All is Forgiven: Gingras Will Continue to Drive Pinkman

Not only is Jimmy Takter not mad at Yannick Gingras for choosing Mission Brief over Pinkman in the Hambletonian, he is giving the drive on the gelding back to his one-time regular pilot.

Gingras had to choose between Pinkman and Mission Brief last Saturday after both won elimination races for the Hambletonian. Gingras picked wrong and chose the filly, Mission Brief, who finished second behind Pinkman. Brian Sears picked up the winning drive on the Takter-trained Hambo winner.

That wasn't the only thing Gingras was wrong about



Hambletonian Day as he said after the race: "Pinkman is Brian's drive now. I am sure he will keep driving him."

But Takter has other ideas and said this week that when Pinkman makes his next start in the Aug. 22 Colonial at Pocono Downs that Gingras will be sitting behind him. "Yannick has been driving this horse all along," Takter noted. "Just because the situation came up with Mission Brief, that doesn't bother me. He was put in a tough situation and it wasn't an easy decision. Whatever he did, he had the chance of looking bad. He probably drove the one he thought was better. Me, personally, I thought it was a no-brainer, but he apparently didn't think that way.

"Yannick does a lot of driving for me. He's been driving this horse through most of his career so I'm not going to fuss with things."

Takter said he will "probably enter four or five" in the Colonial, but Pinkman will be the clear star of his group. With his Hambletonian win he has clearly established himself as the leading 3-year-old trotter in the country and is a serious Horse-of-the-Year candidate. Not bad for a gelding Takter was so down on, he entered him in the Harrisburg Mixed Sale last year before pulling him out.

"He has that star quality, like a great horse has," Takter said. "He's the biggest surprise horse of my life. He's a horse we castrated and put in the sale. \$1.7 million later, he's still going strong. That tells you it is not easy, this game. I'm a guy with a lot of experience and with this horse I was completely wrong. you can be wrong. That's the way it is." | share this story |

Due to Lung Infection, Father Patrick Retired By Bill Finley



Father Patrick has been retired

Father Patrick, last year's Dan Patch Award winner as the top 3-yearold male trotter, has been retired due to what trainer Jimmy Takter describes as a "deep lung infection."

After doing double duty earlier this year, training and breeding at the same time, Father Patrick returned with a bang,

beating Bee A Magician in the Maxie Lee Memorial at Chester. He did not win again, but raced well in his next two starts, finishing second behind JL Cruze both times. But he then raced poorly in the Graduate Final and the Meadowlands Maturity on July 18, where he finished last.

Takter knew he was battling some problems with Father Patrick but the full extent of them did not come to light until after the July 18 race.

"He had a deep lung infection. Very deep," Takter said. "We had him checked out at Cornell. It would take a minimum of three months to recover from it. That's just too much of a risk to take with this horse. We gave it a shot and he came back very good. The two starts against JL Cruze were not bad. The last two after that, anyone could see something was wrong with the horse.

"Eventually the lung is collapsing and they don't get oxygen. They can basically go for three quarters of a mile and after that they have no air."

Takter has said all along that Father Patrick's recent struggles have nothing to do with his being bred this year. Father Patrick retires with a record of 23 for 33 and earnings of \$2.5 million. He will continue his breeding career at Diamond Creek Farms' Pennsylvania facility. | share this story |

A Reprieve, of Sorts, for Chuck Sylvester

Jeff Gural reports that the split sample sent on a horse trained by Chuck Sylvester that tested for an elevated cobalt level also came back positive. Gural said the level was slightly lower on the split test.

With the final piece of evidence in, Gural reports that Sylvester will be allowed to compete in stakes races at his tracks through the remainder of this year but not in overnights. In 2016, Sylvester will be banned in all races at Gural's three tracks, Vernon, Tioga and the Meadowlands.

Gural said Sylvester will be permitted to re-apply for racing privileges at his tracks for the 2017 season and his application will be reevaluated at that time.

Sylvester, a Hall of Famer, has said he has no idea how the horse in question had cobalt in its system.

Wiggle It Jiggleit Looks to Get Back on Winning Track in Milstein

Owner George Teague Jr. answered the question with a laugh, a long, drawn-out laugh.

