## **Hannelore Hanover guns for International fame**

The talented mare will start from the rail in Saturday's \$1 million Yonkers International Trot representing the United States.

A willingness to spend \$2,000 more than was budgeted for a modest Indiana-bred may lead to an historic accomplishment when the mare Hannelore Hanover tries to beat the boys in the \$1 million Yonkers International Trot on Saturday at Yonkers Raceway.

Trainer Ron Burke and Frank Baldachino, one of his owners, set a limit of \$30,000 for the daughter of Swan for All—High Sobriety. They thought the well-built yearling might be a nice fit for Indiana's program for state-breds — nothing more. When the bidding reached that mark, they hesitated, but only for an instant.

"Me and Ron looked at each other and said, 'Let's go one more tick," Baldachino said. "We were fortunate the other bidder did not go to \$33,000 or \$34,000. I don't know if we would have gone to that number."

When the hammer fell, Burke and Baldachino never imagined the bargain they had just discovered. Hannelore Hanover has developed into a brilliant trotter, a mare more than capable of defeating males on the grand stage the International provides.

"She is the type of horse that can make history," Baldachino said.

Hannelore Hanover is listed as the second choice in the morning line at 4-1 after drawing the rail as part of a field of 10 scheduled to go to the starting gate at approximately 3:20 p.m. ET. She will have 3-1 favorite Resolve, also representing the U.S., beside her in post two.

Interestingly, Ake Svanstedt, Resolve's trainer, said of Hannelore Hanover, "She is the horse to beat."

Eight mares have combined for 11 victories in the 37-year history of the International. The race was first run in 1959 at

old Roosevelt Raceway. Yonkers Raceway revived it last season after a 20-year absence in its ongoing effort to establish itself with fans abroad.

Hannelore Hanover is enjoying a fantastic four-year-old campaign, winning 15 of 17 starts with a pair of runner-up finishes while banking \$896,111 of her \$1,201,685 career earnings.

"There are a lot of horses in the race that are in the upper echelon and she's certainly one of them," said her driver Yannick Gingras. "I'm super confident in her. She's been razor sharp for five or six months now."

The ability to continue to perform at such a high level month after demanding month is a testament to Burke and, of course, the mare.

"She's got all the tools," Gingras said. "She's got a very efficient gait. She's big and strong. She has big lungs. She is the total package."

Hall of Fame driver John Campbell must start in the second tier from post nine with Tano Bork of Denmark. He finds consolation in knowing he will be able to follow Hannelore Hanover. There is every reason to expect her to get away quickly from the rail in her first race over a half-mile track.



"She's a great mare. She's one of the best aged mares we've seen," Campbell said. "She is in the Bee A Magician class, put it that way. So she is up there."

Then again, Bee A Magician was unsuccessful in last year's International, finishing sixth, as Papagayo E. gave Norway its first victory in the prestigious race. Papagayo E. was unable to return to defend his title due to an injured suspensory ligament.

Although Burke and Gingras are confident Hannelore Hanover can handle the mile-and-a-quarter distance and the configuration of the track, she will surely be tested by those elements. Baldachino is more concerned about the configuration of the Yonkers oval than anything else.

"She's never raced the half before. That would be my only reservation, not that she's good enough but whether she can get around that tight track at Yonkers," Baldachino said. "She is such a big, long-striding mare, those turns come up on you as soon as she gets in gear."

Even with a great trip, Resolve figures to provide stiff competition. The five-year-old son of Muscle Hill—Anikawiesahalee placed second to famed Nuncio at Elitlopp. He displayed his mettle when he wore down pace-setting Hannelore Hanover by a length-and-a-half in the Maple Leaf Trot at Mohawk on Sept. 17.

"I thought I had that horse beat," Burke said, "and he never quit."

Svanstedt chooses his words carefully in discussing Resolve's prospects. "We need the horse to perform and a little bit of luck, too," he said.

The trainer, who will drive Resolve, believes it will be vital to secure a good early position that will have him in striking distance of the leader.

"It's going to be a European race, not an American race," he said. "You saw last year how the race was. It's going to be the same this year." Papagayo E. benefitted from a pocket trip behind dueling leaders before mounting a successful late charge.

