the kids or golf... We don't dwell on it. We talk about something else and it gets you out of that down period when you're just thinking, 'What the

hell?"

On a bad night, Paula said she is quick to turn the topic to their grandchildren.

"That always puts a smile on his face," she said. "Personally, it helps his mind and helps to turn the page."

Paula Campbell makes one believe every word of that old saying that behind every great man is a great woman.

"I always found that being there, being supportive and being his biggest fan helps him mentally. It doesn't really help his career, but, mentally, if he's sound, then he can drive better," Paula said.

Family as the ultimate priority.

It all started in the most improbable way.

John and Paula were both in relationships with other people when they met in 1976. They only agreed to go out with each other because neither of them wanted to get married.

"He said, 'You don't want to get married, do you?' and I said, 'No, do you?' and he said, 'No," Paula said, laughing.

On that first date -41 years ago this past May - Paula and John kissed for an eternity in his car.

"We kissed for four hours," Paula said. "Literally, that's it. I

don't remember doing that again, but the first night of our first date we kissed for four hours. He had a brand new Cutlass with a gear shift in the middle. From him leaning over and kissing for so long, he actually had a bruise on his leg."

Five months later, the couple that didn't want to get married did just that. He was 21. She was 19.

"We were babies," Paula said. "I think we were so young when we got married, that we kind of grew up with each other. We weren't set in our ways... We knew nothing, absolutely nothing. We thought we were smart, but we really weren't. We fell in love and we just got lucky that it worked."

John said there's no secret to a successful marriage.

"You don't get a manual. There's a lot that goes into it," he said. "But we both think the same."

For their 20th anniversary, Paula and John renewed their vows on a cliff overlooking at beach in Hawaii.

In February, the couple renewed their vows a second time — this time in an Elvis chapel in Vegas, when they were in town for the Dan Patch Awards.

"It was all Paula's idea. I was hesitant about doing it. I thought it was kind of silly," John said, "but she encouraged me and it was so much fun. Just the two of us were there and they really do a good job with it. We just had the greatest time with it. We renewed our vows in Hawaii for our 20th, but I thought she was nuts when she came up with the Elvis thing."

Paula said she wanted to do something fun to celebrate their 40th anniversary.

"I was kind of an Elvis groupie because I had seen him nine times. I was only like 15 when I started and I lived out in California with my mom and stepfather and I took a bus to Vegas to see him by myself, got tickets at the hotel. I was kind of a groupie. I just always wanted to get married by Elvis in the Elvis chapel."

John wore jeans and Paula wore her original wedding dress.

"All three of our daughters got married and none of them wanted my dress, so I took my dress and laid it on my bed and I cut the bottom off and I cut the sleeves off and I wore the same dress I wore 40 years ago," she said. "John told everyone that night – he told the cab driver, he told the bartender, 'she's got the same dress on'. It was tight. It was 40 years ago and I've had three kids, but I got it on.

"It was so much fun. We took a cab there and they put our name in lights outside the chapel. There was an Elvis impersonator that walked me down the aisle. He didn't look like Elvis, because he was way too young, but he sounded like him and he sang as we walked down the aisle. We danced and he incorporated the kids' names and grandkids' names into the ceremony. It was just really touching. We went outside and there was a tour bus going by and everyone was waving at us. It was fun, just fun."

As for a lifetime watching John drive, Paula said she wouldn't trade it for anything. She has great memories of numerous nights at the Meadowlands.

"Lots of friends and lots of family. I have a lot of memories from the old building," she said. "My mother lived with us for 20 years and she was my buddy at the races. She'd go up on Friday and Saturday nights. She was a diehard gambler, with some system where she added something and subtracted something. I have no idea what it was, sometimes it worked and sometimes it didn't. It used to aggravate me that her system wouldn't always come out to John's horse. I'd say, 'I can't believe you're sitting here betting against him.' And she'd say, 'Well, he's a minus-four on this race."

Tonight, the watching and wagering on John at the Meadowlands will come to an end. Next week, he starts his new job as the president and CEO of the Hambletonian Society. Paula, for one, is happy John is staying in harness racing.

"It's not over, it's a new chapter. I think it's going to be a little more fun, more relaxing and maybe there will be a little more time for a vacation. He actually gets vacation time," she said. "There will be more time for the grandkids and our daughters. It's just going to be less stressful and I think it's a time in our life that it's going to be nice. Yes, it's a little bittersweet that he won't be driving, but he can't drive forever."

As much as part of her wishes he could.

John Campbell on the Meadowlands: "It has meant everything to my career."

Tonight, the sport's all-time money king will race for the final time at the Meadowlands.

John Campbell said he's more excited than melancholy about tonight's celebration of his stellar Hall of Fame driving career that will coincide with his final drive at the Meadowlands Racetrack in New Jersey.

