Roy gets chance to shine for Burke in Canadian Pacing Derby


In his first year on the WEG circuit, phenom Louis Philippe Roy has landed himself in Rockin Ron's sulky with a strong shot to win Saturday's Canadian Pacing Derby.

Louis Philippe Roy has made a remarkable impression in his first year on the Woodbine Entertainment Group (WEG) driving circuit and is now rewarded with the liveliest of drives for the sport's biggest trainer in the \$615,000 Canadian Pacing Derby.

Roy will steer the 5-year-old gelding Rockin Ron for trainer Ron Burke, as the strongest of three Burke horses in the race. It's rare that you see someone other than Yannick Gingras or Matt Kakaley on a Burke contender in a race this big, but that will be the case on Saturday at Mohawk. The combination of

Harness Racing Update

Roy and Rockin Ron first came to be last week in an elimination for the Canadian Pacing Derby when Gingras drove Check Six for Burke, leaving a vacancy on Rockin Ron.

In his CPD elimination with Roy at the helm for the first time, Rockin Ron crushed foes that included Sintra and McWicked to win with total authority in 1:47.2; right up there with the fastest miles ever paced in Canada.

Roy provided a spark for Rockin Ron in last week's elimination, but Burke attributed the race to a combination of both the driver and horse. "Roy did a good job but this horse is getting sharp," Burke said. "Yannick was second with him in 1:48 the week before at Tioga and Matt (Kakaley) was second with him at Saratoga in 1:49 coming from last. This horse is getting very good right now."


The fact alone that Roy is getting the call for Burke in a spot this big almost speaks for itself as to Burke's opinion of the upcoming driver, but he explained it in a bit more detail.

"We've used him before in the North America Cup and in the Prix d'Ete," Burke said. "He's a young guy up here that fits the mode of the drivers we usually use. He's one of the guys upcoming with a chance and in a short time with more experience he's getting better and better. And he seems to be available when we need him which works out good."

Although Burke used Roy in the two races mentioned, those horses — Filibuster Hanover and Roll Away Joe — never really had a shot in those races. The Canadian Pacing Derby will be a different story and as good as Roy was last week with Rockin Ron, was there ever consideration to replace him for the final on Saturday with Gingras? "No, there was never a doubt of taking Roy off," said Burke. "Plus, I knew Matt (Kakaley) was going to be staying at Yonkers so Yannick was going to keep All Bets Off or Check Six, whichever came back better. And then Timmy (Tetrick) became available for Check Six so it was the perfect storm of guys that fit each horse everywhere."

For those who still may not be acquainted with Roy, they should be after Saturday. Roy has already made himself well known to those who follow the WEG circuit and among his credentials this year include a 1:50.3 win for the Casie Coleman-trained Summer Travel in the Dream Maker series, which is the fastest mile in North America this year by a 2-year-old. With the more expansive audience on Saturday we'll see if Roy may go even the slightest bit overlooked on the Burke horse.

Rockin Ron rates as the second choice at 3-1 on the programmed line in the Canadian Pacing Derby and he very well may end up as the favorite come race time. Rockin Ron paced a :52:4 back half and that was after setting a :54.3 clip on the front end in his elimination; there's not a real reason to search elsewhere considering how visually impressive a

race that was.

The role of morning-line favoritism lands on the oldest horse in the race, the 9-year-old Keystone Velocity. At his advanced age and clearly thriving under trainer Rene Allard, Keystone Velocity exits a career best mile when he won his elimination in 1:48.2 last week, which included an unbelievable final quarter of :25.1. Keystone Velocity is versatile but I think he's best when coming from off the pace; probably won't want to get too involved early with Rockin Ron and potentially others.

As for the other contenders, McWicked couldn't get closer to six lengths from Rockin Ron last week although he should be much closer early having the benefit of the rail. Trainer Coleman has reported that the horse is training well although he continues to be bothered by a foot issue.

