Racing Hill stunning in Adios

Despite brutal early fractions, favorite Racing Hill still pulled away in the stretch to deliver an astonishing Adios victory for driver Brett Miller and trainer Tony Alagna.

Racing Hill (Brett Miller) set a career best 1:48.4 while winning the 50th edition of the Delvin Miller Adios.

Driver Brett Miller said he "wanted to throw up" when he saw :52.1 half-mile split flash up on the teletimer, but somehow Racing Hill not only survived brutal early fractions, the pacer pulled away in the stretch Saturday (July 30) afternoon at The Meadows to win the 50th edition of the Delvin Miller Adios.

"I said, 'There's no way this horse can keep going' and he did," Miller said. "Thank God this horse is just razor sharp. I don't know if I've ever seen a horse go :52.1 and then start pulling away around the top of the stretch. He was just amazing today."


The 1:48.4 victory over a "sloppy" track rated one second slow, was not only an astonishing performance, it was also a career best for the homebred son of Roll With Joe out of Chasing Ideals owned by Tom Hill of Great Britain and trained by Tony Alagna.

"When I pulled his earplugs in the last turn, he took back off," Miller said. "That was just amazing. Tony Alagna has done some kind of job with this horse. Horses don't do that. That was incredible."

Alagna said Racing Hill, "took my breath away and I have a lot of faith in this horse. He even amazed me today."

Racing Hill, the 2-5 favorite, defeated 3-1 second choice Check Six by two-and-a-quarter lengths. It was Check Six and Yannick Gingras that tested Miller right from the start, looping in front from the five hole and parking Racing Hill (post four) off the wings.

"From the get-go, the race wasn't going the way I wanted it to," Miller said. "I was hoping, maybe, Lyons Snyder fired out of there. I was hoping for a few other people to leave up against the two Burke horses that I thought would be leaving and when they didn't, I kind of started shooting for the three-hole and it really wasn't there. To be honest with you, when we came around the first turn, I said to myself, 'We're in trouble."

Alagna said he didn't expect a nine-horse field featuring five horses trained by Ron Burke would make it easy on Racing Hill — "I knew they were going to make him earn it" — but he said Miller gave him confidence.

"You never want to see your horse stung at :25.2 and... when it flashed up :52.1 of course I was concerned, but I'm a big believer in watching a driver's body language in the bike and you could tell by the way Brett was sitting in the bike that he felt like he had plenty left and the horse responded," Alagna said.

"As strong as he looked still going up the backside into the

last turn, I was watching to see when (Miller) took his plugs out. I knew he hadn't taken his earplugs out and this horse always hits another gear when you do take the plugs out of his ears and he just exploded. It was a huge, huge mile."

The mile was particularly impressive considering the rain that battered the Washington, PA area earlier in the day.

"We had some really, really nasty rain," Alagna said. "Then it would stop and they would go to get out on it and then it would come again. For that track to hold up to that like it did today, the track crew did a heck of a job out there. They put on a heck of a show."

It was the first Adios victory for Miller, Alagna and Hill. Fernando Hanover, starting from post eight, finished third, three-and-a-quarter lengths back. Manhattan Beach was fourth and More Dragon fifth, meaning Burke horses grabbed every check except for the winning one.

Asked whether he found that frustrating or satisfying, Burke said, "Definitely satisfying. My horses raced well. Racing Hill was unbelievable."

Racing Hill, the winner of \$500,000 Hempt Memorial, was second in both the \$780,000 Pepsi North America Cup (won by Betting Line) and the \$732,050 Meadowlands Pace (won by Control The Moment). Neither the Cup of Pace winner came to The Meadows to contest the Adios.

"I think those are three really nice horses and I don't think they get as much credit as they deserve," Alagna said. "I'm sure there are people that didn't have as much faith in (Racing Hill) as I did. I think he made some people believers today about just what kind of horse he is."

Racing Hill now sports a record of 4-4-1 in nine starts in 2016 good for earnings of \$836,802. Lifetime, the pacer is 9-4-3 in 19 starts with earnings of \$970,028.

Alagna said Racing Hill will now skip the Cane Pace at the Meadowlands next Saturday to take a break and prepare for the second half of his schedule.