Does he think any less of Wiggle It Jiggleit after his

gelding finished fourth in the Cane Pace at the Meadowlands? Silly question or not, Teague composed himself and gave his answer: "That horse has shown greatness every time he shows up on racetrack. I think no less of him. I don't think any less of him than I have at any time this year."

Considering that Wiggle It Jiggleit had a wretched trip in the Cane, there probably won't be many doubters among the nation's horseplayers when he goes behind the gate tonight at Northfield Park in the \$405,000 Carl Milstein Memorial, but there could be a few.

After all, the Cane was the first time in the gelding's career that he has finished worse than second. A Milstein win, just six days after the Cane, would be a nice way to bounce back.

Wiggle It Jiggleit is the 3-5 morning line favorite and drew

a favorable post, the four. Regular driver Montrell Teague will again have the assignment. His main challenger in the field, the North America Cup winner Wakizashi Hanover drew post eight, an almost impossible position on a halfmile track.

"I'm sure they'd like to switch post positions with us," Teague said of Wakizashi Hanover's connections. "The six, seven, eight on any half-mile track is a difficult place to start from. But he's a good horse with a great driver (Tim Tetrick)."

Wiggle It Jiggleit is fast off the gate, which has been good news and bad news this year. In his two career losses, competitors have gone after him early and the results were costly speed duels. But Teague said he has no plans to change the horses's style.

"I don't see him taking off the gate and going backwards," Teague said. "The horse is 1-9, 1-5 every time he goes to the gate, and that's not the kind you take back off the gate or come off the pace with."

Wiggle It's trip in the Cane was particularly brutal as Montrell Teague had to use him hard in the opening quarter to outsprint Dude's The Man. Once he got to the front he was joined by In the Arsenal and Brian Sears. Sears and Teague fought for the front with neither giving an inch and the result was splits of 52.1 and 1:20.4.

Burke Quintet Heads Dan Patch at Hoosier

Trainer Ron Burke will have five chances to get to the winner's circle tonight at Hoosier Park as he sends out half the field in the \$300,000 Dan Patch. Burke's team consist of Foiled Again, Limelight Beach, All Bets Off, Bettor's Edge and Clear Vision. The bad news for Burke is that four of his five drew the four outside posts. The 11-year-old, Foiled Again, was the only lucky one, getting post two.

Burke won the race last year with Sweet Lou.

"I definitely like my horse," said Matt Kakaley, who will drive Burke's All Bets Off, who drew post eight. "But with the way the draw came out I think Foiled Again is the one to beat. I'd think otherwise if we could switch posts."

Yannick Gingras will drive Foiled Again, who will be looking for his first win since the June 12 Battle of Lake Erie at Northfield. Burke's biggest challenge ay come from JK Endofanera, who drew post one for the team of Jimmy Takter and Brett Miller.



Sebastian K was a beacon of trotting in North American trotting from his very first start in 2014. The apex of his astounding season took place at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono on June 28, when he shattered the world record in taking an incredible record of 1.49f in defeating a host of North America's best trotters.

Sebastian K comes to Hanover with lifetime earnings of \$2,973,252, over two million dollars of it earned in Europe where he took on and often defeated the best Free For All trotters in the world including victories in the Oslo Grand Prix, UET Trotting Masters and Åby Stora Pris (twice).

Appropriately, he will be officially retired in a special ceremony at the scene of his greatest triumph at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono on August 22nd. The Open trot will be named in his honor – The Sebastian K Invitational.

St Elmo Hero Back in the Groove

After missing most of last year, St Elmo Hero is back and winning at Balmoral. The now 9 year-old pacer will seek his third win from five starts this year when he goes in Saturday's eighth race at Balmoral, a "winners over" race with a \$9,400 purse.

St Elmo Hero did not begin his career until the age of four,

but he proved to be unbeatable at the outset, winning his first 25 starts. He raced just once last year, finishing sixth in a \$9,000 race at Balmoral.

"In the one race last year he threw a shoe and tore up his foot," owner John Barnard

explained. "We just pretty much had to lay him off after that. We gave him last year to get better and brought him back real slow this year.

