# Muscle Hill prices continue to soar

*Stallion shares in the outstanding trotting sire sold for big bucks Thursday in the opening session of the Standardbred Horse Sale Company's Mixed Sale that was dominated by broodmares.*

**Stallion shares for the great trotter Muscle Hill sold for \$175,000 and \$170,000, respectively, which is believed to be a record.**

Muscle Hill's dominance of the trotting marketing continued Thursday (Nov. 10) during the opening Mixed session of the Standardbred Horse Sale at the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex in Harrisburg. Two sets of Muscle Hill stallion shares, both sold by Concord Stud, fetched \$175,000 and \$170,000, respectively.

Preferred Equine Marketing's David Reid said he thought it was a record price for a stallion share sold at auction.

"Obviously, he's a dominant sire, but that's a strong price. Not that he doesn't warrant it, but that could be a record," Reid said.

Hanover Shoe Farms paid \$175,000 to purchase the first Muscle Hill stallion share offered. The other went to Reijo

"In Europe there's two sires they really desire: Muscle Hill here and Ready Cash over there," Reid said. "There's two dominant trotting sires in the world right now and they paid for one of them today."

Otherwise, Thursday's session was dominated by broodmares.

"On a day like today, we saw the people who brought yearlings to sell, especially if they had a good sale, reinvesting," sale vice-president Russell Williams told Ellen Harvey of Harness Racing Communications. "They went from consigner to customer; they were buying. A couple hundred thousand is a good price for a broodmare. I would never sell a broodmare anywhere else but Harrisburg."

**Steve Stewart continues to improve Hunterton Farms' broodmare band. He purchased the session topper,**

The session topper was mare Satin Pillows purchased for \$250,000 by Steve Stewart of Hunterton Farm from the Peninsula Farms consignment.

The 11-year-old daughter of **Conway Hall** out of Bold Dreamer is a half-sister to Pampered Princess, two-time divisional champion, and the dam of Breeders Crown and divisional champion To Dream On (1:52.1, \$975,395). She is in foal to **Cantab Hall**.

"Where we have made our most money, Pizza Dolce, Southwind Serena, Graceful Touch, Emilie Cas El – (broodmares) have been the best," Stewart said. "That's what we are trying to do, playing at the top level with one of the best. We were very surprised that we bought her for that price. We were ready to go

quite a few more (bids). If you can play at that level, that is where you need to try to play. It's worked out for us and she will be a great addition to the other girls at the farm."

Satin Pillows had a 2016 colt by **Muscle Hill** who died, but Stewart is inclined to breed her to Muscle Hill again in 2017.

"I was told by Carter (Duer, of Peninsula Farms) that the foal was spectacular," Stewart said. "She's had some bad luck, but hopefully now that will work out better for us. She will be very happy."

Peninsula also sold the second-highest priced mare sold Thursday when Hanover Shoe Farms paid \$160,000 for Cedar Dove, a daughter of Andover Hall out of Pine For Her. Cedar Dove was the 2011 divisional champion and sports career earnings of nearly \$1.2 million and a mark of 1:52.3.

"She was a great mare, a lot of name recognition and a great-looking mare," said Hanover farm manager Dr. Bridgette Jablonsky. "I like the fact that she's in foal to **Explosive Matter** because he never had a mare bred like that to him, so I'm excited to sell the best-bred Explosive Matter (progeny) ever... She has a Muscle Hill weanling and it probably would be nice to breed her back to Muscle Hill."

Sugar Wheeler will go right back where she started from,

selling for \$150,000 from the Concord Stud Farm consignment as agent for the estate of Bill Weaver and partners Wellwood, Hainsworth and Kelley. She was bought back for the farm, with the sales ticket signed by Julie Meirs.

Her 2016 yearling colt by Muscle Hill sold on Monday for \$400,000 and the current weanling colt by Kadabra sold for \$60,000 to Thomas Dillon just minutes before the mare sold.

"We did not have the intention (to try to buy her) at all," Meirs said. "We sold her \$400,000 Muscle Hill colt earlier in the week, so you have to do a double-take on looking at her that way. We had a good sale and needed to make sure we put something back in to the broodmare band every year that will continue to produce those yearlings that everyone's looking for, so we thought that she would be one to get. She had a nice-looking Kadabra weanling here so we will see what happens."

"It will be nice to have one of the mares that we've had on the farm for Mr. Weaver and his partners," added her father, David Meirs III. "They were family for us and we have one of the better ones now."