"I'm really looking forward to it. All of my family is going to be there, right from the grandkids to my daughters and Paula, obviously," Campbell said of his wife of nearly 41 years. "We've got a lot of really good friends that are coming and it's going to be a night that's a lot of fun."

After an appearance Sunday in Goshen, NY in the \$10,000 Mr. and Mrs. Elbridge Gerry Memorial Trot for Hall of Fame drivers at Historic Track, John will begin his new job next week as the president and CEO of the Hambletonian Society — with one final career drive to come July 30 at Clinton Raceway in Ontario near where he grew up.

But the Meadowlands is the track where he made his name. "(The Meadowlands) has meant everything to my career. It's where I started to get noticed in 1979," John said.

He also was blessed to experience the East Rutherford track in its heyday.

"I saw the best part of the Meadowlands when we were averaging over 15,000 or 16,000 a night there, racing five or six days a week; just the nights of historic harness racing. To



be a part of that has just been really special," John said. "You always want to perform in front of as many people as possible. The one thing I remember, when we had the front paddock the first year, actually it was '78, I remember the noise from the crowd was just incredible. And it was just regular noise, not cheering, but just that buzz and the noise when you came up those steps that's something that I never forgot. I just couldn't believe that noise from the crowd because there were so many people around that front paddock."

John said what he would remember most from the Meadowlands isn't any individual race or success he had.

"The first thought that will come back to me will be how great it was for that period of time. The handle, the horses, the races, how it was run, how the races were presented. That's what I will think about off the top of my head," John said.

"Any success with the racing, you have to go back to Joe De Frank because Joe was in charge of everything on the racing side, from the paddock to the barn area, to putting the races together, to post parades – it all came under Joe's domain and he has to get so much credit for that success and just the show that we put on for those years when everything was going great. From a personal standpoint, he gave me stalls and encouraged me to come down between the '78 and '79 meet. I've always thanked Joe for that and we've just had a mutual respect for one another from the time I raced under him in Windsor."

John said it doesn't seem like it all began at the Meadowlands 40 years ago.

"It's gone so quick, it's amazing," John said. "Everybody in life deals with that, just how quick the time goes."







Celebrating John Campbell Week

In celebration of John Campbell's final drive at the Meadowlands tonight, here's eight amazing facts about his career:

- 1. He has been driving at the same track for 40 straight years (Meadowlands 1978-2017)
- 2. In 1972, the year John Campbell was first active as a driver, 13 drivers with the last name Campbell participated: Carleton, Hartigan, Herbert, John, Joseph, Charles, Jr., Mike, Neil, Robert, Roderick, Sanford, Turner and Winston.
- 3. Among his records are his 140 times in the money in the Breeders Crown in 313 drives. His \$22.5 million is also an all-time Breeders Crown mark.


- 4. Twice, he won the Meadowlands Pace from Post 10-1982 with Hilarion and 1999 with The Panderosa and once almost denying a horse winning from post 10 Beach Towel held on by a nostril over Jake And Elwood in 1990.
- 5. In 2010, he drove the Trotter of the Year Lucky Chucky and took a turn with the Pacer of the Year Rock N Roll Heaven while regular driver Daniel Dube was sidelined with an injury. Not bad at age 55.
- 6. He has 18 million-dollar wins at the Meadowlands alone.
- 7. He won his first time in the bike in the Hambletonian with Joie De Vie in his heat in 1983, then was fourth in the final as part of the favored entry.
- 8. In 41 years of competition at the Meadowlands, Campbell has won 16 titles, won a trotting event in 1:49.4 (J L Cruze), won the last two races at the old building, won seven straight drives on 2/2/83, was favored in the Hambletonian three straight years (87-88-89) and got money with all four of the females he drove in the Hambletonian (Britelite Lobell (\$140,650), Peace Corps (\$135,720), Armbro Keepsake (\$111,320) and Act Of Grace (\$25,000)).

Beal intrigue leads Sun Stakes night at Pocono

Ariana G seeks to become the first female to win the \$500,000 **Earl Beal** final in its seven-year history on Saturday night at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, after last week becoming the first female to even enter the race. The heroine of the trotting ranks has overwhelmed her divisional rivals for the last year now and a win Saturday should keep her squarely on the march to the ultimate showdown with her male counterparts — the Hambletonian at the Meadowlands almost one month from today.

Trained by Jimmy Takter and driven by Yannick Gingras, Ariana G was able to waltz around the track last week unopposed in comfortably winning her elimination. Takter has owned this race in recent years, winning three straight editions of the race with Corky, Father Patrick and Pinkman between 2013 and 2015.

