John Floren completes unique session-topping trade

The owner sold a Muscle Hill colt for \$320,000 and then bought a Muscle Hill filly for \$320,000 during the opening session of the Standardbred Horse Sales Company's yearling sale Monday that posted an average of \$75,305, down 4.3 per cent from the strong 2016 opening day.

John Floren pulled off a unique double Monday at the opening session of the 79th Standardbred Horse Sales Company's yearling sale at the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex in Harrisburg, PA when he sold one yearling for \$320,000 and bought another for the same price. The two Muscle Hill offspring ended up sharing the title as session toppers through the first of three yearling sessions that continue today and Wednesday.

Floren, who lives in Ontario and operates Coyote Wynd Stables, sold hip 112, a colt out of Sheer Glide named Sheer Muscle to Mario Mazza of New Hope, PA consigned by Peninsula Farms. Exactly 50 hip numbers later, Floren purchased hip 162, a filly named The Ice Dutchess out of The Ice Queen bred by David Reid and Stephen Dey III and sold out of the Preferred Equine consignment.

"How often does that happen? Just a little trade," said Floren's Ontario-based trainer Clark Beelby, who signed the

ticket and did the talking for the veteran owner who does not court the spotlight.

"He has an appreciation for bloodstock," Reid said of Floren. "He had a good day here selling one for a lot of money. He is a top-quality guy. I wish we could clone him for 10 more guys. He knows the big picture, he buys quality and he's a first-class guy. It's a perfect scenario all the way around."

During Monday's session, 164 yearlings sold for a gross of \$12,350,000. The average of \$75,305 was down 4.3 per cent from the gangbusters 2016 average of \$78,676 that was up 41 per cent from 2015 and was one of the best opening sessions in the history of the yearling sale.

This year's average is up 35 per cent over the 2015 average of \$55,781, up 23.5 per cent from the 2014 average of \$60,955 and up 15.6 per cent over the 2013 average of \$65,124.

Standardbred Horse Sales Company president and CEO Pete Spears said he was pleased with the results, but was left with one serious mystery from the opening session.

"The pacing colts were light, and I really can't give you a reason for that," Spears said of the group that averaged \$64,557 for 61 sold, compared to an average of \$91,838 for trotting colts (37 sold), \$84,387 for trotting fillies (31 sold) and \$68,514 for pacing fillies (35 sold). "Everything else was

really strong. Pacing fillies were really strong. Why did the pacing fillies out-average the pacing colts? If you can tell me that one, then I'll understand, but I really don't understand.

Monday's opening session drew a strong crowd.

"The trotters were very strong. If it weren't for the pacing colts, I think we would have been far above last year's average. I can't explain it. There were certainly some really nice Hanover pacing colts that went for a whole lot less than we thought. So somebody got some good buys and we'll sell the brothers and sisters next year."

Reid said selling The Ice Dutchess for top dollar not only provided a nice boost of energy to his Preferred consignment just eight horses from the end of the session, the trotting mare is also a great story of one of racing's important, but unheralded, operations.

Reid's co-breeder on The Ice Dutchess, Dr. Stephen Dey III is the son of Dr. S.P. Dey, the founder of Heritage Hill Farm of Allentown, NJ.

"My late partner, Geoff Stein, bought the mare (The Ice Queen)," Reid said. "It was myself and Geoff, with Dr. S.P. Dey when she came off the track."

"We've been selling yearlings for the Deys for probably 30 years. They are a quality family and they do it the old-fashioned way. I'm actually very happy for them, more than myself, because they have been very resilient. Dr. Dey, the father, was very instrumental in the New Jersey Horse

Park and agriculture in New Jersey. They go a little bit under the radar, but they have raised outstanding horses and get no credit for it. So, for them to sell one close to the sales-topper today, it's hats off to them.

"The Deys also bred the last one we sold, #167 as well," Reid said of Cassius, a Bettor's Delight colt out of Ambro Tussle that sold for \$135,000. "(Heritage Hill Farm) had a good day."

The Ice Dutchess is a full-sister to three-year-old filly Ice Attraction who has earned more than \$490,000 lifetime

under the tutelage and steering of Ake Svanstedt. Ice Attraction won the Kentucky Filly Futurity, was second in the Breeders Crown won by Ariana G and just won the \$140,000 Crossroads on Saturday at Hoosier Park.

