Here today, gone tomorrow?

Is harness racing prepared to defend itself to lawmakers in light of Australia's ban on greyhound racing?

With the wave of a pen, Australian lawmakers banned greyhound racing. Is harness racing prepared to defend itself should politicians turn their attention to it?

Back in July, the government of New South Wales (NSW) in Australia banned greyhound racing. There was no moratorium, grace period, or transitional money. The Minister simply banned the sport, with the support of all political parties.

How did an industry with over \$3.2 billion (U.S.) bet (close to double what is bet on harness racing in North America), employing thousands of people, go from a thriving one to one that's extinct with the swipe of a pen?

This happened, generally, because of two words, "animal" and "welfare".

I know what you may be thinking. Those granola eating, yoga doing, *New York Times* editorial page nodding city-folk just don't get it. Maybe there's some truth to that, but in this instance, it was much more than a few activists or urban-dwellers.

Earlier this year, an expose on an Aussie television station was produced which looked deeply into the greyhound industry. A practice known as live baiting, where dogs were trained to chase live animals as prey at a young age was brought to light. That it was only a few bad apples live baiting didn't matter. In addition, the breeding figures were examined, and the greyhound industry could not account for thousands of dogs, which likely perished because they simply weren't fast enough.

When the NSW government began to look into the practices in greyhound racing, the industry could offer no response. The government concluded the industry was too far gone to fix itself.

"If you know people are going to fail, you don't give them false hope," said a government official, regarding the quick decision.

Politically this decision has been cheered. The government has noted in various interviews that they won't lose one seat because of this issue, and in fact will probably gain some, because the general public is on their side.

Switching over to horse racing – harness racing in particular – various Aussie governments have not said anything incendiary at the present time and insiders are extolling the virtues of horse racing's regulatory environment.

"(Racing and the regulators) are proactive in this (horse racing) space, they are really all over this stuff," noted David Attenborough of TAB Corp.

That statement struck me when I read it; whether it's political spin, or the truth, or something else.

Is harness racing here in North America, "proactive in this space" and "all over this stuff"?

When whip bans are forwarded by various stakeholders, to try and project a better image on the sport for the politicians and public to see, we seem to hear the same set of responses.

"Some horses are just lazy and need the whip."

"We should not be bowing to these activists, they will never agree with us."

"We're hitting the saddle pad. We don't hurt the horse. We need to educate people that whipping is fine."

The general response is that the public is wrong about whipping, and they need to be enlightened.

"Kicking", "boots" and "horses" are three words that should probably never be used together in a sentence in this day

and age. However, when I looked into the kicking rules a few years ago, and discussed the issue with various industry insiders, I received some rather curious responses.

"There's nothing we can do about it. Some judges call it, some don't. The rules are different."

"It's just brushing a boot to a hock to scare a horse."

"People that call it kicking are the problem. It's no big deal."

"Would you rather us whip them harder to make them go instead?"

Again, it seems to be someone else's problem.

In Australia, there were great worries from the government about "wastage", i.e. dogs that perish when they are unable to race. The government believed that the industry was doing nothing to combat wastage and would not be able to police itself in the future. There was no plan in place to re-home dogs, no regulations on breeding, and no funding mechanism through handle or slot machine taxes to help this issue along. It's like the lights were on, but no one was home.

Does a percentage of slots money here in North America go to re-homing horses? Are there breeding regulations? How serious is the industry about this issue?

In North America, when slots are rumored to be taken away

from the industry, there is usually some sort of response. Harness racing is a labor-intensive industry with many voters, who buy trucks and trailers and hay. There are sound green space arguments, there are great gaming arguments. I, personally, think the horsemen groups and industry do a fairly good job conveying information to the general public and politicians with these issues, and their work pays off.

When it comes to animal welfare issues – which, as shown above are growing in importance on both Main Street and K Street – I wonder, though. Is the industry taking them

seriously? Is there a plan when these problems inevitably surface? Is the sport doing enough? I really don't think it is, and it's something that harness racing should begin to wholeheartedly, and with open minds and open ears, explore.

More on the Big M's Big 4-0

As we approach the 40th anniversary of the opening of the Meadowlands (Sept. 1, 1976), let's take a look at a few items of interest stemming from those early days, many of which still resonate today.

