# Imperfect Hambletonian goes to Perfect Spirit

It took a judges' inquiry to elevate Perfect Spirit and trainer/driver Ake Svanstedt to victory in the 92nd Hambletonian after What The Hill was disqualified for interference in the stretch of Saturday's \$1 million event.

Perfect Spirit became the first Hambletonian champion to win via disqualification after judges took down What The Hill, the first horse across the wire, for interference in the stretch in Saturday's \$1 million final at the Meadowlands Racetrack in New Jersey.

That gave the victory to 58-year-old trainer/driver Ake Svanstedt and Swedish owner Lennart Agren's SRF Stable and left both What The Hill's driver David Miller and trainer Ron Burke winless in the Hambletonian.

"It was a tough break," Miller said after judges placed What The Hill ninth.

Agren said when the inquiry sign was still posted he had resigned himself to being second, "even though we thought it was quite clear that (What The Hill) should be disqualified.

That's racing. I've been disqualified with horses before."

Perfect Spirit first overcame having the 10-hole in his elimination earlier in the day to finish third, two lengths back of winner Enterprise. Then Perfect Spirit claimed victory, despite finishing a half-length behind What The Hill at the wire, when judges ruled Miller interfered with Guardian Angel AS (Jason Bartlett), who made a break and finished ninth.

Agren said it was an odd way to win a Hambletonian, but he and Svanstedt had good fortune on their side on Saturday.

"You have to have luck," the owner said. "He had post 10 and we were a little bit sad for that, but it turned out okay."

Perfect Spirit, a son of Andover Hall—Good Common Cents was purchased by Agren for \$75,000 at the 2015 Harrisburg yearling sale under the name Grill Hanover.

"I didn't like the name... so we changed it," Agren said. "I had another proposal for the name Free Spirit, but that was taken already, so we went with Perfect Spirit."

Svanstedt left from the six hole in the final and led at every call through fractions of :27.1, :56, 1:25.1 and won in 1:52.3.

"I thought it was a good tactic, but I thought somebody would come and take the lead from him, but they didn't," Agren said. "He really did the race himself. It's not often that you see a horse that leads all the way in the Hambletonian. That never happens."

You also rarely see two judges' inquiries in the Hambletonian.

International Moni, who won the first elimination, was sent

off as the bettors' second choice in the final, but made a break in the first turn that the judges also examined for possible interference.

It was the first Hambletonian victory for Svanstedt and Agren, who said he is pleased with the improvement he's seen in Perfect Spirit in recent weeks.

"He raced well today, but the last month he has come forward quite a bit, the last three or four races. The horse is

in form, at the right time," said Svanstedt, who moved his stable to the United States from Sweden four years ago.

"He's a nice horse to work with. He feels like a big horse when he comes to the racetrack, but a home he's like a cheap horse."

Perfect Spirit paid \$17, \$6.40 and \$5.40 for his fifth win in nine starts this season.


moved up to second and Enterprise (\$4) was placed third. The final two checks went to Bill's Man and Victory Gio It.

# Ariana G dominates; Takter and Gingras win fourth straight Oaks

Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld's opted not to race their homebred trotting filly against the boys in the Hambletonian and the result was an impressive victory.

never wavered.

As Yannick Gingras left the Hambletonian Oaks winner's circle with Ariana G to take her back to the paddock, he spotted the homebred filly's part-owner Marvin Katz and shouted, "You still made the right call."

The driver was referring to the decision of the connections to race Ariana G in the \$500,000 Oaks, rather than against the boys in the \$1 million Hambletonian. Katz just grinned and gave Gingras a thumbs up. After all, the way Ariana G destroyed the Oaks field — winning by four-and-three-quarter lengths in 1:51.2 — one had to wonder how she would have fared against the boys. Even watching Ariana G pull away in the stretch, Katz said he

"Once we made the decision, that was it. I was comfortable that was the right decision," Katz said. "We really vacillated, we went back and forth, and it was a difficult challenge. We left it to the smartest guy in the operation Jimmy Takter and he made the decision for us."

