Wiggleit Jiggle it Silences the Critics with a Dominating Win in the Milstein By Garnet Barnsdale

Wigglelt Jigglelt's back. In a big way.

Not that he really went anywhere, but if there were any seeds of doubt planted from his loss in the Cane Pace last weekend – which was induced by a destructive early speed duel – those doubts were erased by another track record performance in the \$405,000 Milstein Memorial at Northfield Park last night.

The sophomore pacing star motored around the Cleveland oval to an easy 1:49 3/5 win, demolishing the previous track record shared by Griffindor and Hare Craft by more than two full seconds. The sophomore Mr. Wiggles gelding paced the fastest mile ever by a three-year-old over the 1/2 mile track and in doing so easily repelled a first-over challenge by his North America Cup nemesis Wakizashi Hanover.

Winning driver Montrell Teague, who had come under some criticism for his drive in the Cane on social media, indicated that vindication was sweet in his winners circle



interview. "Yeah, to bounce back like that and get back in the winners and quiet the doubters, it's amazing," he said.

Teague eased

battled for

inside. When the

1/4 was passed in 26 1/5 by leader Lost For Words, Teague had moved his charge off the pylons and pointed him for the top. Wigglelt Jiggle It slowed the pace to the 1/2 by taking a 29 1/5 breather which Tim Tetrick, in rein to Wakizashi Hanover sensed so he quickly moved him first-over from 5th to challenge the leader.

That's when Wigglelt Jiggle It really turned it on. With a 27 1/5 third quarter, he turned away his first-over attacker and turning home it appeared briefly that only Lost For Words, who was primed to take a shot up the passing lane might have a shot at an upset. But when they straightened out and Wigglelt Jiggle It set sail for the wire it was obvious there would be no challengers down the lane. A 26 4/5 final quarter sealed the deal for the Meadowlands Pace winner who finished 1 1/2 lengths in front of Lost For Words. It was another 1 ½ lengths back to Wakizashi Hanover in third.

Teague said he is always looking to save his horse as much as possible – last week's early duel notwithstanding. "I've been telling dad that we were always thinking about breaking records and stuff like that. I said I'd rather have him for the long run. So I take care of him as long as I can and we'll see him later in season. I just want to take care of him as much as I can."

Teague, who indicated that Wigglelt Jiggle It, was asked about a possible Battle Royale of Indiana-Breds in match with Freaky Feet Pete - who set a track record of his own at Hoosier on this night – this fall. "He's definitely the main competition out there by far," the winning driver noted. That matchup would have "Race of the Year" written all over it if these two stay fit and sharp leading up to the race.

Wigglelt Jiggle It pushed his season's past the million dollar mark to almost \$1.2 million for owner George Teague Jr. with the win and has now won 15 of 17 2015 starts and 16 of 18 lifetime. He returned \$2.20 to win and \$2.10 to place to his backers and combined with Lost For Words for a \$5.60 exacta payoff.

J K Endofanera Weaves Through Traffic to Take the Dan Patch

You'd think looking at winning driver Brett Miller's pose for the photo finish camera that J K Endofanera was an easy winner of last night's \$300,000 renewal of the Dan Patch Stakes.

While the race winner was a comfortable 2 ½ lengths in front at the end of a 1:48 4/5 mile, how he got there was anything but easy. It's not often you see a horse rally from 8th on the rail at the 3/4 – with three horses in front of him on the rail and four others racing to his outside - to win at any track. But J K Endofanera and Miller pulled it off in exciting fashion in the prestigious race at Hoosier Park last

Miller, who deftly maneuvered that 2014 North America

Cup champ off the rail around the final turn to give him a chance, said afterwards that things looked bleak as they approached the 3/4 pole. "The race didn't quite shape up like I thought it would," he explained. "Heading up the backside I was a little worried. In the middle of the last turn I said: It's just up to God now because we were buried on the rail, we had no shot and then things just opened up." Miller, who is no stranger to Hoosier Park noted that his previous experience over the oval helped. "I definitely know the track and the stretch here is such a long stretch. We use it to our advantage."

