The biggest story of Friday's all-female Breeders Crown card at Hoosier Park was the two men in green and white – driver Yannick Gingras and trainer Jimmy Takter.

They combined twice in victory, with super trotting fillies Manchego (2YO) and Ariana G (3YO). And then both won with another partner – both of those wins behind a pacer:

Gingras with the Ron Burke-trained two-year-old Youaremycandygirl.

Takter with the Mark MacDonald-driven older pacing mare Pure Country, who became a two-time Breeders Crown champion (previously 2015); Ariana G has also now won two Crowns.

Takter's Crown Championship wins were #31, #32, and #33 in his Hall of Fame career; his total is now more than double of the trainer nearest him, Bob McIntosh, who has 16 to his credit.

The Takter barn went 6 3-0-2 on the night, with earnings of \$765,000.

The Gingras family accountant will undoubtedly be pleased with Yannick's Friday night visit to Indiana. He added a second and two thirds to the three Crown triumphs, making him a millionaire in one night – \$1,002,500, for 11 minutes and 21 seconds of racing.

And just like that, Gingras took over the lead in the seasonal drivers money chase, putting him just over \$11 million. No disrespect at all meant to Jason Bartlett, who is having a terrific season at Yonkers, and has led just about the entire season to date. In fact, it took a million-dollar night for Gingras to pass Bartlett and his \$10.4M.

Gingras' three Crown victories boosted the lifetime total of the 38-year-old to 19, now putting him in sixth. The five men ahead of him, John Campbell (48), Ron Pierce (30), Mike Lachance and Brian Sears (tied at 27), and David Miller (22), range in age from 11 to 29 years older than him. (Gingras passed Tim Tetrick, who has 18 at age 36.)

Other big numbers

The next most important set of numbers on the night were "39" and "+2." They are, respectively, the temperature (Fahrenheit) listed on the official charts, and the official track variant, changed just before the Breeders Crown races from "+1" on the night of steady rain.

These conditions all be precluded any kind of onslaught on the track records we saw last week (six within the Crown elimination races), but all of the three trots broke 1:55, even though there was a huge favorite in each of the races who might discourage waves of horses coming at them.

The "off track" early on suggested that it might be a tough night for the favorites, as all of the first five winners paid \$10.80 and \$21.60, until in the final undercard event before

the Crowns, nationally-recognized Bettors Up defeated a lower-level group as a 3-5 favorite.

Then along came the Crowns and four favorites won, all at 1-2 or less (Emoticon Hanover, Manchego, Ariana G, and Youaremycandygirl). Blazin Britches, even-money in her elim last week, bounced back to form to take her 3FP event, paying \$12.20, and then, of all horses, 2015 Crown champion Pure Country charged down the center of the track to return \$31.00 to win. (Just say that to yourself once – “Pure Country paid \$31.00 to win!?”)

The Crowns must have rejuvenated the “favorite juices,” as both Hoosier undercard events held after the Crowns went to chalk, running the favorite tally late to seven wins in 14 races, after starting 0-for-5.

Takter’s “friendly rival” at the top of the training ranks, Ron Burke, had a 1-2 finish in the 2FP with Youaremycandygirl and Majorsspecialady, picking up \$450,000, and added a fifth-place Crown check of \$12,500 and undercard action of two seconds and a third in five starts, totaling \$494,740 on the night. (And tonight he has Hannelore Hanover and six other Crown starters).

Hoosier’s leading driver, Trace Tetrack, had a driving double, one in the Breeders Crown competition behind Blazin Britches, and an undercard victory. For Tetrack, the victory was his third in Breeders Crown competition and second for trainer Brian Brown, as they teamed in 2015 to win the OMP with Color’s A Virgin. Tetrack’s other victory was with Freaky Feet Pete in the three-year-old colt pace at Woodbine in ‘15.

Blazin Britches’ victory also puts trainer Brown halfway toward a “sweep” of the Crown sophomore paces, and with the colts on Saturday he has the favorite – with what some have referred to as his “second-string good 3YO,” Downbytheseaside (hey, if I can make \$1 million one year, you can call me whatever you want!).

