# Hannelore, Obrigado take Vernon top trots

*Hannelore Hanover dominated the Muscle Hill to post her eighth straight win, while Obrigado repeated in the Crawford Farms open trot.*

**Hannelore Hanover (Yannick Gingras) won for the 13th time in 14 starts when she dominated the \$170,000 Muscle Hill at Vernon Downs Friday in a 1:51.3 track record.**

Following wins in the Hambletonian Maturity, Fresh Yankee, and a Miss Versatility preliminary event, Hannelore Hanover (\$2.90) had no trouble maintaining her dominance in the distaff trotting ranks on Friday (Aug. 26) at Vernon Downs, posting a resounding 1:51.3 victory in the \$170,000 Muscle Hill, the ninth event on a 12-race program.

Yannick Gingras had the four-year-old Swan For All—High Sobriety mare involved from the outset, working clear of 2015 Empire Breeders Classic winner Barn Doll (Jeff Gregory) just after a :27.1 first quarter mile. Upon taking charge, Hannelore Hanover faced no threats whatsoever, rating a soft

:29.4 second sectional before accelerating clear of the competition off the far turn. She used a :54.3 final half to put three-and-three-quarter lengths on the first-over Shake It

Cerry (David Miller), who rallied to take second from the fully extended Barn Doll.

Ron Burke trains Hannelore Hanover for the Burke Racing Stable, the Weaver Brusceci partnership, and Frank Baldachino. Hannelore Hanover captured the Vernon track record for four-year-old trotting mares with her 1:51.3 score, topping Maven's performance in the 2014 Muscle Hill by two-fifths of a second.

In the \$193,000 Crawford Farms for open trotters, carded as race 10, 2015 Crawford winner Obrigado (\$14.80) proved successful in defending his crown, dueling with odds-on favorite Resolve (Åke Svanstedt) for nearly the final three-eighths of the mile en route to a 1:51.2 triumph in rein to Mark MacDonald. The six-year-old Boy Band—Malimony gelding approached the first turn from second-over, drafting behind Resolve into a :26 first quarter before capturing the lead for himself in a backed-down :55.1 half mile. Just as Obrigado cleared, Resolve angled back off the pegs to re-engage, and the two duelled through the far turn. Despite being headed just above head-stretch, Obrigado dug deep to prevail, reclaiming the lead in the final 100 yards to narrowly beat Resolve. Flanagan Memory (Brian Sears) closed from last to take third, making massive gains down the grandstand side.

Trainer Paul Kelley shares in ownership of Obrigado with the SRF Stable, Linwood Higgins, and Stable 45.

### Major Moe, Funknwaffles take freshman Sire Stakes splits

A pair of New York Sire Stakes events for two-year-old pacing colts and geldings served as supporting events on the undercard.

Major Moe (\$5.40) worked to earn his 1:52.4 victory in the \$54,500 seventh race, making steady first-over gains on the far turn to reel in pacesetter Andy's Ideal before holding sway from Very Special Agent's late charge by half a length. Scott Zeron drove the homebred son of Art Major and Maureen Rocks for trainer Chris Ryder and owner Emerald Highlands Farm of Mount Vernon, OH.

Funknwaffles (\$2.20) did not disappoint at odds-on in the \$55,500 eighth event, keeping his undefeated record intact through six career races to date. The son of American Ideal and Hatsoff Hanover brushed to the fore before race's midpoint, evading Serious Major by two lengths in 1:52.3. Jim Morrill, Jr. drove Funknwaffles for trainer John Butenschoen and owner Crawford Farms Racing of Syracuse, NY.

# Tenacious Delights

*Fifteen years after Bettors Delight brought Scott McEneny to the top of the sport, the trainer is relishing a resurgence thanks to a group of precocious youngsters that includes a pair of talented Bettors Delight offspring.*

It's been 15 years now since trainer Scott McEneny felt those goose bumps on his arm.

Down the backside at The Red Mile, a second quarter in :26 flat and on top of the field by 15 lengths, he watched his horse Bettors Delight wage war with longtime foe Real Desire in an epic battle still well-remembered to this day.

It was a time when it was impossible to not experience those tiny physical manifestations of excitement, but certainly wasn't the only instance in a year that saw Bettors Delight also win the North America Cup, Little Brown Jug and more than \$1.7 million in purses.

"I started thinking of it more this year, you know, the fact that time really flies. It just means I'm getting older, I guess," said McEneny, with a laugh, acknowledging the passage of time is quite evident when he remembers his now teenage daughter was just a newborn at the time of his Cup victory.

