Decked Out

Inspired by last winter's success of The Deck at Sunshine Meadows, Myron Bell has started On The Deck Partners and spent more than \$1 million buying top-tier yearlings he hopes will attract new owners to the game.

It is the morning of the final yearling session at the Standardbred Horse Sale in Harrisburg, PA and Myron Bell is sitting on a director's chair in the Hunterton Farms consignment near the back ring at the Pennsylvania Farm Show Complex. It is a long way from Florida, but the pedigree guru, owner and racing manger for Brittany Farms is already making big plans for the winter to recruit new horse owners from some of the Sunshine State's tony, gated communities.

"I'm basically trying to get new people who may become active buyers of horses here," Bell said, emphasizing the word 'here' with a wave of his hands to indicate he's talking about Harrisburg. By "here" Bell also means the Lexington Selected Yearling Sale, where part of his new venture called On The Deck Partners spent \$980,000 on six yearlings. The group

added another yearling at Harrisburg for \$100,000 to push its total expenditure for seven yearlings — all colts, and all to be trained by Tony Alagna — over \$1 million.

Where Anthony MacDonald's Thestable.ca is purposely trying to attract blue-collar owners with minimal investment, Bell is aiming for something more blue-blooded. In conjunction with the United States Trotting Association, Bell has taken out a full-page ad in a glitzy magazine pitching the joys of horse ownership to wealthy, semi-retired and restless Floridians. The goal is to get them to check it out during Saturday morning open houses on The Deck at Sunshine Meadows built last winter by

trainers Alagna and Frank M. Antonacci.

"Maybe they would be interested in racing, if it was presented to them in a new and exciting way. They can come down and jog a horse, we have a two-seater. They can eat, drink and ask questions," Bell said. "It's not only for Tony Alagna, this is for the whole industry. I'll introduce them to any trainer that's in Sunshine Meadows and if they hit it off and they want to get involved, so be it."

Bell said the core members of On The Deck Partners, besides himself and his wife, Stephanie, are: Alagna, George Segal and his Brittany Farms, John Fodera, Steve Wienick, Robert Cooper and Joe Barbera. There is a different mix of owners on each

horse and Bell said his goal is, "to have an auction in February and sell part of these horses to some new owners."

"It's a non-pressure situation. We're not actively seeking them to buy a horse, but if they see a horse training in December, January or February and think, 'Boy, I like that.

What's he worth?' I'd say, 'Well, we paid \$200,000 for him, so if you want to buy 10 per cent based on \$200,000, go ahead.'"

Bell said he is trying to reduce the risk for new owners on a couple of fronts. First, he is employing his knowledge of pedigrees to buy the best possible yearlings with the greatest potential to end up as stallions

"Having a true understanding of what bloodlines can do, can get (new owners) to the classic races like the Hambletonian and the Meadowlands Pace and Breeders Crown. That's what we shoot for," Bell said.

Second, getting those horses on the track before new owners are asked to buy in reduces their risk of ending up with a dud.

"We are giving them an opportunity where we might save them some grief. A lot of these horses (we bought at Lexington) are up and going already. They are really nice. Tony Alagna, one of our trainers, treats these (potential owners) like royalty, which they are. The two most important

elements we have in our industry is the horse and the owner, not that the trainer or the catch driver or blacksmith or caretaker isn't important, but the horse makes it happen along with the owner," Bell said.

"This might take two years to work. This year might be too late, but we persevere. Rome wasn't built in a day. I didn't buy \$200,000 horses 20 years ago. I worked up to it. We have people that want the best and we'll make sure they have a shot at having the best."

So far, On The Deck Partners have purchased the following yearlings:

In Harrisburg:

Hip 397 – Mach Three colt out of First Lady named Mach Domi for \$100,000

In Lexington:

Hip 43 – Somebeachsomewhere colt out of Authorize named Singing Sands for \$150,000

"This is the first colt out of Authorize and Delinquent Account is a filly that I bought as a yearling and then George (Segal) bought as a broodmare and she's become one of the most prolific foundation mares in our history today," Bell said. "Delinquent Account has a lot of daughters and granddaughters that have produced numerous horses such as Western Terror, If I Can Dream, Artiscap and Western Shore."

