50 years of Adios memories

As the Adios gets set to celebrate its golden anniversary on Saturday, Roger Huston remembers some of the greatest moments in the history of the race started by the legendary Delvin Miller.



The Adios has been a proud American tradition at The Meadows for 50 years.

On an August day in 1967, I was 17 and just out of high school and riding in my father's car from Cincinnati to The

Meadows in western Pennsylvania. We were headed to see the Adios, a brand new race created to honor the memory of the great pacing stallion. Riding with us was Jim Hackett, the trainer and driver of Best Of All, the colt destined to win the first heat ever contested in the Adios.

Best Of All would lose the Adios when Hackett was out-driven in the third-heat raceoff by Billy Haughton, as the Adios was instantly established as a classic event.

I saw many renewals of the Adios in later years and I've touched on a few of my memories in the sidebar, but one man who's seen far more of them in the last half-century is The Meadows track announcer Roger Huston, harness racing's most celebrated race caller.

"My first one at The Meadows was in 1976," Huston said. "Joe O'Brien had Armbro Ranger and Joe was still using the wooden straight shaft sulky which was being replaced. In fact, Joe was driving Armbro Ranger in an early Pennsylvania Sires Stake at The Meadows that season and Ranger stepped into the arch of the horse in front of him. Joe blamed it on the design of the new sulkies. J. Elgin Armstrong, who was the master of Armstrong Brothers and Joe's principal owner, sent Joe some of the new bikes, but Joe refused to use them. He never took them out of the shipping crates."

Armbro Ranger won an elimination heat as did Stanley Dancer with Keystone Ore.

"In the final, the lead changed hand several times but Armbro Ranger got up to win by maybe a head," Huston said.

When Abercombie won the Adios in 1978, Huston saw something he'd never seen before: winning driver Glen Garnsey was in tears.

He was just bawling his eyes out and said it was the biggest win of his career because he thought so highly of Delvin Miller, the founder of the race," Huston said.

The next year, rain dampened the track early in the card and then Sonsam was upset by Hot Hitter and Herve Filion.

"That's when Herve came back to the winner's circle standing up in the bike," Huston said.

Huston recalls Storm Damage's world record 1:53.2 in 1980 and how Joe O'Brien hand-drove the colt through the stretch.

"Joe was jiggling and using his hands but never once used the whip," said Huston.

In 1981, Huston was astonished to see a colt named Landslide come into the Adios with little racing experience, two starts and five qualifiers. He asked trainer/driver Eddie Lohmeyer about that and Lohmeyer quietly said, "He'll win the Adios." And Landslide did.

The 1985 Adios is best remembered as the day Nihilator was upset, but Huston said that his memories begin with the previous fall when Nihilator was upset in the Breeders Crown at The Meadows. Trainer/driver Dick Richardson had Marauder in that Breeders Crown and afterwards made the seemingly preposterous statement that he'd return with Marauder and win the Adios next summer.

"Seven of the 12 starters in the '85 Adios were connected to Lou Guida," said Huston. "Marauder won the first heat and then Nihilator won the second one. Guida said that he didn't want Nihilator to go three heats in such hot weather, so Nihilator was scratched from the raceoff."

All that Marauder and Richardson had to do was to circle the track solo to claim the trophy.

As they pair eased down the stretch, Huston gave his typical rousing call:

"As they come to the wire, it's all Marauder. Look at the timer – 2:27.1!"

When Barberry Spur won the Adios the next year for local owners, Huston said it was the largest group he'd ever seen in the winner's circle.

"We counted 247 people in the photo," he said.

Huston was thrilled when Beach Towel won the 1990 because Seth Rosenfeld, who managed the horse's career, had been a frequent visitor to The Meadows as a young boy.

"Seth and his mother Lana would watch the races from the announcer's booth and I got to know them well," he said.

In 1993, Riyadh was the 2-5 favorite in the final when the

second choice Mystical Prince was leading down the backstretch for Ron Pierce. Mystical Prince broke and caused interference with several horses, including Riyadh. That put Miles McCool on the front with John Campbell and he won while Riyadh recovered to salvage second.

