Sears doubles up in Ohio

The driver won the \$125,000 Jug Preview with Downbytheseaside and followed that up two races later with a victory with McWicked in the \$225,000 Jim Ewart Memorial at Scioto Downs.

Downbytheseaside (Brian Sears) was dominant in Saturday's Jug Preview at Scioto Downs.

The connections of Downbytheseaside are hoping this truly was a preview of the Little Brown Jug after their charge cruised to a 1:51 win Saturday in the \$125,000 Jug Preview at Scioto Downs.

When the starting gate wings folded, the two Ohio-bred entries, Drunk On Your Love (Dan Noble) and Scotch Mcewan (Josh Sutton) grabbed the early lead, putting the eventual winner in third past the quarter in a pedestrian :28.2.

Brian Sears didn't want to allow the slow fractions and sent Downbytheseaside to challenge Drunk On Your Love and cleared the field of seven before the half in :56.2.

Downbytheseaside was pressured by Sports Column (Andrew McCarthy) down the backstretch and to the three-quarter pole in 1:24.1.

Using a :26.4 last quarter, Downbytheseaside sprinted clear of the closing Filibuster Hanover (Matt Kakaley) to score the 1 1/2 length win. Sports Column and Drunk On Your Love held on for third and fourth respectively.

The son of Somebeachsomewhere—Sprig Hanover is owned by Country Club Acres, Joe Sbrocco, Richard Lombardo and Diamond Creek Racing and trained by Delaware, Ohio based Brian Brown.

“It’s great to win at home,” said Brown. “I’m a little more relieved. He wasn’t his best last week.”

When asked what his plans were for the Little Brown Jug (September 21), Brown’s comments were brief, “We plan on winning.”

Sears was back in the Scioto Downs winner’s circle a couple of races later when McWicked used a wicked late kick to nail Rockin Ron (Matt Kakaley) in the \$225,000 Jim Ewart

Memorial Pace in 1:49.3.

Luck Be With You (Aaron Merriman) led the field of 10 past the quarter in :26.1.

Dave Palone sent the favorite Mel Mara to the lead as they came in front of the stands the first time and led past the :54.2 half.

Rockin Ron moved to the lead as Mel Mara tired badly and retreated through the field at the three-quarter pole in 1:21.3. Rockin Ron was clear by three lengths as they turned for home, but McWicked unleashed a furious move in the passing lane to secure the neck win in 1:49.3. Rockin Ron held on for second and Boston Red Rocks (Josh Sutton) and

Check Six (Chris Page) dead-heated for the show spot.

McWicked, the six-year-old son of Mcardle, is owned by Edward D. James and trained by Casie Coleman.

"I thought the fractions was little slow. I thought I might need to see a half in :53 or even better to have a shot," said Sears. "My horse has a really good move, too. I've had the opportunity to drive him quite of few times... He fires home

for you, if you don't overuse him.

"I thought I had second locked up. My horse kept digging. He's a little lazy at times, but once I got into him, he responded and really fired."

Gelding upsets Bold Eagle in Masters final

Aubrion du Gers defeated many of the best horses in Europe Saturday at Vincennes in the Prix Ete, the final of the European Trotting Masters.

During the year, horses are collecting points from the big races in Europe and at this time of year the finals are contested in some of the countries connected to the U.E.T. (European Trotting Union).

Nuncio, Propulsion, Timoko and Billie de Montfort were some of the most celebrated horses in a field of 14 in the \$217,000 Prix Ete, the final of the European Trotting Masters Saturday at Vincennes in Paris.

Contested over 2,700 meters (1.7 miles) in the pouring rain in Paris, home favourite Bold Eagle was, as usual, served a perfect trip by his driver Franck Nivard. Trainer Sébastien Guarato had two horses in the race and his Valko Jenilat opened quickly for the lead and had about 10-15 meters down to his followers most of the race.

Bold Eagle could follow in the back of Jean-Michel Bazire's gelding Aubrion du Gers by the last turn and it seemed like the Prix d'Amérique winner from the last two editions would bring the gold to the stable of Sébastien Guarato. But Aubrion du Gers is an extraordinary horse and despite the trip, where he had to do the job first over in the field behind the leader, the seven-year-old son of Memphis du Rib fought strongly and disarmed the heavy favourite.

