No matter how you dissect it, L A Delight's Jugette victory Wednesday was decades in the making – from the Hall of Fame trainer and driver duo who have spun magic together for nearly 40 years; to the Ohio boys that never lost hope of one day standing in winner's circle at the Delaware County Fairgrounds when it mattered most on a Wednesday or Thursday and straight through three generations of a royal equine family cared for by one woman.

After John Campbell converted a perfect pocket trip in the second heat into a three-quarter length victory over first heat winner Call Me Queen Bee, the emotions bubbled over in the winner's circle.

John Campbell won a record fifth Jugette when he drove L A Delight to victory.

"It means a lot," said Keith Carpenter, one of the three Carpenter brothers who, along with partner John Strock — all of Liberty Center, OH — have tried to win either a Little Brown Jug or Jugette for 25 years — 23 of those in partnership with Hall of Fame trainer Bob McIntosh of LaSalle, ON.

"We've been with Bob since '92 or '93 and we've never wavered. We've got a great relationship and had a game plan. We wanted to buy good mares and we spent a lot of money early on buying good mares and now we're reaping the benefits of those purchases," Keith said of the group that includes his twin brother, Ken, and their older brother, Mike Carpenter.

One of those purchases came in 2002 when McIntosh, his cousin, Al McIntosh and the C S X Stables spent \$115,000 to purchase a Camluck mare named Los Angeles at the Kentucky Standardbred Sale. Los Angeles quickly became one of McIntosh's great foundation mares, producing a string of talented pacers that collectively earned north of \$4 million, including L A Delight, who now sports career earnings of \$932,253 with 18 wins in 25 starts.

Nicole Pedden-MacQuarrie not only groomed Los Angeles, the caretaker also looked after virtually all of the mare's offspring and their offspring — 11 in total. No wonder she was smiling like she just hit the lottery as she cooled out L A Delight in the Jugette barn as pockets of golden sunshine danced at the hoofs of the homebred daughter of Bettors Delight out of Los Angeles' daughter West Of L A.

"It's so surreal. I can't believe we were in the winner's circle here today. I'm kind of shocked," said Pedden-MacQuarrie

who screamed herself hoarse. "These American fillies have been dominant. (L A Delight is) always giving 100 per cent, but being here four or five days out, getting out of her routine, it's a little difficult for them all. But, she overcame it."

L A Delight also overcame a judges' inquiry in the \$95,760 first heat when she made a break at the wire after finishing second by four-and-a-half lengths to Call Me Queen Bee who set a 1:50.1 world record for three-year-old pacing fillies on a half-mile track.

The judges ultimately kept L A Delight up, but Call Me Queen Bee was the one that made an emphatic statement.

"I think a lot of this is about gaining respect from the other people," said Call Me Queen Bee's driver Scott Zeron after the first heat. "Any time people talk about the three-year-old division they really leave my horse out and she really proved in the PA Final that she can play with the best of them."

Zeron tried to steal the \$143,640 final, going to the front out of the rail and trying to outsprint them to the wire, but Campbell sat patiently with L A Delight and had just enough filly to surpass Call Me Queen Bee in the lane.

Moments later, McIntosh said he couldn't be happier for his partners — his cousin, Al, and the C S X boys.

"They've been supporters of Delaware for a long time," McIntosh said, adding the C S X guys love the Jug so much they donated to help build the spectacular Jug barn many years ago and then noticed they were the only donors who had never won the Jug. They, like McIntosh, are still chasing that dream. Though, they did win the \$1.5 million Pepsi North America Cup together in 2012 with Los Angeles' son,

Thinking Out Loud. Yes, Pedden-MacQuarrie was his caretaker, too.

"We've had some good horses in the Jug, but it just hasn't worked out with post position or racing luck," Strock said. "But winning the Jugette is like the North America Cup – they can't take it away from us now. It's in the bank," Stock said.

"I think Bob said it best," added Keith. "It means an awful lot when you raise them and it's a great family. (L A Delight has) been special."

For the old masters, this victory traces back to the late

1970s at dearly departed Windsor Raceway when McIntosh and Campbell teamed up for the first time to race a horse.

"She was a \$4,000 claimer, and not a very good one," McIntosh said, laughing.

Fast forward 40 years and Campbell was celebrating his record fifth Jugette victory and McIntosh – who won the Jugette in 1992 with

So Fresh (with Campbell driving) and in 1994 with Electric Slide – had just tied Billy Haughton for the most trainer wins in the Jugette with three.