Burke said that the plan was for Yannick to take either All Bets Off or Check Six, and since he chose the former we may be able to assume that horse rates better than the latter. All Bets Off is always around for a share, but hasn't been able to break through of late with a marquee win against these types of rivals. Stablemate Check Six is likely to be forgotten from post 10, although he's only three races removed from his 38-1 upset against similar rivals on Hambletonian day.

Dealt A Winner actually beat Rockin Ron two back at Tioga to the tune of 35-1, but he wasn't as strong in his elimination last week. Sintra was bet all the way down to 2-1 last week but couldn't do anything from the pocket against Rockin Ron and now he's staring at it from post 9; tough to make a case for now.

Race 10: NEW JERSEY VIKING hasn't won, yet, on the year, but this is a huge drop compared to the Hambletonian-type foes this one has been up against. On paper he's fast enough, but he is the lone 3-year-old in here against older. JUST FOR TODAY continues to have issues staying flat, but he isn't without a chance if he shows up with his mind on matters. MANWITHAMISSION comes out of his best try yet for Burke; will look to sit a good seat early once again. SILVERMASS VOLO was able to pounce on weaker last time out en route to a career score, but I'd be surprised if he can do it against these; playing against from post 8.

Race 11: PILGRIMS TIDE was well supported when dropped to this level two and three back, but broke both times. He's since qualified to be second to open trotter Hemi Seelster and gets a driver change to Kakaley; worth including at a price. BY AND BY HANOVER makes her second start since the trainer change to Tom Jackson; need not be much to win this. TOMMY BAR may be a short price by





default; Nap gets a shot now. CO-O-TO BLUEGRASS makes his second start at the basement level and WINNING WIZARD has some early speed.

Race 12: WAKINYAN kept up well enough three back at the Meadowlands in a 1:50:4 mile and doesn't look like he's been bad since at Yonkers and Saratoga; may go right to the front on the drop. FOOL OF IDEAS was active throughout in his race last week here in the same class; goes from Buter to Kakaley. MEETBEHINDTHEBARN has been here before and trainer Renaud is more than playable; I don't know if I'd want to get beat by this one. DEALMAKER drops in need of a wakeup; Marcus might take an early shot from out here.

Race 13: AFFAIR OF HONOR has been battling it out against better and he's capable of speed to overcome the post; simply might be a higher quality horse than most of these. Tough call on CENTURION HANOVER as he won here in 1:54:4 in June, but hasn't looked as strong since returning from the qualifier. OMG HANOVER showed speed and was shuffled last out; has hit the board in two straight in this condition. WIAGRAM HANOVER faces older as does #9 but he comes off a quality score; an obvious short priced contender. COMING UP TOUGH goes for a new barn after fading last time out in a 1:54 mile.

Race 14: The old Michigan-bred CADILLAC CRUISER drops for the third straight race and this is a far cry from out he's usually up against. He's an automatic threat from this level and has to be included on tickets, even from post 8. QUIET GIANT is another class dropper although trainer Bath is 1 for 32 at Pocono, another tough call. JJ ALEX invades from Pocono but looks nothing like that 1:53:4 we see from over this track last year. A LISTER wasn't terrible last out against better.

George Brennan said racing at Yonkers regularly makes more sense to him.

Choosing a less hectic lifestyle suits Sears and Brennan

Why two of the sport's top drivers have chosen stability and a saner schedule at Yonkers over chasing the spotlight.

At the start of the current decade, if you didn't believe that Brian Sears and George Brennan were the top two drivers in harness racing, you knew at worst they were in the conversation.

The pair were the top pilots at the Meadowlands and they both experienced plenty of success on the Grand Circuit, as both had won a Meadowlands Pace (Sears added a second in 2016) and had swept the Hambletonian and Hambletonian Oaks on the same day, the only drivers to turn that trick (Sears doing it twice).

In recent years, the prolific pair have not been seen much on the Meadowlands scene, and while it made sense from their perspectives to move their tacks from the Big M to race for the video gaming machine (VGM)-bloated purses offered at Yonkers Raceway, Grand Circuit opportunities have been few and far between for the duo. They're alright with that.