Bold Eagle finished second and bronze medalist Twister Bi did more than great when he made up many lengths on the leaders with a half mile to go.

Aubrion du Gers won in an approximate mile time of 1:55.1. Unfortunately for the trainer, driver and owner Jean-Michel Bazire, geldings are not allowed to participate in big group 1 races in France, so there will not be a meeting between the two big stars in French harness racing in the 2018 Prix d'Amérique 2018.

Yonkers judges keep longshot up after she left the course to avoid an accident

Replay – Friday, Sept. 8 – Yonkers, race 8

Race 8 at Yonkers Friday night featured an incident where the two leaders hooked wheels around the second turn, and thankfully, all the horses that were racing behind them were deftly taken out of harm's way.

What set social media alight, however, was the path that the eventual second-place finisher, Betabecool N, took to get around the trouble that plagued the \$50,000 fillies and mares open mile dash.

While many of the trailing horses were steered wide and around the trouble, 59-1 shot Betabecool N – who had left last after starting from post 8 – was steered off the course into the safety lane around the turn and she came out of the trouble on the lead.

Betabecool N was overtaken at the half by eventual winner, 4-5 race favorite Newborn Sassy. Betabecool N finished second, in a large part due no doubt to the ground saved during the incident. Some bettors were wondering why – after a lengthy inquiry – the result was allowed to stand when she had been clearly off the course when she passed the field. “How can a horse go from worst to first in the infield and stay up?” asked horseman Jimi DeLucia rhetorically in a lengthy Facebook post started by owner Howard Perlmutter.

“If they left that horse up then it should be no contest! Very ridiculous...,” commented bettor Steve Plantamura.

DRF Harness writer Greg Reinhart chimed in on Twitter by posting the replay with this comment “Gong show race of the year tonight at Yonkers. The 8 was allowed to keep her 2nd place finish.”

While trying to find a rule the judges might have relied on to allow the order of finish to stand, this was the closest I could find in the USTA Rules Book:

“A horse while on stride, or part of the horse's sulky, that leaves the race course by going inside the pylons which constitutes the inside limits of the course, when not forced to do so as a result of the actions of another driver and/or horse, shall be in violation of this rule.

Certainly, it could be argued that driver Greg Merton was forced inside the pylons by the entire field scattering in front of him and it appeared he took the safest route for him and

his horse at the moment he chose to steer left.

Some opined that he had no other reasonable choice. “He HAD to leave the course or else,” chimed in Moira Fanning of the Hambletonian Society. Her comments were echoed by Julie Allison. “They all went everywhere... it would have been too hard to try and place them,” she reasoned.

Yonkers track announcer John Hernan may have hit the nail on the head with his comments, that suggested the judges were in a no-win situation with the bettors. “Either way the judges went would have been unpopular, he did leave but it could have been a horrible scene.” He wrote. “Upon watching it several times, the judges deemed, I think correctly, Merton was justified to leave course. I think part of it is discretionary.”

While some disgruntled punters may have seen this is just “another way to lose a race”, those that cashed in on the exacta or tri would have no complaints. Maybe it's a case of extreme “racing luck” with the best part of the entire incident being that all horses were steered to safety by their quick-thinking teamsters.

Callahan and Butenschoen sweep Cdn Trotting Classic elims

The duo deliver with Bills Man and Dover Dan. Meanwhile Ariana G and Dream Together took the two eliminations for the Elegantimage.

The team of driver Corey Callahan and trainer John Butenschoen connected to capture both eliminations of the Canadian Trotting Classic on Saturday night at Mohawk Racetrack.

A group of 13 three-year-old trotting colts and geldings

were split into two \$40,000 eliminations to determine the field for next Saturday's (Sept. 16) \$684,000 final.

The first elimination saw Bills Man charge home in :27.2 to win in 1:53.2 for Callahan and Butenschoen.

The son of Credit Winner—Silver Springs got away fourth with Callahan and would sit in that position until the final turn. Victor Gio IT showed the way, posting fractions of :27.3, :56.4 and 1:25.2.

What The Hill enjoyed a two-hole trip and was angled out of the pocket approaching three-quarters, which provided cover for a moving Bills Man.

