Ontario on the Brink of a Revival?

A new \$2 million owner bonus and a deal that could provide nearly \$2.2 billion in funding from the provincial government over the next 22 years have breeders and consignors optimistic that Sunday's Forest City Yearling Sale will post strong numbers.

Organizers are hoping for a big day Sunday at this year's Forest City Yearling Sale after a number of good news announcements in the province that indicate the industry may have stabilized.

Ontario's horse racing industry appears to be on the brink of a revival and Ann Straatman said the timing could not be better with the Forest City Yearling Sale set for Sunday afternoon (Oct. 23) at Western Fair's Metroland Media Agriplex in London, ON.

Straatman, the sale manager — and also one of the principals at her family's Seelster Farms in Lucan, ON that will sell some 40 of the 138 yearlings — said Thursday she is cautiously optimistic the sale would exceed the strong numbers it posted a year ago for three main reasons:

1. Confirmation this week from Ontario Racing that details are being finalized on a proposal that could provide nearly \$100 million in annual funding from the provincial government to Ontario's horse racing industry through at least the next 12 years and possibly an additional 10 years to bring the total deal – counting the current \$700 million, seven-year deal that expires in 2021 – to some \$2.2 billion over 22 years.





- 2. A new owner bonus with a total pool of \$2 million for owners of Ontario Sired and/or Ontario Bred horses that begins in 2017 for qualified horses that race in the province.
- 3. A supply shortage of Ontario Sired horses due to lower numbers being bred in the wake of the cancellation of the Slots At Racetracks Program (SARP) in 2013 that should drive demand.

Straatman said a record Lexington Selected Yearling Sale is also a positive sign for this year's Forest City Yearling Sale.

"I would I'm cautiously optimistic given the success of the Lexington sale and reports from a lot of the Ontario buyers that they were not able to get (an Ontario Sired yearling), or one that they wanted in particular there. There's a lot of people still shopping, so we're pretty excited," she said.

"I think the new owner bonus gives something more and rewards those that purchase Ontario Sired, Ontario Bred. The long-term commitment from government would create some stability in the industry where people can feel confident making this purchases knowing that there is going to be a program going forward, not that year-to-year uncertainty. We were wondering what was going to happen after the (current) five-year deal (ends in 2021) and now with some plan for the future, we can all plan for the future."

Stonebridge Farms in Arva, ON will sell eight yearlings at the sale. The farm is operated by Angie Stiller and owned by Stiller and her husband, Dr. Cal Stiller. He said both the owner bonus and the extension of provincial funding, "are positive things. The question is, has that penetrated? Have the buyers really understood that we're into a stable situation in Ontario?... When that settles in, I think that will really have a significant effect. But I suspect that's going to be next year," Stiller said. "The issue of the extra \$2 million, I don't think people understand it."

He said the owner bonus would be easier to understand if there was a concrete example of how much bonus money a horse owner might be able to collect, but that's difficult because the payouts are determined by how many total horses make the races and qualify to be in the bonus pool.

Stiller, who is well connected provincially, said he has high confidence in the stability of the industry in Ontario because he knows the people under current premier Kathleen Wynne involved with trying to correct the damage caused when SARP was canceled by her predecessor and fellow Liberal Dalton McGuinty.

"This premier said, 'Correct it. Correct it right and don't put a Band-Aid on it. Sew up the wound and let's get on with things.' I had full confidence in the people involved. So, to some extent, none of this is a surprise to me," Stiller said of Ontario's revival. "What amazes me is how much skepticism remains out there. People have felt the pain and, for some,

the permanent disruption of what happened with SARP and what was, I thought, the inept attempt to try and correct it to begin with. So, people have this huge skepticism with respect to government... Until it's signed and people know that it's a permanent program, I suspect some will continue to discount whatever is said. But, you know, we've got a program in Ontario that is arguably the best in North America — both for the breeder and for the buyer. My hope would be that they would come to this sale and be full of optimism."

Winbak Farms will sell some 50 yearlings Sunday at the Forest City Sale. Winbak owner Joe Thomson said Thursday, "this business is one of confidence" and the new bonus program for owners, as well as the proposed long-term extension in funding, should help instill confidence.

"As far as breeders are concerned it's not what we're going to do this year or next year, you're trying to think about what we're going to do three years from now. So, I think putting that program together has helped put a bit of confidence in everybody — owners and breeders alike. It showed a lot of strength this year," Thomson said.

