

Harness Racing Update

Campbell won his second last Meadowlands race with Muscle High.

It only seemed fitting that John Campbell, the greatest driver in harness racing history, would end his Meadowlands career with a win. But since he's John Campbell, he did one better and won his final two races at the East Rutherford, NJ track.

Campbell lowered the curtain on his Meadowlands career by winning with Muscle High and Muscle Diamond in his final two drives on Friday night in front of family, friends, and generations of harness racing fans who packed the Big M to wish Campbell farewell.

Next week, Campbell will begin his new job as the president and CEO of the Hambletonian Society, but he will drive two final times before hanging up his colors — Sunday (July 2) in Goshen, NY in the \$10,000 Mr. and Mrs. Elbridge

Afterward, Campbell was honored in the winner's circle by WNBC-TV sports anchor Bruce Beck, Meadowlands owner Jeff Gural and Meadowlands GM Jason Settlemoir.

Campbell's final Meadowlands victory came with Muscle Diamond in the driver's last start at the New Jersey track.

Gerry Memorial Trot for Hall of Fame drivers at Historic Track and then July 30 in the \$15,000 Legends Day Trot at Clinton Raceway in Ontario.

But the Meadowlands will always remain the track that made Campbell's Hall of Fame career.

The 62-year-old Campbell first came to the Meadowlands in 1978. During his five decades in the sulky, he won a record six Hambletonians, seven Meadowlands Pace trophies, and 48 Breeders Crowns.

After his final trip around the Meadowlands oval, Campbell's fellow drivers came to the winner's circle to shake hands and show their appreciation for the man who revolutionized the sport.

On the night, Campbell was in the money with all five of his drives, posting two wins, two seconds and a third and earnings of \$20,250.

With just two drives left in his career, Campbell has 10,667 wins and earnings of \$299,893,741.

While Campbell's career ended, a pair of 2-year-olds began their careers in impressive fashion.

Jimmy Takter unveiled filly trotter Manchego in a maiden race. The daughter of Muscle Hill kicked home in :27 to win in 1:54.4.

Later in the card, Takter's 2-year-old pacing colt Nutcracker Sweet, who posted a pair of :26.1 final quarters in his two baby races, posted another :26.1 final quarter to win a maiden event in 1:52. The \$150,000 Harrisburg purchase is a half-brother to \$3.4 million earner Sweet Lou and a full brother to \$2.7 million earner Bettor Sweet.

Takter won three races on the card with Tetrick driving two of the winners. Jim Marohn, Jr. also posted a driving double.

Total handle on the 10-race card was \$1,657,520. Racing resumes tonight. Post time is 7:15 p.m.

Daley released from hospital

Trainer/driver Dan Daley will find out in two weeks how soon he can return to work after suffering a punctured lung, six broken ribs and a broken collarbone in an accident on June 22 at Saratoga.

Two days after being released from hospital, trainer/driver Dan Daley was on the road Friday to Buffalo Raceway to watch his two-year-old filly trotters race in the New York Bred Excelsior Series.

"I probably pressed it a little too much... the truck ride wasn't all that much fun," Daley said Friday evening, eight days after suffering a punctured lung, six broken ribs and a broken collarbone in a stomach-turning accident June 22 at Saratoga Casino Hotel that also sent driver Stephane Bouchard to hospital.

"They let me out of the hospital Wednesday. They had to make sure my lung was blown up well, because I punctured my lung. That's what they were really worried about," Daley said. "I'm pretty sore, but my lung seems good. I go back in two weeks and get them to check it out. Then I can go on with what I'm doing. My ribs are really sore. I broke six ribs."

Daley said Bouchard was released from hospital Tuesday after having surgery on his neck.

Bouchard told HRU late Friday night that he will provide an update on his health in Sunday's HRU.

The accident happened in the fourth race on June 22 at Saratoga when Daley's horse Mister Miami fell to the track.

"My colt pulled a shoe behind the gate right at the top of the stretch. He straightened up. Then in the first turn, I thought, 'He's a little peggy on it," Daley said. "I had warmed him up well and he paced the turns super. He's a pretty nice colt. But then he was a little gimpy in the first turn and I straightened him up down the backside. About the second step into the second turn, I don't know if he stepped on something or he had some nails in his foot or something from when he pulled the shoe, but he hit the second turn and he kind of snapped up and he hung in his hopple and he was down right then. He just went flop. There was no time to save him (from falling).