After being able to set her own terms through a near :58 half mile last week in her elimination race and her debut against males, Ariana G may find the going a bit tougher in Saturday's Beal final. Landing an outside post could complicate things, but the far larger concern should be the colt starting all the way from the inside, Long Tom.

Long Tom is one of two Muscle Hills in here (Ariana G being the other) and he's come back this season in spectacular form after being highly regarded when first arriving here from Europe in the spring of last year. With Tim Tetrick in tow, Long Tom will be driven with confidence and won't be intimidated by the super filly.

Regarding his chances Tetrick said, "I think I've got a really good shot. (Ariana G) has an outside post and I've got an inside slot. My horse has done nothing wrong and has raced really well every time this year... Last week, (Long Tom) was off three weeks so he should be even tighter and fitter now. He trotted really good last week; never pulled the plugs and he won by open lengths."

Tetrick drove Long Tom on three different occasions last year as 2-year-old in the Bluegrass and International Stallion Stakes at Lexington, as well as the Matron at Dover. Tetrick observed that we're looking at a much different horse this year than what we saw last year. He described Long Tom as "very much improved. He grew up a lot and he filled out. Last year he would make some mistakes. He would hit a knee, hit a shin and his gait wasn't flawless." But this year has been completely different.

"He's come back this year and has been super gaited," Tetrick said of the Marcus Melander trainee. "He's gotten wider so he's not touching his knees like he was last year. He just seems like a very different horse than last year."

After winning the \$100,000 NJSS final at the Meadowlands, Long Tom crushed his Beal elimination competition when he romped home by six lengths while never being asked. Him and Ariana G are the only ones in here to not yet taste defeat in 2017 and the Beal sets up what could be the beginning of this colt and filly rivalry, should they meet back up in the Hambletonian.

In the **Ben Franklin**, the freakishly fast Mel Mara has come back this year looking like a horse that's now been able to consistently put it all together. The speedball has been finishing off his miles strong and he was pacing away strongly from his rivals in last week's elimination. Don't forget that this one wasn't that far beaten in last year's race for the ages that was won by Always B Miki in 1:47.

With 8-year-old Mel Mara being installed as the program favorite and the 9-year-old Keystone Velocity being the second morning line choice, the top two program horses are 17 years old, combined. Keystone Velocity has been only a conditioned level horse for much of his career, but the Levy winner has stepped up time and time again when it counts for trainer Allard and he'll probably drift up in odds once again despite winning his elimination last week.

Perhaps the best alternative to the favorite is the gritty All Bets Off. This one was touched off last week by Keystone Velocity but he went the far tougher trip of the two when

McWicked stayed on the inside and had to go first over a very long way. Dealt A Winner was the other elimination winner when he got first run at a longshot on the lead and was able to win easily; it came in the weakest of the eliminations however.

What a puzzle the **Max Hempt** has turned into in the course of just one week. It figures that after writing a column about how boring and formful elimination races are that two of the three Hempt elimination would produce shockers, including the slaying of 1-9 favorite Fear The Dragon.

The question in this race is what to make of the performance last week from the North America Cup winner. Fear The Dragon had no real response when passed by Miso Fast and it's possible that he was simply a tired horse coming off that taxing NA Cup final where almost all of the top finishers were only pacing home in last quarters of :28 to :29. Fear The Dragon was cutting back into Miso Fast's lead approaching the wire but that might have had more to do with Kakaley shutting the engines down on his horse that already had the race well in hand. Miso Fast finally had a chance last week to flaunt his best after a series of no shot chances; this post should suit his racing style well.

Downbytheseaside is certainly getting along well with Sears. After winning his elimination last week in first over style, Sears will having Downbytheseaside motoring early in the final. That was a wicked display of speed this one showed at Mohawk two back and he obviously owns a strong history of the Pocono track. In the Downbytheseaside elimination last week, Donttellmeagain lunged late when he found a seam in the stretch for Tetrick. He may need similar luck but could play a late role if there is some type of prolonged battle up front.

In the **James Lynch**, it seems like Idyllic Beach may suddenly be forgotten while starting from post 9 and having been assigned a 6-1 morning line. This is a very well-matched group of filly pacers and in all likelihood this one would have won the Fan Hanover at Mohawk two back if not for a bad couple of steps in the stretch. There was nothing wrong with her race last week almost nailing the 1-5 Tequilla Monday in what turned out to be a two-horse breakaway and I'm sure Yannick will figure out a way to get involved; I wouldn't overlook.

Agent Q was able to turn the tables on Bettor's Up after that filly nosed her out in the Fan Hanover; rubber match now. Tequila Monday was able to get some redemption last week in her elimination after coming up short in the Fan Hanover as the heavily backed fave; will most likely be controlling the race from the rail with Sears. You have to get Brazuca credit for winning on the step up last week and she was well backed at the windows to do so; gets the ultimate test for class now.

