JL Cruze upsets in the Spirit Of Massachusetts Trot

Andrew McCarthy orchestrated a 60-1 upset and a 1:52.1 track record in the inaugural race.

JL Cruze and Andrew McCarthy posted a 60-1 upset in the inaugural \$250,000 Spirit of Massachusetts Trot Friday afternoon at Plainridge.


After watching an epic front-end battle between Crazy Wow and Resolve from fourth most of the mile, driver Andrew McCarthy found room up the pylons late for 60-1 JL Cruze and pulled a major upset by winning the inaugural running of the \$250,000 Spirit Of Massachusetts Trot held Friday at Plainridge Park.

Crazy Wow (Matt Kakaley) and Resolve (Ake Svanstedt) both wanted the lead but Crazy Wow got it, seating Resolve before they hit the quarter in :26.1. At that station, Hannelore Hanover (Yannick Gingras) pulled momentarily from third but that prompted Resolve to pop the deuce and the mare went back to the pylons. Resolve pulled alongside Crazy Wow for a few strides, but Kakaley asked for more and put Resolve back in the hole once again.

Just before the five-eighths, Resolve came for the third time and Hannelore Hanover followed. That opened the rail for JL Cruze to move up the inside and right onto the back of front-running Crazy Wow as they hit three-quarters in 1:22.

Around the last turn, Crazy Wow and Resolve continued to slug it out side by side, but at the top of the lane they both drifted a bit and opened a channel for the fresh-legged JL Cruze to get underway. As they drove for the wire, JL Cruze invoked his will and trotted away from group to win the race in 1:51.2 which set a new all-time track trotting record.

Hannelore Hanover got up for second and Crazy Wow hung on to be third.

"It really worked out, that was a lot of pressure up there; they were really rocking along," McCarthy said. "I had my chance just getting through the first turn which was my biggest concern. Then, after that, I had to get lucky to get out. Going into the last turn, I knew I had enough trot to get there, it was just a matter of getting up the inside. So when they were dueling up front, I could kind of cut my own mile back there and just figure it out from there."

McCarthy was asked about filling the seat of Hall of Famer John Campbell, who was JL Cruze's regular driver before his retirement in June and he said that Campbell actually had a part of the day's success.

"JL Cruze has been a great horse for three years now and to just sit behind a horse like that is a great privilege. It worked out before the race that I ran into John (Campbell) and asked him what he thought I should do with this horse on the gate and he gave me a couple pointers and it really worked out."

It was only the second win of the year for JL Cruze, but one that a record live Plainridge crowd will never forget. Let go at 60-1 by the betting faithful, JL Cruze returned \$123.60 to win and a \$732.60 trifecta and \$4,588.80 superfecta with the three post-time favorites in order behind him.

The winner's share of the purse made JL Cruze a millionaire as it pushed his lifetime earnings to \$1.08 million for owners William Wood, William Dittmar Jr. and Stephen Iaquinta. Eric Ell is the winning trainer.

The race before JL Cruze set a 1:51.2 track record, Gural Hanover (Matt Kakaley) lowered the trotting track mark to 1:52.1

The track record that JL Cruze broke was set just one race before by Gural Hanover in the \$25,000 Old North Church Open Handicap Trot.

Gural Hanover (Matt Kakaley) left sharply from post eight and opened up a two-length advantage. He maintained the gapped lead the entire race including easy first-half fractions of :27.1 and :56.1. And that is where the race was won.

As they started up the backside, Kakaley tapped the gas pedal and got to three-quarters in 1:24 and then with the field strung-out behind him, Gural Hanover trotted home in total command tripping the timer in 1:52.1 under Kakaley's wraps. The 1:52.1 track record stood for one race.

It was the sixth win in 13 starts this year for Gural Hanover (\$3.60) who is owned by the Burke Racing Stable LLC, Weaver Bruscemi LLC, Little E LLC and the Panhellenic Stable Corp. and is trained by Ron Burke.

Roaring To Go fastest in NYSS events at Yonkers

Yonkers Raceway Friday night (July 28th) offered up the \$167,499 New York Sire Stakes Mike Cohen Pace for 3-year-old fillies.

