# Jacobs chasing Hambletonian with \$335,000 session-topper

Owner Ken Jacobs bought a Muscle Hill colt out of Missymae Bluestone during Thursday's third sale session. It is the second highest-priced yearling to sell, so far, this year at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale

Southwind Bugz, a Muscle Hill colt out of Missymae Bluestone, was the day three topper thanks to a winning bid of \$325,000 by Ken Jacobs. The colt is now the second-highest priced yearling to sell through three days.

Just one day after announcing he got his (undisclosed) price to syndicate Walner to stand stud at Southwind Farms in New Jersey, owner Ken Jacobs of Baldwinsville, NY was back buying trotters at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale trying to land another Hambletonian hopeful.

Jacobs topped Thursday's third session of the five-night sale being held at the Fasig-Tipton Pavilion in Lexington, KY when he paid \$335,000 for Southwind Bugz, a Muscle Hill

colt out of Missymae Bluestone.

The price is the second highest of the sale following the \$480,000 spent by Swedish agent Robert Lindstrom during Wednesday's second session to buy the Muscle Hill—Sina filly named Beautiful Sin from breeders Jeff and Paula Gural and Monica Reschke and consignor Northwood Bloodstock.

As the name suggests, Southwind Bugz was bred by Southwind. The colt was consigned by Preferred Equine, which, through the first three sessions of the sale, held a large lead over the consignor standings with nearly \$7.5 million in gross sales, so far.


Linda Toscano, who conditioned Walner for Jacobs, will train Southwind Bugz. Toscano said she conditioned Southwind Bugz's seven-year-old half-sister Southwind Cocoa, a Chocolatier filly that earned over \$275,000 for owner Richard Gutnick.

Toscano said Southwind Bugz, "stood well and was a nice mover... and is, basically, the whole package.

"I didn't think he would sell that high but I leave those decisions to Ken. I'm looking forward to training him."

Reid said he thought Southwind Bugz would sell well, but it is very hard to predict exactly how well.

"I'm not shocked, but it was a pleasant surprise for (Southwind). There were four major players in on that horse and it was kind of a sleepy type of horse on the third night,

but that was by design to be here. Physically, he stood out – right spot, right night, but, more importantly, he was the right horse. He was going to sell well, wherever he sold. It was good to have him tonight and put a little energy into the crowd."

Reid said Jacobs is making a statement with the purchase.

"He wants to win the Hambletonian and by picking a Muscle Hill, it's probably a good place to start," Reid said. "It was a good, spirited bid and it ended up going Mr. Jacobs' way and I wish him the best of luck and hopefully (Southwind Bugz is) a champion."

In all, 160 yearlings went through the ring Thursday. The session gross was \$7,615,000 and the average was \$47,594, which is up 13.8 per cent from the \$41,834 fetched on day three in 2016. The gross was up 25.5 per cent from the \$6,066,000 fetched on day three last year.

The number of \$100,000+ yearlings is up sharply from 76 last year to 99 in 2017.

Through three sessions, the 2017 sale has grossed \$30,395,000 for 411 yearlings sold and produced an average of \$73,954 that is up 1.03 per cent from the three-day average of the record 2016 sale of \$73,198.

"The (increase in) average is interesting, because we've sold more horses this year," said Reid who manages the sale with Randy Manges. "We've sold 411 vs. 378. That's 33 more horses. It continues to be good, right across the board. We said, right from the get-go, that we had a very deep catalogue and this carries forward and kind of supports our claim. I was happy to see a good night again."

Ranked by gross sales, Reid's Preferred Equine has nearly a \$3.6 million lead over second-place consignor Kentuckiana Farms through three sessions. Preferred has sold 112 horses and averaged \$66,929, while Kentuckiana has sold 50 horses for \$3,898,000 total and averaged \$77,960.





"I'm very satisfied," Reid said.

