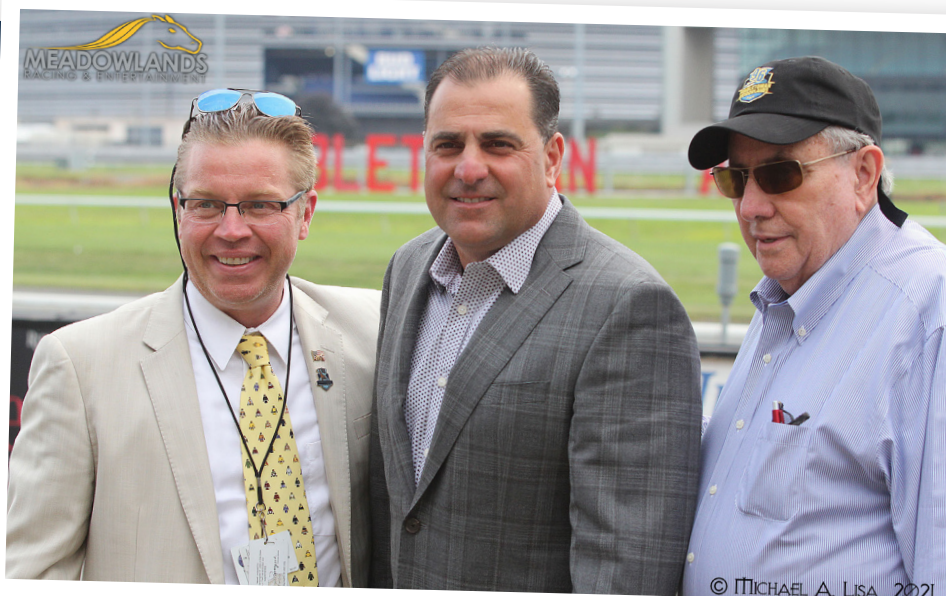

Jason Settlemoir's go-getter attitude pays off

He and perennial top breeder Brittany Farms tied for the prestigious Bergstein-Proximity Award.

The reality of winning the Stan Bergstein-Proximity Achievement Award from the U.S. Harness Writers Association (USHWA) still hasn't quite sunk in for The Meadowlands' chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemoir.

"At 46, even being nominated for the award was an honor in itself," said Settlemoir, who is one of the youngest people ever to receive the honor. "And then to get this award and be tied with Brittany Farms, a farm that has over decades and decades produced some of the top horses in our sport, to me, was unheard of really."

Voting for the 2023 award ended in a tie between Settlemoir and Brittany Farms, which announced in 2023 the **winding down of their operation** over the next three years.

"I thought for certain that Brittany was a slam dunk and that my time would come later," Settlemoir said. "I couldn't have been more surprised about the dead heat, and honored and grateful to receive this type of an award from my peers."

The Bergstein-Proximity Award is "presented annually to an individual (including a horse as "individual"), group or organization for past and/or present outstanding contributions to harness racing." It is the highest honor solely voted on by the members of USHWA.

It is not lost on Settlemoir, who, in part, the award is named for and who has won it before him.

Settlemoir was a vice-president for Harness Tracks of America (HTA) when Bergstein ran the organization.

"I was very fond of Stan growing up, God rest his soul," Settlemoir said. "He communicated with me probably on a weekly basis when we had HTA. Stan was a great guy and to receive an award with his name on it is an honor in itself."

The Bergstein-Proximity Award was won in 2006 by Hall of Famer Jeff Gural, the president/chief executive officer of The Meadowlands, and by the Hall of Fame "Voice" of harness racing and the Little Brown Jug, Roger Huston, in 2011. Those are two people that mean the world to Settlemoir.

"I have a lot of respect for the Gural name and admiration for him and his wife Paula," Settlemoir said. "And then Roger, who I grew up idolizing. To be able to work with Roger in Delaware [Ohio]. Calling races with him is a dream in itself and to win the same award that both Roger and Jeff did, is truly magical to me."

According to Gural, it was a real thrill for him to get the award named for Bergstein, and he couldn't be happier for Settlemoir to receive the same honor.

"Jason deserves this award because of his passion for the sport and his willingness to be a USTA director and fight with me to help get rid of the drugs," Gural said. "Right now, the leaders, and I assume a majority of the members, are focused on keeping the status quo despite overwhelming evidence that we have a major problem, and honest horsemen and women are at a disadvantage."

"Jason is great with people and our employees respond to him. He works tirelessly to improve the product and find ways to get young people interested. He also does a good job making sure the customer experience is enjoyable and helps dealing with the horsemen, which can be difficult at times. His life besides his family is devoted to our industry. Lastly, he probably was influential in getting me elected to the Hall of Fame, which couldn't have been easy."

Settlemoir was a senior in high school when he first started working with Huston during Little Brown Jug (LBJ) Week. Former LBJ director of marketing, Phil Terry, hired Settlemoir to put blankets on horses.

Knowing him as a youngster, Huston had no idea that Settlemoir would end up where he has, but he does remember he had the right attitude.

"The one thing I did notice was that he was a go-getter," Huston

said. "You gave him a task; he'd do it and he'd take it to heart and give it his all no matter what the chore was. That go-getter attitude that he had prompted him to go on to other and bigger things as his life progressed over the years."

Settlemoir remembers being asked by Terry and LBJ former director of racing Tom Thomson to become Huston's assistant announcer at the Jug.

"I said to them, 'That would be an honor, but I would like for you to ask Sam McKee first' and they said, 'We already talked to

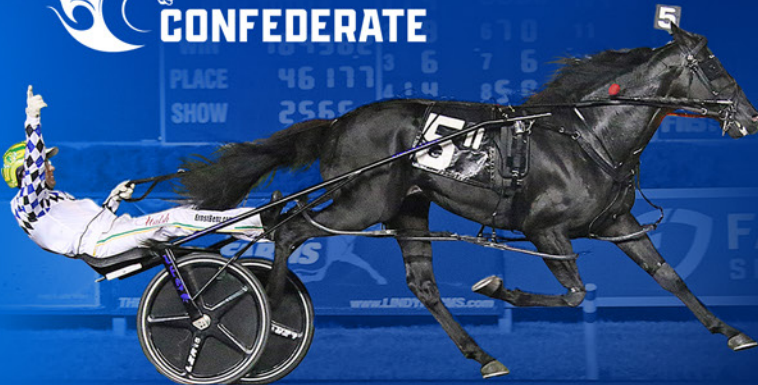

Sam about it and Sam said that you're from Ohio, from central Ohio, particularly, and that he wanted you to call the races,” Settlemoir said. “That was just such an unselfish move and an example of the type of person that Sam was.”

