It was a sweet ending to an incredible racing career for Alway B Miki, the fastest horse in history.

Always B Miki (\$2.10) will always be remembered as a champion.

The fastest pacer in the history of harness racing capped his career in triumphant fashion, using a sustained first-over bid to overpower All Bets Off and sprint off to a 1:48.2 victory in the \$400,000 TVG Free-For-All Pace on Saturday (Nov. 12) evening at The Meadowlands.



David Miller moved Always B Miki first-over out of midfield after patiently stalking sizzling fractions of :25.4 and :54.1, making gradual gains into pacesetter All Bets Off (Matt Kakaley) through the far turn. The five-year-old son of Always A Virgin—Artstopper pushed to the fore in upper stretch, leaving All Bets Off well in his wake and evading eventual runner-up Mach It So (Tim Tetrick) by four-and-a-quarter lengths. Melmerby Beach (Marcus Miller) benefitted from the outer flow and saved third with a mild stand-side push over the tiring All Bets Off.

Miller and trainer Jimmy Takter had nothing but glowing reports of Always B Miki's curtain call.

"When I asked him, he took right off," said Miller. "Jimmy (Takter) has done a great job keeping him good all year, and I tell you what, he's good today as he's been all year. He's an incredible horse; he's a true champion."

"It's a wonderful feeling standing here at our home track," said Takter. "He's just a wonderful horse to be around. He's so personable, anybody working with this horse just would love him.

"It's nice to quit on the top, too. This horse has a future ahead of him, and it's going to be very, very exciting to train his offspring."

Always B Miki wraps up his racing career with 30 wins in 53 starts -12 of those wins coming this year - as well as \$2,719,368 in earnings for the Bluewood Stable, the Roll the Dice Stable, and Christina Takter.

The pacer, who recorded the fastest mile in history when he won in 1:46 in October at Red Mile, now goes to stud duty at Diamond Creek Farm in Pennsylvania.





Hannelore Hanover prevails again in mares trot

In the \$200,000 TVG for trotting mares (race 4), Hannelore Hanover (\$3.60) rallied from off the pace to once again defeat Bee a Magician, vaulting home and reeling in the quadruple millionaire for a 1:51.4 score. Yannick Gingras settled the four-year-old Swan for All—High Sobriety mare well off a contested pace before sliding second-over behind Shake It Cerry (David Miller) on approach to the far turn. After she was carried into the mid-division, Hannelore Hanover angled three-wide off the far turn and found her best strides in the final eighth of a mile, charging home to collar Bee a Magician (Brian Sears) just inside the sixteenth pole and draw clear by one-and-three-quarter lengths. D'One (Tetrick) held third from a pocket trip, but was four lengths detached from the top pair.

Ron Burke trains 26-time winner Hannelore Hanover for the Burke Racing Stable, the Weaver Bruscemi partnership, Frank Baldachino, and the J&T Silva Stables.

Lady Shadow sustains first-over in mares pace

Lady Shadow (\$2.40) used nearly identical tactics as Always B Miki en route to her 1:50 win in the \$200,000 TVG for pacing mares (race 8), grinding down rival Solar Sister and evading the late-emerging Bedroomconfessions by one-and-a-half lengths. The five-year-old Shadow Play—Lady Caella mare earned her 12th win of the season for trainer Ron Adams and the partnership of David Kryway, Carl Atley, Ed Gold, and the BFJ Stable, emerging off the pegs out of midfield as Solar Sister (Sears) brushed into a :54.3 half mile and working to the fore with just over a quarter mile remaining. After wearing down Solar Sister, Lady Shadow worked to gain separation on the field while Bedroomconfessions (Scott Zeron), who knifed through traffic to just capture second from a staying Sassa Hanover (Matt Kakaley). Gingras earned a stakes driving double on the night with Lady Shadow.

Obrigado outlasts barrage of pressure, upsets in TVG trot

Obrigado (\$19.80), one of two of the eight in the \$400,000 TVG Free-For-All Trot (race 10) to have not contested a Breeders Crown event two weeks ago, sought control of the terms early and dug in to parry a barrage of pressure in a

compelling race which saw the entire octet covered by two lengths at the winning post. The six-year-old Boy Band—Malimony gelding pushed clear of JL Cruze (John Campbell) following a :27.2 initial quarter and worked to stave off the first-over threat of three-year-old Crown champion Bar Hopping (Tetrick) through the far turn. Upon straightening for home, Mark MacDonald called upon Obrigado for every ounce of effort he had remaining, and the pair dug in to withstand a late three-wide charge from Crazy Wow (Gingras) by a nose in 1:52.4. Lookslikeachpndale (Zeron) charged down the grandstand side to take third over odds-on favorite Resolve (Åke Svanstedt), who only could muster fourth place from a third-over trip while only missing by a neck.

