When driver John DeLong makes his Breeders Crown debut tonight, it will be special. Of course, such an occurrence would be exceptional under any circumstances, but the fact his appearance will come with a homebred horse at his adopted hometown track makes the moment even more extraordinary.

DeLong's father, Jay, and raised at his family's farm in Wisconsin. DeLong also trains the 4-year-old mare, who is 5-1 on the morning line.

So, did he ever imagine anything like this when he was growing up?

"No, not even remotely close," the 28-year-old DeLong said with a chuckle.

"It's pretty exciting. Just to be part of it, to have a horse that's even considered good enough to put in the entry box, is the first thing. You sit and watch it on TV year after year and to have one that's good enough to think about putting in is pretty cool.

"She's a pretty special horse for us as a family. She's earned her right to compete against the top horses. She doesn't owe us a thing. (The Breeders Crown) is on her home turf and we're going to give her a shot. Not many people get that chance."

Seventimesavirgin has won 23 of 39 career races and earned \$566,110. Last year, she was the Indiana Sire Stakes champion after going undefeated in 11 races on the circuit. The mare is a daughter of stallion Always A Virgin out of the mare Mrs Grant Seven, who was a stakes winner in Illinois.

"She does no wrong," DeLong said. "She's given me some of the biggest wins of my career. This year, she's had a few troubles, but she's worked through them and she always tries hard."

of three drives this weekend in Breeders Crown eliminations. He also will drive Trent Stohler's 2-year-old female pacer Rock On Ladys tonight and Jeff Cullipher's 5-year-old stallion Rock N' Roll World in Saturday's elims for the Breeders Crown open pace.

Rock N' Roll World has won 18 of 77 career races and earned \$705,477. He is 8-1 on the morning line in his elimination, where Sintra is the 5-2 favorite.

"That's a tough division, but he's showed spots where he can go with them," DeLong said, noting a troubled-trip third-place finish in the Dan Patch Invitational at Hoosier Park. "I thought I had a big shot in that race, but it just wasn't his night. He's not the top horse in that group, but he's a horse that can get a check."

Rock On Ladys, who has won two of 11 races this year, is a 20-1 long shot in her elimination but finished third in the Indiana Sire Stakes championship.

DeLong was 19 years old when he won the driving title at Running Aces in its inaugural season in 2008. In 2016, he set career highs with 375 wins and \$4 million in purses. In August, DeLong got career win No. 2,000, which occurred at Hoosier Park, where he is this season's No. 3 driver in victories.

His family, which operates a worldwide agricultural-distribution business based in Clinton, WI, has been involved in harness racing for decades and is one of only two families enshrined in the Wisconsin Harness Racing Hall of Fame.

DeLong, who now lives in Anderson, IN, is looking forward to the Breeders Crown at Hoosier Park, which is hosting the \$6 million event for the first time ([USTA article here](#)).

"There's a lot of excitement surrounding it," DeLong said. "The track owners are rolling out the red carpet. They're really trying to put on a spectacle and display what we have here in Indiana and really make it nice."

Harness racing can ill afford to follow Keeneland's lead

Further hampering the top of the standardbred customer funnel is a non-starter that will curtail any hope of growth.

As most of you are probably aware, Keeneland Racetrack in Lexington, KY, raised takeout for their fall meet, which began Oct. 6. The juice on straight wagers was raised from 16 per cent to 17.5 per cent, and all other wagers except the pick 5 were raised from 19 per cent to 22 per cent.

Thus far, the meet has not been as successful as many in the past, as **handle is off almost 10 per cent per entry** year over year. When looked at in context, the numbers become even more pronounced: Other Kentucky tracks have had a good year (low takeout Kentucky Downs was up 32 per cent this season, for example), and tracks running in the month of October have done well. Outside Keeneland, **betting handle on U.S. racetracks is up 13.3 per cent per entry**.

While everyone can argue until they're blue in the face about revenue and handle in racing, one item that sticks out with a couple of the recent increases in takeout – like Keeneland's – is how it's being done.

The rich get richer (or accurately, less poor), and the poor get poorer

In today's betting environment, takeout increases are not enacted like, say, in 1948, when New York State upped the hold. In 2017, there are subsets of players, playing at various outlets and some of these avenues (some owned by the large tracks) rebate players based on betting volume.

What happens in many of these cases – and this happened at Keeneland with their increase – is the pain isn't spread

around. While your average smaller player at Twin Spires will pay about 2.48 per cent more in betting taxes due to Keeneland's increase, the larger player doesn't. For one example, a good friend who plays in such a shop had his effective takeout at Keeneland go up by only 1.1 per cent, well below half the increase than that of a smaller player, or tarmac customer.

This new model some thoroughbred tracks are employing wasn't like this even 20 years ago.