Hip 56 – Somebeachsomewhere colt out of Credit Rating named Fundamental AM for \$200,000

"(Fundamental AM) has had two fillies. Her filly from last year bought \$275,000 and had an injury, but I knew she had a lot of ability because Tony Alagna trained her. This colt was the first colt out of the mare and, there again, it was a Delinquent Account production and, we feel, a very special horse," Bell said.

Hip 65 – Cantab Hall colt out of Forever Graceful named Gallant Man for \$350,000

“When George Segal bought Brittany Farms (from Bill Shehan), Keystone Profile came with the farm, and she was a foundation mare. She produced a foal named Act Of Grace, who was the same year as Continentalvictory – both great fillies that George bred,” Bell said. “The only problem with Act Of Grace was that after her racing career she only had two foals, one daughter and one colt. The daughter is the second dam of this horse. In other words, her dam, Graceful Touch, had two stallions – Muscle Mass and Muscle Massive. Now, imagine if she has three or four daughters how great that family would be? It’s good now, but they are waiting for another stallion right now, and I hope it’s this one.”

Hip 154 – American Ideal colt out of Perfect Touch named American History for \$150,000

“Perfect Touch was a filly we sold as a yearling to Don Swick and Don sold her as a three-year-old in Canada and I bought her back for the farm. Her first foal was a Tell All filly that brought \$1,000. Then she had a Western Ideal colt that brought \$17,000 and then she had a nice filly that brought \$20,000. But this colt was the cat’s meow. He was phenomenal looking.”

Hip 194 – Conway Hall colt out of Garbo Hall named Godspell Hall for \$120,000

“I think that colt could be a special horse. He’s a very good-moving horse,” Bell said.

Hip 415 – American Ideal colt out of Sure Fun Tryin named Rush To Judgement for \$10,000

“He’s maternally inbred, a 4x4 to Ambiguity who is the dam of Three Diamonds. The mare had a lot of ability. The first foal is a broodmare for us now, Shes A Hot Mess and she’s in foal to Captaintreacherous. This colt, for some reason, brought \$10,000. We took him back and we’re going to offer him as a door prize on the deck. In other words, when we have our sale, we’re going to offer him as a door prize for people that attend the deck. We’ll have a drawing. We’re going to do something, I haven’t figured it out. Whoever bids maybe they’ll donate it to their favorite charity or something. There was nothing wrong with him and he brought \$10,000.”

Racing's marketing is misguided

Donald Trump's digital marketing campaign said so.

In just the last few weeks, *Harness Racing Update* published chatter from some of the movers and shakers in the sport, like Joe Faraldo and Jeff Gural, about marketing racing. This ongoing discussion is probably an offshoot of the debate over the USTA's \$250,000 investment in digital marketing the last couple of years. It's often discussed in thoroughbred racing, as well, around the [efforts of the Jockey Club](#).

Broadly, everyone tends to ask the same question: "Does marketing work?"

It's an honest question, but I think the better question is: "What is marketing nowadays, and how can it work?"

When most people in racing think of marketing they think of publicity; about someone or something getting its name 'out there', especially on television.

Back at the 2004 Olympics in Athens, a man named Ron Bensimhon was on a diving board preparing for the 3 meter springboard. The crowd watched as Ron jumped and did a belly flop, and when he emerged from the pool we saw a logo across his chest; an "ad" for an online casino. That marketing ended up (for lack of a better word) flopping. In this day and age, when consumers and everyone else are inundated with images and imagery, it doesn't work.

When I started in marketing, "getting your name out there," or interrupting people with your marketing, was accepted, but it's not any longer. And grand plans in harness racing (for five per cent of purses, or whatever other funding mechanisms have been floating around) should never include these tactics.

But, don't think for a second I am calling for zero marketing spend, or that five per cent of purses invested is a bad thing. I'm not. Marketing can and does work, if it's spent in the right place. And oftentimes that place is right under your nose.

Let me explain my view, with the recent election as a guide.

In July of this year, [AdAge reported](#) Hillary Clinton had reserved \$111 million for her television ads through November, while Donald Trump booked only \$654,455 for his. In June, campaign disclosures showed Trump spent \$1.6 million on digital marketing, while Clinton's camp had a whopping \$35 million in the digital war chest. This was a massacre.

