Boni touts Goshen Yearling Sale's successful grads

The 2017 sale will be held Sunday at the Mark Ford Training Center in Middletown, NY beginning at noon.

In 2016, Vecellio Hanover topped the Goshen Yearling Sale with a bid of \$60,000.

Goshen Yearling Sale president Bob Boni said anyone looking for horses would be wise to check out this year's sale to be held Sunday (Sept. 10) at the Mark Ford Training Center in Middletown, NY beginning at noon (check out http://goshenyearlingsale.com for detailed sale information).

"Some pretty good horses have come out of (this sale),"
Boni said Friday. "I think that's what every buyer is looking
for... the ability that when they go to the sale they can get a
colt or a filly that's going to be competitive in the regional
stakes or beyond that. Last year we sold a couple. Just off the
top of my head, Natalie Hanover, a Chapter Seven filly, set a

track record at Batavia this year. She's won \$50,000 or so."

Ake Svanstedt purchased the trotter for \$22,000 at last year's Goshen Sale, who is 2-2-1 in just six starts, with earnings just below \$50,000.

"Scuola Hanover, an A Rocknroll Dance filly sold for \$12,000 last year. She's made over \$100,000 and she was just second in the Pennsylvania Finals (to Rainbow Room)," Boni said.

He also mentioned Hurricane Shorty, a winner of more than \$110,000 with a record of :55 on a half-mile track that was purchased (under the name Compatible With U) by John McDermott's Hurricane Racing for \$8,000 at last year's sale.

Venier Hanover is also a successful Goshen Yearling Sale graduate with wins in 10 of 16 starts and earnings exceeding \$75,000. The gelded pacer was purchased for \$7,000 at Goshen in 2016 by Mitchell York of Cranberry, PA.

Finally, Boni mentioned Lioness Hanover, a daughter of Somebeachsomewhere that sold for \$8,000 last year. In July, Adriana Sorella purchased the filly and told HRU he paid \$100,000 for her.

"There are all kinds of opportunities for people here," Boni said. "We've had a lot of winners, a lot of stake horses come out of the sale. Anybody who is in the stakes business... and you see it with Blake Macintosh or Anthony MacDonald or Ake Svanstedt. They all showed up last year and I think every one of them has bought stakes winner out of the sale."

Last year, 152 Goshen yearlings produced a gross of \$1,852,272 and an average of \$12,186. The average was down by a marginal 3.3 per cent compared to the 2015 Goshen sale in which 39 fewer horses grossed \$1,423,800 for an average of \$12,600.

This year, 112 yearlings — many by major consignors such as the sport's two biggest farms, Hanover Shoe Farms and Winbak — are scheduled to go through the auction ring.

"The question of 'Why are they selling here'? There's a lot of reasons why. It's not because of lack of quality," Boni said. "Very often they are being sold because it's two months earlier than Harrisburg for a seller. That's two month less of keeping a horse around. There are consignors, like Hanover, that have an abundance of yearlings that they have to sell at a number of different sales. Likewise, with Winbak and Steve Jones."

Boni said the sale mix is similar to last year.

"Obviously, the bulk is northeastern-type horses. I'm anxious myself to see the first Sweet Lou and the first Captaintreacherous. These will be the first being sold as yearlings, which is interesting. I don't think anybody expects them to be anything but well received and it'll be interesting to start off selling the first two," Boni said.

Both Hanover Shoe Farms and Winbak will sell 35 yearlings each, Cameo Hills will sell 22 yearlings, Blue Chip Farms will sell 11 yearlings, Concord Stud will sell 10 and Boxwood will sell two.

Boni said the weather forecast for Sunday looks terrific, "and that's always a big plus for us. It's always a concern every time you have an outdoor sale, but the forecast is very good, nice fall weather.

"The location is great, it's an hour from the Meadowlands and just a little more from Pocono and the various training centers. There's no excuse not to participate.

"It's a nice, easy day. We start at noon and you'll be out of there by 4 o'clock and hopefully you'll end up with something that will do some good for you."