In the stretch, What The Hill took the lead with an eighth of a mile to go, but couldn't fight off Bills Man on the outside and Dancer Hall on the inside. Bills Man would reach the wire first, defeating Dancer Hall by a neck.

"I knew I had (What The Hill) beat and then I saw (Dancer Hall) sneaking up through there, but the horse had plenty of trot," said Callahan about the victory. "The main thing is we just wanted to get through there error free."

Lindy The Great got up for fourth, while Victor Gio IT dropped back to finish fifth.

Owned by William Wiswell and M And L of Delaware LLC, Bills Man has had a lot of close calls, including a loss by a nose in his Hambletonian elimination. He was winless in his last nine coming into Saturday.

"He's had a lot of bad luck," said Callahan. "You know you don't get many chances to win the Hambletonian and he raced his heart out in the elimination and then drew post 10 and I mean that was really a heartbreaker... He puts forth his best effort and he's going to have his day."

Bills Man is now three for 14 with \$248,986 earned this season, which boosts his career totals to five wins and \$319,427 in lifetime earnings.

The Butenschoen trainee paid \$7.20 to win.

The same duo would return to the winner's circle in the second split, but this time it was a front-end mission that got the job done.

Dover Dan went coast-to-coast for a 1:52.3 victory. The son of Andover Hall—CR Kay Suzie shot out quickly to the lead and proceeded to hang up fractions of :27.4 :56.1 and 1:24.1.

Long Tom and International Moni sat second and third, respectively, throughout the early-going, but both were moved to the outside nearing three-quarters.

In the stretch, Dover Dan dug in to fight off his outside rivals and score the victory by three-quarters of a length. Long Tom was second, while International Moni was third.

Seven And Seven finished two-lengths behind the winner in fourth, while Southwind Cobra was fifth to make the final.

Owned by Wiswell, Jean Goehlen and Eugene Schick, Dover Dan came into Saturday's contest with plenty of momentum after winning last Sunday's Pennsylvania Sires Stakes Championship.

"He's always been better for me when you leave with him a little bit and kind of get him interested," said Callahan. "I told John (Butenschoen) ahead of the race that Scotty (Zeron – International Moni) usually kind of ducks his horse off, so I

was going to push off and hopefully follow Tetrick (Long Tom), but he was content to follow me and I kept the fractions honest and everything worked out well."

Dover Dan's victory improves his three-year-old record to four wins in 14 starts and nearly \$230,000 earned. The Butenschoen trainee sports career totals of eight wins and \$352,047 earned.

Dover Dan paid \$14.40 to win.

Forced to choose which elimination winner he will drive in next week's final, Callahan wasn't shy in sharing which direction he will likely go.

"I'll likely stick with Bills Man. I think he's the fastest of the two, even though (Dover Dan) went a bigger heat tonight, I think just pure speed wise, Bills Man is just a little bit quicker."

Trainer Butenschoen also had a decision to make, as he got to select which posts his duo will start from in the final. Bills Man will start from post two, while Dover Dan will start from post three.

The \$684,000 Canadian Trotting Classic final will take place next Saturday (September 16). It joins the Maple Leaf Trot to make up a huge night of racing with purses expected to top \$2 million.

The three-year-old trotting fillies also had a chance to

shine on Saturday evening in a pair of \$35,000 eliminations for the Elegantimage.

As expected, Ariana G took care of business in the first elimination for driver Yannick Gingras and trainer Jimmy Takter.

The daughter of Muscle Hill—Cantab It All and winner of over \$1.4 million got away fifth before moving first-up at the half. She cleared to the lead at three-quarters in 1:25.4, before trotting home effortlessly in :27.3 to win by nearly five-lengths in 1:53.2.

Coming in off a strong victory in last week's Casual Breeze, Gingras thought Ariana G was even better on Saturday.

"Last week she was very good, but I think tonight she was vicious."

Magic Presto finished second, while On A Sunny Day was third. Lady Grey and Sweet Of My Heart rounded out the top-five finishers.

Owned and bred by Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld, Ariana G is now eight for 10 this season with \$645,027 earned and 17 for 20 overall.

Ariana G paid \$2.10 to win.

The second elimination saw Dream Together turn in a :27.1 final-quarter to track down Feed Your Head and win in 1:53.3.

