## **Handicapping the Division Champions**

A close look at the divisional races for year-end awards in the aftermath of the Breeders Crown.

November has arrived, the Breeders Crown is in the books and the opportunities for those aspiring to division dominance are dwindling. Some races are still wide open while others are over.

Hannelore Hanover, the Swan For All Amazon out of Indiana, towers above the rest of the older trotting mares. Bee A Magician, the 2013 Horse of the Year in the U.S. and Canada, who won this division last year, lost four months to injury in the heart of the season, thus removing the only plausible obstacle between Team Burke's star trotter and a Dan Patch. In addition to the Breeders Crown, Hannelore won the Hambletonian Maturity, Armbro Flight, Muscle Hill, Centaur Classic and Miami Valley Distaff. She is ranked third in the Nov. 1 Hambletonian Society/Breeder Crown Poll. She could call it a year now and still win her division with ease.

Hannelore's opposite number, **Lady Shadow**, who won her division in Canada the last two years, is another sure shot. She won 11 of 18 starts this year and has earnings of close

to \$800,000. The five-year-old daughter of Shadow Play has won the Breeders Crown, Roses Are Red, Milton, Lady Liberty and Golden Girls. In the latter, in mid-July, she broke Always B Miki's world record for a mile-and-an-eighth when she finished in an amazing 2:00.3. And along the way she matched Shebestingin's 1:47 world record for a filly or mare, set three years ago at Red Mile. Granted Miki's 1:46 world record tops all, but this feat is a solid second.

Broadway Donna, the division winner last year and the PASS champ at two and three, is a lock to rule the three-year-old trotting fillies. She won seven of 12, including the Breeders Crown, Del Miller and KY Filly Futurity. Fashion Farms' filly flies under the radar and gets a minimum of credit, although, in fairness, hers has never been a particularly deep division. The Donato Hanover lass's chief competition comes from Ariana G's big sister All The Time, who beat Donna in the Oaks. Donna beat her in the BC and the Del Miller. The downfall for the Muscle Hill filly is the fact that she underwent surgery after the Oaks and didn't race again until her BC elimination in mid-October. She just doesn't have time to accumulate the wins needed to outdo her foe. All The Time won the BC last year, but it was too little too late as Donna garnered 87 per cent of the Dan Patch vote.

Two sons of Somebeachsomewhere, Huntsville and Downbytheseaside, are battling for freshman honors. The latter, a \$65,000 Lexington purchase by trainer Brian Brown, is freaky fast. He spent most of the summer on the restricted circuit in Pennsylvania, but in September he set a 1:50 world record in the Standardbred at Delaware, OH, then went on to win splits if the Bluegrass and ISS at Red Mile.

Ray Schnittker's Huntsville has a similar resume. He beat

Seaside at Pocono in July, then lost to him a couple of weeks later. Huntsville was outstanding in his two starts in Lexington. The public sent Huntsville away the 4-5 favorite in the BC, with Seaside at 7-5. They finished one-two, with the former winning in a track record 1:49.1 for Tim Tetrick. That's a tick off of Sweet Lou's stakes record. Right now it looks like Huntsville will prevail in the quest for division honors. Both of them are staked to the Governor's Cup at Woodbine on Nov. 19 (elims Nov. 11), so it isn't over, yet.

Walner, a star in the making from the first crop of 2012 Horse of the Year Chapter Seven, has the freshman colt trotting title wrapped up. He's the richest and fastest colt in his class, although he didn't progress from restricted racing and the Kindergarten Series until October. He drew off by three in his track record 1:53 win in the BC for Tetrick and Toscano. Walner, who was foaled in Campbellville, ON, drew the nine post in Saturday's \$200,600 Kindergarten final at The Meadowlands. He is not staked to the Valley Victory on Nov. 19, and can't be supplemented to that.