Straatman said one of the prime selling points in Ontario is the strength of the Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) program.

"I think the Ontario Sires Stakes program is one of the strongest in North America. It's very consistent with two levels — good purses at the Grassroots level and great purses at the Gold level. It's very competitive, as we saw at the Super Finals last weekend. I think it's a great place to be and a great place to have an Ontario Sired horse, said Straatman.

Thomson said he's such a strong believer in the OSS program that he continued to breed horses in Ontario even after the lucrative SARP program collapsed.

"What is that deal about the squirrel? Even a blind squirrel finds a acorn every once in awhile. Dumb luck is better than being brilliant any time," Thomson said, laughing. "But I'm optimistic about it paying off.

"Since we've had a farm (in Ontario) we've always been a big supporter of the Ontario program."

Winbak Canada currently stands 10 stallions on the site of the former Armstrong Bros. farm in Inglewood, ON.

Thomson said considerable credit needs to go to those in Ontario that fought hard after SARP ended to convince the government of the jobs and economic benefits of the province's horse racing industry.

"I think those people that put that program together (in Ontario) and have been fighting for it, it just shows you that you can't give up. You have to continually fight the good fight and, sooner or later, the good guys win and you're able to convince the Ontario government that agriculture and

horses being part of agriculture is certainly an important piece of what goes on in the province of Ontario."

Consignors are hoping Sunday's sale may be an early indication that hard work is starting to pay off.

Breaking down the Crown

With Breeders Crown eliminations on tap tonight (Oct. 21) and Saturday (Oct. 22) at the Meadowlands, here are some notes of interest:

- Total horses in the elims 147 (29 on Friday and 118 Saturday (every horse in every race).
- Eleven millionaire horses are entered.
- Pacing stallion Somebeachsomewhere leads the way with 25 offspring entered. Trotting stallion Muscle Hill has 21 offspring racing.
- John Campbell is listed on five in the elims, four of them females: L A Delight, Rock Me Baby Cameron Hill and Celebrity Eventsy, as well as trotting colt Blenheim. As Campbell closes in on \$300 million lifetime, it should be noted that he eclipsed the \$100 million plateau in the Breeders Crown with trotting female Armbro Keepsake in 1991. He also eclipsed the \$250 million career milestone with trotting female Snow White in the Breeders Crown at the Meadowlands in 2007.
- Five trainer/drivers are participating in the elims: Pat Lachance, Charlie Norris, Ake Svanstedt, Jeff Gregory and Trond Smedshammer.
- Eight female trainers have horses in the elims: Casie Coleman, Paula Wellwood, Linda Toscano, Tracy Brainard, Nancy Johansson, Annette Lorentzon, JoAnn Looney and Julie Miller.
- Three maidens will appear in Crown eliminations: Voxy 0-3; Another Chapter 0-9 and Ebury Street 0-6.
- In town trying for some Crown glory are the following drivers: Doug McNair, Randy Waples, Chris Christoforou, Jr., Sylvain Filion, James MacDonald, Dave Palone and George Dennis.
- Jimmy Takter's 16 entrants employ six different drivers.
- No Breeders Crown winner from 2015 had ever won a Breeders Crown before. This year, Pure Country, Boston Red

Rocks, and Divine Caroline are all on the elimination card and will be looking for Crown repeats.

- Notable broodmares with offspring racing in Crown elims includes: Windylane Hanover, Tug River Princess, Flawless Bluestone, Cabrini Hanover, C R Kay Suzie, My Little Dragon, Darlins Delight, Idyllic, Rum Boogie, Yellow Diamond, Spellbound Hanover, Silver Springs and Broadway Schooner.
- Western Hanover (11) and Artsplace (nine) have sired the most broodmares with progeny in this year's Crown elims.
- Driver Scott Zeron looks to become the first driver ever to win a Breeders Crown after winning a Triple Crown (which he did with trotter Marion Marauder).
- When Marion Marauder goes to the gate, Zeron will become the second driver in the 21st century to drive a Triple Crown winner at the Meadowlands after winning the Triple Crown. David Miller first accomplished the feat when he drove Pacing Triple Crown winner No Pan Intended to victory in the 2003 Breeders Crown at the Meadowlands.

Trotting Sire Trends at Lexington

An analysis of how the top trotting sires fared at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale this year compared to 2015.