The Ontario-based trainer is also finding a few reminders in his barn these days, training a precocious pair of Bettors Delight's offspring along with several other promising two-year-olds, who have collectively pushed McEneny's training percentage to a stellar .385 this season, winning 23 times in just 84 starts.

Bettors Up, a \$15,000 purchase in Lexington, has already returned five wins in six career starts and more than \$125,000 in earnings, thanks to some nice work in the Pennsylvania Sires Stakes and Eternal Camnation final.

McEneny and his wife, Michelle, spotted her during some downtime at the sale in the video tent. They typically look at all the Bettors Delights, but she especially caught his eye with a knockout page and an amazing video.

"She just stood right out. So we went to look at her and she's very small, like very small, but very correct as well... I didn't get into the bidding until about \$11,000 and we got her for \$15,000 and the only reason was her size.

"The little mare is still not very big. She wears a very small, like 53-inch hobble, but you can ask any driver... Tim Tetrick said after he drove her last week, 'She sure doesn't pace like one that's got a 53-inch hobble.' She just covers the ground, she's got a big heart and she just wants to go forward."

With Bettors Dream (Bettors Delight—Enduring Dream), another talented two-year-old, it wasn't his size that kept his price down to \$45,000, but rather the absence of familial

two-year-old speed.

"He had five other siblings and none of them raced at two, but this colt just looked like he could race at two," said McEneny, who co-owns the gelding with John Fielding and Domenic Chiaravalle, and noted that many of his brothers and sisters made up for lost time in later years, including two siblings making over \$400,000.

With his father's stocky build, only on a much larger frame, Bettors Dream has broken his siblings' two-year-old jinx, winning three times in four starts in 2016 with an eye towards the upcoming Metro Pace at Mohawk. Tonight the colt will start from post eight in the third of three \$40,000

Metro Pace eliminations at Mohawk with Tetrick in the sulky. The \$685,000 Metro final is Sept. 2.

“So far, I’m crossing my fingers. He’s paid up into the Metro and then we don’t have anything until the Governors Cup because we didn’t stake him very heavily this year, just for that reason. I think he could be a heck of a nice three-year-old, too, and we’re still hoping we can win some of these big races coming up,” McEneny said.

When asked if he saw two-year-old success in his crystal ball for either Bettors Up or Bettors Dream based on their training, McEneny lets out a hearty “No” amid laughter.

“That’s one thing about the Bettors Delights – and I’ve told anyone that’s ever asked – I say, ‘You keep training them until they are in a race bike and behind the gate because most of them aren’t special trainers,’” he said.

“I have never quit with any of them, unless they broke down. I don’t care how lazy they are or whatever they do. I just keep going with them until I can at least get them to the races and a couple of starts because usually they step up. That’s the way [Bettors Delight] was when he was two. I wasn’t sure he’d even win a maiden race at two when he trained down, until I got him behind the gate. But he just got faster and faster and the rest is history,” McEneny said, of Bettors Delight, who was inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame in 2007 and the U.S. Hall in 2013.

For McEneny, part of the fun of this season has been sharing the success of Bettors Up and Streakavana, a Big Jim gelding who is fast becoming an Ontario Sire Stakes star with close to \$100,000 in earnings, with owners Brad Grant and Teresa Davidson – the children of the late John Grant, who owned Bettors Delight throughout his career and was also inducted into the Canadian Horse Racing Hall of Fame as a builder.

“It’s been great. I worked with John Grant for 12 years and I’ve known them all for a long, long time,” he said.

Streakavana was purchased by Grant and Davidson after

his first start, which had caught the eye of McEneny who quickly called the previous owner with an offer to buy.

“He’s got better and better each week. I wish he was paid up into the Metro, but he’s not, because I think he would have a helluva shot in there.”

If that weren’t enough to be excited about, there is also an Angus Hall trotting colt named Tycoon Seelster, who he thinks will be a headturner in the upcoming months, as well as the interestingly-named trotting filly Stuck In My Spanks.

“She’s been a great filly training down, but she has a little bit of a temper. She had a break in her last race, 30 lengths back at the quarter pole, and she still won. She trotted her last three quarters in 1:25 for a two-year-old, which is pretty unreal. She’s going to step up here, I think. If she gets her mind together she could be a force in the Peaceful Way.

All told, the success of the youngsters has been a bit of a renaissance for McEneny, which has energized the trainer following some forgettable years.

“A few years ago, with everything going on (in Ontario), I was ready to get out,” he said.

“But then Brad, Teresa and I got together and bought a few over the last couple of years. We had a little luck last year and bought a few more... I don’t have a very big stable, but I had 10 babies and nine of them qualified.