However, while the Clinton campaign blanketed digital marketing in traditional ways, and headlines like [Wired's](#), "Clinton Has a Team of Silicon Valley Stars, Trump has Twitter" were almost mocking in tone, Trump's digital head (not a Madison Avenue marketer, but a Kansan with a small firm) was ignoring the sexiness of marketing. Instead, he spent money talking to people who were willing to listen.

In July, the campaign's major expenditure – a Twitter ad buy – was about fundraising and contact capture, not marketing, through asking people to text a number on their phones. On Facebook, ads were targeted to supporters with creative that spoke their language and energized them. This strategy was all about seeking and finding people who wanted to help, cataloguing them in databases, learning their likes and dislikes, and raising more money. It was also about digitally data-mining groups that were against Mr. Trump, to be hopefully be used as an asset for hyper-targeting later on.

"Trump's digital operation is focused primarily on tracking down the people who already liked his burgers and getting them to buy more," wrote [Sasha Issenberg and Joshua Green](#) at Bloomberg Business in August.

Vincent Harris, a digital marketing campaign veteran, [told Wired](#), around the same time, "This is about effective digital operations. It's gritty. It's fast-paced."

It worked well, because by building assets, the money



flowed in. \$80 million was raised, a lot of which was spurred by modest digital investment. On the night of the third debate – which most of the punditry said was horrible for Mr. Trump – his digital marketing head **crowded that \$9 million had been raised** on digital channels, at \$72 per person, in just hours. They had built an energized list, hammered it with tested messaging, and people again responded.

While the first part of the marketing equation was to raise funds and get Trump's turnout up, in the *Washington Post*, **Philip Bump talked about** part II of what he titled, "this risky marketing plan": To get Mrs. Clinton's turnout down. People who were not going to vote for Trump were not marketed to in traditional ways, (i.e. by asking them to change their vote with 'marketing') they were going to be fed messages to suppress their enthusiasm. This was primarily done via Facebook. Ads that had been back-tested with hundreds of thousands of iterations during the season (to find the right closing messages) were created. Then, the database of non-supporters was subset based on various target demographics (and geography) and the ads were delivered.

"So this is the Trump campaign's bet, laid on the table by a group of people who haven't run campaigns before. Given the inability to increase Trump's support, they'll try to drag down Clinton's," Bump wrote a week before the election.

There's a mistake often made after a horse wins a close race, or a team wins a close game – we give the driver, jock or the coach too much credit, when the result could've been lucky or random. But in the Trump digital case, the post-election turnout numbers appear to show this strategy played a role. Her core turnout (in key states) was down, and his was up.

And, yes, it was "marketing". It just wasn't the kind that we're used to, or what is longed for in our sport, from many quarters.

The marketing needed in harness racing – all of racing, I think, but harness racing in particular - is much closer to what Trump's team strategized. Cost effective, data-driven marketing that tries to get people who like racing's burgers to buy more of them, is not about a billboard and it's not only about talking to ourselves. It's about creating a marketing ecosystem that can be used to grow the sport.

With this type of marketing and the resulting data that enters the lexicon, we open doors and we learn. We learn what makes customers tick, what they (and more importantly, subsets of them) want from the sport in terms of pricing, or rules, the spacing of races, field size and a hundred other things. We use cohort analysis to learn exactly what new

people may be attracted to, when it comes to owning horses or becoming a bettor. We learn what messaging works and doesn't work, what projects need capital, and what should be scrapped. This marketing holds value; value that the sport can act on, to engage customers, and build a better product.

Marketing in 2016 is not about billboards or TV time in an idle fantasy that someone might happen to see something, pack up the kids, and drive to the track. Horse racing must get past this inherent bias. Marketing is about building assets, grinding through numbers, getting your hands dirty, hyper-targeting, testing, honing strategy, and acting on it; all in the most cost-effective and efficacious way. That's the way forward, and that's the marketing racing must invest in.

Huntsville vs. Downbytheseaside

Renewal of the rivalry in Saturday's Governor's Cup at Woodbine headlines Fall Four finals.

Huntsville (Tim Tetrick) equalled the 1:49 world record at Red Mile.

