From Tennessee to Indiana by way of Illinois

Trainer and Tennessee native Robert Taylor made his mark campaigning Southern Rocketop against the likes of Muscle Hill and has continued to build a solid Indiana stable ever since.

When prohibitive favorite *Satin Dancer* was scratched from the Indiana Sires Stakes final for sophomore filly pacers Wednesday, July 5, it opened the door for the rest of the field. Trainer Robert Taylor and his charge, *Donnas Dream* capitalized, winning the \$79,000 contest in fine fashion. The victory was one more in a growing resume the Tennessee native and 34-year-old conditioner is putting together in the Hoosier State.

Taylor's biggest claim to fame to date is his association with the talented Illinois trotter *Southern Rocketop*. The *Psychic Spirit* gelding was added to Taylor's barn after a freshman campaign where he won nine of 14 starts and

banked just over \$150,000 for fellow Tennessean Claude Powers. During the 2009 season, Southern Rocketop would compete on the Grand Circuit, collecting 11 wins in 17 starts including the Cardinal, Circle City and Galt Trot. The talented trotter finished second to eventual Horse of the Year Muscle Hill in the World Trotting Derby and was third to the champion in the American National and Canadian Trotting Classic. Southern Rocketop finished the campaign with \$478,000 in seasonal earnings.

“It was a great experience. To be able to race against Muscle Hill was an incredible opportunity,” Taylor said. “I met a lot of new people and made some new connections.”

Southern Rocketop took Taylor to places he couldn't have expected when he first began training horses in 2001. The son of a farrier, Taylor got his first glimpse of racing in his youth. His father raced in the early 1980s, shipping to Louisville Downs and also competing in Illinois. Before Taylor graduated from high school he was at the racetrack, and when he turned 18 he acquired his license.

The young horseman found a home racing in Illinois. He

conditioned trotting fillies Miss Vickie and Fox Valley Shannon to divisional honors in the Land of Lincoln in 2008. In recent years, however, he has spent a majority of his time in Indiana, and he has found success racing at the top levels.

My Sweet Shiela was one of the first Indiana Sires Stakes starters to break through with a victory for Taylor. As a freshman in 2011, the Southwind Elia filly won two ISS legs and banked nearly \$60,000. She would go on to win over \$100,000 in her career. In 2015, Dontgetinmyway colt Downthehighway hit the board in 10 of 14 freshman starts. Taylor's pupil collected a pair of \$75,000 sires stakes finals and the \$76,700 Madison County to finish the year with \$174,575 in earnings. Last year, the colt added multiple ISS eliminations and consolation scores to push his career tally to over \$300,000.

Taylor's latest Indiana-sired success is the sophomore trotting filly Donnas Dream. A \$5,500 purchase as a yearling, this trotter from the first crop of Power Play, out of the 100-per cent producing mare Donna Do You Wanna, is putting things together of late. She is co-owned by Taylor

with Kent Schenk.

"I liked her dam side. She's off of a Donerail mare. I've had a few horses that are off of Donerail mares that are real nice," he said. "I liked the way she was built. She's a nice, kind of a square-built mare. She's not a real big filly, but she's built real strong."

As a freshman, Donnas Dream only produced one trip to the winner's circle. She qualified for five of six \$75,000 Indiana Sires Stakes finals, trotting third in two of them. The filly accumulated enough points to compete in the \$220,000 Super Final, but made two breaks in the event for Taylor and was charted last in the field of 10. Still, the trotter paid her way, accumulating \$38,040.

"She showed some speed here and there. She just didn't really put it all together last year, but showed that she had ability," he said. "She was just kind of an up and down filly."

Throughout the season, Taylor tinkered with the filly's equipment. Through trial and error he learned that his charge does not like dirt hitting her in the face, and he's tried to compensate for that. Those challenges are offset by her will to battle.

"She's learned to kind of overcome that stuff now. She tries hard. She's got a lot of heart," Taylor said. "She's got a quick start off the gate, which helps her a lot. When the gate folds, if she's right, she can step right out of there in 27 and change and get position real handy."

Donnas Dream started her three-year-old campaign with a win in her second seasonal start. But sickness hindered her efforts throughout the month of May and into June. While the trotter missed the opening round of ISS eliminations, when the second round kicked off June 28, Donnas Dream was back to her early-season form. Grabbing the lead early from post four, Taylor and his pupil were shuffled to third before retaking command in the stretch and drawing away by more than three lengths in 1:57.1.