"Miles McCool was named after top driver Myles 'Mickey' McNichol," said Huston.

Huston remembers the '95 Adios because Bob Ritchie drove his colt Nick's Fantasy and won a division. He finished third in the final, but Ritchie sought out John Campbell that day and asked if he had a mount for the Jug. Campbell said his Delaware dance card was open, and it was Campbell who drove Nick's Fantasy to victory in the Little Brown Jug on a rainy afternoon in central Ohio.

The only horse ever disqualified after an Adios victory was Dream Away, driven by Ron Pierce in 1997. That made Legacy Of Power, a 22-1 shot beaten five-and-a-half lengths, the race winner. He was driven by Dan Ross.

"Dan's father, Jerry Ross, Sr. was practically dancing with joy as he came down the track to the winner's circle," said Huston. "And I announced, 'Here comes the King of the Ohio County Fair — Jerry Ross!"

Huston credits his late broadcast partner Jerry Erenstein for

calling the winner of the 1999 Adios.

"Dave Palone had won an elimination with Washington VC, but in the final, everyone bet Blissfull Hall down to 3-5 while Washington VC was fifth choice at 10-1," said Huston. "But Jerry noticed that front end speed was not holding up as the day went on, and he said that Palone was smart enough to notice that."

Sure enough, Ron Pierce sent Blissfull Hall to the front at the start while Palone lagged near the caboose. After being seventh at the half, Washington VC advanced and then drew off to win by two-and-three-quarter lengths.

Huston made a bold prediction before last year's Adios.

"Last year Dude's The Man finished third in his elimination, and yet I was so impressed with the way he raced that I made him the morning line favorite in the morning line. I took a lot of criticism for that, but he actually went off as the favorite and wound up winning by two lengths."

When Saturday's Adios is raced, you can be assured that Roger Huston will give it the exciting, accurate call that has been the hallmark of his Hall of Fame career.

Reflections on the Pace for the Orchids

A few of my favorite Adios highlights:

The dead-heat drama in 1972 when Strike Out and Jay Time hit the wire together was certainly unforgettable. Delvin Miller always hosted a post-race party and I recall him asking Keith Waples and Gene Riegle, the drivers of the dead-heaters, up to pose for photos as they both clutched the Adios statuette trophy. Waples and Riegle were horsemen immensely well respected among their peers and that made the moment even more meaningful.

Nero came into the '75 Adios seemingly invincible, but I watched as he went his first warm-up trip several hours before he was to race. While jogging Nero, driver Joe O'Brien pulled the flying-gaited colt to a halt near the finish. O'Brien got off the jog cart, walked up and picked up Nero's left front foot. I had no idea what was going on, but I later learned that was the first signs of a corn that would bedevil Nero the rest of the season and rob him of his ascendency. He won the Adios that day, but was not the dominant Nero of earlier in the season.



The following year, O'Brien won again with Armbro Ranger, as Roger Huston called his first Adios. As they passed the wire in a 1:56 world record, O'Brien turned to Dancer and said, "They're both great colts."

I recall speaking with Glen Garnsey in the paddock after Abercrombie shot to the top of the sophomore pacing colts by winning the Adios in 1978. I witnessed the same sentiment that Huston saw in the winner's circle.

"Winning this race means so much to me," Garnsey told me as he choked back tears, "because of the respect we all have for Delvin Miller."

In 1980, Storm Damage was so deliriously happy not to see Niatross behind the starting gate with him that he fairly flew to then-astonishing time of 1:53.2 in winning the Adios.

A decade later, I recall seeing Beach Towel set the world record in winning the Adios. As trainer/driver Ray Remmen stood behind him in the winner's circle, Delvin Miller appraised Beach Towel and said, "Look at him. After going two heats like that, he's not standing there quivering in his stifles. You know he's a fit horse."

The fastest mile ever in the Adios came just four years ago when Bolt The Duer got a perfect pocket trip behind A Rocknroll Dance to hit the wire in 1:47.4. I got a preview of coming attractions that afternoon as I watched Yannick Gingras score A Rocknroll Dance before the race.