Hannelore Hanover cruises, Mambo Lindy upsets in Maple Leaf Trot elims

The \$593,000 final is set for Saturday, Sept. 16 at Mohawk.

The field is set for next Saturday's \$593,000 Maple Leaf Trot following Friday's eliminations at Mohawk Racetrack.

An All-Star group of 15 older trotters were split into two \$40,000 eliminations.

For the second consecutive year, Hannelore Hanover will head into the Maple Leaf Trot final off a victory in her elimination, as the Ron Burke trainee was victorious in Friday's first split.

Driven by Yannick Gingras, Hannelore Hanover got away fifth in the field of seven, while J L Cruze stepped out to post a sharp :26.4 opening-quarter.

Lookslikeachpndale was parked to three-eighths before clearing to the lead, but the lead was brief, as J L Cruze immediately circled back around for driver David Miller at the half in :55.1.

The intense action up front set up well for Hannelore

Hanover, as Gingras moved her to the outside entering the far turn and was able to pick up the cover of first-over challenger Homicide Hunter.

J L Cruze reached three-quarters in 1:23.4, but then gave way to the outside challengers. Homicide Hunter got the lead for a moment before 'Hannelore' powered by in the final-eighth and pulled ahead for a 2 1/4 lengths victory in 1:52.

Homicide Hunter held second, while J L Cruze was third. Odds On Amethyst and Pasithea Face S rounded out the top-five to advance to the final.

Hannelore Hanover was in a slump by her standards coming into Friday's contest, as the five-year-old snapped a three-race losing streak with her Maple Leaf Trot elimination score.

"We wanted to take it easy a little bit on her," said Gingras post-race. "I didn't care which way I was going to race her, but I didn't want to torture her. She's had many tough trips in a row, but tonight it worked out perfect.

"I thought she was very good at Tioga last time, but she hadn't raced in a little while and it was a world record mile, so it was nothing to worry too much about, but I think she's coming back around and she was really sharp tonight."

Hannelore Hanover is now five for nine this season with \$338,486 banked. Her career totals now sit at 31 wins and over \$1.8 million earned for owners Burke Racing Stable LLC, Weaver Bruscemi LLC, Frank Baldachino and J And T Silva Stables LLC.

Hannelore Hanover, who captured the Armbro Flight for the second consecutive year back in June at Mohawk, is a big fan of the Campbellville oval.

"She's a big strong mare," said Gingras. "She likes to stretch her legs and she seems to like this place a lot."

Hannelore Hanover will be looking for redemption in next week's final after finishing second in last year's event. She paid \$3.90 to win.

The second elimination featured defending champion

Mambo Lindy (Tim Tetrick) posted a 26-1 upset in the other Maple Leaf Trot elimination.

Resolve and trotting Triple Crown winner Marion Marauder, but neither would advance when all was said and done.

Mambo Lindy struck for a 26-1 upset for driver Tim Tetrick and trainer Frank M. Antonacci.

Windsun Revenge blasted out to the lead and called the shots through the opening three-quarters of the mile. The Jeff Durham trainee posted fractions of :27.1, :55.3 and 1:23.3 for driver Rick Zeron.

Around the final turn, Crazy Wow came first up and was supplying cover for Resolve, but the defending champ couldn't keep up and dropped back to ultimately finish seventh.

Resolve's struggles also cost Marion Marauder, who was following him. The four-year-old star was seven lengths from the lead turning for home. There was no rally from Marion Marauder, who finished eighth.

Meanwhile, Mambo Lindy and Tetrick, who got away seventh, saved ground moving up the inside on the turn. Resolve's struggles allowed Tetrick to slide into the second-over position turning for home.

Mambo Lindy exploded off cover and shot by his rivals to trot home to a 1:52.2 victory. Gural Hanover finished second by a length and a quarter, while Windsun Revenge was third. The top-five was completed by Musical Rhythm and Warrawee Roo.

A six-year-old gelding, Mambo Lindy had been racing exclusively at Plainridge Park prior to stepping up into the Maple Leaf Trot elimination. He is now eight for 11 this season.

