# Breeders Crown by the unconventional numbers

A different take on the Breeders Crown being held tonight and tomorrow at Hoosier Park.

Trainer Ron Burke and his top driver Yannick Gingras have the potential for a big Breeders Crown weekend.


When breaking down the Breeders Crown, any numerical discussion in the last decade usually deals with how many horses top trainers Ron Burke and Jimmy Takter have in, and how many as favored to win their divisional prizes.

Both trainers had five horses in tonight's six Crown events, but the scratch of Pasithea Face S in the open mare trot reduces Takter's total to four, including a doubling up in the 3FT event (including favorite Ariana G), while Burke has a threesome in the 2FP and a pair in the OMP. In addition to Ariana G, Takter will also be sending out Manchego as the early choice in the 2FT.

On Saturday, Burke now has seven horses in, with the scratch-in of Gural Hanover in the OHT; he has three in total



in that event, including favored Hannelore Hanover as the mare tests the boys. Takter has five, including two in both the 2CT and 3CP; Burke's other four for Saturday are in different events.

So between them, the two top trainers have three favorites, all of them trotting females, although Hannelore Hanover will be taking on the boys. It may be coincidental — or not — that Yannick Gingras is scheduled to handle the three favorites of the two trainers.

In all, Burke has a total of 12 horses in the Crown events, Takter nine.

Of course, those totals refer to Hoosier's weekend racing only in the Crowns. Takter has no other horses entered in any

"outside" Hoosier races, while for Burke it is, as usual, a slightly-different story. Tonight, he has four horses entered on the undercard, for a total of nine on the night, while on Saturday he has nine trotters and pacers in the supporting races, meaning that 16 Burke horses will be in action at HoP Saturday. Total count at Hoosier for Burke this weekend: 25 horses going gateward.

Takter has no other horses racing anywhere in the U.S. tonight and Saturday – by now you're figured out that that won't be the case with Burke. Tonight, his barn will start 17 horses – nine at Hoosier, four at Yonkers, three at Philly, and one at Freehold. Saturday figures to be an even more demanding day for his bookkeeper, as the gray and gold have no fewer than 32 horses entered in the U.S.: half at Hoosier, plus five at Yonkers, five at Pocono, five at The Meadows, and one at Northfield.

#### The drivers

Yannick Gingras and Tim Tetrick have drives in 11 of the 12 Breeders Crown events this weekend. Tetrick did have a mount in all 12, but Pasithea Face S was scratched from the OMT. Gingras will be missing from the OHP.

Next in line is David Miller, with 10 drives booked. What is interesting about Miller is that neither he nor his horses will

see the righthand side of the Crown starting gate all weekend! He has two PP1s, three PP2s, two PP3s, and one trailing PP10 – all on the lefthand side of the gate – and his other horses both start from PP5, right in the middle of the gate! In contrast, Gingras and Tetrick will see the righthand wing of the gate four and five times, respectively. (So you might want to take Miller in the "Trakus least distance covered" pool. But for how much of an "advantage" this may be, see the Post Position stats at the end of this article.)

Gingras is listed behind the most morning line favorites with three – the three trotting misses split between the care of Burke and Takter, as mentioned above. Brian Sears and Scott Zeron both have two morning line choices (Zeron has eight drives overall, Sears six.)

Miller is one of five drivers who also is listed behind a favorite (Rainbow Room) – but he was originally listed behind another chalk, Dealt A Winner in the OHP, but he opted to stay behind the other elim winner he drove, Mach It So, who is the second choice.

The other drivers with favorites are Tetrick, Daniel Dube (5 Crown drives), and the two "AM"s: Andrew McCarthy and Aaron Merriman, each of whom has two Breeders Crown horses.

(but the guy may have 900 wins this year by tonight!)

The participating driver with the greatest statistical chance to go undefeated in his Crown drives is Trond Smedshammer – he has only one drive, Phaetosive, who is 9-5 behind the 6-5 favorite Manchego.

