## Lexington sale tops \$30 million

With one final sale session set for tonight, the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale has already surpassed a gross of \$30 million for the first time since 2008 and is on pace to smash last year's all-time record for average.


Trainer Chris Ryder will train the day four sale topper after trying to buy the Roll With Joe colt for himself. Bill Donovan got the pacer with a winning bid of \$97,000.

Bill Donovan said he has a couple of surprises coming for trainers. The owner from Pompano Beach, FL is sending some nice yearlings their way after leading all buyers during the fourth session of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale held Friday night (Oct. 7) at the Fasig-Tipton sales facility.

The session sale-topper, a Roll With Joe colt out of Tropic's Beachgirl from the Spring Haven Farm consignment named Rose Run TJ — that cost Donovan \$97,000 — will be going to Chris Ryder.

"I was looking for a New York pacing colt for my portfolio and he was a pretty nice colt and I was fortunate enough to get him. And then I found out that it was Chris Ryder who was driving the price up on me," Donovan said. "I said that if he liked him that much then he should train him. So Chris is going to train him. I've had horses with Chris in the past and have done well. He's a gentleman and a professional and his



record speaks for himself."

Donovan said an Ontario Sired Shadow Play filly he purchased for \$100,000 on the second night of the sale, will go to Ciaran Morrison, a top trainer from Ireland who recently relocated to Ontario.

"I haven't had horses with him before, but an Irish friend of mine is a trainer/driver and he comes to Lexington and has been my second set of eyes," Donovan said. "I pretty much select the yearlings myself, but I'll ask the trainer for his opinion. I look at a couple of hundred, so it's nice to have a second pair of eyes and somebody else looking. I met Ciaran through him and I know Ron Burke and Jimmy Takter have a high opinion of Ciaran so that in itself speaks yards of his abilities."

Donovan said he thought he would be able to buy Rose Run TJ for at least \$20,000 less than he paid.

"I wasn't looking for a sale topper, or anything else with that colt," Donovan said, "but there was a lot of interest in him. When you have an individual with the page and the looks, they are going to sell, it really doesn't matter if it's the first night or the fourth night. They may not go for the money of the first night, but the demand was there."

In fact, the demand for yearlings has been particularly strong through all four nights.

With one session remaining tonight, the sale has already topped \$30 million in gross for the first time since 2008's gross of \$32,111,742. The sale is on pace to smash last year's record average of \$45,204. Through Friday, 491 horses had brought \$30,553,000 total, so far, to produce an average of \$62,226 that is 24.3 per cent higher than the 2015 average of \$50,042 through the first four sessions. The gross is up this year by 10.8 per cent despite 60 fewer horses being sold, so far.

During Friday's fourth session, 113 yearlings grossed \$2,884,000 combined for an average of \$25,522 that was up 19.6 per cent compared to the fourth session in 2015.

"The best number that I saw tonight was

that our gross was over \$30 million," said Randy Manges, who shares the sale manager role with David Reid. "And we've still got another 80 horses to sell and whatever they bring."

Manges said the crowd was particularly strong Friday.

"The crowd was excellent tonight, a really a good crowd," he said. "Of course, we were done early, but they stayed. The last horse brought \$42,000, so that part was good. I was really pleased with the crowd.

"I thought most of the horses sold well. The Ontario-breds sold very well, again. We don't have a lot of them in the sale and that's a supply and demand thing, but we're fortunate to have some good ones. We had a few Sportswriters that sold very well. I thought Betterthancheddars sold well. We had some very nice horses."

Donovan has purchased nine yearlings at the sale and spent a total of \$689,000, which ranks him sixth on the list of the sale's top buyers.

"My number one pick was a sister to Band of Angels," Donovan said of hip #26, a Rock N Roll Heaven filly out of Time N Again named Let's Fall In Love that he purchased or \$150,000. "Band of Angels was a great filly for me and Ron Burke trained her and he'll be training the full sister. I actually think the full sister is a better individual than Band of Angels was and she was an absolutely gorgeous two-year-old, so I was hellbent on getting (Let's Fall In Love)."