"Another horse slammed into my left side. He just kind of bounced off me. He got around me. I don't know how, but he did. Stephane (Bouchard) got stuck there and he got launched. He was flying through the air."

Bouchard's horse Sporty Big Boy was euthanized after the accident. Mister Miami is recovering from injuries.

"(Mister Miami) was right down. There was nothing we could do about it. There was nowhere to go," Daley said, adding his last accident was in 2001.

"I shattered my ankle and that took me out for awhile. But if it goes another 16 years in between, I'm good, because then I can be retired by the next one, or fall off the jog cart dead. One of the other," Daley said, laughing.

He said he goes back to the doctor in two weeks and will find out then when he can expect to return to work.

"They'll take more x-rays. As long as my lung is good, the ribs are going to be sore for awhile," he said.

In the meantime, he said he will be anxious to get back in the bike.

"I've got 18 babies," Daley said.

All but one of his five 2-year-old trotting fillies racing at Buffalo on Friday made breaks.

"I had a couple of breakers that probably wouldn't have run. They're babies and they're used to me. They're not used to just anybody," Daley said.

Drunk On Your Love pays dividends

Sophomore has earned \$123,500 in just 11 career starts for Mark Ford and Jason Settlemoir.

When the third leg of the Ohio Sire Stakes (OHSS) for sophomore colt pacers in held tonight at Northfield Park, the first \$40,000 division will be headlined by current OHSS points leader, Drunk On Your Love.

Drunk On Your Love is the Foreclosure N-Western Show gelding owned by Mark Ford and Jason Settlemoir, the Ohio native and current general manager of the Meadowlands Racetrack.

Ford purchased Drunk On Your Love in January and added Settlemoir as a partner in early May.

"I told Mark a while back that I would enjoy owning part of a horse or two with him. I have known Mark for several years," said Settlemoir. "Mark called me one morning and we were talking about this horse and he asked me if I wanted a piece of him and I did a little research and opted in on him." Drunk On Your Love comes into the third leg of the OHSS with wins in four of six seasonal starts and \$53,500 in seasonal earnings. He is trained by Jim Pollock, Jr.

"(Jim's) another reason I jumped at the opportunity to buy part of this horse," said Settlemoir. "Jim has always been good to me and I have always considered him a friend. I use to go to the Delaware County Fairgrounds and jog and train horses with Jim... He has always had a great attitude about life and is a hardworking, good solid horseman.

"Jim launched my short lived amateur driving career by getting me ready jogging and training horses. I drove a few times, won my first start, was third in one and won another one. I have always liked Jim and his family, they are good people."

Despite living in New Jersey, Settlemoir was able to see his purchase's first start and victory in person (May 27). He was forced to watch Drunk On Your Love's next start (June 10) while at work.

"I watched from the mutuel office at the Meadowlands," said the Newark, OH native. "I think the entire bottom floor heard me rooting for him. Several members of my family ventured over to Scioto Downs that night to see him race

and I was happy to see them in the winner's circle."

Drunk On Your Love was bred by Harold Lee Bauder and Harold L. Bauder and was sold as Sectionline Go Go at the Blooded Horse Pre-Jug Sale in August 2015. Tony Dinges bought the pacing colt (hip #189) for \$5,500.

Dinges put the colt through his early lessons and qualified him in 1:58.3 at Tioga Downs, winning by 21 lengths.

His first charted line was impressive enough to land the freshman in the barn of trainer Jim Dailey for new owners Josh Green, Melanie Atley, Carl Atley and Richard Lombardo.

Drunk On Your Love made his first pari-mutuel start in the opening leg of the Ohio Sires Stake at Scioto Downs on Independence Day. The gelding went gate-to-wire in 1:54.3. The following weekend he took the second OHSS leg in similar fashion in 1:56.1 at Northfield Park.

The third \$40,000 leg was contested on Aug. 16 over a sloppy Scioto Downs surface. Drunk On Your Love scored a neck victory in 1:55, running his record to three-for-three.