Triple Crown winner **Marion Marauder** came up empty — reportedly sick — in the BC and finished last. Still, he has enough equity built up to cruise to a division win. Some were holding out hope for HOY honors, but that's now off the table. Bar Hopping, who appeared poised to take the

Hambletonian, but didn't get there, has won the Canadian Trotting Classic, Bluegrass and Breeders Crown over the last six weeks. And he takes on Sutton again in Friday's \$200,000 Carl Erskine at Hoosier Park. The Muscle Hill colt has earned our respect but it's too late to catch the TC winner.

Like Walner, **Resolve** is the fastest and richest in his class, and he too will win his division. Wins in the Cutler, Cashman, Maple Leaf Trot and million-dollar International Trot add up to a Dan Patch for Ake Svanstedt's Muscle Hill five-year-old. Obrigado was no slouch, with wins in the Maxie Lee, Charlie Hill, Cleveland Trotting Classic, Crawford Farms and Dayton Trotting Derby; and Flanagan Memory took the Crown, but Resolve gets the prize.

Betting Line won 14 of 15 starts and earned more money than all but BC winner Racing Hill within the division. Wins in the Cup, Jug, Milstein, Battle Of Brandywine — in a world record 1:47.2 — Simcoe and Champlain seal the deal for the Bettor's Delight colt. Casie Coleman was hoping for HOY consideration, but the spider that knocked Betting Line out of the BC nixed any chance of that happening. He may start in the Matron on Nov. 10, and he and Racing Hill are both staked to the Progress Pace on Nov. 28.

Breeders Crown winner Someomensomewhere was the only freshman pacing filly to make this week's Top Ten Poll and that was as the last also ran listed — with a single point. At this juncture two years ago, JK She'salady topped the Poll. However, there is no See You At Peelers or Precocious Beauty out there in 2016.

Idyllic Beach, who is the earnings leader and co-holder of the season's record, would have secured a division win with a BC victory, but she finished third. The winner of the Great Lady, Kentuckiana and ISS is still in the thick of things, but no longer the presumptive winner.

And the Art Major filly, **Roaring To Go**, has wins in the Bluegrass and ISS. Being disqualified after crossing first in her NYSS final doesn't help.

Breeders Crown winner Someomensomewhere has little to back that up — just a score in an ISS split and a PA Allstars win. However, she snuck into Saturday's \$149,100 Kindergarten final at The Meadowlands, and a win there would certainly enhance her resume. She and Idyllic Beach are staked to the Three Diamonds on Nov 11. That may settle it. Roaring To Go is not eligible.

The sophomore pacing fillies also have voters in a quandary. Pure Country entered the season as number one in the Experimental Rankings; big things were expected from the daughter of SBSW. But the competition is fierce in that

division and she hasn't been able to close the deal. She's the only distaff pacer to top the million-dollar mark this year, and has taken the Fan Hanover, Garnsey, Lynch and Simcoe, but paternal sisters **Darlinonthebeach** and Call Me Queen Be, as well as the Bettor's Delight filly, LA Delight, keeps raining on her parade.

Darlinonthebeach won the Shady Daisy, Valley Forge and splits of the Garnsey and Bluegrass; LA Delight won the Jugette and Nadia Lobell; and Queen Be took the BC and the PA Championship. All four are staked to the Matron on Nov. 10. It may come down to that.


Dominance of the open pacing division will hinge on how **Miki** and Wiggle close the season. If Miki wins the TVG, after beating Wiggle in the BC, romping in an open at The Meadowlands, and pacing the fastest competitive mile ever in the Allerage, that will be it. The Dan Patch, as well as Horse of the Year honors, will be his. On the other hand, if Wiggle takes the TVG, things will get interesting. If a horse other than those two wins the TVG, Miki will win the division and be crowned Horse of the Year.

## Will it all come down to the Breeders Crown?

A further analysis of each division-by-division race.

It all comes down to the Breeders Crown, or so says that marvelous slogan that has indeed endured the test of time.

In most cases it does, but let's examine the recently concluded 12 races and see exactly what did come down.

