# Looking For a More Manageable Life, Sweden's Top Trainer is Headed to the US

It would seem that Åke Svanstedt has everything he could ask for in Sweden. He was the Driver of the Year and Champion Trainer in 2012, his stable leading in every category imaginable. For the 54-year-old horseman, 2013 has been no different as his stable has earned about \$2.7 million, \$1 million more than his closest competitor.

But his tremendous success has come at a cost. His life isn't exactly easy.

"The weather here, we have very long winters in Sweden and race the whole year," Svanstedt said. "We don't have meetings like you do in the US. We race the whole time. In the winter it is tough. You have to drive around a lot in the car in the snow and rain. Everything is very hard."

So Svanstedt is about to walk away from everything he has accomplished in Sweden and start

all over in the U.S. In November, he will arrive in Vero Beach, Florida and take up residency at the training center owned by one of his main clients Karl-Erik Bender. Some time in the spring he will head north to New Jersey and begin his assault on U.S. racing. His wife Sarah and young sons Erik, 2, and Jonas, a newborn, will take the journey with him. He has already hired Bjorn Noren to be his second trainer and assist him on the transition to U.S. racing.

"You get tired of Sweden," said Swedish native and U.S. Hall of Fame trainer Jimmy Takter. "You race 12 months a year and in brutal weather. I think he wants to have a more comfortable life and be able to enjoy racing more. It's a different system here versus Sweden. But I know Åke quite well and he has been very successful. He's a good horseman."

Svanstedt currently trains more than 200 horses in Sweden, but says he will probably bring no more than 30 or 40 with him when he starts anew in the U.S. He plans to attend the yearling sales in the U.S. this fall to restock, but has no intention of having such a massive stable again.

"I don't know how many I will have all together. In Sweden I had 200 horses but I don't want to train 200 horses anymore," he said. "I need to learn the system and then I can start to build a bigger stable. Bjorn Noren said he has heard from some Americans who want to give me horses. We will see what happens."

Despite all his accomplishments, Svandstedt will face a

huge learning curve when he gets to the U.S. For one, he has never trained a pacer. But he says he does not want to limit himself here to just trotters and looks forward to the challenge of learning how to train pacers. He will also need to adjust to a country where there is a great emphasis on younger horses. In Sweden, 2-year-olds and even 3-year-olds are rarely in the spotlight and the majority of the major races are for older horses.

"It will be new for me, racing 2-year-olds, but I know I can do it," he said.

"He has mostly trained older horses lately in Sweden," said Noren, who came to North America in 1996. "But he's won a lot of big 3-year-olds races in Sweden and 3-year-old races there, you have to look at them there like you would 2-year-old races here.

Svanstedt says he will continue to drive most of his own horses in the U.S. and will use catch drivers only when necessary. He also said will not be getting any of the horses that Bender owns that are currently based in the U.S. with Staffan Lind.

It's clear his knowledge of American racing is limited. When asked about his primary goals in the U.S. he said winning the Hambletonian but admitted he could not name

any other races.

"The Hambletonian is the biggest race and I would love to win it," Svanstedt said. "I know it is not easy to win it. Other than that, I do not know much yet about the other races."

He also told a Swedish newspaper that "harness racing is on the rise" in the U.S., which, unfortunately, not many here would agree with.

He will have a lot to learn, but anyone who has had as much success as Svanstedt figures to have quite an impact on U.S. racing.

"Yes, I was surprised when he said he wanted to come here," Noren said. "You would think someone who did this would be someone who wasn't doing any good in Sweden. Him, he's been doing better and better every year."

So the great experiment and the great challenge will begin in November. Plenty of trainers have come to the US from Europe, Australia, New Zealand, but perhaps none with such stellar credentials. He's not so brash to predict that he will take American harness racing by storm, but he does guarantee one thing: that he will enjoy this.

"Everything will be new," Svanstedt said. "It will be a new life. But I am looking forward to it and I know I will like it."



#### **Gural Responds to Pace Elims Criticism**

While Jason Settlemoir and I encourage feedback from the industry and our customers and are not immune to criticism, I must say I was somewhat surprised by the two letters published on Sunday regarding the decision to give three of the entrants into the Meadowlands Pace byes rather than have a seven and a six horse elimination with the first five finishers making it into the final. It is disappointing that people do not recognize that 100% of our income and 100% of the money going for purses comes solely from wagering on horse racing. As we have seen up in Canada and elsewhere, it is almost impossible to have decent purses and operate a first class racing facility without income from slots or riverboats or some other alternative source.

As a result, we are very sensitive to the needs of our customers and if nothing else this year has proven that our customers do not want six and seven horse races with five betting interests because of entries and a one to five favorite. They much prefer full ten horse fields regardless of the quality of the horses and drivers. There is no better example than what we saw on Saturday, June 8, when all of our regular drivers were up in Canada for the North America Cup eliminations, along with several other major race eliminations and here at the Meadowlands we had thirteen races with lesser horses, unfamiliar drivers, but almost all ten horse fields and as a result our handle that night was \$3,050,000. That was considerably more than the wagering at Mohawk on a great card.