The 2016 Woodbine Entertainment Group (WEG) stakes season will come to a close Saturday (Nov. 19) at Woodbine with nearly \$1.8 million on the line in the Fall Four.

The Governor's Cup, Valley Victory, Three Diamonds and Goldsmith Maid will see many of the finest two-year-olds in the sport attempting to end their rookie seasons in style.

The richest event of the Fall Four is the \$520,000 Governor's Cup, which features a field of 11 pacing colts and geldings. Two of the fastest two-year-olds in harness racing history, Downbytheseaside and Huntsville, will go toe-to-toe in Saturday's main event.

Huntsville is coming into the Governor's Cup off a sensational 1:49.1 Breeders Crown victory on Oct. 29.

The Ray Schnittker-trained colt has won seven of 10 starts this season, including the Pennsylvania Sires Stakes (PASS) Championship and a pair of Grand Circuit events at Red Mile. "He's pretty nice to drive," Schnittker said. "He can leave, sit a hole, and he's very comfortable. He really feels like he wants to get by at the end of the mile; towards the wire."

Tim Tetrick will drive Huntsville in the Governor's Cup.

"We trained him in a mile of [1]:57 at Goshen, and are more or less trying to keep an edge on him. He's probably as sharp as he's ever going to get right now; it's hard to keep him this good this long," Schnittker said.

Downbytheseaside has done his best to stay out of the shadow of Huntsville, despite finishing second to his rival on three different occasions, including the PASS Championship and Breeders Crown.

The Brian Brown trained colt has won seven of 12 starts this season. With no eliminations necessary for the Governor's Cup, Downbytheseaside tuned up for Saturday's contest with a winning qualifier last Friday at Dayton.

The parallels between Huntsville and Downbytheseaside's rookie seasons run deep.

Both are sons of Somebeachsomewhere, both have seven victories this season, both have followed almost identical schedules and both have victories over each other, with Huntsville holding a three to one advantage.

However, the deepest connection that will long be remembered between the two is Oct. 8 at Red Mile.

The same day at Red Mile, Downbytheseaside (David Miller) equalled the 1:49 world record.

On a breezy fall afternoon in Lexington, Huntsville and Downbytheseaside each captured a division of the International Stallion Stake and both did so by equaling the world record of 1:49.

Huntsville versus Downbytheseaside is becoming one of the hottest rivalries in the sport and anticipation is already building for potential classic showdowns next season.

However, one final two-year-old battle looms for the superstar rookies and it only seems right that they will lineup side by side in the Governor's Cup.

Huntsville and driver Tim Tetrick drew post position two, while Downbytheseaside and driver David Miller landed post position three for Saturday's \$520,000 event.

While the two big dogs in Saturday's Governor's Cup will have a close eye on each other, they will also have their hands full with their nine other rivals, which includes Breeders Crown third-place finisher Miso Fast, Kindergarten winner Air Strike and Dream Maker winner Bettors Dream.

The Governor's Cup certainly has the makings of a potential classic, but the three other Fall Four events are also loaded with talent.

The \$427,000 Three Diamonds for two-year-old pacing fillies features Breeders Crown champion Someomensomewhere and Shes A Great Lady champion Idyllic Beach.

Idyllic Beach bested Someomensomewhere in last Friday's elimination by just a neck, while Caviart Ally came through with a strong effort to take the other split.

Someomensomewhere has won three of her last five going into Saturday, while Idyllic Beach is undefeated in three starts north of the border.

The \$404,000 Valley Victory for two-year-old trotting colts and geldings could be the scene of a "Snowstorm."

Ron Burke trainee Snowstorm Hanover turned in a dominating effort to win his elimination last week in 1:55.1. The son of Muscle Massive is red hot going into the Valley Victory final with back-to-back wins, including a victory on Nov. 3 in the Matron at Dover Downs.

Local standout Jake will look to get in the way of Snowstorm Hanover. The Luc Blais trainee captured his elimination last week in 1:55.4 and has never finished out of the money in nine career starts.

Similar to the Governor's Cup, the Goldsmith Maid for rookie trotting fillies did not require eliminations. A competitive field of 10 is scheduled to compete for \$447,000.

Princess Aurora has quietly earned \$212,676 in the shadow of stablemate Ariana G this season, but with no Ariana G in the Goldsmith Maid, the Jimmy Takter trained filly will have a chance to grab the spotlight Saturday.