He tasted his first defeat in the final OHSS leg at Northfield Park when he was edged by a neck by Ron's Pro. Despite the loss, Drunk On Your Love had secured enough points to ensure a spot in the \$250,000 Ohio Sires Stake Final.

Leaving from post four, regular pilot Dan Noble sent Drunk

On Your Love after the early lead and led the field of eight past the three-quarters in 1:24. He tired the last guarter and faded to seventh, eight lengths behind stablemate, Scotch McEwan.

Drunk On Your Love finished his freshman season with three wins and \$70,000 in just five starts.

"I am familiar with most of the trainers and drivers (in Ohio)," said Settlemoir. "I know Jim Dailey is a very good trainer. He works hard and puts the miles in all his horses, so I knew (Drunk On Your Love) would have a good foundation in him. I like the Ohio program and happy to see the success Ohio is having."

Drunk On Your Love is expected to stay in the Buckeye state for most of the year.

"He's staked to a couple races towards the end of the year, I believe the Monument Circle in Indiana and the Matron in Delaware," said Settlemoir. "One race at a time, but it's been fun so far with him. I just enjoy seeing him race well and stay sound. Having a horse with two friends, Mark and Jim, is fun and entertaining."

Will Ariana G become the first filly to win the Earl Beal?

We will find out tonight when the stellar filly takes on the boys from post eight in the \$500,000 final at Pocono.

Ariana G starts tonight's \$500,000 Earl Beal Jr. Memorial for 3-year-old trotters at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono from an unfavorable spot, but trainer Jimmy Takter is confident the filly can step up and defeat eight male rivals in one of the season's few remaining preps for August's Hambletonian Stakes.

No female trotter has ever competed in the Beal Memorial final in its seven-year history. Ariana G, who received the 2016 Dan Patch and O'Brien awards for best 2-year-old female trotter in the U.S. and Canada, is this year's fastest 3-year-old trotter, with a mark of 1:51.1. Takter has won the Beal three times.

Ariana G was among three elimination winners last weekend – along with Long Tom and Perfect Spirit – and begins Saturday's final with driver Yannick Gingras from post No. 8. Horses win 5.8 per cent of their starts from post eight at Pocono, which is second to only post nine's five per cent victory rate for the lowest at the five-eighths-mile oval.

"I really think she can win it anyway. I really do," Takter said. "Of course she's got to work a little harder to get out of there, but if Yannick wants to press it, he can. She could be as good as any horse I ever had.

"It looks like there could be a lot of horses leaving (quickly from the gate). The horse to beat is Long Tom; he's the one that looked the best in the eliminations. But it is going to be a really interesting race."

Ariana G and Long Tom both enter the Beal final undefeated in three races this season. Ariana G is the 5-2 morning line favorite while Long Tom, who starts from post one, is the 3-1 second choice. Both trotters are New Jersey Sire Stakes champions.

The Beal is one of four stakes finals Saturday at Pocono, with the \$500,000 Ben Franklin Pace for older male pacers, \$500,000 Max C. Hempt Memorial for 3-year-old male pacers and \$300,000 James M. Lynch Memorial for 3-year-old female pacers.

North America Cup champion Fear The Dragon and stablemate Downbytheseaside are the top choices in the Hempt while the top four finishers in the Fan Hanover Stakes — Bettor's Up, Agent Q, Tequila Monday and Idyllic Beach — are ready for a rematch in the Lynch. Elimination winners Mel Mara and Keystone Velocity lead the Franklin.

Ariana G, who has won 12 of 14 career races and earned \$816,467 in purses, is owned by breeders Al Libfeld and Marvin Katz. She is a daughter of stallion Muscle Hill out of the mare Cantab It All and is a full sister to 2016 Hambletonian Oaks winner All The Time.

Last week, Ariana G won her Beal elimination in gate-to-wire fashion by 1-1/2 lengths over Bill's Man in 1:53.4. She opened with a :27.3 first quarter-mile and closed with a :27.3 final quarter. The middle half was :58.3.

"She had a very nice elimination," Takter said. "I was a little bit concerned bringing in a horse off a three-week layoff; I don't train horses hard between races. I was very happy for her to get a nice mile; she raced for basically a half. She should be sharp. She came out of the race super and felt wonderful here jogging.