### Track records set in eliminations

The Hoosier track record book received six alternations from Breeders Crown elimination action:

Youaremycandygirl (2FP, 1:51) Mach It So (OGP, 1:48.2, tied) Fourth Dimension (2CT, 1:54) International Moni (3CT, 1:52.4) **What The Hill** (3CT, 1:52.1, 36 minutes after International Moni) **Phaetosive** (2FT, 1:53.3)

The real surprise among this sextet is that only two of them are favored for their Crown championships: Fourth Dimension and International Moni (who wasn't even faster than What The Hill). The matchup favorites for the other three, from top to bottom, are Rainbow Room, Dealt A Winner, and Manchego. Note that David Miller is not driving the favorite in the OHP, but a horse who tied a track record.

It's also interesting to see both two-year-old filly events being categorized as basically head-to-head showdowns: Manchego (6-5) vs. Phaetosive (9-5) in the trot, and Rainbow Room (8-5) vs. Youaremycandygirl (9-5) in the pace.

### Multiple wins in eliminations

Drivers: David Miller six (five on Saturday), Yannick Gingras four (two each day), Tim Tetrick three, Brian Sears and Scott Zeron two.

Trainers: Ron Burke four (three on Saturday), Frank Antonacci and Erv Miller two (each with both on Saturday).

Note: there were eight eliminations last Friday (females), and 14 last Saturday (males).

- 3. **Fear The Dragon**, ranked #1 going into the weekend, did not qualify for the 3CP Championship. But he will race at Saturday at Hoosier, in the "13th Breeders Crown race," the sixth race, the \$60,000 Pegasus Stake.

Going into last weekend, if you were asked in what race the #1-rated horse and the Little Brown Jug winner would be going, the natural answer would be "In their Breeders Crown event, of course." So, with Fear The Dragon and Jug winner Filibuster Hanover (#11 going into last weekend) matched in the Pegasus, it is "the 'Breeders Crown' event that never will be."

### Earnings breakdown

Number of seasonal earners of \$1 million going into this weekend: three.

Number of seasonal earners of \$1 million going into this weekend who will be racing in the Crown events: one — Downbytheseaside (the others are Fear The Dragon and Huntsville).

Number of horses who could join the \$1 million 2017 earnings club with a high finish: 1. (Ariana G). She is currently #5 in seasonal earnings; #4 Devious Man also did not make his Crown championship.

Number of winners of \$500,000 this year racing on tonight's card: four.

Number of horses who could reach \$500,000 in 2017 with a high finish on tonight's card: nine.

Number of winners of \$500,000 this year racing on Saturday's card: nine (includes Downbytheseaside; does not include Fear The Dragon).

### The Breeders Crown should go after the bet

It's time for year-end championships in both harness racing and the runners. Tonight and Saturday, the Breeders Crown is set to sail at Hoosier, and in one week's time the Breeders' Cup begins at Del Mar. For those of us who enjoy watching all types of racing, it's a joyous time to be a fan and bettor of our equine athletes and the humans who work with them.

While a lot of us in the peanut gallery scream for the Crown to be relevant like the Breeders' Cup, unfortunately it's just not realistic. You can bet your bottom dollar the Breeders Crown would love to be more popular, and to do more things to attract attention like the Breeders' Cup does, but it comes down to something it often all comes down to money. The Breeders' Cup has it, the Crown does not.

It's not only the purse money. The Breeders' Cup spends a good deal of its revenue on the brand, and on the event. They believe – and I don't think they're wrong – that without investing any and all profits back into the brand it will fail to grow. This is why they spend millions on TV, print and radio advertising; and why they spend so much on digital.

For the Crown it's not at all like this, but it's not because of a lack of effort.

This season, for example, Hoosier has done amazing work to help bring people out to the track. They're treating the Crown races like their very own Super Bowl by harnessing local TV coverage, using strong event branding and a putting forth a real concerted effort to promote. The Breeders Crown

team, to their credit, is right along with them, burning the midnight oil and what dollars they do have to attract a crowd. They should all be commended.

But it's not enough, and it probably will never be enough.

This is why I think the Breeders' Crown - and its assorted racetrack partners - needs to move into an area I feel they have not explored enough: the bet.

When I opened the program for this weekend's races – just like I do every year – I see great horses, drivers and trainers; and millions in purses. But when it comes to the wagering, I see nothing special. Quite honestly, from a wagering perspective it looks like every other card at every other racetrack across the U.S.. In a lot of cases — because of the formidable heavy chalk in the Crown providing smaller payoffs — it can look even worse to a gambler.