Though Donovan has yet to land a Muscle Hill or Somebeachsomewhere yearling at the sale, he said it's not for lack of trying.

"Like everybody, I want a Muscle Hill. I was hoping to be part of the group that purchased #70 with Ron Burke," Donovan said of the \$800,000 sale topper, a full-brother to Mission Brief that sold the first night to a group put together by agent Ernie Martinez. Burke said he was the underbidder and went to \$750,000 on the colt before giving up. "There are a couple of Muscle Hill's selling at Harrisburg that we'll

be looking at.




"The





## Ariana G stars in Int. Stallion Stakes; wins eighth of nine

Part-owner Marv Katz said his homebred two-year-old trotting filly Ariana G — winner of her \$255,000 International Stallion Stakes division Friday at Red Mile — is an example of how he and partner Al Libfeld are "producing top-flight horses." It was the eighth win in nine starts for Ariana G.

Overtaking pacesetter Cool Cates after the half, Ariana G strolled around the far turn and through the stretch to win one of four divisions of the \$255,000 International Stallion Stakes for two-year-old trotting fillies in 1:51.3 Friday (Oct. 7) at Red Mile.

Setting splits of :27.4 and :55.4, Cool Cates led before losing the lead to Ariana G, who was flushed first-over by Chezatter approaching the final turn. Ariana G parked Chezatter passing three quarters, timed in 1:24.2. Driver Yannick Gingras had Ariana G under a hand drive in the stretch while Chezatter attempted to pursue her on the

outside. She hit the line nearly two lengths in front of Chezatter, while Evelyn trotted down the center of the track to take third.

Trained by Jimmy Takter, Ariana G, by Muscle Hill out of the Cantab Hall mare Cantab It All, won her eighth race in nine starts this year, compiling \$438,967 in earnings for owners Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld. She paid \$2.40 to win.

"This is really thrilling for both myself and Al," Katz said.
"Jimmy has done a fabulous, fabulous job, but this is as
exciting as it has ever been for us. She's our filly; we bred her
through our program and we're so proud of it. It shows that
we're really producing top-flight horses."

"She showed some ability in the paddock," Libfeld said on the two's decision to keep Ariana G. "It was not a hard choice to make."

"That was very impressive; this filly is really scary," Takter said. "Yannick said that he shut her down through the whole stretch. If he would've let her go a little bit and pick up a gear for the record, he said she would've trotted way under 1:51."

In the first ISS division, Treviso tracked Hillarmbro as she sped around the course before slinging out of the pocket and edging to victory in 1:53.1.


Senia Hanover grabbed command and led through a :28.3 opening quarter before yielding to Hillarmbro into the backstretch. Flushed out by Treviso, Hillarmbro extended to a wide enough lead for Treviso to tuck into the pocket, and Hillarmbro held control through a :55.1 half. The two drew away from Senia Hanover as she faltered around the turn. The 3-5 favorite Thats All Moni had to circle by her from fourth heading to three quarters, already trailing Hillarmbro and Treviso by four lengths through three quarters in 1:23.2.

Hillarmbro maintained control as Treviso stalled to her outside. By the eighth pole, she began advancing toward Hillarmbro, soon matching strides with her in the final yards before pushing herself in front at the wire.

By Muscle Massive out of the Taurus Dream mare Valbonela, Treviso won her fifth start in nine this year, earning \$144,569 for owners Klis Brothers Stable and Carrie Norris. Trained and driven by Charlie Norris, she paid \$8.20.

"I thought for sure Trond (Smedshammer on Hillarmbro) would leave," Charlie Norris said. "I didn't mind following her after the way she raced last week, but Andy (Miller on Senia Hanover) kind of surprised me; we were trotting pretty fast. She was relaxed; most (horses) aren't relaxed going that fast. Last week she was a little grabby, but today she was two fingers.