Huston said Settlemoir became a jack-of-all-trades and does many jobs exceptionally well.

“He does a lot more than being the assistant announcer,” Huston said. “I mean, he's in charge of simulcasting, he was selling advertising this year to get that purse [for the Jug] to a million dollars and he's on the Jug Society. So, he's heavily committed to Delaware [Ohio] and the Little Brown Jug.

“This year for the Jug, when we wanted to get to that million-dollar purse, who better than Jason Settlemoir to go get the money and do things like that. So that go-getter attitude and the early days of his life carried on and got him to where he is today.”

Settlemoir has had many people in his corner, both in and out of the State of Ohio, including trainer Terry Holton and Holton's second trainer and former general manager of the OHHA, Jerry Knappenberger, both of whom played pivotal roles in the development of Settlemoir's career.

In addition, throughout his life, Settlemoir has been surrounded by strong and supportive women, including his mom Charlamae, aunt Roberta, grandmother Helen, sister Lynn, and, of course, his Meadowlands' family of Marianne Rotella (assistant general manager), Rachel Ryan (director of marketing and event operations) and Lisa Smoter (executive coordinator), that encouraged him to dream big.

As a teenager, Settlemoir looked up to Bergstein protégé Chris McErlean, the former vice-president of racing operations for the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority, the entity that oversaw the operation of The Meadowlands prior to Gural taking the helm in 2011.

“Growing up, I always wanted to run the Meadowlands Racetrack and it's funny how things worked out,” Settlemoir said. “And here I am now and we're coming off a fantastic year. It's just unbelievable, really.”

“Not too many people get to live out their dreams in life. I have always lived by a motto from Walt Disney, ‘If you can dream it, you can do it.’ That quote hangs proudly in my office and it just goes to show that if you dream big, and you put the hard work and the effort into it, that you can accomplish anything that you want to in life.”

Driver Jeremy Smith closes out 2023 with a bang

Veteran Ohio driver wins Hollywood Gaming at Dayton Raceway meet title by open lengths despite missing a large amount of time due to injury.

You have to excuse driver Jeremy Smith if he wasn't excited to see the ball drop on 2023. The soon-to-be 44-year-old reinsman from Washington Court House, OH, was on a heater and ran away with the recently concluded Hollywood Gaming at Dayton Raceway meet drivers title, despite missing nearly a quarter of the meet.

Smith was sidelined for nearly eight weeks recovering from a sports hernia surgery. He spotted Chris Page and Dan Noble 38 and 24 wins, respectively, before he made his first Dayton drive. Thanks to a clean bill of health and a hot hand, Smith caught and passed the perennial driving leaders and won the meet by 24 driving wins.

"I took off my drives a couple of weeks before the end of the [Eldorado Scioto Downs] meet," said Smith. "My doctor told me that if I felt okay keep going. I drove with it for a little while; a week. I could not do it. The pain was too much.

"I don't know how I got the hernia. It sucked. This was the first time that I had a couple of horses that I drove for Todd Luther that would have been in the [Ohio Sire Stakes] finals. It was hard to be sitting at home, laid up, watching the finals."

Smith returned to the track on Tuesday (Oct. 17) and the winner's circle in the sixth race. Fifty-four race dates later, Smith drove his 141st and final winner of the 91-date meet.

Of his 141 winners, Smith brought 104 different horses to the Dayton winner's circle. The then 9-year-old pacer, Western Hill was Smith's top performer with four wins.

"Western Hill is one of my unsung favorites," Smith said. "I like that little horse. He does everything right and the right way."

Smith spread the wealth by driving winners for 54 different trainers, including 28 winners for Tessa Perin.

Perin and Smith teamed up for seven wins on the Dec. 14 card.

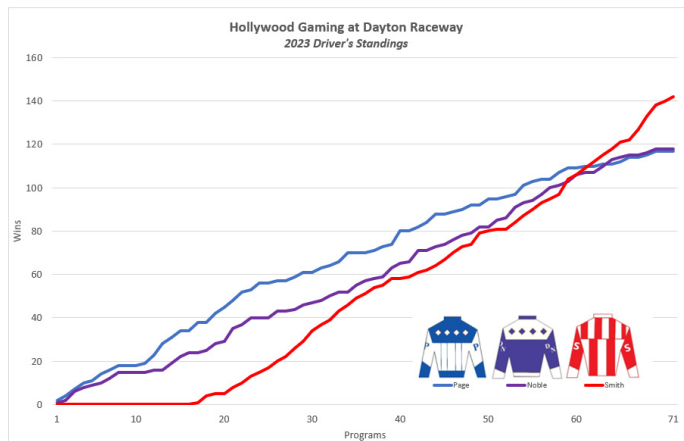
Jeremy scored his 2,000th and 3,000th career wins at Dayton in 2018 and 2022 as well.

So, what is it about the 10-year-old five-eighths mile oval?

"I don't know," Jeremy said with a laugh. "I credit a lot of it to it being a racehorse meet. It's kind of a speed track and that speed

Despite that memorable night, Smith may have been more excited after his four wins for his son, Parker.

"He does a pretty good job for a younger guy," said the proud father. "He started working for a couple of guys like Dan Ater and Jason Brewer for a while. He has since ventured out on his own. He made the decision that he wanted his own horses. He's doing well."

Jeremy finished the 2023 year with 267 wins, one more than last year's total with 450 fewer drives. His earnings of \$3.0 million were just \$71,000 below his career best.