While Reid gave kudos to the Dey family for their patience and perseverance, Beelby was also thanking Floren for his loyalty, as well.

Both Beelby and Floren originally call western Canada home. Though the two did not have horses together out west, Beelby is a former top trainer in Alberta who moved east 21 years ago.

“(Floren) was racing in BC when I was out west. Coincidentally, he moved to Ontario the same month that I did,” Beelby said. “The trainer he had out there, he asked him who he recommended and my name came up and we’ve been together ever since.”

Reid said the theme of loyalty was “one of those things where you need everything to line up and today was the day that it lined up and I couldn’t be happier for all parties... including the purchaser John Floren.”

Beelby said Floren picked The Ice Dutchess out and the trainer “just gave him the thumbs up” after checking out the

filly.

"I'm not sure who else was bidding on her, but there were bids coming from everywhere. I didn't think she'd sell that strong, but I've always underestimated," Beelby said, laughing.

"She has a great video, is a nice racehorse size and just overall a beautiful filly."

Beelby said neither he nor Floren had any connection to The Ice Dutchess' family in the past. The chief attraction was her sire, Muscle Hill, the trainer said.

The sire dominated day one in both gross (over \$3.1 million) and average (\$148,762) for 21 yearlings sold. Six of the seven highest-priced yearlings sold were sired by Muscle Hill.

"Certainly, anything by Muscle Hill was beyond imagination," Spears said.

Somebeachsomewhere was next on the sire list with a gross of \$2.33 million and an average of \$83,321 for 28 sold. First-crop sire Captaintreacherous had 33 yearlings fetch \$1,852,00 in total for an average of \$56,121.

"I think the buyers are happy with the Captaintreacherouses, but they are looking for him to prove himself. They didn't go off the wall," Spears said.

Harness racing's long-time leading breeder, Hanover Shoe Farms, led all consignors in the opening session with a gross of \$4,122,000 for 56 yearlings sold. Hanover yearlings averaged \$73,607 on day one. Concord Stud Farm, agent, was second in gross sales with \$1,667,000 for 20 sold, followed by Preferred (\$1,159,000 for 19 sold) and Fair Winds Farm Inc. of New Jersey that grossed \$1,027,000 for seven yearlings sold for a whopping average of \$146,714.

Twenty horses apart, Fair Winds sold the third and fourth highest priced yearlings — the Muscle Hill colt out of Bluff named Summit In Sight to Story Inc. of Millstone Twp, NJ for \$300,000 and the Muscle Hill filly out of Armbro Déjà Vu named Personal Paradise to Svanstedt for \$265,000.

Fair Winds owner Mark Mullen said Barry Goldstein gets the credit for breeding Summit In Sight.

"I bought the mare in foal from Barry Goldstein. He sold the mare and I bought her for \$120,000," Mullen said. "She delivered this Muscle Hill colt and it was a good-looking horse. As time went, weeks and months before the sale, he was shaping up and looking better and better. He was just a little gawky yearling foal, but he matured into a very athletic individual. Everybody was pouring all over him.

"Everybody was looking at him like crazy and being

complimentary of him, but you still don't know how the numbers are going to go. I was thinking maybe \$150,000 or something. They scrutinized the horse, they scrutinized the pedigree, they x-rayed him from stem to stern, but you don't know at the end of the day how it's going to unfold... I got my \$120,000 back and I'm happy."

Mullen was also hopeful for a good day during today's session.

"I have a Chapter Seven (selling Tuesday) that people are pouring over because there are very few Chapter Sevens. It's a colt, the fourth foal out of the mare, but everyone is interested in Chapter Seven and there's not many in the sale. It's out of Ken Warkentin mare, which is the same cross as Walner.

"Of course, I culled the mare after getting this yearling, so the mare is gone, but it guarantees that this one should sell well and perform well," Mullen said, laughing. "That's how it goes. The buyer gets the benefit of me having gotten rid of the mare."

Spears predicted the final two yearling sessions would be strong.

"I think that compared to last year, we certainly cut a lot off the bottom end, so I think Tuesday and Wednesday will be stronger than last year and we'll hope the sales prove that (Tuesday)," he said.

Post-Crown Driver Trends

Following the Breeders Crown, which drivers are trending up, which are down and which are consistent compared to the same time last year?