"She's definitely going (to the Breeders Crown)."

Diving to the cones as the stretch-battling leaders tired, Temple Ruins squeezed to a 1:54.4 win in the third division over Feed Your Head and Overdraft Volo.

The even-money favorite Dream Baby Dream set the pace through fractions of :28.3 and :57.2. Pocket-sitter Overdraft Volo pulled first-over entering the final turn and was tracked by Feed Your Head. Temple Ruins trotted fourth through three quarters in 1:26 as Overdraft Volo edged to the lead. Feed Your Head struggled to pass to her outside and Temple Ruins began to trot toward the leaders, moving to the pylons and surging to the top. Feed Your Head managed to take second and Overdraft Volo was third.

Winning his third race in 10 starts this year, Temple Ruins, by Donato Hanover out of the Muscles Yankee mare Temple Of Heaven, has earned \$176,885 for owners Burke Racing Stable, Michelle Yanek, Paul Treiber, and Weaver Bruscemi LLC. She is trained by Ron Burke, was driven by Brian Sears, and paid \$30.60 to win.

"Last week she still had a lot of trot finishing," Sears said. "She really doesn't have that high speed that a lot of these [fillies] here do have, but she definitely keeps going and doesn't get that tired.

"She had a little trot; I was gaining some ground, so if I had room (I felt I could get up). It was pretty tight at the wire, but I was glad to see us come up a winner."

Ice Attraction moved to the lead after the quarter and remained in front to win her International Stallion Stakes division in 1:53.3.

Dangle Then Deke launched of the gate to take the lead, soon losing it as Ice Attraction edged out of the pocket and towards the top through a :28.4 first quarter. She was in front through a :56.3 half as Fine Tuned Lady, sent the 6-5 favorite, was flushed first-over by Broadway Idole. Fine Tuned Lady pressured Ice Attraction heading to three quarters, but soon dropped back as Ice Attraction drew away by two lengths through a 1:25 third quarter.

Pursued by Broadway Idole fanning wide of Fine Tuned Lady and Myammie Drama toward the center of the track, Ice Attraction remained in front. Broadway Idole took second, and Myammie Drama finished third.


Ice Attraction, by Muscle Hill out of the Conway Hall mare The Ice Queen, won her third race in seven starts this year, earning \$67,175 for owners Ake Svanstedt, Douglas Sipple, Mal and Janet Burroughs and Little E LLC. Trained and driven by Svanstedt, she paid \$6.40 to win.

"I've gone in with Ake on a couple of horses," part-owner Jeff Gural said. "When he came over (to the U.S. from Sweden), he actually bought a horse I bred, so I walked over to thank him and that's how I met him. I told him if he needed a partner on any horses to give me a call, and I've been lucky, to tell you the truth. I'm partners on a few, but three of them raced here so far and I've got a first, a second, and a third.

"A lot of (Ake's) horses got sick, including this one. We had hoped to race last week, but we were out 31 days so we had to qualify. I was anxious to see her race because I saw her baby race and I thought she was a good filly, but then she got sick and I was kind of disappointed. It looks like Ake's got her on the right track.

"I make sure my horses win at the tracks I own, otherwise it's a problem." Gural was joking about Ice Attraction's recent wins in a \$28,410 Tompkins-Geers division and a \$29,190 Reynolds division at Tioga Downs.

Live racing from The Red Mile resumes today (Oct. 8), with four divisions of the \$260,000 International Stallion Stakes for two-year-old pacing fillies and four divisions of the \$262,000 International Stallion Stakes for two-year-old pacing colts and geldings. First race post for the 10-race program is set for 1 p.m.