The 2023 Hollywood Gaming at Dayton Raceway title was his third at the track (2018 and 2022 previously) and his fourth overall title. He won the 2012 Lebanon Raceway title.

holds up. You can make bold moves. A horse can come first up and keep digging.

"It's crazy how everything aligns for me at Dayton. The facility is great, the people are great. I just love that place. It's just a great place to race horses."

Jeremy was introduced to the sport by his grandparents, Bill and Barbara Redman.

"They had some horses with some family members," Jeremy said. "My grandfather died at the age of 56, when I was 12 years old. I started working with [trainer] Alvin Long a couple of years later. I sure miss those dudes."

Jeremy developed his love for horses from his grandfather, as well as his affection for classic cars.

"I'm working on a square body, two-wheel drive truck," Jeremy said. "I call it a [Cor]vette with a bed. This is the biggest project I have done, from the ground up. I have spent a year on it and I will be done in the spring."

"It is the same type of truck my grandfather would take me to school in."

With the southern Ohio action moving to the Miami Valley Gaming, does Jeremy have a goal for that meet?

"I have one goal, just to stay healthy," he said.

Before we get to our most read stories of 2023, we are wishing you a happy, healthy and prosperous 2024.

All of us at Harness Racing Update (HRU) send our deepest gratitude to our advertisers, readers, and contributors for the support in 2023 and the continued support this year.

This week marks eight years since the new management took over HRU in January of 2016. Since that time, we have gained a little over 2,700 HRU subscribers, an increase of 46 per cent.

In 2023, specifically, we increased our number of subscribers marginally in a year. We are extremely proud and thankful to continue to show year-over-year growth in each of the last eight years.

Even more important, HRU's average click and open rates continue to greatly exceed industry standards.

In 2023, our average open rate was on par with 2022, exceeding 52 per cent, which is 24 per cent higher than the industry average. Our click-to-open rate is 14 per cent higher than the industry average.

HRU continued to post steady growth in other areas, as well. In 2018, we launched our popular broadcast division with 2-year-olds in Training and sales coverage. In 2023, our [YouTube](#) subscribers nearly reached 2,240, up some 240 subscribers from the end of 2022.

Our social media numbers on Facebook and Twitter are up, too.

All that means HRU is showing growth in virtually every category.

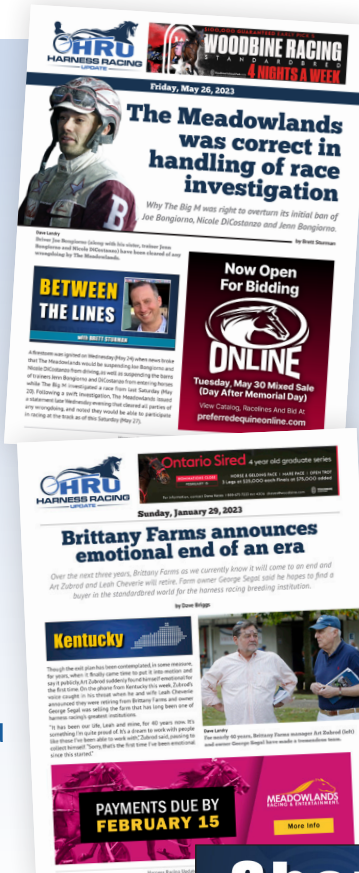

Statistician Gabe Di Paolo reveals top WMP public handicappers of 2023, trends

Public handicappers are everywhere. Woodbine Mohawk Park has a large number of professionals and amateurs weighing in every race. How does a bettor find the most consistently-profitable opinions with so many on offer?

Ask Gabe Di Paolo, or just follow his Twitter account (@noahurstats).

With the start of the new year comes an ideal opportunity to ask the voluntary WMP statistician about final results for 2023, and why he got into tabulating the public handicappers' results.

"I started off being a thoroughbred guy," Di Paolo said Tuesday (Jan. 3). "Just like in Woodbine thoroughbred, there was not any info on how well the public cappers were doing with their choices, so I put it upon myself to do what I call the 'dirty work.' Sometimes, I got the feeling that they were not too happy about it, but I was assured that was not the case."

April 2024 will mark his 10th anniversary of producing Twitter/X charts tracking results for Woodbine Racetrack's thoroughbred public handicappers. Di Paolo said he began compiling WMP harness handicappers' stats in late 2015. They do not regularly appear on any other websites or social media, although he said that "there were occasions that the charts were seen elsewhere."

No individual WMP handicapper dominated throughout 2023.

"Any given day, it seems, any capper has their chance to rise to the top, and they do," said Di Paolo.

Not all public handicappers provided selections for every card, but there were clear 2023 champs. Ghislain Paquet had the most top-choice winners (846), with Robert Reid, Jr. finishing second (830). The best average payout for 2023 was Reid, Jr.'s \$0.8657, ahead of Paquet's \$0.8384. John Rallis only provided selections for 78 WMP race dates. His best average payout was an impressive \$0.8790 in what Di Paolo called "an amazing start to his new journey as new co-host of Mohawk Live."

Di Paolo's charts compare each public handicapper's picks with those of other featured handicappers, as well as against specific metrics, including C5, "the consensus of top five weighted choices from the group." He noticed a particular trend last year.

"Just like with knowing how well the other cappers are doing individually, knowing how well the favorites, morning line, numbers, and consensus of the cappers [are performing] helps me with my selections," he said. "It is interesting to note that in 2023, the favorites and morning line hit ratio went up a bit from 2022, but strangely, some of the cappers average payouts went down."

Di Paolo said he thought that computer-assisted wagering (CAW) "could be" creating a downward trend in average payouts for the WMP handicappers.

"Looking back at the final chart of 2022, it was strange to see that some plummeted with their average payout in their final chart of 2023," he said. "Would this be the case in 2024? Most likely, it seems. When I agree with the morning line and the favorites, my hit ratio is up in the 70 per cent range... It's likely the same for most, since it was a chalky season helped by the CAWS for Mohawk in 2023."

Di Paolo added that he has noticed another, related trend: Winning WMP longshot prices were amplified.

