From the Thoroughbreds, a Less-Is-More Idea Worth Stealing By Bill Finley

No different than Coca Cola, Burger King or Wal Mart, harness racing is all about selling a product to consumers, in this case a product that is primarily betting with a dose of sport thrown in. When any product, be it pacers or pancakes, is over-priced and/or of inferior quality the consumer will simply walk away, which is exactly what has happened in the sport of harness racing these last many years.

You're not going to eat at the restaurant that serves lousy

food and charges too much for it. Neither is anyone in their right mind going to seriously wager on a 14-race card on a Thursday afternoon with a 30 percent takeout in the trifecta. That might have worked when horse racing was the only gambling game in town outside of Las

Vegas. Now, with so much competition, all of it, except lotteries, sold at a much lower price or takeout, the consumer has little incentive to bet on racing.

At the recent industry summit put together by the USTA, Hanover Shoe Farm's Murray Brown hit the bulls-eye with his blunt shot across the bow when he said "our product sucks." Brown couldn't have been more right. If harness racing wants to attract more customers, which means higher handles, it must come up with a way to greatly improve what it is selling.

And it can be done.

In Pennsylvania, the horsemen and management at Parx Racing obviously figured out that they, just like the state's harness tracks, weren't exactly putting on the type of show the customer wants. Parx has terrific purses but it is also a racing factory. There, they grind away, 52 weeks a year, with the same generic horses, the same generic jockeys and with very high takeouts. With the exception of their Pennsylvania Derby Day, which is always among the best days of racing in the sport, there's really nothing going on there to get anyone excited.

So the Pennsylvania Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association (PTHA) became the driving force behind the

"\$20 Million Parx Racing Fall Festival." The festival begins Aug. 29 and concludes Oct. 20. During that period, purses will be doubled to an average of \$500,000 a day. For two months and 32 racing dates, Parx will have the best purses in the sport, which will attract better quality horses and all but guarantee large, competitive fields. The \$1 million Pennsylvania Derby will be part of the festival and it very well could lure Triple Crown winner American Pharoah.

The consumer will still be discouraged by the high takeouts, but at least they will be paying for quality, what very well could be the best product in the sport for more than two months. Racing at Parx will go from humdrum to something most every bettor will enjoy and want to partake in.

To make this work the horsemen had to agree to cut back on racing dates, from 210 in 2015 to 156 in 2016. The track, which has always been a year-round operation, will also shut down for two separate breaks, one around Christmas, one in August .

The PTHA gets it. None of this means that less money will go to its members; it will just be spread out differently in order to create a super meet with super purses that will benefit everyone.



Doing the same for harness racing, particularly in Pennsylvania, is a no-brainer. When purse money comes from slots and the amount of wagering is so small to be virtually insignificant, there is no reason to race night after night, week after week. Wouldn't horsemen be better off if there were fewer racing dates and the savings went to boosting purses on the nights when the track does operate? I know the game would.

If the stars aligned and everyone agreed, Pennsylvania harness racing could create a meet that would be the envy of the harness racing world and something bettors couldn't resist. Not only should there be less racing, but as many of Pennsylvania's eggs should be put in the basket of Pocono Downs. Pocono Downs is one of the few casino companies that actually tries to promote the sport and it also offers one of the best surfaces in the industry. The opposite is true at Harrah's Philadelphia, where management openly loathes the sport and doesn't seem interested in improving what is widely derided as one of the worst surfaces in the game. Cut Chester's dates down to a bare minimum and divert the money to Pocono. Track management at Chester would be delighted, and the sport could be invigorated with a Pocono super meet.

Similar plans would also work in Ohio (does Northfield really need to operate four nights a week, 12 months a year with cheap purses?) and in New York, where a circuit could be formed among the tracks not named Yonkers.

The industry seems ready to stop pretending that its product is working. Copying what they've done at Parx

doesn't even come close to fixing everything that is wrong, but it would be a huge step in the right direction. And there doesn't seem to be any downside.

This needs to happen. | share story |

Bowden on "Patrick": There's Definitely Something Wrong

Coming off the worst performance of his life, Father



Patrick will be evaluated by trainer Jimmy Takter and a specialist as his connections are trying to get to the bottom of what has gone amiss with the 2014 Dan Patch Award winner.

What's wrong with Father Patrick?

Father Patrick has had two poor efforts in a row. He finished sixth in



the July 11 Graduate Final and then last in the Hambletonian Maturity. In the latter race, he was beaten 21 3/4 lengths.

"There's definitely something wrong," co-owner Adam Bowden said. "I know Jimmy takes heart rates on all his horses before and after they race and he knows what normal is for Patrick and he says his heart rate was significantly higher after his last two starts than it has ever been. A specialist is going to come out there this week or next week to evaluate him. Jimmy said he won't race him again until he's perfect."

