Defying the Odds, a Bad Back and a Lackluster Start to Her Year, Mission Brief is the One to Beat in the Hambletonian By Bill Finley

Just a month ago Ron Burke wasn't worried about whether he'd be going in the Hambletonian or the Hambletonian Oaks with filly Mission Brief. He didn't figure either one was a possibility.

"Everyone is saying Hambletonian or Hambletonian Oaks and I'm thinking I'll see you in the fall at Lexington," Burke said. "This was a mess."

Mission Brief became the fastest 2-year-old trotter, of either sex, in history, a feat she achieved last year when going in 1:50.3 at the Red Mile. That race, the International Stallion Stakes, left little doubt who the leading candidate for next year's Hambletonian was at the time. Filly or

no filly, Mission Brief was simply a lot faster and more talented than her male rivals.

But getting her from that day to the point where she'll be favored in a heat of the Hambletonian Saturday, turned out to be one of the most difficult experiences of Burke's career. And it's something he once thought would never happen.

Mission Brief won the first two starts of her 3-year-old season, in New Jersey sire stakes events, but even in victory it was clear there was something wrong with her. She was far from smooth as she made her way around the Meadowlands and her times were far from impressive. She won in 1:53.4 and then in 1:54.3. Burke knew something was wrong, but what?

Eventually, Burke got to the bottom of the issue, figuring out that the filly was suffering from back problems. Still, he had no idea if he could get her right by Hambletonian Day.

It wasn't until Burke called in Dr. James Mitchell that things began to turn a corner. Mitchell was brought in after Mission Brief won a qualifier on July 3 at the Meadowlands, a performance Burke called "terrible."

"He came in, adjusted her, injected into her spine and joints," Burke said. "You're wondering is this just hocus pocus?"

In her first start after the treatments began Mission Brief finished second, beaten by a nose, in the Del Miller. Other

than when breaking stride it was the first loss of her career, but Burke felt it was a major step in the right direction.


"The first time we trained her after (her back treatments) she was better," Burke said. "And then we raced her and she was definitely better still. The next time we trained her I thought 'We got it now.' Every time we've gone with her since then she keeps getting better and better and reminds you of herself."

Burke still hadn't made up his mind about the Hambletonian on the morning of July 26. He wanted to see what Mission Brief would do that afternoon when facing fillies in the Zweig at Vernon Downs. In what was clearly her best start of 2015, she dominated the field, winning by two lengths in 1:51.4. For the first time all year, she looked every bit as good as the Mission Brief of 2014.

It took Burke a few hours after the Zweig to make his decision. Ultimately, he reverted to the mind-set he had last year when he was convinced that if his horse was right, no trotter in her age group could touch her.

"I didn't look at it like I've got a filly and they have colts and that's a knock against our horse," Burke said. "I looked at it as can our horse trot as fast as them? I think she can out-trot any of them if she is right. I felt all along she is the

best horse. If you don't believe in your horse you might as well not even show up."

There are still some unresolved matters, namely who will drive her should she make the Hambletonian final? Yannick Gingras is also the regular driver of Pinkman, widely regarded as the best male 3-year-old, and has been given permission by Burke and Pinkman's trainer Jimmy Takter to forego his decision until after the elims. Burke doesn't seem worried about it.

"Yannick is not impossible to replace," Burke said. "She's a great horse and great horses can be driven by anybody."

If Gingras choses Pinkman, Burke said he might go with Brian Sears. However, Sears will also drive Burke's Habitat in the elims, and should that colt make it to the final that could further muddy the driver picture.

Burke definitely could have had Gingras for the Hambletonian Oaks, a \$500,000 race where Mission Brief would have been 1-10 or lower. The Hambletonian Oaks is a rich and important race, but it's not the Hambletonian. Burke didn't lose sight of that.

"From a financial standpoint, the better bet for us was probably to go in the Hambletonian Oaks," Burke said.
"Pride-wise and for the sport, it's better to go to the Hambletonian. If we were to win the Hambletonian Oaks we'd be happy but it wouldn't change anybody's lives.
We've all done things like that before. For some of us, this would be a lifetime experience so we said the hell with it, let's go."