Yannick scored the colt away from mid-backstretch around the first turn at The Meadows that day at a supersonic rate, and I said to myself, "Yeah, I think he's leaving with him."

Leaving indeed. A Rocknroll Dance got to the front in a stunning :25.1. Amazing. Has there ever been a faster quarter on a five-eighths-mile track? Bolt The Duer left from the inside and sat right on his back and slipped past the pacesetter deep in the stretch to get the 1:47.4 mark that is still the fastest mile ever in the Adios. Bolt The Duer won the race and the trophy, but A Rocknroll Dance won my utmost respect.

Tattersalls Summer Mixed Sale Preview **Prime Opportunity**

For anyone looking for a racehorse, Sunday's Tattersalls Summer Mixed Sale at the Meadowlands will offer plenty of young horses currently racing.

The two biggest consignors to the Tattersalls Summer Mixed Sale set for Sunday (July 31) in the paddock at the Meadowlands Racetrack said this week that anyone in the market for a racehorse would do well to attend the sale.



"If somebody is looking for racehorses, they need to come to this sale," said Northwood Bloodstock's Bob Boni, who will have a consignment of nearly 60 horses on offer. "With the

With the racehorse market the way it is, I just think there is opportunity for people to come and find something that if it doesn't fit here, it's going to fit somewhere.

"The biggest thing I can say is there are a lot of horses that are racing. The vast majority of them are racing."

Sale manager David Reid, whose Preferred Equine Marketing will offer the largest consignment at some 100 head, agreed. He said the appeal is that the vast majority of the horses to be sold are young and have raced.

"Of the 149 horses in the main catalog, 49 of them are two-year-olds, 36 of those have started and we have close to a dozen winners out of the two-year-olds," Reid said.

"There are 47 horses that are racing between (Wednesday) and Saturday night. There are several horses that have won since being catalogued... The horses are racing at all size tracks, all different venues and a lot of the young horses that are racing, especially the three-year-olds, they have a lot of conditions left. I think the statement 'There's something for everyone and every venue' has never been truer. There's just a real cross-section of horses, pacers and trotters, that are going to be offered."

About 175 standardbreds – about 150 in the main

catalogue minus the outs, plus another 25, or so, in the supplement — are expected to go through the ring beginning Sunday at noon, sharp.

"People should just pay attention to the races the next few days because a lot of these horses are racing and somebody could take a new record. There should be updates. There's a lot of nice, young prospects" Reid said, adding the www.tattersallsredmile.com website will have updated race lines today (Friday) and further updates as they become available.



Wearing his Preferred hat, Reid pointed out a number of horses from his consignment, including Winning Linc (hip 118) who is in the \$150,000 Anthony Abbatiello Classic Saturday

at the Meadowlands.

"It drew a short field, but the horse is improving every start and he won his last start at the Meadowlands in :51.3. He's just a lightly-raced three-year-old," Reid said. "Then hip number 75, Eternal Ring, is racing down at the \$100,000 Delaware Breeders Final.

"Then we've got a couple two-year-olds that are racing at The Meadows, hip number 25, House Always Wins, is racing in the Arden, and hip number 45, Traceuse Hanover is also racing in the Arden.

"Then hip number 99, Place To Rocknroll, is another lightly-raced, green filly, who has shown promise quickly. She's going to race in the D'Altrui on Saturday night at the Meadowlands. It's a non-betting race.

"Hip number 126, Hillsonator made a miscue his last start, but, prior to that, he's been racing very well up at Mohawk and he's made over \$100,000 this year. A horse that might be a little bit of a sleeper is hip number 133 Paparazzi Hanover. He's been racing well, pacing in :50, :51 and change and he's just a four-year-old. He's got about \$150,000 made lifetime and he's a horse that could go in a lot of different venues."

Boni also mentioned a number of horses from Northwood's consignment.

"In no particular order, we have a very nice horse in the supplement, Dedi's Dragon (hip 223). He's a horse that's made a fair amount of money this year. He's made about \$60,000 this year. I think he's made \$800,000 lifetime. Horses like that show they're just going to race well wherever they go. I use that as an example," Boni said.