Bowden said there are no plans to retire the 4 year old, who was bred in the offseason.

"I think Jimmy wants to show everyone that he's still the great horse we know he is," Bowden said. "We just have to figure out what's wrong with him first. Even when he lost to JL Cruze he got beat narrowly by a very good horse in great form. Then he didn't race nearly as well. There has to be an explanation." | share story |

Showplace Farms to Close

Showplace Farms, for 36 years one of the premier training facilities in the sport, announced yesterday that it will close Oct. 1.

"It has been a good run", said Bix DiMeo, General Manager. "But with fewer horses racing and the current economic climate here in New Jersey for harness racing, this business model no longer works for us."

Showplace is located in Millstone Township, New Jersey



and has stalls for 425 standardbreds. Over the years it has been the home of many of the sport's biggest stars and still hosts an A list of top trainers.

Joe Holloway, who is among those stabled there, said the owners trued their best to keep Showplace open and unsuccessfully appealed to the local township for tax relief. Holloway said he plans to relocate to nearby Gaitway Farm.

"I know they tried," Holloway said. "They are the biggest taxpayer in the township and tried to get some tax relief but couldn't get it. There's an urgency to their situation because they need to shut it down before the next round of taxes are due. Maybe there's a small chance it will get sold to someone who will keep it as a training center. I have really enjoyed the place and this is a sad day. I understand, though, that they had to make a business decision."

Higher Purses Means More Young Horses Are Heading to Yonkers (press release)

YONKERS, NY - Hall of Fame trainer Chuck Sylvester is a name familiar to everyone in the sport of harness racing. The four-time Hambletonian winner excels at developing young trotters. Sylvester will once again have some of his young trotters on display at Yonkers Raceway this Tuesday afternoon (July 21). The 3-year-old trotting colt Talbot Hercules leaves from post four in race five and the 3-year-old trotting filly A List Lindy leaves from post four in

race 10.

But the lure isn't a New York Sire Stakes event; it's the increased purses that have been implemented at the Hilltop oval for horses that are non-winners of two, four and six pari-mutuel races. Beginning in July, Yonkers significantly raised purses for younger horses. The new purse levels mean the non-winners of two class races for \$20,000 each week, the non-winners of four races for \$25,000 and the non-winners of six races for \$30,000.

Grand Circuit horsemen that might not routinely race at Yonkers took immediate notice of the purse increases and of those Sylvester and Frank Antonacci picked up their first wins of the season at Yonkers during the inaugural week the increased purse levels were implemented.

The recently concluded USTA summit on finding ways to increase breeding and attract new racehorse owners unanimously supported what Yonkers had already put in place: directing more purse funds to younger horses. The thought being that yearling buyers need an attractive place to race horses that don't end up being stakes winners.

On the Tuesday afternoon card at Yonkers Raceway, eight of the 12 races are comprised of these newly elevated non-winners of two, non-winners of four and non-winners of six classes.

There have also been other recent changes on the Yonkers Raceway condition sheet. The Yonkers race office incorporated some recommendations from the SOA of NY membership for more high priced claiming races. With the approval of Yonkers GM Bob Galterio, the Yonkers race



office carded and filled \$40,000, \$50,000 and \$75,000 claiming races this past week, which provide a new dynamic to the weekend cards.

The next major change coming to Yonkers will be the return of the finish line to its more traditional half-mile location. If approval can be received from the New York Gaming Commission soon, the change could be implemented prior to the \$1 million International Trot on Oct. 10.

Interest in the International Trot continues to grow, with inquiries coming in from New Zealand, Canada, Finland, Belgium and other parts of Europe. Some invitations for the International Trot should begin to be extended in the not too distant future.

Indiana's Fair Start Rule Makes It Fair For All (press release)

The Indiana Horse Racing Commission voted unanimously at their regular meeting on Wednesday, July 15, 2015 to adopt a Fair Start rule for the Standardbred racing program at Hoosier Park. With its adoption, Indiana becomes the first Commission in the United States to implement this type of standard.

The rule addresses horses that are breaking or acting improperly before the start of a race, giving the judges the ability to declare them as non-starters for wagering purposes. If a horse does not reach the fair start pole, which is 330 feet before the starting pole, prior to the field

being released, the judges will display the INQUIRY sign immediately and the horse shall be declared a non-starter for wagering purposes. All monies wagered on that horse shall be refunded. Additionally, any horse which fails to reach the fair start pole more than once in a calendar year may be placed on the Judges List and required to successfully qualify before being eligible to race.

All industry stakeholders, including Hoosier Park management, the Indiana Horsemen's Association, and the Indiana Horse Racing Commission judges, worked together to formulate the new regulation.