“So it just makes you want to go to work in the morning, let’s put it that way.”

## **Southwind's incredible twosome**

Anyone see a mirror Image at Southwind Farms?

In 1989, Valley Victory was undefeated as a three-year-old, won his last 10 lifetime starts and went to stud at Southwind Farms.

Twenty years later, Muscle Hill was undefeated as a three-year-old, won his final 20 career starts and went to stud at Southwind Farms.

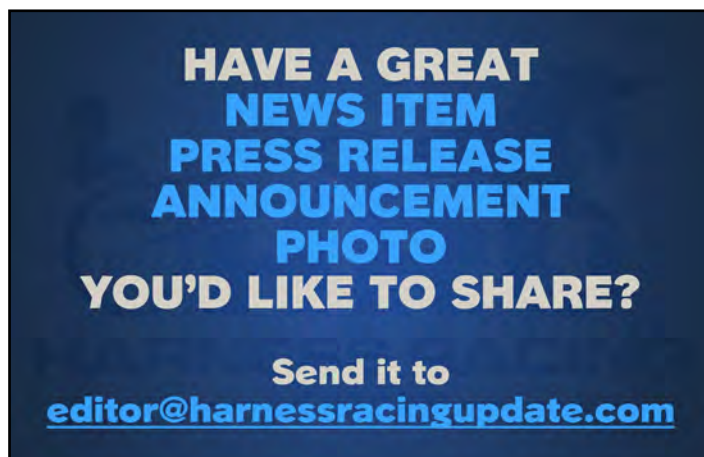
Both colts won the Hambletonian with offspring from their first crop – Valley Victory in 1994 with Victory Dream and Muscle Hill in 2014 with Trixton.

Both won the Hambletonian with offspring from their third crops and were both first and second in the race – in 1996 Continentalvictory defeated Lindy Lane and in 2016 Marion Marauder defeated Southwind Frank.

Both had at least one prominent female who went against the boys in their first three crops:

Valley Victory had Act Of Grace (second in the Dancer and second in her Hambletonian elimination) and Continentalvictory (Horse of the Year).

Muscle Hill had Mission Brief, who was the favorite in the 2015 Hambletonian final.



## **Compelling Casie Coleman**

From 1997 to 2003, Casie Coleman won 84 races and some \$300,000 in purses – total.

In 2005, she was the first trainer to have a sub-1:48 sophomore in a race (American Ideal – 1:47.4)

From 2010 to 2014, she had a sophomore pacing colt/gelding win over \$750,000 each year – 2010 – Sportswriter, 2011 – Betterthancheddar, 2012 – Michaels Power, 2013 – Vegas Vacation, 2014 – McWicked. No other trainer has ever done this more than three times in a row.

Now she's back again with maybe the best colt of all – Betting Line.

Can Coleman join Linda Toscano (2012) and Nancy Johansson (2014) as the third female trainer with a Horse of the Year?

## **Miller's Line**

David Miller, the defending Driver of the Year, may indeed have his first Horse of the Year (Betting Line) in 13 seasons since he last did it in 2003 with No Pan Intended.

## **Pace setter**

If Betting Line continues his winning ways and is named Horse Of The Year, it would mark the first time a three-year-old that did not participate in the Meadowlands Pace was named as such.

## **Spellbound and Syrinx**

Marion Marauder's dam, Spellbound Hanover, actually out-earned Syrinx Hanover as a two-year-old in 2000. She banked \$748,346, \$67,549 more than Syrinx, who would run the table as a sophomore. This is certainly not a case of like mother like son, though. Marauder was only victorious once at two while Spellbound Hanover sported a fancy 15 11-3-1 slate winning from June until November for a pair of Bills: Popfinger and Mulligan.

## **Huge Wiggle**

Wiggle It Jiggleit has done it again. He's the first horse to reach \$1 million two straight years and he's also just the third horse in the sport's history to back up a \$2 million campaign with a \$1 million+ season (joining Gallo Blue Chip



2000-2001 and Market Share 2012-2013). If he maintains his top form and if he is named Horse of the Year again, it would be the first time since 1998-1999 than any horse repeated (Moni Maker) and the first pacer to double up back-to-back since Cam Fella (1982-1983)

### Zeron and Haughton

Scotty Zeron, at 27, is the youngest driver to ever debut in the Hambletonian and win it. Tommy Haughton (winner at 25 in 1982 with Speed Bowl) had already been in it. He was second in 1980 with Final Score when stablemate Burgomeister won it. Tommy was just 23 at the time.