One way to attack this negative branding is to jumpstart the card with seeded pools.

With, say, seven Breeders Crown races, why not throw \$70,000 in carryover money — \$10,000 each race — into the superfecta pools. On the final race of the night, why not seed the Super High Five with carryover money; or alternatively, mandatory pay a jackpot that race.

This one relatively simple policy change can change behavior, and how an event is viewed.

Instead of a fan or bettor seeing a note on their ADW account that there's a big harness racing card tonight and saying to themselves, "maybe I will flip it on and watch a couple," he or she is alerted to a huge carryover card with seeded money each race. That customer's attitude can immediately change from passive interest, to active participant.

This tactic creates a buzz, and since the carryovers are all evening long, it's a reason to watch and wager on every race.

Make no mistake, the Crown will have partners in this venture. ADW's like Twinspires, or Premier Turf Club, or the DRF are all willing to promote the Crown card with more time and urgency, because their players will be playing into pools when they would usually be watching OSU play Penn State. It's a carrot for their customers, and in turn, their businesses.

While some reading might think this is not a terrible idea, carryover money is still hard dollars that could go into a purse, or an on-track event. But as we've explored before, carryover money comes back to the business because it drives new dollars. This money is not lit on fire, it has return on investment.

The Breeders' Cup uses its millions to pay a major network to show the races, for consultants to design apps and websites, and millions more in purses. This is not an option for the Breeders Crown or Hoosier. What is an option is making the Breeders' Crown card not just a card we want to watch, but one we'd have to have our heads examined not to

wager on.

I believe if this (among other things to attract the wagering public) is done correctly, in as little as five years the Breeders Crown handle could double. If that happens, there are more eyeballs driven to the event, there's more buzz, there's more revenue, and yes, the Breeders Crown brand grows.

### Handicapping the Hoosiers Breeders Crown

The state of Indiana plays host this weekend to the Breeders Crown for the first time, and I wonder how many of the connections will be watching the basketball film classic *Hoosiers* in search of some Crown inspiration. Will trainers of the Indiana-sired horses in the Crown be re-enacting Gene Hackman's "I think you'll find these exact same measurements as our gym back in Hickory" in preparation for the big game speech? That's tough to say for sure, but here is analysis for the twelve races for tonight and Saturday night.

#### Friday, October 27

### Race 7 \$250,000 Mares Trot

The first Crown race of 12 over the next two nights features only four horses with the scratch of Pasithea Face S and it should result in a walk in the park for EMOTICON HANOVER. She's been unbeatable since summer and CAPRICE HILL tried to go with her on Jug day but couldn't; the other two mares in here have earned \$39,000 and \$44,000 this year respectively.

### Race 8 \$600,000 2YOFT

MANCHEGO and PHAETOSIVE square off for the third time, and will it be the charm for Phaetosive. In both previous races it has been Manchego with the tactical advantage while the Smedshammer trainee has either been first over or

too far back. I do think Manchego can be had but his main competitor won't offer a big enough price to try. Meanwhile, Manchego is suddenly emerging as a Horse of the Year candidate and a convincing Crown win would help in further making his case.

### Race 9, \$500,000 3YOFP

I think it's safe to say that even with \$376,000 in earnings this year that IDYLLIC BEACH has underachieved, but her last pair have been as good as we've seen her all year. She's peaking at the right time for Takter and is good enough to take this. AGENT Q has been consistent all year and while there's nothing flashy about her, she does what she needs to and is an obvious threat. BLAZIN BRITCHES went a big mile following the break two back but then wasn't strong last out; tough to predict right now. CAVIART ALLY needs to bounce back and NYSS stars TEQUILA MONDAY and OBVIOUS BLUE CHIP have the misfortune of landing the two outside posts.

### Race 10, \$500,000 3YOFT

ICE ATTRACTION proved that her upset over ARIANA G in the Filly Futurity was no fluke as she followed up that race with a solid performance last week in her elimination. Going from the pole to post 10 won't help but she does have speed and will offer a big price; barn has been going well lately. ARIANA G finally lost to this group last out and that minor hiccup aside is the obvious one to beat as always. DREAM BABY DREAM moves all the way inside and hasn't been disgraced while racing against this group; could be in the thick of it a huge price with a little luck. DREAM TOGETHER

broke last out but prior to that slugged it out against Ariana.

