Lexington Sale Smashes Records

The Lexington Selected Yearling Sale concluded Saturday night with a \$56,304 average — that was a whopping 24.5 per cent better than the sale's previous best — and a gross of \$32.3 million that was the second highest in its history.

The Lexington Selected Yearling Sale concluded Saturday night with some incredible numbers; including the second highest gross in the sale's history despite fewer horses being sold and a record average of \$56,304 that was up 24.5 per cent from the sale's previous best.

"It was a very good sale overall, start to finish," said David Reid, who manages the sale in partnership with Randy Manges. "As proud as you are to start off so strong, you're equally proud to maintain it over five sessions and then even prouder to close out on a night like tonight. We had a smaller offering and a great crowd and Randy and I formatted the sale so we had offspring of unique, regional sires selling tonight, in addition to some trotters. Overall, I think it worked to a T and just caps off a fabulous week of weather and racing down here."

In all, 573 yearlings produced a total gross of \$32,262,000 and a record average of \$56,304 that smashed the previous average record of \$45,220, set last year. Despite 69 fewer horses being sold this year compared to last, the gross was up \$3.23 million and 11 per cent from the \$29,031,000 fetched last year when 642 horses were sold. This year's gross was the second highest in sale history behind only the \$35,648,962 set in 2007 when 791 yearlings were sold — 218 more than this year. This year's gross barely exceeded the \$32,111,742 brought in 2008.

"The average record, that's always nice, but I'm a numbers

guy — you know, the bottom line," Manges said. "Like with you, are you happy that you averaged seven more ads in the magazine or do you like it when you have lots of ads and you have the bottom line covered? It's your bottom line, so the gross is what's important for us to have a good sale. The gross is also important for the consignors, to help them pay their bills."

Reid and Manges both predicted the sale would remain strong throughout and Saturday's numbers bore that out.

The fifth session saw 82 yearlings sell for \$1,709,000 combined to produce an average of \$20,841 that was 30 per cent higher than the \$16,022 average posted during the fifth session a year ago when 91 yearlings fetched a total gross of \$1,458,000.

The session topper came with just a handful of horses left to go through the ring. Irwin Samelman of Las Vegas, NV purchased hip 597, an Always A Virgin colt out of My Best Girl named Romantic Interest for \$110,000 out of the Preferred Equine consignment.

One horse earlier, agent Bryan Montgomery of Cream Ridge, NJ purchased Saturday's next highest priced yearling when he paid \$62,000 for an RC Royalty—My Baby's Momma colt named ROC Royal that was sold by Midland Acres.

David Reid's Preferred Equine led all consignors with more than \$7.5 million in sales, a record for Preferred in Lexington. Reid immediately began working on bringing along the next generation when he tutored fourth-generation Antonacci, Frank J. Antonacci, the son of Frank M. Antonacci, grandson of Frank "the elder" and great-grandson of the late Guy "Sonny" Antonacci.

Even the sale's leading buyer, Jimmy Takter, got into the act on the final night. Takter purchased a My MVP—Summer Savory colt named Wolfgang from the Brittany Farms consignment for \$60,000. In all, Takter purchased 12 horses and spent \$2,090,000, nearly double the amount spent by the next highest buyer, Robert Lindstrom, acting as an agent for Lennart Agren's SRF Stable of Boden, Sweden. The Lindstrom/Agren partnership spent \$1,087,000, total, on seven yearlings.

The Burke Racing Stable LLC was third on the buyers' list with \$942,000 spent on 14 horses. That number would be much higher if Ron Burke had been able to land the full-brother to Mission Brief during the Tuesday (Oct. 4) session. Burke said he was the underbidder at \$750,000 for the son of Muscle Hill out of Southwind Serena named Tactical Landing consigned by Steve and Cindy Stewart's Hunterton Farm. An international group led by agent Ernie Martinez of East Prospect, PA, purchased Tactical Landing for \$800,000.

The \$800,000 bid was the second most in harness racing

history for a yearling at auction and the most for a yearling sold in Kentucky. Only the \$825,000 bid by John Cancelliere for Donato Hanover's full-brother Detour Hanover at the 2011 Harrisburg sale is higher.