Obrigado, trained by Paul Kelley and driven by Mark MacDonald, completes a strong U.S. contingent. He drew post six and is rated at 6-1. The six-year-old gelding was the last starter to be invited after Ringostarr Treb of Italy was withdrawn. Obrigado owns six wins in 15 starts this year and boasts \$1,362,019 in lifetime earnings.

Most eyes, though, will be on the Indiana-bred that far exceeded expectations. Burke cannot wait to see whether she can add what would be a momentous victory to her

gaudy resume.

"I feel I have the best driver in the race, I think I have one of the better horses in the race and I have the best post position," Burke said. "Obviously, I think I have a shot."

# Family Affair

Swedish trotter Explosive de Vie will contest Saturday \$1 million Yonkers International Trot on behalf of Jim and Susanne Oscarsson and their son, Kevin.

Susanne and Jim Oscarsson have two children, Kevin, 21, and Natalie, 16. But it often feels more like three since a needy trotter named Explosive de Vie commands so much of their daily attention.

Rarely has one horse been the product of such a family affair. Jim trains the five-year-old gelding, Susanne serves as his caretaker and Kevin will drive him as part of a field of 10 when the \$1 million Yonkers International Trot is held Saturday afternoon at Yonkers Raceway.

"We do what we are best at," Susanne said. "My strongest side is to take care of horses. My husband's strongest side is to train the horses, and my son's strongest side is to drive them. I think we are a good complement for each other."

Their combined talents helped the son of Explosive Matter—Ava put behind him the wayward days of his youth and develop into a trotter worthy of joining On Track Piraten as one of two representatives of Sweden in the International.

"When he was two years old, he trained in Florida and was real crazy," Jim said. "When he was two and three years old, he was a problem kid."

Explosive de Vie was gelded after he injured himself while in his stall as a two-year-old. Jim proceeded slowly with him in his training while Susanne continues to shower him with a mother's love.

"He has so much energy. He's always happy. He loves to train," Susanne said. "He gives me a kick in my life."

Susanne has 35 years of experience as a caretaker. She met Jim 30 years ago, with their mutual love of horses helping to bring them together. Jim was born into a racing family; his father trained as well. Susanne also drove in Sweden early in her career, but she thoroughly enjoys the chance to be hands-on with a horse.

"When the horses race, you have such a feeling," she said. "I just want to scream. You work so hard."

She will surely be heard on Saturday. On his best day, Explosive de Vie can be formidable. He placed second to trotting great Nuncio in the Jubileumspokalen this year. He has cracked the top three in seven of 12 starts this season, including three victories, to earn \$111,842. He is eight for 49 lifetime with 15 second-place finishes and eight third-place efforts in banking \$376,921.

"He's been better for every race," Jim said.

Jim and Susanne both bring a vast amount of experience to the barn. That does not mean they will always view a situation the same way. Susanne said they have disagreements "every day" that never linger.

"He's the boss," she said.

Jim sustained a broken wrist not long ago that opened the door for Kevin to drive Explosive de Vie in the International. The Oscarssons were open to handing over the responsibilities to an American driver. The owners wanted Kevin, who has handled the reins for the last four starts.

Kevin admits to feeling a bit in awe as he prepares to compete in the \$1 million contest. "The other day I saw the list of the other drivers," he said. "Just to be on the list with them is a big thing."

His task became even greater when his horse drew post 10. Explosive de Vie is listed at 12-1 on the morning line.

Kevin is doing his best to take everything in stride. He does not expect nervousness to be an issue.

"I'm not the kind of guy who gets nervous. I'm more excited," he said. "I hope to be the same on race day."

It helps that he grew up in the game. He was given his first pony when he was 8 years old. "My mom and dad have been great for me, teaching me about horses," he said. "They helped me so much."

Susanne expects Kevin to be unflappable as he works to overcome a start in the second tier. "He is like that," she said.

"I am more nervous, a lot of feelings."

Jim said of his emotions when he watches Kevin in action, "I can't explain that. My heart is so fast."