Trainer Paul Kelley shares ownership of Obrigado with the SRF Stable, Linwood Higgins, and Stable 45.

Total handle for the 12-race card was \$2,695,344.

A new look

The presidential results might offer a blueprint for our little racing community. The rewards go to the victor while modesty, logic and civility appear to have little influence in securing victory.

My values are not shared with my rowdy group of friends. Here are a few items in my closet.

Despite being under 40, somewhat sketchy and many laps from elite, my two favorite television shows are Charlie Rose and Masterpiece Theater. My ear buds are books. My preferred film genre is documentaries.

The mere use of the word "genre" could get me pummeled by my

crowd, who get their kicks by watching highly-rated programs like Sex Sent Me To The Emergency Room, My Tattoo Nightmare, Fox News or The Apprentice. People obviously prefer shows that are controversial and confrontational. Take a spin through your TV guide and Cineplex menu, you will see that serenity, discretion, politeness and reason do not sell, they are poor "revenue generators."

The paying public pays for loud soundtracks, violent crashes, sound bites and manufactured drama. This places activities like chess, Shakespeare and harness horse racing in a vexing pickle. Quiet pastimes sit there minding their own business and go nowhere. They watch other pastimes wrap themselves with outrageousness and titillating angles and go to the bank, maybe even to the oval office.

Take chess as an example. The golden age was when a strange, charismatic, rude, enigma named Bobby Fischer was playing. Chess was hot. Money was made. When the

confrontational Mr. Fischer exited the scene, chess interest faded.

Maybe it is time for the circus to visit the harness race industry. Sophistication and understatement are out. Outrageous is in. Bizarre stunts are news. Real is irrelevant. Wild is wonderful. These concepts may offend old time harness racing traditionalists but we have fewer of these each year. We need attention. Let's get started with the new program.

Drivers and trainers.

Any driver fortunate enough to have a camera aimed at him must remove their helmet and goggles so they do not look like spacemen. Those with hair should consider a bizarre comb over. Trainers should strive to be politically incorrect. Interviews should be spiced up and controversial. For example:



"I'm just looking for a good trip."

"It's a real nice horse."

"Got lucky, got a good trip."

"The trainer sure had the horse ready tonight."

Good interview quotes (These should be accompanied with wild gestures):

"Any fool looking for a hole will be waiting over two minutes." This comment should be followed with

muscle flexing and crazed looks.

"Let's see that cheating SOB race his so called stock out of a real detention barn." Finger pointed at camera, serious, angry glare."

The Races

Corporate sponsorship will be encouraged.

Every horse will have product decals on their flanks and shoulders. Local tracks will sell local sponsorship space that will be prominently displayed on the race horse - "Eat at Dung Foo's Wok and Roll Palace," "Call Reggie's Radiator Repair, a great place to take a leak," "Count on Buziniki Brothers Electricians, we remove shorts." The upper tier of harness racing will shoot for national sponsors such as Viagra or Volvo.

Exciting new harness racing series will be instituted.

"The Weakest Link Futurity" – Harness horses race eighth-of-a-mile, then stop, and the last place horse is then eliminated amid humiliation and sarcasm. This is repeated until one horse remains.

"The Jerry Springer Handicap" - The winner gets a free breeding to a famous stallion, or he can send a mare.

"The Survivor Series" - Horses and drivers must perform strange feats such as eating snakes and walking through huge piles of manure.

Hoosier Park concludes season; Burke and Tetrick win titles

Hoosier Park Racing & Casino concluded their 2016 harness racing season with a 14-race card in front of a packed house on Nov. 12. In addition to the racing action, Ron Burke and Trace Tetrick were recognized as the leading trainer and driver, respectively.

Burke, who secured his fifth consecutive and sixth leading trainer title at Hoosier Park, was officially recognized as the 2016 leading trainer of the season at Hoosier Park. The Burke barn had an impressive 89 trips to the winner's circle and amassed over \$2.6 million in purse earnings throughout the 160-day season. The Walter Haynes Jr. Stable finished second in the leading trainer standings with 71 trips to the Hoosier Park winner's circle this season.