Princess Aurora has three victories this season and has hit the board in eight of 10 outings.

Saturday's card will be the final million-dollar card of the 2016 North American harness racing season, which has seen many classic moments.

The full draw for the Fall Four card will take place Wednesday. Post time Saturday is 7:30 p.m.

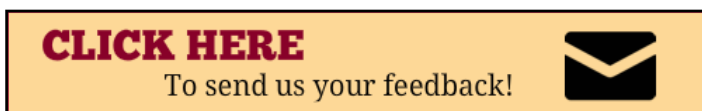

Driver Trends

A look at how some of the top drivers stack up to their stats from a year ago.

Let's take a look at how some of the top drivers are faring in comparison to last year through Nov. 14, 2016.

David Miller, who won his first NA Cup in 2016, is having another terrific year.

Last year's Driver of the Year **David Miller** is number two in earnings, just as he was on Nov 14, 2015. He has 23 more wins and his money is up by five per cent — \$558,173. Miller, who has prospered after taking last winter off, has seen his UDRS rise from 0.278 to 0.325. The Buckeye, who benefits from his association with world champion Always B Miki, appears to be the favorite to repeat as

Driver of the Year.

Four time DOY **Tim Tetrick** is in third, just like last year. He has 102 more wins than he had at this point in 2015 and his earnings are up 3.5 per cent — \$388,328. He's number two at The Meadowlands and Harrah's Philadelphia. Tetrick will be looking to dominate next year's sophomore colt divisions with Walner and Huntsville.

Scott Zeron is having a career year: he moved from 11th at this point last year to number four. The driver of Triple Crown winner Marion Marauder has seen his win total jump by five per cent and his money increase by 22 per cent — \$1,866,372 more than he had in mid-November of 2015. Scott was the leading driver at The Meadowlands this year.

Brett Miller, who got off to a slow start and was in 12th at the halfway point, is in sixth, three spots better than last year. Brett's UDRS is about the same and he has just two

fewer wins than a year ago, but his earnings are up by \$491,863, or seven per cent. Racing Hill and Pure Country have helped account for that.

Matt Kakaley, who was at 13 a year ago, and finished the year there, is in seventh. He has 23 more wins and \$963,459, or 11.6 per cent, more in earnings. Matt's UDRS is up from 0.220 to 0.236. In addition to being one of Ron Burke's go to drivers, he's number four at Pocono Downs and was the runner up in the NYSS.

Sylvain Filion, the top driver on the WEG circuit, moved up five spots to number 12. He has three fewer wins, but his earnings are up by \$760,008—13.5 per cent. Sylvain was the leading driver in the Ontario Sire Stakes, finishing more than a million dollars ahead of second place James MacDonald.

Chris Page jumped 10 spots to number 13. He has 110 more wins and his money is up 27 per cent \$1.4 million. He was number two at Scioto Downs and Miami Valley. The Ohio Sire Stakes and Ron Burke's stock were both key factors in his success.

Mark MacDonald, who recently won the Breeders Crown with Obrigado, like Page, jumped 10 spots, to number 14. His win total is up 30 per cent and his earnings have increased by 29 per cent — \$1.5 million. His UDRS is up to 0.240 from 0.198. Mark is number six at Yonkers Raceway and was number three in the NYSS.

Trace Tetrick, the leading driver at Hoosier Park, winning at a 21 per cent clip, moves up from 20 to 15. He had 62 more wins—up 14 per cent — and increased his earnings by

\$664,032 – more than 12 per cent. Trace's UDRS dropped from 0.304 to 0.246. Freaky Feet Pete didn't have the sort of year many expected him to.

Jordan Stratton, who was very successful in the Levy and Matchmaker series, stepped up 11 spots to number 16. His win total is up 30 per cent and his money has risen by 27 per cent – \$1.3 million. Stratton is number five at Yonkers.

Marcus Miller made a giant 15-spot leap to number 17. Miler is number six at Pocono Downs and number eight at Harrah's Philadelphia. His win total is up by better than 33 per cent while his money has risen by 32 per cent – \$1.6 million. He won the Breeders Crown with Someomensomewhere.