The Dan Patch was a race with plenty of action throughout starting with both Lyonssomewhere and Bettors Edge blasting off the wings of the gate at the start. When they reached the opening guarter in a swift 25 3/5 Bettors Edge had a clear lead but soon Lyonssomewhere would pull the pocket and head for the top with the ageless veteran Foiled Again in hot pursuit. J K Endofanera, who left third and was sitting third at the 1/4 stayed in and was 6th and buried at this point. Foiled Again cleared just past a 53 1/5 half and was soon under siege as Clear Vision was making a bold bid that it was apparent Foiled Again couldn't repel. As the field hit the 3/4 in 1:21 1/5 and Clear Vision took over with challengers in pursuit, J K Endofanera appeared in nowhere man's land buried on the rail, but Miller cleverly steered him into the two-path coming off the turn and began to weave through traffic.

As All Bets Off ranged up and looked briefly like the winner, Miller managed to swing J K Endofanera to the middle of the track at which point it was clear that he had

the most horse and the momentum. In an instant they blew by the leaders and sprinted away to a clear 1:48 4/5 victory with the winning driver waving to the crowd in the win photo. Miller commented on his obvious jubilation. "It's a race I always wanted to win!" he exclaimed. All Bets off was 2 1/2 lengths back in 2nd and Clear Vision finished 3rd, 3 3/4 lengths in arrears of the winner.

Miller noted that winning trainer Jimmy Takter, who had taken over training the colt at the beginning of July had been telling him that he has been very high on the millionaire son of Art Major. "Jimmy just got this horse a few months ago and he's told me all along that this horse is the real deal and we know that – he won the North America Cup for the Burkes," Miller remarked. "But since Jimmy's had this horse he's said I expect big things from him, and he showed it tonight. This is a race that I've always wanted to win!"

With his Dan Patch triumph, J K Endofanera raised his season's earnings to more than \$236,000 for owners 3 Brothers Stables of New York. His 17th lifetime win in 35 starts also raised his lifetime earnings to more than \$1.7 million.

J K Endofanera paid \$6.40 to win and combined with All Bets Off for a \$38.60 exacta payoff. Combining those two with third-place finisher Clear Vision in a trifecta wager returned \$327.60.

Freaky Feet Pete's Connection Talking Breeders Crown after Dominating Win By Garnet Barnsdale

Freaky Feet Pete was freaky enough last night at Hoosier Park to get his connections to talk about a Breeders Crown engagement for their homebred start three-year-old colt pacer.

Following one of the easiest 1:48 2/5 Track Record wins you'll ever see in a \$75K Indiana Sires Stakes, Freaky Feet Pete's trainer Larry Rheinheimer couldn't dodge the inevitable question: Breeders Crown? "He certainly deserves a chance at it," he replied. "And we're probably going to try it. It's sure looking that way."

Indeed, the way Rheinheimer's homebred performed last night and all season long indicates should be racing against

the best and the Breeders Crown certainly doesn't seem beyond his scope. After leaving third off the gate for driver Trace Tetrick, Freaky Feet Pete was asked to go just past an opening quarter timed in 25 4/5 and he moved immediately to the front. The colt, from the first crop from stallion Rockin Image, just kept rolling from there and there was very little movement as the mile progressed as his foes seemed to just be keeping up to his strong pace.


After rolling past the 1/2 in a strong 53 1/5 and the 3/4 in 1:21 flat, only American Virgin, who moved first up from 4th, had made any ground as he made it up to second briefly but clearly was no threat to the eventual winner. Freaky Feet Pete effortlessly paced home 5 1/2 lengths if front in 1:48 2/5 under wraps to Tertrick to set the new standard for three-year-old pacing colts at Hoosier Park. The Big Year slid up the inside to parlay a following trip into a second-place finish and American Virgin was a good third after moving first-over into the strong pace set by the winner.