Jamie Macomber, Burke's assistant trainer, oversees all training operations in Indiana and was in the winner's circle to accept the award from Jim Brown, Centaur Gaming's president and chief operating officer, and Rick Moore, Hoosier's vice president and general manager of racing.

"I don't want to sound like a broken record but it truly is a team effort," Rucker said. "We have a great team at the Burke Stable and that has made for a great year of racing. I know I speak on behalf of everyone involved with the Ron Burke Stable, it is always a pleasure racing at Hoosier Park. We had another great season this year, our team has worked hard all season and Ronnie (Burke) does a great job leading the way."

In the driving ranks, Trace Tetrick, who is now the all-time leading driver in Hoosier Park history, earned his fifth leading driver title and third consecutive title at Hoosier Park this season. Tetrick scored 372 wins and earned over \$3.6 million in purse earnings to secure the title over John DeLong, who finished second with 301 victories. Tetrick also earned a spot in Hoosier Park's record books as he re-established his own record for most wins in one season, a record that he previously set in 2015 with 325 victories.

The Southern Illinois native started driving in 2003 and has since surpassed the \$37 million mark in purse earnings

in the bike. With multiple stakes wins to his credit, Tetrick is on track to record his best season to date in 2016 with over \$5.4 million in purse earnings and counting. Tetrick is also closing in on career win 4,000.

"It's certainly an honor and a great accomplishment," Tetrick said in the winner's circle after accepting the trophy from Rod Ratcliff, Centaur Gaming's chairman and chief executive officer. "I would like to thank all the owners and trainers for the opportunity to drive great horses all season. It has been a great year and I really appreciate all the support from everyone. My family is the reason I am in the position I am in today, without them, none of this would be possible."

Moreau gets 5,000th training win

Richard Moreau celebrated a career milestone on Friday night (Nov. 11) at The Raceway at Western Fair District, earning his 5,000th training win.

Cavier Cartal and driver Alfie Carroll won the evening's fifth race conditioned trot to give Moreau his 5,000th career victory. The 3-5 favorite secured an early pocket trip, and after being shuffled to fourth while the outer flow developed, he closed through the passing lane to prevail by one and a half lengths in 2:03.1. Race leader Malia (Nick Steward) held off Typhoon Seelster (Garrett Rooney) for the runner-up honors.

Owned by Michel Baril of Mascouche, QC and Gabriel Moreau of Terrebonne, QC, the five-year-old Broadway Hall—Caviar And Pearls gelding has won two of his last three starts at The Raceway since joining the Moreau stable.

Moreau, Canada's three-time O'Brien Award-winning Trainer of the Year, continues to lead the national standings in 2016 with 224 wins and over \$3.5 million in purses. Lifetime, the Puslinch, ON-based horseman has trained winners of nearly \$45 million.

Moreau just earned the 2016 training title at Mohawk Racetrack. He also topped the trainer standings at Georgian Downs and is the current leader at Woodbine Racetrack and Flamboro Downs.

Faraldo responds to Towers' column

Dean Towers wrote on Nov. 7th entitled, "Joe and Jeff have more in common than we think," which was absolutely correct, that a thoughtful, respectful and honest discussion of the industry's challenges and opportunities is necessary to move New York harness racing forward. However, what was missing in this analysis of what Mr. Gural and I may or may not have "in common" is the fact that this important discussion has unfortunately been less of an interactive conversation between ownership and the horsemen and more a one-way monologue from Mr. Gural. The disparaging comment that an amateur race out handled the International Trot is just Yonkers' bashing and a flat out misstatement. Perhaps with the overpayment of the purse account last year at the Meadowlands, one might just chalk it up to an inability to do basic math.

So when Mr. Gural talks about the 10 per cent marketing fee he "helped to write into the law," he neglects to mention that when it comes to his tracks, he alone determines how this money is to be spent - with no interaction with or input from the horsemen and the money is not being used to promote racing. As Jeff likes to say, racino/casino operators are "not going to spend money promoting racing" despite the revenue multiples they receive as opposed to that of the horsemen. The use of the marketing fee is, no wonder, not done with oversight or accounting of the marketing funding or as a measure of its success/failure simply because it is not being done for racing. The interests and experiences of the men and women in the paddock who live racing every day and night are therefore not taken into account and so the much-needed "dialogue" once again reverts to nothing more than a monologue.