At the other end of the price spectrum, the 21-year-old Neverhave neverwill, Hip No. 1249, sold for \$2,000 as the

third from last sale of the day, to Mitchel Skolnick of Bluestone Farm.

The grey mare is the dam of **Always A Virgin** (1:48.4, \$1,135,559) and thus granddam of the fastest Standardbred in history, **Always B Miki** (1:46, \$2,519,368). Skolnick is a partner on both **Always A Virgin** and **Always B Miki**.

"She will go out in the field and she'll live out the rest of her life," Skolnick said. "She won't be bred. I was told she did a great job for us; she gave us **Always A Virgin**. I didn't come here thinking I was going to buy her. I was told I was going to buy her by a lot of bleeding heart employees (Emily Homan and Kelly Deitweiller).

Today, in the final Standardbred Horse Sale session, the racehorses will take the ring to round out a sale that has

proven to be one of the best in Harrisburg in many years.

"I'm really looking forward to (today)," Reid said. "I think I have a lot of outstanding prospects, a little bit of everything, I've got some nice two-year-old racehorses. I've got very well-bred fabulous fillies. I've got some very good three-year-old pacing and trotting colts and some outstanding aged performers.

"I'm looking forward to capping off a week that you have to assume sale management is very happy with the outcome."

## Boston Red Rocks, Pure Country, Caprice Hill and Dayson take Matron finals

Boston Red Rocks, Pure Country, Caprice Hill and Dayson were all winners of Matron three-year-old finals Thursday (Nov. 10) at Dover Downs.

Boston Red Rocks, the 2015 USHWA Two-Year-Old Pacer of the Year, came from off to pace to get the lead on the final turn and scooted to a 1:49.3 victory in the \$160,200 Matron for sophomore pacing colts. It was his fifth win of the season for trainer Steve Elliott and owns Peter Blood and Rick Berks. It was winning driver Tim Tetrick's third of five wins of the night. The victory boosts the Rocknroll Hanover—McGibson colt's earnings to \$382,055 this year and \$961,260 lifetime.

Brett Miller and Diamond Creek's homebred Pure Country, arguably the sport's leading sophomore filly pacer, chalked up her 10th win of 2016 by overpowering seven distaffs in 1:50.2 to win the \$148,400 Matron and improve her lifetime bankroll to \$1.7 million and her seasonal earnings to \$1,082,430 for trainer Jimmy Takter. In Matron trots, Tom Hill's Caprice Hill received a well-timed drive from Hall of Famer Brian Sears to record a 1:52.3 triumph in the \$149,000 Matron Filly Trot. The win put the Kadabra—Bramasole filly over the half-million mark this year and just shy of six-figures in her career. All The Time, piloted by Yannick Gingras, was runner-up. Non Stick and Ake Svanstedt, took show honors.

Gingras and New York Sire Stakes standout Dayson won for

the 12th time in 19 starts this season recording a 1:53 score in the \$178,650 Matron Colt Trot. Ron Burke conditions the Conway Hall—Nervey's Taurus gelding for Our Hrs Cents and J&T Silva and Burke Racing stables. The win lifted his purse total to \$479,508 this year. Double L Lindy and Ake Svanstedt finished second in front of Lagerfeld handled by Hall of Famer David Miller, third.

Montrell Teague drove three Delaware Standardbred Breeders Fund freshmen winners, all sired by George Teague \$1 million winners, and trained by Clyde Francis, to

impressive victories.

Henry The Dragon by Custard The Dragon—Surveille Hanover, won his fifth in-a-row in an unbeaten start, easily outdistancing Automatic Dragon (Tetrick) and Hallie's Comet (Ross Wolfenden)

## Always B Miki set to join elite class

Assuming Always B Miki wins the TVG Final Saturday night at the Meadowlands and if he's named Horse Of The Year, he'll join a list of super-notables that met the following criteria: Triple Crown winner or world record holder/setter who were named Horse of the Year and scored a win in New Jersey in their last career start.

In 1984, John Henry won his last start at the Meadowlands on the Turf in the Ballantines Scotch Classic on Oct. 13 for a \$400,000 purse, plus a \$500,000 bonus for winning the Turf Race in New York, also. The nine-year-old gelding improved to \$6.597 million – the highest ever for a racehorse – was named HOY for the second time and never did race again.

In 1985, Nihilator won the Breeders Crown on Nov. 29 at Garden State Park to cap off a HOY season.