"Another filly that we have in that supplement, which people may not have seen is Seaside Illusion. It's a Muscle Hill out of Seaside. That's a big pedigree. First foal of a mare. While she may not have done all that much on the racetrack, it's a huge, huge pedigree, so people have a chance to do some good there.

"I don't think there's anything wrong with saying they may not be quite what the people that purchased them were looking for, but that doesn't mean they're not going to be okay for another racing program."

"A change of scenery is good for horses and people," Reid said. "The owners of the horses that are selling them, they're looking to go in a different direction, or there may be some partnerships that are aiming for the sky, they're just going to turn the page, reload and raise some capital for the upcoming yearling sales. A lot of times, someone's loss is another person's gain. There have been lots of success stories that have happened in cases like this.

"I think we have a lot of nice horses to offer that really do fit every venue. People should do their homework and get in here and look at the horses. More importantly, people from outside the tri-state area, the Metropolitan New York area, there's a lot of horses that will fit the bill at other racetracks, for sure. I think a lot of these horses could fit on the Mohawk circuit. I strongly encourage all my Canadian friends to get looking, because there's definitely an opportunity for everyone."



Remembering BJ

Bruce Johnston, the man that gave us Lance Loser and other unforgettable characters through his popular Short Turns column, was as colorful as they come. Next week, BJ will be posthumously inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame.

(Editor's note: Next Wednesday (Aug. 3), the late writer, publisher and larger-than-life character Bruce Johnston will be officially inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame in just the Hall's third class of communicators. Gary Foerster, Johnston's former partner in The Canadian Sportsman magazine remembers the man known as BJ)

I remember it as if it were yesterday.

On Wed., May 5, 1993, I was putting the finishing touches to the latest edition of *The Canadian Sportsman*. As usual, that process involved Bruce Johnston's weekly column, Short Turns. As Bruce couldn't type and by his own admission had terrible handwriting, it was always down to the deadline wire when BJ's words of wisdom finally hit the page.

After putting the paper to bed that day, Bruce was off to a golf course near Cambridge, ON to play with his buddies Bill Wellwood and Ray Bednarz. I was headed to a Toronto Maple Leafs playoff game (yes readers, there was a time when the Leafs did engage in playoff hockey) with my friend Dick White.

"Well, aren't we quite the pair," BJ said chewing on his cigar. "Just a couple of high rollers we are — taking off work early to go play with the boys.

"Keep smiling," he said as he walked out the door.

Those were the last words he ever spoke to me. Later that

afternoon, BJ passed away on the golf course after suffering a massive heart attack at the age of 59.

Hardly a day goes by when I don't think of him.

It took me a long time to deal with the grief of losing my friend, business partner and mentor. But, as much as I still miss him, now I remember him with a smile. And when I get together with any of BJ's friends, it's only a matter of minutes before the BJ stories roll out — and believe me, there are plenty of them — and everyone is laughing it up.

Can you think of a better way to be remembered?

One of my favorite BJ stories comes from his longtime and diminutive (BJ said that's the nice word for "really short") friend Stan Chauvin. BJ and Stan were both very competitive and they were teammates — that's important to remember — on their local baseball team. Neither were shy about pointing out the other's athletic foibles and during one game they got into a heated discussion about Bruce's lack of prowess (in Stan's opinion) on the pitcher's mound.

Stan told BJ that he was packing a few extra pounds and rather indelicately suggested that was hurting his play.

"I'll tell you this much Chauvin," BJ shot back, "I can always get thinner, but you'll never get any taller!"

Stan recalls, "that's the one thing about Bruce, he always used his 'A' stuff."

BJ loved Kentucky, especially the horse sales and The Red Mile. Whenever he traveled there, he would take a camera with him. This was before the days of digital photography and because BJ was a bit of a mechanical klutz, he would never re-load the camera with new film. So a roll of 36 pictures would have to do for the entire trip.