Despite the victory, and the scratch of favorite Satin Dancer, Donnas Dream was still overlooked by bettors in the July 5 final. Sent off at 14-1 odds, the trainer used a strategy similar to the elimination. Firing from post six, the filly reached the quarter in 28 seconds before catching a two-hole trip behind post time favorite Ajessia. They would hold that position until the lane, overtaking the leader and trotting home a

length and a half in front, establishing a new lifetime best with the 1:55.2 clocking. The victory raised the filly's career bankroll to \$92,848.

"Here in the last few starts she's really coming back around and put it all together now," Taylor said. "Any three-year-old trotting filly, that's a good mile in my opinion. I thought we could get a check, I really didn't believe we could win the race. She really kind of shocked me; she surprised me. These horses, when they get their confidence built up and they're healthy and sound, they can really go forward."

With a finals win to her credit, Donnas Dream has earned a return trip to this fall's Super Final. If she continues to improve, the sophomore can make up for lost opportunities last season.

Miller jumps into second money spot all-time

With a second-place finish Monday (July 3) at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, David Miller jumped over Ron Pierce into second place on the all-time money list for drivers, behind only John Campbell.

As of July 4, the leaderboard looked like this:

Miller moved up the list driving Bye Hanover for trainer Brian Brown in the third race Monday, finishing 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ lengths behind Double A Mint in a race with a \$30,000 purse. Miller then added a couple of more seconds in the PASS and a third in a \$14,000 overnight to finish at \$215,358,358.

The five drivers who have been second to Campbell on the all-time list are Herve Filion, Bill O'Donnell, Mike Lachance, Ron Pierce and now David Miller.

Racing royalty

Two, and perhaps three, Hambletonian champions have been, or will be, in action at the Meadowlands this weekend. Market Share raced Friday, Marion Marauder races tonight and both 2017 hopefuls International Moni and Walner also race this weekend.

Marion Marauder will make history with his Graduate start tonight. He is the first Trotting Triple Crown winner in 47 years to be back on the track and racing at four since 1970 when Lindys Pride did it – the year after Nevele Pride did it.

On this date in Big M history

On this date in 1994, Beat The Wheel edged by Pine Chip in a 7:30 non-betting event and scored in world record time – 1:51.4. Cat Manzi drove the mare to victory over the defending Trotter Of The Year Pine Chip, who would repeat that at 4 in 1994, making him the last trotter to twice be Trotter Of The Year in the only two years he/she raced.

Meadowlands Pace elims through the years

- In 1977 and 1978 the eliminations and final were held the same night.
- John Campbell (1982 Hilarion) and Mike Lachance (1988 Matts Scooter) both won the Meadowlands Pace final before they ever won an elimination.
- The 2008 Meadowlands Pace final was the reverse of an elim that year – Somebeachsomewhere over Art Official in the final but not in the prep.
- Ralph Hanover is the only horse to win the Meadowlands Pace, the Triple Crown and not be named Horse Of The Year. Cam Fella earned that honor in 1983.
- The last time Cam Fella missed the board in his career was in his 1982 Meadowlands Pace elim when he got no money and did not advance to the final.
- What do these seven names have in common? Always B Miki, Life Sign, No Nukes, Abercrombie, Somebeachsomewhere, Bettors Delight and Artsplace. All were Meadowlands Pace final runners.
- These four division winners all finished seventh in the Meadowlands Pace final: 1987 Jate Lobell, 1989 Goalie Jeff, 1992 Western Hanover and 1999 Blissful Hall.
- Jerry Silverman was the first trainer to win the Meadowlands Pace and not drive.
- In 1982, Campbell got the assignment when Billy O'Donnell qualified a pair and Campbell became the first catch driver to win the Meadowlands Pace.
- In 1993, Riyadh was the first horse to win his Pace elimination in sub 1:50 (1:49.4). He finished third in the final.
- Miss Easy broke in the 1991 Meadowlands Pace eliminations, but won easily in the consolation over Cambest.
- Brett Pelling twice won the Meadowlands Pace on his birthday (July 17) in 1999 with The Panderosa and in 2005 with Rocknroll Hanover.
- In 1995, there was a tie after the elims for the fourth spot between CA Connection and Davids Pass. The coin flip went to Davids Pass – and he went off the favorite and won for Campbell-Pelling.

The diamond shined for Forsberg

For many years, Peter Forsberg was one of the best hockey players in the world and had a big interest in harness racing. Today, the retired NHLer is enjoying the success of his new diamond, Diamanten.