In a sense, the Oscarssons believe they cannot lose. Whatever the outcome, Kevin will benefit from the experience. "The better races he drives in, the better he gets," Jim said.

Their time together in New York has been so enjoyable that they are already talking about the International next year, if they are in position to receive another invitation. They believe Explosive de Vie will respond to the half-mile oval at Yonkers extremely well because one of his strengths is his ability to handle turns. They also think he is a year away from peaking.

"I think he's going to be perfect next year," Susanne said. "He's still learning. He's a boy."

And very much a member of the family.



#### A deeper look at Marion Marauder's Triple Crown

Thanks to Marion Marauder's win in Sunday's Kentucky Futurity at Red Mile, Paula Wellwood is the first female trainer to win a Triple Crown. Driver Scotty Zeron, 27, is the youngest to win one — and the only driver under 30 to win a Triple Crown race with both a trotter and a pacer (he won the Jug in 2012 with Michaels Power at the age of 23).

Prior to Marion Marauder's victory, it had been 10 years since the last Triple Crown (Glidemaster) and two more years to the one before that (Windsongs Legacy), who ended a 32-year Trotting Triple Crown drought that stretched back to 1972 when Super Bowl won it.

#### Slim margin

Marion Marauder's Nose-Head-Head victories in the Triple Crown events is the closest ever combined margin for any Triple Crown winner.

The last nose winner of the Hambletonian who then went on to win the Triple Crown was Scott Frost in 1955 — the very first Triple Crown champ.

#### **Trotting Triple Crown first**

Marion Marauder is the first Trotting Triple Crown winner ever to be sired by a Horse Of The Year (Muscle Hill – 2009).

On the pacing side, the 1971 and 1972 Horse of the Year Albatross sired the 1980 Triple Crown winner Niatross.

#### Oh, Canada

Joe O'Brien won the Triple Crown in 1955 with Scott Frost. O'Brien was Canadian just like Marion Marauder's connections Scott Zeron, Paula Wellwood and Mike Keeling. The only trainers in the last four decades to win a Triple Crown and not be born in Canada were Ivan Sugg (2003 with No Pan Intended) and Trond Smedshammer (2004 with Windsongs Legacy).

#### The book on Marion Marauder

- The ninth trotter to win the Triple Crown (10 pacers have done so)
- Scott Zeron is the eighth different driver to win the Trotting Triple Crown
- Paula Wellwood is the eighth different trainer to win the Trotting Triple Crown (Stanley Dancer doubled up with Nevele Pride 1968 and Super Bowl 1972) and the first female trainer to win the Triple Crown
- Marion Marauder at 11-for-26 lifetime is the only Trotting Triple Crown winner with a lifetime slate of less than 50 per cent.
- Zeron, later this month, will try and win his first Breeders Crown after winning his first Triple Crown.

#### **Double Crowning?**

No Trotting Triple Crown winner has ever contested the Breeders Crown after winning the Triple Crown. In 2004, Windsongs Legacy passed on the Breeders Crown the following month and the horse he defeated by 33 lengths in the Kentucky Futurity final — Yankee Slide — wound up winning it. In 2006, Glidemaster had already competed in the Breeders Crown (finishing second to Majestic Son) before he won the Yonkers Trot In November.

#### Four horsemen

The four riders/jockeys over \$290 million in career earnings have a combined zero Triple Crowns — John Velazquez, John Campbell, Pat Day and Jerry Bailey

#### Fun note on Glidemaster

Eight was enough for the next most recent Trotting Triple Crown winner Glidemaster.

His Hambletonian victory came in the eighth race on Hambletonian Day in 2006 from post position eight and it had been eight years since John Campbell's previous Hambletonian winner.

Glidemaster ended the year with eight wins (in 15 starts) and his hip number as a yearling was 88.

#### Support of family and staff help Steacy to career best year

Mohawk Racetrack plays host to the \$2 million Ontario

Sires Stakes (OSS)
Super Finals on
Saturday, (Oct. 15)
and trainer Mark
Steacy will cap off a
career best year in
the program by
sending out starters

With 263 points, Steacy is poised to capture his first Johnston Cup title as the top trainer in the Ontario Sires Stakes program. Heading into the season finale, Steacy has a 39-point lead on reigning title-holder and eight-time winner Robert McIntosh and sits 42 points ahead of three-time winner Gregg McNair. Steacy and his staff have

harnessed 128 starters in the provincial program to date for 14 wins, 13 seconds, 20 thirds, 28 fourths, 12 fifths and earnings of \$573,540.

