Captaintreacherous, Put On Show Top Crown Elims, Preps

The storm before the bigger storm, a night of elims and important preps, will kick off Breeders Crown action tonight at Woodbine. With four elims and an appearance by Put On A Show in a prep for her Breeders Crown showdown against males, the card will have no shortage of star power or important storylines.

There will be seven more Breeders Crown elims on Satur-

day's card.

The 2-year-old pacing sensation
Captaintreacherous is the biggest name on the card, and he will help get the night going in the second race, an elim for the Breeders
Crown 2-year-old male pace. He's coming off an unexpectedly difficult win in the International Stallion Stakes at

the Red Mile, where he won by a mere nose as the 1-5 favorite. After it was over, trainer Tony Alagna discovered that his colt was a bit under the weather. Tests showed that he has an elevated white count.

"He was definitely fighting off some kind of sickness or bug," Alagna said. "We feel like he's back to his self."

It's been a near perfect year for Captaintreacherous, but it will be over after the Breeders Crown. Alagna said the plan all along was to race him sparingly this year and have something left in the tank for his 3-year-old campaign.

"Ten races this year was our plan," he said. "From the time we were ready to baby race this horse we had his schedule mapped out. Of course things can always change but when Myron Bell and I sat down at beginning of the season we put this schedule together and we've been fortunate that he's lived up to our expectations so far as what we felt was a proper schedule for him. We're hoping he comes back and races great as a 3-year-old as well."

Alagna will also take a shot at the 2-year-old filly pace with Nikki Beach, like Captaintreacherous an offspring of Somebeachsomewhere. After a rough stretch in late summer, she's bounced back to win two of her last three.

"She's had a nice little comeback for us," Alagna said. In his first Breeders Crown, Alagna is poised to make history. He has entered 10 horses in the event, many of which have solid chances.

"It's a tremendous feeling," he said. "Last year we had a couple of horses who were fringe players and I just didn't


feel like they were good enough. This year we've brought horses with legitimate chances to come up here and do well. I am not disappointed with any of them coming into the Breeders Crown All had good starts in Lexington and give me every indication they deserve this opportunity."

Though not an elimination event, the eighth race on the card figures to have serious Breeders Crown ramifications. A \$42,000 Open for older fillies and mares, it features six horses slated to go eight nights later in the Breeders Crown race for older female pacers. A seventh, Put On A Show, will be warming up for what could be an historic victory over males.

Co-owner Richard Young said he has long wanted to try his 5-year-old mare against males and felt this the Breeders Crown was the perfect place to go for it.

"If I was ever going to try it now is the time, " Young said. "When you look at the best older males, at least three or four have fallen by the wayside the last few months, including the best one, Betterthancheddar. They're still a strong group but not as strong as they were and that added to my decision to give it a try."

Young said he wants to give his mare a chance to show the sport just how good she is.



"Maybe I am an over optimistic owner, but this is our shot to do something special," he said. "I think she's as good as the boys and if she trips out she can beat them. If ever there were a shot to show everyone just how good she is this is it. You've got to have some fun with these things every once in a while."



Return of Final Four Among Many Changes at Meadowlands 2013

A major revamping of the 2-year-old stakes schedule and return to fall racing head a list of changes that will be implemented when the Meadowlands resumes racing in 2013.

The Woodrow Wilson and the Sweetheart have been dropped from the Meadowlands racing schedule. Their place will be taken by the return of the "Final Four" races for 2-year-olds, the Governor's Cup, the Three Diamonds, the Valley Victory and the Goldsmith Maid. Those races began at Garden State Park and have been looking for a permanent home after the South Jersey track closed in 2000. They were last contested at Chester in 2011.



"I'm going to shift things around so that the majority of 2-year-old money will be in the latter half of the year, " Meadowlands owner Jeff

Gural said. "We will reward those trainers who are a little more patient with their 2-year-olds and, hopefully, we won't see as many breakdowns and will make it easier for horses to come back at three. Hopefully, guys will go easy at the beginning of the year because the vast majority of purse money is going to be Lexington, the Breeders Crown, the Matron and my races. All the big money will be out there from late September to late November and I think that will shift the focus on 2-year-olds racing a little later in year."

Gural said the purses for the Final Four races have yet to be determined but he expected they would be comparable to what was offered when they were last held in 2011.

The Meadowlands meet will end Hambletonian Day in 2013, rather than two weeks after the track's biggest event. Gural said he would re-open the Saturday after Thanksgiving and continue to race through Hambletonian Day 2014. The extra stretch on the calendar won't, however, mean more racing days as Gural plans to drop Thursday night racing whenever Harrah's Philadelphia is open.