#### Race 11, \$600,000 2YOFP

REIGN ON ME had good pace on both ends of her mile last out in her elimination and what's not to like from Norman and Sears from the rail. Well Said filly took a giant step up and showed she can handle it; will be driven with confidence tonight. YOUAREMYCANDYGIRL brushed and crushed last week in a fast elimination time as the 1-9 favorite; good matchup coming with her and #'s 1 and 3. RAINBOW ROOM jogged last week but will get a stern test tonight; daughter of the great Rainbow Blue seeks revenge on #4 from their International Stallion stake two races ago.

#### Race 12, \$250,000 Mares Pace

It's been one thing or another for LADY SHADOW in recent months and I know she hasn't won in awhile, but last week was the best we've seen from her since the summer. She now makes her third start back with Adams and is actually now for sale online; expect her to close out career for current connections with a win. DARLINONTHEBEACH tripped out to a big win last week; is a threat to repeat with a similar trip for a dam that was one of my all-time favorites. NIKE FRANCO has won her last two by open lengths and lands the post edge on all her main rivals; would be deserving for her to cap off her campaign with a crown win. PURE COUNTRY doesn't appear at her best as is the case with many from this barn but she's beaten all of these at times this year.

### Saturday, October 28

### Race 7, \$526,250 Open Trot

MARION MARAUDER had some late trot two back against Twister Bi and then was belated again last week in his elimination. We all know what he's capable of and he can pick them all off including the mare with the right setup; offers a price. HANNELORE HANOVER was soundly beaten two back over this track but never faced an anxious moment last week; big favorite can be beaten. CRAZY WOW picks up David Miller as Yannick goes to Hannelore; his best would give him a fighting chance. MAMBO LINDY could be seen late at a huge price if the pace up front falls apart.

### Race 8, \$600,000 2YOCT

This is a highly competitive group but FOURTH DIMENSION seems to have put forth the best piece of overall work. Sears toyed with his elimination field last week and prior to that was a big win in Lexington; the one to beat. Haughton winner YOU KNOW YOU DO seems to have tailed off a bit lately but it's still YG and Takter and now he lands an inside post; may surprise. CRYSTAL FASHION will be up close from the rail but was no match for the top choice two back. FIFTYDALLARBILL proved last week that he can go with these; Trace Tetrick has a legitimate chance. MET'S HALL will bring his customary early speed.

### Race 9, \$600,000 2YOCP

SHNITZLEDOSOMETHIN impressed last week and the Fred

and Ginger Indiana-bred proved that he can go with the big colts. He has early speed and Wrenn will play his hand early; rates just as good a chance as any. KARPATHIAN KID is a deserving short priced contender from the rail for Dave and Erv Miller as a convincing elimination winner last week; the rail is a big plus. STAY HUNGRY is out of the great My Little Dragon and he was another elimination winner with a solid late burst; a case can be made here as well as with LOST IN TIME. CLOSING STATEMENT made a big middle move last week and that could tighten him for the final; all of the sudden THIS IS THE PLAN will offer a big price from post 10.

### Race 10, \$527,500 3YOCT

WHAT THE HILL returned to racing where he likes it best and took them all the way in his elimination on the front end. He can be hit or miss but I like him best in here. I doubt he'll win any year-end honors, but you have to admit that a Crown win, a Canadian Trotting Classic win and a first past the wire Hambletonian is a nice resume. INTERNATIONAL MONI stormed by everyone last week to win impressively and when he's good, he has a dangerous late move. Only needs to maintain that form to sweep by them all once again. LINDY THE GREAT bottomed out a weak elimination field; I'd be surprised if he got there now.

#### Race 11, \$527,500 3YOCP

How about DOWNBYTHESEASIDE last week? Just when you think he's tailing off he pulls a down the road mile from the outside. Sears obviously knew he was good that night and with his arch rivals being vanquished last week in the other elimination it's clearly his to win or lose tonight. BOOGIE SHUFFLE did all he could last out from second but was no match for the winner; hasn't yet broken through against these types but it always close. PHOTOBOMBR HANOVER is in deceptively good form right now for Fanning and I wouldn't be quick to dismiss despite longshot status; was overloaded last out.

