With the shocking and sad demise of the great colt Walner, the 2017 Hambletonian seemed to be a wide open affair with the box brimming with entries. However, after a closer look, it may not be as evenly balanced as it seemed at first.

After expressing my condolences to Walner's connections – trainer Linda Toscano and owner Ken Jacobs – on Facebook and thanking them for making a decision that protected their prized colt, I got to work trying to separate the contenders from the pretenders. As it turns out it was not that difficult a task.

"Time only counts when you are in jail."

NOT TRUE.

Since the opening of the Meadowlands, handicapping has become quite different than before. With 10 horses going all out over a mile, no sharp turns to slow down the pace, time becomes a factor. The simple fact is there are horses in every race that are just not fast enough.

Before revealing my selections, there are some interesting facts I have noticed after reviewing the entries.

There are almost as many Andover Halls (four) as Muscle Hills (five).

The average price of those that went through public auction is \$67,800. Where are all the \$200,000 plus yearlings that sold in this crop? It is proof you will have a hard time trying to buy a Hambletonian. There are way too many variables.

Most alarmingly, where are the Cantab Halls? I find it hard to believe not one was entered.

International Moni will win the 2017 Hambletonian. The colt has everything. Frank M. Antonacci and Scotty Zeron have been there before and will know how to complete the puzzle. The colt's performance in the elimination of the Goodtimes was more than amazing and if it was not for the existence of the crazy fast Walner I would have anointed him in June.

The Antonacci family goes for their sixth Hambletonian victory that easily could have been eight had I not lost with MB Felty and Cantab Hall.

International Moni is undefeated in three starts this year and no one can guess how fast he is. He is blessed with an amazing outcross pedigree that will enhance his prowess going two heats. He drew very well and it will take a great performance to beat him.

It is still a horse race and there are many nice colts with formidable connections to challenge my choice. For second, I will go with a long shot, Dover Dan. John Butenschoen has a

barn full of nice trotters and Brian Sears is no stranger to the classic winner's circle. The colt drew well and has a good closing kick.

Devious Man would have been my second choice, but the draw was not kind to him. The colt has been ultra consistent all year and comes from a wonderful barn. With some racing luck, he could win the whole thing. Remember, he is a brother to a Hambletonian winner, the Roger Hammer-trained Vivid Photo.

My favorite on looks alone is Long Tom. He has a young trainer (Marcus Melander) with a bright future and is as beautifully gaited as a horse can be. I just feel he may not be fast enough.

I haven't selected a Takter or Burke trainee because on paper I don't see them winning, but both are capable of magic in big races and if you like to go that route Victor Gio it and What the Hill are the best they have to offer.

If you are looking for a windfall, Shake It Off Lindy and Perfect Spirit have connections that wouldn't start them in a race like this unless they knew something that you and I don't know.

Is nine a lucky number?

Julie and Andy Miller are about to find out Saturday when favored Devious Man goes to post in the Hambletonian and Overdraft Volo starts in the Hambletonian Oaks – both from post nine.

Over an 18-race career that has produced 11 wins and over \$750,000 in earnings, Devious Man has never left the gate from the nine spot.

Until now, that is.

Campaigned by the wife-and-husband team of trainer Julie Miller and driver Andy Miller, Devious Man is the 5-2 morning line favorite in Saturday's 10-horse Hambletonian division elimination.

On Tuesday, the four-time winner from six races this year (who hasn't finished lower than second) drew post nine for

the race.

"Andy has a September birthday, so maybe that is a good sign," said Julie. "We were watching the live stream of the draw and when you hear your horse's name, it is what it is. Those are the things you can't control. I was glad that there

were only two divisions. It takes a little stress off being top five, versus being top three or top two. With Walner being out, a lot of people were contemplating putting their hat in the ring. Having two divisions...I was glad to see that, especially after we drew the nine-hole."

Devious Man's scores include the Earl Beal Jr. Memorial at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono on July 1 and the Empire Breeders Championship on June 18 at Vernon Downs.

Owned by the Andy Miller Stable and Stroy Inc., Devious Man, a son of Credit Winner out of Miss Garland that is a half-brother to 2005 Hambletonian winner Vivid Photo, comes into the Hambletonian off a runner-up effort to Walner in a division of the Stanley Dancer Memorial.