"She's much more a horse this year. Last year she was a little awkward looking. She just was fast. Now she is very solid. She grew a good inch and a half and she filled out. She probably weighs 150 pounds more than she did last year. She couldn't be better. She's gorgeous now."

Takter is uncertain whether Ariana G will race against the fillies on Aug. 5 in the \$500,000 Hambletonian Oaks at the Meadowlands or challenge the boys in the \$1 million Hambletonian Stakes. And he is in no rush to make a decision.

"We'll just take one step at a time with her," Takter said.

Takter remains hopeful that colt Rubio can find consistent winning form in time for the Hambletonian. Rubio has won six of nine career races, with two of his losses — including a seventh-place finish in his Beal elim — coming in races in which he went off stride.

"I'm still very optimistic about Rubio," Takter said. "I know (last week) he was over-trotting himself in the last turn, but Yannick said he had plenty of go. I know he can go with these horses. I don't say he can go with (returning Dan Patch Award winner) Walner, but he's a very good horse.

"If Rubio is really good, then I'll probably keep Ariana in the (Hambletonian Oaks). I've been in this game a long time, and you can look like you have five horses going into the Hambletonian and you have none. And it can look like you have no horses going to the Hambletonian and you have five. There is so much going on. It's how these horses handle these tough races. The main thing is don't get panicked. If you know you have a good horse, you can be a little more patient."

Racing at Pocono begins at 6:30 p.m. tonight. The night's stakes finals are races nine through 12.

Brazuca hoping to make some noise in Lynch

The normally quiet pacing filly comes to life on race night.

Brazuca is a quiet filly around the stable, but she is capable of making noise on the racetrack.

Unbeaten in three races this year, Brazuca heads to tonight's \$300,000 James M. Lynch Memorial for 3-year-old female pacers at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono off a 1:52.3 win in her elimination last weekend. She starts the final from post No. 5 with Corey Callahan driving for trainer Tom Cancelliere and is 5-1 on the morning line.

Tequila Monday and Agent Q, also elim winners, are 5-2 and 3-1, respectively, on the morning line. Fan Hanover winner Bettor's Up, second to Agent Q last weekend, is 4-1.

The Lynch is one of four stakes at Pocono on Saturday, with the \$500,000 Ben Franklin Pace for older male pacers, \$500,000 Max C. Hempt Memorial for 3-year-old male pacers and \$500,000 Earl Beal Jr. Memorial for 3-year-old trotters.

Ariana G, the Dan Patch Award-winning filly who is 3-for-3 this season, is the favorite in the Beal as she looks to take down eight male rivals; North America Cup champion Fear The Dragon and stablemate Downbytheseaside are the top choices in the Hempt while elimination winners Mel Mara and Keystone Velocity lead the Franklin.

Brazuca, purchased by the Cancelliere brothers – Tom and John – for \$65,000 at the 2015 Standardbred Horse Sale, is a daughter of stallion Bettor's Delight out of the stakes-winning mare Knock Three Times. Her family includes New Jersey Sire Stakes champion Doo Wop Hanover and Dorsoduro Hanover, who makes his debut Sunday in a Pennsylvania All-Stars division for 2-year-old male pacers.

Last year, Brazuca won five of 10 races, finished second twice, and earned \$89,666. She was the Pennsylvania Stallion Series champion for 2-year-old female pacers and also won a Keystone Classic division over favorite Agent Q.

Brazuca prepped for her Lynch elim with two wins in the Stallion Series, the first at Harrah's Philadelphia in 1:51.2 and the second at The Meadows in 1:51.3. Her Philly time is tied for sixth fastest of the year by a 3-year-old filly pacer.

"She's a nice filly, coming along slower," Tom Cancelliere said. "I started her in the Stallion Series and bravened her up a little bit, aiming for this race. I think she fits okay. She should be very respectable in this field."

There often are times when Brazuca seems more interested in resting than racing. It was a trait that worried Cancelliere initially, but he has come to appreciate it.

"At The Meadows she slept all morning and then turns around and goes (1):51.3," Cancelliere said. "It's stuff that makes you nervous when you see it at first, but she's just quiet. She's very calm. You train her and she's okay, but when she sees the gate all the lights come on and she wants to do it. You've got to love that.