That “other” 3YO referred to above, Fear The Dragon, off the disappointment of not qualifying for his Breeders Crown event, will look to bounce back in Hoosier’s sixth race tomorrow, a \$60,000 stake, where he will take on Jug winner Filibuster Hanover – who is listed as the 5-2 morning line favorite from the trailing post ten in the 11-horse field (but after all, Filibuster does have Gingras, coming off that million-dollar night). Fear The Dragon is the 3-1 second choice from post seven.

Hoosier’s second-leading driver, Sam Widger, also had a driving double during the undercard, as did Ron Wrenn Jr.

The mention of Ron Wrenn gives us a chance to introduce a fiendishly-tricky trivia question: Name the five former North American dash-winning leaders, for a given year, who are at Hoosier Park this weekend. (Answer at the end.)

We have mentioned Gingras times three, Trace Tetrack, and Mark MacDonald as winning Breeders Crown drivers on Friday. To complete the group, Dan Dube was the driver of the winner of the OMT, Emoticon Hanover. Emoticon went over \$1 million in her career with the victory.

She also earned the highest portion of a purse tonight – 55 per cent. There were only four entrants in the race, and under the rules the fifth-place money is redirected to the winner, so she took home \$137,500 of the \$250,000 purse.

Emoticon Hanover's sire Kadabra is also the sire of second-place finisher Caprice Hill, so his offspring got 80 per cent of the purse, or \$200,000.

Three homebred horses won their Crown event: Blazin Britches (Emerald Highlands Farm), Ariana G (Katz/Libfeld), and Pure Country (the breeding/racing divisions of Diamond Creek).

Manchego was bred by Brittany Farms, giving them their 22nd Crown breeding credit, one behind the leader, Hanover Shoe Farms.

In a bit of an anomaly, the only double siring winner was trotter Muscle Hill – but his offspring compete for the prizes of two different states: Manchego (PA) and Ariana G (NJ)!

The forecast for Indianapolis on Saturday: mostly cloudy and 44. But that's an improvement over what was raced through on Friday.

Blais says Emoticon Hanover deserved her Crowning moment

The daughter of Kadabra cruised to a 1:53.4 victory over a four-horse field on the sloppy Hoosier Park oval for trainer Luc Blais, driver Daniel Dube and owner Serge Godin.

Emoticon Hanover set the tone for the 34th Breeders Crown with an effortless gate-to-wire victory in the \$250,000 Mare Trot Friday at Hoosier Park, putting the icing on a stellar four-year-old campaign.

"I think she deserved that, she had a good season," said trainer Luc Blais, a Quebec native now based in Ontario. "She deserves that and Determination, Mr. (Serge) Godin, deserves that, too.

"The way she raced for the last month, that's the cherry on the cake, you know."

Emoticon Hanover cruised over the rain-soaked seven-eighths mile oval in 1:53.4, ringing up fractions of :27,

:55.3 and 1:25 on her way to the three-quarter length victory. Emoticon Hanover's long-time Ontario Sires Stakes rival Caprice Hill (Kadabra—Bramasole) finished second, Pink Pistol (Cantab Hall—August Revenue) was third and Flowers N Songs (Deweycheatumnhowe—Pleasures Song) completed the abbreviated field of trotting mares. Swedish mare Pasithea Face S was scratched early in the week due to

"She was grabby to the half but I got her to relax the third quarter," driver Daniel Dube said of Emoticon Hanover. "She was on idle all the way to the wire and won easy. I never really had to ask her, she did it all on her own, she was just as solid as could be despite the slop."

The win was the fourth straight for Dube and the daughter of Kadabra and Emmylou Who, a streak that started with a

world record 1:50.2 performance at Tioga Downs on Aug. 27 and continued through the Miss Versatility Final at Delaware on Sept. 21 and the Allera Farms at The Red Mile on Oct. 8. In 12 starts this season, the mare has recorded five wins, three seconds, three thirds and banked \$373,166 for Montreal, QC resident Serge Godin's Determination stable.