Diamanten (Adrian Chip) was the strongest horse when Halmstad track held the Sprintermästaren for four-year-old trotters on Thursday night (July 6). Trainer Robert Bergh was in the sulky in the elimination and Diamanten had no problem in winning in 1:53.2 over the mile.

The second elimination saw the strong Rajesh Face (Raja Mirchi) and Lutfi Kolgjini as winner. The mile is not yet the best distance for the favorite in the upcoming Derby (two and a half 5/8ths of a mile) in September, but Rajesh Face came to the lead early in the race and was never threatened by his opponents.

The last winner in the eliminations was Makethemark (Maharajah) who put his nose first on the finish line in a tight struggle.

Robert Bergh qualified three horses for the final and had to sit behind American-bred Muscle Hustle (Muscle Mass) since he is the co owner of that horse. Bergh needed to find another driver for elimination winner Diamanten and Christoffer Eriksson, who won Kungapokalen with Diamanten in May, stepped in and took care of the reigns behind Forsberg's trotter.

An even field with many potential winners made up the mile race with \$115,000 going to the winner.

Muscle Hustle was kit up with new bridle for the final and from post position six behind the gate the son of Muscle Mass left quickly for the lead. With 5/8ths to go, Diamanten was first over and the last two quarters of the race became a speed show with two horses from Bergh's stable dulling side by side.

Diamanten passed his stablemate shortly before the finish line and came home in 1:52.3. Bergh also trained Adrian Chip for the Forsberg and in the Hambletonian 2007 the Andover Hall son was second behind Donato Hanover. It was meant to be that Adrian Chip would race in Sprintermästaren in Halmstad.

"But that day (Adrian Chip) got a fever and we had to scratch him," Bergh said after Diamanten's elimination.

"I would have liked to win this race myself, but when I knew who was on the outside I understood that it should be tough to do it. Diamanten is not so easy to beat when he gets close to the leader like this time. He has just such a great morale," Bergh said after the final.

Diamanten cannot race the Derby in September since the owners forgot to make the entry for that race, but for now Diamanten can be called the king in the Swedish corp of four-year-olds. In 21 starts, he has crossed the finish line as a winner 15 times and in his account we find over \$475,000.

The owner Forsberg was, according to his father Kent, spending time playing golf when Sprintermästaren was held, but we can assume that he followed the races on television.

Mac's Jackpot will try to advance to the final of the Meadowlands Pace when he contests the lone elimination tonight.

Jim Campbell looking for a Meadowlands Pace jackpot

The trainer has Mac's Jackpot in tonight's lone Meadowlands Pace elimination, along with a nice list of other stakes starters.

Jim Campbell hopes Mac's Jackpot can cash in with a strong performance in tonight's Meadowlands Pace elimination.

Mac's Jackpot is among 10 horses in the \$50,000 elimination at the Meadowlands Racetrack, where the top seven finishers will advance to the \$700,000 final on July 15. They will be joined in the final by three bye recipients based on seasonal earnings: Downbytheseaside, Classic Pro, and Miso Fast.

Dan Patch Award winner Huntsville, last season's top male 2-year-old, is the 9-5 morning line favorite in the

Meadowlands Pace elimination. Filibuster Hanover is the 4-1 second choice, followed by Blood Line at 5-1.

The elimination winner will draw from post one through six for the final.

First race post time is 6:30 p.m. tonight. The card also includes the \$240,000 finals of the Graduate Series for 4-year-old trotters and pacers, the \$41,880 Reynolds for 3-year-old female trotters, and the seasonal debut of Hambletonian contender Walner in a conditioned race.

Mac's Jackpot, who will have David Miller in the sulky and is 10-1, heads to the Meadowlands Pace elimination off a career-best 1:50.2 win in a division of the Tompkins-Geers Stakes at Tioga Downs on July 2. In his previous start, Mac's Jackpot was beaten by a head in the consolation division of the North America Cup at Mohawk.

"He raced really well at Tioga," Campbell said. "This is a different level, but he's a good gaited big strong colt. He's got

the speed and everything, we just hope he can take it to the next level. Dave's going with him Saturday and Dave gets along good with well. We're hoping he can continue to put in a good race."

Mac's Jackpot was bred by owner Jeff Snyder, who is a record three-time winner of the Meadowlands Pace. Mac's Jackpot is by Somebeachsomewhere out of the O'Brien Award winning mare Michelle's Power. He hails from the same family as Snyder's first Meadowlands Pace winner, Cam's Card Shark, as well as 2012 Canadian Horse of the Year Michael's Power.