"Yes, I would say there was some doubt that he would make it back. We wanted to make sure, through the training process, and if we had found any lameness I would have just guit with him. He came back strong and he's acting like his old self. He wants to race."

With St Elmo Hero now sound again and with his having missed his two and three-year-old seasons, Barnard believes his gelding will last for several more years.

"He can race a lot more years because he hasn't been raced really hard over the last couple of years," Barnard said, "Hopefully, he'll be around for a long time."

OBC and Little Brown Jug Purses Boosted By OHHA Allocation (press release)

COLUMBUS, OH (August 12, 2015) - The Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association (OHHA), with unanimous approval from the Association's Board of Directors, has allocated \$580,000 from the horsemen's video lottery terminal revenue to the Delaware County Fair for the eight Ohio Breeders' Championship races and the Little Brown Jug.

A total of \$400,000 will be divided equally among the eight divisions of the Ohio Breeders' Championships and should bring each OBC event to over \$80,000. With \$180,000 in added money the 2015 Little Brown Jug presented by Fazoli's purse is expected to be in excess of \$700,000.

"Ohio breeders are committed to producing great racehorses, support for the Ohio Breeders' Championships are a great way to reward their commitment, and the Little Brown Jug draws racing's elite to Ohio," noted Renée Mancino, Executive Director of the OHHA. "The Grand Circuit meet at the Delaware County Fairgrounds provides an important opportunity to showcase the Ohio harness racing community nationwide."

"We are very grateful for the support of the OHHA and the Ohio State Racing Commission," noted Phil Terry, director of marketing for the Little Brown Jug. "We look forward to a great week of racing showcasing the best the state of Ohio has to offer."

The Delaware County Fair will host five days of harness racing starting on Sunday, September 20, through Thursday, September 24 (Little Brown Jug Day).

PASS Recap fro Harrah's Philly (press release)

There were 3 divisions of PASS events for 2-year-old filly trotters held at Harrah's Philadelphia on Thursday afternoon (Aug. 13) each going for a purse of approximately \$78,000.

In the first division, it was part of the Charlie Norris

trained entry Synonymous Hanover rallying to win. The daughter of Andover Hall drafted in mid pack throughout much of the race, as second-favorite Best Of Dreams (Andy Miller) set the tempo. Race-favorite Windowshopper made a break early on. Synonymous Hanover swung wide for the drive at the top of the stretch, narrowly out closing the John Butenschoen charge Lookin Sharp (Corey Callahan) to win by a nose, stopping the clock in 1:58. She paid \$21.40 to win. Ultra-long shot Sand Grenade (Yannick Gingras) finished third.

In the second division, it was Brittany Farm's Twice Is Right (Yannick Gingras) going all the way to win. The daughter of Donato Hanover went right to the front from post 1, setting fractions of :28.1, :57.2, and 1:26.3, with an overall time of 1:56.2. It was the second career win for the Jimmy Takter trainee, pushing her lifetime earnings beyond \$50,000. Ultimate Shopper (Tim Tetrick) rallied for second, while Maker A Yankee (Marcus Miller) was third. Twice Is Right paid \$11.60.

In division three, it was Paul Holzman trainee Whitelake Hanover remaining unbeaten. The daughter of Explosive Matter floated off the gate into third, before quarter-brushing to the front. There were some anxious moments in the stretch however, as upset-minded Maeve Quaider (Corev Callahan) made the most of a pocket journey to finish just a neck behind, with Parimutuel Hanover (Andy Miller) finishing a distant third. The final time was 1:57.4. Whitelake Hanover is now a perfect 5 for 5 for owners Omar Beiler, Dennis Coons, and Sue Oakes. She paid \$2.60.

Barn Girl, Jewels in Hock Win Divisions of 168G NYSS Joe Goldstein Trot

YONKERS, NY (August 13, 2015) - Yonkers Raceway Thursday night hosted the \$168,374 New York Sire Stakes Joe Goldstein Trot for 3-year-old fillies.

The event, honoring the memory of a legendary sports publicist, went in two, \$84,187 events.