This will be the 90th edition of the Hambletonian and the race has been won 13 times by fillies. The last to do so was Continentalvictory in 1996. No filly has started in the Hambletonian since Pampered Princess in 2007.

It's quite possible that Mission Brief will prove to better than any of her female predecessors that have won the Hambletonian. At this point, no one knows. But this much is certain: she is very fast, is healthy again and should be hard to beat. | share this story |

Gurfein Now A Mission Brief Fan

Ron Gurfein knows something about getting a filly to win the Hambletonian. He's the last trainer to do so, winning the

Eighteen years later, will it
happen again with Mission
Brief? Gurfein believes it can.

Gurfein ruffled the feathers of Mission Brief's trainer, Ron Burke, earlier this year when he didn't place Mission Brief in his Top 5 in a preseason poll of 3-year-old trotters to

be. Gurfein later explained that he thought Mission Brief raced so fast as a 2-year-old that it was bound to cost her at three.


"When you look at a standardbred or a thoroughbred, their bone density is so weak at two," Gurfein said. "Just by racing at two you're bound to suffer somewhat down the road, and you can really suffer when you go as fast as she did."

For that reason, Gurfein predicted Mission Brief would have an off year at three.

"I don't wish anybody any bad luck in this game," Gurfein said. "There's enough bad luck in this sport as there is. The bottom line is I didn't think he'd get her where she is today."

For a while, Gurfein looked right as Mission Brief came

He may not overpower his opponents but he's ultra-reliable and ultra-consistent. He's lost just one race this year. He is the top male candidate in the race and a male, presumably, should have an advantage over a filly. Unlike with Mission Brief, there's not much concern that he will break stride. By choosing him, you don't alienate top trainer Jimmy Takter.

back at a level below her 3-year-old form. But over her last two starts she has turned things around, and comes into the Hambletonian off a very strong effort in the Zweig.

Now, Gurfein not only believes Mission Brief has a chance in the Hambletonian, but is quick to give kudos to the job Burke has done.

Amid Takter, Mission Brief Mania, Don't Forget About Centurion ATM

If someone other than Jimmy Takter or Ron Burke is standing in the winner's circle Saturday after the Hambletonian it's likely to be Åke Svanstedt.

Svanstedt's Centurion ATM looks like the main threat to the sport's two most powerful stables, Burke and Takter, in Saturday's Hambletonian.

The horse turned some heads last out when he finished second behind The Bank in the Stanley Dancer after breaking stride. The break cost Centurion ATM a good 10 lengths. He only lost by a length.

"Of course we were disappointed he lost the race because of the break, but we saw we had a horse who is a tremendous horse and his form is getting better and better," said Svanstedt's

assistant Bernie Noren. "He just took a wrong step. He had never broke before in his life and he's never going to break again. There's nothing to worry about. He never does it, so why should he do it again? It was one misstep and any horse can have one misstep in life. Fortunately, it was not a big race that he did it in."

Centurion ATM showed some promise last year winning the Peter Haughton (watch the race here) on Hambletonian Day, but didn't exactly come back strong this year. He lost his first three races this year, including a Pennsylvania sire stakes race, before the Dancer. But the Dancer was definitely an indication that he is back on top of his game.

"He is a great horse and he is a great race horse," Noren, said. "He loves to race. Training-wise he never gets really tired. He's not a standout in training, but when he sees the gate he's a great race horse."

Before settling in the U.S., Svanstedt was among the top trainers in Sweden and he has won important races all over the world. The Hambletonian, though, would be an important addition to his record.

"It would be one of the great achievements of his career," Noren said. "I know Ake is very focused on this race Saturday and if he can win it will be one of his greatest memories ever. He has won a lot of big races in Sweden,

Between Svanstedt, Jimmy Takter, Nancy Johansson, Staffan Lind and Jonas Czernyson, 12 of the 19 entrants in the Hambletonian were born in Sweden.