The tracks hope, of course, that the small player keeps playing, to subsidize the larger one enough so revenue increases.

The top of the sales funnel doesn't fill

The problem with this tactic (in addition to the smaller players getting ground down by higher takeout, and betting less), is that the top of the funnel – new players, or others who once liked horse racing but didn't win enough to keep them engaged – has trouble filling. All they see is a worse bet, and they thought racing was a worse bet before the takeout increase.

Why this can be dangerous for the long-term health of the sport – as [I presented at the World Trotting Conference last month](#), buttressed by data from Woodbine – is that the top of the funnel is already on life support.

“What was most worrisome was that the top of the funnel for this lifetime pursuit we all enjoy has been sputtering – the 20's to 40's segment is seeing negative growth. Based on analysis of Woodbine's current trends, (in as little as two decades) almost all the betting giant's patrons (will be) over 60 years of age.”

The way this takeout increase happened (and others like it have happened), just gives new players – players already wary of racing as a skill gambling game – another reason to stay away.

Harness can't follow Keeneland, because its top of the funnel is even worse off

We can all remember as short as 15 years ago seeing a horse in the program on an almost daily basis that we really wanted to bet. We'd work for sometimes hours handicapping and constructing tickets around him; he was sure to be 5-1, and probably had a 2-1 chance to win, so we were ready. When we got to the track he may have been bet a little heavier than we'd like at 9-2 or 4-1, but we were firing.

In 2017, the chances of this happening are much lower. Often times the horse I am dying to wager on opens up at 4-5, stays there, and I jump off him to bet someone else. In some cases it's gotten so bad that it has spawned [a social media meme called “they knew”](#). This occurs when a horse who looks 5-2 on paper wins by four under a hold at a completely 'overbet' 3-5. Yes, “they knew”; well, someone did, and it isn't your top of the funnel bettor.

Harness pools are filled with more and more sharp money, and today – even on Hambletonian Day, or at the Breeders Crown – the top of the funnel barely seems to exist.

What should harness racing do? That's the million-dollar question

Fixing harness racing's customer issues is a question every one of us struggles with. There are probably a thousand answers to this problem, and it's quite possible that the vast majority of them are wrong.

But one thing I can say with some assurance – anything that restricts harness racing's top of the funnel, needs to be shelved.

Although there are some harness tracks likely looking at the Keeneland model and saying to themselves it sounds like a good idea, I think they're simply not thinking things through. When they do, I hope they resist the temptation of taking a bite into Keeneland's forbidden fruit, because if they do, it has little chance to ever grow.

On Sunday, Yonkers will play host to some 2,000 people walking to raise money to find a cure for Type 1 Diabetes.

Yonkers comes together to walk for a cure

Sunday's three-mile walk will raise money to fight Type 1 diabetes, the disease that has changed the life of GM Bob Galterio's daughter, Cara.

The fight against Type 1 diabetes has become a community venture at Yonkers Raceway.

The half-mile track is expected to play host to approximately 2,000 participants for a three-mile walk on Sunday (Oct. 22) to raise funds for research aimed at curing the disease. The event has generated more than \$2 million in donations since it was first held at Yonkers five years ago.

The cause is particularly dear to Bob Galterio, who oversees the racing operation and adjacent Empire City Casino as vice president and chief operating officer. His daughter, Cara, was diagnosed with juvenile diabetes in 2000. She was nine years old.

"Personally, I appreciate the support," Galterio said, "and professionally I feel our team is very conscious about the conditions some people find themselves in."

Not long after Cara's illness was discovered, Galterio and his wife, Maggie, brought together family and friends to walk

for a "Cure for Cara." The effort, previously held at several other venues, expanded dramatically after it shifted to Yonkers.

"When we started doing it here at Empire City, we started really engaging our employees, which we have almost 1,300 of," said Taryn Duffy, director of public affairs. "What we found was so many of our employees had personal connections to this disease.

"We started having them write the names of the people they were walking for, whether it was friends or family, and we put those in the hallway for our employees to see. They saw this was something we were doing that was directly impacting them. It is not just one member of the Empire Casino family being impacted, it is hundreds."

Duffy was referring to Type 1 Diabetes in general. When it strikes a juvenile, it can be particularly difficult.

Maggie will never forget her anguish when Cara was found to be ill.

"I couldn't even talk to anybody," she said. "Any time somebody would call me, the relatives, I would burst out crying because it was so devastating."

Cara understands that there are many people who must deal with far greater adversity. But she said of life with diabetes, "I'd give my arm to get rid of it. It's something you

have to deal with every single day, every single hour even.”

When Cara was younger, her mother was almost obsessed about caring for her. Getting the proper amount of sleep became difficult, if not impossible.

“I give Maggie all the credit for this,” Bob said. “She was up all the time checking her in the middle of the night. It changes your life around significantly.”