For the year, Mac's Jackpot has won three of nine races and earned \$84,950. For his career, the gelding has won seven of 23 starts and banked \$180,079.

"It's going to be a tough field," Campbell said about the Meadowlands Pace elimination. "Huntsville stands out in there, but anytime you're racing in a race like the Meadowlands Pace there are always horses that step up that maybe don't look as good in the program. There's never an easy spot. There's never an easy spot at the Meadowlands, it doesn't matter what the class is."

Mac's Jackpot is not Campbell's lone stakes hopeful in action tonight. The trainer will send out two-time Dan Patch Award winner Broadway Donna in the Graduate final for trotters and, across the Hudson River at Yonkers, Jo Pa's Way and Matinee Fashion in the eliminations of the Lawrence B. Sheppard Pace for 2-year-old male pacers.

Broadway Donna, the only female in the nine-horse Graduate field for trotters, is 5-1 on the morning line. Marion Marauder, last year's Trotting Triple Crown winner and Trotter of the Year, is the 5-2 choice from post nine while Trolley is 3-1 and Dayson is 4-1.

In her most recent start, Broadway Donna finished eighth in the Armbro Flight Stakes for trotting mares at Mohawk. Campbell said Broadway Donna suffered from tying up (muscle cramping) while in Canada and looks better since returning to his stable's base in central New Jersey.

Broadway Donna has won one of five starts this season, with the victory coming in a preliminary round of the Graduate, and has hit the board a total of four times. For her career, the Fashion Farms bred and owned lass has won 17 of 27 races and earned \$1.25 million.

"She didn't have a good week that last week up in Canada," Campbell said. "She seems to be happy to be back in New Jersey. She acts good, everything like that. We'll see how she goes. Marion Marauder is the one to beat in there, but there are a few other horses in there that can go along pretty good

too."

There are three \$25,000 eliminations of the Sheppard, with Jo Pa's Way at 9-2 in the first division and Matinee Fashion at 15-1 in the third. The first two finishers from each elimination plus the two fastest third-place finishers return for the \$110,500 final on July 15.

Jo Pa's Way, a son of American Ideal—Marie's Z Tam owned by Emposimato Stables, makes his debut after two qualifiers, one at Harrah's Philadelphia and the most recent at Yonkers. He finished sixth at Yonkers, timed in 1:59.4.

"It's kind of a strange situation with him," Campbell said. "We haven't really gotten a fair reading on him. His first qualifier he locked up on a line and flipped his palate. His next one was a qualifier at Yonkers and he was against older horses. He's a really good-gaited colt and he trained down nice. At least he's had a go around Yonkers, which I think is an advantage. We'll get a better reading on him on Saturday."

Fashion Farms-owned Matinee Fashion, who finished fourth in his only start, meets three horses with wins under their belts in his elimination, including 2-1 favorite Paprike Blue Chip. Matinee Fashion is a son of Roll With Joe out of the mare Clara and was bred by Yonkers Raceway President Tim Rooney.

"He's a nice big, strong, good-gaited colt," Campbell said. "He went well in his one start and he's an easy going colt. He's in what looks like a pretty tough division, but he seems like the type of horse that should go around Yonkers well.

"I think it's the toughest I've ever seen this race. There are a lot of good colts. It's amazing how fast these 2-year-olds are starting off."

Palomino has Dr J Hanover in prime contention for Graduate victory

The Tony Alagna trainee has excelled since being paired with a palomino quarter horse for company.

Even horses can use a pal, or in this case, a palomino.

Dr J Hanover recently started enjoying daily paddock time with a palomino quarter horse named Zippy, who is the “mascot” at trainer Tony Alagna’s stable, and the buddy system seems to have produced favorable results when it comes time to race. Dr J Hanover has won two of his last three starts, including a world-record 1:46.4 effort in a preliminary round of the Graduate Series on June 3 in Canada.

“They go out together every day,” Alagna said. “When we first put them out together they played really hard. I think it just kind of woke (Dr J Hanover) up a little and piqued his attention. Since then, he’s really gotten better. I don’t know if that’s all of the reason why he’s gotten better, but I’m not

going to find out by taking him away.”

Dr J Hanover, who is a gelding, is the 5-2 morning line favorite in tonight’s \$240,000 Graduate Series final at the Meadowlands Racetrack in New Jersey. The Graduate Series, which featured preliminary rounds at the Meadowlands, Mohawk and Tioga Downs, is reserved for 4-year-olds.