"He's just a really sharp horse," said Tetrick following the

victory. "He thinks he's still King Kong because he's been winning every week at Plainridge and you know horses can't read a program.

"When I tipped him off (Gural Hanover's) back at the top of the lane, he gave me a really good step and from then on it was just my job not to fall off."

Owned by Greathorse of Hampden, MA, Mambo Lindy is now a 22-time winner with \$175,260 earned. The clocking of 1:52.2 lowered his career-mark by a full-second.

A \$2 win ticket on Mambo Lindy returned \$54.50.

The draw for the \$593,000 Maple Leaf Trot final took place following the eliminations. By virtue of their victories, Hannelore Hanover and Mambo Lindy's connections were able to select their post.

Pure Country, Blue Moon Stride take Milton eliminations

The \$256,000 final is set for a week from tonight.

Four-year-olds Pure Country and Blue Moon Stride captured Friday night's \$35,000 Milton Stakes eliminations at Mohawk Racetrack.

A loaded group of 15 pacing mares were split into a pair of eliminations to determine the field for next Saturday's \$256,000 Milton Stakes.

Double millionaire Pure Country started things off by turning in a huge effort to extend her current win streak to three.

The Jimmy Takter trainee got away fourth in a field of seven with driver Mark MacDonald, who wasn't content to sit for long. Pure Country was right-lined entering the backstretch and quickly overtook a second-quarter moving Call Me Queen Be for the lead before the half.

The fractions were hot, as Pure Country was forced to pace a :53.3 opening-half to secure the lead. The Takter trainee rolled right along in the third quarter to reach that station in 1:21.4 and carry the lead into the lane.

Pure Country sealed the deal by edging away from her

rivals and pacing home in :28.1 for a 1:50 score.

"She's got a huge set of lungs," said MacDonald. "I thought, 'I'd rather be on the front than first-over, so I may as well keep pushing' and I was confident she would be strong."

L A Delight turned in a :27.2 final quarter to rally for second, beaten just a length. Lyons River Pride, Witch Dali and Wrangler Magic rounded out the top-five to advance to next week's final.

MacDonald, a former leading driver on the WEG Circuit, took over the driving duties behind Pure Country on July 28 and has since driven her to three wins in four starts.

"I think this game is all timing," said MacDonald. "I caught her at the right time. She was kind of in a four-year-old slump and I got on her right when she was getting on a good roll and we've been a good roll together."

A daughter of Somebeachsomewhere—Western Montana, Pure Country is now three for nine with over \$230,000 banked this season to bring her career totals to 23 wins and nearly \$2.2 million earned. She is owned by Diamond Creek Racing.

Pure Country paid \$2.90 to win.

The second elimination saw all eyes on defending champion Lady Shadow, but Friday wasn't her night to shine.

Blue Moon Stride and driver David Miller capitalized on an

off night by Lady Shadow to win in 1:50 at 7-1.

Sent off at 1-9, Lady Shadow was parked for more than three-eighths before clearing Blue Moon Stride for the lead ahead of a :54.4 opening-half. Blue Moon Stride had also been parked early before finding the front just after the opening-quarter.

Lady Shadow and driver Yannick Gingras turned up the heat with a :27.3 third-quarter to reach that station in 1:22.2. The heavy-favorite didn't have anything left to offer in the lane and drifted out.

Blue Moon Stride took full advantage by powering up in the inside and taking the lead home to win by a length. Sandbetweenurtoes finished second, while Frost Damage Blues was third and Darlinonthebeach was fourth.

Lady Shadow was able to find a way to hold on for fifth to make the Milton Stakes final.

A daughter of Rocknroll Hanover—Classic Star, Blue Moon Stride was just two for 11 coming into Friday's contest, but was coming in off a victory on Aug. 20 at Pocono.

"I raced her a couple weeks ago and she went a big mile on the front end and she beat a couple nice mares," said Miller. "I thought if she could hold that form she would be alright tonight."

Owned by Emilio & Maria Rosati, Blue Moon Stride made over \$400,000 last season as a three-year-old and Friday's victory pushes her over the \$100,000 mark this season. She is now a 13-time winner with \$826,421 in lifetime earnings.