For Cara, now 26, everything about juvenile diabetes was life-changing, down to the college she chose and the man she married. She wanted to enrol at a school in Maryland. Her anxious mother pushed her to opt for Fairfield University, because it was located 35 minutes from their home. She would only be a drive away if medical issues arose. Cara slammed the door in frustration when she told her mother she would agree to attend Fairfield.

Cara now acknowledges that the decision, however grudgingly it was made, could not have worked out better. For it was at Fairfield that she met Michael Buckenmeyer, now her husband. Their first child, a healthy son named Gallus, was born on May 25.

Michael never viewed Cara’s diabetes as an obstacle in their relationship because his sister, Erin, received the same

diagnosis at a young age. His goal since he was a boy has been to help find a cure, and he is pursuing his doctorate in biomechanical engineering at the University of Pittsburgh.

“He’s on such a mission,” Maggie said. “I wouldn’t be surprised if he helped find it.”

Cara and others already have benefitted from greatly improved monitoring equipment. Other advances are being made.

“We are getting to the day – it’s not tomorrow – but we’re getting closer to the day when we can eradicate this disease,” Bob said.

Cara, her husband, their infant son and Otto, their 98-pound Bernese Mountain dog, will be coming in from Pittsburgh to walk the track where standardbreds usually pace or trot. They have come to treasure the annual show of support.

“It’s kind of overwhelming,” Cara said. “It’s really emotional to see so many people wanting to make a change.”

The return of Walter Case, Jr. to the bike leads to polarizing buzz

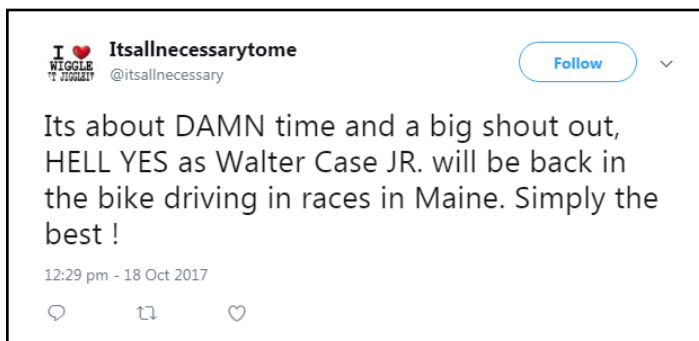
If you follow harness racing closely or even casually, you have heard by now that Walter Case, Jr. is returning to the bike this Saturday ([Scarborough Downs entries @ USTA](#)). That's right, that Walter Case Jr., the one who has not driven full-time in 14 years, yet still ranks 8th on the all-time dash-winning list with more than 11,000 wins.

There is little argument that Case Jr. – a three-time national dash winning champion – knows how to get one to the winner's circle. But his reinstatement in Maine has caused a buzz this week due to the reasons why and incidents related to Case Jr.'s banishment from the sport. He tried to kill his estranged wife, Nadine, and in 2003, Case Jr. was convicted of felonious assault and he was imprisoned for four years. Case also had drug-related and horse-kicking related violations in a checkered career, but, that didn't stop no fewer than 20 trainers at Scarborough Downs to list him as first call on their horses this Saturday. There is no doubt in their minds that the now 56-year-old "Casey" can still point one to the wire first.

The return of Case has been polarizing, to say the least. He has a legion of fans that have been clamoring for his return for years, but it seems there are just as many who don't believe he should be given a licence again.

In response to this statement from Case's lawyer, Evan Fisher: "Everyone deserves a second chance. The commission's decision is not only good for Walter, but it's good for the sport and it's good for Maine's harness racing industry."

Greg Reinhart ([@GregReinhart](#)) tweeted: "Yeah, too bad his second chance was like 18 chances ago."



The owner of Twitter handle [@itsallnecessary](#) didn't agree. He tweeted: "It's about damn time. Best harness driver in history. I sure hope he also can drive at other tracks. Simply the best."

Andrew Middleman, commenting on a post about Case Jr. in the Facebook group "Harness Racing History" said: "If he can't keep his feet in the stirrups, I won't bet the track he drives for," while Roger Sobell commented "Hoping to seeing Casey again... the missing years are a reality and can't be discounted."

It seems everywhere you look on social media if Case's return is mentioned there are those firmly in his corner that can't wait to see him back on the track and just as many at the opposite end of the spectrum who say he's had too many chances already and that his offences are serious enough to preclude his privilege of having a licence to race.

Any way you slice it, the return of the first driver in history to notch more than 1,000 wins in a single season is causing quite a buzz and you can bet there will be far more eyes than usual taking a look at Scarborough Downs this Saturday when Case Jr. makes his return.