First race post time is 6:30 p.m. tonight. The card also includes the \$240,000 final of the Graduate Series for 4-year-old trotters, the \$41,880 Reynolds for 3-year-old female trotters, a single elimination for the Meadowlands Pace for 3-year-old pacers, and the seasonal debut of Hambletonian contender Walner in a conditioned race.

Dr J Hanover, a son of stallion Somebeachsomewhere out of the mare So Perfect, was in Alagna’s stable at ages 2 and 3, winning eight of 19 races and earning \$326,773. The majority of his success last year came at Yonkers Raceway, where he won six times. On the Grand Circuit, he finished third in the Messenger Stakes, Little Brown Jug, and a division of the Tattersalls Pace.

The horse sold at the Tattersalls January Select Mixed Sale, where Alagna had the top bid of \$280,000 for new owners

Brad Grant, Robert Leblanc, Steven Wienick, and Irwin Samelman.

"That horse came so good last year at midseason; he just got better and better and better," Alagna said. "I think he was showing us that he was going to continue to improve. That's why I bought him out of the sale for a new partnership, because I felt like he was going to continue to improve. He's a gelding so he can hopefully race a long time."

Dr J Hanover started slowly this season, in part to drawing outside posts (seven or eight) at Yonkers in three of his first four races. He was fifth in the first round of the Graduate Series at the Meadowlands, but won at Mohawk with his 1:46.4 mile, which established a world record for a 4-year-old in addition to being the fastest mile in Canadian history.

He followed that victory with a 1:48.3 score in the Graduate Series at Tioga Downs and then finished fifth in the Gold Cup Invitational at Mohawk, where he got parked from post eight in an opening quarter-mile of :25.4.

"He's definitely getting better and getting stronger," Alagna said. "His last couple races have been phenomenal. Even in the Mohawk Gold Cup he got hung pretty hard and still hung in there tough to be fifth. I'm really happy with how he's been racing."

Dr J Hanover heads to the Graduate Series final off a 1:50.3 win in a qualifier on July 1 at the Meadowlands. The Graduate final also includes Sintra, who has won five of seven races this year and is the 3-1 second choice, and Boston Red Rocks, who is 5-1. A group of horses – Lyons Snyder, Check Six and Western Fame – are 8-1.

"I was happy with the way he qualified and these are horses he's been racing against, so as long as he's sharp and on his game there's no reason he can't be there on the wire," Alagna said. "It just depends on how the trip works out. Doug (McNair) is coming down to drive him and he knows the horse and has gotten along with him well. Hopefully, everything works out."

Alagna will also send out two horses in the \$50,000 Meadowlands Pace elimination tonight – Mr Varsity and Western Hill. The top seven finishers will advance to the \$700,000 final on July 15. They will be joined in the final by three bye recipients based on seasonal earnings: Downbytheseaside, Classic Pro, and Miso Fast.

Western Hill was second to Downbytheseaside in their North America Cup elimination and then finished fifth in the final from post nine. He heads to the Pace elim off a 1:50.1 win in a conditioned race. For his career, the son of Western

Ideal—Cosmo Blue Chip has won six of 15 races and earned \$134,507 for breeder/owner Tom Hill.

Mr Varsity, a son of Roll With Joe—Bronzer Babe, has won three of seven career races and earned \$21,024 for owners Crawford Farms Racing, Robert Leblanc, Joe Sbrocco and In The Gym Partners. He is 1-for-2 this season, with a 1:50 win in a conditioned race. He is scheduled to be sold at the Tattersalls Summer Mixed Sale on July 16 at the Meadowlands.

"Western Hill has been fantastic coming back," Alagna said. "He was really good the other night. He ended up first over a long time against aged horses and had a nice colt, R J P, following him and he fought him off down by the wire. He was fifth in the (North America Cup) final from an impossible spot, but he raced his heart out. We definitely wanted to give him a shot in the Pace. The post position (nine) isn't ideal, but he's a strong closer and maybe Doug can work something out."

"Mr Varsity was really good in his first start. His next start there were big fractions up front and he was kind of stuck in an impossible spot. He was just too far back with poor cover, but I thought he raced well to even be fourth. I figured we'd take a shot and put him in there. We'll see how it works out."

VIP Stable bargain purchases to take on Sheppard Pace

"We try to zig when everybody else is zagging," VIP Stable's Ed O'Connor said as he reflected on the partnership's unconventional path to success with Keystone Velocity. Purchased for a hefty price as an 8-year-old who had missed years on the track, the 2017 George Morton Levy Series winner captured the Ben Franklin Pace last Saturday (July 1) at Pocono Downs.