The Mark Harder trainee paid \$17.70 to win.

The post positions for next week's \$256,000 final were drawn following the eliminations. Pure Country and Blue Moon Stride earned the right to select their posts for the final.

What The Hill returns in CTC, and lingering thoughts on rules

Sidelined since his controversial disqualification in the Hambletonian over one month ago, What The Hill returns to the races tonight in one of two eliminations at Mohawk for the Canadian Trotting Classic (CTC).

Trained by Ron Burke, What The Hill underwent a procedure for his throat the Monday following the

Hambletonian and was tentatively being pointed towards making his return in the Zweig three weeks ago at Vernon Downs. Not quite ready to return by that date, the Muscle Hill—K T Cha Cha colt recently qualified a week ago at Harrah's Philadelphia where he posted an easy 1:55:4 win while holding off a stakes-caliber horse trained by Julie Miller from the pocket in that qualifier.

If the What The Hill from Hambletonian Day is what shows up in the CTC, he'll be a force to reckon with. With International Moni in the other CTC elimination, What The

Hill faces a group in his elimination that seems widely overmatched on paper. There are still formidable challengers in the likes of Victor Gio It and Bill's Man, but overall this relatively soft 7-horse field looks like a nice return spot for What The Hill.

Somewhat off-topic from the CTC but relevant to What The Hill, I have lingering thoughts when looking at his past-performance lines; specifically the one from his infamous Hambletonian final.

Despite crossing the line first in a time of 1:52:3, What The Hill was given a notation of TDIS (for Time Disqualified) as his officially charted race time in the Hambletonian. It raises the question about this rule itself, and that is why should a horse have a winning time taken away from him, even he is subsequently disqualified?

Using What The Hill as an example, does the fact he arguably interfered with a non-contending horse take anything away from the fact that he did in fact trot his mile in 1:52:3? I could see the TDIS action taken if a horse crossed the line first but was galloping while doing so, or if he left the course at any point in which the horse wouldn't have actually went a full mile on the trot, but interference or not, this horse earned that win time. In What The Hill's case it doesn't really matter because he already has a lifetime mark of 1:52:1 which is faster than what he would have earned in the Hambletonian, but what if that 1:52:3 from the Hambletonian would have established a new lifetime mark?

In harness racing, a horse's career lifetime mark (or fastest career winning time) carries tremendous weight when considering the historical ability of a horse, not to mention the ability to market the horse as a stallion. A potential career mark should not be "forgotten" because of a disqualification knowing that the horse did actually earn that time on his own merit.

Conversely, why should the second-placed-first beneficiary of a disqualification have their own individual time from a race count towards their lifetime mark? Doesn't this go against the very principle of why only winning horses in harness racing have the winning time of a race count towards their record? This isn't to take anything away from Perfect Spirit, but why should he inherit a win time (which in this case doesn't matter anyway since he too had already established a faster win time than the Hambletonian final), when other horses who miss by winning a race by a nose don't have the benefit of having the time of a race qualifying as a potential lifetime mark?

Another burning issue of mine (or pet peeve I guess you could say) is of the ease in which disqualifications are made

here in the U.S. and in Canada. Throughout most of Europe and Australia where something truly egregious must occur for there to be a re-placing of the results, what we saw in the Hambletonian would have never resulted in a change of order.

At some point, common sense needs to be used and disqualifying a horse that was clearly the best in a million dollar race needs to be re-examined. As is the case elsewhere where far more money is bet into racing than it is here, race infractions should be met with heavy fines and suspensions towards the involved drivers, but other connections including bettor's shouldn't be penalized.

Taking it a step further, almost all of the large bookmakers in Europe have a "first past the post" wagering option meaning that if you bet a horse and that horse crosses the wire first, you would get paid out regardless of the result of any objection or steward's inquiry. I realize that a separate pari-mutuel pool for that very purpose in North America would never catch on, but it's yet another demonstration of other jurisdictions taking all possible measures to ensure that horses that cross the wire first are deemed the race winner in all but the most blatant of circumstances.