With fall racing the Meadowlands once again becomes an option for the Breeders Crown. Gural said he would like to host the Breeders Crown races for older horses in 2014 and bevond.

"I know there is some sentiment to having all 12 on the same day," he said. "Having been there for that I think by the tenth or eleventh race the place starts to empty out. Personally, I think it's more appealing if the 2 and 3-year-old races are separate. We would love to have the whole card, but we just don't have the money."

Gural had no updates on his search for a new general manager at the Meadowlands other than to say he has been contacted by several candidates.

US Trotting Association (USTA) members who plan to give away or sell a horse with the provision they not be raced or bred are urged to take one important last step. Members now have the option, at no cost, to convert their horse's registration to Pleasure Horse.



eny registered."

"This is the only way to ensure that a verbal agreement between two parties to not race or breed a horse is honored," said USTA Registrar T.C. Lane. "Once the conversion to Pleasure Registration is complete, there is a record of the Pleasure Horse transaction in our database and no entry to race can be made, no prog-

Lane urges careful consideration, as conversion is permanent and cannot be reversed by a future owner. "This is a process we hope will be undertaken by owners who want to ensure their intentions are honored throughout the horse's life, when no longer in their care," explained Lane.

In its effort to promote pleasure registration and off-the-track options for Standardbreds, the USTA has completely revamped the Life After Racing section of ustrotting.com, which was launched today and can be seen by clicking on the Life After Racing tab on the homepage.

"The timing of the announcement of the USTA's Pleasure Horse registration and Life After Racing initiatives coincides very well with my participation in the Welfare and Safety of the Racehorse Summit in Lexington over the last two days," said USTA Executive Vice President/CEO Mike Tanner. "The welfare of our race horses when their racing days are

over is an issue of great importance and one that demands and deserves our attention."

Pleasure Registration conversion is open to members with care, custody or control of a horse for which they are the listed owner in the USTA database. New registration papers can be prepared to reflect the horse's converted status, if that is required for pleasure discipline competition. Members should complete a pleasure registration conversion



form, which can be obtained here or by calling 877-800-8782 x 1. The form should be returned with the horse's registration papers, unless they have electronic registration.

Conversion cannot be done on a horse no longer in the care, custody or control of the owner listed in the USTA database and cannot be done over the phone. The Pleasure Registration logo (attached) will appear next to the horse's name in the Pathway system for all horses whose registration has been converted. Pleasure Registration is one of three USTA initiatives to address Standardbred welfare. The Full Circle program click here uses the USTA database to allow anyone to record their name in a horse's file if they wish to be contacted if that horse needs help in the future. Support Our Standardbreds (SOS) click here provides financial assistance to horses whose care has fallen to a level requiring legal intervention. New York's Equine Industry: Vital to State's Economy (edited press release)

A thriving equine industry is vital to the health of the New York State economy, according to the results of a study released earlier this week. The New York State Equine



Industry Economic Impact Study determined that the equine industry has a \$4.2 billion effect on the state's economy and generates 33,000 full-time jobs. Equine commerce also results in \$187 million in state and local taxes for New York. The thousands of horse farms, training centers and riding stables doing business across the state pre-

serve 1.3 million acres of open space. There are 157,500 horses in New York.

Joe Faraldo, president of the Standardbred Owners Association and advocate for harness horsemen across New York State, said, "Thanks to the thoughtful and effective VLT initiative put in place by New York State legislators, New York's harness racing industry is stronger than ever and has regained its rightful role as the nation's leader in high-quality harness racing. This harness renaissance has meant new jobs across the state for horse trainers, veterinarians, farmers, feed suppliers, breeders, grooms, blacksmiths and countless others throughout our local economies, and our priority now must be to ensure that our racing and agriculture industries are protected and promoted as part of any future gaming expansion in New York."

New York's racing industry engenders a particularly strong work force. The Study demonstrates that there are 80 jobs for every 100 racehorses in New York. In addition, each individual racehorse has an economic impact of \$92,100 on the state's bottom line. The racehorse population is 23,100.



The equine industry contributes to the local economies of every one of New York's 62 counties. In addition to the 2,300 breeding, training and racing facilities across the state devoted to Standardbreds and Thoroughbreds, there are 23,000 family-owned farms and stables, as well as commercial enterprises that include show horse operations, boarding and riding stables, and breeding farms for recreational and show horses. Every member of the equine industry in turn supports state and local businesses.