"I'm pretty proud of that," said Steacy of his career-best statistics. "Again, that's not just me, that's the staff too.

"First of all you've got to have the great owners and then you've got to have the great help. These guys work hard, and if it wasn't for them the results wouldn't be the same."

In addition to his season-long OSS success, Steacy achieved a major milestone in August when his career earnings surpassed \$20 million. Both accomplishments are part of a decade-long evolution in Steacy's operation that

started when son Shawn joined the business.

"It all happened probably in the last 12 years; we were kind of low key until about 12 years ago," said Steacy, a lifelong horseman who was introduced to harness racing by his father Clarke, Sr. "After Shawn graduated out of school

> and came on with me I was able to keep horses and race them rather than sell them, which I used to do before. I used to develop them, race them a few times in Ottawa or Montreal, and then sell them."

For several years, Shawn supervised a temporary operation near Mohawk during the peak months of the Ontario Sires Stakes season, but last fall father and son decided it was time to establish a more permanent base at the First Line Training Centre in Nassagaweya, ON.

"Shawn was up here all winter this year. We've come up before with half a dozen or 10 horses

and stayed for three or four months, and we've done that for 10 years or so, but we've never stayed all winter until this year," explained Steacy, who was honored with the O'Brien Award for Horsemanship in 2007. "We're going to be here again all winter. I'll do my babies at home in Lansdowne, but we'll keep the older horses up here."

Steacy has already acquired 18 yearlings and expects that number to climb as high as 25 before the sales season wraps up. While Shawn, who now makes his home in Guelph, ON, handles the older horses, Steacy will have the support of his younger son Clarke, Jr. when it comes time to start the yearlings.



"I have Clarke on board too," said Steacy, adding that Clarke, Jr. has decided to switch his focus from catch-driving to training for the time being. "He's actually running the Lansdowne outfit right now, and so I think that's going to help us to even get to another level."

All three men are currently focused on finishing the Ontario Sires Stakes season on a high note, ensuring Dream Massive, Sass, Royal Charm and Nocturnal Bluechip are in peak shape for their respective \$250,000 Super Finals on Saturday.

Two-year-old trotting colt Dream Massive will kick things off from post six in the first Super Final, and his connections are hoping the son of Muscle Mass minds his manners after making breaks in his last two Gold Series starts.

"We trained him (Wednesday), and he trained good, so hopefully," said Steacy, who conditions the colt for Michael Soehnlen of Dalton, OH. "I thought we had him sorted out there and he went out and made a mistake again last time. He just got bully in the hole. Off and on he's showed that he does have quite a bit of ability, but he can be his own worst enemy."

Three-year-old trotting colt Sass gets post three in the fifth Super Final of the card and Steacy is hoping the Kadabra colt has bounced back from a viral infection that showed up after the Oct. 6 Gold Leg at Mohawk.

"He still got fourth, but that was his worst start," said Steacy, who put the colt on a course of antibiotics after the race. "Hopefully he'll be good to go on Saturday; I think a healthy Sass has got a shot. Obviously you've got to have that thing called luck on your side, but if it is then I think he's got a shot."

Hudson Standardbred Stable Inc. of Hudson, QC bred and owns Sass, who has earned \$177,980 in his career to date.

Sophomore trotting filly Royal Charm landed post four for her last Ontario Sires Stakes start and will be looking to continue the hot streak she has been riding through the last six weeks. After a pair of third-place finishes in the Simcoe Stakes and her Elegantimage Elimination, the daughter of Steacy's former superstar Majestic Son scored an upset win in the \$436,000 Elegantimage Final and then finished second in the last Gold Leg.

"She's finally coming together for us. We always knew she had a lot of go to her, and she's been behaving herself, touch wood, lately," said Steacy. "As long as she does that, she's not a big horse getting off the gate, but she can always kick home well.