In 2003, No Pan Intended wrapped up his super season with a Breeders Crown triumph at the Meadowlands and became the only horse ever to double up in the Breeders Crown and the Triple Crown.

In 2005, Rocknroll Hanover won the Breeders Crown at the Meadowlands and waltzed to a Horse Of The Year coronation. He then stayed in Jersey to stand at Perretti's and embark on a fabulous stallion career.

In 2008 Somebeachsomewhere, won the Breeders Crown at the Meadowlands, wrapped up the HOY and sailed off to become the number one pacing sire in the sport in 2016.

### If Miki is HOY...

... It will be the first time since 2008 that the fastest horse of that year will have been so honored (Somebeachsomewhere in 1:46.4 in 2008).

... It will be the 24th consecutive year that a different stallion (Always A Virgin in Always B Miki's case) would have had the best at years end. The last time a sire repeated was 1991 and 1994. Cam Fella did it with both Precious Bunny and Cams Card Shark. (Note that Speedy Crown repeated

also, but with the same horse 1998-1999 with Moni Maker)

... It will be the first time since Adios Butler in 1961 that a five-year-old pacing stallion was so honored.

... It will give Jimmy Takter three HOY credits before going into the Hall Of Fame and his first after.

... and Wiggle It Jiggleit and Hannelore Hanover are in the top three for HOY, it would give Indiana-breds a clean sweep going into the Hoosier Park Breeders Crown debut year.

... Part-owner Bob Boni can say he's seen this before. In 1985, he also raced Nihilator, who called it a career with a win in the Breeders Crown, and he too was the fastest racehorse of all time by virtue of his 1:49.3 at the Meadowlands just three months earlier (August)

### Finally

The year will end with two trainers from Sweden having conditioned the fastest ever trotter and the pacer. Ake Svanstedt with Sebastian K in 1:49 and Takter with Always B Miki in 1:46.

## Evaluating Harrisburg Pacing Sires

*A look at how the pacing sires fared at the Standardbred Horse Sales Company's yearling sale.*

Fifty-three percent of the yearlings sold in Harrisburg were by sires standing in Pennsylvania, so it's no surprise that Hanover's **Somebeachsomewhere** topped the ledger on the pacing side. Sixty of them averaged \$74,400, up eight per cent over last year, when a politically induced cloud hung over the proceedings. The son of Mach Three sold 21 fewer for a \$123,615 average in Lexington. Fifteen of them brought at least \$100,000 (25 per cent), with a pair topping \$200,000. Contrast that with last year when six beat \$100,000. Thirty-nine, or 65 per cent, of the 60 sold brought at least \$50,000, while 52 of them beat \$25,000. The sire of Huntsville, Downbytheseaside, Check Six, Pure Country and Darlinonthebeach had a very good sale.

The 14-year-old New York sire, **American Ideal**, averaged \$48,946 for 37 sold. A colt and four fillies, 11 per cent, brought \$100,000 or more, while almost a quarter of them topped \$50,000. Twenty-six of the 37 beat \$25,000. The sire of Funknwaffles, He's Watching and Heston Blue Chip led the NYSS in both the two and three-year-old classes this year. Last year's average jumped 28 per cent from 2014 and it's up another 31 per cent this week.

Seventeen-year-old **Mach Three** sold 10 yearlings this year, the same number as 2015 when his average increased by 38 per cent. While he averaged a healthy \$44,900 this week, it represents a 14 per cent drop from last year. Mach Three

sold 47 in Harrisburg in 2014 so his presence has been reduced. Last year 70 per cent topped \$25,000; this year it was 90 per cent. Consistency is the trademark of the leading 2016 pacing sire in the Ontario program.

The eight-year-old New York sire **Roll With Joe** saw his average increase 20 per cent from last year to \$39,887 for 21 sold. The sire of Racing Hill, who occupies the number two slot on the all horse earning's list, experienced a similar sale pattern to 2015. One topped \$100,000; five beat \$50,000; and 66 per cent sold for at least \$25,000. Joe's 2017 stud fee will increase by a third to \$7,500.

**Art Major**, another New Yorker, sold 31 for an average of \$38,371, down 6.5 per cent from 2015. He also sold 31 in Lexington, for about the same average. Twelve, or 39 per cent, topped \$50,000 this week, but 32 per cent of them failed to exceed \$25,000. Seventeen-year-old Art Major saw his fee drop 17 per cent to \$10,000 in 2016. The sire of Roaring To Go ranked third in both classes of the NYSS.