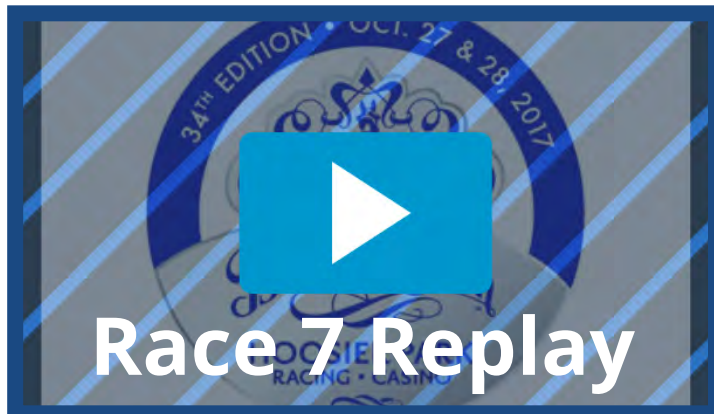
A \$165,000 purchase by Godin at the 2014 Harrisburg Yearling Sale, Emoticon Hanover was bred by Linda Wellwood of St. George, ON, Tammy Aspden of Caistor Centre, ON, Anne Shunock of Dorchester, ON and Diane Ingham of Mount Pleasant, ON. The trotter has been a star for most of her racing career. She has only missed a check on three occasions through 37 lifetime starts. At two she was a two-time Gold Series winner in the Ontario Sires Stakes (OSS) program and captured a Champlain Stakes division, banking \$219,258 in 10 starts. She finished fifth, behind All The Time, in the 2015 freshman trotting filly Breeders Crown. At three Emoticon Hanover dominated the OSS Gold Series, winning three legs and the year-end Super Final, and also captured her Casual Breeze and Simcoe divisions before finishing her \$604,168 season with a second to Broadway Donna in the Breeders Crown final.

"I always liked her," said Blais of his four-year journey with the mare, whose Breeders Crown victory put her over the \$1 million mark in earnings. "She's a competitive horse, she's a professional. She never made a bad race, always 200 per cent she gives. It's a joy to be around a horse like that."

Provided she remains happy and healthy, Emoticon Hanover will continue to compete through the Nov. 25 TVG Stake at The Meadowlands and Blais says current plans will see her back on the racetrack as a five-year-old.

"You know, we'll go race by race and see, but right now that's the plan," said the trainer.

That will be good news to Hambletonian Society president and CEO John Campbell, who noted that gathering 10 aged trotting mares to battle in the year-end Breeders Crown has



always been a challenge.

“Historically the trotting mares have always been light as far as entries. There was a period of time when we didn’t even carry a mare trot for the Breeders Crown. So it’s something that we have to deal with,” said Campbell, in his first Breeders Crown winner’s circle as an administrator rather than a victorious driver. “It’s very difficult with these trotting mares when these foals sell for so much money. Out of a trotting mare with any kind of breeding at all they are bringing upwards of \$100,000 regularly.”

In spite of the abbreviated field for the opener, Campbell

was pleased with the way Emoticon Hanover kicked off the Breeders Crown’s 34th edition.

“She’s a top, top mare,” said Campbell, adding that the remainder of the program – both Friday and Saturday – would see full fields of 10 battle for the other 11 Breeders Crown trophies. “I look at 10 horses in 11 races and I’m tickled about that.”

Manchego starts big night for Gingras, Takter

The Brittany Farms-bred daughter of Muscle Hill is the first undefeated freshman filly trotting Breeders Crown champion.

In early October, Hall of Fame trainer Jimmy Takter announced in HRU that he would walk away from the sport at the end of 2018 ([full story here](#)).

Interestingly, that time frame would coincide with the completion of Manchego’s sophomore season. Takter said he would be eagerly looking forward to Manchego’s future after she took the \$600,000 Breeders Crown Final for two-year-filly trotters Friday at Hoosier Park to push her career mark to a perfect 12-for-12.

When the gate wings opened, a trio of trotters left quickly with S M S Princess (Ake Svanstedt), Manchego and Phaetosive (Trond Smedshammer) going three wide into the first turn. Manchego and Yannick Gingras cleared past the quarter in :27.2, parking Phaetosive and forcing S M S Princess into the two-hole.

Phaetosive continued to pressure Manchego down the backstretch and passed the eventual winner just before the half-mile station in :55.4. Smedshammer backed down the fractions and jammed up the field as they passed the three-quarter pole in 1:26 2/5.

Gingras eased Manchego off the rail and sprinted right past Phaetosive in the stretch and cruised to a 4 1/4 length win over a fast closing Seviyorum (Andy Miller), who rallied from the outside post number 9. Phaetosive held on for third

and Atlanta (Rick Zeron) rounded out the top four.