Tactical Landing will be trained by Kentucky's Bob Stewart, Steve's brother.

Hunterton was the sale's second highest grossing consignor, selling 81 yearlings for a total of \$5,316,000.

David Reid's Preferred Equine topped all consignors with a gross of \$7,521,000 for 119 yearlings.

"That is a personal best for Preferred at this sale," Reid said. "The majority of my consignors were very happy. You can always find a few things to improve. I think I might have made a mistake placing a few horses, but that's something we'll go back and review and try to improve for next year, even though we had an outstanding result. I didn't think we'd beat last year's numbers overall for the sale and here we came back and had a stronger sale. I'm really happy for the industry and totally satisfied overall."

Two sires dominated the sale, as expected — Muscle Hill on the trotting side and Somebeachsomewhere with pacers. The two accounted for \$10,769,000 in sales, 33 per cent of the total sale gross despite representing just 16 per cent of the

total number of yearlings sold.

Muscle Hill led all sires in gross with \$5,948,000 from 52 yearlings, an average of \$114,385.

Somebeachsomewhere led the sale in average with \$123,615 from 39 yearlings that sold for \$4,821,000 combined.

The next closed sire in average (with more than three yearlings sold) was Kadabra who averaged \$82,091 for 11 yearlings.


Canadian buyers spent \$4,236,000 at the sale, 13.1 per



cent of the total. Europeans were close behind, accounting for 11.2 per cent of the total, with \$3,612,000 spent in all. Just over 75 per cent of the yearlings were sold to U.S. buyers.

"There was a lot of energy in the crowd and I can't thank the consumers enough for participating and staying around all week," Reid said. "It really was a great week from an operational point of view. We can't thank the purchasers enough and we wish them all the good luck and may their horses go on to be future champions, internationally or in their own regions. It truly was a fun week."

Manges said perfect weather all week helped, but the reason the sale was such a success really came down to a simple equation: "I think the key was that we had good horses to sell," he said. "Good horses sell well, and I don't care what sale you're at... the best horse they will pay for." their presence felt and I think that's good for everyone."





Huntsville and Downbytheseaside post 1:49 world records

Huntsville and Downbytheseaside were the quickest winners of the four divisions of the \$262,000 International Stallion Stakes for two-year-old pacing colts and geldings on Saturday (Oct. 8) at Red Mile, winning in 1:49 to establish a new world record for a mile track. Sweet Lou's 1:49 mile in 2011 came on Woodbine's seven-eighths mile oval.

Sweeping to command after Rock The Boat set a :27 quarter, **Huntsville** led to the half-mile and three-quarters in :55.2 and 1:22.1. R J P, tracking Huntsville's backside brush, found room to tuck into the pocket at the top of the stretch, while Fear The Dragon chased Huntsville from first over. He took second from R J P while driver Tim Tetrick encouraged Huntsville to pace to the line, finishing about three lengths clear of Fear The Dragon.

Hunstville, by **Somebeachsomewhere** out of the Western Hanover mare Wild West Show, won his fourth consecutive race and his fifth race overall this season in eight starts, earning \$293,234 for owner/trainer Ray Schnittker along with partners Ted Gewertz, Charles Iannazzo, and Steven Arnold. He paid \$2.80.

Downbytheseaside rushed to the top, taking the lead from Eddard Hanover after a 27:4 first quarter. He blazed through the rest of the mile, pacing a half-mile in :53.4 and three-quarters in 1:22.3. Boogie Shuffle attempted to pursue the leader from first over, while Eddard Hanover slid by rivals towards the pylons. Downbytheseaside remained in front by about two lengths over Boogie Shuffle and Eddard Hanover.

Sent off the 3-5 favorite, Downbytheseaside, by Somebeachsomewhere out of the Allamerican Native mare Sprig Hanover, won his sixth race in 10 starts, earning \$239,706 for owners Country Club Acres Inc., Joe Sbrocco and Richard Lombardo. Trained by Brian Brown and driven by David Miller, he paid \$3.20 to win.