Trending Up

Jason Bartlett, who earns almost all of his money at Yonkers Raceway and in the NYSS, is now second on the earnings list, after leading until Breeders Crown weekend. Bartlett expanded his role in the NYSS this year, topping the ledger with \$1.3 million. He and Gingras were the only ones to cross the \$10 million threshold by Nov. 1. Bartlett drove in 3 per cent more races and saw his wins remain the same, but his earnings were up an impressive \$2.7 million, or 25 per cent, from the same period in 2016.

Jordan Stratton is having a spectacular year. His wins and money are both up an eye opening 41 per cent over the same period last year. And his UDRS rose from 0.242 to 0.287. Stratton is the number two driver at Yonkers. He was

17th on the earnings list on November 1st 2016. He was number five this year.

Aaron Merriman led the dash race by a ridiculous 362 wins through 10 months of 2017. He had 906 wins on 3,910 drives. His drives were up 11 per cent; his wins were more than 12 per cent ahead of 2016; and his earnings were up by more than 14 per cent--a million dollars. Merriman moved up from 9th to 7th on the money list. His UDRS remained strong as it rose from 0.343 to 0.367. The top driver at Northfield and number two at The Meadows is having a tremendous year.

George Brennan, who was voted DOY in 2010 and 2011, is having a terrific year at Yonkers Raceway. His wins are up 19 per cent and his earnings have increased by 30 per cent on 10 per cent more drives. The number three driver at Yonkers, where he moved in late 2010, Brennan moved up from 16th at this point last year to 8th.

Trace Tetrick, the top driver at Hoosier Park, moved from 14 to 11. His wins increased by 16 per cent and his money by 18 per cent on the same number of drives. Tetrick recently won divisions of the Breeders Crown with Fiftydallabill and Blazin Britches. His UDRS rose from 0.295 to 0.331.

Dan Dube, the number five driver at Yonkers, who was successful with Levy and Franklin winner Keystone Velocity and BC winner Emoticon Hanover, rose from 14 to 9. Dube drove in 11 per cent fewer races and saw his wins drop by 27 per cent, but his earnings were up by \$287,000, or 13 per cent.

Andy Miller is having a very good year. He moved from number 28 on Nov. 1, 2016 to 15 this year. His wife, Julie, is fifth on the trainers' list. Their sophomore trotter Devious Man is the richest in North America. Andy made 555 more starts this year, an increase of 23 per cent. He won 133 more races—up 45 per cent. And his earnings increased by \$1.7 million — 33 per cent. Andy's UDRS rose from 0.262 to 0.338.

Doug McNair, who won a Breeders Crown division with the freshman colt Stay Hungry, moved up from number 30 last year to 19. The leading driver in Canada made 9 per cent more drives, upped his win total by 27 per cent and increased his earnings by \$1.2 million, or 27 per cent. McNair was the top driver on the WEG circuit and number three in the OSS.

Andrew McCarthy moved up five spots to number 20. His starts and wins were down 10 per cent and 5 per cent, respectively, but his earnings stepped up by 17 per cent. He's fourth at Harrah's and eighth at Pocono Downs. Jugette winner Caviart Ally did well for him.

Jimmy Marohn, who was the top driver at The

Two-time reigning Driver of the Year David Miller is having a bit of an off year compared to his terrific 2016 season.

Meadowlands earlier in the year, and is number two at Pocono Downs of late, moved up from 38 to number 22. His wins were up 14 per cent and his earnings 31 per cent on 4 per cent more drives.

Brent Holland, who didn't make the top 50 last year, finished October at number 23. The fourth leading driver at Yonkers, his wins are already up 35 per cent and his money 40 per cent over his 2016 year-end totals.

Trevor Henry, who was number three on the WEG circuit during the first ten months of 2017, drove in 8 per cent fewer races and logged 6 per cent fewer wins, but his money was up by \$699,000, or 17 per cent. He went from number 27 last year to number 24.

Louis P Roy, who made his debut as a regular on the WEG circuit this year, hit Nov. 1 as the number 25 driver. He was second at Woodbine-Mohawk and number six in the OSS.

Yannick Gingras, who was voted Driver of the Year in 2014, should be favored to win that award again in 2017. Comparing his performance during the first 10 months of 2016 and 2017, his wins were the same, while his earnings were down \$75,000, or one per cent. Generally, Gingras ascends to the top of the earnings list in August, but this

year Jason Bartlett held on until October. Right now the three favorites for Horse of the Year are Ariana G, Hannelore Hanover and Manchego; Yannick drives all of them. This in addition to Filibuster Hanover, You Know You Do, Lady Shadow, Idyllic and Crazy Wow. His main sources for quality drives are Ron Burke and Jimmy Takter. Burke is right in step with his 2016 pace, while Takter, despite Ariana G and Manchego, is well short of last year's earnings through October. Despite being the leading money winner, Gingras failed to appear on the DOY ballot last year.