The winning driver seemed in awe in the winner's circle when speaking of the star colt. "He's just a pleasure to drive; like a nice car," Tetrick beamed. "He lets you do what you want to and when you ask him to go its all business. "He was still strong at the 3/4 pole and right to the wire. He's just an amazing animal."

Winning trainer Rheinheimer concurred. "When he goes to the track, he just amazes me," the winning conditioner exclaimed. "He'll do what you have to do and keep on going."

Freaky Feet Pete, whose only loss came to Wigglelt

Jiggle It - who also set a new track record winning the Milstein Memorial at Northfield on this night – may be on a collision course for a rematch of the two great Indiana-breds as both are eligible to the Monument Circle at Hoosier on October 25th. Rheinheimer indicated earlier this week that there is a good chance that his colt will start in that event.

Freaky Feet Pete ran his season's record to 7 wins from 8 starts with one second and boosted his earnings more than \$172,000 for owners Mary Jo and Marty Rheinheiemer of Indiana. He has 16 wins from 18 starts lifetime and has earned close to \$440,000.

As an overwhelming favorite, Freaky Feet Pete returned \$2.10 to win and \$2.10 to place. There was no show wagering. He combined with The Big Year for a popular \$5.10 exacta payoff. Interestingly, Freaky Feet Pete's time of 1:48 2/5 was 2/5 of a second faster than that of J K Endofanera, winner of the Dan Patch Stakes on this night for aged pacers.

Breeder Looks Forward to Father Patrick's Fulltime Stallion Career Story and photo by Ken Weingartner Harness Racing Communications/USTA

With Father Patrick's racing career now completed, breeder and co-owner Adam Bowden is looking forward to the next phase of the trotter's career as a fulltime stallion.

The 4-year-old Father Patrick did double duty this season as a race horse and stallion. Diamond Creek Farm, owned by Bowden and his father Chris, is managing the multiple

Dan Patch Award honoree's breeding career. Bowden said he learned earlier this week that Father Patrick would be retired because of a lung infection.

Trained by Jimmy Takter, Father Patrick won 23 of 33 lifetime races, finished second on six occasions, and earned \$2.55 million. He is

owned by the Father Patrick Stable, a group made up of Brixton Medical Inc., Diamond Creek Farm LLC, John Fielding, Christina Takter, Brittany Farms, and the partnership of Marvin Katz, Al Libfeld and Sam Goldband.

Father Patrick is a son of stallion Cantab Hall out of the mare Gala Dream. He is a full brother to Dan Patch Award winner Pastor Stephen as well as stakes-winner Whom Shall I Fear. His mother, Gala Dream, is a half-sister to Dan Patch Award winner Chocolatier and stakes-winner Sugar Trader.

"Pedigree, looks, race record – he checks all the boxes," Bowden said. "It doesn't hurt that Jimmy said he's the best horse he ever trained. He had class and charisma on the track and he exhibited the same qualities in the breeding shed this year. He took to his job easily. He was able to

differentiate between breeding and racing. We were happy."
Bowden said Father Patrick bred 73 mares this year and
58 are in foal.

"That was sort of a trial run and now we're ready for the big leagues," Bowden said. "We were very happy, considering there were weeks where he only bred twice because of a race. He had an intermittent schedule throughout the year between qualifying and racing. But everybody was flexible with us and he got a great group of mares."

Father Patrick's wins included the Breeders Crown at ages 2 and 3 plus last year's Canadian Trotting Classic, Earl Beal Jr. Memorial, Dr. Harry M. Zweig Memorial, Stanley Dancer Memorial, and American-National Stakes. In 2013, his victories also included the William Wellwood Memorial and Peter Haughton Memorial.

His 1:50.2 win in the Beal at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono is the fastest mile ever by a 3-year-old on a five-eighths-mile track. He also holds the world record for a 2-year-old colt on the same sized oval, with a mark of 1:52.1.