BJ was at Castleton Farm the day Niatross arrived to stand stud for his first season. He captured the great pacer during his first romp through one of the famed Castleton stallion paddocks. After publishing the photo in The Sportsman, a letter arrived a few days later from Lou Guida, eloquent in his praise of the black and white photo saying it "caught this great horse in all his majesty." Guida ordered several copies of the photo.

After that, whenever I griped about having to put more film in the camera, BJ snapped, "Yeah, and how many damn pictures did Lou Guida order from you?"

It's been nearly a quarter-century since BJ's passing and it is only fitting that his name be placed among those in the Hall of Fame. Because he left us much too soon, the world was robbed of BJ's uncommon wit and humor, often delivered by BJ's alter-ego Lance Loser in Short Turns. There's no better way to remember BJ than by his own words... here's a few selected from his columns:

Training Reports (March, 1983)

One of the most popular features of our spring editions are the training reports of two-year-olds. Dave Perkins of the Toronto Star recently complained that harness racing would be a lot more interesting if drivers and trainers were more frank, that is, simply acknowledged a bad drive or bad horse.

That may be so, but the whole two-year-old industry is fueled by optimism, not frankness! It's necessary sometimes to translate what the trainers mean:

Trainer: "This is a nice colt. A bit headstrong at times, with lots of spirit."

Translation: "The S.O.B. jumped the rail and ran away in downtown Kingston before we brought him down with a tranquilizer dart."

Trainer: "This filly is a bit growthy and immature. We may turn her out and let her fulfill her promise."

Translation: "I'd hate like hell to hold her for ransom."

Trainer: "Those two colts owned by Mr. X have a lot of talent. I'd hate to ruin them by pushing them too hard this year."

Translation: "Let's not discourage Mr. X. He's loaded and could get us a nice race horse this spring."

Language (November, 1983)

Hundreds of yearlings have been pulled out of their stalls, feet and tails lifted, prodded, measured and poked over the last two months. It's important to note some phrases that are used by buyers and consignors. These phrases must be vague enough not to insult the consignors and have enough truth to leave the buyer with a clear conscience. The old favorites "nice individual" and "that's a racy looking dude" are still popular.

One that impressed us in Toronto was "the dam had a lot more speed than she ever showed."

Was she shy?

Remember the old comeback when shown an ugly kid by a proud parent: "Now, there's a baby!"

Lilacs Bloom in Tippytoes

Stuck for fast-breaking news our correspondent made his annual pilgrimage to Tippytoes, Ontario last week to check out Lance Loser. Last fall, Lance was contemplating reconciliation with Agnes but had deserted the standardbred business. Sportsman: Are you and Agnes getting back together?

Lance: No sir. We bunked together over the winter but she left with a Great Lakes sailor from Goderich. He was driving a truck for the winter and dropped into the annual Ground Hog Day Dance. Agnes fell in love and took off in the cab of his transport truck. I guess I'm a victim of "Seaman Transportation". They won't let them over the border anyway, that's USTA territory.

Lance Sets Sale

It was a quiet last week until the phone rang with a collect call from Tippytoes. Lance, who looked like a spent force when Agnes split, is back in action.

Sportsman: Lance, sounds like things are good again.

Lance: Yeah, things have turned around since I met FiFi this spring. It's like I've been born again.

Sportsman: How did you hook up with FiFi?

Lance: FiFi Laflesh, my companion, was a table dancer from Baie Comeau and working the local linoleum festival when we met. I gave her a bite of my Snickers bar, between dances, and she said it was the nicest thing anyone had ever done for her. One thing led to another and our hearts have been trotting team-to-pole ever since.

Christmas In Tippytoes

Lance Loser in his Christmas card reports, "Everything fine here. FiFi has been taking ballet lessons. It shocked the boys at the Christmas Rotary Stag when she danced Swan Lake. Training another colt, one of these years I'll qualify one. Here's my year-end poem:

All Hail to 1989

It's cold and it's damp in my old Tippytoes, As I sit on the sulky, my fingers is froze. The snow and the sleet splash up in my face, The horse hits the trot and it's bred to pace. His harness is tattered and his leg looks funny, But I can't quit this job, 'cause I sure need the money!" Rest easy, BJ. We're still smiling.