Resolve to stand in Ontario at Tara Hills

World champion Resolve 4,1:50.4 (\$2,614,574) (Muscle Hill–Anikawiesahalee–Credit Winner), the fastest and richest son of champion sire Muscle Hill in North America, will be retired to stud at the conclusion of the racing season and stand at Tara Hills Stud in Port Perry, ON under the management of Southwind Farms.

Owned by Hans Enggren of Abbottstown, PA, who acquired him in a private transaction at the beginning of his 3-year-old season, Resolve achieved international success under the tutelage of trainer Ake Svanstadt. His 18 victories include the International Trot at Yonkers in a world record 2:23.4h, the Maple Leaf Trot at Mohawk, the Cashman Memorial, Cutler Memorial (twice) and TVG elim and final at The Meadowlands. He took his mark of 1:50.4 winning the Vincennes Trot also at The Meadowlands. He competed in

the Elitlopp twice, finishing second to Nuncio in 2016 and third to Timoko and Propulsion in 2017.

Bred by Edward Wilson and Michael Pozefsky, Resolve was a \$115,000 Harrisburg yearling sale graduate.

Frozen semen will be available in Sweden through PONESIA AB/Sievert Ingvarsson.

Live harness racing returned to Woodbine Racetrack on Thursday for the 2017-18 Woodbine Fall-Winter meet.

The Fall-Winter meet will feature live racing every Monday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday evenings at 7:30 p.m. The lone exception is a special matinee card on Boxing Day (Dec. 26) at 1 p.m. The final number of race dates for the meet is pending regulatory approval.

The meet will be the last for harness racing at Woodbine, as Mohawk Racetrack will become the home of year-round harness racing beginning in April of 2018 under the name Woodbine at Mohawk Park.

Doug McNair captured the driving title last season at Woodbine and while he carried that momentum over to post leading numbers during the Mohawk meet, the Guelph, ON reinsman feels he is a perfect match for racing at Woodbine.

"It's good for my style, I like to be aggressive and it's more of a front end track," said McNair. "They're going such big speed nowadays, especially back-halves, you can come a half in :53 and not get a check, so you got to be up in the hunt especially going back to Woodbine.

"The front end is a real good spot to be and first-over is not that bad either if you have the right horse."

The wagering menu for Woodbine standardbreds remains the same and continues to feature the popular multi-leg wagers, including the \$50,000 guaranteed Pick-5 and \$50,000 guaranteed Early Pick-4.

The popularity of the Pick-5 wager reached new heights

during the recently concluded Mohawk meet. The average Pick-5 pool for the Mohawk meet was \$73,437 and horseplayers can expect much of the same this season at Woodbine.

Meanwhile, per-race-handle was up eight per cent during the recently-completed Mohawk meet.

The meet, which began on April 13, featured 127 race cards, 17 fewer than 2016, and had an "all-sources" wagering total of \$202,145,413.

The average per-race handle during the 2017 Mohawk meet was \$152,908.78, up \$12,279.27 from the 2016 meet.

Support from U.S. horseplayers saw a per-race increase during the 2017 season, as they wagered an average of \$94,231.14 per-race, up 9.8 per cent from 2016.

The nightly Pick-5 wager rose to new heights in popularity during the meet, as the first-race multi-leg wager had an average pool size of \$73,437.

The Jackpot Hi-5 wager continued to be a staple of the Mohawk wagering menu. A mandatory payout on Oct. 14, featuring a record carryover of \$978,779, saw \$2.3 million wagered into the pool.

Several top racing and community events were highlights for the 2017 season at Mohawk.

On June 13, Woodbine Entertainment announced a \$10 million investment and new branding for Mohawk Racetrack. McNair led all drivers during the Mohawk meet in wins with 155, while Trevor Henry of Arthur, ON was the top earning driver at \$3.8 million.

Trainer Richard Moreau of Puslinch, ON was the top conditioner for the 2017 season, as his stable recorded 78 wins and earned \$1.4 million.

Brad Grant of Milton, ON led all owners in victories with 30, while Serge Godin's Determination stable of Montreal, QC led all owners in earnings with \$839,604.

The tweet by Courant Inc., noted: "Pasithea Face injured and will miss Breeders Crown; will now most likely be retired and bred in the 2018 season."

Trained by Jimmy Takter, Pasithea Face S won six of 13 starts since arriving in North America this year after competing in Europe. The 5-year-old daughter of Muscle Hill finished second in her last start in the \$67,000 Allerage Farm final on Oct. 8 at The Red Mile, which brought her career earnings to \$562,815. She took her lifetime mark of 1:50.4 while capturing a leg of the Miss Versatility on Aug. 20 at Tioga Downs.

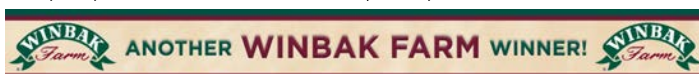