A trio of equally-parsed (\$55,833) six-horse fields comprised the event, which honored the memory of the former publicity director of both Yonkers Raceway and NBC Sports.

Any number of Cohen family and friends joined in for the winner's circle presentations, with just one public choice returning for the meet-and-greet.

Roaring to Go (Brett Miller, \$3.40) won the evening's final event in a night's-fastest 1:52.4. From the pole, she retook from Planet Rock (Dan Dube), then had few issues (:27.4, :57, 1:24.4). She owned a 21/4-length lead into the lane and a comfy length-and-a-quarter at the wire.

Touchamatic (George Brennan) was a second-up second, with Artrageous (Jordan Stratton) a first-up third.

For Roaring to Go, a daughter of Art Major—Lioness Hanover owned by Frank Chick and trained by Kevin Lare, it was her first win in seven seasonal starts. The exacta (two wagering choices) paid \$9.50, with the triple returning \$33.

One of the faster frosh a year ago (she crossed the line first in last season's final of the New York Sire Stakes, but was set down for a pylon violation), Roaring to Go has won eight of her 21 career starts.

"She was sick in the (last season's) Breeders Crown, and she never really recovered," Miller said. "Before that, I thought she was as talented as anyone in her division.

"Tonight, she was very good... not quite the way she was last season, but close."

Aother NYSS elimination was won by Clear Idea (George Brennan) in 1:53.1.

Friday's opening NYSS event saw Clear Idea (Brennan, \$13.80) stalk 1-10 fave Tequila Monday (Brian Sears), then pick her off in the passing lane by a desperate nose. Candlelight Dinner (Miller) was a charging third, beaten just three-quarters of a length.

From post No. 2, Clear Idea saw Tequila Monday set unpressured intervals of :27, 56.1 and 1:25.1. She had a length-and-a-half lead in and out of the final turn, only to get snapped on the money in 1:53.1.

For second choice Clear Idea, an American Ideal—Glass Maker miss co-owned by (trainer) Blake MacIntosh and Hutt Racing, it was her seventh win (five consecutive, fourth in NYSS) in 13 2017 tries. The exacta paid \$17.60, with the triple returning \$121.

The second state-bred grouping saw the longest shots on the boards, 26-1 Gurl Band K (Dan Dube) and 15-1 Winsun Brooklyn (Pat Lachance), roll home first and second, respectively, in 1:56.1. The latter won the battle, dueling 3-5 pace-setter World Apart (Jason Bartlett) into submission after that one couldn't hold sway (:27.4, :57.4, 1:26.4) despite pokey fraction.

A reserved — from post No. 3 — Gurl Band K, a seasonal O-fer entering the evening, was fifth in the stretch before winning by 2½ widening lengths. Marquesa Seelster (Stratton) was third as World Apart tired to fifth.

For sixth choice Gurl Band K, a Rock N Roll Heaven homebred ma'am owned by Robert Key and trained by Andrew Harris, it was that first win in a dozen seasonal starts. The exacta paid \$402, with the triple returning \$1,885.





Will the Hambletonian see a 1:50 mile?

It took 32 years for the Hambletonian to record its first 2:00 mile.

America's greatest trotting classic was born in 1926 during the Roaring Twenties, and endured the Great Depression and World War II without ever adding a "magic mile" to its luster.

Hoot Mon changed that in 1947 with his epic 2:00 effort at the long-defunct Good Time Park in Goshen.

It was another 31 years before Speedy Somolli tripped the timer at 1:55 in the first heat of the Hambletonian and Florida Pro matched that clocking in the second heat.

The Hambletonian, however, has never notched a 1:50 mile Will this be the year that all changes?

Some might feet that the absence of Walner makes a new record unlikely, but never underestimate what will happen on a hot afternoon with a wide-open field.

Muscle Hill set the current record of 1:50.1 in 2009 and that seemed easily within the reach of Walner, but let's not dismiss the chance of a 1:50 mile by those seeking the crown in Walner's absence.