**Bettor's Delight**, who is second on the all pacer money list in 2016, presented a large offering of 58 that averaged \$36,466. The 18-year-old sire of Betting Line and LA Delight has never sold as well as his offspring race. This crop, like last year's, is Pennsylvania eligible. His average is up 16 per cent over last year when it was down 27 per cent from 2014 when he was still enrolled in the Ontario program. Again, there was political trouble last year. Three colts, or five per cent of this year's offering, topped \$100,000. That's a little light for a sire of his stature. Ten, or 17 per cent, beat \$50,000. That's also a little light. And 57 per cent topped \$25,000. He fared much better in Lexington where 29 averaged \$55,655. Bettor's Delight's 2017 fee has been increased from \$12,000 (Cdn) to \$15,000 (Cdn).

**Shadow Play** outdid his provincial rival Sportswriter by \$244 in their respective averages, as he came in at \$36,458 for 24 sold. At Lexington, it was Sportswriter who developed an average that was \$378 better. This is a huge improvement of 50 per cent over last year when five of 13 failed to top \$15,000. The 11-year-old sire of world champion Lady Shadow sold a pair for at least \$100,000. A quarter of them beat \$50,000 and more than 62 per cent brought at least \$25,000. Shadow Play only sold five in Lexington but he showed a 35 per cent increase in his average over 2015. There were some dead years after his initial success, but he seems to be back in favor with the buyers. Sporty lover Casie Coleman bought four Shadow Plays in Pennsylvania.

**Sportswriter**, the nine-year-old sire of Sports Column, averaged \$36,214 for 28 sold. That's down 24 per cent from



what his small nine-horse offering averaged last year, and down 34 per cent from what he sold nine for in Lexington last month. In Harrisburg 10, or 36 per cent, topped \$50,000, while 69 per cent of them beat \$25,000. Unlike Shadow Play, there were no six figure sales. Coleman bought five of them.

Ten-year-old **Well Said** has been afforded every opportunity to live up to his on track performance during his second career but with four crops racing it simply hasn't happened, and that fact is reflected in the numbers. Fifty-eight per cent of the 52 sold in Harrisburg failed to top \$25,000. His average of \$31,183 was up 6.5 per cent over 2015 when he sold 61 here. He's a high-volume sire, but that isn't always a good thing. A pair topped \$100,000 and 21 per cent beat \$50,000. His best son, Meadowlands Pace winner Control The Moment, will stand in Ontario for \$6,000 this year. Well Said's fee was cut in half to \$7,500 in 2016.

**Western Ideal** saw 23 average a disappointing \$28,304, down almost 15 per cent from last year, when he was off 10 per cent from 2014. Eleven of his 12 fillies failed to top \$25,000. Only three, or 13 per cent, beat \$50,000. More than 56 per cent failed to exceed \$25,000. The 21-year-old sire of Rocknroll Hanover and Artspeak stood for \$7,500 in Pennsylvania in 2016.

**Rock N Roll Heaven** is in the same boat: despite a few successful fillies, like Sassa Hanover and Divine Caroline, it just hasn't happened for him. This is a New York crop but he now resides in New Jersey. Twenty-seven averaged \$27,444. Forty-four per cent of them failed to top \$25,000; one beat \$100,000; while five exceeded \$50,000. This is up more than

36 per cent from last year when 38 averaged a disappointing \$17,447 in Harrisburg. He'll have another New York crop next year before switching to New Jersey eligibility. It's hard to see how that will help.

Seven-year-old world champion **A Rocknroll Dance** got a chilly reception for his first crop in Harrisburg. Twenty-five averaged \$22,120. One topped \$50,000; nine beat \$25,000; and 67 per cent of them failed to crack \$25,000.

**Betterthancheddar** is another first crop sire who failed to elicit a warm embrace from buyers. Nine from his only New York crop averaged \$19,722. Seventy-eight per cent of them failed to top \$25,000. Contrast that with his excellent \$50,875 average for eight sold in Lexington. Three-quarters of them topped \$50,000. Go figure? The son of Bettor's Delight stands in Ontario for \$3,500 (Cdn).

Twenty-one-year old **Artiscape** saw seven average \$17,286. Eighty-six per cent failed to beat \$25,000. He stands in New York for \$4,000.