The last seven times the richest race in the sport's history was contested, it happened at the Meadowlands:

7. 1977 Meadowlands Pace (won by Escort for a purse of \$425,000)
6. 1978 Meadowlands Pace (Falcon Almahurst, \$560,000)
5. 1979 Meadowlands Pace (Sonsam, \$750,000)
4. 1979 Woodrow Wilson (Niatross, \$862,750)
3. 1980 Meadowlands Pace (Niatross, \$1,011,000)
2. 1980 Woodrow Wilson (Land Grant, \$2,011,000)
1. 1984 Woodrow Wilson (Nihilator, \$2,161,000)

Thirty-two years later and no one, anywhere has topped the high water mark of Nihilator and Bill O'Donnell winning the Wilson for Billy Haughton with a colt from the first crop of Niatross – who himself is the only horse in the last 40 years to twice win the richest race in the sport's history.

The richest race prior to the Meadowlands opening was the \$236,250 Monticello OTB Classic in 1976 won by Oil

Burner. Two days after the Meadowlands opened in 1976, Steve Lobell won the Hambletonian in four heats at DuQuoin for a purse of \$263,524.

Haughton is the only trainer in history to win two races valued at over \$1.75 million. Nihilator in 1984 in the Wilson and McKinzie Almahurst in the 1981 Wilson (\$1,76 million). The latter was the only million-dollar driving victory in Haughton's incredible career.

Wilson remembered

For those who do not remember the prominence of the Woodrow Wilson or where born too late, here's one for you: The six richest races ever held were all Woodrow Wilsons from the 1980s.

Quiz (it's a tough one)

Q. Who was the first Hambletonian winner that John Campbell ever drove?

A. In 1983, Campbell qualified Historic Freight (1984 winner with Benny Webster) three times for Skip Lewis. So, technically, that would be the first. Campbell's first Hambletonian-winning victory came with Mack Lobell in 1987.

Abbatiello at 80

No Jug, Pace, Hambletonian or Breeders Crown. For Carmine Abbatiello, that's no problem. Abbatiello, who turned 80 in May, is one of the most likeable – and talented – drivers ever.

From 1975, when he led all of North America as the only driver past \$2 million (\$306,000 ahead of Benny Webster) the Red Man was in the top three in the nation for the first five years of operation at the Meadowlands. This despite the fact that he was only a regular in East Rutherford, NJ the first year, 1976.

Remember that when the Meadowlands began, it was the

Herculean efforts of one Anthony Abbatiello (Carmine's older brother) that got the ball rolling. A \$300 million project developed legs due, in no small part, to the insistence and persistence of the man who nearly single-handedly got the SBOA of NJ going, got the USTA in 1973 to recognize the state of New Jersey as "District 12", lifted up the New Jersey Sires Stakes program that went from 10 registered stallions to 81 in the state in a single calendar year.

Hats off to Tony Abbatiello, Hall Of Famer and a true visionary/pioneer in his efforts to get New Jersey racing on the map – and, specifically, the Meadowlands and the Sports Complex a reality.

Maybe the best quote from Tony four decades back was: "We pull together or we starve together. That's the secret to our success."

Quiz 2

Q. The first trotter to win a Meadowlands race was also the first Horse of the Year to appear in East Rutherford. Who was he?

A. Savoir, the 1975 HOY, won in race six on Sept. 2, 1976 for the Haughton barn. He became the first trotter to win with Peter Haughton driving, even though father Billy Haughton was listed. Also on that card was a freshman by the name of B Gs Bunny. He won, too, less than a year before scorching the oval to a 1:24.1 three quarter time in his Meadowlands Pace elimination en route to a 1:54 world record mile. That race turned out to be his last, too. He came up lame and headed to a stallion career. The aforementioned McKinzie Almahurst was from his very first crop and won the \$1,760,000 Wilson of 1981.

Wellwood was there

Bill Wellwood was driving at the Meadowlands on the track's second night of live racing when he drove Dar Hanover from post 10 in the final race on the card. That drive was a mere 40 years before his daughter Paula would call the Hambletonian trophy hers in 2016 with a gallant colt named Marion Marauder.