So much depends on the weather and how the heats unfold. With Walner looming as the overwhelming favorite, there was the chance that he would so intimidate his rivals that he could forge to the front, moderate the pace, and dare anyone to challenge him. Walner's driver Tim Tetrick understands that the first goal in the Hambletonian is simply to win and not set a record. He is also mindful that Walner has many other engagements on his dance card later this season.

But with Walner MIA in the 2017 Hambletonian, could the first 1:50 mile be scored by another trotter?

The Early Years

Guy McKinney won the first Hambletonian at the New York State Fair in Syracuse with a best time of 2:04-3/4. The Hambletonian alternated between Syracuse and Lexington in the early years, with the best winning time Spencer's 2:02-1/2.

In 1931, the Hambletonian moved to the three-cornered track at Good Time Park in Goshen, where it would remain through 1956. The track featured a sharp first turn, a veritable "Dean Man's Curve" that ended the chances of more than a few Hambletonian hopefuls.

Any man driving Hambletonian starter at Good Time Park knew that having a fast trotter counted for naught in the Hambletonian if he didn't stay flat through Dean Man's Curve.

In 1941, the winner Bill Gallon was able to take home the trophy with a best time of just 2:05. The next year The Ambassador needed only a 2:04 mile to claim the top prize.

The match between Hoot Mon and Rodney in 1947 started with Hoot Mon breaking entering the stretch and Rodney cruising to a first-heat victory. Hoot Mon made no mistakes in the second trip as he whirled to the wire in an astonishing 2:00. Spectators were stunned. Hoot Mon never lowered that mark.

With the death of Hambletonian impresario William H Cane in 1956, the trotting classic relocated west to the resplendent DuQuoin State Fairgrounds in southern Illinois. The mile track was always manicured to perfection and the winning times reflected that.

The fastest heat of 2:00.1 in the first Hambletonian at Du Quoin in 1957 flirted with the stake record, but a year later, the filly Emily's Pride took off a tick with a 1:59.4 mile. Like Hoot Mon, Emily's Pride notched her record mile in the second heat.

Record times in the Hambletonian dropped regularly at Du Quoin, notably with Ayres winning in 1:56.4 in 1964 and then Green Speed repeating heats of 1:55.3 in 1977.

The 1978 Hambletonian shaped up as a titanic clash featuring the troika of Speedy Somolli, Florida Pro, and Brisco

Hanover. They scared off all but a handful of rivals.

Speedy Somolli drew post one and his cat-quick speed discouraged any challenges away from the gate. The other drivers simply assumed that Howard Beissinger would step on the accelerator at the start to protect his position. That prospect prompted other drivers to duck for cover at the start.

Beissinger, looking over his right shoulder and seeing no pressure, simply let Speedy Somolli dawdle around the first turn and he reached the quarter in 30 seconds. The other drivers knew their horses had no chance if this tempo continued and began to apply pressure.

Speedy Somolli responded by trotting the final three-quarters in 1:25 to record the first 1:55 trotting race in history. Now 94, Beissinger told me recently how proud he was that the milestone was achieved without frantic early fractions.

Rival Florida Pro turned the tables on Speedy Somolli in the next heat with yet another 1:55 mile.

That led to a third heat and Beissinger changed bridles on Speedy Smolli in hopes that a Kant-See-Bak would spur him to finish better. That tactic worked and Speedy Somolli got the trophy.

When the Hambletonian moved East to the Meadowlands in 1981, the winning times began to shade 1:55 on an annual basis. Predictably, Mack Lobell set a record in winning in 1987 and others followed suit.

In 2009, Muscle Hill whirled through an unbeaten season seemingly without breaking a sweat. He tripped the timer in 1:50.1 claiming the Hambletonian for his owners, driver Brian Sears, and trainer Greg Peck.

That eight-year-old record still stands, defiantly withstanding the best efforts in recent years.

Will this year see a new record? It's certainly possible, although Walner's absence seems to diminish that prospect. Unexpected things happen when horses strive for the greatest of all American trotting events, so stay tuned.