The winning time of 1:54.4 was over a sloppy track that was pelted with afternoon and early evening rain.

The Muscle Hill–Secret Hill filly is owned by Barry Guariglia’s Black Horse Farm, John D. Fielding and Herb Liverman.

Manchego was bred by Brittany Farms, who inched closer to the ‘all-time breeders’ lead with 22 Breeders Crown trophies, one behind Hanover Shoe Farms.

Purchased as Whispering Hills at the Lexington Select Sale for \$120,000, the renamed Manchego has now earned \$873,948 on the season.

“The race kind of unfolded the way I thought. I figured Trond would leave with a trailer in there. Yannick did a great

job. He kind of left, let him go, sat at his back. She was loaded as usual," said Guariglia. "She just has an attitude that is unparalleled. She just wants to do it...she always brings it."

With the victory, Gingras hoisted the Breeders Crown trophy for the 17th time (he added two more trophies later on the Friday card for 19 titles).

Takter has dominated the two-year-old filly trot division, taking four out of the last five events.

"It's so nice to have a filly go undefeated. I haven't done it since See You At Peelers (two-year-old pacing filly who went 13-for-13 in 2010)," said Takter. "These horses today are so fantastic. You teach them once and they remember."

Where does Manchego rank among Takter's record 33 career BC wins?

"That is one thing that I don't want to do. I don't want to rate horses. You know, It is not fair to the other champions we had, but you know she is unique. What she had done all year. Twelve straight wins is tough to do in today's market," said Takter. "I am so proud to be a part of her."

Does Manchego know she's a great one?

"She is really, really bitchy. She wants her way and is tough to work with," Takter said. "She has stuck the groom three or four times. She can be a handful, even though she's not very big. But she's a pro on the track and has not made a mistake

yet."

With divisional honors guaranteed, Manchego will likely be considered for Horse of the Year with fellow Takter trainee, Ariana G, who overcame a tough trip to win her Crown division by open lengths.

"You know, (Manchego) is definitely two-year-old trotting filly of the year and I think she's a big candidate," said Takter. "It's all coming down to Breeders Crown. She has as much reason to be there. She couldn't have done any more than she has."

Manchego will not get another chance to impress the voters this season as she will be shut down to prepare for her three-year-old season.

"That's it," Takter said. "We're not going to race her anymore. I want to have a horse that can step into her three-year-old shoes and she's not a very big filly. She's a good keeper and she takes care of herself, so she could have raced another start, but why should we?"

Blazin Britches rebounds with a vengeance

Trainer Brian Brown breathes a sigh of relief after a challenging week.

After recording 10 wins in her first 11 starts of the year, Blazin Britches appeared to be heading in the wrong direction in the lead up to her start in the \$500,000 Breeders Crown 3-year-old filly pace on Friday night at Hoosier Park.

Blazin Britches broke stride before the start of the \$234,000 Glen Garnsey Memorial on Oct. 8 at Red Mile, and last week she faded to seventh after making an early move in the Breeders Crown elimination. She rebounded in a big way when it counted, as she recorded a half-length win over Caviart Ally in the Crown final.

Blazin Britches broke well and settled along the inside in the early going, while Agent Q and Idyllic Beach went out for the lead. Driver Trace Tetrick, a Hoosier Park regular, made a first-over move along the backstretch to get Blazin Britches to the front, and she held off all challengers in the stretch, crossing the wire in 1:52.1. Caviart Ally loomed at the top of the stretch, but couldn't get by the game Blazin Britches. After being forwardly placed early, Idyllic Beach came on late for third, while the favorite, Agent Q, was fourth.

"I wanted to sit close, maybe move back to the front, and get a good trip," Tetrick said. "I thought it was the right move to make and it worked out in the end."

Tetrick, who's been Blazin Britches' driver for 13 of her 15 starts this year, recorded his third career Breeders Crown victory.

"To win at your home track, it's unbelievable," he said. "It's a great opportunity that they've given me and I'm just glad that we've all come together as a team and we've succeeded."

Trainer Brian Brown said he was breathing a big sigh of relief after seeing Blazin Britches rebound in the Breeders Crown. Following her break in the Glen Garnsey Memorial, Blazin Britches made up a significant amount of ground on her rivals in the late going to finish fourth, but Brown believed that the daughter of Rock N Roll Heaven may have come out of that effort a little worse for wear.