Driven by Daniel Dube for trainer Luc Blais, Dream Together got a three-hole ride, as Feed Your Head got her way on the front. The Takter trainee posted fractions of :27.2, :57.2 and 1:25.4 to lead into the lane.

Dream Together avoided a three-quarter breaking Thats All Moni and then found her best stride in the lane. The Blais trainee rocketed home and zoomed by Feed Your Head to win by two lengths.

"I got away third and moved her late and she responded well," said Dube, who had last drove Dream Together in the Hambletonian Oaks. "The last time at The Meadowlands I left and moved first over and she raced really well and now she finally got a better trip and raced well."

Winter Sweet Frost finished third, while Glitzey Gal was fourth. Dream Baby Dream made a break at the start, but recovered to finish fifth after a few others made miscues.

A daughter of Muscle Hill—Danae, Dream Together picked up just her second win of the season, but has been consistent all year. She's hit the board in seven of eight starts and earned \$130,341.

Dream Together is now a six-time winner with career

earnings of \$230,934 for owner Determination of Montreal, QC. She paid \$8.30 to win.

The \$385,000 Elegantimage Stakes final will also take place next Saturday.

The finals for both the Canadian Trotting Classic and Elegantimage were drawn following the eliminations.

Art Scene and Bettors Up impressive winners in Simcoe

The 2017 Simcoe Stakes wrapped up Saturday with two events for three-year-old pacers at Mohawk Racetrack.

A field of 10 colts and geldings competed for a purse of \$162,838, while nine fillies battled for \$163,872.

Knocking on the door coming into the Simcoe for colts, Art Scene kicked the door down with an impressive five-length victory in a career-best 1:49.4 for driver Scott Zeron and trainer Tony Alagna.

The son of American Ideal—*Lover Of Art* got away fourth in the early stages. *Penzance Hanover* posted an opening-quarter of :26.2, before allowing *Classic Pro* to clear and hang up a half of :55.

Zeron got Art Scene in motion approaching the half and rushed up to take the lead entering the final turn. The colt reached three-quarters in 1:22.1 and then said goodnight to his rivals by pulling well ahead and pacing home in :27.3 for the impressive victory.

"I know he's raced really well his last two races over at

Yonkers, but that was impressive right there,” said Zeron.

Ocean Colony finished second, while Hurricane Beach was third.

Art Scene only made one start as a rookie, but his connections knew he had potential.

“We had to really be patient with him,” said Zeron. “Tony (Alagna) did a great job with him all throughout the beginning of the year.

“We really thought he was going to be a top colt right at the beginning and it took us a while to get to the point where we’re at right now, but it’s exciting to have a horse finishing off the year and peaking right now.”

Art Scene is owned by Brittany Farms LLC, Alagna Racing LLC, In The GYM Partners and Americam Art Stable. He is now three-for-13 this season with \$255,936 in earnings.

Art Scene paid \$4.40 to win.

Fan Hanover champ Bettors Up picked up another stakes victory at Mohawk with a huge performance in the Simcoe filly stakes.

Driven by Doug McNair, Bettors Up got away fifth in the early stages, while Obvious Blue Chip had to work for more than a quarter of a mile to get the lead and post a :54.2 opening-half.

Idyllic Beach came first up from fourth on the far turn and that allowed McNair to situate Bettors Up in a perfect second-over spot. Obvious Blue Chip led by three-quarters in 1:22.3.

In the stretch, Bettors Up rocketed off cover and stormed home for an impressive 6 ½ lengths victory in 1:50.

Dudesalady finished second, while Stonebridge Sundae was third and Idyllic Beach fourth.

Trained by Scott McEneny, Bettors Up came into the Simcoe Stakes off a solid victory in last Sunday’s Pennsylvania Sires Stakes Consolation.

“I didn’t want to be first up,” said McNair. “I floated and found a good spot and live cover. On the last turn I thought I was in a good spot and she still felt good, but that’s the best she’s felt since

the Fan Hanover.”

Bettors Up is now four for 12 this season with earnings of \$415,735. Her career totals now sit an impressive 10 wins and \$631,964 earned. She is owned by Brad Grant, Teresa Davidson and Michelle McEneny.

Bettors Up paid \$12.60 to win.