Katz, who shares Ariana G's ownership with Al Libfeld, said the fact the Hambletonian is raced in same-day heats was a consideration.

As for Takter, it was his fourth straight Hambletonian Oaks victory.

"I don't think about that too much," Takter said of his accomplishment. "I think about each individual horse coming

up, you know. But she's fantastic, she's a really good filly... She's the kind of horse that it doesn't matter, she's tough to get by. She's really hard. She fights to the death."

Sent off at 1-5, Ariana G was moved to the lead at the half-mile mark at :54.4 and then cruised to victory, also the fourth straight Oaks victory for Gingras.


"I was really concerned about Magic Presto and obviously you have to respect the competition," said Gingras. "When he got away on the first turn and I really didn't want to be first over that long of the way, so I decided to do whatever I needed to do to get her to the front. It wasn't the best move I think, but she is just a great horse and a great horse can overcome anything."

Arianna G's full sister, All The Time, won the Oaks last year with a time of 1:52.1.

"That's about as excited I've been in a race,"Katz said of Ariana G. "We've had some phenomenal victories. With all the hoopla in the build up to it, obviously, it just felt like it put more pressure on the whole thing and you know with the history, of course, to win the Hambletonian Oaks twice back to back, with full sisters that we bred ourselves. It's an extraordinary accomplishment and one that I'm going to cherish forever."

Magic Presto with Brain Sears finished second paying \$3.00 and \$2.40, and Dream Together with Daniel Dube finished third paying \$2.60. Dream Baby Dream finished fourth. Feed Your Head was fifth.







# **Hambletonian Day had it all**

From superstar efforts to the "DQ", once again Hambletonian Day was anything but dull.

I think Hambletonian Day 2017 was one of the most compelling I've seen in some time. We had not only a wide-open Hambletonian, where most could not even tell you who the post time favorite for the final was going to be, but also 15 other contests; many of which looked competitive.

Please allow me to count down a few things that happened Saturday afternoon that caught my eye; perhaps they caught your eye, too.

# The "DQ"


We might as well get this out of the way first, right?

First off, in my view the judges did exactly what they were supposed to do – disqualify a horse that clearly interfered with another horse. It didn't matter that Jason Bartlett's colt was backing up, or Perfect Spirit was drifting a little. It was a perfectly fine disqualification.

But it doesn't mean we have to like it.

What the Hill, after a very subpar elimination, was driven masterfully (save for one brief nanosecond) by David Miller, and was trained up perfectly by Ron Burke. He was like a new horse in the Final, and he deserved a better fate.





#### **Harness Racing Update**



I type this, taking nothing away from the connections of Perfect Spirit. Rules are rules, and they're there for a reason. Perfect Spirit's name is on the Hambletonian trophy, exactly as it should be. I'm as elated for them, as I am disappointed for Ron and David.

#### The five-alarm fire

I'll ask Ariana G and Perfect Spirit to forgive me in advance, but I thought the most riveting performance of the day was from Brian Brown's Blazin' Britches in the Shady Daisy. The daughter of Rock n' Roll Heaven took the lead in a scorching half (with her ears pricked, like she was barely breaking a sweat) and went on to make a few pretty nice fillies look very ordinary in a ridiculous final time. I'm so excited to see what she has in store for us next.

# The great ones can have a day off and still be great

Hannelore Hanover is 21 for her last 26, and looks capable any given race of tripping the timer in sub-1:50. She certainly never looks like she's not a safe bet for a minus show pool. But she was not quite herself, and the boxcar payoffs followed. This game is never predictable, and Hannelore's loss was another disappointment for the Burke brigade.

# Hindsight is 20/20

Ariana G romped in the Oaks, and did so with authority in a sparkling 1:51.2. She's pretty incredible.