"I'm not sure that mile in Lexington didn't hurt her a little," he said. "My cousin timed her own mile in :49-and-a piece in Lexington. On that track, I think it bored her up a little. Her feet were bugging her. She's always had some stifle problems. We worked on it all week."

Brown said the work that groom Tim Carruthers, blacksmith Eric Thomas, and veterinarian Dr. John Riker did this week in advance of the race led to Blazin Britches' form reversal.

"She was no good last week," Brown said. "Last week, she was just sore and a little too hot. Trace had to move her before the quarter and her head was way up in the air. It was not a good day, but I could tell after all the work that my people did this week, I was finally happy with her. She was relaxed, better-gaited and today, warming up, I was thrilled with her."

A key equipment change also played a big part in the victory, Brown said. With the rainy conditions and sloppy

track, Brown opted for an aluminum shoe in the Breeders Crown after Blazin Britches ran in a flip flop last week.

"When the track is muddy, you generally don't race in a flip flop," he said. "So maybe it was to my best that it rained because maybe I wouldn't have changed them, but I could tell warming up that she was travelling better in the aluminum shoes."

It was the second Breeders Crown win for owner/breeder Emerald Highlands Farm, who won their first Crown race with Colors a Virgin – and Tetrick – in the Crown Mare Pace at Woodbine in 2015.

"We were glad to see the real Britches show up tonight," said Bruce Trogon, owner of Emerald Highlands Farm. "I think she's the fastest filly of all time. I know that's a crazy thought. She's got issues and everything, but whoa, the horse

has unbelievable ability. I was happy to see it tonight."

Following her win, Brown said Blazin Britches could return to action next weekend right back at Hoosier Park in the \$115,000 USS Indianapolis Memorial Stakes.

"She could race here next week," he said. "We'll see how things go. If she doesn't race again this year, I'm okay with that. I think she stamped herself as the best filly tonight in the crop. She doesn't have to race again this year. If she's okay and comes out of this, we'll race again."

Trogon said it was also possible that Blazin Britches could be bred to another Emerald Highlands Farm homebred, Fear The Dragon, who will race in Saturday's \$60,000 Pegasus at Hoosier Park.

"Brian doesn't want me to quit with her, but we might have to embryo transplant her to Fear The Dragon," he said. "I'd hate to have Dragon not get that opportunity."

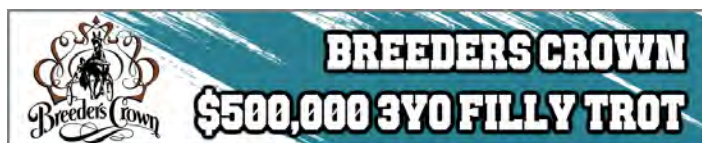

Tenacious, tough-as-nails and triumphant

Arian G posted back-to-back Breeders Crown scores to the delight of her owners and breeders Marvin Katz and Al Libfeld.

The connections of trotting megastar Arian G have the enviable ability to choose from an expansive and impressive list of top-shelf triumphs, both on and off the racetrack, and deem any of them as her No. 1 career highlight. They now have a new entry for consideration after Friday's Breeders Crown Three-Year-Old Filly Trot performance.

It's hardly a new scene for those who know the ultra-consistent champion best: a trip to the winner's circle on the big stage.

With regular reinsman Yannick Gingras in the sulky, Arian G, trained by Jimmy Takter, added another memorable moment to her head-turning racing résumé after a thoroughly dominant five-and-a-quarter length Breeders Crown score in 1:54.3 over a sloppy Hoosier Park strip, for Al Libfeld, who bred and co-owns the daughter of Muscle Hill—Cantab It All, with his partner Marvin Katz.

Katz has 10 Breeders Crown wins and Libfeld nine.

"(Arian G) really doesn't like this kind of weather and wet track. It was very tiring and kind of crazy even up front. She had to work hard and she got a little tired at the end. She got leg tired," Takter said.

It was a win made even sweeter considering the bay came into the race off a rare defeat, losing by a neck to Ice Attraction (second tonight) in the \$168,000 Kentucky Filly Futurity final for 3-year-old trotting fillies on Oct. 8 at Red Mile.