The rescue of Killean Cut Kid

A disturbing story about a pacer that was sent to slaughter with open wounds looks like it will have a happy ending thanks to a social media campaign and Dina Alborano paying his bail.

Killean Cut Kid is a 12-year-old gelding who raced 258 times over the last decade earning over \$300,000. His last charted mile was a seventh-place finish at Miami Valley on April 11.

His unusual story has more recently made the rounds on Facebook and Twitter, drawing anger, concern, praise and “trolls,” according to Dina Alborano, who orchestrated the pacer’s rescue. The New Jersey-based standardbred racehorse owner said she “paid bail” for Killean Cut Kid at Bastrop, “one of the most horrific thoroughbred auctions, in Louisiana.”

The Mach Three—Winning Lin’s son’s identity was not known to Alborano at the time. “Somewhere along the line, he had a guardian angel, I think, because he came to the attention of several of the people with Standardbred Retirement (Foundation),” she said. The pacer’s “bail” was \$600, reflecting his extremely poor condition. “Sad as it sounds, they couldn’t ship a horse with open wounds across the border to Mexico for slaughter. He was marked as ‘direct ship,’ which meant we should have never even been able to get him.”

Killean Cut Kid is now in a secret location, but the Standardbred Retirement Foundation (SRF) is appealing to the public for help.

“If Kid must retire with SRF the expenses will exceed tens of thousands of dollars,” the SRF said in a statement. “We are very hopeful that the right offer for a lifetime home for him is in the mix or will come through. Serious inquiries to home him when he is ready should fill out an application for adoption on [SRF’s website](#). Donations are still needed, are tax-deductible and may be made by mail to SRF, 353 Sweetmans La., Office 101, Millstone Township, NJ 08535, through the [website](#), through Paypal at SRFHorsesandkids@gmail.com, or by calling SRF at 732 446-4422. Please note Kid on your support for him.”

How Killean Cut Kid ended up at Bastrop, following Facebook posts indicating he was euthanized by previous owners in August, is a matter now playing out on social media. Importantly, the facts are also being investigated by the U.S. Trotting Association. USTA Executive Vice President and CEO Mike Tanner provided an official statement to HRU on Sept. 9:

We are aware of the situation involving Killean Cut Kid, and are disturbed by the photos that we have seen. There is no room in the sport for what is alleged to have happened to Killean Cut Kid. The USTA has assigned its contracted investigator to explore this matter, and that inquiry is ongoing. The USTA also has been in contact with the appropriate authorities to make them aware of the existence of our investigation, and have committed to turning over to them all of our findings when the process has been completed.

It is important to understand the limits of the USTA’s authority as it relates to investigations like the one pertaining to Killean Cut Kid. The USTA is not a regulatory or enforcement agency and can only suspend membership to the Association if the facts warrant it. The USTA does not have the authority to suspend a member’s racing license; that power resides with the state racing commissions. Nor can the USTA seize horses, which is a matter for the legal authorities. Our investigation is progressing and the USTA will issue another statement when it is completed.

Alborano admitted it’s frustrating that a minority of owners assume programs such as the USTA’s Full Circle and Save Our Standardbreds will take full responsibility for their retired horses. “At SRF, they call the ex-owners, and a lot of them are really good. They’ll pay the full ‘bail’ [to buy horse at auction]. A trainer will pay the full bail; a driver will pay the full bail. There are really good people in the industry.”

The USTA provided a description of the Full Circle Program, founded by the American Quarter Horse Association, which the USTA was the first breed registry to adopt. “Anyone, member or not, can enrol a horse. The Full Circle icon appears by a horse’s name in our free tattoo lookup and we have three staff available 7 days a week to provide that information to those making inquiries.”

The USTA said the program is well-utilized and helpful: “This year, we have had 17 inquiries from people who’ve identified horses in Full Circle and in need of assistance. While we wish that number was bigger, it is well ahead of last year’s pace and we expect it to keep growing. There are 9,330 horses enrolled in Full Circle by 1,242 people. Many have enrolled every horse they ever owned or bred, there is no charge to do so.”