The Oaks, of course, immediately followed the two Hambletonian eliminations, which did not go nearly that fast. As one bettor quipped on twitter, "she'd be 3-5 in the Hambletonian Final." And he was probably right.

You never know what the right decision is (or was) with a filly like that, and a bird in the hand is worth two in the bush. But, 3-5 in the Hambletonian Final sure has a nice ring to it.

# Ake says "Take That!"

There are three truisms of social media: One, you'll

probably know what someone thinks of Donald Trump, two, sooner or later you'll tune that out, and three, if someone drives a horse questionably, you'll hear about it, a lot.

Last week, after Ake Svanstedt's drive with Resolve in the Spirit of Massachusetts Trot, the social media channels lit up like a Christmas tree. This week, after Resolve's textbook victory in the Cashman, and Ake's perfect drive in the Hambletonian with Perfect Spirit, the ship turned.

As my old track friend used to say, "sometimes you're the bug, sometimes you're the windshield." Ake was the windshield today. He drove like a champ.

# **Takter Country**

By now you've read all about Jim Takter's big day with the trotters, but how about that pacer of his, Pure Country? This remarkably good filly was zero for six this year and we were beginning to wonder if she'd ever win a race in 2017. In the Lady Liberty she dug in like the game horse she is, all the while holding off another bearcat in Nike Franco. I'm happy for her, Diamond Creek and all the connections. What a fun mare to watch.

# Sam's first was a good one

Always B Miki and Wiggle It Jiggleit battles were fun, yes, but is there a better division to watch and wager than the older pacers? It seems any given week about five or six may get the job done.

In the inaugural Sam McKee, the very hard luck Check Six motored off cover for Burke and Gingras and took all the chocolates.

I have this weird feeling that Sam would've been happy with that win. It was a wide open, fun race, and with the disappointment of the Hambletonian result for the Burkes, it put a smile on some faces who likely needed it.

## The Hambletonian delivers the goods

Total domestic handle for the Hambletonian card was \$5.78 million, up about two per cent from last year. This is a solid number, especially since the underlying handle numbers across harness racing are down thus far this season.

Pool size is an issue for a lot of harness racing tracks, but yesterday we saw a Pick 5 pool of \$99,434; Late Pick 4 pool of \$101,769; and the 8th race Pick 3 handled \$23,666.

Attendance was over 18,000, proving once again, there are few days in harness racing like Hambletonian Day.

# Blazin Britches smokes to 1:48.4 track record

With a win in the Shady Daisy, she equalled the mark for sophomore pacing fillies held by Agent Q and Dancinwiththestarz.

Bruce Trogdon said he knew Blazin Britches was primed for a big mile on the big track. That's why her owner and breeder said he and trainer Brian Brown decided at the last minute to put her in Saturday's \$113,950 Shady Daisy for 3-year-old fillies at the Meadowlands.

"We weren't going for the track record, but I just knew to win the race it might be the track record," said Trogdon, owner of Emerald Highlands Farm of Mount Vernon, OH.

Blazin Britches cruised home to a 1:48.4 victory, breaking the stakes record of 1:49.1 set last year by Darlinonthebeach, with an impressive four and three-quarter length victory over Caviart Alley.

The 1:48.4 clocking matched the track record for three-year-old fillies shared by Dancinwiththestarz (2010) and Agent Q (2017).

Driven by David Miller, the 1-5 favorite, went three-wide prior to the half-mile pole, taking control, and coasting to the her fourth straight victory, paying her backers \$2.60, 2.40, and 2.10.

The 13-1 longshot Caviart Alley, driven by Andrew McCarthy, paid \$4.40 and \$2.60 for second and 2-1 second-choice Idyllic Beach, last year's Dan Patch Award winner for best two-year-old female pacer, completed the payouts, with \$2.10 for third, five and three-quarter lengths back.