A thing to remember, too, is that, in some divisions, there is life after the Breeders Crown particularly at Hoosier, Dover, and the upcoming final four in Canada.

In the open mare's division, Hannelore Hanover defeated Bee A Magician, virtually re-enforcing her claim to the aged mare title. It was Hannelore Hanover's 16th win in 19 starts. It was the first loss of the year in just five starts for Bee A Magician, who sat out much of the summer with a tendon injury.

In the open pace for horses and geldings, Always B Miki edged his chief rival Wiggle It Jiggleit but he'll most likely have to do it again in the upcoming TVG Free-For-All at the Meadowlands on Nov. 12 to solidify his hold on the divisional championship.

There are four other Breeders Crown winners that likely locked up their division title. They include:

- Lady Shadow in the open mare pacers thanks to her open-length Crown tally.
- Ariana G in the two-year-old filly trotters' division. Her Crown win maintained her dominance of this division and solidified her Championship aspirations with her ninth seasonal victory.
- Walner in the two-year-old trotting colts' group. He solidified his stranglehold on divisional honors with a

decisive Crown victory. This race won't be close.

• Broadway Donna in the three-year old filly trotters' category. Her overhaul of front-stepping All The Time will likely clinch divisional honors, though it could be more of a plurality than an actual landslide given her rival's season-long body of work.

However, there are six other divisions likely still up for grabs or unlikely to go to the Crown winner:

- Huntsville likely locked up the two-year-old pacing colt title when he defeated chief rival Downbytheseaside, but divisional honors might just flip if Downbytheseaside wins the rematch in Canada.
- In the open trot, Flanagan Memory was along in time to best Resolve, though it probably won't be enough to overtake the latter for the divisional championship.
- The two-year-old filly pace featured one of the closest Crown finishes of the night, but Someomensomewhere's win might not be enough for her to overtake division-leading Idyllic Beach. A win by Someomensomewhere in the Kindergarten could put her over the top. This race will be interesting.
- Bar Hopping won the Breeders Crown for three-year-old trotting colts and won the Canadian Trotting Classic in



September, but he's unlikely to dethrone Triple Crown-winning Marion Marauder for the division title.

- Call Me Queen Be won the Breeders Crown and threw a monkey wrench into the aspirations of divisional leaders Pure Country and Darlinonthebeach. Sometimes late impressions are the best impression and Queen Be does have decisions over both rivals, in the PASS final, the Jugette world record heat and now the Breeders Crown. This race could be very interesting.
- Racing Hill dominated the Breeders Crown for sophomore pacing colts, but it won't be enough to overtake divisional leader Betting Line. Still, it could dent Racing Hill's margin of victory somewhat.

It all comes down to The Breeders Crown is a great slogan, but, often, there is life thereafter.







## **Expect fireworks at the Harrisburg sale**

The blood bay colt sashayed into the sale ring, and suddenly the Pennsylvania Farm Show Arena went silent. It was the fall of 1958.

It was the hush of anticipation. Horsemen in the crowd knew that fireworks would explode when the bidding started, but they had no idea where the offers would end.

When the bidding ended, the auctioneer hammered down a yearling pacer named Dancer Hanover for \$105,000. He was the first standardbred — or thoroughbred — yearling to command a six-figure price.

The sale of Dancer Hanover is one of the many storied moments in the history of the Standardbred Horse Sale, known in the harness racing vernacular as simple the "Harrisburg Sale."

After its inception Harrisburg in 1939, the sale was moved to the fairgrounds in York, PA during the World War II years, but soon returned to the huge agricultural arena in the state capital. It's been the site of many memorable moments in standardbred sale history.

In 2011, the trotting colt Detour Hanover fetched a fantastic sum of \$825,000, the highest price ever paid for a fledging trotter or pacer.

Ironically, when adjusted for inflation, Dancer Hanover's \$105,000 in 1958 equaled \$817,252 in 2011, nearly matching Detour Hanover's sale price.