### Paula and her Peanut

Paula Wellwood captured her first Hambletonian in 2016, but it is likely that Paula's Peanut captured her heart first. She was given "Peanut" as a present for Christmas at age six, and wouldn't you know it, went on to become an Ontario Sires Stake champion.

### 90 years ago

In 1926, 90 years ago as of Aug. 30, the first Hambletonian was held at Syracuse Fairgrounds. It was the largest crowd for any New York Sire Stakes day and Guy McKinney won the Hambletonian in straight heats for Nat Ray. The \$73,451 pot was bigger than any of the next 23 Hambletonian purses! The \$73,451 pot was more than the top six trotting sophomore purses of 1923 combined.

## Kadabra fillies sweep Casual Breeze

Emoticon Hanover and Caprice Hill made their sire Kadabra proud with impressive victories in the Casual Breeze Stakes Friday (Aug. 26) at Mohawk Racetrack.

A group of 20 three-year-old trotting fillies were split into a pair of \$97,000 (Cdn) divisions.

Emoticon Hanover was a gate-to-wire winner in the first division for driver Sylvain Filion and trainer Luc Blais. The trotter, out of Emmylou Who, left alertly from post two to grab the lead and it was lights out from there.

Emoticon Hanover posted fractions of :28, :57.1 and 1:26.2 before firing home in :28 for the victory. Double Exposure left hard from post eight, landed the two-hole and ultimately finished a length and a quarter back in second.

Jangone finished third, while Worldclass Hanover was fourth.

Following the race, Filion was very pleased with the Emoticon Hanover's effort and her progression as a three-year-old.

"I wanted to get to the front and control the pace, which we did, and she did it pretty handy," Filion said. "Last year, she was a little tough to drive, but this year she is way handier, so that makes her much better."

Owned by Determination of Montreal, QC, Emoticon Hanover scored her fourth victory of the season Friday in her eighth outing. She now has eight career victories and a bankroll of \$436,658.

The Blais trainee paid \$2.80 to win.

Caprice Hill continued her fantastic season by overcoming the 10-hole to win the second division in 1:53.3.

The Tony Alagna-trained filly was unhurried at the start by driver Randy Waples and eventually found a spot along the rail in sixth just after the opening quarter. Side Bet Hanover led the field to the half in :57.3, but was quickly confronted entering the far turn by a charging Caprice Hill, who took the lead before five-eighths.

After reaching the three-quarter pole in 1:26, Caprice Hill trotted home strongly in :27.3 to win by three-and-a-quarter lengths. Side Bet Hanover held on to second over a charging Flowers N Songs.

Caprice Hill, out of Bramasole, now has five wins in 2016 and has yet to finish outside the top two in eight starts.

## Lexington considering spending millions on Castleton

The *Lexington Herald-Leader* reported Friday (Aug. 26) that Lexington's Rural Land Management Board may decide this Monday whether it will spend up to \$4 million to buy the development rights for the famed Castleton Lyons farm.

The story, written by Beth Musgrave, said Lexington Mayor Jim Gray is against the expenditure saying the city can't afford it.

"Since its creation in 2000, the PDR program has allocated \$77 million — \$37 million in local money, \$24 million in federal money and \$16 million in state money — to buy conservation easements for 29,165 acres of land, protecting it from future development," Musgrave wrote. "The problem with Castleton Lyons is that it's owned by Shane Ryan, who is Irish and doesn't pay income taxes in the U.S. That means a federal program that generally pays for half the cost of conservation easements in the PDR program won't help pick up the tab, leaving local taxpayers to foot the entire bill."

## NJ resident mare program deadline extended

The deadline to apply for the SBOANJ resident mare rebate program has been extended to Oct 1.

It was brought to the attention of the SBOANJ that there was some confusion as to the requirements for the rebate program for New Jersey resident mares.

The Mare Residency Rebate program is for mares that reside in New Jersey for at least 150 days and have been bred. The program will rebate up to \$500 to the owners of qualified mares. For mares bred to a NJ stallion, the foal must be made eligible to the New Jersey Sire Stakes program. Rebate payment will be made before the end of the year.

For resident mares bred to stallions outside of New Jersey, the mare must be eligible to the New Jersey Sire Stakes Standardbred Development Fund that requires that the mare reside in New Jersey for 150 days up to and including foaling. The \$100 eligibility fee will be paid directly to the New Jersey Sire Stakes and deducted from the refund.

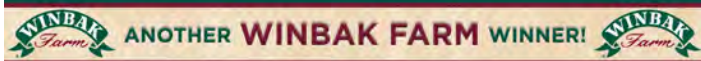