"When I go 'lone wolfing,' my payouts sometimes are way more than I expected them to be, thanks to the CAWS," he said.

Playing favorites paid off last year at WMP and will likely continue in 2024.

"Most likely the favorite/morning line players will do better than the longshot players," said the Richmond Hill, ON horseplayer. "There are days when [WMP simulcast show hosts] Elissa [Blowe] and Randy [Waples] fare better than Ghislain and Robert, Jr., and

then there are days when Ghislain and Robert, Jr. fare better than Elissa and Randy.”

Perhaps surprisingly, WMP public handicappers have welcomed Di Paolo’s tabulation of their results, which cast an objective spotlight on predictive accuracy.

“No one has asked me to remove them from the charts,” said the unofficial statistician. “A few have asked to be put on, but some of them were not willing to put out the effort of having their picks ready for all the race cards. Life sometimes gets in the way, so sometimes they are not able to.”

Much can change between making selections and post time.

“Remember most public handicappers put in their picks two to three days beforehand,” said Di Paolo. “The public cappers’ picks are intended to give the [horseplayers] their view of what might occur in a horse race. Like in real life, [bettors] must go with their own instincts and rely on their work to find their picks and use the public cappers as a guide.”

Running his @noahurststats Twitter/X account is just the tip of the iceberg for Di Paolo. Much more goes on behind the scenes.

“Creating the charts [is] tedious,” he said, adding with a laugh, “You only see a small portion of them. [There are] 79 Sheets in the current spreadsheet. The dirty work of copying, pasting, typing the information needed doesn’t take that much time; it usually happens when I have time to do them, and I am not distracted from another project. I was a data/database analyst in my prior life.”

Calling the tabulation of handicappers’ results “a serious hobby for me to help pass the time,” Di Paolo said he got into it for one reason.

“Quick answer, I bet Mohawk,” he said. “If I do the charts for other tracks, it is safe to say that I am probably betting those tracks too: Grand River, Western Fair, Hanover, Truro, Meadowlands to name a few.”

Di Paolo said he would like to see formal appreciation for the WMP horseplayers of Twitter/X, who generate lively online dialogue every card.

“We go back to a tweet I recently tweeted, that Mohawk and Woodbine need to acknowledge those that help bring handicappers into the fun,” he said. “Cappers like Brad A., Sean N., Larry B., Trey S., pghPhil, Chad C., Lisa G... Sorry to anyone I may have missed.”

He added that he appreciated public handicappers allowing him to analyze their selections.

“I would like to give thanks to Sheri [Riddoch], Elissa [Blowe], Garnet [Barnsdale], John [Rallis], Brad [Almonski], Kevin [Plowcha], Sean [Patrick Nolan], Mike [Pribozie], Robert [Reid], Jr., Randy [Waples], Monique [Vág], Jeff [Bratt], Chad [Rozema] for allowing me to put in their opinions on races for Mohawk (and Woodbine) in these charts,” he said.

Di Paolo’s charts bring clarity to making picks for Canada’s top track, and that’s his intention.

“I hope the charts challenge the cappers to improve on what they are doing right, and get better with what they are doing wrong, in their view,” he said.

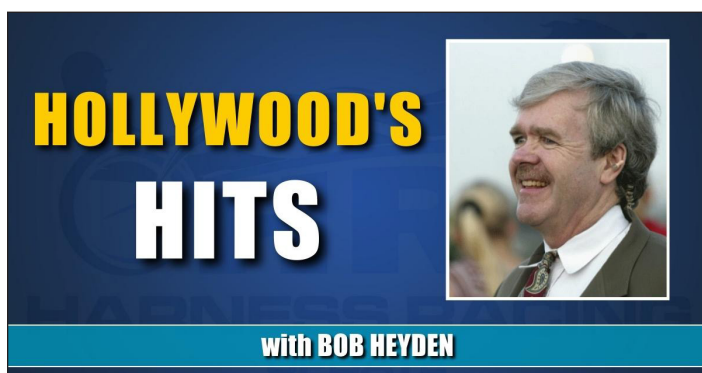
When it comes to those whose work he most admires, Di Paolo found it tough to narrow down the field. “There are so many that come to mind – everyone’s work habits and ability to have fun at the job is a joy to see,” he said.

On the thoroughbred side, he named Woodbine’s Jim Bannon and father Jim Bannon, Sr. (aka Abernathy), “one of the best at finding longshots.” Mike Hamilton and Ken Middleton earned top marks for harness handicapping.

Numbers show what separates the most successful WMP handicappers from the rest, but Di Paolo said attitude is probably the most important factor in their success.

“Cappers who tend to win more often than lose are not worried about obstacles that they cannot control,” he said. “Cappers may want the obstacles to change, but changing might result in worse rewards, in my opinion. To each his own.”





Happy 30th Birthday Western Dreamer!

He is the oldest living Triple Crown champion regardless of breed.

Western Dreamer just turned 30 and he's the oldest living Triple Crown winner.

He's the most senior member of either the thoroughbred or standardbred Triple Crown club.

A 23-year resident of the Kentucky Horse Park (since July 2001), he is a fan favorite, a kid lover, a ham, you name it, and it's not like there isn't competition. Personality-plus characters like Mr Muscleman and Marion Marauder also love the spotlight and attention, too.

Speaking of the Triple Crown, an in depth look into the thoroughbreds reveal that Secretariat – Triple Crown champ in 1973 – had the shortest life of any of the 11 who have passed on. Big Red only made it to 19, passing the first week of October 1989.

HORSES OF THE YEAR SIRING HORSES OF THE YEAR

The pacers are holding up their end, but what about the HOY trotters?

It's been 77 years (1947) and we are still without a trotter named HOY siring a HOY. Not Muscle Hill, Muscles Yankee, Nevele Pride, Scott Frost or Mack Lobell.

But on the pacing side, they are holding up their end of the deal, thank you.

Rocknroll Hanover (2005 HOY) sired 2010 HOY Rock N Roll Heaven from his first crop.

Albatross 1971-72 HOY sired a three-pack: Niatross (both 1979-80 HOY) and Fan Hanover, 1981 HOY.