Will there be any such magic moments in next week's Harrisburg sale? Anything can — and often does — happen at a horse sale. Logic is tossed out the window when bidders are determined to buy a coveted horse.

One standardbred yearling consignor told me that an owner loved one of his colts so much that he confessed before the sale, "I'm going to buy him no matter how much he costs."

The breeder told me, "Now if I could've found one more person who felt the same way, I'd have been a rich, rich man."

The Harrisburg Sale has long been associated with

Hanover Shoe Farms, which has sent powerhouse consignments into the ring since the sale's inception. This year, Hanover sells another bountiful crop of yearlings at Harrisburg. So it's not surprising that yearlings with the Hanover surname have made major headlines at Harrisburg.

Before Dancer Hanover made history in 1958, the record price for a standardbred yearling was the \$72,000 price fetched by Imperial Hanover in 1949. He turned out to be a colossal dud, earning \$1,731, and bidders were, thus, a bit gun shy about paying astronomical sums.

Dancer Hanover changed that. He had been named for the rising young New Jersey horseman Stanley Dancer and the colt's namesake had assembled a group of owners willing to pay a record \$75,000 to acquire the prize colt.

When hip number 914 came into the ring in 1958, Delvin Miller opened the bidding with an offer of \$25,000. (Keep in mind that Hanover's consignment the previous year at Harrisburg had averaged \$5,564.)

There have been some great stories out of the Harrisburg Sale over the years.

The bids came fast and furious and soon the record price of Imperial Hanover and Dancer's limit of \$75,000 were both passed. Dancer was sitting with Martin Shriner, one of his investors, and Shriner told Dancer to keep bidding.

The bids didn't stop until Dancer offered \$100,000, and then the onlookers in the arena burst into applause. But the colt still hadn't been sold. Jim Camp from California tossed in a \$102,000 bid. Shriner told Dancer to keep going.

"No, Mr. Shriner, you're the only one of the owners here, and the others don't want him at this price," Dancer protested. Shriner assured Dancer that he'd handle the money worries.

Dancer raised his hand at \$105,000, and Camp capitulated.

(Swapson was the first thoroughbred yearling to sell for six figures when he commanded a \$130,000 bid in 1961.)

In 2011, Detour Hanover set the all-time record price for a standardbred yearling sold at auction when the full-brother to Donato Hanover brought a bid of \$825,000.

Dancer Hanover proved to be a fast, but erratic, pacer and ended this career with a then-sensational 1:56.4 mark, but only \$87,746 on his card. He returned to Hanover Shoe Farms and sired the Triple Crown winner Romeo Hanover in his first crop.

A dozen years after Dancer Hanover sold, his daughter Romalie Hanover became the first filly to command a hundred grand price as she sold for \$101,000. She was the dominant Grand Circuit filly of her class for two seasons and banked almost \$400,000 in the early 1970s.

On the day before the Harrisburg sale opened in 2011, longtime sale manager Murray Brown spotted me and asked, "Have you seen him? Have you seen him?"

I wasn't certain if he was referring to a two-legged or four-legged specimen, but I should have realized that four-legged specimens take center stage at Harrisburg.

He was referring to Detour Hanover, the brother to Hambletonian winner Donato Hanover. Detour was a big, strapping dude and Murray told me, "I guarantee you he's the sale topper."

Detour Hanover was not only the sale topper of that auction, but of all time when the Cancelliere brothers of New Jersey got into a bidding duel with Karl Erik Bender of Sweden. Both parties wanted the prize colt badly.

In the end, the Cancellieres collared the colt, but it cost them \$825,000 to do so. They celebrated and accepted congratulations when the colt was hammered down.

That was about the only time they had reason to celebrate their acquisition of Detour Hanover as he earned just over \$25,000 on the track. He's embarked on his breeding career, serving a book of 17 mares last year and four mares this year. He's under lease to the Delaware Valley University.

Will history be made again this year at Harrisburg? Who knows? As is often said, anything can happen at a horse sale.