"She's the sweetest thing you'd ever want to be around."

Brazuca is eligible to a number of stakes including the Pennsylvania All-Stars, Mistletoe Shalee, Adioo Volo, Shady Daisy, Jugette, Bluegrass, Glen Garnsey, and Breeders Crown.

"I chose not to go to Canada early with her because if you want to race all year it's not easy," Cancelliere said. "It's not an easy schedule for a 3-year-old filly. There's so much money; you can pick your spots. Hopefully everything will work out for her. I'm looking at the big picture, not just one race. I just want to keep her progressing in the right direction."

Following her racing career, Brazuca is expected to join the brothers' growing band of broodmares. But for now Cancelliere is focused on tonight.

"I thought she raced well in her elimination," Cancelliere said. "She's going to be fine."

Racing at Pocono begins at 6:30 p.m. Saturday. The night's stakes finals are races nine through 12.

Santafe's Coach will have big cheering section for Hempt final

Edward De Rosa hopes his sophomore pacing colt can slay Fear The Dragon, Downbytheseaside and Miso Fast in tonight's \$500,000 final at Pocono.

When Santafe's Coach strode into the winner's circle at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono on Saturday (June 24) after his triumph at odds of 21-1 in his \$25,000 Max C. Hempt Memorial elimination, quite the contingent was there to greet him.

Although the public did not appreciate the 3-year-old colt's chances to have his picture taken, his connections were not surprised they were exactly in that very position and hope to repeat that experience tonight after the \$500,000 final.

"It was one of the most spectacular moments of my life; just unbelievable and words cannot really express watching him last Saturday," said Edward De Rosa, the colt's co-owner and breeder. "However, none of us thought it was stunning he won. He is very lightly raced, but we knew he had the

talent and the heart to pace with these types of horses. His desire is something that makes him very special because he really wants to win and that is a trait you cannot breed into them."

The son of Bettor's Delight—Thesantafe Express, also owned by Matthew Iovaldi and Ralph Woythaler, will attempt to replicate his last journey at the Wilkes-Barre, PA facility when he and his regular pilot, Anthony Napolitano, begin pacing from post position two in the evening's 10th race.

The Hempt is one of four stakes at Pocono on Saturday, with the \$500,000 Earl Beal Jr. Memorial for 3-year-old trotters, the \$500,000 Ben Franklin Pace for older male pacers, and the \$300,000 James M. Lynch Memorial for 3-year-old female pacers.

To duplicate his effort from last weekend, Santafe's Coach, who is 12-1 on the morning line and conditioned by Leo Iordan, will have to best the daunting duo of North America Cup victor Fear The Dragon (post one, David Miller, 5-2) and world champion and Hempt elimination winner Downbytheseaside (post eight, Brian Sears, 3-1), along with the other elimination winner Miso Fast (post four, Matt

Kakaley, 4-1).

With a lifetime record of 11 4-3-1 and \$51,010 in earnings, Santafe's Coach has been brought along slowly with an eye on this class level shortly after he entered training. Unfortunately, an injury adjusted his connections' plans for his 2016 season.

"Last spring he got a hind leg stuck in the back gate of his stall and popped a splint," De Rosa said. "So we gave him the time to heal from that and took all the precautions necessary to not rush him along. He only had three starts last year and then this year we got him ready with the mindset that he would go up against these powerhouse horses like Fear The Dragon and Downbytheseaside. He deserves the opportunity to show himself."

Santafe's Coach is the culmination of a friendship between De Rosa, Iovaldi, Woythaler and Iordan, that developed at The Meadowlands in the 1980s. This same group also owned and trained the colt's mother, who possessed enough ability to compete in the eliminations for the Three Diamonds and Matron as a 2-year-old and the Breeders Crown at age three.

"This horse's story begins with having such a nice mare," De Rosa said. "She is by Western Hanover and made more than \$100,000 (\$112,010). She did well for us in her racing career, in fact she was fifth in her Breeders Crown elimination to Put On A Show, but she didn't make the final because Casie Coleman had a horse in the other elimination that made more money than her. However, we were so proud of her. Put On A Show was just a monster out there and towered over the other horses. We were just thrilled she paced in 1:51.4 and kept up with a horse of that caliber.