Taking it a step further, last Saturday we had the same top horses here at the Meadowlands and the best drivers in the sport but only 4 full fields and seven races with eight or fewer betting interests and as a result our handle last Saturday was \$200,000 less than it was on June 8.

Our customers are very important and we are proud of the fact that our handle has increased almost 35% because while we do not have the highest purses we do have competitive racing and that is what our customers want.

The real issue that no one mentioned is the fact that with Pennsylvania having so much slots money available we now have a situation where in order for the top three year olds to race in five of the major three year old stakes they have to race nine weeks in a row which is insane. I would hope that we can address this problem next year so that we can come up with a schedule that allows a great horse like Captaintreacherous to race at as many racetracks as possible, but I do not see how having nine straight weeks of races for these top three year old colts is good for the sport or good for the horse or the owner. I think the three horses that got byes earned the right and they took a chance by not trying to earn their post as the winner of the elimination did. The bottom line is that we try to give our customers what they want and unfortunately sometimes what they want are camel and ostrich races which is a little discouraging...but it is what it is. **Hambletonian Notes**: Though **Wheeling N Dealin** suffered his first career defeat last week at Mohawk in his 3-year-old debut, trainer Dustin Jones has not lost any faith in his colt. "At first I was disappointed that he lost his first race, but then when you look at his lines it was a different story," Jones said. "He had to come first over and first over at Mohawk, that's a big sweeping turn there, so that's a pretty good move when you move first over. He came

back 28 and 2 and he trotted in 53 and 4 and he had never trotted that fast before. I actually thought it was a pretty good race because it was something like two seconds faster than he had ever been." The plan for Wheeling N Dealin is another open at Mohawk on July 23 and then a possible start at the Meadowlands on July 26 before the Hambletonian itself...Though Jones remains confident, his competitors know that with Wheeling N Dealin's first loss the Hambletonian now looks more wide open than ever. "I'll be honest, to think my horse (All Laid Out) could win the Hambletonian was definitely pie in the sky," trainer Noel Daley said."But with the way things have fallen here everything looks different. To me, the RC Royalty colt (Royalty For Life) looks really good, but he has to stay flat. He's quicker than my horse, for sure. I'd be shocked if I could win but worse horses than him have won it."...Last week's Pennsylvania All-Stars races at Pocono may launch a bunch of horses toward the Hambletonian. Four of the five winners in the male trotting races are Hambo eligible. They are **Brew Master, Aperfectyankee, Bluto** and **All Laid Out**. As

expected, Saturday's Stanley Dancer at the Meadowlands is loaded with horses with Hambletonian aspirations. It could be a pivotal race for **Smilin Eli**, who had looked so good before finishing fifth in the Beal at Pocono. After the race trainer Deshawn Minor said he colt was sick and off his game and expects a full recovery in the Dancer. The Dancer favorite could be **Corky**, who is coming off a win in the Beal, but he will have to deal with the 10 post. All together, 12 will take part in the \$294,000 event...**Royalty For Life** warmed up for the Dancer with a qualifier win in 1:51.3 last Saturday at the Meadowlands, where he won by 19 lengths. But the problem for the talented colt is that he has broken stride in three straight pari-mutuel starts.

Race 7, F&M C-1/B-2 Pace

ODDS ON AVENTURE had no shot in her last and her race here prior to the scratch was encouraging. There's no one else in here that I feel is that much faster and she's playable while picking up JC. EIGHTHUNRDOLARBILL was a square priced winner in these pages last weekend and if anything this field might be a little lighter than the one she just beat; short priced repeat contender. TWIN B ELITE will be going forward early from the outside for YG and Burke; Jereme's Jet 4-year-old steps up while in good form. RAMONA DISOMMA has been lacking in both her recent starts here and AUTHORIZE simply never progressed during the off-season.

#### Race 8, C-1 Trot

SWAN IN A MILLION takes what I think is a bigger drop than how it looks on paper and is capable of surprising against these despite not yet earning a single penny on the year. Two back this one raced well off the qualifier against an uncatchable winner in 1:52:4 and is worth a swing at the anticipated square price. SHOELESS WHITE SOX is no stranger to this oval and could return to better form on the drop and move back to the big track for Harder. ELIN invades from Canada and moves to Elliott; worth keeping tabs on. THISTLE DHU doesn't find herself in the easiest spot for a 3-year-old filly, but she's already won here this year and barn warrants consideration. LUCKYCHARM HANOVER is a tough call; that was a 99/1 winner this one couldn't track down last week.

#### Race 9, C-2 Pace

In a field where no one looks particularly inspiring, it's hard to believe this where AVENUE HANOVER has fallen to but he does stand out against these. This one makes his third start back on the year and that was a pretty lively clip he went last week; winner of his race from two back has gone onto do good things against far better. ESPRIT DE KAYJAY A doesn't appear as sharp as he was at times earlier in the year but I wouldn't rule him out entirely against these. HE'S A BEACHBOY is just 1-19 on the year and isn't one of my favorites, but the change to Tetrick does warrant attention. CORAL SNAKE qualified against a couple classy ones and CC RACY could find a way into from the rail at a big price.