## Marion Marauder tested sick after Breeders Crown

Trainer Mike Keeling told Harness Racing Update Tuesday morning (Nov. 1) that Trotting Triple Crown winner Marion Marauder tested sick after fading to last in Saturday's (Oct.

Wellwood, said driver Scott Zeron told him them after the race that, "'At the half, I had no horse. He was just loose-lining

and he's never done that before. He just didn't perform well.

"We brought him off the track and physically, you couldn't see anything. He just didn't seem himself and he was slow recovering and he's always really quick to recover."

Keeling said the next morning their New Jersey vet pulled some blood and discovered Marion Marauder "had a quite elevated white count and his liver and kidney function were out of normal range and he said that points toward a viral infection. The vet said, 'These are the ones that haunt you because they don't manifest themselves until they're racing.' You don't know until they have to perform at 100 per cent and they can't because they have a viral infection. He said, 'Physically, you won't see it and they won't have a temperature and they won't look different to you. Just their body isn't capable to function at 100 per cent."

The loss put a damper on a terrific year in which Marion Marauder won the Hambletonian, Yonkers Trot and the Kentucky Futurity, among other stakes, posted a record of 10-3-0 in 15 starts, set a mark of 1:51.3 and earned \$1,484,532 for Wellwood's mother, Jean Wellwood, and Paula and Keeling's son, Devin Keeling.

"It was a bitter pill to swallow (Breeders Crown) night, but we weren't long getting over it," Mike said. "As long as he was fine and he was still happy and himself, that was all that mattered. He still trotted in :53. That tells you how tough it is at that level. They have to be at or near 100 per cent every

start. It's just crazy competitive."

Mike said Marion Marauder's season is over and no decision has been made, yet, about the colt's future.

"The Breeders
Crown was always
his last race of the
year and that's why
we raced through
it. Most people
said, 'You should
just end the
season after the
Triple Crown.' We
said, 'No, we've
stuck to his
schedule.' Other

than throwing in the Kentucky Futurity, we had a plan for him and the plan was to race him through the Breeders Crown before we made any decisions about anything. We did. It just didn't work out the way I had dreamed it in my head... He's now on a well-deserved holiday.

"In hindsight, we got lucky that it didn't happen in August (in the Hambletonian). This could happen to anybody. Horses get sick. They're not machines. I was just kind of shocked in the moment, thinking, 'Wow, we're getting the trip we want and he's not keeping up. That's not Marauder.' It was obvious to the world that something was not right, but it wasn't soundness or anything. It was just purely a sickness issue."

## Anthony MacDonald: We simply have to do a better job of attracting young people

I read the story in HRU by Dave Briggs titled "Getting out of the red at Red Mile" (Sept. 30).

I was a bit shocked with the tone of the story.

I understand as a jurisdiction Kentucky faces many hurdles, and none of them are new.

In the story, this was the quote that caught my eye:

"When the (current) ownership group bought it, it was meant to be a breeders' meet. That's what we think it should be."

For me, as a 39-year-old horsemen with a wife, mortgage and two kids, I find statements like this to be a perfect metaphor for horse racing in 2016.

Every jurisdiction still believes it's every man/women for themselves.

It appears the destruction of horse racing in other states and provinces and repeated government warnings to our industry has not changed our trajectory.

Look at our medication rules, our agreements with governments, our marketing and advertising.

Nothing is done in unity, little for the greater good of horse racing.

There is no sense of one voice, or one industry and what we are left with is a sea of whispers in an ocean of economic noise.

I'm not writing this to attack Kentucky. Substantially more in fact, this a call to all young people in this industry.

Our industry has tried and consistently failed to connect with a younger generation for decades now.

I'm sure it's frustrating, and I certainly can't blame our establishment for trying to steady the ship, but their inability to do so is troubling.

The average age of the members of the Hambletonian Society and almost every governing body in our industry makes this a very challenging task.

In their defence, it's not like many people under 45 are looking to lead.