"When I first went to the Meadowlands," said Sears, 49.
"They were racing 220 days a year and that was my home track. Then they started racing 81 days. I'm looking for steady

employment, and George was also, and not only would we have steady employment if we moved to Yonkers, the place is 20 minutes from my house. I live closer to Yonkers than any track. And, for purse money, it's the best place in the country. The best place in the business."

"What happened was," said Brennan, 50. "I would race at Yonkers on the off nights while I was racing at the Meadowlands, but then Gov. Christie reneged on his promise to bring slots to the Meadowlands. The Meadowlands cut their days to 80 a year. It was kind of a no brainer for me. Race 240 days at Yonkers or race 80 days at the Meadowlands. I'm no mathematician, but I knew I could make more money racing at Yonkers."

While overnight purses are low at the Big M when compared to YR, virtually every stakes horse passes through the track that sits in the shadows of MetLife Stadium during the months of July and August. Over the last two years, Sears has had a small handful of stakes performers at the Big M while Brennan has not. They both say it's about how one wants to live.

"You got Dave Miller, Yannick (Gingras), getting on a plane to race sire stakes on a regular basis," said Sears. "Are you kidding me? That's not the way it was. That's not what too many people signed up for. When you came out to the Meadowlands, every good horse had to go through the Meadowlands because it was the best circuit, and then, the Meadowlands drivers picked those horses up and raced on the Grand Circuit. They didn't chase them on the sire stakes

circuit. I would not be surprised if a couple more drivers moved to Yonkers because of the purse money."

"I was totally aware that there would be less opportunity to go out on the Grand Circuit," said Brennan. "I still had some good trainers that I was racing for when I first went to Yonkers, but then I realized I wouldn't be at the Meadowlands to qualify them. The consistency of what I'm doing now appealed to me and it still does. It's a grind. I accept that it's a grind. That's what it is. That's what I do."

One thing is undeniable. The Meadowlands still has big power in harness racing world.

No track comes close in terms of handle. It has the Meadowlands Pace, Hambletonian and a slew of other top-flight stakes races. Scott Zeron said several months ago that one could win four or five on a card at Yonkers and hear nothing. Yet, win twice at the Big M, and the texts come pouring in. Other drivers and trainers have echoed that sentiment.

The purses are huge at Yonkers, for sure, but there is a degree of anonymity when you race there. It doesn't seem to annoy either Sears or Brennan.

"It doesn't bother me," said Sears. "I see the anonymity of the whole business. I think it's about making a living and doing something that you are comfortable with. I really enjoy racing good horses, no question about it. And I really enjoy the pressure of and winning big races. But there's also a thing called lifestyle. When you look at what these guys go through, you get on a plane how many times a year? That's not a lifestyle that I would be very fond of. I came to Yonkers for a reason: To make some money. I've been able to accomplish that. Why do I have to run around at this point? It puts miles on your life. You aren't getting those Sundays and Wednesdays that you race back."

The YR driver colony – according to Brennan and Sears – is

the best in the game. But, still, all is not perfect.

"The shame of it is," said Sears. "We are not racing on a mile track. There's going to be three horses in the race that really don't get to race. You can't race eight horses on that track. You can't race five horses on that track. There's not enough room to put four horses into movement. That's the down side. I prefer racing on a mile track. It's a better scenario for the horses. But it is what it is."

Brennan sees some things moving in the right direction. "They moved the wire back," he said. "The racing is a lot better now. The start and finish are a lot safer. Horses can now make up ground racing first over on the last turn. Before, for some reason, you could not do that."

Sears has been fortunate enough to get some top horses both this year and last. In 2016, he was asked to drive Control The Moment, who went on to win the Meadowlands Pace. This year, he handles Downbytheseaside (who figures to be 2-5 or so in tomorrow night's Messenger at YR), who is in the mix with Fear The Dragon and Huntsville for top 3-year-old colt Pacer of the Year.

"I guess somebody put in a good word for me," said the humble Sears of his getting Control The Moment. "I can be a go-to guy if they need somebody. It's great to get opportunities like that. It's fun to win those big races. It's fun to be in those spots and even more fun to have a competitive horse."