Just as sweet? The only other time she had competed at Hoosier Park, Arian G broke stride and finished 10th in last year's Kentuckiana Stallion Management. It's the only race – out of 26 career starts – in which she has finished lower than third.

Tonight, she was back to her typical self – tenacious, tough-as-nails and triumphant.

"I can't even articulate this how remarkable this is," said Katz. "I'm thrilled that Hoosier Park has put on the evening they have. It's just a fabulous evening and I know tomorrow will be just as great. I'm thrilled that there is a new venue that has become part of the Breeders Crown. Of course, I'm a Hambletonian director and for all of our society, we are thrilled. This is a new venue and an expansion of the industry in a great way."

Katz was equally complimentary of Takter.

Al Libfeld, who bred and owns Ariana G with Marvin Katz, said of the filly: "I don't do the voting, but she's my Horse of the Year,"

"This isn't a partnership, this is a friendship, which is even far more deep and meaningful to me and I hope to Jimmy as well," Katz said. "We've known each other for years and he is a fantastic man. He's at the pinnacle of this sport at which he deserves all the accolades he gets. People have to understand how difficult it is to do

what he does and do it year in and year out. It's not easy. This is a special, special man. And he deserves all the fame and accolades he gets."

A Breeders Crown and Dan Patch Award winner last season, Ariana G is in the midst of a stellar season, having won 12 of her 15 starts. Her victories include setting a track and Canadian record in the \$385,000 Elegance final at Mohawk on Sept. 16.

Ariana G, who has also taken the Hambletonian Oaks and Simcoe Stakes, is the second of five foals out of Cantab It All. Her older full-sister All The Time made just shy of \$1 million.

After the Breeders Crown score, Ariana G, who paid \$2.40 to

win as the 1-5 favorite, is closing in on \$2 million in career earnings, courtesy of 21 wins.

"I trained her mother and when you take these horses from the beginning and teach them everything they are supposed to do, that is a special moment for me," said Takter. "We spend so much time with these horses. It's just a fantastic feeling."

There could be more big moments ahead for the trotting titan and her connections, including possible Horse of the Year honors.

"I hope so," said Katz. "I don't vote. This is an exceptionally great horse. They tried to beat her and they just can't. She fantastic."

It's a sentiment echoed by Libfeld.

"I don't do the voting, but she's my Horse of the Year," he said. "Whether they vote her or someone else, you know, it won't take any of the allure. She's just really special and I just can't wait. She's outrageously special. She's probably the best horse we've ever owned and we've owned some great horses."

Sweet score! Youaremycandygirl crushes field

Bill Donovan's prize filly won by four-and-a-half lengths.

Juvenile pacing filly Youaremycandygirl improved her record to seven wins from nine starts while providing driver Yannick Gingras with a third win on the Friday Breeders Crown card from Hoosier Park.

The betting public has been sweet on the daughter of American Ideal for much of her inaugural campaign going to post as the favourite six times and Youaremycandygirl didn't disappoint as the pacesetting 2-5 mutuel favourite over a sloppy strip.

"She's a world record holder and she showed them tonight that she's for real," said owner W.J. Donovan of his filly who in October sped to a division score in the International Stallion Stakes at Red Mile in a world-record timing of 1:50.

Not that the betting public has always been so keen to play the well-related filly. Following a trio of scores in New York Sires Stakes events to start her career, Youaremycandygirl shipped north to Mohawk and with catch driver Louis Philippe Roy in rein, scored a 40-1 upset in the Shes A Great Lady.

The winning result was admittedly bittersweet for

Donovan who notes he was confident his filly would win that night despite the price.

"I absolutely did. I was on a cruise ship in the middle of the Atlantic Ocean with bad Internet connection and a bad cell phone," Donovan said. "We were trying to watch the race and not being able to bet, and I never bet my own horses, but I tell you what I would have bet her that night. I thought she should be 6-1 or 8-1, I couldn't believe it."

Donovan, who has won a pair of Breeders Crown titles with the talented trotting mare Maven, is an executive in the transportation and logistics field. However, Donovan also proves to have some serious chops when it comes to picking a racehorse after signing the bill on Youaremycandygirl for \$150,000 at the Harrisburg sale after careful consideration. The filly was bred by Birnam Wood Farms of Boca Raton, FL.