Josh Sutton, the leading driver at Scioto Downs and Miami Valley, moved ahead 13 spots to number 21. He has 33 more wins and his money is up by 30 per cent – \$1.4 million. Like Page, Merriman and Wrenn, he has benefitted from the new and improved Ohio Sire Stakes program.

Aussie **Andrew McCarthy** stepped up five spots to number 23. He's number seven at Pocono, eight at Harrah's Philadelphia and 11 at The Meadowlands. His win total is up 25 per cent while his money rose 12.5 per cent – \$516,202.

John DeLong, who was second at Hoosier Park, jumped 23 spots to 24. He has 151 more wins – up 41.5 per cent – and more than 42 per cent more money – up \$1.6 million. His UDRS rose from 0.266 to 0.300.

HOLDING STEADY

Yannick Gingras, the unanimous choice for Driver of the Year in 2014, is on top of the money tree, just as he was last year. The number one option for leading trainers Ron Burke and Jimmy Takter has 21 fewer wins than a year ago and his earnings are down \$139,189 – about one per cent. His UDRS is 0.324 as opposed to 0.349 last year. He has dominated the senior mare divisions with Hannelore Hanover and Lady Shadow.

Last year's dash champ **Aaron Merriman**, who is a shoe in to repeat, has moved up from 12th to ninth. His win total is off by four while his money is up by \$141,435, or two per cent. He holds a 100 win lead over George Napolitano, who loses Pocono Downs from his calendar very shortly. Merriman is number two at Northfield and in third at The Meadows.

Ronnie Wrenn Jr, who won the dash title in 2013 and 2014, moved up one spot to 20. His wins are down 17 per cent – 115 – but his earnings have stepped up by \$353,256. The leading driver at Northfield, he made a strong showing in the Ohio Sire Stakes.

TRENDING DOWN

Jason Bartlett, who topped the earnings list for the first half of the year, is in fifth, one spot lower than a year ago. His win total is up by 70 – 12.5 per cent – but his money is off by 12 per cent – \$1,107,900. The leading driver at Yonkers Raceway has upped his UDRS from 0.347 to 0.371. He's number four in the NYSS.

Our newest Hall of Famer **Brian Sears** is at eight, down from five a year ago. His win total is off by 16 per cent – 54 – and he's more than 18 per cent short money wise – \$1,608,715. Sears has tried to augment his regular gig at Yonkers – where he's second to Bartlett – with success on the Grand Circuit, but the wins have been hard to come by this year. Bee A Magician is back, but most of the stakes dollars have dried up at this point.

Corey Callahan, who just joined the 5,000 club, is at number 10, down from six last year. His win total is off by 33 per cent from mid-November of 2015 and his earnings are down by 24 per cent, or more than \$2 million. Corey's UDRS is down to 0.264 from 0.319. He's working off of 10 per cent fewer starts.

George Napolitano Jr, who is second on the dash list, is at 11, down from seven. His win total is off by 16 per cent – 122 – and his money is down by 17 per cent – \$1.3 million. George's UDRS dropped from a heady 0.403 to 0.351. He's the leading driver at Harrah's Philadelphia and Pocono Downs.

George Brennan, the number three driver at Yonkers Raceway, has fallen 10 spots to number 18. His win total is off 30 per cent and his earnings are off by 29 per cent. His UDRS is down to 0.257 from 0.276. Brennan, who has made fewer than three dozen starts away from Yonkers, has driven in 11 per cent fewer races this year.

Dan Dube is another Yonkers regular who fell hard – from nine to 19. He has 55 fewer wins and is short \$2 million. Dube is number four at the Hilltop track.

All-time dash leader **Dave Palone** dropped from 16 to 22. The top driver at The Meadows is down 61 wins and \$516,202 – 12.5 per cent.

Jim Morrill Jr, the top driver in the NYSS by more than double, dropped 11 spots to 25. He had 89 more wins and saw his UDRS rise from 0.388 to an eye opening 0.425, but his earnings were down by \$1.4 million.

Always B Miki officially retires tonight at Big M

Always B Miki will make one final trip to the winner's circle before he goes off to his second career as a stallion. The world's fastest Standardbred of all-time will officially be retired tonight (Nov. 18) in a ceremony at the Meadowlands.