Niatross had a first crop winner with Nihilator, 1985 HOY.

Cam Fella joined Albatross as the only ones to double up on each side. Cam Fella was the 1982-83 HOY and sired both Precious Bunny and Cam's Card Shark to the honor in 1991 and 1994, respectively.

Bye Bye Byrd was the 1959 HOY and 17 years later so was his son Keystone Ore (1976) that gave Stanley Dancer his seventh HOY trophy, easily an all-time record.

DRIVER OF THE YEAR SCOTT ZERON

It's not supposed to play out like this if you look at the PPs.

Scott Zeron is 34 and is a three-time Hambletonian winner before age 35.

Keep in mind he's never won a Hambletonian with a favorite, he was wiped out in 2017 with International Moni in the first turn after winning his elim, and was not even in the race in 2022 due to injury.

I am guessing Zeron never saw the following list:

WILL WE EVER HEAR THESE WORDS AGAIN?

"Richest ever pace, richest ever race."

It happened 40 years ago in the summer of 1984. They were just 27 days apart. The richest ever Meadowlands Pace (\$1,293,000) went to On The Road Again driven by Buddy Gilmour for trainer Harry Poulton, then the richest race ever held, the \$2,161,000 Woodrow Wilson was won by Nihilator driven by Bill O'Donnell for trainer Billy Haughton. Five drivers appeared in both, and surprise, all are Hall of Famers: Carmine Abbatiello (Andrel and Ramblin Storm), Bill O'Donnell (Guts and Nihilator, favored in both), John Campbell (Russ Lynn Scott and Supreme Dynasty), Ron Waples (Jariz and Witsends Wizard) and finally Buddy Gilmour (On The Road Again and Standing O).

BURKE POWER

For 17-straight seasons, the Burkes have led the trainer standings. Fifteen for son Ronnie and two for dad Mickey. All-time records in \$10 million, \$20 million, and career money and all-time records in wins during the last 17 years. And the all-time richest horse, Foiled Again with \$7,635,538.

LITTLE KNOWN FACTS

1. John Campbell's first divisional winner was a 4YO son of Albatross in 1981 named Royce.

2. he Meadowlands Pace was not advertised as that initially. It was the \$400,000 estimated "The Meadowlands" prior to 1977 when Escort, after a 0-for-18 freshman season, won it in Year 1 with a record \$425,000 on the line.
3. John Kopas is well known for his famous DQ with Savilla Lobell in 1981 in the \$700,000 Sweetheart, then the richest race for females. But, just 11 months earlier in 1980, he was DQ'd with Center Square in the Wilson elims after winning in 1:58.3. He was placed fourth and out of the richest race to that point – \$2,011,000 won by Land Grant – one of the horses elevated to make it to the final. That was the elim where 1-10 favorite French Chef broke at the start, recovered to make it to the top in :58 flat, but tired and finished well back.
4. There were 154 eligible to that 1980 Wilson. Two would sire million-dollar race winners and both involved Ray Remmen. In 1985 the \$1,344,000 Wilson went to Grade One, giving Remmen his biggest purse win, from the first crop of Slapstick (favored in the 1980 Wilson). The aforementioned French Chef was the sire of 1990 HOY Beach Towel.
5. One of the many reasons why Garden State Park (GSP) was not the "Track of the 21st Century" as advertised. There was the erroneous thought that it would be "Meadowlands South," but I was all over that from Day 1. What I didn't know was that the idea was actually hatched in 1977. On July 13, New Jersey Governor Brendan Byrne passed legislation to allow the NJSEA to buy and rebuild Garden State Park. The purchases would be made through bond issues (Sound familiar?). A fire had destroyed GSP on April 14 that year and the project was actually called "Meadowlands South."
6. I never knew that Adios Harry, a yearling in 1952, was named that by Max Hempt, who was furious with President Harry Truman (in 1952 his near eight-year reign was about to end) and this was Hempt's way of waving sayonara. Adios Harry ended the decade with a \$345G bankroll to edge by Belle Acton as the richest and the fastest of the decade too by virtue of his 1:55 mile at Vernon Downs.
7. Has there ever been a more forgotten/maybe even disrespected horse who made \$2 million in their career than Jake And Elwood? He was 33-for-63 racing at 2-3-4 and missed a nose to 1990 HOY Beach Towel in the Meadowlands Pace, and you never ever hear his name mentioned. Not even then.
8. Speedy Crown was the first sire to sweep all divisions for 2 and 3YOs in the year end ballots in 1982 with Dancers Crown (2YOCT), Armbrus Blush (2YOFT), Jazz Cosmos (3YOCT) and Dance Spell (3YOFT).

Stig H Johansson retires

Hall of Famer Stig H Johansson, 78, has ended his career as a professional trainer. The most successful trainer in Sweden's history will now enjoy his retirement in his home Stora Alby outside of Stockholm.

Johansson won his first race in August 1963 and 6,224 additional victories in the bike would follow during his long career. As a trainer, Johansson claimed 8,206 wins and among all these victories he won Elitloppet six times, The Derby seven times, the Kriteriet five times and the Prix d'Amérique one time.

Johansson's dominance in the sport in Europe during the '80s and '90s was total. He was a serious factor wherever he competed and he was not shy in testing his horses in countries outside of Sweden. In America, Johansson was successful with Peace Corps in the Breeders Crown and when he won the Nat Ray Trot with Victory Tilly in 2002, he did it in a new world record time of 1:50.4.

At the end of 2005, Johansson announced that he would quit driving his horses in races and Erik Adielsson became the stable's first driver. Since 2005, Johansson has won a handful of races participating in events where special drivers have been invited to compete.

It's hard to imagine that someone else will dominate the sport to the same extent as Johansson, creating so many great memories for the fans of harness racing all over the world.

UPSET IN PRIX DE BOURGOGNE

The third B-race before the Prix d'Amérique, the \$125,000 Prix de Bourgogne over 1.3 miles, starting with a car, was held at Vincennes on Sunday (Dec. 31) afternoon and an already Prix d'Amérique-qualified trotter became the answer to the riddle.