"You're not supposed to have favorites," said Julie. "I'm supposed to treat everyone equally, but it's hard to with him. I qualified him his first start at Gaitway (Farm). He's always had that cool, great personality you gravitate towards. He has a presence in the barn. If I'm just walking by with my coffee doing my rounds, I better make sure I say hello. He commands an audience.

"I'm really happy with him. We trained him on Saturday and he was really good. The biggest thing for myself is not to

overthink it. Treat him like you always treat him. I don't think he knows right now the difference between a New York-sired stake or the Hambletonian. I just try to prepare him the same way."

The same approach applies for Overdraft Volo, who'll contest the Hambletonian Oaks.

No need to guess where the daughter of Yankee Glide will leave from in the \$500,000 event.

The Pinske Stables and Kentuckiana Racing Stable trotting miss, who won a division of the Delvin Miller Memorial, has had just one experience from post nine over her 16-race career.

And what an experience it turned out to be.

With David Miller at the controls, Overdraft Volo pulled off a major upset in last year's Kindergarten Classic two-year-old filly trot.

The bay rallied to notch a 1 ¼-length victory, paying \$34.80 for the win.

"That was my first thought when they did the draw for the Oaks," said Julie, in referencing post nine. "Actually, when the owners and I were messaging one another, that's what we talked about, the Kindergarten win. That's the first thing we all mentioned. It wasn't a deterrent then and hopefully, it won't be this time."

A lifetime winner of six races, accompanied by four seconds and a trio of thirds, Overdraft Volo finished fourth (1:52.4) in her Oaks elim on July 29.

"Trotting fillies – you can get a wide range of personalities," said Julie. "And she's just a sweetheart, on and off the racetrack. She's a nice, big filly, but she's easy on herself. She's really a versatile horse. Whatever Andy decides

to do that day, whether they leave or try to work out a trip, she's really manageable."

With two big races just around the corner, the Millers are taking it all in stride.

"I'm not anxious, I'm eager," said Julie with a laugh. "I'm looking forward to it. What a great opportunity we have this weekend. I just try to focus on staying positive and ensuring that my horses are the best they can be that day. All of those variables I can't control, I try to put out of my mind – what the draw is, if it's raining or windy that day. I can't do that to myself."

Which is why a little R&R is the perfect tonic for the couple heading into Hambletonian day.


"It's funny because Andy and I are obviously together a lot for work," said Julie. "In the summer time, especially, if he can get a round of golf in, it's kind of like he got turned out for the afternoon. He really enjoys golf and he has a nice group of friends he can do that with. That's his relaxing time away from thinking about the horses.

"I'm different. I like going to yoga. I think that really helps keep me grounded. But we actually do things separately to get re-centered on the task at hand."

So, while Andy is taking his best swing at draining a few birdies on the front and back nine, Julie will focus on the number nine during her yoga sessions.

"Exactly," she said. "That will definitely be a thought that comes to mind."

Peering in the pedigrees of the Hambletonian hopefuls

The field is a fascinating mix of international bloodlines and strong families with great legacies.

Perhaps the moon was in the right phase on the evening of April 4, 2014 because two of the Hambletonian starters this year were born that day at Hanover Shoe Farms.

These were Stealth Hanover and Long Tom. Their sires — Andover Hall and Muscle Hill, respectively — are also the leading sires of this year's Hambletonian starters.

Muscle Hill leads with five representatives: Jake, Long Tom, Southwind Cobra, Southwind Woody, and What The Hill.

Andover Hall will be represented by Achille Duharas, Dover Dan, Perfect Spirit, and Stealth Hanover.

Ironically, two other 2017 Hambletonian hopefuls were born on the same day of March 24, 2017. There were Sortie, foaled in Paris, Kentucky, while Seven And Seven was foaled to the northeast in Shreve, OH.

Of course, the absence of Walner, last year's juvenile champion, makes the Hambletonian anyone's race. Walner's talents seemed so extraordinary that the Hambletonian was virtually conceded to him. But there is a reason they give the trophy after the race, not before it.

As has been detailed, this year's Hambletonian has a distinctively international flavor with two starters by French stallions.