Back to the Canadian Trotting Classic, it's quite possible that next week's final could serve as a springboard for either What The Hill or fellow CTC top contender International Moni, if one of these two are able to win the \$684,000 final next week, provided they both qualify for the final (there are only seven horses in What The Hill's elimination and just six horses in International Moni's elimination, with five from each elimination making the final).

No one in this division has been able to separate themselves from anyone else despite the absence of Walner, but there is still a ton of stakes racing to go between now and the end of the year and that begins with the CTC.

Tight finishes at Yonkers

Tuesday night (Sept. 5) the first and last race at Yonkers had dead heats for win.

The 2017 Yonkers Trot and the Messenger were both decided by a nose, as well as the Lady Maud, making the three richest races on the Sept. 2 card ALL that close.

Brian Sears doubled up in the Messenger with Downbytheseaside and the Flight Angel in the Yonkers Trot. This came two months after Sears' Hall Of Fame induction ceremony, and 13 years to the weekend of his driving the very first sub-1:50 freshman Rocknroll Hanover to a 1:49.4 score in the Metro for Brett Pelling.

Sears has two more chances at a Triple Crown race before he turns 50 in January of 2018 — the Jug and the Kentucky Futurity. Can you remember which horse Brian drove in his initial Jug assignment? It was Eicarls Rum And Coke, who was sixth in 1995.

Meanwhile, Sears' nose victory in the Messenger was no big deal compared to the 1969 edition when driving brothers Stanley and Vernon Dancer finished a nose apart at the wire with Bye Bye Sam and Tempered Yankee, respectively, despite being sixth and eighth at the top of the stretch.

With Flight Angel winning the Yonkers Trot from the second tier, it evoked memories of the 1966 Little Brown Jug, when in the first heat Romeo Hanover won from post 6, but both the place and show finisher started in the second tier. Good Time Boy for Jimmy Larente from post 11 and Silent Byrd for Vernon Dancer from post 10. This was a 12-horse field won in straight heats by Romeo Hanover.

Ladies Night at Yonkers

And on a Triple Crown Night, no less. Female conditioners had over half of a Triple Crown race field — the 2017 Yonkers Trot. Julie Miller was 1-3-6, Nancy Johansson was fifth and Annette Lorentzon ninth in this nine-horse field. five of the nine starters. Linda Toscano, not to be outdone, then went 1-3 in the Lady Maud two races after the Yonkers Trot.

Record miles 24 minutes apart

In Toronto in 2004, Cabrini Hanover and Rocknroll Hanover posted the fastest ever freshman miles 24 minutes apart when filly Cabrini Hanover posted a 1:51 scorcher with Mike Lachance, followed by Rocknroll Hanover's 1:49.4 world

record. It was especially historic for Cabrini Hanover's trainer Jimmy Takter, who, on the very same weekend had his sophomore colt Tom Ridge become the sport's fastest trotter with a 1:50.2 world record mile. Last year, Takter sent out history's fastest standardbred when Always B Miki seat a 1:46 world record.

Youth on the Jug menu again?

In 2012, Scott Zeron was 23 when he won the Jug with Michaels Power. In 2015, Montrelle Teague was 24 when he won the Jug with Wiggle It Jiggleit.

That makes them the only two drivers to win the Jug prior to their 25th birthdays.

John Campbell was 27 when he won his first of three Jugs in 1982 with Merger. Mark MacDonald was 27 in 2006 when he made his Delaware, OH debut a winning one with Mr Feelgood and Hall Of Famer Del Cameron was 27 in 1951 when he won the Jug with Forbes Chief.

Doug McNair, Matt Kakaley, Marcus Miller and Zeron could all continue this youth movement in 2017.

No Jet Lag here

In 1999, Jet Laag with Luc Ouellette driving for Linda Toscano, won the Senior Jug in a world record 1:49 on Sept. 19, then came back four days later to win the Magical Mike in 1:50.1.