#### **Careless Whispers**

"A lie that is half-truth is the darkest of all lies." — Alfred Tennyson

My mother is a retired college professor. Now, in her 70s, she has devoted her time to three hobbies: The New York Yankees, painting pictures in her studio and watching thoroughbred racing. The 800-pound fact that her son makes a career in harness racing hasn't had any effect on her unyielding love for the runners. Ask my mom about Todd Pletcher or Bob Baffert and she'll give you an afternoon of illuminating conversation. Ask her to name three harness racing trainers, aside from my close friends, and she'll be hard put to name even one. She doesn't know much about them because she doesn't care. She isn't interested in harness racing. Her only contact with the sport comes from what little I tell her and tangential news snippets she might stumble upon in thoroughbred media. Perhaps this sounds like a somewhat quirky mother-son relationship, but I've never gotten all Norman Bates about it. Believe me, the last thing I want is for my mom to pay too much attention to anything I do.

Because of my mother's non-interest in harness racing, it came as quite a shock to me a few weeks back when she called to ask about "some race called the Little Brown Jug" and something about yogurt and drugs and trainers barred in Mexico. Yikes! For my mother to have even heard about this, and to almost get the story straight, it must have sounded pretty bad. When I tried to explain the situation, she interrupted me coldly and said, "Everything about that business stinks. That's why I don't like it and your grandfather didn't like it, and I don't like the fact that you work in it."

I emphasized that those were all rumors and half-truths and lies, but she added, "That's the other thing I don't like about your business. It's always something about shady dealings and rumors of race-fixing and rumors of drugs and

backstabbing and horse trainers who all hate each other. It has no charm and I feel sorry for the horses."

Wow! Turns out mom knew a hell of lot more about my little harness racing world than I thought. She actually schooled me with her anger. She never did that when I was young.

When I was a child of about 10 or 11, I would often sit with my mother on our sofa and watch old movies. If there was something I didn't understand about the film, my mother would carefully explain it to me. Some movies were just plain fun, but others taught me valuable life lessons — which was my mother's real intention all along.

One movie I remember especially, "The Children's Hour," tells the story of how a rotten kid named Mary Tilford completely ruins the lives of the people around her when she whispers a scandalous lie to her grandmother. What made Mary's lie especially egregious was the fact that it accidentally contained a morsel of truth. I liked the movie, and I understood why Mary's lie was far worse than any fib I may have told. It taught me how lies lead to rumors and unhealthy suspicions. And, as it was told in "The Children's Hour," a lie can sometimes lead us to an unfortunate truth that can inflict fatal wounds.



Outright lies and innuendo in the barn area never make anyone's horse go faster, but they are readily used by the also-rans to explain the inexplicable speed and stamina of someone else's horse. Malicious gossip in our sport is a kind of careless checkbook with which someone can buy themselves a few brief moments of credibility or even an entire career. It's a strange kind of currency handed out by some so as to depreciate the costs of their own failures, and to devalue and debase the triumphs of others. Basically, it's chicken feed for malevolent chickens, but what happens when the lies and rumors and accusations turn out to be true? I mean, that happens a lot, right?

**QUESTION**: What do they call the Hospitality Suite at the Little Brown Jug?

ANSWER: The detention barn.

Oddly enough, backstretch gossip, even at the higher ranks, is usually babbled by the very same people who pretend to be greatly outraged by the stuff they're babbling about. The hypocrisy of it all is rather vexing when you think about it, and we got to think about it a lot a few weeks ago at the Little Brown Jug. In fact, we're still suffering through stories about uninvited and rumored-to-be-nefarious guests in the detention barn and some kind of alleged laser beaming, pro-biotic culture shock accompanied by sinister text-messaging and a dose syringe. Why not throw in some evil Pygmies with poisonous blow guns too? The few fans that care can't wait to see how this all pans out — if it pans out at all.

Perhaps this latest buzz around the barn can help to ease the not-so-glamorous monotony of a life spent working with horses and mice. What's so wrong about sharing some dirty laundry about another horseman and his horses? Of course there are lies and rumors and scandal in all forms of business, the trouble is that these lies and rumors are rooted in truth, and they become a great deal more perilous when helpless animals are involved — especially when they fall onto the ears of the surviving fans and bettors.