This year, Father Patrick won one of five starts — capturing the Maxie Lee Memorial Invitational by two lengths over Bee A Magician on May 24 at Harrah's Philadelphia — finished second twice and earned \$120,995. He finished sixth in his final two races, the most recent on July 18 in the Hambletonian Maturity. His runner-up efforts came to JL Cruze in preliminary rounds of the Graduate Series.

"Even though he lost to JL Cruze, he lost by a neck and a

half-length in 1:51 and 1:50.4," Bowden said. "You can't complain about those two efforts. Clearly in his last two races something wasn't right.

"But Father Patrick is a great horse and we expect great things from his foals."

Mission Brief Could Try Boys Again in Kentucky Futurity

behind Pinkman, trainer Ron Burke said he hasn't given up on the idea of beating the boys this year with Mission Brief.

Burke said he is mulling the possibility of Mission Brief going in the Kentucky Futurity.

"There's a reason to try it again," he said. "The purse of the Kentucky Futurity is double what it is for the filly race, so I wouldn't rule it out. The odds that we'll go there? Maybe 50-50."

Burke decided to race the boys in the Hambletonian even though Mission Brief would have been all

but unbeatable in the \$500,000 Hambletonian Oaks. She raced well in the Hambletonian, but ran into a tough customer in Pinkman.

"It was probably the toughest loss I've ever had, but that's not because I wasn't happy with her." Burke said. "Things just didn't work out. If I had to do it all over again I'd do the same thing and I'd still go into it thinking I had a good chance of winning. I am very confident in her."

Mission Brief will make her next start in Friday's Moni Maker at the Meadows.

"She came out of the race great," Burke said. "I look forward to racing her next Friday at the Meadows and then it's on to Canada and on to Lexington."

Posterity Dominates in Freshman NYSS By James Witherite (Vernon Downs Racing Media)

VERNON, NY - Four New York Sire Stakes events for 2-year-old trotting fillies headlined Friday (August 14) evening's card at Vernon Downs, and Lucky Chucky filly Posterity (\$7.30) proved most impressive among the quartet of winners.

In the \$27,250 seventh race, trainer-driver Charlie Norris floated Posterity into midfield from her outside post, rating well off odds-on favourite Dizzy Broad (Jim Morrill, Jr.) through a :27.4 first quarter before charging to the fore amid a slackening :58.1 half mile. Upon reaching the end of the backstretch, Posterity was able to clear down to the pegs, turn aside a mild challenge from the first-over Credit To Thelimit (Sam Schillaci), and draw clear of her rivals through a dazzling :27.4 final quarter. Her 1:56 mile was the fastest of the four Sire Stakes splits, and she defeated runner-up Dizzy Broad by 3-1/2 lengths.

Carrie Norris, Janine Zito, and Buck Sprinkle share the ownership of Posterity.

Åke Svanstedt recorded a Sire Stakes driving double, teaming up with Jimmy Takter trainee Pampered Winner (\$13.00) in the \$27,250 fourth race for his first of two co-featured wins. The royally-bred daughter of Credit Winner kicked clear off a first-over effort, holding off a late charge from Monarchs Sequel (Mark MacDonald) in 1:56.2. Svanstedt also prevailed with his own pupil Non Stick (\$6.30) in the \$27,750 ninth race, kicking clear from the pocket to defeat Swinging Royalty (Chris Lems) by 3-1/2 lengths in 1:56.3.

The greatest margin of victory went to Goosebump Hanover (\$6.10), who drew off for a 4-1/4 length triumph in the \$27,250 sixth race. After brushing to the lead on the first half of the far turn, Goosebump Hanover gradually extended her advantage over Lucky Kristen (Marcus Melander) and I Will Take Credit (Dan Daley), prevailing ultimately in 1:57.2. Jim Morrill, Jr. drove the RC Royalty filly for trainer Ron Burke.

Live racing returns to Vernon Downs on Saturday (August 15) evening. Post time is 6:45 p.m. Eastern.