Takter going for a three-peat in four different stakes

Jimmy Takter is about to embark on four attempts at a three-peat: in the Hambletonian, Hambletonian Oaks, Kentucky Futurity and the Kentucky Filly Futurity.

NJ Classic on tap: Only five entered for Saturday's \$150,000 Anthony Abbatiello New Jersey Classic, all of them sired by Rocknroll Hanover.

John Campbell won the first ever NJ Classic in 1980 with Bold Rush. The \$300,000 purse was his biggest money victory at the time. Sunday marks the 29th anniversary of Campbell surpassing Herve Filion on the all-time earnings list at just over \$59 Million (July 31, 1987).

Oaks notes: Ake Svanstedt's five Hambletonian Oaks elimination fillies is impressive but not as impressive as having five different sets of owners.

Jules Siegel is hoping for lightning to strike twice. He won the 2009 Oaks with Broadway Schooner by the slightest margin ever – most thought she'd lost. Now-her daughter Broadway Donna goes for the same pot.

Valley Victory's purse sweep: This year marks the 20th anniversary of sire Valley Victory getting all five checks in the 1996 Beacon Course (now the Stanley Dancer) with a full 10-horse field. The finish was Lindy Lane-Act Of Grace-Continentalvictory-Mr Vic-Pietro Pan.

More anniversaries: This year also marks the 30th anniversary of Chuck Sylvester winning the Meadowlands Pace with Laughs and Buddy Gilmour. Sylvester then followed that up a year later with Mack Lobell winning the 1987 Hambletonian en route to the Horse of the Year title.

Scott Frost: Saturday's fifth race at the Meadowlands is a Reynolds named in honor of Scott Frost. He was the first repeater as Horse of the Year 1955-1956. He was the first Triple Crown winner (1955) and he is the only horse to not be named Horse of the Year despite getting the most first

place votes (1954) when he got named on more first-place ballots than Stenographer, but lost to her in the final tally due to total points.

Name that driver: Guess which driver was named on the most freshmen in the Peter Haughton and Jim Doherty eliminations? Give up? Matt Kakaley (four).

Sing for Wing: Happy 68th birthday on Saturday to Ted Wing, the leading driver at the Meadowlands in 1978 (after missing by one win the year before to Benny Webster).

Throwback Friday? It must be. Tonight's 12th race at the Meadowlands has five, count 'em five, trainer/drivers in one race: Don Swick (Sigmund), Jan Johnson (Oakie), Trond Smedshammer (Free Willy Hanover, Ray Schnittker (Northern Sweetie) and Ake Svanstedt (Millbrook Hanover).

Also Friday's card is notable because 37 trainers were born outside of the United States.

Big Muscles: Muscle Hill has 19 sons or daughters in this weekend at the Meadowlands. Headed by Southwind Frank, Muscle Hill's impact is one that matches the siring legends of the sport. His first three crops have seen him right in the mix with 2014 winner Trixton, 2015 favorite Mission Brief and now the clear cut choice of 2016 Southwind Frank.

Second-tier champs: Next week's U.S. Pacing Championship should be interesting as the three greatest free-for-alls in the sport all renew their rivalry. Wiggle It Jiggleit, Always B Miki and Freaky Fete Pete. Remember, in 1980, this was and remains the only race in the Meadowlands history where all three on-the-board finishers were second tier starters - #13 Niatross #11 Storm Damage and #12 Royce.

Best name of '16: Candidate for the best-named horse of 2016: Bucketlist Hanover. The sophomore trotter won last week at the Meadowlands and is Hambletonian eligible. How great would that be? One of the owners is Brad Maxwell, who fulfilled his first "Bucket List" request the week before winning his first ever Meadowlands Pace with Control The Moment.

Big money DH: The first dead heat between John Campbell and Dave Miller – the two richest active drivers in the sport - happened last Saturday at the Meadowlands with Intheblinkofaneye and Yippity Hanover.