Herve and Campbell

You don't normally think of Herve Filion and John Campbell as trainers, but both trained their first Jug winner — Filion in 1971 with Nansemond and Campbell in 1982 with Merger.

Quiz

Q. When was the first pacing Triple Crown race held on a mile track?

A. In 2015, Dealt A Winner — with David Miller driving for Mark Silva — won the Cane Pace at the Meadowlands in 1:47.3. It still stands as the fastest Triple Crown race ever.

Ouiz II

Q. Tom Artandi won his first two times in the Jug with B Js Scoot in 1988 and Matts Scooter in 1989. Many forget he won the 1990 Jugette, as well. Can you name the filly?

A. Lady Genius.

Holloway's speed demons

Check out this Joe Holloway stat. He trained the first ever 1:50 two-year-old — Badlands Hanover (in 1998); the fastest three-year-old filly of all time — Shebestingin in 1:47 flat; the first horse to win in 1:47.3 — Jennas Beach Boy in 1996 and trained Always B Miki for a big chunk of his career.

NYSS at Batavia go to Azreal As It Gets and Ubettergo Go

The 2-year-old pacing fillies were at Batavia Downs on Friday night (Sept. 8) to battle for their share of the \$109,000 in purse money up for grabs in the New York Sires Stakes (NYSS).

The first \$54,500 contest saw Azreal As It Gets (Matt Kakaley) lead briefly before yielding to favored Alexis Faith (Jim Morrill Jr.) past the quarter and settle into a garden-spot trip. Azreal As It Gets took full advantage of that strategic spot as Alexis Faith then battled Michelle's Jazz (Ray Fisher Jr.) from the three-eighths pole to the top of the stretch. From there, she found the passing lane and scooted through to win by two lengths in 1:55.4, with a snappy :28.2 final panel. The time was a new lifetime mark for the filly.

It was the first win in six tries for Azreal As It Gets (So Surreal—Vanite Semalu) who now shows \$58,461 on her card for owners Our Horse Cents Stable and Stable 45. Azreal As It Gets (\$6.70) is trained by Jake huff.

In the second \$54,500 division, Ubettergo Go (Billy Davis Jr.) took off the gate and tucked in fifth while Wisdom Tree (Kevin Cummings) and Hurrikane Shorty (Jason Bartlett) set the early pace on the front-end. When Jan (Jim Morrill Jr.) pulled first past the half, Ubettergo Go followed second-over and advanced up the backside. Around the last turn, Hurrikane Shorty gapped the leader and Jan dropped in second. But Ubettergo Go continued to advance against the stubborn Wisdom Tree, who would not give up. Down the lane Cummings and Davis were driving hard but Davis got more out of his filly in the end and won by a half-length in 1:55.3.

The victory was the third of the year for Ubettergo Go (Art Major—Ubetterthink Think), all of which were in NYSS races. Ubettergo Go (\$22.40) has earned \$87,359 so far this year for owners Tony Basile, Reginald Petitpas, Ozzie MacKay and Blake Macintosh, who also trains the filly.

There were also three \$15,000 Excelsior A races on the program Friday night.

In the first division, Act Like A Diva (Roll With Joe – Music Row) went wire to wire for Jim Morrill Jr. in 1:57.2. Act Like A Diva (\$6.00) is owned by Paymaq Racings, Greg Gillis, Louis Willinger and Craig Henderson and is trained by Erv miller.

The second division went to Checkered Past (American Ideal—Character Flaw) who tripped-out in 1:57.4 for Jim Morrill Jr. Checkered Past (\$4.30) is owned by All Star Racing Inc. and is trained by Peter Foley.

The final split was won by Pelican Blue Chip (Rock N Roll Heaven—Feathery Fame) who went gate to wire in 1:56.2. Pelican Blue Chip (\$3.60) is owned by Blue Chip Bloodstock Inc., Michelle Rosato and Matthew Dugan and is trained by Tracey Brainard.

PL Jill defeats Caprice Hill, takes Miss Versatility

Into the stretch, 1-2 favorite Caprice Hill tipped out of the pocket and trotted past Oho Diamond. But Corey Callahan had PL Jill geared up and trotting up a storm farther outside and the 4-year-old Kadabra—Friday's Gem mare kicked home with a :26.3 final quarter to win in 1:53.1.