"Harness racing in Sweden is very big," Noren said. "The big races draw big crowds. This Saturday a lot of people will follow the Hambletonian with over half the field trained by people born in Sweden. It will be a huge day for Swedish harness racing. After Cane, Wiggle Might Try Older Horses Bv Bill Finlev

Owner George Teague Jr. has been extra careful all year not to be overconfident or to slight his competition, but

deep down he surely knows that Saturday's Cane Pace at the Meadowlands doesn't figure to be much of a challenge for his 3-year-old Wiggle It Jiggleit. He'll be facing the same horses he has been beating all year, and the only horse to ever defeat him. Wakizashi Hanover, will pass the \$319,400

But there might be a more difficult challenge ahead for the sport's No. 1 ranked horse as Teague said earlier this week that he is entertaining the thought of taking on older horses at some point this vear.

"One thing I would love to do, if he is still fresh, is try one shot at the aged pacers," Teague said.

There's little doubt he could handle the assignment as the older male pacing set is not particularly tough this year and Wiggle It Jiggleit is not only in a class by himself among 3-year-olds but is a horse that never has a bad day. As the year progresses his ability to hold up to the grind of a long racing season is becoming almost as notable as his raw talent. The Cane will be his 16th start this year, a year, for him, that started way back on Jan. 25 at Dover Downs.

"What separates him from a lot of other horses is his stamina to race week in and week out," Teague said. "When it comes to that he has shown to be as good as any horse to ever race. And I'm hoping he can go on that way through October and November. I don't see any weakness in him today versus where he was when we started with him in January.

"I'm not trying to sound like I know it all but I've been down this road a few times. I don't think this horse needs pampering. The horse is telling me exactly what he wants to do. Honestly, I think I could race into high the 20s when it comes to the number of starts in a year and maybe into the 30s."

Considering how hard he has been going, Wiggle It Jiggleit will come into the Cane off a relative vacation. He has not raced for three weeks, but competed six straight weeks before that. He would have had a longer break if not supplementing into the Cane at a cost of \$35,000. Teague has been having some second thoughts about the move.

"There's a little bit of a downside to this," he said. "I thought I was putting up \$35,000 to go for \$400,000," he said. "If things don't work out and he finishes third I break even. I don't make one dollar off this race. For \$400,000 it seemed the real logical thing to do. If I knew the purse was \$300,000 I don't think I would have gone. But I am sort of glad I did. To race on Hambletonian Day is special. The only kicker is that I just wish they were going for another \$100,000. But that's neither here nor there now. He's in the box."

After the Cane, Wiggle It Jiggleit will make his next start just six days later in the Carl Milstein at Northfield. Teague is also planning on going to the Battle of Brandywine at Pocono Downs and likely to the Little Brown Jug. He will also have to supplement to the Jug.

Wiggle It Jiggleit will likely be the shortest priced favorite on the Hambletonian Day card. Coming off a win in the Adios, Dude's The Man may be the second choice. He was second behind Wiggle It in the Crawford Farms Meadowlands Pace. Artspeak and In The Arsenal are top horses but neither performed at their best in their last starts.

When asked if this was an easy sport for his horse, Teague replied: "Once I started thinking like that it's a quick set up for disaster. I still think this is a great group of horses. I still like Artspeak and In The Arsenal and Dude's The Man finished second in the Meadowlands Pace and then won the Adios in a great mile. That horse is legit. Even though Wakizashi isn't in there there are four or five horses that you can count on giving us stiff competition. I am not taking anything lightly.

Rockin in Heaven, Artistic Major Lead 156G NYSS Armand Palatucci Pace

Publicity Director, Empire City @ Yonkers Raceway YONKERS, NY (August 6, 2015) - Yonkers Raceway Thursday night hosted the \$166,874 New York Sire Stakes Armand Palatucci Pace for 3-year-old colts and geldings. The event went in two divisions, worth \$84,187 of

\$82,687, respectively.

The first division saw Rock in Heaven (Dave Miller, \$5.30) last on the lead and win a three-horse photo. Leaving from post position No. 2, Rock in Heaven worked around 7-5 favorite Betting Exchange (Jim Morrill Jr.), then put up intervals of :28.1, :57.4; 1:26.2 and 1:53.2.

He held off a closing Soto (Dan Dube) by a nose, with Betting Exchange beaten in neck from the pocket.