And Downbytheseaside? "The same way," said Sears. "My name must have been on a list. It's not like I have an agent. They know who they might like, they know the list. And I'm glad to still be on it. They know I'm out there, and it's not hard to reach out to me."

Both have won driving titles at the Meadowlands and Yonkers. These days, Jason Bartlett is top dog at the Hilltop Oval. Do they still strive to be No. 1? It doesn't appear to be a high priority anymore.

"If I can win four or five or six on a given card, great," said Brennan, who says he'd still jump at the chance to drive a top stakes-caliber horse on the Grand Circuit were one to come his way. "And if I can get home safe, that's a great night."

"I like the down time at Yonkers," said Sears. "I definitely look for some time off. A few days off here and there. We work hard. It's not necessarily the 12 horses you drive every night. It's the travel to get there. It's time consuming. It's not like you play golf all day and then race at night. You have to prepare. You stay in your routine."

Undefeated Prsntpretynperfect headlines Ohio Super Night

Brian Brown Stable poised for a potentially big weekend.

For trainer Brian Brown, knowing where the next champion will come from is hard. Sometimes he isn't even sure how he ends up with some yearlings. That was the case for Big Bad Princess, whose name was later changed to Prsntpretynperfect.

"My wife bought her at the Sunbury (Ohio Select) Sale," said Brown "I wasn't bidding and they kept looking at me. Jennifer was standing next to me and I didn't realize that she was the one bidding."

Big Bad Princess wearing hip number 61 was hammered down to Jennifer for \$6,000. She soon changed the name of Big Bad Princess to Prsntpretynperfect and the two-year-old pacer is just that, perfect, this season.

"We just call her 'Pretty,' said Brown. "I honestly don't know how to spell her name. I think Jennifer left out some letters to make it all fit.

"We were looking for a cheaper price horse for my son (Beau Brown) and my son-in-law (Cameron McCown) to race at the fairs. She just turned into a much better horse than we ever expected. She trained down really well before the qualifiers (finishing third twice at the Delaware County Fairgrounds)."

Prsntpretynperfect's first start would come in the opening leg of the Ohio Sires Stake (OHSS) at Scioto Downs.

Driver Chris Page floated Prsntpretynperfect off the gate wings out of post seven and patiently sat last in the field of nine past the half mile station. The pair rallied late in the stretch to score the 19-1 upset in 1:55.4.

In the second \$40,000 OHSS leg on July 17 at Northfield Park, Kayne Kauffman was given the assignment behind the promising filly.

"Chris drove another winner the week before (Kay Again in 1:53.4) and chose to stay with that one," said Brown.

Kauffman didn't disappoint, using a first over move to earn a 2 ½ length victory over Prsntpretynperfect's stablemate, Shadows On Time, in 1:54.2 at 8-1.

While bettors were not quite taking notice of Prsntpretynperfect, Richard Lombardo of Solon, OH and Josh Green of Milford, DE certainly did and bought into the daughter of Big Bad John.

"We had been doing some talking before (the July 17th race) and Rich has owned a lot of horses with us. I didn't do a very good job with Rich's yearlings this year and he was

looking for horses to race. He and Josh partner up on a lot of horses so Josh cam along with him," said Brown.

The first race with the added partners was the \$47,000 Ohio State Fair event back at Scioto Downs.

Sent off as the second betting choice, Prsntpretynperfect took the lead just past the 14 mile station and cruised to her third straight win.

The third OHSS leg brought yet another driver's change, this time to Ronnie Wrenn, Jr.

Wrenn guided Prsntpretynperfect to a four length victory over the Scioto oval in a lifetime best 1:54.

"Kayne had to drive his own horse when they drew into the same division, so Ronnie drove her. Ronnie drives a lot for me, but I just thought it was the right thing to do to give her back to Kayne," said Brown "He won twice with her and besides, he's a very good driver."

Although the Prsntpretynperfect and Kauffman reunion for

the final OHSS leg at Northfield Park resulted in a comfortable victory, it also caused some concern when the filly took a couple of bad steps at the start.