Though relatively light in purchases the first two nights, Canadian buyers were more active on day three, accounting for more than 25 per cent of the gross sales, compared to just 12.5 per cent of the gross on opening night and 17 per cent of the gross on day two.

"It was a little bit of a different crowd and I actually thought the Canadian trotters, especially, were received quite well between the E L Titans, the Archangel and Royalty For Lifes. There was definitely a good Canadian feel and I expect that to continue the next two nights," Reid said.

Manges said he was "really pleased to see how strong the Ontario-bred yearlings sold."

Canadians make up three of the sale's top six buyers, so far. Gino Toscani of Mount Hope, ON, is the sale's third leading purchaser — behind Jimmy Takter (\$1,057,000) and Burke Racing Stable (\$925,000) — with \$902,000 spent on 12 yearlings.

"I think, more importantly, it's the number of horses (Toscani) is buying not the gross dollars, even though they are both very impressive," Reid said.

Quebec's Determination Stable is fifth on the buyer list with \$790,000 in purchase, just slightly ahead of Quebec's Team Allard which has spent \$780,000 to buy 10 yearlings.

Sires Muscle Hill and Somebeachsomewhere continue to top the sire list as in previous years. Muscle Hill is averaging \$115,857 through three nights with 49 sold. Somebeachsomewhere is second on the list (for stallions with three or more offspring sold) with an average of \$103,448 for 29 sold.

"Overall, it seems like there's been good flow and the numbers have supported that and I'm looking forward to (tonight) and Saturday night," Reid said. "There's a lot of nice horses and there's a nice mixture. It's a very healthy environment right now and that's great to see."

## Uniform rules will someday be a reality...

... thanks to an important person's willingness to lead

During the evenings this week I spent my time watching Mohawk and Red Mile, but due to the horrible event in Las Vegas on Sunday night, I also kept the news channels on my screen.

I, like many of you I imagine, watched stories of both horror and heroism, often times going through the range of emotions about the good in people, contrasted with the bad.

What I also saw watching the news — almost each hour — was panel after panel talking about guns. After seeing four or five (of what seemed like four or five hundred) of these segments, something very odd struck me. At times, when the yelling subsided, I noticed there was quite a bit of common ground on several issues. The panel would vociferously agree, for example, that existing rules were not enforced as well as they could be, and there was not proper accountability in the current laws. They'd all nod, and then they'd resume yelling at each other.

I thought it was pretty weird – sad really – that people could actually agree on something regarding this polarizing topic, and it never seems to get worked on; it's just a short respite before starting up another argument.

Not to equate harness racing with such an important societal topic, but in our sport I get the same type of feeling when it comes to uniform rules. In fact, I think it's even more perplexing.

A driver driving for the first time at The Meadows has to invariably ask another driver what the rules are; say for whipping, or pylons. That driver will hopefully get the correct answer, but it might not be the right answer, because these rules are so different. He'll probably find out the rule for certain, only if he does something wrong.

And, strangely enough, sometimes the answer given might not have anything to do with a rule at all. "Yes, the rules say you can't do that, but they never call it, so you can do it."

Then this odd tribal dance occurs the next week at Monticello, or Mohawk, or the Meadowlands.

Could you imagine what it would be like for an NFL offensive lineman where holding is called differently at 31 different stadiums? That's not too far off what drivers go through.

Flipping over to the customer – that pesky person that pays for a lot of purse money – what he or she goes through on a regular basis is equally, if not more crazy.

On any given evening, a customer may find they're holding a potential \$2,000 superfecta ticket, but there's a pylon inquiry. As the judges wind and rewind the tape, the bettor can't even form an opinion if their \$2,000 is real money or ticket confetti, because they have no idea what the pylon rule is at this track. They saw this exact same thing called last week at Scioto so they should cash the ticket, but you just never know, because the judges (and perhaps the rule) could be different here at Yonkers.