The foremost is International Moni, the perfect-pedigreed colt by Love You out of the international trotting queen Moni Maker.

Moni Maker won many of America's biggest trotting races as well as the Prix d'Amerique in France and Elitlopp in Sweden. Love You has been a champion sire in France for many years and his semen is shipped widely, making him the champion stallion in countries where he has never stood.

International Moni is also an embryo transfer foal, and a

victory in the Hambletonian would certainly quell some of the qualms that horsemen often have about purchasing ET foals.

Love You, a robust chestnut stallion, is also the sire of the dam of Shake It Off Lindy. This is the result of the Antonacci family's commitment to international trotting. Mixing American and French blood has been the winning formula for many years in Europe where races are longer and the biggest prizes are for older horses. Now we're beginning to see the impact of the Franco-American blend in American stakes racing.

The other French connection in the Hambletonian is Victor Gio IT, who was foaled in Italy but was sired by Ready Cash, a top French stallion. Ready Cash was a blazingly fast trotter and engaged in memorable duels with the Swedish champion Maharajah.

I first heard of Ready Cash many years ago on the eve of the Prix d'Amerique in Paris, when a top Swedish trotting journalist told me to watch Ready Cash closely in a 4-year-old race.

"Ready Cash is a French trotter with American-style speed," he told me. And he was dead right.

A trio of stallions tie for broodmare sire credits with a pair of 2017 Hambletonian starters. Andover Hall, Kadabra, and Pine Chip each have two daughters with sons in the race.

Not surprisingly, April and May tie for honors as they leading birth month with seven Hambletonian starters each.

For those who shy away from late foals, it should be noted that Devious Man (May 21), Shake It Off Lindy (May 25) and International Moni (May 29) would each fall into that category.

Horror of horrors, Achille Duharas is a June 2 baby! Historically, many top horses have been late May foals.

There are other interesting observations that you discover when poking around in the pedigrees of this year's starters.

Moni Maker is not the only former female Horse of the Year with a son in this year's race. Dover Dan is out of CR Kay Suzie, the 1995 Horse of the Year. The Hambletonian that year proved to be one of the few bumps she encountered as she jumped it off as the heavy favorite.

It should be noted that Dover Dan arrived when CR Kay Suzie was 22 years old and his 1:52.4f mark this season makes him the fastest foal of his celebrated mama.

Devious Man, one of the favorites, was born to the mare Miss Garland when she was 24 years old. He was her final foal, but she'd done quite well earlier in life as she produced the Hambletonian winner Vivid Photo.

Who knows what to expect in this year's Hambletonian? All that is left for the fans is to sit back and watch as the horses duke it out at the Meadowlands.

Muscle Hill fillies dominate Oaks

Breaking down the Hambletonian Oaks field.

This year's Hambletonian Oaks might well be renamed the Muscle Hill Oaks as five of the 10 finals are daughters of the remarkable young stallion that stands at Southwind Farms.

What Muscle Hill has accomplished in his brief stud career is staggering and the best may be yet to come. Remember, he's only 11 years old and he still holds the record for the fastest mile ever in the Hambletonian when he jogged home a winner in 1:50.1 in 2009.

The influence of the patriarch Muscles Yankee (1998 Hambletonian winner) in this year's Oaks comes primarily through Muscle Hill, but Caviart Wonder is a daughter of Muscle Massive, while Magic Presto is out of a daughter by Muscles Yankee himself.

Although his five starters are out of mares by four different stallions, there is a strong connection among the broodmare sires of the Muscle Hill starters.

Two – Dream Together and Dream Baby Dream – are from mares by Andover Hall.

Southwind Avanti is a Muscle Hill filly from a mare by Windsong's Legacy, a son of Conway Hall (brother to Andover Hall).

Caviart Wonder by Muscle Massive is out of a mare by Conway Hall.

The affinity of Muscles Yankee blood for mares by the "Band of Brothers" (Conway, Angus, and Andover) is obvious.

Favored Ariana G, however, is by Muscle Hill out of a mare by Cantab Hall, who is by Self Possessed.