"I'm very humbled to be in the same class," McIntosh said, referring to Haughton.

"As I get older, I get fewer opportunities, fewer people sending me horses. That's just the way the business goes. It rewards youth," McIntosh said. "I've had a good career and I've been lucky, but people just kind of turn the page on you and think you don't take outside horses. Well, I do. I will take horses, but at least I have my homebreds."

McIntosh and Pedden-MacQuarrie raced L A Delight's dam in the 2009 Jugette. West Of L A finished fourth in the first heat and seventh in the final.

"I raced her second dam. She's a true homebred," McIntosh said of L A Delight. "To have John drive her and with all we've been through together, it's just a great day. I can't even describe it. It made my whole year."

Filly scratched from Jugette, Pena evicted from Delaware County Fairgrounds

Tuesday afternoon, judges at the Delaware County Fairgrounds (DCF) scratched I Said Diamonds from Wednesday's Jugette and evicted trainer Lou Pena from the grounds after Pena was allegedly discovered in the filly's stall Tuesday morning in the Jugette Barn. Pena is unlicensed in the state of Ohio. I Said Diamond is programmed as being trained by Matias Ruiz.

Wednesday afternoon, an official with the DCF released a statement that said, in part, "It was determined that an unlicensed individual was present in a restricted area in violation of detention rules. In the best interest of the race it was decided to withdraw her from the field."

Harnessracing.com reported that Pena was holding I Said Diamonds while the Well Said—Silksndiamonds filly was being treated by a veterinarian and the pacer's connections "told Jugette Barn security the filly was in distress due to signs of colic, and needed to be treated. Security did not immediately recognize Pena, despite the fact that his name was on the front of his shirt. Security confiscated what was being used to treat the filly and sent it for testing."

Trainer Bob McIntosh, who won the Jugette with L A Delight, told harnessracing.com he was prepared to scratch his filly when he heard about the incident, but said he was glad the issue was resolved by judges.

I Said Diamonds is owned by Perry De Luna's A Piece Of The Action LLC of Culver City, CA. She has earned \$410,957 lifetime with a record of 7-6-2 in 19 starts. She is 4-4-1 in 13 starts in 2016 with earnings of \$268,687.

Meadowlands racetrack owner Jeff Gural, who successfully banned Pena from his racetrack, was asked to comment on Tuesday's events involving the trainer. Gural responded by email saying he believes progress is finally being made in the integrity battle.

"I think we may finally be making progress in dealing with these criminals," Gural wrote. "In New York, the state is working with us on out-of-competition testing and we are seeing some dramatic changes in the performance of horses being trained by known drug trainers."

Jug Society eliminates raceoff beginning in 2017

The 25-member Little Brown Jug Society held their annual meeting Wednesday morning (Sept. 21) at Ohio Wesleyan University. The LBJ Society voted in several major changes for future Little Brown Jug and Jugettes.

The Society voted to eliminate the possibility of a third heat (race-off) starting with the 2017 Little Brown Jug. The event will be raced at two heats and the winner of the second heat will be declared the Little Brown Jug champion.

"Our number one concern is the health of the horses," said Tom Wright, president of the Little Brown Jug Society. "We have wrestled with this decision for a number of years. We respect the traditions of the Little Brown Jug, but we felt the long term interest of the horses were more important."

The Society also voted to revise the post-position draw for the second heat starting with the 2018 LBJ. The elimination winners will draw for the inside posts and the remaining positions will be drawn at random.

Supplemental entries to the filly companion event the Jugette will be honored starting in 2019. Horses not eligible for the three-year-old event may enter for \$25,000.

The Society also announced that future Jugettes may be raced at one heat should the entries levels dictate. The Society will work with the Delaware County Fair racing officials to determine the appropriate number of entries to go one heat. That announcement will be made in the near future.

In other business, Tom Wright (President), Phil Terry (Vice President) and Bill Lowe (Secretary) were re-elected as officers.



Racing Hill primed and ready

Tony Alagna said his trainee is in great shape heading into today's 71st Little Brown Jug.

Tony Alagna has no regrets about passing up a great shot to win the Little Brown Jug three years ago when he and the other connections of Captaintreacherous opted to skip a race that didn't suit their horse. But then, as in, now the trainer was effusive in his love of the Jug.

"We wanted to do the right thing by the horse and hopefully this is our year to win it. The Jug and the Hambletonian are still on our list, that's for sure," Alagna said Wednesday in the Jug Barn shortly after his hopeful Racing Hill received a new set of shoes. "We haven't been able to win the Jug yet, but we'll get our shot and maybe he's the one."