"The new rule balances the interests of connections of the horses competing in the race with the betting public wagering on the race in a way which provides fairness to all involved, stated Presiding Judge Mike Hall. "Everyone involved in its adoption agrees that it is one more step in improving Indiana Harness Racing."

The road to the Hambletonian will wind its way through Vernon, New York Sunday as several top 3-year-old trotting stars will compete in the \$370,000 Zweig Memorial at Vernon Downs.

Trainer Jimmy Takter, who has several Hambo candidates in his barn, will tackle the Zweig with quantity at

quality as he has entered four horses. The likely favorite in the race will be Takter's Pinkman, who has been the most consistent of his 3-vear-old trotters this year. Ynanick Gingras is down ro drive.

Takter has also entered Uncle Lasse,

Canepa Hanover and Whom Shall I Fear. With Habitat, trainer Ron Burke looks to have the best shot of beating the Takter quartet.

The card also includes a \$185,000 Zweig division for fillies. Though beaten in her last start in the Del Miller, Mission Brief looks like the one to beat in there.

Ron Waples piloted two-year-old trotting filly Devils Advocate to a Gold Series win at Mohawk Racetrack on

Thursday evening, but the Hall of Fame horseman says his assignment to the Jack Darling trainee's race bike could be a temporary one.

"Well when we were training her down, and I'd just started working for Jack, we were just

talking one day and I said, 'I hope that whoever drives her just backs her off the gate a couple times to get her used to it, so she don't get stupid," recalled Waples, who turned 71 on Tuesday. "And Jack says, 'Well you're gonna go with her.' And I said, 'No, I don't need to be out there anymore, we'll put somebody up that's gonna be out there oftener than me.' And he said, 'No, I want you to go with her.' I said, 'Well, I'll tell you what the deal is, I'll go with her 'til I screw up and then we're firing me.' "So far I'm still employed I think," he added with a chuckle.

Starting from Post 4, Waples sent Devils Advocate to the front and never had to glance over his shoulder. The

Manofmanymissions daughter rolled through fractions of :28.2, :59.2, and 1:28.1, then pulled away from the field to a four and one-half length victory in 1:57. Its All About Sam and fan favourite Sky Angel finished second and third.

"She's a bit jittery you know, like she's a kind of a nervous thing — not that she's a puller or anything like that — but we've been really careful with her and it's paying off, she's just getting a little better all the time," said Waples, who last appeared in the Mohawk winner's circle on May 28, 2010. "She's just a super gaited little thing, and you've always gotta pull her up at the end of her mile. She's not a horse or a filly that just pulls itself up; you've got to always pull her up, which is a good sign, good wind to her."

Cambridge, ON resident Darling acquired the half-sister to \$175,699 winner Unabating from last fall's Harrisburg Yearling Sale for \$47,000. So far Waples, who makes his home in Guelph, ON, has piloted Devils Advocate through three qualifiers, a June 28 overnight event at Georgian Downs where she made a break, and the July 12 Gold Series season opener at Georgian Downs where she finished second.

When Waples and Darling met in the winner's circle on Thursday they pulled the race bike off Devils Advocate and held the Ontario Sires Stakes blanket up behind the jittery youngster for the trophy presentation and photograph.

"I didn't want to have the bike on her up there in the winner's circle and her flip herself over backwards and bust the bike or something, so I said we'll take it off and get her picture taken that way," Waples explained. "She's getting better, like I said, but she's not foolproof yet.

"But I think she's worth working on, or waiting on," he added.

The other two Gold Series trophies went home with first-time winner Magical Wonder and division leader

Magical Wonder and driver Sylvain Filion of Milton, ON opened the evening with a sprint to the wire that saw them snatch a neck victory away from Powerful Glare, Caprice Hill's stablemate in the Tony Alagna barn. Northern Sweetie finished third in the 1:58.2 mile.

Like Devils Advocate, Magical Wonder had started in one overnight event, logging a second-place result at Rideau Carleton Raceway on July 2, and the Gold Series season opener, where she was third. The Kadabra daughter is trained by John MacMillan for owner-breeder Andrea Lea Racing Stables Inc. of Lakefield Gore, QC.

A winner in the season opener, Caprice Hill cruised to another easy victory in the third division. The Kadabra daughter and driver Yannick Gingras — who made the trip up from his Allentown, NJ home expressly to drive Caprice Hill — sat fourth through the early going, stepped into the outer land heading for the half and had taken control by the three-quarters, pulling away in the stretch to a three and three-quarter length victory in 1:56. Danish Darby and High Heels completed the top three.

Manalapan, NJ resident Tony Alagna trains Caprice Hill for Tom Hill of Lancashire, GB. The half-sister to \$278,868 winner Bramalea Hanover was a \$55,000 purchase from the Harrisburg Yearling Sale. With 100 points through two

events, the talented youngster has a firm hold on top spot in the division point race.