The five-year-old son of Always A Virgin—Artstopper capped off his brilliant career last Saturday at the Meadowlands by winning the \$400,000 TVG Free-For-All Final by four lengths in 1:48.2. He retires with 30 wins, 13 seconds, and three third-place finishes in 53 lifetime starts for earnings of \$2,715,368. Miki set the all-time speed record of 1:46 when winning the Allera Farm's open pace in October at Lexington.

"I think it's really poetic to end his career where it started," said co-owner Bob Boni. "My partner Mitchel Skolnick and I made the deal to buy half of the horse after his third baby race at the Meadowlands. It's our home track — from myself and Mitchel, to Jimmy Takter, and David Miller. It all comes full circle. I've been at the Meadowlands since day one so it's nice to have this happen here."

The retirement ceremony will take place after the fourth race. Miki will jog from the back paddock to the winner's circle while a highlight video of his career plays throughout the building. He will be presented with a commemorative blanket and pose for photos while his connections are interviewed on the Meadowlands TV broadcast.

"It is our honor to send this tremendous racehorse out with a ceremony that honors his legendary career," said Meadowlands GM Jason Settlemyre. "All of us have watched with such excitement the battles that Miki waged with his rival Wiggle It Jiggle this season and I don't think anyone that was here at the Meadowlands for the Breeders Crown will ever forget Miki prevailing after that epic stretch duel."

Always B Miki will begin his stallion career at Diamond Creek Farm in Pennsylvania. He will stand for \$12,500.

Meanwhile, Miki's ownership group continues to grow as several major breeders have joined the bought in.

The latest breeders to buy an ownership interest in Always B Miki are Steve Jones of Cameo Hills Farm, Lindy Farms, Hunterton Farm, Fair Winds Farm, Dr. Steve Dey and Anthony Perretti. All American Harnessbreds jumped into the ownership group prior to the Breeders Crown.

"The plan was to bring in the sport's breeders and that has come to fruition," said Diamond Creek's Adam Bowden.

"These are very active breeders so we're thrilled to have them aboard," added Boni.

"I own a few nice mares and I plan to support him with my better ones and I wanted to be part of the ownership group. In my mind, he's one of the most exciting stallion prospects to come along, and I wanted to be part of the syndicate," said Jones.

Lindy Farms has 12-13 pacing broodmares and will be retiring several fillies and mares, among them Imagine Dragon p,4, 1:49.3, who hails from the same maternal family as this year's sensational filly Darlinonthebeach.

"We've got young mares with fast records and great pedigrees and we're going to support him big league," said Frank M. Antonacci, who has trained the Lindy fillies/mares who will be heading to the breeding shed.

Hunterton Farm's Steve Stewart said he saw buying an ownership interest in Always B Miki as a "logical" business decision.

"The horse has a really good group of breeders behind him and that's key for stallions," said Stewart. "With our partners, we've bought a lot of pacing mares the last few years and we've been breeding them to Captaintreacherous, Somebeachsomewhere and Sweet Lou and it's time to move some of them around."

Fair Winds Farm has 25 top producing pacing broodmares. "I haven't made my mating selections just yet, but I'm excited to join the Always B Miki team," said Fair Winds' Mark Mullen.

Bags To Riches upset at Dover

Bags To Riches enjoyed a perfect two-hole trip en route to ending Henry The Dragon's five-straight win streak on Thursday (Nov. 17) to win the \$100,000 Delaware Standardbred Breeders Fund (DSBF) Dover Downs championship.

With Tim Tetrick at the controls, Bags To Riches left fast to get the early lead and gave way to prohibitive favorite unbeaten Henry The Dragon. Montrell Teague steered Henry The Dragon upfront, challenged only by the Corey Callahan-driven James Isaac on the backstretch. The duo continued that way until turning for home when James Isaac retreated allowing Bags To Riches to come to the outside where he uncorked a :27.2 final corner to get up by a half-length in DSBF stakes record time of 1:51.1.

Bags To Riches was bred by Only Money Inc. who shares ownership in the Roddy's Bags Again—Pint The Sky Blue colt with trainer Jason Skinner. The win by freshman is his fourth in eight starts with two seconds and a third to bring his bankroll total to \$86,862.