"We took care of her with the intention of breeding her and this colt is a second foal. Her first one is a 4-year-old gelding by Four Starzzz Shark (Santafe's Prince) and we had a younger Rock N Roll Heaven sister to those two, but we ended up losing her."

Although the result of Santafe's Coach's endeavors this weekend has yet to be determined, his future is bright as he is eligible to a number of events, which will only provide more opportunities for him to demonstrate his ability.

"We don't have a big stable and this is our only horse racing really, but he is staked to everything," De Rosa said. "We are really excited about what this year will bring as our trainer does an unbelievable job and Anthony (Napolitano) fits him like a glove. We really feel his desire to win and his speed will make him competitive with the top class horses. This was his first time going up against them and it was so incredibly special to see him win.

"I live in California and stayed out here for the week to watch him. All of us had a bunch of family and friends with more than 20 people in the winner's circle for him and they probably were ready to kick us out because we spent so much time there just savoring the moment. We are hoping to be in the winner's circle with him many more times over his career and are thrilled to be part of this Saturday night. It really is a dream come true for all of us."

Racing at Pocono begins at 6:30 p.m. Saturday. The night's stakes finals are races nine through 12.

Cleveland Trotting Classic on tap at Northfield tonight

Northeast Ohio's newest premier race, the Cleveland Trotting Classic, will go to post tonight at Northfield Park. The Classic carries a \$185,000 purse and has attracted some of the best veteran trotters in North America. The Grand Circuit race is the featured event on a program that includes four \$40,000 divisions of Ohio Sire Stakes for 3-year-old colt pacers.

Resolve drew post one and has been named the 8-5 morning line favorite in the Classic field by Northfield Park Executive Vice President of Racing and Simulcasting Dave Bianconi. Resolve enters tonight's race off a 1:54.3 mile against open company at Yonkers. The race was his first start in the United States since returning from Sweden where he competed in the prestigious Elitlopp at Solvalla Racetrack. In 2016, Resolve won the \$1,000,000 Yonkers International Trot, a race that was renewed after a 20-year hiatus. Resolve sports 16 wins, lifetime earnings of \$2,327,254, and a mark of 1:50.1.

Crazy Wow is the 3-1 second choice. He drew post two for powerhouse trainer Ron Burke. The 5-year-old has two wins this year including a track record-setting win at Scioto Downs in the Charlie Hill Memorial Trot on June 10 and an

impressive victory in the Maxie Lee Invitational at Harrah's Philadelphia. He has garnered career earnings of \$1,772,564 and took a mark of 1:51.1 at Vernon Downs in 2014.

The 2016 winner of the Cleveland Trotting Classic, Obrigado, will return to Northeast Ohio to defend his crown. Obrigado comes off two strong efforts, including a second to Crazy Wow in the Charlie Hill. Mark MacDonald will be looking for back-to-back Cleveland Trotting Classic wins as he is scheduled to drive the talented 7-year-old gelding. Obrigado has a mark of 1:50.3 at the Meadowlands and has made \$1,684,749.

Bianconi said about the Classic: "This is the strongest field of trotters we have hosted in my 26 years at Northfield."

Miller named to Wall of Fame

Four-time Little Brown Jug champion driver, David Miller has been selected as the 33rd Little Brown Jug Wall of Fame Honoree by the Delaware County Fair.

Miller, 52, is the all-time leading driver at the Delaware County Fair. Among his 218 career wins are a pair of Jugette titles, four Old Oaken Buckets, two Buckettes and 20 Standardbred events.

The native of Columbus, Ohio won his first Little Brown Jug title in 2003 with No Pan Intended, capping a 10-win day at the Delaware County Fairgrounds. Miller other Jug titles include Shadow Play (2008), Big Bad John (2011) and Betting Line (2016).

Miller is only the third driver in history of the sport to pass \$200 million in career earnings (currently at \$214.7 million) and ranks fifth in career wins with 12.170.

He was inducted into Harness Racing's Hall of Fame in 2014 and was enshrined into the Ohio Harness Racing Hall of Fame in 2010.

Miller will be presented the Wall of Fame jacket and wall plaque during the 2017 Little Brown Jug week (Sept. 17-21).