Andover and Cantab each have two broodmare sire credits, while the others are claimed by the aforementioned Conway Hall, Windsong's Legacy, Tagliabue, Donerail, Pine Chip, and Muscles Yankee.

Two states – Kentucky and New Jersey – were the birthplaces of more than half the Oaks field.

Ariana G, Southwind Avanti, and Feed Your Head are Jersey girls while Dream Together, Sunshine Delight, and Overdraft Volo are native-born Kentucky gals.

The other four fillies were born in Pennsylvania (2), Florida and Ontario.

March was the birth month of four of the Oaks fillies, with Ariana G and Southwind Avanti being foaled only four days apart in New Jersey.

There were two fillies foaled in late May, often a penalty against yearlings when they go through the sale ring. Feed Your Head was born on May 21 and Fine Tuned Lady was a

May 28 foal.

Three pairs of Oaks fillies hail from the same maternal family.

One of the most sensational fillies of the 1950s was Lady Ann Reed, who came out of obscurity from her early training in Missouri. She was astonishing on the track and now is an influential broodmare.

Lady Ann Reed's daughter Tarport Lady Ann by Jamie is the fourth dam of both Feed Your Head and Caviart Wonder.

Southwind Avanti and Dream Together are both from the Nelly family (also known as the Honeymoon H family), although Southwind Avanti is from the branch associated with Moni Maker and Claire Sampson while Dream Together is from the branch identified with Lively Lady and Delmonica Hanover. (Yes, that is indeed a strong female family).

Fine Tuned Lady and Overdraft Volo hail from the famous Maggie H family.

All 10 Oaks finalist were foaled in different locations, although many of them at breeding farms in the same area. Dream Together was foaled at Cane Run Farm in Georgetown, KY, while Overdraft Volo first saw the light of day at nearby Kentuckiana Farms.

All these statistics will count for nought when they line up behind the gate and fight it out for the honor of being the 2017 Hambletonian Oaks champion.

Butenschoen trying to take measured approach to his Hambletonian trio

The Illinois-born, Pennsylvania-based trainer will send out Bill's Man, Dover Dan and Giveitgasandgo in Saturday's \$1.2 million event.

Trainer John Butenschoen has come from the cornfields of Illinois by way of Pennsylvania, and Saturday he will send out four starters at the Meadowlands on harness racing's biggest day. His trio of Bill's Man, Dover Dan and Giveitgasandgo will look to advance in two Hambletonian eliminations, while Fine Tuned Lady will compete in the \$500,000 Hambletonian Oaks. Butenschoen is doing his best to handle the excitement, and pressure, of racing on the sport's grandest stage.

"Well anybody can do that, all you've got to do is write a check for \$45,000. It's simple, right?" he said of entering three colts in the prestigious Hambletonian with a hearty laugh. "I'm sure it hasn't sunk in yet. It's pretty cool when you think about it. It's uncharted territory for me. Hopefully we have a little bit of luck."

Butenschoen's Hambletonian trifecta is matched in number by Ron Burke's three-horse entry. The only other trainer to saddle four trotters in the day's two headline events is Jimmy

Takter. It's a day that Butenschoen has been planning for since the early months of 2017. Planning is one thing, getting there is a challenge in and of itself.

"When we were in Florida this winter, when we made the payments in February, I paid six horses in," Butenschoen said. "Three of the five that I had last year as two year olds continued on and have had a real good year. We're trying to get the other two on track. It very well could have been that we were trying to get all five on track. You have hopes, you have dreams, and you make plans. Fortunately these three have stayed on track."

Bill's Man, the most consistent of his three-pronged attack, has drawn post two in the first Hambletonian elimination with morning line odds of 5-1. Corey Callahan will steer the son of Credit Winner out of 2004 Hambletonian Oaks winner Silver Springs. This season Bill's Man sports a 2-4-2 record from nine starts. The colt finished second to Devious Man in the \$252,000 Empire Breeders Classic and raced third to Walner and Devious Man in the Stanley Dancer, trotting in 1:51.3.

Post six will be occupied by Giveitgasandgo, PASS champion last year as a two-year-old. With a 3-2-1 tally from seven starts, the son of Yankee Glide—Mazda Hanover is on the upswing after finishing fourth in his Beal elimination and missing the final. He raced third in the \$75,000 consolation and has since registered two wins. Giveitgasandgo, an 8-1 morning line selection, picks up the services of David Miller Saturday. It will be the first time the Hall of Famer has sat behind the trotter this season.