For second choice Rockin in Heaven, a Rocknroll Heaven colt co-owned by (trainer) Dr. Ian Moore, Douglas Polley, Francois Lecomte and Gordon McComb, it was his sixth win in a dozen seasonal starts. The exacta paid \$56.50, with the triple returning \$124.50.

"He only does as much as he to," Miller said of the winner, and, for that matter, the author.

Thursday night's second Palatucci grouping was not for the squeamish, as the state's glamour division was anything but glamorous.

After Cartoon Daddy (Matt Kakaley) broke behind the gate, Penji Hanover (Tim Tetrick) misbehaved in the first turn. That indiscretion impeded Arque Hanover (Brian Sears), while A Bettor Hat (Tyler Buter), not wanting to be left out, also broke.

Meanwhile, 17-10 favorite Artistic Major (Morrill Jr.), bothered by all that fun from post No. 5, did gather himself. He slipped in behind pole-sitting My Spirit Soars (Dube) as that one led through early intervals of :28.4 and :57.4. Artistic Hanover thought about pulling pocket, but relented. My Spirit Soars then saw a three-holed

Americanprimetime (Jason Bartlett) move to the lead at the 1:26.1 three-quarters, taking a half-length advantage into the lane. Artistic Hanover edged out to chase that one and, despite drifting, went by easily.

The final margin was two lengths in 1:54, with Penji Hanover crossing the line third. He was then set down to sixth for his earlier transgression, mobbing My Spirit Soars from fourth to third.

For Artistic Major, an Art Major colt owned by (trainer) Steve Elliott, David Van Dusen, Michael Cimiglio, and Gunjan Patel, he's now 3-for-8 this season. The exacta paid \$70, with the triple returning \$519.

Whenuwishuponastar To L A Delight Courtesy of Woodbine Entertainment

L A Delight extended her winning streak to four-in-a-row thanks to a dominant performance in Thursday's \$36,800 final of the Whenuwishuponastar Series for two-year-old pacing fillies.

Randy Waples got away second with L A Delight, who stalked Shes Lights Out to the quarter pole in :28.2 before popping the pocket and taking command. L A Delight cleared to the top with the greatest of ease and she controlled the tempo through middle panels of :58 and 1:26.1. She kicked home in :27.3 to win by 4-1/4 lengths over Bad Lightning. Third prize went to Shes Lights Out.

"It looked like that (a training mile), but take them however you get them," said Al McIntosh, co-owner of L A Delight following the race. "We are very pleased with the way she's coming now and it looks like better things could be ahead."

Bob McIntosh trains the homebred daughter of Bettors Delight-West Of L A for Robert McIntosh Stables Inc, C S X Stable and Al McIntosh Holdings Inc. The victory improved her record to 4-0-1 from five assignments and the lion's share of the loot lifted her earnings to \$70,080.

Thursday's card also featured the opening leg of the Define The World Series for two-year-old trotters, and Bucketlist Hanover snuck up the rail late to win the lone division in 1:57 for driver Randy Waples.

The Brad Maxwell trainee got away fifth and he held that position while race favourite threw down first-half fractions of :29.2 and :59. Blenheim was still in charge at the three-quarter pole in 1:28.1, but he drifted on the rail in the lane allowing Waples to shoot through with Bucketlist Hanover. The colt fired home in :27.4 and won by a half-length margin over stablemate Deep Impact. Lean Hanover rounded out the Triactor ticket.

The son of Cantab Hall-Bar Queen, who was sent off at odds of 11-1, races for Maxwell and Van Camp Trotting Corp of Port Perry, ON. The colt was purchased for \$11,000 from last year's Harrisburg Yearling Sale. He's a full-brother to Barham Hanover (1:57 - \$376,011).

This Hambo Day: More Than Just About Watching the Horses

If you are reading Harness Racing Update, I'm pretty sure you know what Saturday is - Hambo Day. Every year it's probably the card many of you, (it is for me) are most looking forward to, for any number of reasons. It truly is old time harness racing; raced in the afternoon; with trotters - the staple of this sport; in heats. It has all the best horses, the best drivers, the best trainers. The crowds are huge, trackside entertainment is tops. There's just so much great about Hambo Day.