Racing Hill and Brett Miller will start from post two in the second of two \$92,320 Jug heats. Racing Hill is the 3-5 morning line choice in the field of five. Betting Line is the 3-5 choice in the six-horse first heat.

Alagna said Racing Hill, a homebred owned by Tom Hill of the United Kingdom — who will be present on Jug Day — is coming into the race in top form.

"I think he's coming into the race in good shape and the rest, I believe, is up to Brett. I don't think there's anything, at this moment, that I would wish to be different with him right now. His bloodwork is good, everything checks out good, so it's all systems go.

Racing Hill's last pari-mutuel start was a victory on Sept. 3 in the \$500,000 Messenger at Yonkers.

"I figured if he could go over Yonkers, then he could go over (Delaware)," said Alagna, referring to the fairgrounds' half-mile oval. "He was very good in the Messenger, just a shutdown mile in :53 and he was very good over that track.

And if he got around Yonkers, he ought to get around here with no problems."

The son of Roll With Joe—Chasing Ideals has not finished off the board in his 11 seasonal starts and owns a lifetime mark 1:48.4.

Alagna said what he loves most about the Jug is its history.

"The people that are here, they truly, truly are harness racing lovers," Alagna said. "Now Ohio has been able to get slots and some more money around here, but long before that these people were true harness racing

fans. So any time you can bring a top-notch horse to have the people come to the Jug barn and see him, it means something. And it means something to a lot of us. We spend so much time as trainers with our heads down just doing our job that we never lift our heads up and realize how blessed we are to have these horses and it's an honor to bring them here and have these people be able to see them. That's what I enjoy about the Jug the most.

As for a favorite Jug, Alagna motioned to the stall where Wiggle It Jiggleit was holding court.

"I didn't see a lot of the early Jugs, but, of course, Wiggle It Jiggleit's Jug was one of the greatest races ever," Alagna said as Wiggle It Jiggleit's caretaker Big Mike Taylor walked past and grinned. "It goes down in history."

Today, Alagna is hoping to make some of his own.

A Feelgood Moment 10 Years On

A decade after Mr Feelgood won the 61st Jug, driver Mark MacDonald reminisced about one of his greatest career victories.

In a quiet moment in the Jug Barn Wednesday, driver Mark MacDonald slipped over to Western Fame's stall to give the colt a pat and some inspiration the day before the two will contest the 71st Little Brown Jug.

Ten years ago in this very stall, Mr Feelgood stood, virtually unnoticed, as a crowd gathered around his neighbor, straining to see the dog-sized speedster named Doonbeg.

"Everyone wanted to see the little horse. Adam Hanley was (Mr Feelgood's) groom and he was standing there with Mr Feelgood and it was like a joke, 'Hey guys, Mr Feelgood over here.' But no one wanted to see him. He was put off, because he loved the horse so much and I said, 'We'll get them on the track, don't worry about it,'" MacDonald said.

Get them they did. Mr Feelgood won the 61st Jug for MacDonald, Hanley, trainer Jimmy Takter and owners Lindy Farms of Connecticut, Diversity Stable and Canamerica Capital Corp.

MacDonald said he remember Takter working some serious trainer magic on Mr Feelgood prior to the Jug.

"He changed his gear because we couldn't get him around Mohawk. He wore a giant rollover and I couldn't get him around the turns at Mohawk and Jimmy warmed him up (in Delaware) and said, 'Mark, the turns are so small here that he's in and out of the turns before he gets running in, so I'm going to take the Murphy and the big pole and put a little headpole on him,'" MacDonald said. "I said, 'I don't know about that,' but he said 'Trust me,' because he said I don't

think you'll be able to make any speed with him if he's running out in the straightaways. He was 100 per cent right and the horse was so good. That was the only time he went straight all year. He was in and out on the turns, but then down the backstretch when it straightened up, he'd just go and we could never make speed like that. So, in hindsight, it did make sense. He was just thinking outside the box and that's

why Jimmy is as good as he is."

MacDonald said the Jug win was one of the biggest of my career.

"You know, my mom and my dad were here. My family was here. They were all in the winner's circle," MacDonald said. "I remember seeing the aerial shot, there was almost 50,000 people here. I've won some Breeders Crown and North America Cup with Sportswriter, but this is just such an intense atmosphere for a driver. To win on that stage, it's a heightened stage."