"He's had a tough schedule. We're going to shoot for the Battle of Brandywine at Pocono and that gives him a nice three-week break," Alagna said.

"It gives him a chance to freshen up. He has raced some hard starts, but he is very fresh. He cooled out great. He actually cooled out better today than he did last week, because last week it was so hot out there at The Meadows."

Oaks Upsetters

Side Bet Hanover and Celebrity Eventsy both posted upsets in the Hambletonian Oaks eliminations Saturday night at the Meadowlands.

Side Bet Hanover and Celebrity Eventsy registered upset victories in their respective Hambletonian Oaks eliminations Saturday night (July 30) at the Meadowlands, and as a result, may select posts one through five for next week's \$500,000 final for three-year-old trotting fillies.

Corey Callahan orchestrated a 38-1 upset with Side Bet Hanover in one of two Hambletonian Oaks eliminations Saturday at the Meadowlands.

Side Bet Hanover lit up the board as a 38-1 chance in the first elim. After leaving quickly from post one, the Jonas Czernyson trainee settled into a three-hole trip down the backstretch.

All eyes were on 2-5 favorite Caprice Hill, who trotted past the half in :55.3 and three-quarters in 1:25 and was clear of the field by three lengths at the eighth pole.

Driver Corey Callahan then moved Side Bet Hanover (\$78.20 to win) off the rail, found a seam late, and sprinted the final 50 yards to catch the odds-on choice and win by a head in a lifetime-best 1:53.2. Earning the final three berths in next week's final were Dream Child, Black Broadway and Windowshopper.

"I guess they have no respect for me," said Czernyson of the odds. "It looks like we have her peaking at the right time."

Also peaking at the right time is the Staffan Lind-trained Celebrity Eventsy (\$12.60), who scored for driver John Campbell after taking the early lead before working out a pocket trip behind 8-5 second choice Broadway Donna. In deep stretch, she charged up the rail to register a neck win in a lifetime-best 1:53.1 over the sloppy going.

All The Time, the 3-2 favorite, got within a length of the leader racing first-over at the head of the stretch, but went

evenly from there. Broadway Donna finished a neck in back of the winner, but was off stride at the wire, was disqualified and placed third, behind All The Time. Double Exposure and Wildflower earned the final two tickets to the final.

"We've been aiming for this all along," said Lind.

FRANK READY FOR HAMBO: Southwind Frank overcame a track bias that played to closers all night long and took the Reynolds Memorial in a lifetime-best equaling 1:52.1 after brushing with authority to the lead at the half for his 16th win in 18 lifetime starts, setting him up perfectly for next week's \$1 million Hambletonian.

SEVEN FOR GINGRAS: Driver Yannick Gingras had the hot hand at the Meadowlands Friday night (July 29), winning seven times on the 13-race program, including the \$25,000 featured open handicap with the top trotter in training, Hannelore Hanover.

Taking full advantage of being first call for two of the top stables in the game, Gingras won four races for Jimmy Takter and three for Ron Burke.

Gingras kept the Burke-trained Hannelore Hanover (\$3.20 to win) last in the field of six until picking up live cover at the five-eighths. JL Cruze, who had led from the start, was still going well in the stretch but was bearing out some as Hannelore Hanover charged up on the outside to score by a half-length in 1:51.1, equaling the Big M's track record for four-year-old trotting mares.

IT'S TAKTER'S WORLD: Trainer Jimmy Takter once again dominated the two-year-old trotting stakes events at the Meadowlands, winning both of the Peter Haughton Memorial Eliminations for colts and geldings and one of two Jim Doherty Eliminations for fillies.

Takter actually found a way to win three times in the Haughton, scoring twice in the opening elimination as his King On The Hill (Tim Tetrick, \$5.20) got up on the wire to dead heat with stablemate Rubio (Gingras, \$2.10) in 1:54.2 before Victor Gio It (Gingras, \$6.20) took the other elim in 1:54.4.

Ariana G (Gingras, \$2.10 to win) remained unbeaten in three starts for Takter with an easy win in the first of two Doherty dashes in 1:54.1. Trainer Trond Smedshammer's Chezatter (David Miller, \$9.00) prevented a Takter sweep by taking the other Doherty elim in 1:54.3.