John Campbell to help launch book in PEI

The Hall of Famer will be the special guest at the World Harness Racing book launch on Aug. 16 at Red Shores Charlottetown.

Recent harness racing-related book releases have included historical titles, biographies, and even fiction. As managing editor and contributor for RetroMedia Publishing's World Harness Racing, Jerry McCabe admits to being a bit partial, but says that the "commemorative book" for the upcoming World Trotting Conference (WTC) in Prince Edward Island is unique.

RetroMedia is an independent PEI press, helmed by Larry and Nancy Resnitzky. "We're a publisher that dabbles in harness racing, releasing two books in the last 10 years with harness racing themes," said McCabe, who previously worked on Paul Murphy's popular Behind the Gate (RetroMedia, 2008) and HorsePower: Behind the Gate Returns (RetroMedia, 2014), books about racing personalities in or from the Maritime provinces. The former title is a regional bestseller which won a PEI Heritage Award in 2010 and is currently in its third printing.

World Harness Racing is global in focus, although WTC host province PEI receives consideration in its 170 pages. It contains summaries for 17 countries, with details not readily available online in English, and 100+ photos. "I think this is a good synopsis to get started, to give you a snapshot of racing in those countries," said McCabe. "I haven't seen any book that's covered that international angle. The International Trotting Association has been doing this for 50 years now—this will be the 25th meeting, this year, for the World Trotting Conference, so we thought it was time to have a book to cover all that."

The racing historian says World Harness Racing shares the WTC's main objectives, although it was produced independently: "The general aim is to grow harness racing globally, but how is that happening? I'm hopeful that in some small way, this book can make our community a little bit tighter. Knowledge can do that — a little bit of knowledge of how some of the horsepeople from Europe or Down Under operate, it narrows the gap between you in some small way."

Each WTC delegate will receive a copy of the new release, a limited number of which are available by pre-order at retromedia.ca. It will also sell for \$29.95 Canadian at the official launch, slated for 3:30 pm on Wednesday August 16 at Red Shores Charlottetown and open to the general public.

"John Campbell will be available to sign books. He'll be there in his new capacity as the president of the Hambletonian Society, one of 13 sponsors of the book," said

McCabe. "There will be another announcement, hopefully in the next week, for another celebrity harness racing participant we hope will be there, who is 99 per cent certain right now." Former PEI minister of harness racing Robert Mitchell and publisher Larry Resnitzky will also attend the main-floor event, to be emceed by Red Shores marketing manager/WTC panelist Lee Drake.

World Harness Racing was assembled by corresponding with governing bodies, journalists and participants over the past year, then turning that material over to writers Trish Dooling, Shannon "Sugar" Doyle and McCabe. Support from sponsors, beginning with the Government of PEI, later encompassing some of the best-known breeders, racetracks, and organizations in the sport, made the project possible.


It's not sugar-coated promotional material—McCabe emphasizes that the book puts facts first, even harsh ones, like "brutal statistics in one country where breedings were 6,000 10 years ago, and now they're 400... The reality is that things are in crisis in that country."

There's room for debate too, as representatives from each of the 17 nations in World Harness Racing were asked to

provide the names of its top three drivers. "It was interesting, because we knew there was going to be an element of, perhaps...controversy?" he said. "Any time you have to narrow a list of all-time greats, there's going to be discussion. There's going to be some that will surprise in a pleasant way, and some that will surprise by omission."

McCabe has a longstanding appreciation for the international nature of the game. "I was in the states in 1986, when I worked with Ron Waples; just after I left, they had the March of Dimes Trot... To me, that was one of the pinnacles. It was bigger than a Triple Crown race, in a sense: taking the best from here and racing the best from Europe." He suggests that today, events like the WTC/WDC take on a greater importance than ever before. "I think the harness world is getting smaller. Increased collaboration is going to be part of the way forward." World Harness Racing can serve as a primer for navigating that course.


In advance of this Sunday's biennial event, Legends Day, Clinton Raceway would like to inform race fans of the following details.