The fact is that owners and horsemen can, in fact, work collaboratively on issues ranging from marketing to drug testing, as evidenced by the significant successes the SOA

has achieved in partnership with the management at Yonkers Raceway. But what distinguishes this relationship is the respectful, two-way communication that occurs.

To Dean's most important point airing these facts and positions will bring more light than unwelcome heat to topics that could indeed be beneficial to our industry. New York State's harness horsemen have shown quite clearly that they can, and will, partner successfully with management on marketing initiatives and more, but at the end of the day there need to be two willing participants. Not one dictating the use of the others funds.

Hail to the fans

The op/ed piece by Bill Finley (HRU, Nov. 8) has driven me to write in response, something I have not done in years. He seemingly is the first to recognize that in addition to bettors, there truly are fans of harness racing. That is not to say that I do not wager, but whether I do or not, I love harness racing as a sport. I love its history and the halcyon glory days when neighbors raced one another on nearby dirt roads. Sadly, I believe the sport is once again headed in that direction.

By being a fan I mean that I own thousands of photos of past horses and drivers, thousands of race programs and thousands of books and magazines and countless other pieces of memorabilia related to the sport. I watch races on my computer several times per week and have relished every battle between Wiggle It Jiggleit and Always Be Miki. I want to argue that neither would beat Bret Hanover or Niatross.

It is the stars such as these that drive people to come to the races — and yes, wager. I know there is much money to be made in breeding — I have owned nine standardbreds over the years — but I really believe Jeff Gural has it right by encouraging owners to race four-year-olds before retiring. As an avid sports fan I can't imagine having Lebron James, Tom Brady or Mike Trout retire after two seasons. These sports would be crippled if that occurred.

For full disclosure, I served as executive director of the Maine Harness Racing Promotion Board until the position was abolished and have written feature articles for Hoof Beats as well as a column for Horseman and Fair World. Dean Hoffman and I share the same birthday and have joked about that often. He chides my being wizened as I am three hours older. I cherish the times I worked with the estimable Ellen Harvey.

Much of what I attempted to accomplish in my position was through the eyes of a fan. Too much of what is being done to attract bettors is designed for those who already own, train, groom or drive horses. As was written last week, college kids need to be enticed. Reading a program is complicated for the novice, but so is studying the odds of online poker and we all know how that has exploded. The difference is time. Players don't have to wait 20 minutes for the next hand after they fold. I have seen many gray-gained patrons pulling two slot machines simultaneously. People want action. This is why football is replacing baseball as America's pastime.

Lastly, what frustrated me more than anything when serving in my capacity as executive director was the disconnect between factions of the industry. The breeders, overnight owners, fairs, simulcast facilities and track owners seemed to only care about themselves. None of them seemed to care about The Fan. I remember years ago noted Maine horseman Donnie Richards told me that getting casino money was the beginning of the end for the sport. I fear he may be right. Greyhound once raced on the Grand Circuit at Old Orchard Beach's kite track. Scarborough Downs will soon be a strip mall.

While I abhor big government, I believe the sport needs a commissioner and probably a tough Kennesaw Mountain Landis type because tough decisions must be made — and implemented. It's great that yearling sales are up but that may be fools gold. The number of horses, tracks and fans are way down and if something is not done soon you will find me sitting beside the road watching two horses race — still a fan.

Appealing to the mainstream

I was sorry to read that attendance was not as good as expected for the Breeders Crown races. I would have been there if I wasn't four hours away. There is constant entertainment for any age. I think to get more people to the tracks, the first thing you have to do is to make all areas of your facility comfortable. All employees have to be pleasant and helpful all the time. You have to keep the over 45s happy, because we are here now. To draw in the younger crowd, I'm not sure. You need to ask them. Owners, trainers, managers, etc, do you bring your children to the track? My mother took me to Harrington Raceway when I was 8 years old. I learned to read a program and lost my allowance, but it didn't stop me from wanting to go back. I guess it was the "lure of easy money."

To all the PR people at the tracks: Do you send out press releases when there are big payoffs to your local news media? I don't mean just HRU and other harness news sources. You have to attract people that are not familiar with harness racing. I work in the summer at Ocean Downs. We had a payoff one night of \$14,000 plus on a superfecta! How many people knew about it, if you weren't there? I think Heather Vitale told about it on her Post Time TV show, but, it mainly reaches people already in the business. 