The average at the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale was a record \$56,304, up 24.5 per cent over last year, when the sale was up 13.46 per cent over 2014.

Last week (Oct. 15 issue), we brought you an analysis of the pacing sires. Here's how the trotting sires stacked up compared to a year ago:

Muscle Hill was

far and away the leader as he sold 52 from his fifth crop for a weighty \$114,385 average. That represents a 25 per cent increase over last year. The fact that this is the first crop eligible to the Pennsylvania Sire Stakes adds considerable value to each purchase. And many of the yearlings sold at Lexington, from a variety of stallions, have dual eligibility to resident programs such as Kentucky and New

No surprise, Muscle Hill (shown winning the 2009 Hambletonian with Brian Sears at the controls) led all trotting sires at the Lexington sale by a wide margin.

Jersey. A brother to Mission Brief brought \$800,000, while two other colts sold for \$350,000 and \$300,000. Last year in Lexington, a half-brother to Father Patrick, who went for \$350,000, was the only plus \$300,000 sale. In addition, three colts and a filly topped \$200,000 and 10 colts and five fillies broke \$100,000. In all, 22 yearlings, or 42 per cent of his offering, sold for more than \$100,000. Twenty-five colts and 14 fillies — 75 per cent — broke \$50,000, while all but four of the 52 topped \$25,000. The sire of Ariana G, Southwind Frank and Bar Hopping sold 26 at Lexington and 31 in Harrisburg in 2014, but last year it was 49 at Lexington to 17 at Harrisburg. In 2015, his average jumped \$16,000 in

Lexington, while it declined 18 per cent in Harrisburg. Only 22, or 42 per cent as many, will sell in Pennsylvania.

Cantab Hall, who averaged \$28,000 less than Muscle Hill last year at this event, while selling 48 yearlings, fell \$46,705 behind this time around. Cantab Hall's 48 averaged \$67,680, up \$9,451, or 14 per cent, from 2015. A colt out of a sister to Muscle Mass and Muscle Massive brought \$350,000; a colt and a filly exceeded \$200,000 and two colts and three fillies topped \$100,000. That represents 16 per cent of the offering crossing the \$100,000 threshold. Twenty-two — 44 per cent — broke \$50,000, while 92 per cent topped \$25,000. This is an improvement over last year when 34 per cent topped \$50,000. Cantab Hall, who stands for \$20,000, the highest

published fee for a trotter (Father Patrick also stands for \$20,000), had a very good sale; it's almost unfair to compare his figures with those of the behemoth with the bulging muscles.

Kadabra sold 11 yearlings from his 11th Ontario crop for an impressive \$82,091 average, up 32 per cent from last year. A pair of fillies topped \$100,000. Nine brought at least \$50,000 while all of them beat \$25,000. There will be no

Muscle Mass freshmen to compete with in the OSS next year, and no Muscle Mass get at all in 2018. The Ontario trotting stallions aren't exactly a murderer's row of talent so Kadabra will have free reign. He stands for \$12,000 (U.S.).

Archangel sells his first Ontario crop next year. The same goes for E L Titan.

Credit Winner sold 38 for a \$59,842 average. He sold the same number here in 2015 for 14 per cent less. A filly out of Pizza Dolce, eligible in New York and Kentucky, brought \$350,000, while the first foal—a filly—out of world champion Check Me Out sold for \$260,000. Four, or 12.5 per cent,

brought at least \$100,000, while 20, or 62.5 per cent, commanded \$50,000 or more. And 94 per cent topped \$25,000. The sire of Devious Man and Fad Finance saw his fee drop from \$14,000 to \$10,000 in 2016.

Chapter Seven sold 24 from his second crop of 71 for an average of \$53,042 — down 13 per cent from last year's sale. A colt and a filly topped \$100,000 and 42 per cent beat \$50,000. Twenty of the 24 exceeded \$25,000. The sire of world champion Walner was second to Credit Winner on the NYSS points list. Chapter Seven stands for \$7,500.

Donato Hanover sold 34 — eight more than last year — at a \$40,029 average. That's about the same as last year. A half-brother to Snow White sold for \$200,000, while a colt and a filly topped \$100,000. Nine, or 35 per cent, exceeded \$50,000 and 15, or 58 per cent, broke \$25,000. Last year, only one topped \$100,000. The same 35 per cent cracked \$50,000 in 2015. The sire of Broadway Donna, CMO, D'One, Shake It Cerry and The Bank isn't exactly knocking them dead in Kentucky. The results weren't any better last year in Harrisburg, where he will sell 42 in November. Forty averaged \$38,744, and there were three in the supplemental offering. Only a third of them exceeded the \$50,000 level. Donato stands for \$15,000.