"We are not sure what happened at the start," said Brown "The track was real bad that night. I'm not sure if it was the track or she was a little warm behind the gate."

With a perfect five-for-five record this season and \$103,500 on her card, she should head into the \$250,000 Ohio Sires Stake Final on Saturday (Sept. 2) as a solid favorite from post three. Shadow In Time also earned enough points and will start from post five.

"The credit for this filly really goes to Cam and my daughter (Jess). He does most of the training with her and she has taken care of her all year," said Brown. "This filly has something that most horses don't have, the desire, heart and the guts. She just wants to be a winner."

Prsntpretynperfect is one of 10 starters for the Brown Stable in the \$2 million Ohio Sire Stakes Finals at Scioto Downs.

The Browns will send out a quartet in the three-year-old colt pace - Barnabas (post five), McThriller (post seven), Lightning Onmyfeet (post eight) and McRaven (post nine).

"Lightning Onmyfeet was really good in his last race last Friday. I think he will end as one of the favorites. He's not real big horse, but he's a hard-trying horse."

In the two-year-old colt pace, they will send out Slick Mick (post four), Dragonology (post five) and Rock On Creek (post eight).

"If he's 100 per cent, Rock On Creek should be right there," said Brown.

Bye Bye Felicia (post nine) will compete in the sophomore filly pace.

"I think the three-year-old filly pace will be the best race of the night, it is so wide open," said Brown. "If she gets a good trip, Bye Bye Felicia will have a chance."

Despite having several good chances to win at Scioto, Brown will be watching the action from the east coast. He will be with Downbytheseaside in the \$500,000 Messenger Stakes Final at Yonkers Raceway Saturday and with Fear The Dragon in the \$252,000 Pennsylvania Sire Stakes Final at Harrah's Philadelphia on Sunday (Sept. 3).

NAADA (North American Amateur Drivers Association) has categorically rejected any rule aimed at writing out any driver. It is surprising to me that the Meadowlands would put this on the condition sheet as it is still state-owned property. Anyone who has amateur status is welcome in NAADA and will continue to be. All our rules and conditions apply equally regardless of age or talent. I believe that the Billings, NAADA and most of the amateur clubs will continue to accept all who qualify. NAADA named Hannah Miller to represent the USA in the last World Cup and she had the best showing for the U.S. ever. Directing

this at her, Joe Lee and other young individuals is just wrong, plain and simple.

Bartlett hoping to add important line to his resume

The driver would love to earn his first Yonkers Trot at his home track by driving Guardian Angel AS to victory Saturday.

For all the success Jason Bartlett has enjoyed since making Yonkers Raceway his office nearly a decade—and six driving titles — ago, one of the few holes in the resume is a rather chasmic one — a victory in the Yonkers Trot.

"It's the signature race and my home track and it's eluded me," Bartlett said. "It's an important race for me personally and I want to win it.

"I've had three good chances to win it, but none worked out."

In 2008 (when 'sure winner' Holiday Credit jumped it off with an open-length, late-stretch lead), Velocity Hall was sitting in the two-hole (behind eventual winner Napoleon) and had plenty of trot. "I was deciding whether I should get out and go wide, and he broke (going toward the three-quarters). That hurt, because his owner, Tom Dillon, is a good friend of mine from Maine," Bartlett said. A year later, Broadway Bistro, "was very good winning his elimination (first-up), but drew the eight-hole in the final. Even then, I thought he had a chance. Unfortunately, he made a break the second time down the back."

In 2013, Creampuff Macdaddy "couldn't have been any smoother in the elimination, but he hit the bike in the first turn of the final and made a break."

Fast forward to this Saturday night (Sept. 2). Bartlett certainly figures to have a legit shot in the \$500,000,63rd edition. The open draw has him taking a seat behind

Guardian Angel AS from post position four.

The 'Guardian' won the second of two, \$40,000 elimination races a last weekend, grinding by Money Macintosh late to win by a half-length in 1:56.

"I like my chances with him," Bartlett said. "I can't complain about the draw. I'm in between Devious Man (post position one) and Yes Mickey (other elim winner, post six)."