### Race 12, \$421,000 Open Pace

MCWICKED sat off the duel between MACH IT SO and SINTRA last week and flew late in :25.4 to just miss. He was motoring just as well two back in the Allerage and there's no question that Coleman has him going well right now; rates a big chance at a fair price. MACH IT SO was as stellar last out and that's not the first time this year he's come up with a big mile on the front end; Dave Miller opting to him for the final is a huge vote of confidence. DEALT A WINNER loses Miller but gives Aaron Merriman the chance to notch his first ever Breeders Crown win; impossible to fault his form right now for Harder. KEYSTONE VELOCITY is coming back around; Erv Miller down again as trainer.

### Manchego aims for historic Breeders Crown victory

Manchego will put her perfect record on the line in tonight's \$600,000 Breeders Crown for 2-year-old female trotters at Hoosier Park and a victory there would be historic. None of the previous 33 winners of the event for 2-year-old female trotters has been undefeated.

The Jimmy Takter-trained Manchego has won all 11 of her races this season, including a 2-1/2 length victory over Lily Stride in 1:54.1 in her elimination last week. She has earned \$573,948 and is the No. 2-ranked horse in North America behind only 3-year-old stablemate Ariana G.

"It will take a heck of a horse to go by this filly," Takter said in the winner's circle after the race.

"She is a fantastic horse. She is a little bit of a repeat from Ariana from last year. She is the same type of horse. She knows what she's supposed to do. She's very professional."

Ariana G won last year's Breeders Crown for 2-year-old filly trotters for Takter. The Hall of Fame trainer, who owns a record 30 Breeders Crown trophies, has won this race four of the last five years.

Manchego, with driver Yannick Gingras, is the 6-5 morning-line favorite in this year's event, but 9-5 second choice Phaetosive also has attracted attention.

Phaetosive, trained and driven by Trond Smedshammer, has won four of six races and finished second twice to Manchego. She won her Breeders Crown elimination by three lengths over Seviyorum in a track-record 1:53.3.

"When you come across a top talent like this,"
Smedshammer said, "you just got to watch after them and take care of them."

Ariana G is the 3-5 morning-line favorite in the \$500,000 Breeders Crown for 3-year-old female trotters despite

starting from post eight in the 10-horse field. Post eight has an 8.6 win percentage, which is better than only posts nine and 10 at Hoosier.

The connections of Ariana G, who has won 11 of 14 races this year, accepted a bye to the Breeders Crown final. Only one of Ariana G's losses this season has come against female competition; a neck setback to Ice Attraction in the Kentucky Filly Futurity on Oct. 8 at Red Mile.

Last week's sole Breeders Crown elimination was won by Overdraft Volo and driver Andy Miller by a head over fast-closing Ice Attraction. Overdraft Volo is 4-1 on the morning line and will start from post five. Ice Attraction, who will start from post 10, is 5-1.

"It was really awesome," Overdraft Volo's trainer Julie Miller said. "It was a picture-perfect drive by Andy. He got a two-hole trip and even though he might have had to go a little sooner than he liked, when he asked her to go, he pointed her forward and she went. And to hold off Ice Attraction, who also got a good trip, I was pleased with that too.

"I think we're fresh coming in. I think we made a good decision to bypass the Kentucky Futurity for the girls. I think she's been a model of consistency this season. I'm really proud of her."

In the \$600,000 Breeders Crown for 2-year-old female pacers, Youaremycandygirl brings a four-race win streak to the event. Youaremycandygirl, driven by Gingras for trainer Ron Burke, has won six of eight races and is 9-5 on the morning line. She is the second choice, though, to Joe Holloway's 8-5 Rainbow Room, who has won seven of 10 and never been worse than second.

Each filly won her elimination last week, Rainbow Room by 2-1/2 lengths over Firestorm in 1:52.3 and Youaremycandygirl by one length over Reign On Me in a track-record 1:51.

"She was just great," Burke said. "She's my best shot (to get a win) for the whole weekend. She was a little bit hot (in her elimination) but I think it's just new surroundings and everything. She seems to be a very smart filly and adapts well so I think she will come back next week and be a lot better.

"She's just a very good horse. She had one bad start at Yonkers, where she got caught in a bad spot and put in a couple steps and I think lost her confidence, but other than that she's been pretty damn good. After she qualified this year (in June), me and Yannick both said she was our best filly."