"I was a little worried; I knew we were going too (fast) at the quarter," David Miller said. "Rolling up the backstretch, when (the half) flashed up :53, I was like 'Oh boy, that's not good.' He's a strong horse. He did settle down for the third quarter but then he had (Scott) Zeron (on Boogie Shuffle) come at him. He had enough to fight him off. It was impressive. Brian told me the first time I drove this horse that this was his best horse and I told him he was crazy."

"He has been getting a little bit grabbier every week," Brian Brown said, "so we tried to change some things. I was more worried at the half than David was, but I was surprised that the horse had that much fight in him."

Meanwhile, **Dragnet Alert** tipped off the rail and swung

down the center of the track to upset at 18-1 in 1:49.2.

Drafting behind a blazing pace set by Filibuster Hanover, Dragnet Alert set fractions of :27.2, :54.2, and 1:21.4, Filibuster Hanover held an uncontested lead. Odds On Delray, the 1-2 favorite, sat in the pocket while Dragnet Alert raced third. At the top of the stretch, Odds On Delray edged off the pylons and was tracked by Dragnet Alert. Midway through the stretch, Dragnet Alert moved towards the center of the track and passed Odds On Delray, who took second, and Filibuster Hanover held on to third.

By **Dragon Again** out of the Jenna's Beach Boy mare Jettin Jenna, Dragnet Alert won his second race in seven starts, earning \$58,463 for owner Crawford Farms Racing. He's trained by Chris Oakes, was driven by Brian Sears, and paid \$29.80 to win.

"We bought him in early July," Albert Crawford said. "Chris (Oakes) gave us a call; he spotted the colt and really liked him. He asked if we were interested and we were."

"I thought he had this type of speed," Oakes said. "He was coming quarters of :26.2 at The Meadows, which is pretty solid; it's not a real fast track. When I got the colt, he was sick, so I had no choice but to quit with him for over a month, and he's coming around nice now."

Chip Walther paced down the center of the track to win the second ISS division in 1:50.3 at 41-1. Blood Line pulled first-over from fourth around the first turn, taking the lead from Normandy Beach after a :28.1 first quarter. Leading through a half in :55.4 and challenged at three-quarters in 1:24 by Point Somewherelse from first over. Blood Line tried to hold control through the stretch, but was passed by Normandy Beach sliding up the rail, Mcthriller towards the center of the track, and Chip Walther from Mcthriller's inside. Chip Walther grabbed the front, while Normandy Beach finished second and Mcthriller was third.

The Erv Miller-trained colt by **Art Major**, out of the **Western Terror** mare Bittorsweet Terror, won his second race in 11 starts, earning \$63,111 for owners Ervin Miller Stable, Paymaq Racing, Nick Surick Stable, and Louis Willinger. Driven by Marcus Miller, he paid \$84.80 to win.

"The other night, when the track was off, Marcus and Nick were pretty confident that the horse would race good," Erv Miller said. "But the horse has been getting better in the last three weeks; he had a bit of a bad go in New York. Getting onto the mile track really helped him. He's one of those horses that when he's good he'll go by somebody. He may not be good enough, but when he was following the horse that kept carrying him I thought he'd be pretty good."

Zane Hanover posts 93-1 upset in Stallion Stakes

Flying up the pylons as the even-money favorite Loreenas Ruffian drifted on the lead, **Zane Hanover** sprinted to a 1:50.4

win at 93-1 in the first of four divisions of the \$260,000 International Stallion Stakes (ISS) for 2-year-old pacing fillies Saturday at Red Mile.

Robin J grabbed the lead from Loreenas Ruffian, who then circled to take control after a :27.4 quarter. She led through splits of :55.2 and 1:23.3 before drifting off the cones in the stretch. From off cover, That's The Ticket tried to storm down the center of the track, while Robin J slid by Loreenas Ruffian to her inside along with Zane Hanover, who emerged to the lead and drew clear to win. That's The Ticket got up for second, and Robin J finished third.

Winning her first race in nine starts, Zane Hanover, by Somebeachsomewhere out of the **American Ideal** mare Zellweger Bluechip, has earned \$43,382 for owners Paymaq Racing, George Golemes and D. R. Van Witzenburg. Trained by Ervin Miller and driven by Marcus Miller, she paid \$189.80 to win.