"I was looking for a New York bred filly and I loved her bloodlines. She was actually my top pick. I looked at three or four dozen fillies, looking specifically for a pacing filly," said Donovan.

Youaremycandygirl's dam, Sweet Lady Jane, is a half-sister to Sweet Lou a 33-time winner of some \$3,484,251.

"Her page was loaded with performers I've admired, especially Sweet Lou," said Donovan. "She also had a great video and when I saw her she lived up to expectations. She's a gorgeous filly, good body and strong. We could see she would grow into a racehorse. She was destined for that."

There was no doubt in Donovan's mind that his quality purchase would be brought to the races by veteran conditioner Ron Burke.

"I have horses with various trainers but because Ron Burke had Sweet Lou and several other good performers from the family, it was a given she would go to him," said Donovan. "He brought her along slowly and gave her time to mature on the New York circuit and away from the bearcats, if you will, when she won the Great Lady. I think that's helped her at the end of the season here that she didn't get beat up early as so often these young horses do."

To win the Breeders Crown, Youaremycandygirl had to overcome difficult conditions but Donovan knew he had an ace up his sleeve.

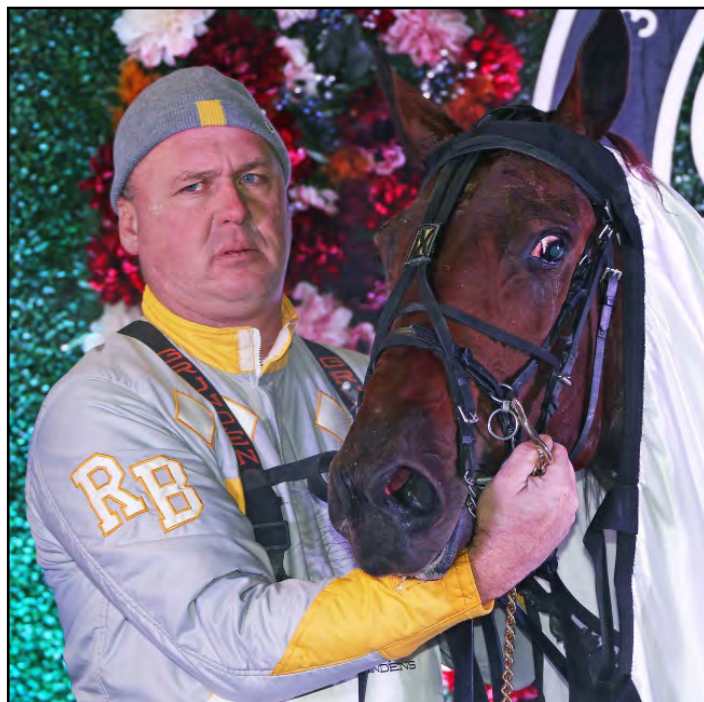
"In these conditions, you never know, but it worked out. Yannick's the man," said Donovan. "I was happy to have him back driving her (after the Shes A Great Lady). I think he's the best driver in the world right now."

Gingras engineered a difficult elimination win last week and was understandably concerned with the conditions on Friday night.

"Last week she was a loose horse. I tried to get her in a hole and she wanted no part of that. It ended up a little bit different (tonight) and she was perfect and I could have done anything I wanted with her," said Gingras. "When I did race her outside I thought I would race her from the back and she paced by horses really fast, so I knew obviously that the monkey was on my back and had the chance to go to the front, but I could do whichever I wanted."

Working quickly through splits of :27.1, a :56.3 half and three-quarters in 1:25.2, Gingras knew the final turn would make the difference for Breeders Crown glory.

"I was a little worried because she was on a loose line and it could be either really good or really bad. But around the last turn I showed her the whip and she had the gear that I

knew she had, so at that point I knew she was a winner," said Gingras.

Donovan, who also sent out 30-1 shot Firestorm, couldn't have been happier with the end result as Youaremycandygirl cruised home in 1:53.2.

"There's not a trainer, driver or owner that wants to see a sloppy track like that, especially when they're going miles like this," said Donovan. "It was a concern, but she obviously handled it quite well. My other horse (Firestorm) came from an impossible position to get fourth. I'm thrilled with the result."

Youaremycandygirl paid \$2.80 to win.