"If she races respectable I think then she is eligible to the Breeders Crown, and I think the Matron, so it's possible that we could finish the year off with that." Steacy conditions the winner of \$341,462 for David McDonald of Cornwall, ON, Shelly MacMillan of Waterloo, ON, Hudson Standardbred Stables Inc. of Hudson, QC and Bridle Path Stables Ltd. of Ossining, NY. "We'll just have to see how Saturday goes first."

Steacy's final entry comes in the three-year-old pacing colt showdown with Nocturnal Bluechip lining up at post nine, alongside the reigning division champion Betting Line, who gets the outside post 10

"He's got a tough post and he probably needs a better post more than them all," said Steacy of Nocturnal Bluechip. "He's been kind of a letdown this year, you know, a horse that's got lots of speed but just hasn't done what we expected of him. The way he's going, he's going to have to trip out really well."

Landmark 8 Racing Stable of Kingston, ON, Jane Phair of Thornbury, ON and NLG Racing Stable of Wallkill, NY share ownership of Nocturnal Bluechip, who heads into the Super Final with lifetime earnings of \$225,901.

James MacDonald will steer Nocturnal Bluechip, Dream Massive and Sass, while Paul MacDonell pilots Royal Charm.

Mohawk Racetrack's first race goes postward at 7:30 pm on Saturday, with the eight \$250,000 Super Finals slated as Races two through five and seven through 10. In addition to the on track excitement, Mohawk fans will receive an Ontario Sires Stakes ball cap when they purchase a program and can play the fun-filled OSS Trivia Spin and Win game for more great prizes.

# **Extended government funding in Ontario?**

Ontario Racing (OR), the new industry association for horse racing in Ontario, is pleased to announce that consultations have begun regarding a proposed longer-term funding framework and agreement for the industry beyond 2021. This framework, subject to government approval, will be presented to the industry for feedback. If approved, this framework will provide the industry as a whole – from owners, trainers and breeders to racetrack operators – with the certainty they need to make investments in their businesses. OR's primary objective, to this point, has been to engage directly with the Ontario Lottery and Gaming Corporation and the government to provide input to the development of a roadmap to sustainable funding for the industry. Now, OR's focus will shift towards engagement with the industry as a whole to garner feedback on this proposed framework.

This proposed framework is based on key principles including:

- A new racetrack alliance: all Ontario racetracks that conduct live racing will be invited to create a new alliance. It is proposed that Woodbine Entertainment Group (WEG) will serve as the administrator of this new alliance.
- Longer- term, predictable funding: Ontario's horseracing industry can invest in their businesses beyond 2021.
- **Ongoing accountability and transparency:** decision-making based on evidence and agreed upon success indicators.

• Industry leadership: racetrack business plans, race dates, purse levels will be aligned across racetracks for a coordinated approach. Ontario Racing will play a key industry leadership role in the future.

Next steps include, in addition to an introductory webinar, widespread 'in person' conversations with the industry about these principles, across Ontario. Sessions will take place in every region of the province that has horseracing, throughout the month of November. Dates and locations will be posted on the OR website, at <a href="https://www.ontarioracing.com">www.ontarioracing.com</a>. Industry participants can also provide feedback by answering consultation questions online on the Ontario Racing website. Ontario Racing will collate feedback from the industry, and this perspective will inform recommendations to government.

#### **Indiana Super Finals Saturday**

The 2016 Indiana Sires Stakes program will culminate at Hoosier Park Racing & Casino on Saturday (Oct. 15) with the \$220,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Super Finals. The star-studded 14-race card will showcase the best trotters and pacers in the state of Indiana and provide an exciting conclusion to the 2016 Indiana stakes season.

With purses in excess of \$2 million, the Indiana Sires Stakes Super night will be the richest night offered in the Indiana Sires Stakes program this season featuring eight \$220,000 finals. The two and three-year-olds competing in the Super finals have accumulated points throughout the season, based on performance in the previous \$75,000 finals, and the top point earners have earned the right to seek glory in the \$220,000 finals. Complimenting the program will be four divisions for the aged competitors, each carrying a purse of \$50,000.