Can you name one single thing in this sport that 100 per cent of your customers agree on, that 100 per cent of your participants also agree on? If not, I think you've found one – uniform rules. Yet, time and time again, decade after decade,



nothing seems to get done.

Why I think problems or issues with so much agreement fail, is because of a lack of leadership. A leader brings people together, finds common ground, and creates a system whereby something gets done through the bedrock of modern policy making — honest debate and accountability. Without it, molehills become mountains.

But for harness racing at least, I think that's recently changed.

As you've probably heard, John Campbell of the Hambletonian Society (I still can't get used to typing that) has begun rallying people behind a new uniform rules initiative. Unlike so many other policy starts that come and go, John, through his leadership position, is looking at this as a long-term solution. There's no timeline, it's not dictatorial; it's bringing people together who agree on a common theme, and working towards a goal.

"The beneficiaries are twofold – this will benefit the gamblers betting on our game across North America as well as participants and judges. It will be better for all involved to get this accomplished. It's not something to be done quickly," he said.

John's leadership on this topic was felt almost immediately. Barely two months after the initial announcement in the U.S., Dan Gall put together a similar **committee at Standardbred**Canada to work hand in hand with John, to hopefully ensure that U.S. and Canada rulebooks would be uniform.

That's what happens with leadership – the snowball is given a push at the top of the hill, and it grows bigger and bigger.

Whether John succeeds or fails over the next few years is debateable – harness racing certainly is not structurally built for change. And I certainly don't want to put undue pressure on him and him alone. But I'm confident this time it has a chance.


Why? Because virtually every driver, groom, trainer and owner; every bettor, handicapper or fan, wants this to happen. And they have a respected leader at the helm to rally around. That's much more than half the battle.

Trainer/driver Kurt Sugg has toured the state of Ohio competing at county fairs from Ashland to Wooster. Thanks to his hard work and the success of his stable, he has two morning line favorites in the \$200,000 (div) Ohio Fair Championships Saturday night (Oct. 7) at Northfield Park.

In the \$25,000 Jay Wolf three-year-old filly pace, Sugg will send out Da Vinci Artist, the 7-5 choice from

The daughter of Art Official-Da Vinci Road has won 14 times in 26 seasonal starts, including nine wins in 11 starts at the county fairs.

"(Da Vinci Artist) is not a very big filly, she's kind of little, but very good gaited and kind of quick," said Sugg.

Da Vinci Artist owned a seven-race win streak, including winning efforts at Marion, Cortland, Hilliard, Bucyrus and Painesville, completing an undefeated July. She earned her two most important fair wins at Ashland and Wooster, the home fairs for her owner and Sugg.

She was purchased at the 2015 November Blooded Horse Sale as a yearling by owner Robert D. Corbin.

Da Vinci Artist has shown tremendous consistency, failing to earn a purse check in just three career starts. Her career earnings have now surpassed \$130,000, turning a nice profit from her original \$10,000 price tag.

She competed in three legs of the Ohio Sire Stakes, finishing third, third and fifth against the top level of sophomore filly pacers in the state.

"The draws are what hurt her in the sire stakes. She just didn't draw very well," said Sugg. "She will race in the (\$50,000) consolation of the Ohio Sire Stakes next weekend and she will shut down for the rest of the year."

Sugg will also drive Momentsoffire in the two-year-old filly

trot final (post 1 / 2-1 choice).

The freshman daughter from the first crop of Winning Fireworks out of KT Pricelessmoment has a 4-3-3 record in 17 seasonal starts.

"She's kind of a big filly," said Sugg. "I wish she didn't have that many starts, but if she didn't she wouldn't have made the finals. She just squeaked in with her last start (a win at Dover on Sept. 24) to get into the top nine."

She took her 2:00.3 mark in the July 12 leg of the Buckeye Stallion Series leg at Northfield Park.

"The draw is really going to help her a lot. Last weekend she had the seven hole in the (\$40,000 Buckeye) Stallion Series (Final) and she didn't fare so well," said Sugg. "The competition may be a little easier this weekend and the rail isn't going to her any."