All of the Breeders Crown championships for female pacers and trotters are tonight. Racing begins at 6 p.m. (EDT) at Hoosier Park and the Breeders Crown events are races seven through 12.

### Wrenn makes return to Crown

The two-time Crown winner leads a parade of local Indiana drivers in Crown events this weekend.

This weekend, Peter Wrenn returns to the Breeders Crown finals for the first time in 21 years. He hopes to create a few more memories in the event, which is tonight and Saturday nights at Wrenn's home track, Hoosier Park Racing & Casino.

Wrenn has won two Breeders Crown trophies in his career, the second of which came in 1996 when he guided Personal Banner to victory by a head over Moni Maker in the 3-year-old filly trot at Vernon Downs. It was Moni Maker's only loss in 20 races that year.

He got his first Crown with Yankee Cashmere in 1994 at Woodbine Racetrack.

"It's always a good thing," Wrenn said about driving in the Breeders Crown. "It's been a while since I've been on that circuit. Being back part of it is kind of a cool thing.

"And Hoosier is really taking this to a different level. They're trying their best to make it a showcase. So far, I think they have. I don't know what the weather is going to be, we can't control that, but they're trying to control everything else. They're trying to make it an A-1 show."

Wrenn, a native of Detroit, won multiple driving titles on the Michigan circuit and was a top driver at Pompano Park before heading to the East Coast and enjoying success at the Meadowlands. He returned to the Midwest in 1999.

His 9,913 career wins are 13th in North American harness racing history.

Wrenn has three drives in this year's Breeders Crown finals. He gets started Friday with 20-1 longshot Inverse Hanover in the 3-year-old filly pace. Inverse Hanover finished sixth in her elimination, but was beaten by only two lengths.

"If I was able to have racing luck through the stretch I think she would have won the race," Wrenn said. "It didn't work out to our favor. She's not going to be able to do the work on her own, but if things work out and she's the same as last week, you never know. She could be a bomber come through.

"It's going to be a cold night and there is going to be a lot of speed and horses are going to be tired. As far as an upsetter, she's definitely a player. She was really good."

His remaining two Breeders Crown drives are Saturday with 2-year-old male trotter Skyway Torpedo, who finished fourth in his elimination and is 20-1, and 2-year-old male pacer Shnitzledosomethin, who missed by a nose in his elimination and is 8-1.

"(Skyway Torpedo) is a pleasant colt," Wrenn said. "He drives like an old horse. He's very professional about his work. He got sick around mid-summer and (trainer Alvin Miller) did a good job getting him on track. It's quite rewarding for him to get to the final. That's always a fun thing.

"(Shnitzledosomethin) raced very respectably. He's a big strong colt and actually got better as the year wore on. He doesn't know a day's work end as far as that goes. He seems to have easy speed. That was the fastest elimination. I was impressed with him. It took a good trip to beat me. He put away a lot of nice horses."

Wrenn ranks eighth in wins this year at Hoosier Park. Each of the track's top three drivers — Trace

Tetrick, Sam Widger and John DeLong — and fifth-place Ricky Macomber Jr. will be in the Breeders Crown.

Tetrick won a Breeders Crown in 2015, with 3-year-old male pacer Freaky Feet Pete, while the others are making their Crown debuts.

"It's a real thrill," said Widger, who has won 5,891 races in his career. "It's a huge event. Just to be able to participate is exciting. For Hoosier Park to host it and to be able to meet new people, people I've only read about and now get to meet in person, is great."

Three of the track's top four trainers — Jamie Macomber, Jeff Cullipher and Walter Haynes Jr. — as well as Trent Stohler and Alvin Miller, who are in the top 13, have horses racing in the Breeders Crown finals.

Stohler won a Breeders Crown in 1997 with pacing mare Extreme Velocity. The others are making their debuts.

"This is something new for me, (driver) John DeLong, and my owner (Tom Pollack)," said Cullipher, who sends out Rock N' Roll World in the Open Pace. "I've been in racing all my life and this is very exciting.

"I'm glad to be on our home turf. I think it has an advantage, especially here with the long stretch."