Also on night #2

A six-year-old horse named Arbor Bachelor also raced on the second night card. Seven years later, when John Campbell

won seven in a row at the Big M, Arbor Bachelor, at age 13, was one of his winners.

Niatross quiz

Niatross was born six months after the Meadowlands opened, but many would consider him the greatest performer in the history of the track.

Q. Can you name the only horse of the 117 Niatross faced in his career, that earned over \$1 million lifetime?

A. J Ds Buck, a 39-time lifetime winner for Ron Waples, banked \$1,141,792.

Betting Line goes for nine

The NA Cup champ will try to win his ninth straight when he tackles Control The Moment and Racing Hill in the \$500,000 Battle of Brandywine, part of Pocono's Super Stakes Saturday.

Betting Line will put his eight-race win streak on the line in Saturday's (Aug. 20) \$500,000 Battle of the Brandywine for sophomore pacing colts at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono, where multiple-stakes-winners Control The Moment and Racing Hill await the opportunity to challenge the Casie Coleman-trained standout for the first time since the North America Cup nearly two months ago.

The race is part of Pocono's Super Stakes Saturday and also features the \$500,000 Battle of the Brandywine for sophomore pacers and the \$350,000 Valley Forge for three-year-old female pacers.

Canadian-based Betting Line won the \$1 million (Cdn) Pepsi North America Cup on June 18 at Mohawk Racetrack, with Racing Hill finishing second and Control The Moment finishing third.

Since then, Betting Line has won three times on the Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) circuit and won last week's Carl Milstein Memorial Invitational.

Racing Hill has won four of five starts, including the Max C. Hempt Memorial and Delvin Miller Adios, and finished second to Control The Moment in the Crawford Farms Meadowlands Pace. Control The Moment, who finished fourth in the Hempt, has won three consecutive races including the Meadowlands Pace and Cane Pace.

"It will be a great race for the fans and everybody involved," Coleman said. "I'm looking forward to it. I think my horse is good coming into it and I'm sure the others will have their horses really good too. It will be a really good race."

Betting Line and driver David Miller will start the Battle of the Brandywine from post one. Betting Line, who has accumulated \$1.13 million in career purses thanks to winning eight of nine races this year and 14 of 21 lifetime, is the 5-2 morning line favorite.

In his most recent start, Betting Line raced first over from prior to the halfway point until the top of the stretch, overcoming a brief break of stride on the final turn, to win the Milstein by four lengths over filly Pure Country in 1:51 on a surface labeled "good" at Northfield Park.

"He was phenomenal," said Coleman, whose West Wins Stable is among the colt's owners along with Christine Calhoun and Mac Nichol. "I wish he didn't put in that bobble in the last turn, but we think we've got it rectified. I had his

hobbles too long and I'm going to bring them in. But when David hit the turbo button, he was just gone. His speed is unbelievable and his desire to win is unbelievable."

Control The Moment won the Cane Pace on Aug. 6 and Meadowlands Pace on July 16. Control The Moment, trained by Canada's Brad Maxwell, has won four of eight races this year and 12 of 17 in his career, good for \$1.02 million in earnings. He is owned by the Control The Moment Stable.

Brian Sears will drive Control The Moment, who will start the Battle of the Brandywine from post eight. Control The Moment is 3-1 on the morning line.

"He's got his work cut out for him," said Sears, who is undefeated in three drives behind Control The Moment. "Our chances definitely would have been better with a better starting spot, but I wouldn't rule us out, that's for sure. But that track is a speed track and you've got to be up close. That's the bottom line. It's just go, go, go."

"He is versatile. He can race off the pace. He's got a good mouth. You've got to have a horse that will work with you. This horse, he will let me do my job."

Racing Hill will enter the Battle of the Brandywine off a three-week respite following his 1:48.4 win in the Adios on July 30 at The Meadows. Racing Hill was put through quick early fractions of :25.2 to the opening quarter and :52.1 to the half as he wrested the lead from Check Six.

For the year, Racing Hill has won four of nine starts, good for a division-leading \$836,702 in purses. For his career, the colt has won nine of 19 races and \$970,028 for owner Tom Hill of the United Kingdom.