Me, I've always spoke my mind. I'm not always right, but if this makes people talk and speak up, then right or wrong, I'm doing what I can.

As an industry it took us this long to get where we are, how long are we prepared to stay the course?

Without addressing our dwindling fan base across the

board we will eventually run out of investors to buy our yearlings, meaning you could run the sales at half time of the Super Bowl and no one will be buying.

We need to understand that the crutch that casinos and governments give us in the form of handouts may help us stand, but they will never help us walk.

We need to show the general public we are worthy of their entertainment dollar and build a unified brand and voice that can represent horse racing across the board.

The generational rift in this industry is obvious and reared its head when I wrote a blog on this very topic.

It's seemed anyone under the age of 45 agreed with what I was concerned about, and everyone over the age of 50 condemned it like it was treasonous.

I'm sorry, I don't believe "it's just how they do things in Kentucky or anywhere else" is an acceptable answer any longer.

This industry doesn't have to be in such a sad state.

Young people can attend horse races, I saw at least 25,000 of them in Keeneland at the exact time harness racing set two world records at the Red Mile 15 minutes away.

People say it's "tradition" and we could never get college kids to watch our sport at the Red Mile the way they do at Keeneland.

Well, I talked to many young people in Kentucky and it appears you're right, like most cities with horse racing, they don't know we exist.

But, I also see Keeneland doing all it can to bring kids out to their track.

I saw a shuttle every 10 minutes to the University of Kentucky and back full of people.

Yet it took me 15 minutes to get uber to pick me up at the front door of Red Mile.

The gentleman driving the red Nissan Rogue that finally showed up, lived in Kentucky and didn't know they "held races at the casino."

I was always told if you want something bad enough you better be ready to work for it.

There is no shortage of hard work in this industry, and I truly believe that we only need to focus it.

Kentucky is no different then Ontario, Pennsylvania, New York, Ohio, or any other jurisdiction.

We are all in the same boat and it's about time we start rowing in the same direction.

Leave the past behind us and push forward to a brighter future.

We need to work hard to retain our gamblers, grow our fan

base and cultivate investment from the general public.

I want to bring my family to Kentucky,

But if we continue to lose money on a breeders meet that makes all of Kentucky choose between "Tetrick or Tepin", or "Red Mile" or the "Kentucky Wildcats" I fear by the time my kids are old enough to truly understand how incredibly beautiful Red Mile is, it will be student housing for the University of Kentucky.

I mean no disrespect by either my blog or response to Mr. Briggs' story. I love this industry and I truly believe it will rise up.

I believe it's time the younger generation pull their weight, speak up and start to take more responsibility in building the future of this industry.

I'm not as concerned about yesterday as I am 2017 and beyond, and I believe we all owe it to ourselves to help horse racing find a better way.

What's Going On, with Hall of Fame driver David Miller in his bike, rolled from last at the three-quarters to score a 1:55, 32-1 upset Thursday at Dover Downs in the \$171,300 Matron two-year-old colt and gelding stake, one of four rich Matron finals on the card. Ain't Three OK won the filly pace, while Fine Tuned Lady and Snowstorm Hanover took the trot finals. There were also four Delaware Standardbred Breeders Fund (DSBF) first leg colt elims on the five-race card.

What's Goin On and David Miller pulled off the 32-1 upset in their Matron test Thursday at Dover Downs.

It was Miller's first effort behind What's Goin On, a son of Roll With Joe—Xclamation owned by Bob Phillips, Deena Frost, VIP Internet and trainer Mark Harder.

Miller waited while Every Way Out and then race favorite Boogie Shuffle and Scott Zeron took the eight starters to the three quarters. Miller then moved What's Goin On to pass horses and beat Rock N Tony (Trace Tetrick) to the wire for his third win of the season. Boogie Shuffle held on for third. What's Goin On almost has now won \$172,397, nearly doubling his lifetime earnings.