In the second elimination, Butenschoen sends out Dover Dan from post five at odds of 8-1. Brian Sears will be at the controls for the trainer. The Andover Hall colt is out of the great CR Kay Suzie, and has won two of eight seasonal starts. He earned a berth in the \$500,000 Beal final in July but finished sixth. As a freshman, Dover Dan won his division of the Bluegrass at Lexington and trotted third in the International Stallion Stake.

"Bill's Man has just been consistent all along. Dover Dan and Giveitgasandgo took a step back in the Beal, but subsequently they've both come back and raced very well," the conditioner said in assessing his pupils. "After the draw came out you feel better knowing they're in a spot where they can maybe dictate a little more of their own fortune and outcome instead of drawing outside. We'll keep our fingers crossed and see if they make the final."

Butenschoen has been here once before. In 2013, he arrived at the Meadowlands with Glidemaster colt

Punxsutawney. An early break and fifth-place finish in his elimination prevented the trotter from advancing to the final. This time around, he is hoping for better racing luck. As exciting as it is to have three horses in the Hambletonian, he's trying to treat Saturday's events as just another race.

"My job is to make sure they are eating well, we don't do anything stupid and nothing bad happens; try to minimize the mistakes," he said. "I don't think you can lose the fact that they are horses, and you can't do things a whole lot different just because they are in the Hambletonian. You can't do anything different than what you were doing to get here. You try to stay on the same program and stay out of their way."

The trainer is happy for the connections behind Saturday's four starters. Nine years ago, he left the Land of Lincoln for the Keystone State, and many of his owners came along for the ride. Now they have a chance at Hambletonian glory.

"We were forced out of our home state because of the economics of racing," Butenschoen said. "Our owners followed us and stepped up and bought some nice colts. I just feel lucky and privileged for the chance to get there."

Many eyes will be on the favored Devious Man and

International Moni, and rightly so. Butenschoen doesn't have illusions of grandeur. He's taking a grounded approach to Saturday, knowing that the day could unfold in many different ways. He has prepared himself for all the scenarios that could play out, and despite the outcome, he has a simple desire for the trio.

"My goal is for them all to race well. If they race well and they get beat, they get beat, and that's the way it is," he stated. "What I'm hoping for out of the race is that they don't beat themselves up. You want to see a good, clean race and let the horses decide. Obviously you want them all to get in the finals and all get checks, but realistically, it's hard enough to get just one there."

Hambletonian Day handicapping musings and selections

Between waiting on a decision to see if Ariana G would opt to the Hambletonian in the absence of Walner and the Meadowlands being successful in the barring of top race mare Lady Shadow, this week leading up to the Hambletonian wasn't lacking any drama. With those subjects and others, let's go through the top races one by one.

\$113,950 Shady Daisy: Talk about a barn change. Ella Christina was bombs away last weekend in her division in the Adioo Volo when she won at 56-1 on the barn change from Nancy Johansson to Nick Surick. It was hard to see that one coming when looking back at prior lines, but now she faces even tougher and would be an even bigger shock. The other Adioo Volo winner from last week at The Meadows is also in here and Blazin Britches set a lifetime mark in 1:50:1 in that race; both Ella Christina and Blazin Britches have supplemented to this race. The Brian Brown trainee also goes from Trace Tetrack to David Miller and that ought to count for something; a solid test against #6. Idyllic Beach has been going against tougher in all six of her starts this season and she did all she could last out to chase after Agent Q in the Shalee to be second best; no disgrace there.

\$176,250 Steele Memorial: What an odd and frustrating trip that Hannelore Hanover got last out in her Spirit of Mass race at Plainridge, through no fault of driver Yannick Gingras. Every time Gingras went to make a move out of the three hole, Svanstedt popped the pocket with Resolve only to go nowhere – this happened continuously in the race. Regardless, it's back to racing against fellow mares now and she was untouchable when last seen here on the Meadowlands Pace card; seems tough to go against. Emoticon Hanover was a sharp front-end winner last out on that same Pace card and everything that we've seen in these parts from trainer Luc Blais has been firing. She couldn't get to Hannelore earlier this season in Canada but may be able to give her a run for her money now. Pasithea Face S will

probably attract attention in her second start since for Takter since arriving some Sweden. That last quarter of :26:1 stands out, but I'll note that every horse in that race came home in :26 and change.