Fabrice Souloy-trained **Gu d'Heripre** (Coktail Jet) didn't get an easy trip by his driver Francois Lagadeuc. The duo got cover three-wide during the race's first mile, and from that point Gu d'Heripre did the heavy job outside of new leader Horsy Dream.

Souloy's trotter had already qualified for the Prix d'Amérique finishing third behind San Moteur and Izoard Vedaquais in the Prix du Bourbonnais and he proved that he will be a serious threat even in the big race later this month as he easily sprinted to a safe win in a mile rate of 1:52.3.

Strong finisher Emeraude de Bais captured his spot in the Prix d'Amérique as second and Souloy's mare Ampia Mede Sm was third.

Closing day at Harrah's Philly; 2023's leading horsemen recognized

On Sunday (Dec. 31) Harrah's Philadelphia held a 14-race twilight card to close out its 2023 racing season.

The feature was the \$15,000 championship for the American Harness Drivers Club, and the Uncle Peter gelding **Lionhead**, plagued by bad early luck in recent outings, stayed out of trouble for driver Newton "Yogi" Sheridan, refusing to give up the lead and posting a winning time of 1:57.4, equaling his lifetime best on the last day of the year, while defeating Trump This by 1½ lengths. Dawn Anderson trains the winner for owner Terry Morgan.

The Muscle Mass gelding **Warrior Way** was sharp in a two-move 2:00.3 victory in the \$10,000 AHDC consolation. Neil Glasser guided the Joseph Eisenhower, Sr. trainee for Henry Ottinger.

The year's leading horsemen's honors went to one new name (locally at least) and a couple of very familiar ones. On the training side, Brett Pelling picked up his first local UTR title, winning at almost a 37 per cent clip and landing on a final percentage of .497. (Brett's son Jack topped all drivers on closing day with six victories, putting new marks on three of the winning quintet).

Jeff Cullipher's barn finished the meet hot, but Ron Burke's stable had built enough of a lead to register an 83-81 success story. This was Burke's 10th time sending out the most winners in the 18-year history of the riverside oval.

Another 10-time Philly winner is Tim Tetrick, who had a UDR of .395 in claiming his second straight crown in this category. Tetrick also won the dash-winning derby with 242 visits to Victory Lane, his ninth dash crown breaking a tie for the most local driving win titles with George Napolitano, Jr. Only Tetrick, scoring his third consecutive victory in this column in 2023, and Napolitano have won the dash championship since Cat Manzi won the inaugural title way back in 2006.

Racing in eastern Pennsylvania thus comes to a halt; but just for a short time. The 2024 opening of Pocono Downs at Mohegan Pennsylvania is penciled in for Feb. 19, while Harrah's Philly is slotted to be back in action after its traditional winter break on April 12.

Dayton concludes with another successful season

The curtain has fallen on Dayton Raceway's 10th racing season, with records all around. Five track records were tied or broken, a repeat driving champion was crowned, the all-time single day handle record was set, and 2023 saw an increase in total handle for the fifth straight year.

Starting off with new track records, the track crew, led by track super Jim Shelton, had the racing surface extremely sharp all year and it didn't take long into the meet to start setting new marks as the first three fell on Dayton Derby night. **Tattoo Artist** set a new mark for older horses at 1:48 while winning the Dayton Pacing Derby and **Hillexotic** would set a new mark for older geldings by winning the Dayton Trotting Derby in 1:51.1. In the Buckeye Stallion Series final for filly trotters, **Justasiam As** would shatter the old mark in crossing the line in 1:54.4. In December, not exactly a well-known track record breaking month, we saw two records tied. **Art Scaping** tied the older gelding mark at 1:49 and **Dover In Motion** tied the 4YO gelding mark of 1:52.1.

Jeremy Smith picked up where he left off, defending his driving title in 2022 by repeating in 2023. Smith, who was sidelined the first five weeks of the meet while recovering from surgery, spotted his rivals nearly 150 starts. On Dec. 7, he still trailed by 14 wins, and by Dec. 29, he had clinched the title being 22 wins ahead at that time. He won at nearly a 30 per cent clip in December to accomplish that feat. He finished the meet with 143 wins, 25 wins clear of second place Dan Noble. On the training side of things, the Burke Brigade finished out the meet with 37 wins to edge out last year's training champion, Jason Brewer, by just two wins. It's the second title for the Burke barn in the last three years. Burke's \$713,455 in earnings also topped the meet.

Handle at the track saw an increase for the fifth straight year. In 2018, all source handle checked in at \$18.3 million. This year, a new record of \$33.5 million was achieved for an increase of 83 per cent over 2018 and 9.4 per cent over 2022. Dayton also saw a single night record fall handling \$1.286 million on Dec. 28, just one year after setting the previous mark of \$1.272 million.

Dayton Raceway would like to thank all the drivers, trainers, owners, fans, bettors, and staff for helping make our 2023 meet the most successful yet. We look forward to seeing everyone next year.

Clever Cody, Seaside Diva named top 2YO pacers in Ohio for 2023

Clever Cody hit the board in nine of his 10 starts in 2023, winning six including the Ohio Sires Stakes Scarlet Championship, on the way to being named the Ohio 2-Year-Old Pacing Colt of the Year.

In addition to winning the Sires Stakes Championship, the son of The Panderosa won three legs of the Ohio Sires Stakes and the Ohio State Fair Stakes as he earned \$383,372 in 2023.

Trained by Dr. Ian Moore and owned by the Clever Cody Stable, Clever Cody was bred by Marvin Raber.

Moore said Clever Cody had a lot of class as a 2-year-old.

"He was such a pleasure to train," Moore said. "He was fantastic for us and the classiest of our 2-year-olds. I am looking forward to training him back in 2024."

Seaside Diva overcame a catastrophic mid-year injury and returned to the track on her way to being named the 2023 Ohio 2-Year-Old Pacing Filly of the Year.

Trainer Ron Burke said the daughter of Downbytheseaside was injured while out in the field.