AND THE REST: Gingras' other winners came with Sassa Hanover (Burke, \$4.00), Classical Annie (Burke, \$3.60) and Reigning Moni (Takter, \$2.80).

HAMBO TV: The 91st Hambletonian will be televised live Saturday (Aug. 6) on the CBS Sports Network. The 90-minute program, hosted by Gary Seibel, co-hosted by Dave Brower with interviews by Justin Horowitz, begins at 4 p.m. with the Hambletonian post time scheduled for 5:15 p.m

Head West, Stud

Thanks to the growth of the Ohio Sire Stakes program, a number of stallions are finding success in the Buckeye state despite limited returns elsewhere.

The Ohio Sire Stakes (OHSS) program is undergoing a transformation unmatched by any other. Neighbors to the east and west (Pennsylvania and Indiana) made no significant on-track additions to their stallion ranks, aside from Ponder's move to Pennsylvania and Lucky Chucky's single PA crop. Yet, the Buckeyes have seen major upgrades come online in 2016.

First-crop trotting sire Dejarmbro is in the throes of a terrific debut; Triumphant Caviar is proving that his initial offering was no fluke; Break The Bank K's first modest Ohio crop of 36 is doing well; and then there are the pacing stallions.

Seventeen-year-old McArdle, who was named after Nevele R Stud's founder Bob McArdle, won 28 of 54 starts for Chris Ryder, David Miller and Mike Lachance. He earned more than \$2.4 million, but was not king of his crop. The son of Falcon Seelster—Lilting Laughter won his NA Cup and Meadowlands Pace eliminations and finished second to Mach Three in the latter, but he was second, 167 votes behind Art Major, in freshman Dan Patch voting; and he was second again, 167 back of Art Major, at four.

This is McArdle's 10th crop. He sired two in New Jersey before being shipped out due to questions about his ability to be competitive in that environment. This was followed by seven years in Pennsylvania, before relocating to Ohio in 2013. One More Laugh, McWicked and Big McDeal notwithstanding, the Keystone State was not an ideal environment for him: There's a lot of restricted money up for grabs, but not enough of it went to his get. His last two crops there consisted of 37 and 26 foals. Contrast that to the 176 mares he bred his first year in Ohio, resulting in the 97 foals in this crop.

July 28 at Scioto Downs there were five \$32,000 pacing splits of the Buckeye State program at Scioto Downs: the freshman gelding Barnabas took one in 1:53., after having already captured two \$40,000 divisions of the OHSS at Scioto and Northfield; McThriller, already the winner of a \$40,000 OHSS split at Scioto, won his from the 10 post in 1:54.2 for Ronnie Wrenn Jr and Brian Brown; and Scotch McEwan, a gelding, won the final split in a track record 1:52.3 from the 9 post for Josh Sutton and Jim Dailey. And

the previous night Brian Brown's filly, Bellasbrowneyedgirl, beat a 1-9 shot at 47-1 in a division of the State Fair Managers Pace.

On July 4 there were eleven \$40,000 OHSS divisions raced at Scioto and seven of them went to McArdle freshmen: Ohio Larry, Barnabas, My Superman, McThriller, Stanley K, McRaven and Scotch McEwan all won.

On July 11 at Northfield, McRaven, Barnabas, Jim McRhody and McSpidey all won \$40,000 OHSS splits.

Results like that have become the norm for McArdle, who appears to have finally found his niche, after all these years of not syncing with his surroundings. He's second to SBSW on the earnings list for freshmen pacers and he already has 29 winners to his credit.

In a year when stud fees were dropping across the board, the immensely popular McArdle saw his jump 20 per cent. Home at last.

Unlike McArdle, Art Official had no success to speak of in restricted races or on the Grand Circuit during his three-year stint in Pennsylvania. His fee gradually dropped from \$7,000 to \$3,000. Let's Drink On It and Cinamony are good journeyman pacers, but they can't be your king and queen.