There's a saying in screenwriting: "If you want your audience to dislike a character, have him kick the kid. If you want your audience to despise that character, have him kill the dog." Our harness racing screenplay has too many dog killers and alleged dog killers in the story line. It's murdering the box office, and great horses like Wiggle It Jiggleit and Hannelore Hanover are playing to empty houses. Even an amoeba living in a Chernobyl mud puddle could figure that one out.

Much like Mary Tilford's careless whisper, the backstretch

rumor with the element of some truth, or perhaps the whole truth, is the killer. The harness industry needs to come to terms with the fact that many or most of the rumors and big juicy stories we hear on the backstretch are not only true, they're what's destroying harness racing from the inside out. The general idea, however, is to ignore what you see or hear and try to keep it classy, but that concept didn't play out so well this year in Columbus.

Spotting malfeasance in harness racing is not like finding a pressure cooker on a bus. The "see something, say something" slogan doesn't apply unless you're really important. But even then it's not a sure thing. Especially when the pressure cooker belongs to someone just as big and important as you.

All of this bulls\*\*t in harness racing trickles down from one filtering screen to the next until all that's left is one jagged little pebble that falls into an innocent man's shoe where it rolls around forever and cripples him for life. What happens then? What's the big deal? It's not your life that's been ruined. It belongs to someone else. What can the crippled guy expect from the harness racing chatter that crippled him — an apology? Harness racing muck doesn't apologize. It doesn't apologize, it doesn't change, and, it never washes off.

Maybe I'm being overly dramatic. I mean, it's basically harmless all in all. Rumors and innuendo burn themselves out faster if you just let them float. It's only when you start screaming and stomping on them that you've got yourself a fire that can't be extinguished, right? Sadly, common sense like that doesn't cut it in harness racing. Next year's Jug will still have a new stain, and like Lady Macbeth's damn'd spot, it will n'er be clean. The stains just keep getting deeper and deeper because the people who are supposed to wash them out are the very same people who keep rubbing them in.

Let's face it, my mother, as much as it secretly bugs me that she doesn't like harness racing, is, to a lesser extent, just like many, or most, of the people we all know who exist outside or at least partially outside of harness racing. To them we're just the crooks with the drugged buggy horses. That's the stigma and the mournful disfigurement worn by the harness racing industry, and if someone doesn't quickly do something to at least fix its face, the whole business is headed for the leper colony.

#### Trainer, vet fined for Pena Jugette barn incident

The Ohio State racing Commission (OSRC) has issued \$1,000 fines to trainer Matias Ruiz and veterinarian Dr. Louis Bauslaugh for their part in what led to the scratching of I Said Diamonds from the Jugette for 3-year-old filly pacers on Wed., Sept. 21, at Delaware, OH.

The morning before the Jugette, Dr. Bauslaugh was in the Jugette Barn stall of I Said Diamonds administering treatment, joined by Lou Pena, who currently does not hold a race license in any jurisdiction and is not licensed by the U.S. Trotting Association. The pair were in the stall prior to the prescribed time, thus the OSRC sanctioned Bauslaugh for conducting "yourself in a manner that was detrimental to the sport of horse racing by injecting and administering IV fluids to the horse I Said Diamonds during the time frame not allowable by detention barn rules and was not granted permission by the security staff to do so. Furthermore you allowed an unlicensed person to assist you with an injectable device."

Ruiz was fined as the "trainer responsible for the condition of the horse I Said Diamonds." Ruiz received his penalty because of having an unlicensed person in the detention barn assisting a veterinarian. The ruling stated: "In order to protect the integrity of racing and the wagering public, the horse I Said Diamonds was scratched by the judges."

## Lawyers involved in Jug controversy

Columbus Dispatch sports columnist Michael Arace reported Wednesday (Oct. 5) that trainers that refused to take part in the post parade for the first of two Little Brown Jug heats on Sept. 22 have hired a Columbus law firm to "supplement their initial objection" against Betting Line and trainer Casie Coleman.