Racing Hill will start the Battle of the Brandywine from post three with Brett Miller at the lines for trainer Tony Alagna. Racing Hill is 4-1 on the morning line.

"My colt has been roughed up a few times, but Tony gave him three weeks off and I think that will help," Miller said. "I'd love to be able to give my colt a trip and not get torched like I did in the Adios. I've always loved this horse and had a lot of confidence in him, but that day he showed me what kind of heart he has. I don't know if I've ever sat behind a horse that got parked that hard and went on to win. He really impressed me."

"This race is definitely going to be a tough one. With Betting Line having the rail, in my opinion, he's going to be able to do whatever he wants. He does have gate speed, but he doesn't have to use it. With Control The Moment having the eight hole, I kind of feel like he's forced to go forward out of the gate. With my post position, I think I am in a good

spot; I think I can see what's going on leaving the gate and hopefully work out a trip."

First race post time is 6:30 p.m. (EDT) Saturday. Below is the field for the Battle of the Brandywine, followed by the fields for the Colonial and Valley Forge.

Sutton tackles Marauder, Frank in Colonial.

After seeing Sutton come within a photo finish of winning the Hambletonian earlier this month, co-owner/driver Andy Miller believes the three-year-old colt can remain in the picture among the division's best trotters the rest of the season.

Sutton's next opportunity arrives Saturday (Aug. 20) when he competes in the \$500,000 Colonial at The Downs at Mohegan Sun Pocono.

The Colonial's nine-horse field includes the top six finishers in the Hambletonian, which was won by Marion Marauder. He beat Southwind Frank by a nose and Sutton by a neck, with that trio followed by Waitlifter K, Bar Hopping, and Milligan's School.

Sutton, trained by Miller's wife, Julie, will start from post seven and is 6-1 on the morning line. Marion Marauder, leaving from post two with Scott Zeron at the lines for trainer Paula Wellwood, is the 5-2 favorite.

"He raced super in the final of the Hambletonian," Miller said. "I'm very happy with third, but to be that close, if things had gone a little differently, maybe he could have gotten there. He got close to a win at least."

Sutton, who battled health and soundness issues earlier this year, has won four of 17 career races and earned \$280,306 for owners Andy Miller Stable, Jason Allen, and Doug Allen. Over his last five starts, Sutton has posted a win, two seconds, and a third. His only off-the-board finish came in his Hambletonian elimination, where he was fourth.

"He's really been good his last three or four starts," Miller said. "He had a few issues earlier in the year but the last month or so he's been on his game. He's been pretty sharp."

"I think he's a major player. I don't know if he's the best, but I think he's a major player in the three-year-old ranks and might go on to be a nice aged horse after that. He's a fast horse, it's just a matter of keeping all the pieces of the puzzle in place."

Sutton is a son of 2007 Horse of the Year Donato Hanover out of the stakes-winning mare I Wanted Wings. He was purchased for \$40,000 at the 2014 Standardbred Horse Sale.

"We liked his family and the way he looked," Miller said.

“He’s a very nice looking horse.”

Last year, Sutton had two wins – including a track-record 1:54.4 effort at The Meadows – and three second-place finishes among his first six starts. He then got post eight in the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes championship, also at The Meadows, and was parked for three-quarters of a mile before going off stride in the stretch. From there, he had two off-the-board finishes at Lexington’s Red Mile and was shut down for the year.

“He had a pretty good year until the luck turned,” Miller said. “After the sire stakes final, things kind of went bad for him so we quit with him. But he was always very nice. He has a lot of speed and is a very talented horse; things just didn’t always work out for him.”

Earlier this year, Sutton won a qualifier at the Meadowlands in 1:51.2. The time is tied for the fastest mile of the season by a three-year-old trotter. Dayson, another Colonial contender, shares the mark.

Marion Marauder (1:51.3), Bar Hopping (1:51.4), Southwind Frank (1:52.1) and Waitlifter K (1:52.3) also are among this year’s 10 fastest three-year-old male trotters meeting in the Colonial.

“Hopefully with a little racing luck we can be close somewhere and get a good piece of it,” Miller said.