"It was a hard year for her," Burke said. "She was cut after being caught in a fence and it changed her whole year. The fact that she came back and made the Sires Stakes final is a testament to her and the people who took care of her."

Seaside Diva finished the year hitting the board in eight of 11 races with four wins, three second-place finishes, and a third-place finish. She earned \$239,805 in 2023.

Clever Cody and Seaside Diva will be honored at the Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association Annual Awards Banquet on Jan. 13, 2024, at the Marriott Columbus OSU in Columbus, OH. Tickets to the banquet are \$30 each and can be purchased by calling the OHHA office at 614-221-3650.

The 2023 Ohio Horse of the Year will be announced at the annual awards banquet.

Dunkin' earns title of winningest horse in North America

Finding a champion racehorse is sometimes like finding a diamond in the rough. The husband-and-wife team of Nick and Betty Clegg found their diamond late in 2021 when they purchased Ohio-bred Dunkin' from the Harrisburg Sale.

Most champions are very expensive at yearling sales; Dunkin' cost the Cleggs just \$7,000, purchased late in the sale.

"We got unbelievably lucky with this gelding," said trainer Betty Clegg. "We purchased him late in the sale, not expecting much, and he is by far the best horse we have ever owned."

The \$7,000 price tag seemed a little steep to Mrs. Clegg, but the gamble paid off for the duo.

As a 2-year-old, Dunkin' mainly raced on the fair and Buckeye Stallion Series circuit, earning six wins in 19 starts with \$47,736 made. He blossomed during the off-season and showed he was all heart in his sophomore campaign.

"Something just clicked with him; we knew he had a lot of heart, and he always would give us 100 per cent, but he had to grow up as a 2-year-old," said Betty. "He grew a lot in the off-season, and I knew he would be something special during his 3-year-old campaign."

His first win of 2023 came at MGM Northfield Park against conditioned company on March 21, 2023. He reeled off a victory in his next three starts and hit the board twice before trying his luck against more challenging foes.

After some tough defeats against stiff competition, the Cleggs took Dunkin' to the Paulding (OH) fair to braven him up, a race that he won easily in 1:59.2. Dunkin' heated up in the latter part of his 3-year-old season, winning 11 straight races, including a leg of the Buckeye Stallion Series and Ohio State Fair at Eldorado Scioto Downs.

The Ohio State Fair is something that still astonishes his connections today.

"I don't think it was his breeding that made him as good as he has been for us; his will to win and his heart stands out with every start," said Betty.

Nick echoed his wife's comments, "Dunkin's biggest attributes are that he loves to race and never gets tired; he is as fast as they come."

Following the 11-race win streak, Dunkin' won five of his next seven starts and was fourth in both the Ohio Sires Stakes final at Scioto Downs and the Ohio Breeders Championship at Delaware (OH). Dunkin' earned \$202,208 in his 3-year-old season, putting up 21 victories in 40 starts, earning him the title of winningest horse in North America for the year.

"I could not be any more proud of my boy, but what he did this year was absolutely astonishing," said Nick.

The Cleggs enjoyed how well-received he was by the fans, no matter where they took him.

"Every time we would win at the fair, Nick would take him by the stands, and the roar from the crowd was something that almost made each of us emotional," Betty said. "The way Dunkin' has become a fan favorite is something very special to us."

On Wednesday (Jan. 3), Dunkin' began his trek back to the races in a qualifier, scoring an impressive victory after getting the perfect trip. The Cleggs knew it was time to get their star back to the track.

"He is bored to death in the barn and is definitely missing racing," said the husband-and-wife team.

As for what the future holds for Dunkin', the Cleggs will enjoy the ride and let their star dictate where they take him next.

For trainer, Betty Clegg, the love of the horse and Dunkin's attitude, week in and week out have brightened her days.

"The only thing I have ever really done is show him love and toss a harness on him," Betty said. "He is a complete sweetheart, while I'm not religious, saying I'm blessed to have my boy Dunkin' in my life, which seems fitting."

Reflecting on the last few years with Dunkin, Nick said, "It's better to be lucky than good; in the case of Dunkin', we got unbelievably lucky. I believe true champions are born, ruined, and never made. Anyone who works as hard as Betty deserves one Dunkin' in their lifetime."

Page and Burke take 2023 Kaltenbach honors

For the fifth straight year, driver Chris Page and trainer Ron Burke have captured the Kaltenbach titles.

The Jerry Kaltenbach Memorial Trophies were established in 1988 and are awarded annually to the driver and trainer who have earned the most dollars competing in Ohio Sires Stakes (OSS) events in a single season.

It is the eighth Kaltenbach title for Page, who passes David Miller for the most titles won. Page started 98 OSS events, winning 27 races, finishing second 10 times, and adding 11 third-place finishes, earning \$1,365,200. Last year Page started in 74 OSS races and had a 23-15-8 record earning \$1,442,700.

Aaron Merriman finished second with 15 wins, 15 second-place finishes, and 10 third-place finishes in 73 starts and earnings of \$1,015,800. Brett Miller finished third for the second straight year. Brett started in 84 races and had a record of 12-11-9 and \$913,150 in earnings.

A total of 58 drivers participated in the 2023 OSS events with 47 garnering at least one purse check. Sixteen had earnings over \$100,000 or more, with eight amassing earnings over \$250,000.

The Kaltenbach title was the sixth for Burke who had 108 starts in the 2023 Ohio Sires Stakes legs, championships, and consolations. His total money earned from these OSS events was \$1,555,000.

Burke finished with 29 wins, 10 second-place finishes, and nine third-place finishes.

Chris Beaver finished second for the fifth straight year with \$626,900 in earnings with a 7-9-8 record from 49 starts. Virgil Morgan, Jr. finished third. He had earnings of \$460,850 with a record of 8-4-2 in 27 starts.

A total of 113 trainers participated in 2023 OSS events with 17 earning over \$100,000 and six with earnings over \$250,000.

In the 36 years the Kaltenbach trophies have been awarded, Page leads all drivers with eight trophies followed by David Miller with seven. David Hawk and Brett Miller have three each. On the training side, Morgan, Jr. and Burke have captured the title six times, while Jim Dailey won the award four times. Only two horsemen have won the Kaltenbach in both the training and driving categories: Sam "Chip" Noble, III and Dave Rankin.