When VIP Stable starts a pair of 2-year-olds in tonight's Lawrence B. Sheppard Pace Eliminations at Yonkers Raceway, it will put its zig-zagging tactics to the test again. Phat Blue Chip and Paprike Blue Chip cost just \$9,000 and \$7,000 at auction last year, respectively, but are already proving to be valuable additions to VIP's roster.

Trained and co-owned by Tom Fanning, Phat Blue Chip was the first yearling sold at public auction in North America last year and will make his debut in one of the first open stakes race for 2-year-olds this season when he starts against the pylons in the second of three Sheppard eliminations.

"Tom liked him and he bought him for himself and approached us after the fact. We bought in. At the price he was, he fit a lot of the things that we look for," O'Connor said. "We buy well-bred horses, but we don't buy six-figure type horses. They individually look the part, they look nice."

A gelding by American Ideal, Phat Blue Chip is the second foal out of the Camluck mare Warm Waffles and will be the first to race. Although he isn't flashy, Phat Blue Chip does his work and has shown some promise.

"He always showed ability, but was never one that Tom was talking about as being a superstar. There's no indication yet that he's going to be, but he does well," O'Connor said. "He's shown some ability and he looks like he might be worth the money we paid for him."

In his first qualifier June 19, Phat Blue Chip raced near the back of the field before finishing with a :27.3 final quarter. He returned June 27 at Harrah's Philadelphia and starting from post eight, cleared the lead before sitting the pocket. Posting a :29.3 final panel, Phat Blue Chip ranged up to win by 3/4 of a length in 1:56.

"We've got our fingers crossed. So far, so good. He's never had a problem, he trained well down the whole way," O'Connor said. "He qualified kind of easy the first time and came home really nicely. He won his next qualifier and it looks like he might be a nice one."

While Phat Blue Chip is a 3-1 chance in his \$25,000 trial, trailing the 7-5 morning line choice Kwik Hanover, a winner

in both of his two pari-mutuel starts thus far at Rideau Carlton, Paprike Blue Chip is the 2-1 favorite in his split, set to go as race six on the 12-race program.

Paprike Blue Chip hammered down at the Goshen Sale just 10 horses after Phat Blue Chip. Trainer John Butenschoen found the son of Roll With Joe, a half-brother to then 17-time winner Buddha Blue Chip and New York Excelsior Series winner Oh Sugar.

"My partner Tom (Janes) was there with him, so we were kind of in from the ground floor on this one," O'Connor said. "Paprike Blue Chip really fit the M.O. for the stuff we end up buying with John. He's a Roll With Joe, who's a good commercial sire. We look at the individual and John does a fabulous job picking out ones that just look nice."

While Phat Blue Chip doesn't attract attention in the mornings, Paprike Blue Chip makes his presence known.

"He's been a little flashier the whole time," O'Connor said. "He has always looked like he's going to do okay. Paprike Blue Chip has been toward the better ones in John's barn the whole time and we had some pretty big expectations for him for the last couple months."

Those expectations came closer to fruition when Paprike Blue Chip made his debut June 27 at Pocono Downs. Fresh off a third place finish to \$450,000 buy Pro Beach in a June 17 qualifier at The Meadowlands where he was beaten just 1 1/2 lengths and posted a final quarter of :26.1, Paprike Blue Chip tracked winging leader Real Rayenbow before settling in the pocket up the backstretch. On the final turn, Paprike Blue Chip edged to the outside, glided to the lead, and bested the pacesetter by 1 3/4 lengths to stop the clock in 1:54.2.

"John goes down to Florida every year with 35 or 45. They train three, four, five at a time. They're used to passing, they're used to sitting in holes. I can't say enough good stuff about how he gets them ready," O'Connor praised. "This is a good example of him having the horse ready to do what he needed to do from day one."

Like Phat Blue Chip, Paprike Blue Chip will start from post one in his Sheppard Elimination. To return for next week's \$110,500 final, the freshman must finish first or second in their eliminations or be among the fastest two third place finishers.

"There's no telling how good the rest of the fields are. They look like talented bunches in there," O'Connor observed. "We're just hoping we can get a clean trip and try to come away with some money. If we get lucky, maybe one or both of them proceed onto next week, but starting from the rail is a huge advantage."

First post time tonight at Yonkers is 7:10 p.m.

Four divisions of the New York Sire Stakes (NYSS) for freshman filly pacers were held Friday (July 7) at Vernon Downs.