The Miller Stable also sends out Milligan’s School in the Colonial. Brian Sears is listed to drive the colt, who has won eight of 25 races and earned \$490,226 for owner Stroy Inc.

“He’s a very nice horse,” Miller said. “He’s honest and goes about his work. He’s close all the time. He almost always races very good.”

Extended Mohawk Grand Circuit meet starts Saturday

Two-year-old pacers will step into the spotlight Saturday (Aug. 20) to kick off a month-and-a-half stretch of Grand Circuit action at Mohawk Racetrack.

The Nassagaweya Stakes for freshmen pacing colts and geldings and the Eternal Camnation Stakes for rookie pacing fillies will each feature two divisions. Each event carries a total purse of \$211,000 (Cdn).

Many of the two-year-olds competing in this Saturday's stakes are preparing for next week's Metro Pace and Shes A Great Lady eliminations.

Bettors Dream, an undefeated son of Bettors Delight—Enduring Dream headlines the \$106,250 first division of the Nassagaweya. The Scott McEneny trainee is a perfect three for three to start his career, including a three-length score in the Aug. 1 final of the Dream Maker Series.

A \$45,000 purchase at last October's Lexington Selected Yearling Sale, Bettors Dream really caught the eye of his trainer.

"He was a good looking colt, he was well-bred," said McEneny following Bettors Dream's series victory. "A lot of the two-year-olds in his family didn't make it to the races, but he looked like he could've been a two-year-old, so I thought he was kind of cheap."

John Fielding and Domenic Chiaravalle share ownership of Bettors Dream with McEneny, who noted that he was forced to geld the pacer early while training down.

"He's been a pretty nice horse to train down, a little lazy, he

shows that on the front end, but I think he would be a lot better horse out of a hole."

Doug McNair will steer the undefeated gelding from post six in the first split.

Listed as the 4-5 morning line favorite, Bettors Dream will be looking to follow in the footsteps of last year's Dream Maker winner Control The Moment, who followed up his series victory with a win in the Nassagaweya and ultimately the Metro Pace.

Trainer Casie Coleman is regularly well represented by her rookies during the Grand Circuit events at Mohawk and this Saturday will be no different.

Ideal Wheel is two for two to start his career and will look for a stakes victory in the \$104,750 second Nassagaweya split. The Coleman trainee hasn't raced since July 28, but qualified last Friday at Mohawk and finished first in 1:54.4, two-and-three-quarter lengths ahead of Bettors Dream.

The son of American Ideal—Bet On Luck was a \$150,000 purchase at last November's Harrisburg Sale and is owned by Mac Nichol. Jonathan Drury will drive Ideal Wheel and the duo will start from post seven.

The Eternal Camnation Stakes attracted 16 pacing fillies, but much of the focus will be on Coleman trainee Candlelight Dinner.

The daughter of American Ideal—Time N Again is a perfect three for three entering Saturday's contest and has not only been the most impressive rookie pacer locally, but arguably in the entire sport.

Candlelight Dinner caught the eye of Coleman last year at Hunterton Farms and eventually was purchased for \$110,000 at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale.

"There was nothing not to like about her at sale time," said Coleman after her filly's last start. "I went to Hunterton Farms and saw her a few weeks before the sale and I actually couldn't turn her out.

"I love to turn my horses out in the field and see how they travel, but she had hurt her leg, just a superficial thing, and Cindy and Steve (Stewart) were like 'we can't turn her out' and I understood, but there is nothing to fault on her, she's just phenomenal."

Candlelight Dinner appears to be a special filly based on her performances to date. Through three starts, her smallest margin of victory is four-and-a-half lengths and most recently she captured the final of the Whenuwishuponastar Series by five lengths in a nation's best 1:52.2.

Drury will once again have the assignment behind the talented pacing filly and they will start from post five in the first division. Candlelight Dinner is the 2-5 morning line choice.

Just like Coleman, McEneny is also well represented in both of Saturday's event.

Bettors Up returns to Mohawk after three starts in Pennsylvania Sires Stakes action. The McEneny trainee is riding a two-race win streak, including a 1:52.3 victory in her last start on Aug. 7 at Pocono.