Freshened-up McCarthy wins four at Big M

A 10-day vacation suited driver Andy McCarthy just fine, as the 37-year-old pilot returned from a family getaway in Costa Rica and won four races — from just 10 drives — on Saturday night (Dec. 30) at The Meadowlands, including the 10th-race feature.

"It was nice to spend some time away with the family," said McCarthy. "Things worked out tonight. I had some good drives. It was time to get back to work."

Coachellabound N took the featured \$27,500 pace for fillies and mares who were winners-over \$10,000 in their last four starts by sitting an ideal pocket trip and pulling off a 6-1 surprise as the fourth choice in the wagering.

"I wasn't sure how the race would shake out," said McCarthy. "I thought there would be more horses leaving out of there."

The Ricky Bucci-trained Coachellabound N left alertly and raced in the 2-hole right behind 5-1 third choice Alexa Skye, who cut out fractions of :26.4, :55.2 and 1:23, but Alexa Skye was softened up by 3-2 favorite Intothemysticmoon, who pressed the leader past the middle calls, setting things up for a closer. And McCarthy took the short route to victory lane.

"The trip worked out," said the pilot, whose 85 Big M wins were good for third in the 2023 final driver standings. "She was loaded and had plenty of go. We just needed to get some room. We snuck inside late and she got the job done."

Coachellabound N, a 5-year-old daughter of Sweet Lou—We Love To Party, was a half-length better than Alexa Skye at the finish in 1:51.2. She paid \$15 while scoring for the 14th time from 41 career starts.

McCarthy's other winners came in the third (**Oakwood Ardan Jr**, \$2.60 to win), sixth (**Boiling Oar**, \$3.40) and ninth (**Sport Secret**, \$10.40) races.

BIG BUSINESS: Saturday marked the final program of the year at The Big M, and 2023 from a handle perspective was historic.

After \$3,435,939 was pushed through the windows on the 14-race program, a grand total of \$274,765,520 was wagered on Meadowlands' races over the 89 programs that were contested at the mile oval during the year, establishing a "Jeff Gural-Jason Settlemoir"-era record average nightly handle of \$3,087,253, eclipsing the previous best of \$3.00 million, which was established in 2021.

Gural took over The Big M in December of 2011.

"It's been a great year of business for us at The Meadowlands," said Settlemoir, the track's chief operating officer and general manager. "A race office that always writes competitive events, horsemen who support our entry box which permits us to have full 10-horse fields, and patrons who love wagering into the largest pools in the sport. Those factors were the keys to our success."

A LITTLE MORE: Bucci finished the night with a pair of winners to lead the trainers. The 20-cent Pick-8 failed to yield a winning ticket, setting up a carryover of \$2,942 for when racing resumes. Winning 20-cent Pick-6 players had smiles on their faces, as after a sequence that saw winner's odds of 9-2, 4-1, 6-1, 2-1, 3-1 and 6-5, they walked away with \$5,327. Racing resumes tonight at 6:20 p.m.

Ursis Des Caillons retires at age 16

Jan. 1 was a party day for all horses as tradition has it that all of our four footed "family members" become another year old on this day.

One such horse that will now enjoy the "Life of Riley" in retirement is the French-bred gelding Ursis Des Caillons (Kool Du Caux), who just turned 16-years-old.

Traditionally, horses are forced to take off their shoes when they reach 15, but with horses having an "amateur exemption" of sorts, they get an extra year on the track, if any owner or trainer approves.

Foaled in 2008 and raised in France, his earlier years on the track in France were in distances up to 1 7/8 miles before coming overseas to the U.S. in the middle part of 2018 as a 10-year-old.

He came over with some credentials, too, with the equivalent of \$298,314 on his resume.

He made his first U.S. start in a qualifier on July 13, 2018 and, in an unusual qualifier of 1 1/4 miles, showed his immediate potential by winning in 2:30.4.

On to the French-American Trotting Series at Yonkers, "Ursis" won his first start at 1 1/4 miles in 2:26.2 (:27.4), and followed that up by handily capturing the next leg at 1 1/2 miles in 3:01.3 and, then, the third leg of the series at that same 1 1/2-mile distance in 2:27.2 off of a mile timed in 2:00.

He made a miscue early in the final of that event from post 8 but rallied to finished fourth in a game effort.

Since then, he made winning appearances at Harrah's Philadelphia, Miami Valley Raceway, Scioto Downs, Dayton Raceway, Pocono Downs, Yonkers Raceway, Saratoga and The Meadows with a final tally of 18 wins in the U.S. and \$233,527 in bounty on this side of the Atlantic to go along with a 1:54 mark as an 11-year-old.

As a 15-year-old in 2023, his number was atop the tote-board just a single time — at 67-1 — and made his final appearance on New Year's Eve "eve" before a winner's circle celebration marked the end of his gallant career.

Owned by Fox Racing, Inc., Ursis Des Caillons is one of a vanishing breed of horses that actually make it to retirement age in this era of speed.

Frosty Affair, a 16-year-old trotter competing in amateur events at Pompano Park, won a race in 2003, but that is a rarity in this day and age.

Of course, prior to age restrictions for horses competing, there were several horses in competition that were in their 20s racing, including Abax at 26-years-old (in the early 1950s), Baldwin, 24, Ada Symbol, 23, and Lord Sherbrooke, 21, who raced against his 5-year-old son Lord Sherbrooke II... and beat him in a race.

In summing up Ursis Des Caillons, trainer Justin Ferrari said, "He's just a rare type of equine athlete that would love to continue to ply his trade on the racetrack, but it's time for him to enjoy some well-earned retirement where he can romp in the fields and enjoy life.

"He has certainly earned it."

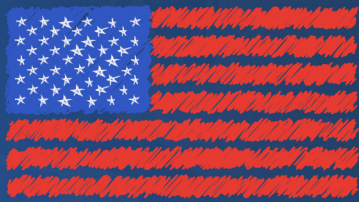