"Britches had an abscess on her foot and some issues or people would have heard about her earlier," Trogdon said. "We showed her to the world at The Adios and Trace Tetrick – he's been her driver. He taught her lessons and he's had a lot to do with this. He's driving horses back (in Indiana) and we let David (Miller) drive, because it's good for everybody. She's a great filly, just the fastest that I've ever owned. It was just getting her together to show what she could do."

Brown said Blazin Britches' team was ready to go to the Fan Hanover "and she popped a gravel (in her foot). I give credit to her groom Kim Carruthers and the grooms at Bruce's farm, they got her finally to pop it. That took two weeks and took us right out the Fan Hanover and the Lynch. We thought she was a good horse, but I can't tell you I thought she was this good."

The daughter of Rock N Roll Heaven out of Soggy Britches is a part of an equine family Trogdon has long owned.

"Soggy Britches, was a really good mare and made a couple hundred thousand. She was a big and tough mare. She gets her good looks, partly from Rock N Roll Heaven, but she looks just like her mother," Trogdon said. "The next dam, the grandmother, Soggy Dragon, died earlier in her career, but she lived long enough to have a couple of foals. She was a beautiful grey filly that I bought at the Harrisburg sale as a weanling. So we've had the family for a long time.

"(Blazin Britches) was fabulous just to look at her. Like, one day old and you thought, 'Wow."

Trogdon, who also owned top-rated sophomore pacing colt Fear The Dragon, said he has joked about retirement.

"I told Brian Brown in the winner's circle of The Adios last week, 'Maybe I should retire right now because I'm never going to have a day like this one again," Trogdon said.

"My broodmare band is really good, just because I've been doing it for 40 years... these are not big time, high-priced horses, but they are nice horses. I've been culling and every year adding a couple and the last few years the broodmare band has just sort of matured and I've got some nice foals coming... but I never won this much until I got connected with Brian Brown. I think it's been about three years. I'm Mr. Take Care Of The Horse and Brian trains them and when we came together, it's been a really good team."

You Know You Do overtook stablemate Samo Different Day in the stretch to win Saturday's \$360,650 Peter Haughton Memorial Stakes for 2-year-old male trotters in 1:54.2, the fourth race at the Meadowlands Racetrack.

Samo Different Day held on for second in a photo over Farsetti Hanover. The margin of victory was two and a quarter lengths.

You Know You Do, driven by Yannick Gingras, started a first-over bid on the backstretch against fraction-setting Samo Different Day, who led the field to the quarter in 28, half in 56.1 and three-quarters in 1:25.3, and was alongside the leader as the field exited the final turn. He won for the third time in four races for trainer Jimmy Takter.

The colt was a \$350,000 purchase at the Standardbred Horse Sale. He is owned by Howard Taylor, Order By Stable, Bud Hatfield, and the partnership of Marvin Katz, Al Libfeld,

and Sam Goldband.

"His pedigree is the same cross as Bar Hopping and his conformation was impeccable," Libfeld said. "Everyone wanted a piece of him and we made it happen. It's great to have friends, winning good races."

"We have 80 to 90 per cent fillies, 10 per cent colts," Katz added. "(But) he was very, very special. We'll look for colts here and there that we think could be exceptional. It's really a policy of pursuing excellence and we thought he could fit that category."

You Know You Do, sent off as the 3-2 favorite, paid \$5.00, \$3.00 \$3.00 to win. He pushed his career earnings to \$206,932. More importantly, it puts him on a path toward next year's Hambletonian.

"It sets the table with some serious credentials," Libfeld said. "The money is not hard to take, either, so we are about winning the big races and also breeding horses. We can never have too many top stallions."



# **Game Huntsville wins Cane Pace**

Huntsville got to the lead in the first turn and never looked back, winning Saturday's \$334,325 Cane Pace for three-year-old pacers by a neck over R J P in 2:03 at the extended distance of 1-1/8 miles at the Meadowlands Racetrack.