Momentsoffire was purchased in July by John Schlabach, Walnut View Farm and Stebe Mullet from Aaron Yoder. Yoder purchased her as a yearling for \$4,300.

The \$200,000 (div) Ohio Fair Championships will also feature Carmensdaleyapple and Dekeyser.

Carmensdaleyapple, a two-year-old colt pacer, will be looking to run his undefeated streak to 17 straight. The son of Mr Apples – Mydaleybread must overcome the outside post number 8 for driver Pierce Henry and owner/trainer Joe Paver.

The sophomore colt trotter, Dekeyser won the \$40,000 Buckeye Stallion Stakes Final last weekend and has been installed the 3-5 morning line choice from post. The son of Djarmbro-Pink Ribbons has earned \$110,289 for his owners, Synerco Ventures, Steven Zeehandelar and trainer Christopher Beaver.

## Met's Hall leads International Stallion Stake winners

Other divisions went to Night Rhythm, Fourth Dimension, Quality Kemp and Fashionwoodchopper.

Met's Hall trotted into a hot pace to take the top, maintained and expanded his lead while advancing to a 1:52.4 open-length performance in the fourth of five divisions of the \$300,000 Trixton International Stallion Stakes, sponsored by Deo Volente Farms, on Thursday (Oct. 5) at Red Mile.

Sitting second as Farsetti Hanover sprinted to the quarter in :26.4, Met's Hall took the front moving into the backstretch, setting a half of :54.4 and held control at three-quarters in 1:24.1 before kicking away from pocket-sitter Farsetti Hanover into the stretch. Dawson Springs, riding cover around the turn, closed for third.

Owned by Stroy Inc. and Andy Miller Stable Inc., Met's Hall, by Cantab Hall out of the Mutineer mare Met's Inn, won his fifth race in eight starts this season, compiling \$127,135 in earnings. The \$2.80 winner is conditioned by Julie Miller and was driven by Andy Miller.

Following a disqualification, **Night Rhythm** was placed first in the opening division of the ISS, taking over the top spot from Shoshie Deo, who interfered with 6-5 favorite Wolfgang down the backstretch, causing him to lose stride.

Night Rhythm launched for the top, grabbing the lead before trotting a quarter in :28.1, with Shoshie Deo trotting in second. Into the backstretch, Seven Iron tipped first over, advancing toward the leader with Wolfgang riding his cover briefly, clearing the top before a :57 half.

Patent Leather rushed first over after the half, taking the lead from Seven Iron moving into the turn. Shoshie Deo, shuffled to third, tipped wide moving to three-quarters, pressuring pacesetter Patent Leather in 1:26.1 before powering to the lead in the stretch. Night Rhythm, shuffled to fourth, fanned off the rail and trotted down the center of the track while Patent Leather faded at the inside in third, with Shoshie Deo holding a length advantage on Night Rhythm at the line, with Patent Leather third and Seven Iron fourth.

With Shoshie Deo disqualified to sixth, Night Rhythm, by Muscle Hill out of the Andover Hall mare Tail Of Night, won his second race in six starts, earning \$77,552 for owners Lindy Farms of Connecticut and Robert Rudolph. Trained by Frank Antonacci and driven by Scott Zeron, he paid \$26.80 to win.

Fourth Dimension brushed to the front and coasted to a lifetime-best 1:52.4 win in the second ISS division.

Sitting third as Hat Trick Habit posted a :28.3 opening quarter, Brian Sears tipped Fourth Dimension wide, rushing to take control before three-eighths. Leading unchallenged through a :57 half and three-quarters in 1:25.2, Fourth Dimension turned for home clear of Hat Trick Habit chasing from second, with Crystal Fashion rallying off cover down the center of the track, grabbing second while Hat Trick Habit settled for third.