The opening division was won by Barn Girl (Jeff Gregory,

\$5.60) in a snappy 1:56.4. Unhurried from post position No. 2, she saw pole-sitting Nunkeri (Mark MacDonald) contend with a second move

from 9-10 choice Lady Winona (Andy Miller).

Nunkeri owned a short lead into the lane, but Barn Girl—who had chased Lady Winona before falling into a vacant pocket—ducked inside and went by. She beat "Winona" by a 1¾ lengths, with Nunkeri an easily-better-than-the-rest third.

"She was very good in Excelsiors (lower-level statebred races), so they wanted to try her in sire stakes," Gregory said of Barn Girl. "She's turned into one of the better one in

this group."

For second choice Barn Girl, a daughter of Cash Hall co-owned by (trainer) Steve & Nancy Pratt and Out in the Country Stable, it was her fifth win in nine seasonal starts. The exacta paid \$17.80, with triple returning \$28.

Thursday night's second sire stakes event saw Jewels in Hock (Jim Morrill Jr., \$4.60) hold off a troubled-trip, 1-2 favorite in last season's freshman champ Barn Doll (Gregory). The final margin was a length in 1:57.3. First leader Waiting Room (Miller) held third.

In play from post No. 4, Jewels in Hock retook from Waiting Room as Barn Doll, in search of a ninth consecutive victory, was caught wide early. She eventually found a five-hole before moving again first-up.

For second choice "Jewels," a Credit Winner miss trained by Linda Toscano for owner Ken Jacobs' KJ Stables, she's now 7-for-14 this season. The exacta paid \$9.50, with the triple returning \$45.20.


"She's given us a lot of headaches with her equipment," Toscano said. "John (Campbell, who drove her exclusively earlier in the season) wanted her rigged one way, while Jimmy (Morrill Jr.) wanted her another way. We eventually (and lovingly, we'd guess) told Jimmy to shut up and we're leaving her the way she was with John, and it's seemed to work out."

The Raceway's live season continues Friday and Saturday (first post both nights 7:10 PM).

Camluck Leaves Enduring Impact on Canadian Pacing Pedigrees

Hall of Fame horseman Bob McIntosh paid tribute to an old friend after Camluck died recently at age 27.

"I was so lucky to have this great horse be part of my life," he said. "It was truly like winning the lottery."

Camluck died at Seelster Farm inOntario, his longtime home.

Camluck has sired the winners of \$203.5 million, putting him just a couple million behind the leading all-time sire Western Hanover. He will likely overtake Western Hanover soon as he was active in the breeding ranks until last year. Camluck has sired 752 horses with 1:55 marks and they were a dominant factor in the Ontario Sires Stakes in recent decades. His name will be prominent in pacing pedigrees on both sides of the border for decades to come.

McIntosh trained the son of Cam Fella and owned a big piece of the champion stallion the rest of his life. McIntosh is a smart and tough horse trainer and he was paired perfectly with a smart and tough horse like Camluck.

His sire Cam Fella personified iron determination and durability in his three seasons at the races and Camluck was a chip off the block.

McIntosh said in an interview with The Harness Edge that he trained a lot of horses sired by Camluck and a common trait was their ability to race tough.

"I think most of them, even when they aren't 100 percent, suck it up and give 110 percent. That's rare amongst sires," McIntosh said.

"Another thing I noticed about them, when you breed to some sires, if you don't get a stakes horse, you don't even have a horse. Camluck sired horses of any class."

"You could get a good hard-hitting racehorse or you could get a stakes horse. You didn't have to worry about getting a filly or getting a colt, because they were both good."

Despite the fact that Cam Fella's richest performer was the mare Eternal Camnation, Cam Fella was not known as an outstanding sire of female pacing prowess. Only two of his 20 richest performers were females.

Yet Camluck's daughters were dynamite on the track in stakes as fillies and in open events as older mares. The richest and best known among Camluck's female stars were Burning Point and Dreamfair Lady. Then you can add Chancey Lady, Invitro, Michelles Power, Camille, and Jans Luck. All were millionaire mares.

Perhaps it should be no surprise that Camluck sired top

fillies because his own dam Striking Lady was a brilliant success on the track. She took a 1:55 mark in 1983 when such race records were still rare and she banked more than \$500,000 as a sophomore with a slate of 11-12-3 in 33 starts. She was a Grand Circuit lass of the first order.