"I think this is a prime example that shows what The Red Mile can do for a horse," Erv Miller said. "We had been up (in Pa.) on the five-eighths racing and not really getting her stretched out, but we got her a little stretched out last week and she seemed all week like she was getting better."

Sent to the top after the half, Someomensomewhere maintained control as she advanced to a 1:52.4 win in the second ISS division. Miss Jones led through a :28 first quarter before yielding to Someomensomewhere as she brushed to the lead before the half. Unchallenged in :57.3, Someomensomewhere was soon pressured by Rockette from first over into the far turn. Past three-quarters in 1:26.4, Someomensomewhere turned away Rockette, who held onto second as Caviart Cherie slid into contention to take third.

Earning \$102,771 for owners Nick Surick Stable LLC and Kdm Stables Corp, Someomensomewhere, by Somebeachsomewhere out of the Western Hanover mare Omen Hanover, won her second race in nine starts. Trained by Erv Miller and driven by Marcus Miller, she paid \$5.40.

"I trained the mare Omen Hanover and my owner bred her," Surick said. "Then I bought her here last year with Erv and (Kdm Stables) wanted back in, so Erv trained her. She has been really good. She tailed off in Pa. at the end, but Erv said she was bleeding a little bit. Marcus has driven her great in every start; never put her in a bad spot. She was just never finishing. Now she's finishing with the good drives."

"We were really going slow and she was just getting into gear; she wanted to go faster than I wanted her to into that wind," Marcus Miller said. "I just had to let her settle down and it was cruise control from there."

Off a second-place finish in a \$73,000 Bluegrass split last week, Idyllic Beach took control after the half and was wrapped up before winning in 1:52.2 over Big City Betty and World Apart.

It was David Miller in the bike for Downbytheseaside's 1:49 triumph.

Caviart Ally was sent to the top through a :27.3 first quarter. She was rough gaited when met with the backstretch headwinds and took the pocket when Idyllic Beach rushed first over to the front. Leading through a :57 half and 1:25.2 third-quarter, Idyllic Beach strolled to the line, finishing about two lengths clear of Big City Betty.

Idyllic Beach, by Somebeachsomewhere out of the American Ideal mare Idyllic, won her seventh race in 10 starts this year, earning \$500,132 for owners Christina Takter, John Fielding, Brixton Medical Ab, and Marvin Katz. She's trained by Jimmy Takter, was driven by Yannick Gingras, and paid \$2.40 to win.

"I wanted to race her from the back today," Gingras said. "She has raced on the front so many times, but Andrew (McCarthy's) filly (Caviart Ally) was jumping shadows on the backstretch and we weren't going (fast), so I had to make a move. She was much the best in here."

Roaring To Go won the final ISS split in 1:51.1 going wire-to-wire. She was unchallenged through fractions of :28.3, :55.3 and 1:23.2 before Planet Rock, moving first over around the far turn, gained ground into the stretch. Awash tipped off her cover and chased Roaring To Go from the center of the track, managing to take second from Planet Rock.

Hanover, Roaring To Go won her sixth race in 12 starts, amassing \$242,636 in earnings for owner Frank Chick. She's trained by Kevin Lare, was driven by Brett Miller, and paid \$3.00 to win.

"She's not a half-mile track specialist and in New York Sires Stakes that's pretty much what you have to be," Lare said. "Brett has done a great job with her, getting her over the half-mile track all year, and we thought the bigger track would help her out. I was very impressed with her, going the second quarter in :27 flat. I was a little nervous into the headwind, but Brett said she was kind of waiting on him and once she heard him, she took off again. She has the Breeders Crown left, but then after that I think she's done for the year. (Frank Chick) has talked about the Matron, but I'll leave that up to Frank."