By Chapter Seven out of the Muscle Hill mare Corazon Blue Chip, Fourth Dimension, owned by Courant Inc., won his fifth race in seven starts, earning \$129,700. Trained by Marcus Melander, he paid \$5.40 to win.

**Quality Kemp** sat the pocket and slingshot passed 3-2 favorite and tempo-setter Keystone Apache to take the third ISS split in 1:54.3.

Matt Kakaley sent Quality Kemp for the lead, trotting a quarter in :28.3 before yielding to Keystone Apache after a :57.1 half. Sitting as Keystone Apache trotted to three-quarters in 1:25.4, Quality Kemp remained at the rail until pulling wide into the eighth pole, trotting 1-3/4 lengths clear of My Lindy Winner rallying down the center of the track into second, while Keystone Apache shortened in stride and held on for third.

Returning \$26.60 to win, Quality Kemp, by Muscle Hill from the **Credit Winner** mare Impressive Kemp, broke his maiden in the tenth start of his career. The Ron Burke trainee has earned \$67,962 this season for owners Burke Racing Stable, Silva, Purnell & Libby, Weaver Bruscemi, and Michelle Yanek.

Scoring his fifth consecutive win and besting Peter Haughton winner You Know You Do, **Fashionwoodchopper** took the final ISS division, winning in 1:53.

## DeLong sweeps 3-year-old stakes finals at Hoosier Park

Hoosier Park Racing & Casino highlighted the Thursday (Oct. 5) program with two \$75,000 Indiana Sires Stakes finals for the sophomore trotting colts and pacing fillies and it was driver John DeLong who made a clean sweep of both divisions. The stakes wins were two of four wins on the evening's 14-race card for DeLong, who is currently third on the leading driver standings at Hoosier Park for the 2017 season.

Swan Chase continued his winning ways and turned in a gritty performance to capture the \$75,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Final for three-year-old trotting colts and geldings. With a final time of 1:54, the William Crone trainee recorded his fifth consecutive Hoosier Park victory.

DeLong sent Swan Chase away from the gate to get the first call through the opening panel in :27.3 but would eventually yield the lead to the Bluebird Rambo and Sam Widger just before the half in :57.

Bluebird Rambo continued to call the shots through the three-quarter clocking in 1:25.4 and looked strong on the front. As the field turned for home the stage was set for a battle down to the wire with Bluebird Rambo on the front and Swan Chase poised to strike from the pocket. DeLong sent Swan Chase up the passing the lane but Bluebird Rambo didn't go down without a fight.

Using a :28 closing quarter, Swan Chase was able to stick a nose in front of Bluebird Rambo on the line. Ideal Jesse and Verlin Yoder rallied well to round out the trifecta. As the 3-5 post time favorite, Swan Chase returned \$3.40 to his backers at the betting windows.

With the win, the son of Swan For All-Precisionist notched

his 12th win from 18 seasonal outings. Owned by John Barnard, Swan Chase has now won 15 of 29 lifetime outings while bankrolling \$268,543 in lifetime purse earnings.

DeLong would find the winner's circle just a few races later, this time scoring the 18-1 upset with Amazing Arya in the \$75,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Final for three-year-old pacing fillies. Scoring in 1:52.1, Amazing Arya found racing room late in the lane to prevail in a tight photo and establish a new lifetime best in the process.

Owned in partnership by William C De Long., William P De Long, and Ray E De Long, Amazing Rya recorded her fourth victory from 16 trips behind the gate in 2017. The daughter of Rockin Image—Honey's Luck is trained by Roger Welch and has now won eight of 30 lifetime outings while earning \$172,559 in purse earnings.

With the wins, Amazing Arya and Swan Chase solidified their spots in the \$200,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final for their respective divisions slated for Oct. 13, Hoosier Champions Night, at Hoosier Park. Hoosier Champions Night will culminate the 2017 Indiana Sires Stakes program and feature eight \$200,000 finals.