Camluck's most famous son was Michael's Power, winner of the Jug in 2012. In that season, he won 14 of 20 starts and banked more than \$1.4 million. At Delaware he drew post three in his Jug elimination and got up to win by a head in 1:52.3. In the final, he drew the rail, a coveted spot at Delaware, and went gate-to-wire in 1:50.

Camluck's daughters have already produced such stars as American Jewel, I Luv The Nitelife, Thinking Out Loud, Aracache Hanover and many others. And that's a legacy that will grow for decades.

Camluck was a very fertile horses and able to handle the large books of mares that flocked to him. His progeny racked up millions each year, not only in Ontario Sires Stakes events but in open races on both sides of the border. Camluck's offspring had the best toughness traits of the Cam Fella line.

McIntosh paid \$70,000 for Camluck as a yearling because he liked the colt's shoulder and neck and was only a trifle concerned by that fact that he was a little straight in front.

"He was a gorgeous horse," McIntosh told me many years ago. And he knew all too well what a great filly Lucky Lady had been.

McIntosh experienced great success with pacers by Abercrombie, as did many trainers, but you had to motivate the Abercrombies before they would show their speed. That was not typically the case with Cam Fellas, and Camluck was no exception. While McIntosh said that Camluck was not a puller, he willingly showed his speed.

A bone chip in his hind ankle nixed a freshman campaign, but when Camluck came back as a sophomore McIntosh knew he had a real racehorse. That season Camluck's shining moment was when he won the \$250,000 Provincial Cup at Windsor Raceway, practically in McIntosh's backyard.

Camluck came into his own as an older horse. As a 4-year-old he won the Breeders Crown on a night when rain pelted The Meadows in western PA. The conditions didn't deter Camluck as he ripped off a 1:52.1 win.

The following year Camluck faced the new kid in the McIntosh stable in the 4-year-old Artsplace. Camluck couldn't beat Artsplace that year, but neither could anyone else as Artsplace went undefeated.

McIntosh tried to keep the two older pacing stars in his stable apart but they inevitably met at times. When they headed a short field in the Senior Jug in September, Camluck made Artsplace work hard for his win. Camluck got right in Artsplace's face in the final quarter and looked momentarily like a winner. Artsplace responded and won.

After that race, Camluck went to Lexington and his regular driver Mike Lachance slipped into the sulky for a time trial. Camluck was rated through panels of 27, 53.3, and 1:21.1 before hitting the wire in 1:48.4, second only to Matt's Scooter then in the all-time speed list.

Trainer Ron Burke sends out of five of the ten entrants in this years Dan Patch although, with the exception of FOILED AGAIN, who drew post two, the rest of the brigade drew the outside four slots. JK ENDOFANERA won here on this same night last year in the Monument Circle as a 3-year-old and seems in line to win again tonight from the rail for the team of Takter and Brett Miller. Overall this one has shined since the move to Takter over the summer (otherwise Burke would have six in here) and he was cooked last week in the US Pacing Championship when going first over through fractions of :53 and 1:19. He did beat the best horses in the sport two back and will be able to control it from the inside; gets back on a track with a win. FOILED AGAIN hung in there pretty good last week at the Meadowlands considering he was brutally parked for almost the first half mile through those near record fractions. His last few have all been deceptively good and it's hard to believe he has just a single win all season; should be able to give the top choice all he can handle. LYONSSOMEWHERE has been showing wild speed of late for Andy and Julie Miller and he was able to take it all the way last out in an Invite at the Meadows. More impressively was the game speed try he showed three back in a race won by Doo Wop Hanover; could be a sneaky longshot in here. LETS DRINK ON IT steps back up to face the FFA types but he has more experience over this track than all others combined; should make a good account for himself. CLEAR VISION comes off a win in the US Pacing Championship last week and is now rewarded with landing the outside post 10. That win tied his lifetime mark but it came off a dreamy inside trip; he would need luck to suddenly win back to back for the first time in a year. ALL BETS OFF was closing wide in that same race as many of these last week and he should be moving forward late again; usual pilot Kakaley is aboard.