Conway Hall only sold six — half as many as last year — but his average jumped 45 per cent to \$62,833. One sold for \$120,000; four of them beat \$50,000; and all six topped \$25,000. The sire of Wishing Stone, Habitat and Dayson, who ranked third in the NYSS, will sell 14 in Harrisburg. His fee was cut from \$7,500 to \$5,000 this year.

Andover Hall didn't spark any parades as 14 — four more than 2015 — averaged \$39,143, which was slightly more than last year. One colt brought \$120,000, while 21 per cent beat \$50,000 and half of them failed to top \$25,000. Twenty-nine will sell in Harrisburg where his average for 26 sold dropped 23 per cent to \$31,808 in 2015. His fee was reduced from \$10,000 to \$8,000 in 2016.

Explosive Matter, the sire of Pinkman, Love Letters and Iron Mine Bucky, averaged \$35,067 for 15 sold — up 10 per cent from last year. One topped \$100,000 and three beat \$50,000. Seventeen averaged a disappointing \$17,564 at Harrisburg in 2015. A large offering of 39 will be served up in Harrisburg. He stands for \$7,500.

Muscle Mass, who is back in Ontario, but has two New York crops to peddle, averaged \$31,688 for 16 sold. Last year he only offered one at this sale. A couple topped \$50,000 and 69 per cent broke \$25,000. This is his sixth crop — the first from New York. Muscle Mass, who has been more successful

than his more celebrated brother, is second to Kadabra in the OSS, and while his offspring haven't wandered far from the provincial program, he has been very successful in it.

Twenty-two-year-old **Yankee Glide**, who is moving from Pennsylvania to Kentucky for the 2017 season, averaged \$30,148 for 27 sold in Lexington — down slightly from last year. A brother to Manofmanymissions sold for \$120,000 and 22 per cent broke \$50,000. Only 41 per cent sold for \$25,000 and up. Yankee Glide stood for \$20,000 in 2011, but that fee has gradually dropped over the last several years. It was \$7,500 in 2016 and will revert to "private treaty" status in the Bluegrass State.

Lucky Chucky sells his fourth crop this year. Last year's group was bred in Pennsylvania, but this one is eligible to the NYSS, as well as the Kentucky and Maryland programs in some cases. After seeing his average drop by 43 per cent in 2014 and more than half last year, he came out of his tailspin — relatively speaking — and registered a 44 per cent rise to \$24,917 for a dozen sold. One, a filly out of a sister to Windsong's Soprano, cracked \$50,000, while 42 per cent of them topped \$25,000. Dog Gone Lucky, who showed great promise at two with late season wins in the Valley Victory and Matron, came up empty at three, but NYSS champ Non Stick met with much success. Eighteen will sell in Pennsylvania. Chucky's fee went from \$7,500 to \$6,000 and is now at \$4,000.

Muscle Massive sold 12 for a \$19,500 average—down 13 per cent. Two beat \$25,000. His fee was cut from \$7,500 to \$4,000 in 2016. Twenty-nine will sell in Harrisburg.

Crossover deal between breeds links Deo Volente and Taylor Made

This week, New Jersey-based Deo Volente Farms, a leading standardbred breeding operation, and Kentucky-based Taylor Made Stallions and Taylor Made Sales Agency, an outstanding business in America's thoroughbred world, along with California Chrome's breeder Perry Martin, announced an unprecedented crossover deal in which owners of Trixton and California Chrome will buy shares in their new partner's horses. In doing so, these captains of their industries are establishing a strategic relationship that will encourage growth and new investment in the racehorse industry.

Deo Volente Farms was founded in 2008 by its CEO, Michael J. Gulotta, and a board of investors. Gulotta has been an owner in the harness racing business for over 25 years. In turn, Muscle Hill is a son of the 1998 Hambletonian-winning sire, Muscles Yankee, a stallion responsible for three consecutive Hambletonian winners. Muscles Yankee in turn is the foremost son of the foundation sire, Valley Victory. Trixton's dam is a full-sister to three very successful stallions in the standardbred industry. Trixton retired from racing in 2014 and his innovative dual continent syndication sold out in two days. 