#### Race 10, C-2 Trot

KENDA might be a bit better than I first gave her credit for and that Flower Child final that she shocked in two back has produced a couple subsequent big efforts from others next out. This one didn't disgrace herself last out against Summer Indian's huge mile; an honest try at a square price should be coming. PILATUS has generally been facing better throughout the year but he's disappointed here a number of times at short odds. If my memory serves me, CHINESE CUISINE has won here before and returns while switching for Duer to Bittle; a possibility. MARCUS BI could be around for a share.

#### You'd Have to be a Magician To Beat This Horse By Bill Finley

The best 3-year-old trotter in North America may be Bee A Magician, but she's not going to get a chance to prove it



Bee A Magician is on her game as she heads into the Del Miller (New Image Media photo) Saturday night or on Hambletonian Day. Her trainer Richard "Nifty" Norman has ruled her out of the Hambletonian and will instead concentrate on races for fillies, like Saturday's \$265,500 Del Miller.

"Hypothetically, I think she stacks up really well against them," Norman said of the top trotting colts. "I think two or three of the fillies stack up pretty good with the colts.

Everybody realizes the colt division

is not as strong as it has been in

other years. The fact that the Hambletonian is two heats all but made up our minds for us. I talked with one of the owners the other day and said this particular year, with colts not looking as strong as the fillies, you'd be very tempted to go in the Hambletonian. But that it is two heats rules us out."

Bee A Magician is 6 for 6 this year, but will do battle Saturday with a new driver as Brian Sears replaces Rick Zeron.

"(Going to Sears) was always in the back of our minds," Norman said. "Nothing against Rick, who did a fantastic job driving her, but we always felt that on Hambletonian Day and in the biggest races we wanted to try to get the best driver we could for the particular event. For my money, there's nobody better than Brian."

As Bee A Magician has steamrolled the competition this

year one of her victims has been 2012 Dan Patch Award winner To Dream On. She's beaten her the two times the two have met this year. But doing so again may not be that easy. After going off form To Dream On looked like her old self last week when winning a division of the Reynolds. She is trained by Jimmy Takter.

"I always fear that horse and I always fear that stable," Norman said. "I know she hasn't been at her best for some of her races this year, but I would imagine she's going to race very well over the next several weeks."

Also undefeated this year at 4 for 4, Frau Blucher is another who can't be thrown out. The Chris Oakes-trained filly will be stepping up after racing against fellow Pennsylvania breds.

Freehold, NJ --- I Luv The Nitelife tries for her third
consecutive stakes final win Saturday night when she faces

six foes in the \$184,250 Mistletoe Shalee for 3-year-old filly pacers at the Meadowlands Racetrack.

Trained by Chris Ryder and driven by Tim Tetrick, I Luv The Nitelife will start from post two and is the 4-5 morning line favorite. She has won five of six races this year, earning \$409,922 for owners Richard and Joanne Young. For her

career, I Luv The Nitelife has won nine of 16 starts and \$1.09 million.

With only seven fillies entered in the race, eliminations were unnecessary last weekend. The down time was fine with Ryder, particularly because I Luv The Nitelife raced the previous five weeks in a row.

I Luv The Nitelife was a 1:50 winner in the \$300,000 Lynch Memorial on June 29 at Mohegan Sun at Pocono Downs. "I just take it as it comes, but I'd rather have the week off than go in the elim really since she's been racing every week for a while," Ryder said. "She's pretty much push button and so far she's taken everything we can give her and handled it."

I Luv The Nitelife heads to the Mistletoe Shalee off her win

in the \$300,000 Lynch Memorial on June 29 at Mohegan Sun at Pocono Downs, where she beat Shebestingin by 1-1/2 lengths in 1:50 over a sloppy track. Two weeks earlier, she captured the \$384,044 Fan Hanover Stakes by 5-3/4 lengths over Belle Boyd in 1:49.1.

Her only setback this year was a third-place finish behind Ms Caila J Fra and Jerseylicious in the New Jersey Sire Stakes championship on June 1 at the Meadowlands.

Last year, I Luv The Nitelife won the \$616,100 She's A Great Lady Stakes and divisions of the Eternal Camnation and Bluegrass. She finished second in the Breeders Crown, Champlain, and a division of the International Stallion Stakes.

I Luv The Nitelife's second dam, Lisheen, won the 1994 Mistletoe Shalee and is the mother of Lis Mara, who was voted the sport's top older male pacer in 2006 and earned \$2.14 million in his career. I Luv The Nitelife is a daughter of Rocknroll Hanover out of the mare Lisjune.

"She's good, real good," Ryder said. "She trained really well. There's not a whole lot to tell you, she just keeps going."

Shebestingin has won eight of 11 career races and never finished worse than second. She won a division of the Simpson Memorial Stakes on May 3 at the Meadowlands. Jerseylicious won the Bobby Weiss Series in April at Pocono Downs, beating Shebestingin by a neck in the final, and was third in the Lynch and Fan Hanover.