Twin B Peaches (Mark MacDonald) come on late to get an upset win during the first division of the NYSS (\$27,750) for freshman pacing fillies. All On Top Hanover (Betterthancheddar—Allamerican Apex)) who was driven by Marcus Miller, went to the front. However, Hurrikane Shorty (Art Major—Speed Date) who was driven by Jimmy Marohn Jr, would take over before the half. As they went to the top of the stretch the two favorites duked it out. Twin B Peaches (Betterthancheddar—Beach Bound) who is owned by Onaroll Stable, Touch Stone Farms, Ozzie Mackay and Reginald Petipas, would watch from third then fire out at mid-stretch and go by to take the victory at the wire. Twin B Peaches (\$23.60), who is trained by Blake Macintosh, won in 1:52. Hurrikane Shorty finished second best while All On Top Hanover got third.

The second division NYSS (\$28,250) for the 2 year-old fillies would go to another long shot, Walk From Heaven (Rock N Roll Heaven—Walk Of Shame). Owned by Frank Chick, while trained by Kevin Lare and piloted by Brett Miller, she would follow the lead of Dance Blue (Rock N Roll Heaven—Tessa Hanover). Dance Blue (Mark MacDonald) would put up the fractions of :27.4, :57, 1:24.4, but would go off stride just before the top of the stretch. This left an opening for Walk From Heaven (\$37.80) and she would hold

off the late charge of Classy Chris (Art Major—Rockroll Wishes) to win in 1:53.2. Classy Chris (Jim Morrill Jr.) finished second. Let's Fall In Love (Rock N Roll Heaven—Time N Again), who was driven by Matt Kakaley, finished third.

The third division NYSS (\$27,750) went to Ubettergo Go (Art Major—Ubetterthink Think). Owned by Blake Macintosh (trainer), Tony Basile, Reginald Petitpas and Ozzie Mackay, while driven by Mark MacDonald, Ubettergo Go (\$9.80), went gate-to-wire in 1:53 putting all the rest away with a :26.3 last quarter. Line Dancer (Art Major—Burning Beaches), who was driven by Brett Miller finished second. Matt Kakaley drove Step Beyond (Art Major-Apogee Hanover) to a third place finish.

The final division NYSS (\$28,250) went to the big favorite Betterthangraduate (Betterthancheddar—Western Graduate) who was driven by Jim Morrill Jr. She would follow early leader Silk Reed (Rock N Roll Heaven—Fantasy Jet) who was driven by Tyler Buter all the way to the stretch. Betterthangraduate (\$2.70) who is owned by Burke Racing, Silva Pernel and Libby, with P Collura and Weaver Brussemi, and trained by Ron Burke, would hold off a late charge by Speedo Miss (Roll With Joe—String Bikini) to win in 1:55. Speedo Miss (Marcus Miller) got second. Mark MacDonald steered Lulu De Vie (Rock N Roll Heaven—Jetta Blue Chip) to third place.

Dancin Doug and Sports Legend impress in OSS debuts

Sons of Ontario sire Sportswriter put on a show at Mohawk Racetrack on Friday evening in the first Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold Series event for two-year-old pacing colts and geldings.

A total of 10 Sportswriter offspring went postward in two \$97,200 Gold Series divisions and it was Dancin Doug who emerged from the first battle with a Gold trophy. Starting from Post 4 the colt, in rein to Doug McNair, landed third and watched from a respectful distance as fan favorite Taste Of History and second choice Simple Kinda Man rocketed out to a :25.3 opening quarter, a :53.4 half and a 1:22.3 three-quarters. Rolling off the last turn McNair tipped Dancin Doug around the exhausted leaders and the fans' third choice paced down the stretch to a one-length win in 1:52.2. Western Passage and Lucky Sport, also sons of Sportswriter, closed well to finish second and third.

"I actually thought I had him up too close because the speed was real hot," said McNair. "But he kept up and he did

everything I needed him to do.”

McNair crafted Dancin Doug's first lifetime win for trainer Ron Adams of LaSalle and owners David Kryway of Amherstburg and numbered company 1362313 Ontario Ltd. of Windsor, ON. The partners acquired the half-brother to \$1.5 million winner Dancin Yankee at the 2016 Lexington-Selected Yearling Sale for \$95,000 and have recouped \$50,280 through the youngster's first two starts.

Friday's outing was the fourth time McNair has sat in a race bike behind Dancin Doug and the Guelph, ON resident has been slightly more impressed with the colt after each outing.