The \$220,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Super Finals will start in the third race on the program with a field of 10 three-year-old trotting fillies. Fawn De Savage and driver/trainer Dan Shetler have been enlisted as the 5-2 morning line choice and will start from post five. The daughter of Keystone Savage—Ms Mastercraft has won seven of 18 starts while bankrolling \$133,109 this season.

The sophomore pacing filly sensation Seventimesavirgin will put her eight-race winning streak on the line facing nine other rivals in the \$220,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final for three-year-old pacing fillies. Trained and driven by John DeLong, the daughter of Always A Virgin—Mrs Grant Seven is

undefeated in stakes action this season and will start from post three as the 4-5 morning line choice.

Driver John DeLong will also look to keep a winning streak alive with Bridge To Jesse's who looks to notch his seventh consecutive victory in the \$220,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final for three-year-old trotting colts and geldings. Slated as the 11th race on the 14-race card, Bridge To Jesse's will start from post eight as the even money morning line favorite for trainer Roger Welch.

The \$220,000 Indiana Sires Stakes Super Final for three-year-old pacing colts has been slated as the 13th race on the program and will provide an exciting conclusion to the evening's stakes action. Granite and driver Mike Peterson will look to score their second consecutive stakes victory against this group from post six for trainer Melanie Wrenn. The last time the sophomore pacing colts met behind the starting gate in stakes action, Granite pulled a 44-1 upset in the fifth and final \$75,000 preliminary stakes final in September at Hoosier Park.

"Hoosier Champions Super Finals Night has become a hallmark of the Hoosier Park racing season," Hoosier Park's vice president and general manager or racing, Rick Moore said. "It is with pride that we showcase the crème de la crème of Indiana Sired horses to the rest of the country and beyond. Who knows, several of these Indiana phenoms may soon follow in the footsteps of Wiggle It Jiggleit, Always B Miki, Freaky Feet Pete and Hannelore Hanover."

In addition to all of the exciting races on the track, there will be a multitude of activities for racing fans to enjoy off the track as well. Hoosier Park and the Indiana Standardbred Association (ISA) have once again partnered to offer numerous giveaways and live entertainment throughout the evening.

# **Canadian Driving Championship** on Friday

Canadian The National Driving Championship, presented by Standardbred Canada, will take place tonight (Oct. 14) at The Raceway at the Western Fair District in London, Ontario.

The Championship is an eight-race event and drivers earn points based upon their finishing positions. Drivers were able to have input into the horses they will be driving as a hockey pool style "draft" was conducted Tuesday for them to choose their horses in each race before the post position draw was made.

Eight drivers from across the country have qualified in four regional events co-ordinated by Standardbred Canada and will congregate in London, ON this October to battle it out for the National Driving Championship title and the honor of representing Canada in the 2017 World Driving Championship on home turf.

Here is a recap of the qualifying events from earlier this year:

James MacDonald of Guelph, ON won the **Ontario Regional event** at Grand River Raceway while Trevor Henry, of Arthur, ON finished as the runner-up. This will be MacDonald's first NDC and Henry's second, as he competed in the 2011 event. Henry later went on to represent Canada in the 2013 World Driving Championship in France.

Atlantic Regional winner Jason Hughes of Stratford, PEI, and runner up Corey MacPherson, of Vernon Bridge, PEI, will make their first NDC appearance after qualifying at Red Shores Racetrack & Casino at Charlottetown Driving Park.

After finishing 1-2 in the **Western Regional** at Century Downs Racetrack and Casino, Brandon Campbell, of Calgary and Jim Marino, of Surrey, B.C., are both hoping to return from the NDC with more than Air Miles. Both of these drivers took part in the 2014 event at Red Shores Racetrack and Casino at CDP, and this will mark Campbell's third consecutive attempt at the National title as he also competed in 2011.

The Quebec/Eastern Ontario Regional was won by Guy Gagnon, of Gatineau, QC, who competed in the 2014, and 2009 events, while Brett MacDonald, of Embrun, ON, makes his NDC debut with his runner-up finish, only one point back of Gagnon in the qualifier.

The NDC races are carded as races 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9 and 10. First race post time is 7:05 p.m.