All of the Breeders Crown championships for female pacers and trotters are tonight. Racing begins at 6 p.m. (EDT) at Hoosier Park and the Breeders Crown events are races seven through 12.

### Hannelore Hanover seeks large payday in Crown open trot

The mare is taking on the boys Saturday for one simple reason.

There could be numerous theories and reasons as to why Ron Burke is racing trotting mare Hannelore Hanover against the boys in \$526,250 Breeders Crown open trot final at Hoosier Park.

But the answer is simple and logical.

The trainer pointed out that one reason overrides all the rest. Sounding like the Jerry Maguire of harness racing, Burke is thinking in terms of "Show me the money" when he notes the open trot purse is twice the size of the mare trot, which

Hannelore Hanover won last year.

"For me, it's very simple," Burke said. "They go for 500, the other one goes for 250. I'm gonna take a chance going for 500."

It looks like sound thinking so far, as Hannelore Hanover won her elimination race last Saturday in 1:52.4. The daughter of Swan For All and High Sobriety stormed quickly from the gate and led throughout as Yannick Gingras brought her home in a final panel of :27.

She drew the fourth pole position in the final.

"We were very happy," Burke said after the elimination race. "She did what she was supposed to. She got an easy half and she finished off strong with her ear plugs in."

It was an upgrade from the previous week, when

Hannelore Hanover finished second behind Churita in the \$70,000 Indiana Sires Stakes for older trotting mares.

"Last week we were a little bit worried," Burke said. "To take nothing away from Churita she wasn't even a good second, she kind of gave it up a little bit. That's not like her."

Nothing some new-old shoes couldn't cure.

"We went back to the drawing board again," Burke said after the elim. "Last week I tried a different shoe on her for the first time in her life. Really, I think that was it, I don't think she liked the shoe. I put her old shoes back on and she was better today."

Hannelore Hanover is not just the only mare in the final, she is the only horse to break 1:50 as her best time this season was a world record 1:49.2. She has hit the board in 13 of 15 races this season with eight wins and five places and her \$689,754 in earnings is the second highest total in the field. The horse could be in line for some post-season honors, but that is the least of Burke's worries.

"Obviously you love the awards at the end of the year, but for me she doesn't need to get any award to prove anything," Burke said. "She's the best trotting mare right now. That's a tough call because Emoticon Hanover and Pasithea Face; these are good horses. I have all the confidence in her and I'm going to give her the chance to be the best."

Hannelore Hanover is trying to become the third mare to win the open trot and first since Moni Maker in 1998. CR Kay Suzie turned the trick in 1996.

Burke also trains Crazy Wow, who went wire-to-wire in the second elimination with Gingras bringing him around in 1:53 to pull off the sweep. The son of Crazed and No Pan No Gain will leave from the second post and try to improve on a season in which 15 starts have produced five firsts, four seconds, two thirds and \$551,306 in earnings.

"I'm very happy," Burke said. "He's had a few bad bumps, but he's won a lot of major races. I think, right now, he's right there for aged (male) Trotter of the Year."

Adding big-time name recognition to the final is Marion Marauder, the 2016 Triple Crown Winner who came from the back to finish second, 1-3/4 lengths behind Crazy Wow in the eliminations. He drew the five hole this Saturday.

"We knew it was going to be one of those races with a short field, where it's hard to get positioned and we were going to have to take what we get," trainer Mike Keeling said. "(Driver) Scott (Zeron) said he was vicious down near the wire, so we're very pleased with him."

Marion Marauder is having another big year as a

4-year-old. He leads all finalists with \$712,347 in purse money, having won three of nine starts along with three seconds and a third.

"Marauder raced exceptionally well at Yonkers (in finishing second in the \$1 million International Trot) and followed that up with another great effort in the elims, coming from last," Zeron said. "He has a nice post position Saturday and I look forward to facing other strong competitors."

Another horse also overcame a slow start in the second elimination, as Resolve used a late burst up the rail to take fifth and sneak into the final. He has four wins in 12 season's starts and earnings of \$486,399.

"He was good again," said trainer Ake Svanstedt, who will drive Resolve from the rail on Saturday. "I went to the inside with him and I thought (Lookslikeachpndale) was going to take the passing lane, so I went outside, but then he went outside also. Then I went back over to start over. But he came home fast.