George Berkner dead at 74

George W. Berkner universally known as B throughout the harness world succumbed Thursday (July 28) to the ravages of pancreatic cancer following a gallant, year-long battle. He was 74.

Berkner was perhaps best known for campaigning BG's Bunny but more recently training 2010 New Jersey Classic winner BG's Folly and Feeling You, and co-owned Rockeyed Optimist.

BG's Bunny won an elimination for the 1977 Meadowlands Pace, setting a 1:54 world record by a whopping five lengths. Unfortunately, the euphoria from the big win didn't last long as BG's Bunny shattered a sesamoid in five places in the race and never made another start.

Born in New York City, in Manhattan's Washington Heights district, Berkner's father was a tool and die maker who liked to make a trip to the track. When young George took a summer job as a waiter at Kuschner Country Club in Monticello, he was conveniently close to Monticello Raceway.

Berkner got his first job working with horses in the Anthony Abbatiello Stable. He stayed there until he was drafted for service during the Vietnam War.

"I was in the Army for about seven months stationed in Hawaii and waiting for the next plane to Asia when I was discharged because of family hardship," Berkner told Harold Howe in a 2010 interview published in The Harness Edge. "My father was gone by then and I was the only male in the family, it was my mother and I. So I came home and went straight back to Monticello Raceway to get a job."

Berkner's next employers were Maurice Pusey, who had worked as an assistant for Clint Hodgins, and Sam Caton.

Not long afterward, Berkner moved to California to train there for three years. When he moved back to the East Coast, he again settled at Monticello.

While at Monticello Berkner met Bob Greenberg, who owned a bus line which specialized in transporting handicapped children in New York City.

"He was brand new to the game and Monticello was a happening place back then," said Berkner of meeting Greenberg.

At the 1975 Old Glory Yearling Sale, Berkner bought a colt named Cooring for \$15,000 that had a bog spavin. Taking the initials from their first names, the colt was renamed BG's Bunny, with "Bunny" a reference to a bunny Greenberg kept on the mirror of his car. In later years Berkner developed 1989 Little Brown Jug winner Goalie Jeff. When the colt was in training, Berkner was still trying to take it easy after suffering a heart attack in the previous year, so he began to work with young trainer Mark Loewe. Goalie Jeff was sold to a group formed by Tom Artandi and went on to win the Jug.

Berkner trained horses for the late Alan Kirschenbaum, his close friend from the days when Kirschenbaum worked for him. Among Kirschenbaum's horses were the money-making overachiever Little Steven and Feeling You, who finished second in the Tarport Hap and Lynch Memorial.

Berkner is survived by his beloved wife Ginny Whipple, who was at his side throughout. In lieu of flowers, the family requests that any donations be made to the Alan Kirschenbaum Heading for home Horse Retraining and adoption center 683 Lake Avenue, Saratoga NY 12866

Joe Marsh Jr., 82, dies

Joe Marsh Jr., 82, one of the top drivers from the "glory days" of harness racing, died peacefully on Wednesday (July 27, after a long illness.

Born on June 20, 1934, at Cadiz, OH, Marsh followed in the footsteps of his father, beginning as a groom in 1952, and entering the driving ranks in 1959, when he batted .316 against all other North American drivers, placing him 12th in the nation.

He soon became one of the leading drivers on the continent, competing at Roosevelt, Yonkers, Liberty Bell, Washington Park, Hazel Park, Wolverine, The Meadows, Sportsman's Park, Maywood, Aurora Downs and Hollywood Park.

Marsh and his son Ron share membership in the "5,000 win club" as the only father-son driving team in harness racing history to achieve that elite status.

Joe drove 5,882 winners to the tune of \$36,401,271, and also had the longest streak (35 years) of driving at least 100 winners per season, from 1960 through 1994. From 1978-1992 he also had consecutive \$1 million-plus seasons.

Joe also held the distinction of being the first American driver to win the World Driving Championship in 1974. He also represented the U.S. in 1973, 1975 and 1987, and over the years won driving titles in Illinois, Pennsylvania, Ohio, and Michigan. In fact, he won nine consecutive driving titles

at all Chicago area racetracks from 1971 through 1973, and as a result, was voted 1973 Horseman of the Year by Harness Horsemen International.