Downbytheseaside was third.

Starting from post one in a field of 12, Huntsville and driver Tim Tetrick outdueled longshot Lawrencetown Beach for the lead as the field entered the first turn and reached the quarter in :25.4. Lawrencetown Beach remained parked out on the backstretch, with Downbytheseaside on the pylons in third, as Huntsville hit the half in :54.

R J P made a three-wide move around Lawrencetown Beach and moved into second as the group neared three-quarters, which was reached in 1:21.4. Huntsville and R J P battled through the stretch, timed in 1:49 for a mile, with Huntsville prevailing for his seventh win in 10 starts this year.

"He showed some toughness today," winning trainer Ray Schnittker said. "After the first quarter I was a little concerned and (R J P) eyeballed him, but he's just a very good horse.

"I don't think they were going to beat us today."

Just how tough is Huntsville compared to other horses Schnittker has had?

"He's moving up the ranks a lot," the trainer said. "I had Covert Action, he was a great horse years ago, but (Huntsville is) right there."

Schnittker co-owns Huntsville with Ted Gewertz, Steve Arnold, and Crawford Farms Racing. The colt is a homebred son of Somebeachsomewhere out of the mare Wild West Show.

"Any time you have a top horse it feels great because the lesser ones outnumber the greater ones and the great ones have to pay for all the others," Gewertz said. "So, it's a relief when you have one like this, though, you are more or less holding your breath... hoping they don't get him. Sometimes he holds them off and sometime they just nip him so you don't know what's going to happen."

Huntsville has won 14 of 21 career races and never finished worse than second. He has earned \$1.58 million.

"I hope he goes the rest of the year like that," Schnittker said. "I'd be very happy."

The Cane Pace is the first jewel in the Pacing Triple Crown. "At \$300,000, I think it's good," Schnittker said. "Any time

you win at the Meadowlands it's exciting."

The remaining two legs are the Little Brown Jug and Messenger. Schnittker said Huntsville would not go to the Little Brown Jug.

"He's not eligible," Schnittker said.

Huntsville paid \$3.40, \$2.60, \$2.10. RJP returned \$5.40, \$2.60. Downbytheseaside paid \$2.10.

# Pasithea Face S goes from Sweden to Hambletonian Day winner's circle

Pasithea Face S and Tim Tetrick won the \$176,250 Dr. John Steele Memorial for trotting mares by two lengths in 1:51.2 Saturday at The Meadowlands. It was her first win in the United States.

Emoticon Hanover, driven by Daniel Dube, got to the lead in a time of :27.3 for the first quarter, but were soon overtaken by Hannelore Hanover (Yannick Gingras), who had the lead at the :54.4 half, before Pasithea Face S came up to challenge at about the five eighths mile mark. Those two trotted together around the final turn and in to the stretch, with Emoticon Hanover looking to squeeze up the rail.

Pasithea Face trotted on to the wire with mild urging for the win by two lengths, paying \$9.60, \$6.00, \$15.20. Caprice Hill (\$15.60, \$41.60) got up for second and Emoticon Hanover (\$23.00) was third.

"This horse is really strong," said Anders Strom, who races the five-year-old mare under his stable name of Courant, Inc., "I thought she would do great by the mile track and so did her trainer, Lutfi Kolgini in Sweden. We are friends with (trainer) Jimmy (Takter), so of course this is a great option to come over and try to get a big record for her before she goes to the breeding barn."

Pasithea Face races in the red and gold silks of her owner, designed for a simple reason, said Strom, "It's because my mom can't really find my horses in the race, so that's why we wear this color for the horse.

"We have this style in France, the owner's colors, and I think it's a good thing because the fans of a certain stable can follow it easier. Of course, the drivers moan about it, but I guess they are going to have to do if they are going to (want the drives)."