PL Jill paid \$7.00 to win. She is owned by Daniel Clements and has now won eight times in 33 career starts for earnings

of \$94,389.

Friday's card also included eight divisions in the Kindergarten Series for 2-year-olds of both sexes and gaits.

The fastest mile of the night was turned in by I'm Trigger Happy. The half-sister to millionaires Heston Blue Chip and Sunfire Blue Chip was gapping the field while sitting fifth through the first three-quarters. Into the stretch Callahan got her into gear. I'm Trigger Happy showed greenness while zigging and zagging, but also showed a huge turn of foot to sweep past her competitors and win in an impressive 1:52.2 for her second win from three lifetime starts.

Total handle on the 11-race program was \$1,704,153.

Live racing continues tonight with a 12-race card beginning at 7:15 p.m.

Feisty Kendall Seelster adds Gold win to her growing resume

Kendall Seelster added an Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) trophy to her collection at Mohawk Racetrack on Friday with a commanding victory in the \$125,800 two-year-old pacing filly Gold Series contest.

The win was the Shadow Play—Kiddie Cocktail daughter's second straight at the Campbellville, ON oval — she also won the \$169,381 Champlain Stakes on Sept. 2 — and Mohawk fans sent her off as the heavy favorite in Race 5.

Starting from the trailing Post 11, driver Randy Waples settled Kendall Seelster in sixth on the rail, behind two-time Gold Series winner Big Thong, as Play The Bell and Lady Grande battled to a :27.3 opening quarter. As Cardiff took control heading for the :55.3 half, driver James MacDonald tipped Big Thong into the outer lane and Waples sent Kendall Seelster out in her wake. Cardiff led the field of 10

past the 1:25.1 three-quarters, but Waples swung Kendall Seelster out from behind Big Thong coming off the corner and the fan favorite cruised by her peers to a three and one-quarter length victory in 1:52.4. Lady Grande closed hard to be second, as did Kendall Seelster's stablemate Just Her Luck, to claim the third-place finisher's spoils.

"Randy had mentioned it before that he didn't have to gun her out of there, that she would come from off the pace, and she proved it tonight," said trainer Paul Reid of Kendall Seelster's victory. "It's always good to see when you're not one dimensional; it just makes it so tough if you are."

Reid, whose Ontario operation is based at First Line Training Centre in rural Milton, conditions both Kendall Seelster and Just Her Luck for 1187422 Ontario Inc. of Ottawa, ON and has been impressed with both youngsters since their arrival in his barn.

"I picked them up the first of May and they'd been in like 2:25, 2:20 I guess, and we finished them off and started to race them. (Kendall Seelster) felt like a nice filly right from

the start, obviously I didn't think she was going to be this good. She did feel like she had the ability, but she's a smaller filly you know, I was a little concerned.

"When we first started going fast with her, training fast miles, it was just like flipping a switch, two different horses, because she's kind of short, even in the post parade she's kind of short and trappy going, and then as soon as she hits a nice gear boy it just smooths out and it's just great," the trainer added.

In addition to Monday's win and her Champlain victory, where she dealt Ontario Sires Stakes rival Percy Bluechip her first loss, Kendall Seelster has an overnight win in an Aug. 1 event at Mohawk and four runner-up efforts, three of them behind Percy Bluechip, to her credit. A \$47,000 purchase at the 2016 Forest City Yearling Sale, the filly has amassed \$262,085 through eight lifetime starts. Friday's victory boosted Kendall Seelster's Gold Series point total to 108, putting her in a tie for second behind Percy Bluechip, who skipped Friday's event.

Stablemate Just Her Luck has accumulated 31 points and currently sits seventh in the standings. The homebred daughter of Sportswriter and Just Luck has made just five starts to date, recording one second and two thirds for earnings of \$34,888, but Reid is hopeful that Friday's result means things are moving in the right direction for the youngster.