The 3-year-old New York-bred son of 2012 Trot winner Archangel, trained by Anette Lorentzon for co-owners ACL Stuteri AB and Kjell Johansson, has won seven of his dozen seasonal starts (\$138,093), including all four starts here.

This season's Trot has a bit of a different feel, with nine in the final (first time since 2000) after last week's dead-heat for fourth (Di Oggi and Southwind Hydro) in the race won by Guardian Angel AS.

"I can't speak for anyone else, but the extra horse in the field doesn't bother me," Bartlett said. "I just drive my race and go from there."

The Trot goes as the fifth race (approximate post draw 8:35 PM), with each horse (and driver and early computerized line) racing independently...

- 1-Devious Man (Andy Miller, 5-2)
- 2-Di Oggi (Montrell Teaque, 10-1)
- **3-Southwind Cobra** (Matt Kakaley, 20-1)

Was it excessive whipping in this race at Batavia?

A reader wrote in and suggested that I should watch the **9th race from Batavia Downs** last Sunday with reference given to the way the 3rd-place finisher, Cartoonist was driven, thinking it merited mention in this column.

In the interest of full transparency, I think there are a couple of things I should point out before discussing this race and the drive given by J D Perrin to the 7-year-old gelding in this non-winners of \$2,500 in the last five starts pace for a purse of \$4,800. First of all, I am not an anti-whipping zealot. Having been around horses a bit, I somewhat understand their behavior and the need for a whip as a training aid and as a means of correction. I am also a bettor and when the horse or horses I bet are coming down the stretch, I want to see that maximum effort is being made to win a race, and that means urging, most times using a whip. Still, there are supposed to be limits.

In this race at Batavia, Cartoonist was allowed to leave fifth in a six-horse field and sat in until the horses reached the top of the stretch for the first time, heading to the 1/2-mile pole. He was then sent first up and given four one-handers in front of the stands. Down the backstretch, Perrin continued to urge Cartoonist, while he maintained position and he even advanced a bit on the turn after appearing to stall momentarily.

Coming down the stretch to the wire, Perrin wound up and whipped Cartoonist one-handed no fewer than 11 times, with the final one being right on the wire, but the gelding also managed to hold third, so it could be argued that he responded to the zealous urging by Perrin.

The reader's complaint was that the driver in this case was not punished for what he though was egregious whipping action. I consulted the United States Trotting Association Rules Book for an explanation of what constitutes a whipping violation and found that it is basically up to the discretion of the judges:

§ 18.11 Brutal, Excessive, Indiscriminate Use of Whip.—The brutal use of a whip or crop or excessive or indiscriminate use of the whip or crop shall be considered a violation and shall be punished by a fine and/or suspension.



When consulting the list of fines on the USTA's website, it looks like they are reported weekly for the week previous and this appears each Friday. At press time, the information wasn't available, so it isn't entirely evident if Perrin has been suspended for this drive or not. Perrin – who has an impressive record of 94 wins from 387 starts and a .401 UTRS as a trainer this year, has driven only 15 times, recording four wins, the most recent of which was a wire-to-wire score with Cartoonist on August 20th.

At least one reader thinks he should get some time off for this drive. The video evidence suggests that perhaps he may have a point.

USTA providing assistance to Texas

The United States Trotting Association (USTA) has offered assistance to multiple animal welfare groups caring for horses displaced in the recent hurricane and flooding in east Texas.

The USTA's **Support Our Standardbreds** (SOS) program has, since 2011, provided financial help to animal welfare groups or agencies caring for registered standardbreds subject to criminal neglect or abandonment.

There are nearly 100 USTA members in Texas, many of them in east Texas, where flooding has caused massive damage and separated thousands of horse owners from their animals. SOS funds can help cover costs of their care until they can be reunited with owners. Additionally, freeze brands or tattoos should help identify the horse and expedite return

to their owners; USTA staff will assist in that process.