All that seems to be changing for the better with his first Ohio crop. Type A Grey, a grey filly out of the American Ideal mare Just My Type, is the richest freshman filly in North America. She's three-for-three, with a pair of romps in \$40,000 splits of the OHSS and another cruise job in a \$35,800 division of the State Fair Managers Pace. This head turner doesn't appear to be staked outside the program.

Corner Con Artist is another OHSS winner by Art Official, driven by Ronnie Wrenn Jr and trained by Brian Brown. The colt Official Delight was second in that race. DaVinci Artist is another good one. Seventeen of his 35 starters have won.

The Rocknroll Hanover stallion Foreclosure N is garnering attention with his single Ohio crop of 20 foals. The winner of 15 races and almost \$808,000, who raced for Peter Heffering and Richard Young, and finished his career in the Burke Barn, was sold to European interests in March, 2015. He was relocated to Ireland.

Thirteen of the 20 have raced and six have won. Drunk On

Your Love and Rosemary Rose are both multiple winners in the Ohio SS. The former took a mark of 1:54.3 and the latter 1:54.4, both at Scioto Downs. Pace Car, the fastest of them all, with a 1:54 win in the Ohio SS at Northfield. He is a son of the rugged mare Breakheart Pass, who won 27 times and banked more than \$600,000. He races for Ron Burke. Please return to sender, Ireland.

Twenty-year-old The Panderosa, the sire of Shadow Play, Ponder and Yagonnakissmeornot, stood for 13 years in Pennsylvania before moving to Ohio in 2013. His last two Keystone crops consisted of 35 and 27 foals. His stud fee, which was \$10,000 back in 2008, dropped to \$3,000 when he relocated to the Buckeye State. His current two-year-old crop consists of 46 foals and 29 of them have started. Air Raid, Ron's Pro and Rosa's Touch all scored wins in the state bred program. The Panderosa was a lost soul in Pennsylvania, perhaps his moribund stallion career will also find new life in this home of second chances.



(Editor's Note: This item originally appeared on the Ontario Racing website recently under a section called For The Love Of Racing which still adds new stories weekly. Paul MacDonell knows you're expecting him to say Somebeachsomewhere is the horse that changed his life. MacDonell was, after all, the only man to ever drive the world champion pacer and Hall of Famer in a pari-mutuel start.

There's no question that Somebeachsomewhere was the best horse MacDonell has ever driven. But if it wasn't for Cavans Jovial, MacDonell isn't sure whether he would have had the kind of career that led to Beach in the first place.

MacDonell was just 21 and racing at Kawartha Downs near Peterborough, ON in the spring of 1984 when Cavans Jovial came into his life.

"I happened to drive her at Kawartha Downs in an overnight race," MacDonell said. "I liked the way she went. The owner was there and I asked him, 'Would you be willing to sell her?' Sure enough, he came with a price."

MacDonell said the price was \$12,000 and he, his father, Blaise, and Bob Hayes jumped at the chance to buy Cavans Jovial, who was in the early stages of her sophomore season.

"She went on and made \$100,000 in the Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) that year," MacDonell said. "She was a horse that launched me into driving in the OSS. She sprung me to a different level. I can remember she raced against Annie Ivy. She raced against her and Ted Jacobs had a really nice mare. There were three or four really nice ones and she raced right with them. We were riding on Cloud 9 to be able to compete against those horses."

Lifetime, the daughter of Kawartha Skipper out of Jovial Georgia earned \$142,611 with a record of 17-10-6 in 50

starts and a mark of 1:57.3 taken at the Meadowlands in her five-year-old season.

MacDonell went on to win more than 5,300 races and post earnings exceeding \$116 million. In all likelihood, he will always be associated most with Somebeachsomewhere

"What amazes me today is how people still come along and want me to sign stuff that has Beach on it, or a program, or something as simple as a card — anything that has Beach's picture. I just find that amazing eight years later," MacDonell said. "People ask about him. They ask, 'Have you seen him lately?' They're truly interested in the horse. I think that's kind of neat."



Walter Marks dead at 85

Driver Walter Marks, one of the top drivers at Brandywine and Liberty Bell in the 1970s, died Tuesday (July 26) at Brandywine Hospital. He was 85.

Born in Bridgeton, N.J., Marks was the son of the late Esther (Anderson) and Samuel Marks. He was the husband of Phyllis (Raine) Marks, with whom he shared 60 years of marriage.