"(Just Her Luck)'s very, very nice, better gait, more fluid right from the word go," said Reid. "Honestly, when I started with them I thought she might have been the better of the two. It didn't take long to figure out that the other one was, but she's a very nice filly.

"She's been fighting sickness and hasn't been 100 per cent and we give her a little time, and she's coming back around now. I think she's a fast filly, like she's already paced 1:52.3, so I mean she's no slouch. I think this start will help get her a little tighter and hopefully we can keep her healthy. I think she's competitive, maybe not with the top two, but she's only a step behind."

Kendall Seelster will put her two-race win streak on the line against North America's top fillies in the Shes A Great Lady Eliminations at Mohawk on Saturday, Sept. 16, and Reid hopes she continues to channel her growing feistiness into winning races.

"Last week after she won, on the way home she kicked the back window out of my horse trailer. She doesn't get very tired either. A lot of them, as they get racier they get a little more feisty, so hopefully she just keeps putting that feistiness toward the race like she has been."

Following the break for the Shes A Great Lady, Ontario's talented two-year-old pacing fillies will wrap up their Gold Series regular season at Mohawk on Oct. 5, with the top 10 point earners advancing to the \$225,000 Super Final at the Campbellville oval on Oct. 14.

Ontario's top two-year-old pacing colts will battle in their fourth Gold Series event tonight at Mohawk, competing in Races 8 and 10 on a card that also features eliminations for the Canadian Trotting Classic and Elegantimage Stakes and the Simcoe Stakes divisions for three-year-old pacing colts and fillies. Saturday's program gets under way at 7:30 pm.

Jim Morrill, Jr. topped \$100 million in career earnings with a second-place finish in Friday's first race at Batavia.

Jim Morrill, Jr. tops \$100 million

The first race at Batavia Downs Friday night (Sept. 8) may have only been a \$6,500 Excelsior B pace for first-year fillies, but to one participant it was a once in a lifetime milestone.

After finishing second with Fast Date in 1:57.2, Jim Morrill Jr. surpassed the \$100 million dollar mark in career earnings. That places him 22nd on the list among all harness drivers in the history of the sport.

Morrill got his start in the business working for his father at Foxboro Park. The elder Morrill, an accomplished driver himself, always had a small stable there and he laid the groundwork for his son and helped him hone his skills. Jim Morrill Jr. got his first driving start in 1984 and from there he was on his way.

"My father meant everything to my career. He set down everything to get me going when he was still driving and put me on every horse in the barn. I didn't really know what I was doing at the time and would drive one bad here or there and if the owner complained about it, he told them to take their horse to somebody else. And then he'd come back to me and tell me 'You cost me another horse you little whelp."

The family's operation was eventually moved to Maryland and Rosecroft Raceway where the number of horses in the barn grew. Besides driving his father's stock, Morrill started getting a lot of catch drives and soon was finding himself in demand.

Rosecroft used to take six weeks off during Christmas each year and Morrill didn't want to sit idle, so in 1990 he went to New York and started driving for Ray Schnittker and George Anthony at Yonkers Raceway. He soon found a lot of success there as well and decided that move would be permanent.

Morrill recalls his most memorable races as being the 2004 Meadowlands Pace where Holborn Hanover was a 58-1 upset winner in 1:49, equaling the stake mark and the 2009 Jugette where Showherthemoney made a break in her elimination before coming back to win that race and the final as well three races later.


Jim Morrill Jr. left the New York metropolitan area in 2005 and relocated his business and family to western New York.

"I have never regretted moving to the Batavia-Buffalo circuit, we love it here. My wife's sister and mother live near us and when I'm on the road she has her family now instead of being up in New Jersey by herself. The New York Sires Stakes has been great for me as well as the overnight starts and we're just gearing up for the next however-many years to come."

In 2006 at Batavia Downs, Morrill set the all-time driving standard for the track with 177 wins and a UDR of .537 for one meet.

For his career to date, Jim Morrill Jr. now has had 37,332 starts with 6,902 wins, 5,692 seconds and 4,753 thirds with \$100,046,554 in earnings.