Trending Down

Tim Tetrick, who just became the 12th driver to win 10,000 races, is third on the earnings list, just as he was at this point in 2016. He took time off during the winter so his starts were down by 371, or 14 per cent. As a result, his wins also dropped by 14 per cent. Tim's money was off by \$531,000, which translates to 5 per cent in his case. He's number two at Harrah's. Nike Franco proved to be a pleasant surprise, but losing Walner so early in the season hurt.

George Napolitano Jr, the king of Pocono Downs and Harrah's, is another snow bird. He drove in 278 fewer races this year, a 9 per cent reduction. His wins were off 9 per cent and his earnings 6 per cent. GNap, who is a distant second to Merriman on the dash list, dropped from 11 to 13.

Mark MacDonald, who is number six at Yonkers and Number five in the NYSS, had 35 fewer wins and saw his earnings drop by 3 per cent. He got to drive some good horses for Jimmy Takter, leading to a BC win with Pure Country. However, Obrigado, who earned \$873,000 last year as a division winner, was zip for six with earnings of \$109,000.

David Miller, the DOY the past two years, is in fourth place on the money list, two spots lower than last year. He took the winter off so he made 186 fewer starts than he did in 2016—that's 17 per cent fewer. Hence, his wins were down by the same percentage. David's earnings are down \$1.3 million, or 12 per cent. His UDRS dropped from 0.324 to 0.306. He drives What the Hill, who was disqualified in the Hambletonian but subsequently won the CTC and BC. Always B Miki, who earned \$1.4 million for him last year, has been retired. Fear The Dragon leads the all-horse money list, but he finished eighth in his BC elimination, after winning the Tattersalls Pace and finishing fourth in the Jug. HOY honors no longer seem likely. What The Hill and Agent Q are favored in Saturday's Erskine and USS Indy. With Yannick leading the earnings list and serving as driver of the top three HOY candidate, it's hard to see David repeating as Driver of the Year.

Matt Kakaley is having another solid campaign.

Scott Zeron, who appeared on the DOY ballot in 2016, drove in 277 fewer races – 14 per cent – and saw his win total drop by 73, or 26 per cent. His money was off by \$1.2 million, or 15 per cent. Marion Marauder has banked \$715,000 less this year than last.

Brian Sears, who dropped from eight to 12, missed the first third of the season due to eye surgery. He made 347 fewer drives – 22 per cent – and logged 39 per cent fewer wins than he did during this stretch of 2016. His earnings are off by \$734,000, or 21 per cent. His UDRS fell from 0.305 to 0.269. Sears, who drove Downbytheseaside and Fourth Dimension, is seventh at Yonkers and third in the NYSS.

Chris Page dropped three spots to 16. His wins were down 15 per cent and his money off 8 per cent on 5 per cent fewer drives. He was the top driver at Scioto Downs. Thirty-three-year-old Page got win number 4,000 at Northfield on Monday.

Brett Miller, who engineered an upset win with Split The House in the Breeders Crown, fell from number six to number 17. Last year he had Racing Hill, the richest sophomore pacing colt in North America, with earnings of

\$1.5 million. His number of wins was about the same but his earnings were off by \$2.2 million, or 31 per cent. Miller has also been driving Homicide Hunter and Tequila Monday.

Trending Steady

Matt Kakaley, who won the Dan Rooney and Hoosier Park Pacing Derby with All Bets Off, rose one spot, from seven to six. His starts were down by 2 per cent but he won 19 per cent more races. And his earnings were off by 8 per cent. He also drives Filibuster Hanover and Miso Fast, and was an upset winner of the Kentucky Futurity with Snowstorm Hanover.

Corey Callahan, is at number ten, just as he was last year. The leading driver at Dover Downs, his starts rose slightly, while his wins were up 9 per cent and his money 5 per cent. Driving for John Butenschoen accounted for much of his success. Funknwaffles was one of his better charges.

Ronnie Wrenn Jr went from 20 to 21. His wins were off 15 per cent but his earnings only dropped 1 per cent. Wrenn is number two at Northfield.