Live racing will conclude at Red Mile this afternoon with a stakes-rich card that includes the \$100,000 Allerage Filly and Mare Pace, \$101,000 Allerage Open Trot, \$138,000 Allerage Open Pace, two divisions of the \$213,500 Glen Garnsey Memorial, two divisions of the \$416,000 Tattersalls Pace, two eliminations and two heats for the \$312,000 Kentucky Filly Futurity, and the \$431,000 Kentucky Futurity, where Marion Marauder races to be the ninth winner of the Trotting Triple Crown.

Sunday's card also features a mandatory-payout Pick-5 carryover of \$5,289.36. The first race goes to post at 1 p.m.



Jug judges should have scratched Betting Line

Sometimes "Draconian" rules work

Michael Arace of the *Columbus Dispatch* wrote a commentary this week about the detention barn situation (and aftermath of which) on Jug Day, involving the eventual winner, Betting Line. In the article, he broke some news.

"The trainers who protested Betting Line's sizzling victory in the Jug on Sept. 22 have hired a Columbus law firm to "supplement" their initial objection. The firm produced a seven-page document that details alleged infractions against Betting Line's trainer, Casie Coleman." Mr. Arace wrote.

This isn't over.

Why it isn't, in my view, is that the Ohio judges dropped the ball. Betting Line (again, in my opinion) should've never been allowed to race.

There are some rules in this sport that need to be draconian, and when they're broken, or there is intent to break them, they have to be held to that very high bar.

I remember about a decade ago there was a curious case in Hong Kong. A trainer's charge won a race, but tested positive for a supplement. This supplement was in no way a performance enhancer, or some sort of exotic drug, it was a simple supplement that trainer's use every day, but was not allowed in a horse on race day.

After an investigation, it turns out nothing nefarious occurred, it was a freakish mistake.

The charged trainer supplied video from the shedrow (video cameras run 24/7 in Hong Kong) that showed the horse in question, at morning feed time, was extra-hungry. He somehow contorted himself and was able to get at his stablemate's feed tub. The horse began ingesting his pal's breakfast right on video – a breakfast that included the

supplement he ended up testing positive for.

I thought this evidence was enough to absolve the trainer of any wrongdoing. But it wasn't.

The Hong Kong Jockey Club said there would be a fine, because the rule is clear: It is up to the connections to ensure nothing gets into a horse that should not be in that horse on the backstretch on race day. In this case, they bluntly said feed tubs should be placed nowhere near another horse, it was the trainer's mistake, and that this provided a lesson to everyone else at feed time.

For years I thought this was the stupidest, most unfair, most ridiculous ruling I have ever seen anywhere in this sport. But recently I have changed my tune.

After this strange ruling, horsemen responded by watching their horses more closely while feeding, they made sure grooms and hotwalkers hands were washed when handling just about everything (no, there have been no cocaine positives from residue on tongue ties in Hong Kong); they instituted best practices to ensure this doesn't happen again.

It hasn't. There have been no contamination or freakish positives like this on the backstretch since. None, zip, zilch.

Since that strange positive, Hong Kong handle is up over 100 per cent, the stalls are full, and there's a line as long as the Nile River of jockeys, owners and trainers who all want to be there. Everyone sure doesn't seem to mind.

I don't want to come off as a proponent of draconian rules in all instances. I abhor the withdrawal time issues where honest horsemen get pinched, honest mistakes that are made where these fine trainers are branded a "cheater", and so on. But in the case where things can be corrected, I believe the hard and fast rules do make sense, and make this a better sport.

One of those cases where I believe there can be no wiggle room is the detention barn.

Everyone knows – from owners, drivers, trainers, grooms, security people and the average fan – you never, ever, ever bring something you're not sure of into the detention barn.

Over the years there have been horses scratched, and fines given, for electrolyte residue in feed tubs, perfectly legal supplements that were brought in, and yes, in the case of Susie Kerwood in a detention barn at Woodbine back in the early 2000's — even for yogurt.

This "rule" is draconian in nature, yes, but everyone knows it, and horsepeople stick to it.

It works because there is no grey area. There are no

excuses. There are no "I didn't know the rule."

On Jug Day, the judges were allegedly given evidence that a horse was going to be given "something" while in detention. In the aftermath – according to Mr. Arace's article and other press reports — this was not even denied.