State Senator John Bonacic, Chairman of the Senate Committee on Racing, Gaming and Wagering said, "New York State is moving in the right direction with respect to the horse racing industry. The industry though, is greater than what you see on the track. It includes jobs in rural communities like Shawangunk in Ulster County - at Blue Chip Farms, and it includes direct tourism in destination communities like Saratoga."

Horses are one of the leading agricultural commodities in the state.

"The equine industry is tremendously important to agriculture in New York State," said Dean Norton, president of the New York Farm Bureau. "Horse farms create jobs, support the agricultural infrastructure and drive economic development in many regions of the state. Equine farms, of all types, are critical to the success of the agricultural community and the state."

Revenue from New York's equine industry has grown significantly in the last six years. According to a study re-

leased in 2005, the state's racing and recreational horse industries had an economic impact of \$2.4 billion. Despite a national and global economy crisis in the interim, equine commerce has enjoyed a 75% increase, underlining the success of the state's investment in the industry through the VLT initiative.

New York State Assembly Racing & Wagering Committee Chair J. Gary Pretlow said, "The equine industry is a critically important sector in our New York State economy, with tens of thousands of jobs across virtually every region of the state. These range from horse breeders, trainers and backstretch workers to jobs in affiliated industries like hay farmers and veterinarians, and all of them represent a strong and growing economic development success story. Our goal must be to ensure that our agriculture and racing industries can continue to grow and thrive in New York State."

Total handle at the state's harness tracks has been on the rise, with reported increases of as much as 10% in 2012. Handle at Yonkers Raceway grew 20% between 2006 and 2010. The closing of New York City OTB at the end of 2010 took its toll, but Yonkers handle was still 10% higher last year than in 2007, and wagering is on pace to return to its 2010 peak this year. Over the last decade, the number of Standardbred broodmares in the state has grown 25%, and stud fees for New York's Standardbred stallions has risen 140%. The quality of the racing has paralleled economic gains, with New York-bred harness horses competing at the highest level across the country, and New York sires among the leaders in the nation.

Went first over three back in a Milton elimination against Drop The Ball and Put On A Show, held very well. Gets along good with Jack; might seek jump on #5. TEA

PARTY PRINCESS has been more than good enough in recent starts and throughout the year but for whatever reason is never in a good position; thus the 1 for 16 on the year. I don't completely get it and she could win; but morning line favoritism might be excessive. MAUREEN ROCKS has her work cut out while looking in.

### Race 9, Fillies & Mares Open

In an Open that for all intents and purposes could be called the Crown Prep, ANNDROVETTE seems just as good as anyone. This is one is obviously capable of big time speed, but should be able to get off fairly cheap tonight from the rail considering the conditions. Much better chance now as opposed to next week. The supplemental entry REBEKA BAYAMA has proved on numerous occasions in recent months she can go with these; a legitimate Crown threat. Too bad her trip didn't work out better last out in the Milton final; she was deceptively good that night. Morrill follows Rocklamation up here; that's encouraging. Some of her biggest wins of the year have been shockers. PUT ON A SHOW stopped when last seen in these parts; rebounded nicely at Pocono. An obvious contender – maybe even the favorite – for next week, but for tonight I'm not sure. Note that CAMILLE finally gets a chance with Gingras; will offer a price and can't be ruled out.

### Race 10, Claiming \$20-\$25,000

SHIFTIN GEARTOGEAR was one that I noted of last week despite making his first start back in months. Erratically fast gelding blazed the front end path as a longshot last week and nearly lived to tell about it at 20/1; just got passed late by only one horse. No question about the strategy; will be winging. Despite being compromised by the post, ST LADS HE MAN hasn't seen a claiming group this low in awhile. Will offer a price and could be heard from. COOL ROCK swept last out for his second in a row. Steps up for the third consecutive time; very sharp. SMOKEYS LUCK remains razor sharp despite having his streak derailed last out; it was still a top notch effort. Any repeat of that powerful 1:51:4 win from a couple back would be good enough to overcome the post; win. CAMPASSER should have been better on the drop in his last; I still wouldn't include at a short price.

### Race 11. N/W 4 F&M

DRIVING MISS DEO was second best last out to the sports best 2YO filly, L Dees Lioness. Someone had to be second that night, but she was moving well late nonetheless. Those Grand River lines from JET SPEED look formidable; was rock solid when last seen at Mohawk three back. MACHLEEN will be aggressive in this spot from the rail; could work out a la September 10. Speed should be coming from the far outside for Coleman's JEREMES SWEET-HEART; is capable of taking these all the way. RED SHADOW seeks to repeat for O'Sullivan; post will put her into the flow. HOPE FOR PADDY was won 10 of 26 on the year.