Sears elected to Hall of Fame

Brian Sears, a “youthful veteran” of the sport of harness racing who stands fifth on the all-time list of money-winning drivers and has driven some of the sport’s greatest horses of the last 15 years to victories in championship races, has been elected to the sport’s highest honor, the Hall of Fame. Balloting was conducted by the United States Harness Writers Association (USHWA), the trade organization of harness journalists.

In addition, Gordon Waterstone and Steve Wolf, two veteran harness publicists and writers whose careers share many similar highlights and awards though they never worked together directly, have been elected to the sport’s Communicators Hall of Fame.

Sears was named USHWA’s Rising Star of the Year in 1991 and hasn’t looked back. Sears, a 48-year-old native of Fort Lauderdale, FL, who now resides in Secaucus, NJ, was at the top rungs of the driving colony of Vernon Downs, Pompano, Pocono, and The Meadows before moving eastward to the metro New York area a dozen years ago.

He has continued to dominate on the toughest circuits in harness racing, winning multiple driving championships at the Meadowlands and also topping the charts at Yonkers Raceway. Sears entered Monday with 9,670 career wins, good for 14th place among all drivers in North American history.

Among the horses that have helped boost his career driving earnings to \$174 million all-time are three winners of the Horse of the Year title: Rocknroll Hanover in 2005, Muscle Hill in 2009, and Bee A Magician in 2013.

Sears is the only driver to twice win the Hambletonian and Hambletonian Oaks on the same day, accomplishing the feat with Muscle Hill and Broadway Schooner in 2009 and again with Royalty For Life and Bee A Magician in 2013. He also won the Hambletonian in 2015 with Pinkman in his only drive behind the horse that season.

The sport’s Driver of the Year in 2009, Sears has won 26 Breeders Crown titles, good for number four on the all-time wins list in the series. Horses driven by Sears have earned more than \$10 million in the series, which is among the top five in history.

Waterstone was for many years the publicist for Hazel Park in Detroit, also working at other area racetracks, before becoming associate editor of The Horseman And Fair World, which was a magazine when Waterstone started and for whom he wrote two John Hervey Award-winning stories, before becoming a multimedia enterprise in recent years.

Wolf was a publicist for several tracks in the immediate area of his native New Jersey and for the Standardbred Breeders and Owners Association of New Jersey before “shipping south” to Pompano Park in Florida, rising through the ranks to become senior director of racing operations, until starting his own consulting agency. He also served on the Board, including as president, of the Harness Horse Youth Foundation.

The formal induction ceremony will be held at the Hall of Fame dinner at the Harness Racing Museum and Hall of Fame in Goshen, NY, on Sunday, July 2, 2017.

Hall of Fame voting is conducted among eligible USHWAs and members of the Hall of Fame; Communicators Hall of Famers are voted on by all members of the Harness Writers Association.

Polls bad for NJ Casinos

According to an article Tuesday on NJ.com written by Brent Johnson, a new poll indicates the north Jersey casino referendum indicates the measure may not pass.

A Rutgers-Eagleton poll released Tuesday “shows 50 per cent of the voters say casinos should stay confined to Atlantic City, a one-point increase from the group’s last survey. Meanwhile, 40 percent say such gambling should be expanded, a four-point drop. Three per cent say they don’t want gambling anywhere in the state and seven per cent are unsure.

“New Jersey voters will be asked Nov. 8 to decide whether to expand casino gambling outside of Atlantic City and allow two new gambling halls to be built in the northern part of the state.”

Delaware casinos to plead for legislative relief again

Delaware's casinos are set to make the same recommendations for legislative relief for the third year in a row, according to an article Tuesday in the Delaware State News.

Dover Downs Hotel and Casino president and CEO Ed Sutor said the market remains "saturated" because of competition in neighboring states, although Dover Downs did make a profit of \$1.9 million in 2015.

"The plan the council is set to approve next month would contain several recommendations.

The first option would be to alter the revenue-sharing formula, lowering the tax rates when revenue is down and increasing them when more money is flowing in.

The casinos will also suggest having the state pay all the slot vendor costs. In 2014, lawmakers agreed the state would take on 75 per cent of the vendor costs, at a cost of \$9 million.

Another proposal has two facets that deal with table games. Both parts would eliminate the annual license fee of \$3 million, while the first would slice the table game tax rate from 29.4 per cent to 15 per cent. The second would have the state share in the cost of vendor fees instead.

The final part of the recommendations calls for implementing marketing and capital credits, essentially incentivizing the casinos to invest more in themselves.

If nothing is done, proponents of legislative help say, the casinos could go under."