Yet, the horse raced.


The trainers who are moving this forward have been pretty much raked over the coals in some quarters. I've seen the comments on social media:

"They once did bad things too"; "it's sour grapes"; "why don't they just take a loss like men"; and so on.

I fervently disagree with these characterizations. I believe they are standing up for a rule that has to be draconian, that has to be ruled with an iron fist.

"Don't bring anything but hay, water and oats into the detention barn" is not a suggestion. And for the sport of harness racing, it should never be treated like one.

Suggestions for Gural

After reading Mr. Gural's comments regarding the decision to concede any chance of a Big M casino, I was at least relieved to hear that he doesn't plan to close (at least in the short term). However, I was amazed at how unprofitable the track was considering its handle dwarfs almost all other harness tracks racing in the same time frame. I hate to say this, but I'm not sure any real future exists for the sport. So many tracks have bloated purses, but in reality no one bets them. Yonkers, for example, has ridiculous Saturday night purses. They give out between 250k and 275k on an average on a Saturday night, but their handle is embarrassingly in the 600k range. It got me thinking, what's the point of all this slot and casino revenue if we can't be self sufficient? The Meadowlands has a handle that's respectable but LOSES \$5 million a year. Imagine if the BiG M handled Yonkers numbers...Yikes!

I would like to throw out a couple of suggestions. For Mr. Gural, cutting the stakes program to survive will not help Jersey breeders, but the breeding industry in the state is dead anyway. Thus, cut away. I would suggest eliminating the Graduate and other four-year-old races since despite his best efforts, the "Gural Rule" was discontinued. No use in funding those races. I would advise against doing anything to jeopardize the Hambo Day program. All of those stakes should be retained and fully funded. Hambo Day is too special to marginalized. As for the future of the Meadowlands Pace, it's tough to get people out to the track for that night when you are constantly running into a ridiculous concert at MetLife Stadium. It's not Mr. Gural's fault, but it doesn't help attendance. Also, the Pace no longer has the prestige it once had. There are so many other stakes that were created due to slots, horsemen are just going to pick their spots. For three-year-old pacers, I might contend that their are too many races for that class. Finally, I would suggest the obvious, which is to stop jabbing the horsemen, with the "they aren't supporting me line." Yes, it would be great if the horsemen would do more to help the sport, especially when it comes to the chemical trainers. However, I

This will never happen, but it would be or would've been very smart for the states that allow expanded gaming to link the portion on funds given to the horsemen and the track operator to the growth of the sport. The only thing that motivates people in the industry is money. Imagine the possibilities if the track and the horsemen were forced to work together. I would've suggested that for the track, they have to grow handle and/or increase attendance. Conversely, I would withhold money to the purse account if trainers racing at the track had a high number of positive tests, and/or the drivers had an excessive number of animal welfare infractions (i.e. Kicking, excessive whip use). If the purses go down, horsemen and their owners would suffer. Maybe, this would induce some much needed self-policing.

Let drivers keep their colors

I don't want to discourage any ideas that try to improve the sport, but until there is a strong foundation to build on, the focus must stay on that foundation. The foundation of anything that involves gambling is of course the gambler.

In my opinion, to change the colors of drivers to owner colors (HRU Oct. 2 – Wire to Wire), as it is in thoroughbreds, will only make it harder on the gambler. Here are two reasons:

One, many players follow the driver. Two, driver changes can make a huge advantage or disadvantage. In an age where you can bet several tracks at one time the only way to spot a change it to notice the colors of the listed driver do not match who is scoring the horse prior to the start of a race. If it is the owner's colors, then it is possible to miss the change. I do realize it is announced, scrolls on the screen and shown during a post parade, but it still can be missed. Remember we're trying to encourage betting, not make it more complex.

You want to increase ownership in harness racing, increase the purses. I'm sure there is a large majority of the owners wouldn't care if they were listed as Owner #1 if purses for a \$10,000 claimer were \$30,000.

How do you increase purses? Increase handle. And handle comes from gamblers... your foundation. How to do that is not an easy answer, but unless that happens, owners will have to put \$100 in a hat and winner take all.