Brian Sears piloted Canadian-bred Ain't Three OK to a lifetime best 1:52.4 win in the \$170,000 Matron filly stake. Steve Carter conditions the Chuck Grubbs-leased daughter of Mach Three—Ain't Given Up to her fifth win in 11 races this

year. She has now banked \$282,224. Rockette picked up second money with Matt Kakaley in the bike. World Apart and Scott Zeron finished third.

Delaware was well-represented in the \$148,700 Matron filly trot. Dover Downs' leading driver Corey Callahan drove the 1:56.3 triumph for owner M&L Of Delaware, the nom-de-course for Ralph, Roz and Doug Paul and their partner Bill Wizwell. Ice Attraction was second for Ake Svanstedt with Winter Sweet Frost piloted by Scott Zeron third. The victory was the sixth of the campaign for the John Butenschoen-trained Fine Tuned Lady, a Cantab Hall—Poster Princess filly, now a winner of \$438,340.

Kakaley drove Snowstorm Hanover home in 1:55.1 to win the first Matron event for freshmen. The Muscle Massive—Snow Angel Hanover colt got going late in the mile to overtake Sortie with Andrew McCarthy in the final strides for win number four this year. Weaver Bruscemi, Baldachino, Colluri and Burke Racing own the winner of \$178,719 in his rookie season. Southwind Cobra got up for third for Yannick Gingras.

There were four Delaware Standardbred Breeders Fund (DSBF) two-year-old colt paces on the stakes-filled program. Automatic Drago (Vic Kirby) took the lead early on the way to a 1:54.3 victory in the first \$20,000 event. Daylen (Montrell Teague) was runner-up with Suspinder (Allan Davis) third. Bobby Clark trains the Art Director-Dragon Woman gelding for Tina and Joe Clark.

Apple Heir and Jason Green took the second DSBF pace in 1:56.3. Brian Wright trains and co-owns the Mr. Apples—Paris The Heiress gelding with Bill Hall. Unbroken Vision (Callahan) and Takeittotheface (Ross Wolfenden) were second and third, respectively.

Montrell Teague guided Henry The Dragon to his fourth consecutive victory in his \$20,000 DSBF prelim. Sired by Custer The Dragon from Surveille Hanover, the Clyde Francis-trainee is owned by George Teague Inc. Stay In Your Place (Kevin Switzer Jr.) was second. Bags To Riches (Art Stafford Jr.), third.

James Isaac with Tony Morgan driving for trainer Vick Keeler II and owner Dan Keeler posted a 1:53 conquest in the other \$20,000 DSBF first leg pace. Hallie's Comet (Ross Wolfenden) was a strong second in front of Rat Tail (M.Teaque).

## **Grand Circuit Stakes action tonight at Hoosier**

Tonight (Nov. 4), Grand Circuit racing action will make its way back to Hoosier Park for the fourth and final time this

season and with it, bring the top rated horses in North America to Hoosier Park in search of the lucrative purses offered on the 14-race card beginning at 5:45 p.m. With purses approaching \$1 million, Hoosier Park will play host to a standout card that includes the \$200,000 Monument Circle Pace for three-year-old pacing colts and geldings, the \$220,000 Carl Erskine Trot for three-year-old trotting colts and geldings, the \$115,000 Crossroads of America for three-year-old trotting fillies and the \$112,500 USS Indianapolis Memorial for three-year-old pacing fillies.

Fresh off a win in the \$500,000 Breeders Crown Final for three-year-old trotting colts, Bar Hopping will look to add to his bankroll when he visits Indiana for the first time this season in the \$220,000 Carl Erskine Trot for trainer Jimmy Takter. The Muscle Hill—Cocktail Hour colt, whose seasonal earnings just surpassed the \$1 million mark, has won eight of 17 seasonal outings while also recording wins in the \$522,210 Canadian Trotting Classic and \$300,000 Zweig Memorial. Bar Hopping will play the role of morning line favorite at 3-5 in the Carl Erskine Trot and start from post two with Tim Tetrick in the bike.