Race 3 \$1 Pick 4: 3-8 / 1-5-7 / 2-4 / 3-7 \$24

\$360,650 Peter Haughton: If Meadowlands boss Jeff Gural has a rooting interest in this race, it's probably anyone except You Know You Do. That colt is one of a remarkable six horses in here that are trained by Jimmy Takter, but this one is co-owned by Howard Taylor with whom Gural continues to fight with. Despite the 2-1 morning line, this one hasn't proven to be as fast yet as a number of others although Yannick does go here over a number of other ones he could have chosen. Samo Different Day brushed and crushed in his elimination at a big price in a fast mile. Met's Hall had the tougher trip last out in that 1:54:2 mile and is one of the obvious contenders.

\$330,800 Jim Doherty Memorial: Phaetosive capitalized off some wild fractions in her elimination last week to win going away in an amazing 1:53.1. Manchego is the other top contender and no one's been able to come close to touching her just yet; intriguing showdown coming.

\$303,050 John Cashman Memorial: Crazy Wow has never been better than he's been over the past couple of months and he gave way late at Plainridge a week ago after coming under pressure multiple times throughout the race. It's back to Yannick now and he's just a race removed from the fastest qualifying mile ever for a trotter; he can upset. Marion Marauder shined on this day one year ago when he won the Hambletonian over Southwind Frank and he's been mowing them down in grinding fashion in almost every race since. Zeron times the wire with this one perfectly nearly every time and he lands the ideal post to stalk once again; a deserving favorite. Flanagan Memory owns a good history the seldom times he appears here and won on this day two years ago. Looklikeachpndale is another one of these Luc Blais invaders that shocked last time; picks up Dube. JL Cruze got the trip last out and scored in huge upset fashion; I doubt it'll happen again but you never know. Resolve looks

like he could be tailing off just a bit and I'll swing against if the price is short.

\$334,325 Cane Pace: It's a rematch between Huntsville and Downbytheseaside and what can I say that you don't already know? The wide trip for the first half of the mile in the Adios likely cost Huntsville and the move back to the big track should help. Downbytheseaside ran out of real estate when he was about to get to Huntsville three weeks ago in the Pace and I can't wait to see what we get this time. Burke's entrant R J P had belated pace down the inside in the Adios, but wasn't a factor against these rivals in the Pace; would need a hot battle up front early.

\$100,000 Hambletonian Elimination: Victor Gio It has climbed the ladder quickly and it's tough to get a read on him since he's been racing against older conditioned foes, but he was second last out in one of the fastest trotting miles ever and at the end of the day it's Takter and Gingras. I think they're sitting on a good one. Stanley Dancer winner Long Tom has been excellent this year since returning like a new horse for Melander; one of the obvious contenders to not win just this elimination but the entire thing. International Moni looks no worse for the wear since returning from a bout with illness; will be storming home as usual. Giveitgasandgo and Bill's Man are both entrants from the Butenschoen stable; regular pilot for both horses is Callahan and he goes to Bill's Man; may or may not be telling.

Race 8 \$1 Pick 4: 5-7-8 / 1-9 / 2-10 / 4-8-9 \$36

\$100,000 Hambletonian Elimination: Devious Man took a run at Walner in his division of the Dancer and turned in a respectable performance to be second. With that rival not racing in the Hambletonian, the Beal winner Devious Man inherits the role of lukewarm favorite. His speed always gives him a shot and if he's to win the final he should be able to handle this group. There's nothing to knock with What The Hill and he'll be in the thick of things starting from the rail. Enterprise was game last week in nearly fending off International Moni.