This year, however, there's more to it.

For most big days in harness racing, the prevailing thought - since perhaps the Wilson administration - has been about juicing purses and filling an entry box. The horses will come, and so will the people. If a leg of the Holmes has six horses, so be it. If we have a total chalk pick 5, so what. If 12 of 13 races have 3-5 morning line horses, well, it's Hambo Day, who cares? This year that is simply not part of the elixir. The team at the Big M has done their duty, not only for the fans and insiders, but for the people who pay the takeout - customers.

The shortest field on the entire card has nine entrants. The Lady Liberty, to kick off the first 15% juice pick 4, has 11; the Fresh Yankee, 11; the Cashman, 12; the Ackerman 11. According to Dr. Richard Thalhiemer's 1999 study on the determinants of betting handle, field size is the second

most important driver of handle, behind takeout, but ahead of number of races, and yes, purse size or quality. The Big M understands this, and they are delivering what betting customers want.

Speaking of the Cashman, the namesake for the race - a man many of you likely knew - would probably be happy with his field having 12 horses, along with the big betting enchilada on the card - the Super High Five mandatory payout. Several years before he passed, I, and a few betting friends met with John in Lexington. He wanted a bet that carried over to the Hambo card and was asking for advice. 'We

need a million dollar pool on Hambletonian Day, it's more than just about the race', he said. Seven or eight years later, it's here.

The mandatory payout super high five, to be paid out in the last race of the day (a 12-horse pace), is sure to be the race with the highest handle on the card. The carryover of \$231,403 is large, and new money will flow into the pool. It is likely that over \$1 million will end up being wagered, and at 8% takeout it will provide customers with a rare event: A negative takeout pool. Negative takeout pools are not hard to understand. It's like putting up \$50 for a coin flip and getting back \$60 if you win; like betting into a poker pot where the casino puts a \$1,000 in before you ante. It's what true bettors - whether they are betting the Seahawks, Bruins, Oakland A's, poker chips or slot machines, or horse racing - live for. And it drives massive handle.

This event should not be overlooked, or be just sloughed off as a 'gimmick'.

Super High Five pools for harness racing are becoming a branded bet. And it's a bet that people are noticing. Little Western Fair has seen handles on the bet over \$50,000 with modest carryovers. Last week Balmoral Park had a \$39,000 pool, Maywood \$26,000, the Big M's 5th race pool at low juice clicked in with close to \$10,000 with no carryover while competing with a superfecta on the same race. Let's compare that to some Thoroughbred tracks' super high five's last week - some who handle 50 times as much as Maywood on an entire card: Laurel, \$2,100, Gulfstream, \$5,300, Ellis Park, \$673.

When Thoroughbred fans see these pools, they know there's something going on in harness racing. When new fans at the Hambletonian this weekend hear about a "negative takeout pool that may reach \$1 million" some will notice, learn, and ask questions. A Times Square ad didn't do this, a commercial on CBS didn't, JHO and Jen (God Bless 'em, they do a great job) aren't making people bet into them with their good looks. This is being done with a bet; a bet that has some value for bettors.

Last week, Monmouth landed the Triple Crown winner American Pharoah for the Haskell. \$750,000 was spent to increase a purse, after what was quite the negotiation. It is likely a few more people showed up than usually would have, and it is equally likely the horse helped increase handle by a few million dollars. But it was a one-off, because Triple Crown winners don't come around too often. The people who attended the Haskell didn't bet much, with only a \$48 per capita wager (about \$3.50 a race), so these were probably not long term fans or bettors.

In contrast, this week at the Hambletonian there's great racing, great fun, great entertainment, and great horses (maybe not as great as American Pharoah, but great in their own way) just like last weekend at Monmouth. But there is something more. There's also great betting value with positive expected pools. There's a good chance some of the 25,000 or so in attendance will be staying to the end of the card, not for a face paint or band, but to handicap a harness race and make a bet.

This Hambo Day, harness racing is more big tent than it ever has been. Bettors, owners, fans, trainers, drivers, and participants all have a home.

Enjoy the day everyone. Good luck and good racing.