Hoosier Park's leading trainer, Ron Burke will send out a strong contingent in the \$200,000 Monument Circle Pace which has been slated as the 12th race on the evening's program. Check Six, one of five horses from the Burke Stable in the Monument Circle, is the slight 7-5 morning line favorite over stablemate Manhattan Beach who has been enlisted at 8-5. Manhattan Beach finished second in the Breeders Crown Final and Check Six was third. Burke has trained three of the last four winners in the previous editions of the Monument Circle Pace at Hoosier Park.

"Check Six has been racing tough all year racing week in and week and out," Burke said. "He went a brutal trip last week in the Breeders Crown final so if the trip works out a little better for him in the Monument Circle, I think he will be sharp."

Burke also has two chances to win the \$112,500 USS Indianapolis Memorial for three-year-old pacing fillies with Yankee Moonshine and Dime A Dance. Dime A Dance has won four of 16 seasonal outings while earning \$237,510 in purse earnings and will start from post 10 with Matt Kakaley in the bike. Yankee Moonshine and Yannick Gingras drew post six. The Burke pair will look to upset the Indiana Sires Stakes Champion Seventimesavirgin and John DeLong who will start from the coveted rail position. Seventimesavirgin went undefeated in Indiana Sires Stakes action this season but had her nine-race winning streak snapped last week in Grand Circuit stakes action at Hoosier Park.

## Monticello-Goshen USHWA to honor Bob Boni

Bob Boni has always had a good eye for a horse. It was this keen sense of pedigree and conformation that prompted him to inspect and select world champion Nihilator as a yearling on a cold morning in February at the colt's birthplace in Indiana.

Fast forward 30-plus years and Boni finds himself associated with another world champion from Indiana, Always B Miki, who is the fastest standardbred of all time. It is this sharp eye for horseflesh that has helped Boni develop his own Northwood Bloodstock into one of North America's leading harness horse sales agencies over the last several decades.

His efforts have not gone unnoticed. When the Monticello-Goshen Chapter of the United States Harness

Writers Association holds their 58th annual awards banquet on Dec. 4 at the Fountains at Wallkill Golf Club, Boni will receive the chapter's highest honor—the lifetime achievement award.

A native of NYC's borough of Queens, Boni's interest in harness racing began at Roosevelt and Yonkers during his childhood. "In those days," he said, "everyone owned a horse or a piece of a horse. And, my dad was no different. It was a very popular form of entertainment."

This 'family ownership' began when Boni was in the fourth grade, and eventually led to weekend and summer work on the backstretch at Roosevelt Raceway. However, by his early 20s, Boni yearned for a change of scenery from what he had grown accustomed to in the Big Apple.

The aspiring horseman jumped into his car and drove from NYC to Goshen Historic Track where he met with Harry Pownall, Sr., trainer for the famed Arden Homestead Stable.

"You hiring?" Boni politely asked. But it was not to be. The Pownall/Arden Homestead crew were well entrenched and caretakers rarely left that successful stable.

So he continued on his quest and found himself in Pine Bush, NY at Pine Hollow Stud Farm, one of the two premier farms in the state at the time.

He met the farm manager, Jack Adams, who asked the young Boni, "Who did you work for in Westbury?" Boni replied, "George Butterworth, sir. I worked for George Butterworth."

Adams hired him on the spot, noting that "If you can work for that guy, you can work for anybody!"

Boni continued to work for Pine Hollow for the next 11 years, ascending to the position of vice-president, until he went out on his own in 1980. And the rest, as they say, is history.

This year, in addition to the year-end awards for horses and horsepeople from the local tracks, the Monticello-Goshen chapter will also honor Keith Hamilton (Excelsior Award); Kenneth Jacobs (John Gilmour Good Guy Award); Dave Little (Phil Pines Award); Roger Dowd (Amy Bull Crist Distinguished Service Award); Robert Krivelin (Amateur Driver); Justin Huckabone (Rising Star); and Denise DeSimone (Award of Appreciation).