**So Surreal**, the first son of SBSW to arrive at the yearling sales, is a head scratcher. The five-year-old saw 11 average an underwhelming \$12,091, and that's with a \$42,000 outlier thrown into the mix. Needless to say, the other 10 failed to top \$25,000. As is the case with Betterthancheddar, we have an inconsistent situation, as three colts and a filly by the half

## Yonkers' own a racehorse program already a success for new owners

All of the potential rewards of owning a standardbred, none of the risk.

For 10 fans, that seemingly too-good-to-be-true proposition became reality when each was given a five per cent stake in Emerald Chip, a three-year-old trotter competing at Yonkers Raceway. The promotion represents a joint effort by the Standardbred Owners Association of New York and the track.

To make matters even sweeter for those enjoying the rare free ride, favored Emerald Chip, driven by Daniel Dube, drew the rail and was much the best in the third race at Yonkers Tuesday (Nov. 8). His victory in the conditioned event allowed

him to bring home half of the \$20,000 purse for trainer Andrew Harris and his new "owners."

The initiative underscores how much of a priority is being placed on attracting new owners.

"It's kind of a hands-on experience without the risk and a financial reward to keep their attention," said Joe Faraldo, president of the Standardbred Owners Association of New York.

Bob Galterio, general manager at Yonkers, noted how much the breeding and racing elements of the industry depend on those willing to risk disposable income. "It all comes down to

ownership,” Galterio said, “and we think that is where we can do our best job of promotion.”

The United States Trotting Association recently reached out via email to 219 people who had either dabbled as owners or expressed interest to offer the five per cent stake to the first 10 respondents. Jay McKenna, 63, of Merrimack, NH was skeptical at first.

“Nothing is for free,” he said.

But he had attended an owner’s seminar at the Meadowlands during the summer and everything about the email seemed legitimate. So he replied.

“To me, it was pretty unbelievable,” he said, “because you can own a piece of a horse without actually having to buy it.”

His new partners are Christopher Cox, Albert Fiorita, Dale Geruschat, Ken Hamilton, Doug Jefferis, Chris Kawolsky, Pat Liberatore, John McCormick and Luis Ravina. Three are from New York and three from Pennsylvania. New Hampshire and Ohio also are included.

According to Allison Conte of the United States Trotting Association, eight of them stemmed from social media in that they had completed an online form for more information about ownership. Two had attended seminars intended to attract new money.

The group will continue to have a stake in Emerald Chip through the end of the Yonkers meet on Dec. 18. Potential earnings are capped at \$10,000. They will receive copies of the bills incurred during that time for informational purposes only to help them to understand the kind of expenses associated with such a venture.

The SOA of New York and track management believe ownership is increasingly appealing because the success of Empire City Casino has led to a more rewarding purse structure than before.

“I tell people all the time that purses drive the game,” Faraldo said. “Without those purses, you don’t even have a game because no one is interested in taking the financial risk of ownership if the purse structure is not correct.

“The purse structure here at Yonkers does not eliminate, but it minimizes the risk someone can have in this game. There is an opportunity to make money by owning on a regular basis.”

Galterio did not mince words in describing the advantages he believes Yonkers has over tracks that do not benefit from casino revenue. “If you have any interest in owning standardbreds and you are not racing them at Yonkers,” he said, “you are crazy.”

Harris oversees a barn of 35 standardbreds that compete in

New Jersey, New York and Pennsylvania depending on how well the horse fits different tracks – some horses do not take to Yonkers’ half-mile oval – and the level of competition offered. He readily agreed to participate when he was approached about the program.

“We don’t have any young owners in this game,” said Harris, 31. “We have some great owners in this business, don’t get me wrong, but they are a lot older. We need to spur the younger generation to get into ownership.”

Harris noted the advantages partnerships can offer by limiting an individual’s risk and possibly creating an experience with multiple horses. “It’s really hard to own a horse by yourself,” he said. “But if you get involved with four or five guys, it’s really very affordable. We are trying to show them it is very affordable and it can be an amazing experience.”

Geruschat, 47, a Federal Express employee from Monaca, PA, can attest to that after watching Emerald Chip provide him with an immediate reward via the internet. “It doesn’t matter if you have one per cent or five per cent,” he said. “It’s a great feeling whenever your horse wins.”

Kawolsky, 53, from Rochester, NY, said his ownership experience allowed him to check off an item on his bucket list. He hopes to be viewed as a “mini-ambassador” for a sport that has interested him since he was a teenager attending races at Quad City Downs in Moline, IL.

It is uncertain whether the promotion will be repeated.

“We may do it again even if we don’t see immediate results from it,” Faraldo said.