You make the call on Merriman's disqualification

The ninth race at The Meadows on Monday caused quite a buzz when the winner, Bad Medicine, was disqualified following an incident on the first turn.

Bad Medicine (#5) was racing fifth early and shot up the inside to stay clear of two breakers on the outside on the first turn, when the pace appeared to slow abruptly as the leader perhaps was keeping an eye on the breakers who were galloping two and three-deep to his outside.

At that point, Bad Medicine, with Aaron Merriman driving, appeared to run up into the back of #2 U Turn Hanover, then got briefly tangled up with the already off stride #1 Snappy Time. Both Bad Medicine and Snappy Time then both dropped back, seemingly out of contention. Meanwhile, the trailing horses, likely from being taken up abruptly by their drivers seeing the field scattering in front of them, also broke stride.

Bad Medicine was at least 15 lengths back as they came off the first turn, but Merriman deftly got the sophomore

Yankee Cruiser—Modern Medicine filly back into contention by the time the field reached the half.

Merriman – who as the runaway winning dash leader in North America with 553 as of Wednesday night and held a 253-win bulge on his nearest rival – managed to coax a :57.3 back half out of a game and determined Bad Medicine, who bravely got up to win. Her gutsy effort appeared to save the chalk bettors, who made her the 4-5 public choice.

But it was all for naught. Following a lengthy inquiry, Bad Medicine was disqualified, with Merriman apparently being told by the judges that he "wasn't in control of his horse."

The controversial judge's decision set off a few people on social media, for example, Joseph Musser and Mike James who posted these comments on Merriman's wall:

"Hey Aaron, you drove great on Bad Medicine today and did nothing wrong. Just BS. Keep your head up"

"You got interfered with three times and you got DQ'ed!?! Makes sense"

It was a bitter pill for both Bad Medicine and favorite players to swallow. Was it the right call? Watch the video replay above. You be the judge.



Vernon Downs to stay open, gets state relief

The Utica Observer-Dispatch reported Thursday (link here) that the New York State Senate passed a measure that would save Vernon Downs owner Jeff Gural \$2 million in each of the next two years. In turn, Gural will keep the track open and save 300 jobs.

The mechanism of the measure, which passed the Assembly Wednesday night, would work by lowering some administration fees the track pays for video lottery terminal usage.

"Basically, instead of paying the (state) Gaming Commission 10 per cent in administration fees, we only pay 2.5 per cent," Gural said. "We just have to show financial hardship which won't be a problem."

Gural announced in April that the opening day of racing would be delayed from its April 21 date. He claimed to have lost about \$150,000 a month since November because of the increased competition from Yellow Brick Road, Lago and Rivers casinos. Live harness racing began May 6.

Over the last few weeks, the state Senate and Assembly passed differing measures to help the facility but couldn't agree on a plan until Thursday.

"I would like to take this opportunity on behalf of all of my employees, the many local businesses that rely on Vernon and me personally to thank Governor Andrew Cuomo for his support yesterday and today in getting the legislation we needed that would allow us to remain open," Gural said in a release.

"A special thank you to Senator Joe Griffo, who worked tirelessly in this effort and the Mohawk Nine, whose bipartisan support yesterday also made a difference. In the Assembly my thanks going out to Assemblyman Anthony Brindisi, who also worked extremely hard, along with Assemblyman Bill Magee and Assemblywoman Donna Lupardo from Binghamton.

Supreme Court to review NJ bid for legal sports betting

The Associated Press reported that the Supreme Court agreed Tuesday to take up New Jersey's bid to allow sports betting at its casinos and racetracks.

The justices will review a lower court ruling against the state, which is hoping to capture some of the estimated \$150 billion that is illegally wagered on sports each year.

New Jersey Gov. Chris Christie and supporters in the state Legislature have tried for years to legalize sports gambling to bolster the state's casino and horse racing industries.

The case will be argued in the fall. Daniel Wallach, an attorney in Fort Lauderdale, FL, and an expert in sports law, said the case could lead to a nationwide repeal of the federal sports betting ban.

The 3rd U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals struck down the New Jersey law last year, ruling that the law violated the federal Professional and Amateur Sports Protection Act of 1992 that forbids state-authorized sports gambling.

The case has lasted nearly as long as Christie has been in office. New Jersey voters passed a non-binding referendum to allow sports betting in 2011.

The four major pro sports leagues and the NCAA sued the state in 2012, after Christie signed a sports betting law.

Legal sports gambling is allowed in Nevada and three other states that already had approved some form of wagering before the federal law went into effect. Nevada is the only state to allow single-game wagering.