Alborano called Killean Cut Kid’s situation “just so different” in that a horse which was destined to disappear became extremely prominent instead, attracting attention to rescue efforts, like those of the Standardbred Retirement Foundation. She said that she is independently dedicated to equine rescue across all equine breeds, but has a special place in her heart for standardbreds — her brother, Joe Alborano, owns world champion stallion Artistic Fella (p, 5, 1:48.0f; \$2,604,855), a Full Circle enrollee.

She said she would rather see a program which reserves one per cent of all racehorses’ earnings, and one per cent of their sale price as yearlings, to be put toward their future, than reliance on programs and donations to support them. Not all of the animals can be retrained for use as pleasure horses, she noted, although SRF provides many to new homes. “I want an article to get out there and say to people, please don’t send your horses to someone you don’t know; don’t send them up to the Amish. Give us a call,” said Alborano, who can be found under the Twitter handle [@EquineAltitude](#).

Betting Yonkers is frustrating

It is almost impossible to bet races at Yonkers Raceway. First off, dealing with the minutes to post is one thing – it must mean Central Stand time. But that's not my main point.

How can you bet a race without knowing what the odds are? In every race there seems to be odds on one, two or three horses at 3-1 to 5-1. But that means nothing as with every flash of the board its bounces all over. The 3-5 is now 2-1, the 5-1 is now 2-1. I would like to play the 5-1 but how can I as by the time the race goes off, at Central Standard time, the horse is 8-5?

I know the reason. THERE IS NO HANDLE. There's \$4,500 in the entire win pool. The exacta pool has more money than the entire WPS pools, and that isn't much either. Each night the total handle is roughly between \$450,000 and \$550,000 regardless of the day of the week.

Now they have a beautiful live stream in HD available to all free of charge. That's a great thing but they do not have a product worth streaming. I can only imagine what goes on behind the scenes involving betting and when bets are placed and all the other games.

Also, the way races are raced. In every race someone battles for the lead in a :27.2 quarter, then backs down the second quarter to :56.1 or slower. Hardly anyone pulls first over until the third turn. Usually that horse stalls somewhere down the backstretch forcing someone to go three wide on the final turn. Then an inside move in the passing lane. Rarely does a horse not in the top four finish in the money. BORING.

With no handle and only slots supporting the extremely large purses this is a situation that is doomed. The Meadowlands far and away offers a substantially better betting product with lesser quality horses and cheap purses,

but generates over \$2 million in handle nightly. How is this possible? Mr. Spock would say "It's not logical."

Big supporter of Gural, but...

No one roots for the Meadowlands to succeed, get slots, and return to glory more than I. Thus, I preface my comments by saying I am a full supporter of the Big M. However, why Mr. Gural felt it necessary to comment on the story regarding drivers George Brennan and Brian Sears is beyond me ([2017-09-03 Feedback](#)).

Yes, these big name drivers left the Big M to chase the slots money in front of an empty grandstand and watchful pigeons over at Yonkers. However, for the most part, drivers have nothing to do with the success of the Meadowlands. Don't get me wrong, no one wants to bet amateurs or C track drivers, but the success of the Meadowlands is based on the handle generated by FIELD size and competitiveness. When the fields have nine and 10 horses and the races are competitive, the races will produce a good waging results regardless of whether the drivers are Hall of Famers, newbies, or D track drivers. Oddly, last year I believe Mr. Gural pointed out that an amateur trot at the Meadowlands produced more wagering than the International Trot at Yonkers. Thus, one only has to remind him of his own comments to prove that NAMES mean nothing. The success of the Meadowlands, sans slots, will rise or fall on competitiveness and field size as well as the fact that the track is a one mile oval.

Claiming that Brennan and/or Sears should have "called" Mr. Gural before he invested in the new grandstand is preposterous as well. That statement may be the biggest pile of horse dung ever spoken. I'm sure Mr. Gural has good intentions and a great desire to aid the sport, but just be honest in saying that the \$130/140 million "investment" is more about a casino. The partners involved with Mr. Gural, such the Hard Rock (I'm not 100 per cent sure if they are still on board, I admit) are not interested in the equine athletes. They're interested in the gold mine that would come from a casino in northern NJ. I, along with a lot of my friends at track I've spoken with, preferred the old building. Even the some tellers and some of the security preferred the old Big M. That ridiculous expenditure of a new grandstand has all to do with preparing in case a casino is approved. The new building hasn't done anything to increase handle or attendance.