Marks served as an airplane mechanic in the Air Force during the Korean War. He was a member of Parkesburg VFW.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Marks is also survived by his daughters, Cindy (George) Simmons and Felicia (Jeff) Lacey; four grandchildren; one great-granddaughter; and a brother, John. He was preceded in death by his daughter, Melissa; and two brothers, Samuel and Victor.

The funeral service was held Saturday (July 30) at Wilde Funeral Home, 434 Main St., Parkesburg, with a viewing from 10-11 a.m. The interment will be held on Monday (Aug. 1) at 12 noon at Lawnside Cemetery Association, 1017 Route 40, Woodstown, NJ.

Wildwild Men in Dream Of Glory

Wildwild Men and driver Robert Shepherd dominated the 15th edition of the \$67,500 Dream Of Glory Trot, winning in wire-to-wire fashion to close out a stakes-filled Saturday night (July 30) at Hanover Raceway.

Shepherd left quickly from post four with the 6-5 favored elimination winner and controlled the tempo through fractions of :29.1, :59.4 and 1:29 on their way to the 1:58.2 victory. P C Cantore (Ross Battin) chased the winner home from the pocket, finishing two and three-quarter lengths behind in second-place, while Very Classy (Steve Byron) followed in third. Gonna Fly (Brad Forward) rallied three-wide down the backstretch off the cover of Chestnut Schofield (Keith Jones) to finish fourth, with Pukka (Bob McClure) tracking that move to earn the final pay check in fifth.

Wilwild Men paid \$4.20 to win. The 8-5 second choice in the field, elimination winner Smoke Monkey, broke stride at the start and was never a factor.

"He's a nice horse. He's very handy; he caught the turns really good," said Shepherd after the race. "My girlfriend (trainer Isabelle (Darveau) has done a great job with him. He's a nice horse."

Wildwild Men has now won four straight races, including a pair of Quebec-Bred Series legs prior to his Dream Of Glory sweep. His 1:58.2 winning time in the final matched his lifetime mark.


"We had a couple of eliminations in Quebec before he came and we timed it out that it would give him 12 days until the eliminations," said Shepherd of the three-year-old gelding's schedule leading up to the signature Hanover race. "He was really good. The same routine as usual. He trained really good two days out and he loves his work."

Wildwild Men earned his ninth career win from 17 starts and boosted his lifetime earnings over the \$100,000 mark.

The Muscle Mass—Seeyouinthecircle gelding was joined in the winner's circle for the celebrations by owners Catheline Pelletier of Mirabel, QC and Chantal Gravel of St-Cyrille-De-Wendover, QC.

MacDonald unstoppable on the bounce?

Grand River Raceway is inviting fans to test the mettle of driver James MacDonald. The reigning champ of the Drivers' Edition of the Bouncy Pony Stakes during the track's annual Industry Day event, MacDonald seems virtually untouchable.

With five consecutive victories in MacDonald's pocket, the track has posted polls on their **Facebook** and **Twitter**, gathering consensus for the best tactic to level the playing field for the 2016 edition on Monday (Aug. 1).

#1: Shoeing Change: From steel to flip-flops. (James races in flip-flops.)

#2: Bridle Change: Open bridle, add Murphy outside. (James wears an eye-patch.)

#3: Add Ground: Add starting distance of 25%. (James starts 10 meters back.)

"Everyone's got their God-given talent," said MacDonald in a post-race interview in 2015. "Gretzky had hockey. I've got the bounce."

The most popular tactic will be instated when the Industry Day Halftime Show kicks off after Race 5.

A win in the race will cap off a Grand

River Raceway triple crown of sorts for MacDonald. In June, he won the Ontario Regional Driving Championship at the Elora oval. In July, his two-year-old Dachshund, Tank, won the second annual Ren's Pets Depot Wiener Dog Races.

MacDonald is also driving one of the favorites in the \$107,800 Battle Of The Belles on Industry Day. The Guelph, ON reinsman piloted Bid Writer to a three-length win in 1:56.3 in her elimination division on July 25. MacDonald won the 2014 edition of the race with Win The Gold.