Arace reported, "The firm produced a seven-page document that details alleged infractions against Betting Line's trainer, Casie Coleman. The document was sent to William Crawford, executive director of the Ohio State Racing Commission, and Tom Wright, president of the Little Brown Jug Society."

"The back story goes like this," Arace wrote. "The night before the Jug, one of Coleman's grooms had a wee bit too

much hard cider, or whatever, and wound up sleeping in a horse trailer. When he arose, presumably to locate some Brioski, he discovered that he had been dispossessed of his cellular telephone. The good news is somebody had found the phone and knew the owner. The bad news is the somebody who found the phone was more interested in monitoring the groom's text messages than returning the phone. Screen shots of those messages are included in the supplemental complaint. Among the messages are these:

'Where is the s--- for betting line?'

'Anytime between 830-1030 range when its clear to saftly (sic) get his treatments into him."

Trainers Tony Alagna, Jimmy Takter and Ron Burke saw photos of the text messages and pressed Jug judges to scratch Betting Line, saying the text messages indicated something illegal was administered to Betting Line.

Coleman vehemently defended herself, saying the pacer is given yogurt to calm his stomach and that the yogurt is administered orally though a large syringe.

Betting Line went on to win the Jug final by eight lengths in a 1:49 world record.

Arace wrote, "The Supplement to the Objection says the complainants don't know everything that happened in the Detention Barn, where horses are stalled on race day. 'What we do know,' they said, 'is that Betting Line's record-breaking performance was remarkable even for a favorite."

The lawyers are alleging Coleman violated a number of rules ranging from Detention Barn infractions to fifth-degree felonies.

Coleman was thoroughly searched after the incident and Betting Line's fluids are being thoroughly tested at the Ohio Department of Agriculture's testing lab. Test results are expected soon.

## Warner promoting Ontario owner bonuses in Kentucky

Long before Ontario Sired and Ontario Bred trotting filly Magic Carpet Glide topped the third session of the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale Thursday night (Oct. 6) with a bid of \$175,000, Jackie Warner had already spent days talking to sale consignors and buyers to tout the benefits of the Ontario program.

"Most people understand the Ontario Sired product and the Ontario Sires Stakes program... and breeders understand

the Ontario Bred program, specifically the benefits for them (of the bonuses). So now that there are benefits for the owners and purchasers of these horses, I'm down here promoting that," said Warner, the Promotions and Industry Development Coordinator for Ontario Racing.

Starting in 2017, owners of two- or three-year-old horses that are Ontario Sired, Ontario Bred or both will share in a pro-rated portion of a \$2 million Owners' Bonus, based on their earnings in overnight races in Ontario. A horse that is both Ontario Sired and Ontario Bred will receive double the bonus.

"It adds value," Warner said. "I was (in Lexington) for Sale Preview Day and put up stall cards that were specific to the Ontario-sired and Ontario-bred horse or cards that indicated they were both and that they were eligible for double bonuses. I spent time with consignors so that they understood the program.

"There were a lot of questions from American breeders regarding the program and the benefits to potential owners for the Ontario Bred product."

Through the first four days of the Lexington sale 27 Ontario eligible yearlings sold for \$1,778,000 combined, for

an average of \$65,852.

Swedish agent Robert Lindstrom purchased Magical Carpet Glide on behalf of Lennart Agren's SRF Stable of Boden, Sweden. The same group also purchased the second highest-priced Ontario Sired horse to sell, so far in the five-day sale, spending \$150,000 on a Kadabra filly out of On The Bright Side named Magical Lindy.

Floridian Bill Donovan purchased a Shadow Play filly out of Hallie Gallie named Data Driven for \$100,000 and a Sportswriter colt out of Dancewiththebest named Dancin Doug was bought for \$95,000 by a numbered company based in Windsor, ON.

Non-Canadians purchased five of the six highest-priced Ontario Sired horses sold, so far, which may be an indication that Warner's campaign to promote Ontario bonus programs is having an impact.