“I schooled him about a week before he qualified. They told me to go in 2:05 and I went in 2:00, but he just did it so handy,” McNair said. “And then — I knew he had a little go to him, I didn't know how much go he had — and then after the first qualifier (June 10) obviously, last quarter in :26 flat, you know that's pretty good speed. A lot of horses can go in :27 and a piece or :28 last quarter, but :26 flat in the first start is pretty impressive.

“He's a big horse, he's nice gaited and he's smart. I mean it's still early, but he's doing everything right.”

Four races later, the second group of novice pacers lined up behind the Mohawk Racetrack starting gate and once again it was Sportswriter sons crossing under the wire first. Fan favourite Goth Hanover took control early and led a parade of colts through a :27 quarter, :55.3 half and 1:23.4 three-quarters. Goth Hanover was being shadowed by Atomic Seelster and Sports Legend and as the leader squared up in the stretch both colts were preparing their charge. Laying down a :27.4 final quarter, it was Sports Legend who reeled in Goth Hanover, scoring a one-half length victory in 1:52.2.

Atomic Seelster, a son of Shadow Play, finished third.

Like Dancin Doug, Sports Legend prepped for Thursday's Gold test with a two-year-old event at Mohawk on June 30, finishing second, but Mohawk fans overlooked the gelding, sending him off as their seventh choice. Even trainer Richard Moreau admitted that he was a bit surprised by the pacer's victorious effort.

“They deal with the babies all winter and they had good expectations for this horse,” said the Puslinch, ON resident, who conditions Sports Legend for Gestion J Y Blais Inc. of Montreal, QC and welcomed the gelding to his barn just before his June 24 qualifier at Mohawk. “I didn't really believe until tonight.”

Milton, ON resident Sylvain Filion piloted Sports Legend to the win and noted that the gelding was significantly improved over his maiden outing.

“Last week he raced pretty good, but he got bumpy late because he lost his momentum, if he doesn't do that last week he's way closer to the leader you know,” explained Filion from the winner's circle. “But tonight he was pacing way better and he raced big.”

The first foal from \$258,417 winner Island Terror, Sports Legend was a \$50,000 purchase from the 2016 Harrisburg Yearling Sale and has earned \$52,100 in his first two starts.

The two-year-old pacing colts will return to Mohawk Racetrack for their second Gold Series event on July 20. In the meantime the Campbellville oval plays host to the first Grassroots event for the two-year-old pacing colts on Monday, July 10. The freshman pacers will kick things off in Monday's first race, post time 7:30 pm, and will also be featured in Races 3, 6, 7, and 9.

Beckhams Z Tam and driver Ricky Macomber Jr. made a clean sweep of the second round of Indiana Sires Stakes action after they captured the featured event of the evening, the \$75,000 Indiana Sires Stakes final for three-year-old pacing colts and geldings, at Hoosier Park Racing & Casino on Friday. With a final time of 1:50.3, Beckham's Z Tam notched his third consecutive victory at Hoosier Park and became the sport's newest \$100,000 earner after the victory.

Leaving from post two in a talented field of 10, Beckham's Z Tam was unhurried from the gate and settled along the rail in fifth. Ronnie Wrenn Jr. had Meadowbrook Tiger pointed to the front from post six to get the first call through a snappy opening panel in :25.4. Limited Edition and Todd Warren benefitted from a pocket trip while Dave and Dennis and Brandon Bates were next in line, third.

Macomber Jr. gave Beckham's Z Tam the go-ahead and he quickly marched to the front to grab command just before

the half in :54.2. Unable to wait any longer, Trace Tetrick also gave Rock N Tony the green light down the backside and he began his long first-over journey to the front.

Reaching the three-quarter clocking in 1:22.1, Rock N Tony was able to reach the leader's wheel as the field tightened and turned for home. Rock N Tony began to feel the long first-over mile just as Beckham's Z Tam found another gear. Utilizing a :28.2 final quarter, Beckham's Z Tam kicked home to win by a two and a half lengths over Rock N Tony. Meadowbrook Tiger held on for third place honors. As the heavy betting favorite, Beckham's Z Tam returned \$4.80 to his supporters at the betting windows.

Trained by Hoosier Park's leading trainer, Jamie Macomber, Beckham's Z Tam recorded his seventh victory from eight seasonal starts and seventh lifetime win from 14 outings. The 1:50.3 clocking established a new lifetime mark for the three-year-old son of Always A Virgin—Sara's Lucky Charm. Owned by the Z Tam Stables LLC, Beckham's Z Tam pushed his lifetime bankroll to \$115,861 with the victory.