"Most of our membership is a long way from Texas, but we want to support standardbreds and their owners, wherever they are," said USTA executive vice-president Mike Tanner. "By extending assistance through the SOS program, we can help care for standardbreds who may be sick or injured as a result of the flood and we'll also help identify them and get them reunited with their owners. In emergencies such as these, very few animals have any kind of traceable ID, but our horses will be the exception."

Zeron sweeps Champlain Stakes

The Rick Zeron stable stepped into the spotlight by sweeping Thursday evening's Champlain Stakes at Mohawk Racetrack.

Harness Racing Update

A group of 17 rookie trotting fillies competed over the course of two \$86,940 Champlain divisions to start Grand Circuit week. Rick Zeron sent out three starters in Thursday's stakes and came away with victories in both events.

Cantab Hall—Choose Happy filly Courtney Hanover extended her current win streak to three with a 1:56.4 score in the first division for trainer/driver Zeron.

Sent off as the 3-2 favorite, Courtney Hanover got away third heading into the first turn, but quickly inherited second due to a break and was moved to the lead at three-eighths. After taking over the lead from Miss Mimi, the Zeron trained filly led through middle-half panels of :58 and 1:28.1.

Poised to seal the deal in the lane, Courtney Hanover opened up a lead of at least three lengths with an eighth of a mile to go. Blonde Magic, who was 28-1, made things interesting by uncorking a strong stretch rally, but came up a head short at the line.

Bella Glos finished third, while Miss Mimi was fourth.

A \$47,000 purchase at last November's Harrisburg Yearling Sale, Courtney Hanover is now three for six with \$71,570 earned for owners Rick Zeron Stables, Paul Marion, Bruno Dipoce and Howard Taylor.

"This was the first time I moved her and raced her on the front," said Zeron. "She loves chasing horses... She's more of a fighter than a leader, so I was very happy that she trotted right home for me tonight."

A \$2 win ticket on Courtney Hanover returned \$4.90.

The Zeron barn went right back to the winner's circle in the second split, as Atlanta pulled off a 9-1 upset in 1:56.1

A Chapter Seven—Hemi Blue Chip filly, Atlanta turned in a big final-quarter to nail race-favourite Jordan Blue Chip at the line for a career-best victory. The Zeron-trained filly was trotting along fifth at the half, while Jordan Blue Chip had just secured the lead and proceeded to post fractions of :57.4 and 1:27.2.

In the stretch, Jordan Blue Chip turned aside challenger Apprentice M and looked to have victory in her sights, but Zeron tipped Atlanta off cover from third-over and the filly took off. Atlanta got up to win by a nose with a :27.4 final-quarter.

"When I moved her coming down the lane, I knew I needed a lot to come and catch Paul (MacDonell – Jordan Blue Chip)," said Zeron. "Paul heard me coming and I was barking at my filly pretty good and we went across the wire and Paul said 'You didn't beat me again' and I said 'I don't know if I did or not, but I'm pretty happy'.

"She raced really good. She dug right in where she had to and got the job done."

Atlanta was one for four coming into Thursday's contest. Zeron had initially tried the filly in the New York Sires Stakes, but the small tracks weren't to her liking.

"She would get to the first turn and look at it and say 'I'm not going to do this,' so she let me know 'I want to be on a big track,' so here we are and she's doing her own thing."

A \$60,000 purchase at last November's Harrisburg Yearling Sale, Atlanta is owned by Rick Zeron Stables, Holland Racing Stable, Howard Taylor and Brad Grant. The rookie trotting filly now has \$55,025 earned in five starts.

The top four-finishers in the second Champlain division were rounded out by Swing It Cathy in third and Ciao Dolce in fourth. A \$2 win ticket on Atlanta returned \$20.90.

Courtney Hanover and Atlanta are both eligible to the upcoming Peaceful Way eliminations on Monday, Sept. 11.

Grand Circuit action continues Friday night at Mohawk Racetrack with the \$187,760 Champlain for two-year-old trotters (two divisions) and the \$166,872 Simcoe Stakes for three-year-old trotting fillies. Post time is 7:30 p.m.

Dayton preparing for fourth season