\$224,400 Sam McKee Memorial: With the official announcement Thursday that Wiggle It Jiggleit will not start this year due to injury, the older pacing ranks continue to lack depth, but you can't say that they aren't a competitive group. They've put on a show the last couple of weeks between the Haughton here on Pace night and most recently the Gerrity at Saratoga. Mach It So has turned it on in the last couple of weeks for Bamond since the driver change to Miller and he was touted here two weeks ago at 16-1; unfortunately all of that value is now gone. Mel Mara was an easy play against two back when starting from the second

tier and I'm inclined to play against him once again; speedster would need things his own way on the front. Wakizashi Hanover is razor sharp at the moment as a number of other starters from this barn have been lately; offers some interesting value from post 9 for a horse that should be going forward early. Boston Red Rocks went a game trip two back but hung when it counted; still has earned my respect in recent weeks.

\$500,000 Hambletonian Oaks: The connections of Ariana G have settled on what looks to be a "sure thing" by electing to race their filly in the Oaks instead of the Hambletonian, and it's probably in the best interest of the horse to do so and avoid multiple heats against colts. There really isn't a reason to go against as this one's proven time and time again that she's too good for this group.

\$1,000,000 Hambletonian Final: Victor Gio It, Devious Man, Long Tom

\$200,400 Lady Liberty: As we all know by now the Lady Liberty will go on without the presence of the top pacing mare in the country, Lady Shadow. Due to a recently reported therapeutic medication overage from Betsy Ross at Harrah's Philadelphia in May, Jeff Gural was able to use that to bar Lady Shadow from racing. It would have been a treat to watch Nike Franco N slug it out with Lady Shadow once again, but what we're left with is a raging Nike Franco N fresh off a 1:48 clocking renewing her battle with Pure Country. That rival almost held on last week despite setting scorching fractions but Nike Franco N rattled home in :25.4 to beat her; seems like a two-horse affair.

Superior Court upholds Meadowlands ban of Lady Shadow

In a hearing Wednesday (Aug. 3) in Bergen County Superior Court, Hon. Robert P. Contillo, P.J.Ch., denied an application for emergent injunctive relief filed by the owners of Lady Shadow, seeking to enjoin The Meadowlands from refusing the entry of the mare in Saturday's (Aug. 5) Lady Liberty.

On July 29, the Meadowlands announced Lady Shadow, an earner of \$1,915,777 and the 2016 Dan Patch Award winner as champion pacing mare, was barred from racing at the Meadowlands after a post-race test at Harrah's Philadelphia on May 28 came back positive for Clenbuterol.

According to the ruling issued by the Pennsylvania Horse Racing Commission, "Ronald Adams as trainer is in violation of PHRC medication rules and the trainer responsibility rule. Mr. Adams has waived his hearing before the Judges and will appeal the ruling to the Racing Commission. All purse money earned on 5/28/2017 must be returned and redistributed. Transfers of horses must be approved by the Judges at Harrah's Chester or by the PHRC.

"As a result of the finding that Lady Shadow was found to have unacceptable levels of Clenbuterol when she raced at Harrah's Philadelphia and the split sample came back positive, the owners have been advised that the horse will not be allowed to race in the upcoming stake at the Meadowlands," said Meadowlands chairman Jeffrey Gural.

On Monday (Aug. 1), the SBOA of New Jersey, on behalf of its horsepeople, released a statement saying, "While the SBOA applauds and supports the efforts to protect the integrity of the sport, it cannot agree with this decision. Lady Shadow had a Class 3 overage for a therapeutic medication. The ruling is under appeal, with a stay granted by the Pennsylvania Racing Commission. The SBOA believes Lady Shadow's owners are entitled to due process and no action should be taken pending the outcome of the legal proceedings."

Hambletonian Day wagering information

A Pick Five carrying a \$50,000 guaranteed pool will begin the program covering Races 1-5. It will also offer a 50¢ minimum wager with 15 per cent takeout rate.

There will also be a special Oaks-Hambletonian daily double on Races 12 and 13.

10-cent superfectas will be offered on every race with the regular win, place, show, exacta and trifecta also available every race.

A total of 14 stakes races will be contested on the card with 10 of them featuring field sizes of 10 or more horses.

Post time is noon.

TVG will provide full-card coverage and offer horseplayers its popular "Money Back Special" on all 16 races. Live network coverage will air on CBS Sports Network from 4-5:30 p.m.