Besides steering racehorses in California, Florida, New York, New Jersey, Illinois, Michigan, Ohio, and Pennsylvania, he drove in Canada, Australia, New Zealand and Europe. In 1972 and 1973 Joe finished second to Herve Filion in North American dash wins, and was also voted Chicago Driver of the Year in 1972.

Joe captured numerous stakes races, and trained and/or drove some of the top horses in the country in some of harness racing's major events for five decades. He won seven American-National events and finished third in the Little Brown Jug once.

Some of his top horses included Careless Time, Tarport Hap, Sir Dalrae, Follow That Star, Rambling Willie, Jiffy Boy and Pacific Dream.

"Joe was a very good friend of mine and was at the very top of the list of great drivers," said USTA president Phil Langley. "Were he in his prime today, he'd rank right up there with Yannick, Brian, Tim, Dave and other top drivers.

"I had the good fortune to go to Europe with him in the World Driving Championship and also to see him race a good part of his career in Chicago. He drove and trained a lot of very good horses including the excellent mare Glad Rags."

Joe was preceded in death by his wife, Marge; and is survived by his sisters, Donna Dusseau and Patricia Snide; sons, Ronnie, Ed (Maureen), Robert (Niki) and Dan; daughter, Susie (Jay) Litchfield; grandchildren, Deadra, Brad, Ryan, Tara, Chris, Frankie, Eric and Adam; and great-grandchildren, Brooke, Brandon, Mackenzie, Eddie, Logan and Cadence.

20 fillies to contest Hambletonian Oaks

Twenty fillies have been entered for the \$500,000 Hambletonian Oaks, the filly division of the Hambletonian.

Hambletonian Festival week kicks off Saturday (July 30) with two \$50,000 eliminations to narrow the field to 10 for the \$500,000 Oaks Final on Hambletonian Day, Sat., Aug. 6, at The Meadowlands Racetrack in East Rutherford, NJ.

Favorite in the field will be Dan Patch divisional champion Broadway Donna, a daughter of 2007 Hambletonian winner Donato Hanover and 2009 Oaks winner Broadway Schooner. Owned by Jules Siegel's Fashion Farms and trained by Jim Campbell, Broadway Donna has made just three starts this year, with two wins and a second. She prevailed by a gritty half-length in her division of the Del Miller Memorial over All The Time and Celebrity Eventsy on July 16 at The Meadowlands.

The other Miller Memorial division featured a rare deadheat between Unica Steed and Woman's Will. Those two will match up again in the same Oaks elimination along with Ontario Sires Stakes star Caprice Hill, making her first pari-mutuel Meadowlands appearance after racking up more than \$578,696 north of the border.

Swedish trainer/driver Ake Svanstedt entered a total of five fillies in the Oaks eliminations. Jimmy Takter has three representatives, including Unica Steed, a daughter of 1998 Hambletonian winner Muscles Yankee and Premier Steed by Workaholic. Unica Steed was foaled in Italy, sired in France and is owned by French stable Ecurie AB Trot, and yet has American trotting blood coursing through both sides of her pedigree.

Plainridge casino posting modest returns

The Boston Globe reported Tuesday (July 26) that Plainridge Park Casino's first-year revenue of some \$160 million has fallen short of its initial sky-high projections.

Reporter Sean Murphy wrote, "casino specialists said Plainridge fell victim to much larger rivals in Connecticut and Rhode Island, especially Twin River Casino in Lincoln, RI. Just 11 miles from the Plainville casino, Twin River has a full array of table games, more than three times as many slot machines, and it has smoking sections.

"Penn National Gaming, the casino company that owns Plainridge, said it underestimated the effect of nearby Twin River Casino."

Full-scale casinos in Everett, Taunton and Springfield, MA are projected to open in three years.

"Plainridge's own five-year projections, submitted to the state in 2014, call for as much as a 55 per cent drop in business when all three Massachusetts resort casinos open, which would drive annual revenue well below \$100 million," Murphy wrote.