The two-year-old trotting fillies will also make their third Gold Series start at Mohawk Racetrack, returning to the Campbellville oval on August 4.

Thursday evening's card also featured the first leg of the Whenuwishuponastar Series for two-year-old pacing fillies.

Paul MacDonell captured the \$12,000 lone division with Shes Lights Out, who was a front-stepping winner in 1:53.4. The youngster marched to the lead from Post 5 and successfully sliced out splits of :28.3, :57.1 and 1:25.2 before storming home in :28.2 to win by 2-1/2 lengths over Miss Print. Itsallabouthebass was a distant third.

Ken Sucee trains the homebred daughter of Somebeachsomewhere-Arts Diva, who was a maiden-breaking winner for Brian Legge of Toronto and Dr. David Legge of Ajax, ON. She's banked \$8,800 to date.

Upsets abound in PASS at Harrah's Courtesy of Harrah's Philadelphia Racing

CHESTER, PA (July 23, 2015) - There were upsets a plenty in PASS action at Harrah's Philadelphia on Thursday afternoon. 2-year-old colt and gelding trotters were in action in five divisions, each going for a purse of just over \$52,000.

In the first division, it was Jon Erdner and Martin Garey's Truemass Volo (Tim Tetrick) turning a pocket journey into victory. The son of Muscle Massive drafted behind the speed of Ake Svanstedt trainee (and eventual third place finisher) Dupree for most of the mile, before charging up the



passing lane to win by a length in 1:57.4. Race favorite Lagerfeld (Jimmy Takter) grinded first-over to finish second. It was the first career win for Truemass Volo (\$26.40) out of 3 starts. He is trained by Doug Hamilton.

Hititoutofthepark (Corey Callahan) was the public's choice in division 2, but the day belonged to Bill Mulligan's Alexander Hanover (John Campbell). The 2-year-old son of Cantab Hall led at the opening quarter, but yielded to Jimmy Takter trainee Earn And Burn (Yannick Gingras). Hititoutofthepark made a brief bid, but tired at the top of the stretch. That opened the door for Alexander Hanover, who sprinted by leader Earn And Burn in the straight, stopping the clock in 1:57.1. It was the second career win for the Bill Popfinger trainee, who paid \$7.20.

In division 3, driver Marcus Miller gave Erv Miller trainee Love Matters a clever steer to take the lion's share. The son of Explosive Matter used the cover of eventual second place finisher Sutton (Andy Miller) to gain striking position, and eventually the win. Love Matters is now undefeated in two starts for owners Erv Miller, Harvey Eisman, and the Paymaq Stables. He paid \$21.20.

There was no catching Ron Burke trainee Make Or Miss (Yannick Gingras) in the fourth division. The son of Donato Hanover gained the front early from post 6, and went on to make every call a winning one, stopping the clock in 1:56.2. It was the fastest of 5 divisions on the day. Mulligan's School (Andy Miller) finished second, while Iron Mine Bucky (George Dennis) finished third. Make Or Miss is owned by Burke Racing, Our Horse Cents Stables, Weaver Bruscemi, and J&T Silva Stables. He paid \$13.00.

In the final division, Randy Bendis trainee Sweettooth Hanover (Dave Miller) sprung the biggest upset of all (\$55.20) The son of Donato Hanover was able to secure pocket position behind heavily favored Staying Focused (Andy Miller). Sweettooth Hanover stormed up the passing lane to win in a time of 1:58.1. He is owned by Broadway, Pollack, Varney, and Bendis. Staying Focused held place, while Landjack Hanover (Corey Callahan) finished third.

I certainly hope we don't miss the boat this time. Harness Racing has missed the boat all too often - in fact, harness racing has missed an entire fleet of boats. I've never known a business to talk so much about and yet do so little about its problems. No wonder we are in the shape we are in. Montrell won't be the magic bullet that restores crowds to harness tracks, but he could be a step in the right direction.

Believe me, after a lifetime in the advertising and promotional business, I know talent when I see it. This young man already has hundreds of followers and gaining more each day.

Yes, Montrell may not always be driving the top-ranked horse in harness racing, but he will be smart and articulate and he won't reach 30 for another six years. Furthermore, Montrell and the Teague Stable success story embody one of the most endearing and enduring parts of harness racing: family. The Teague family has been living and breathing harness racing for decades and they're proof that this is a family sport that has broad appeal.

Harness racing organizations have staffs of people paid to promote the sport and yet the sport has spiraled downward faster and faster in the last decade. Let's enlist the services of Montrell as a spokesman and give him a chance to succeed where the old generation of harness racing has failed.