A \$15,000 purchase at last fall's Lexington Sale, Bettors Up has earned \$87,955 through five starts for her connections of Brad Grant, Teresa Davidson and Michelle McEneny. The four-time winner will start from post six in the second split with driver James MacDonald and has been installed as the 7-5 favorite.

The Nassagaweya divisions have been carded as raced five and seven, while the Eternal Camnation splits are carded as races three and nine.

Pair of NYSS freshman colts remain undefeated in five

The New York Sire Stakes (NYSS) continued downstate Thursday night, with Yonkers Raceway playing host to the \$151,624 Jim Meagher Pace for two-year-old colts and geldings. The pair of races honored the memory of the Raceway's long-time corporate controller.

The outcomes were eerily similar in both resume and result.

The winners graduated from the Excelsior ranks, did their damage from off-the-pace and left town five-for-five to begin their careers.

The opening (\$75,112) event saw favored Serious Major (Scott Zeron, \$4.70) moved from third down the backside. He rolled past Chip Walther (Marcus Miller), then widened to win by two-and-a-quarter lengths in 1:56.2.

Willie Joe Hill (Pat Lachance) was perched second-over as the second choice, but never came close. He did hold second, with Americanfirewater (Jim Marohn Jr.) a third-over third.

For Serious Major, an Art Major—Seriously colt making his NYSS debut, it was his third win for Chris Ryder, who now trains the Emerald Highlands Farm homebred. The exacta paid \$9.50, with the triple returning \$80.

"When they sent him to me, I couldn't guarantee he'd stay unbeaten," Ryder said. "He had proven himself (in the Excelsior), so there was no reason not to try him here.

"He's not fast, but he tries."

Thursday's second (\$76,512) division saw another one from the Excelsior finishing school do good work.

Eight-baller Funknwaffles (Joe Bongiorno, \$10.80) left for a tuck sixth, then patrolled from third-over. He was actually gapping the outer tier before unleashing a furious wide rally in and out of the final turn.

Funknwaffles, fifth turning for home, whipped a pocketed What's Goin' On (Mark MacDonald) by two lengths in 1:55.4. Very Special Agent (Zeron) was third, while 1-2 choice Miso Fast (Matt Kakaley) could not sustain an uncovered bid and was a non-threatening fifth.

For Funknwaffles, a son of American Ideal—Hatsoff Hanover owned by Crawford Farms Racing and trained by John Butenscheon, it was his second NYSS after a trio versus Excelsior company.

The exacta paid \$182, with the triple returning \$606.

"He was very good," Bongiorno said. "He did it wrapped up."

Fresh from their American invasion, fillies take Gold at Mohawk

Over the last month, three-year-old trotting fillies Caprice Hill and Flowers N Songs have battled the best fillies in North America, bringing home one win and three seconds between them from the Dr. Harry M. Zweig Memorial, the Hambletonian Oaks and the Moni Maker Stake.

Flowers N Songs captured her first OSS Gold Series win at Mohawk Racetrack on Thursday. Doug McNair piloted the three-year-old trotting filly to the 1:53.4 victory.

The talented trotters returned to Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) Gold Series action on Thursday (Aug. 19) at Mohawk Racetrack and were sent off the heavy favorites in their respective divisions, and both fillies delivered resounding victories.

Caprice Hill captured the first \$105,000 Gold division with a commanding effort from post three that saw her take control after the :27.3 opening quarter and cruise through a :57 half and 1:26 three-quarters on her way to a two and one-quarter length victory in 1:53.1. Early pacesetter Emoticon Hanover finished second and Dottie closed well to be third, seven lengths behind the winner.

“(Caprice Hill) felt like she wanted to go coming out of the turn, and she got away second, so I decided to take a shot and try to control it from there and it worked out good,” said driver Randy Waples of Milton, ON. “I’ve got a lot of respect for the filly that was on my back (Emoticon Hanover), but I’ve got a whole lot of respect for the one I was driving too.”

Waples drove Caprice Hill to her third Gold Series win of the season for trainer Tony Alagna of Manalapan, NJ and owner Tom Hill of the United Kingdom. The reinsman said the Kadabra—Bramasole daughter was in great shape after her trip to the Meadowlands for the Hambletonian Oaks, where she finished second in both her July 30 elimination and the Aug. 6 final.