Gural to receive equine savior award

Meadowlands, Vernon and Tioga Downs owner Jeff Gural will receive the Ellen and Herbert Moelis Equine Savior Award on Aug. 3 at the historic Canfield Casino in Saratoga Springs for his commitment to the humane fate and aftercare of horses bred for racing, their safety during their racing careers and toward maintaining integrity and honesty in racing.

Gural has become a driving force in keeping trainers suspected of using illegal performance-enhancing drugs and those trying to buy or sell horses to slaughter out of his three racetracks. The world-renowned equine surgeon, Dr. Patricia Hogan, who was honored by Equine Advocates at this event in 2008, had this to say about her friend, Jeff Gural:

"Horse racing faces many modern challenges today, not the least of which is a shaken public confidence in the integrity of the competition itself, but also in the racing community's ability to handle the whole host of welfare issues surrounding the care (and aftercare) of our magnificent horses. Jeff Gural has certainly been a trailblazer in implementing innovative ideas that have chipped away at these problems and started some very important conversations in racing that no one wanted to have, but were sorely needed. Oftentimes, he is doing these things alone - at great personal and financial cost. He richly deserves this

recognition and more from our industry."

Also being honored are actress and author, Cornelia Guest and the Honorable Ed Whitfield of Kentucky who served in the House of Representatives from 1995 – 2016.

Guest, who can currently be seen in the return of "Twin Peaks" on Showtime, is being honored for her equine rescue work, for her strong public stance and activism against horse slaughter and for founding the Artemis Farm Rescue in New York State for abused and slaughter-bound equines.

Ed Whitfield will receive a Special Lifetime Achievement Award for his tireless work and dedication to the protection of horses. He has been a staunch opponent of horse slaughter, horse soring and all forms of equine cruelty both personally and throughout his years in Congress where he fought hard to prevent equine abuse.

Takter dominates Peter Haughton and Doherty eliminations

Eliminations for the pair of signature freshman races at the Meadowlands, the Peter Haughton and Jim Doherty Memorials, were contested on Friday night at the Big M and Jimmy Takter was the human star.

The Hall of Famer sent out both elimination winners in the Haughton with You Know You Do (1:56.1) and Samo Different Day (1:54.2). He drove the latter, who scored as a 21-1 longshot. Takter's four other colts all qualified for next Saturday's final, giving him a six-pack in the Hambletonian Day fixture.

In the Doherty, Trond Smedshammer's Phaetosive followed behind as S M S Princess rolled through suicidal fractions of :27.3 and :54.4. As that one folded through three-quarters of a mile in 1:24.3, Phaetosive got rolling and drew away to win with ease in 1:53.1.

In the second elimination, Takter's Manchego remained undefeated in four career starts with a facile win off a picture-perfect second-over trip in 1:55.2. Takter will send three fillies into next Saturday's final.

Nike Franco backed up her powerful win in the Golden

Girls two weeks ago with a lifetime-best mile of 1:48 to win the fillies and mares preferred handicap. She enters next Saturday's Lady Liberty in top form for trainer Jo Ann Looney-King and owner Richard Poillucci.

The biggest upset of the night was authored by Canadian invader Lookslikeachpndale who powered up first-over to win the \$20,000 preferred trot in a lifetime-best 1:51.1. The Luc Blais trainee was winless in seven seasonal starts entering Friday night, but has shown a liking for the Big M surface in the past, finishing third at 24/1 in last year's TVG Free For All Final. He is being pointed to next Saturday's John Cashman Memorial on the Hambletonian undercard.

Earlier in the night, the fifth race jackpot super high 5 pool featured a mandatory payout. The jackpot stood at \$35,864 and attracted \$57,774 in new money, chasing the negative takeout scenario. Second choice King's Cavalier and favorite Nono Lindy finished 1-2 with 80-1 longshot Jazebel De Vie finishing third. That helped trigger a 20-cent return of \$2,832.40 to 30 winning tickets.

Total handle on the 11-race card was \$2,121,251. Live racing continues tonight with a 12-race program headlined by a pair of eliminations in the Hambletonian Oaks. Post time is 7:15 p.m.