Pure Country storms back to score upset

Diamond Creek's homebred mare won her second Breeders Crown at 14-1.

Pure Country has been a tough mare to figure in a year where she's had more than her fair share of ups and downs, but she picked the right time to put it back all together.

In a wet and rainy night where favorites ruled on the opening night of the 2017 Breeders Crown at Hoosier Park, Pure Country (Somebeachsomewhere–Western Montana) came barreling through the stretch to win at odds of 14-1 in a time of 1:52:1 on the sloppy rated track.

At only three wins from 13 starts on the season heading into her Breeders Crown final, it was understandable to see how Pure Country had been overlooked while racing against the likes of Lady Shadow and Nike Franco N throughout much of the year. But on the other hand, this is the same mare that set a world record with a 1:48 qualifier over the summer and whose three wins included the Lady Liberty, the Artiscap, and an elimination of the Milton at Mohawk.

Winning trainer Jimmy Takter summed it up best following the race. "I never really knew where I had her all season," Takter said, in terms of how tough it was to get a pulse on Pure Country. He said, "We were dealing with a lot of struggles with her this year. She got sick early and then she raced well. She's a pure champion, obviously."

For Takter, the nightcap win was his third Breeders Crown win of the night, winning also with horses guaranteed to win divisional honors, Manchego and Ariana G.

Pure Country was driven by her usual pilot Mark MacDonald, and MacDonald won while wearing the colors of winning owners, Diamond Creek Racing of Wellsville PA. Diamond Creek Racing also bred Pure Country and for Adam Bowden the win was particularly sweet.

"She's a homebred and I actually bred the mare myself and was there when she was foaled," he said. And Bowden means it literally. "Like I said, I bred the filly myself. Literally, I had my hands up the mare. I put in the Somebeach semen; this hand right here did it all," he said, laughing.

As Bowden mentioned, Pure Country was the winner of the 2015 Breeders Crown for 2-year-old fillies and she finished unbeaten that year with a perfect 10 for 10 record. From that freshman campaign through Friday's Breeders Crown win, Pure Country has now banked over \$2.1 million in career earnings. Bowden indicated following the race that his prized mare will target the TVG Mares as her next start and may race one or two more times this year before potentially

breeding her next year.

In addition to breeding Pure Country, one of the special parts in this process was having Jimmy Takter train her. What better trainer to go manage a horse such as Pure Country that you never know what you're going to get from one start to the next throughout this year. Said Bowden, "I trust Jimmy, that he's going to have her ready in the big races. The eliminations don't matter as much and Lexington was bad weather. You can write those off, but when the big money is on the line, Jimmy has his horses ready."

This was Mark MacDonald's third Breeders Crown win but his first outside of Canada. Despite faltering a bit with a first over trip, MacDonald didn't lose confidence heading into the final. "I talked to my dad this afternoon and said I thought she could win if I could get her in the right spot; and she did win," MacDonald said.

The race unfolded with Lady Shadow predictably blasting to the front, clearing past Nike Franco N through an opening quarter of :26:2. Lady Shadow proceeded to the half and then three quarters relatively unchallenged through fractions of :54:4 and 1:23:2. Around the final turn L A Delight came calling and a wall of mares began to stack wide to the outside.

Through the stretch, Darlinonthebeach made a late inside move after sitting third on the rail through much of the mile and looked to be coming through, but the outside horses were closing fastest of all. Lady Shadow continued to dig in and fight, but in the end it was Pure Country who cleared away to win by a length and a quarter over

Bedroomconfessions who had been rallying alongside the race winner. Lady Shadow held on for third.

MacDonald bided his time throughout much of the mile with Pure Country but felt good about his chances turning for home. She chases down horses and you know, I honestly thought she had a good chance to win it from that spot."

The winning driver added that what he admires most about Pure Country is her grittiness. "She's always going forward, even in Canada (in the Milton). I was going all I could the whole race in the Milton in like :53, 1:20; it was just like 'Argh' and she just got tired in the last 20 feet, but she's just so tough. She takes one stride when other horses are taking two. She's a big, rangy mare and she just keeps coming."

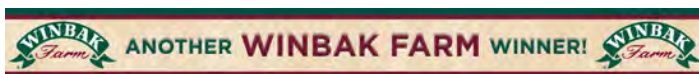