“I trained her here the other morning and she was really good. They do a really good job with their horses; they’re always fit and healthy and ready to race when they come

here,” said Waples. “She’s a special filly, she really is, just her gait and her manners and the fact that she’s such a professional about whatever she does. She’s a real, real beautiful thing.”

In 17 lifetime starts, Caprice Hill has finished no worse than third, and this season she boasts a record of four wins and three seconds in seven starts. Thursday’s victory bumped her lifetime earnings to \$931,877 by Standardbred Canada accounting.

In the second Gold division, Flowers N Songs dropped into fourth spot from post two and watched as Major Muscle did all the heavy lifting, leading the field through a :26.3 quarter and :56 half. Heading by the 1:25.1 three-quarters, driver Doug McNair tipped Flowers N Songs out three-wide and the filly powered by the leaders and on to a four length victory in 1:53.4. Tymal Tempest followed Flowers N Songs into second and pacesetter Major Muscle had to settle for third.

“That’s obviously the best she’s been in the Gold. We’ve had a lot of bad luck in the Golds, but she’s been very good all year,” said McNair, adding that the Deweycheatumnhowe—Pleasure’s Song daughter is at her best off a helmet.

Thursday’s win was the filly’s first in OSS action. In her first three Gold Series starts, Flowers N Songs finished third, fifth and sixth. In the 20 starts since her February debut, the filly has tallied eight wins, six seconds and one third for earnings of \$325,989. In her mid-summer forays across the border, Flowers N Songs captured the Dr. Harry M. Zweig Memorial at Vernon Downs on July 24, finished sixth in her Hambletonian Oaks elimination and then logged a runner-up result in the Aug. 13 Moni Maker Stake at The Meadows.

“She’s been a great filly. She’s been tougher than a two dollar steak, I mean she’s just unreal how she can travel around and still race like that,” said trainer Paul Reid, who conditions Flowers N Songs for owner/breeder Robert Key of Leechburg, PA.

“I’m real happy with the way she’s going, but that’s a lot of starts on her, so hopefully we can keep her like she is,” the trainer continued.

Thursday’s victory bumped Flowers N Songs into third spot in the division standings with 70 points, which will assure her of a berth in the season ending Super Final. Through four regular season Gold events Caprice Hill and Emoticon Hanover share ownership of top spot in the standings with 150 points.

Before they wrap up their regular season Gold Series campaign at Flamboro Downs on Oct. 2, the sophomore trotting lasses have a series of open stake opportunities at Mohawk, including the Casual Breeze on Aug. 26, the Simcoe Stakes on Sept. 2 and the eliminations and final of the Elegantomage on Sept. 9 and 17.

8,000th driving win for Rick Zeron

Rick Zeron, one of harness racing's most popular drivers, scored his 8,000th career driving victory Thursday night (Aug. 18) at Mohawk Racetrack.

Zeron, 59, entered the evening just a single win shy of the milestone. Driving three-year-old pacing filly Dixie Lullaby in the evening's seventh race, Zeron was able to get the filly up in the final strides for the milestone victory.

Nicknamed "The Whip", Zeron has been a regular driver and trainer on the Woodbine Entertainment Group (WEG) circuit for over two decades. The Oakville, ON resident has consistently posted impressive numbers throughout his career, including driving the winners of over \$3 million in 14 of the last 16 seasons.

Zeron, who won his first race at Rideau Carleton Raceway in 1975, was the top driver in Quebec for many years before relocating to Ontario in 1995. His career best season for wins came in 1989, when he won 437 races and captured another Quebec driving title.

Zeron's best season for earnings was recorded in 2006, when he drove the winners of over \$7.7 million. Last season, he put together another solid campaign with 126 wins and earnings of nearly \$3 million.

The past few weeks have been memorable for the Zerons, as Rick's son, Scott, won the Hambletonian with Marion Marauder on Aug. 6. The father-son duo also teamed up to capture the U.S. Pacing Championship with Rick's stable star Shamballa on the same day.

A model of consistency, Rick is on pace for another solid season with 71 victories and earnings of over \$1.4 million. He currently ranks ninth in the WEG drivers standings and sixth in the trainers standings.