"I'm happy with him. He raced with shoes and it was his best race with shoes. He had the power today. If he is normal, he is very strong and I can go with him earlier. He can go on the outside and is very strong."



### Sophomore trotting colt elim winners set for battle

International Moni, Lindy The Great and What The Hill set for Saturday's Crown showdown.

After watching their 3-year-old male trotters win two of the three \$25,000 Breeders Crown eliminations last weekend, trainers Frank M. Antonacci and Domenico Cecere will look to continue their success in Saturday's \$527,500 final at Hoosier Park.

In the first elimination, Scott Zeron drove International Moni to victory by 2-1/4 lengths in a track record of 1:52.4 (which would be broken later in the night). Antonacci and Cecere train for the Moni Maker Stable, which bred and owns the colt. The group is comprised of members of the Antonacci family and David Reid.

Lindy The Great won the second elimination by 4-1/4 lengths in 1:53 for the Antonaccis' K R Breeding and Robert Rudolph. Tim Tetrick drives the homebred Lindy The Great.

A son of the French stallion Love You and former Horse of the Year Moni Maker, International Moni brings eight wins in 13 season's starts into the final, and has earned \$385,555. Cecere feels the only thing to beat him has been misfortune.

"Moni is money," Cecere said. "He's shown all year, I think, that he is the best 3-year-old. He's had very, very bad luck. Bad luck in the Hambletonian and bad luck in Lexington. In the Futurity, he got the one hole and it was all water and he put in a bad step and we lost him. But he came out of the race great and we decided to supplement him because he deserved to be in the big one."

International Moni, who drew the four post for the final, had to come from behind in his elimination. After three different horses took turns up front, Sears went on the outside to overtake the leaders and pull away.

"He did it the hard way," Cecere said. "He came first over, and (Friday) I was watching the races and it looked like it was hard to come first over. But it looks like he loved first over. He raced great."

As did Lindy The Great, who ripped off fractions of :27.3, :56

Geoff said Daniel is mostly non-verbal, but "has expressive language to ask for things he wants or repeats what we ask him. I hope for Team Lindy, who has been supportive of us all these years, that perhaps my guy is paying them back with his special vibes!"

and 1:23.3 to lead wire-to-wire. According to Cecere, the horse lived up to the last part of his name.

"He was great," the trainer said. "He raced great, too, in Lexington. He's been strong. He trained great, he warmed up great. Last year on this track he struggled a little bit in the last turn, but this time he raced with more confidence. His gait was more fluid."

In nine starts this year, Lindy The Great has three wins, a place and a show for \$168,683 in earnings. He drew the five hole for the final.

"I'm very happy with him," Cecere said. "He wasn't a hundred per cent this year up in Canada and we made some changes and got him right. We always knew he was a great horse."

Speaking of greatness, What The Hill enters the final as the field's top 2017 money winner with \$495,026. The son of Muscle Hill-K T Cha Cha made sure International Moni's track record did not last long, as he set a new standard of 1:52.1.

Trained by Ron Burke and driven by David Miller, What The Hill took the lead at the :28 quarter in his elimination and stayed there for the rest of the race. He drew the third post in the final, and enters with seven wins, a second and two thirds in 14 season's starts.

"I was thrilled with his effort and I'm thrilled with our post position," Burke said.

Another horse to watch is Guardian Angel As, who took third in his elimination behind What The Hill and Yes Mickey.

"I think he raced good," trainer Anette Lorentzon said. "He made a break at Yonkers (in his previous start) so it's been almost three weeks since he had a real race. He was locked on a line and (Tim Tetrick) couldn't really race him (in the elimination), so we've got a few things to work on this week. He's not really a half-mile horse; he likes the bigger tracks better. This was the toughest division."

In 18 starts this year, Guardian Angel As has won eight times, to go along with three seconds and a third, good for \$235,543 in earnings. Lorentzon feels those numbers could have been better without some bad fortune.

"He's been very unlucky," she said. "He had terrible luck in the Hambletonian and in the Yonkers Trot I thought we had a good chance of winning it if we just made it around the track, and unfortunately we didn't. I'm just keeping my fingers crossed that we can get him better (for the final)."

With Tetrick driving Lindy The Great, Yannick Gingras will be in the sulky for the final, where his horse has post 7.