Tetrick said he got to drive Pasithea Face S two weeks ago, not long after the mare arrived in the United States from Sweden.

"I got to drive her two weeks ago (in a second place finish in the Ms. Versatility) and I just loved her," said Tetrick. "It was her first start here and thought we'd go nice and easy with her and she trotted strong to the wire. She did her job today. Hannelore Hanover was the one to beat today. She didn't have the best day, but take nothing away from my mare, she was awesome."

Odds on favorite Hannelore Hanover faded to fourth.

The 12-horse field was led to the first quarter by Resolve, who hit the first quarter :26.3, with Crazy Wow (Yannick Gingras) behind them. Those two led the field to the :55.1 half when Marion Marauder (Scott Zeron) came up to challenge on the outside, just before the 1:22.3 three quarters, around the final turn, and took the second spot away from Crazy Wow. Resolve trotted away from the field in the homestretch for the win.

Resolve returned \$7.00, \$4.00 and \$3.80. Marion Marauder, paying \$4.00, \$3.00, was second and Lookslikeachpndale returned \$14.20 in third with Daniel Dube driving.

"[Marion Marauder] was the horse to beat before the race," said Svanstadt. "But Resolve was good enough."

Asked if Resolve was as good as Sebastian K, "Not yet, It's hard to beat [1]:49," he said.

In the stretch, Check Six and driver Yannick Gingras fanned three-wide and powered to victory.

Check Six has won two of 12 races this year and 17 of 45 in his career, with earnings of \$1.38 million. The son of Somebeachsomewhere—Southwind Vanna is trained by Ron Burke and owned by Burke Racing, the partnership of Mark Weaver and Mike Bruscemi, Bill Switala, and Jim Martin.

"I thought I had a chance to get a good piece," Gingras said. "I thought this horse has a lot of bad luck. The last time he raced here he had post 11 and he never saw daylight. I was running over top of horses in the stretch. He's had a lot of troubled trips, but I thought he was sitting on a big one and he was."

Check Six paid \$79.00, \$23.80 and \$8.60. Mel Mara paid \$3.20 and \$2.60. Mach It So paid \$3.00.

The McKee Memorial, formerly the U.S. Pacing Championship, honors the late Meadowlands Racetrack announcer and Communicators Hall of Fame member Sam McKee, who passed away earlier this year.

Nike Franco N started a first-over drive prior to three-quarters and was alongside Pure Country when they hit the marker in 1:22.2.

The two mares raced side-by-side the rest of the way, with Pure Country putting her head in front at the wire.

"She's a really good mare, I'm very fortunate to pick up the drive," said winning driver Mark MacDonald, who sat behind Pure Country for the first time in her career. "That was a really brave, courageous effort down the stretch to fight off (Nike Franco N). She was actually beat. Halfway down the stretch Nike Franco had her headed. She's just so game and gutsy that she dug back in and stuck her head out and got there for me."

Pure Country, a Dan Patch Award winner at ages 2 and 3, won for the first time in seven races this year, although she had three second-place finishes.

"She's a fantastic filly," winning trainer Jimmy Takter said. "We ran into a lot of problems with her. She got sick and stuff like that."

Takter credited former driver Brett Miller for suggesting a driver change.

"He's such a class guy," Takter said.

"This filly fits Mark's style. He drove a great race. I was very happy for Mark."

Pure Country is owned by her breeder, Diamond Creek Racing. She has won 21 of 38 career races and earned \$1.9 million.

Pure Country paid \$10.40, \$3.20 and \$2.60. Nike Franco N, the 2-5 favorite, paid \$2.10 and \$2.10. Penpal paid \$3.20.

# Heavy favorite Manchego stays undefeated with Doherty win

"She is a really special girl. We liked her from the get go and she keeps developing and certainly has a very effective way of going and has a tremendous inner-strength that few horses have," said Takter, who recorded his fifth win in the Doherty, formerly named the Merrie Annabelle.
