New Jersey purse subsidy on the cusp of being extended through 2029

The deal, which is critical for the survival and growth of the standardbred industry in New Jersey, has passed the State Senate and now awaits Governor Phil Murphy's signature.

This week, New Jersey Assembly Bill 5893, which extends annual horse racing purse subsidy through the State fiscal year 2029, passed through the State Senate by a vote of 35-1. That followed the passing of the bill by the state Assembly of 73-0 from Dec. 21. It is widely presumed that the formal signing of the legislation by Governor Phil Murphy is imminent.

Current law from 2019 required \$20 million annually for the purse subsidy to be allocated to the New Jersey Racing Commission to be split evenly between the thoroughbred industry and the standardbred industry. With the fiscal year 2024 budget already approved with the subsidy, an extension of five fiscal years would put the subsidy in place through the end of the decade.

The pending extension of the bill is the result of work put forth by many different stakeholders and organizations, one of those being the Standardbred Breeders & Owners Association of New Jersey (SBOANJ). SBOANJ president Mark Ford, who reserved just the slightest bit of reservation until the bill is formally signed, noted that the subsidy is piggybacked to other bills.

"First of all, I am extremely proud of all the work that the board has done to acquire this subsidy both last time and this time, because it was a tremendous amount of work," Ford said. "It was a lot of old-fashioned roll up your sleeves, door-to-door, going to all the different functions of cold hard politics, and it was a

hard sell, too. There was some fighting and at times even some infighting, but I have to take my hat off to Mike Gulotta, Tom Pontone, Al Ochsner, Julie Miller and really the entire board for all the work and nights it took to get it done."

The thoroughbred industry will receive \$10 million of the subsidy. The remaining \$10 million to the harness industry will be allocated as follows in accordance with current law: 60 per cent will go towards overnight purses at The Meadowlands, 12 per cent to Freehold overnight purses, 12 per cent to the New

Jersey Sires Stakes purses, a six per cent purse bonus for New Jersey-sired horses and six per cent for breeders’ awards purses.

“It means a lot to all of us,” said Ford. “It’s all for the overnights, both at The Meadowlands and at Freehold. It’s for the breeders’ awards, and every bit of it goes back to the grassroots and to the people that make New Jersey racing. It doesn’t go into any of the programs administering open stakes. It goes into what it’s made to do, and that’s to promote New Jersey harness racing. I think it’s sometimes perceived as a handout, but it’s not. The subsidies allow for money to remain in the state, it supports the grassroots programs, and encourages people to breed in New Jersey.”

The subsidy first began in 2019 as a means for New Jersey racing to remain competitive with neighboring states whose racing programs receive support directly from casino gaming revenues. Securing the purse subsidy now for another five years in a single shot will be monumental for the industry in the state.

Ford said that going back to 2019, “We knew we needed subsidies for 10 years as sports wagering in the state gets to a larger point. We had five years initially, and then with COVID and all the political unrest, we were able to get it for another

year (2024), and this time we were able to get it through for five years. It was challenging in how we approached this too, with much of the surrounding negativity and positive tests in the news, so we’ve been very careful in promoting the right end to this.”

With funding being secured for the year’s end, it should further a renewed confidence in the state’s breeding program.

Already standing top trotting sires Walner, Muscle Hill and Tactical Landing, New Jersey adds Ecurie D to the roster in 2024. All four of those trotting sires stand at Southwind Farms of New Jersey. On the pacing side, the state awaits the first crop of 2021 3-year-old champion Perfect Sting and adds Tattoo Artist as a new sire this year too. Both of whom stand at Deo Volente Farms. With a strong program ensured for the foreseeable future, the state could play home to more top stallions.

Ford does note caveats in that the industry will need to perform in order for the subsidy to be continually renewed. As a condition of receiving continued purse subsidies, recipients of the funds must report to the Legislature, the Governor, and the New Jersey Racing Commission on the uses of funds appropriated in the preceding year. This annual report – something that has already been submitted since 2019 – includes information on handle, breeding, and other indicators that show the effects of the subsidies to the health of the industry in the state.

Woodbine announces changes to Mohawk Million, Metro Pace back to \$1 million purse

Woodbine Entertainment has announced changes for the 2024 Mohawk Million.

Following a review of the Mohawk Million format, Woodbine has reduced the price of purchasing a slot in the race for 2-year-old trotters from \$100,000 to \$50,000 (Cdn) and will offer all 10 slots in the race for purchase.

The race will continue to offer a \$1 million purse with \$500,000 in added money.

The winner of the William Wellwood Memorial will no longer receive a free slot in the Mohawk Million.



“The Mohawk Million has quickly risen to prominence through four editions and we’re excited to make the investment to continue building the race and event,” said Michael Copeland, CEO, Woodbine Entertainment. “Similar to a race like the Pegasus at Gulfstream, it was necessary that we adjust the conditions to keep this race alive and drive interest.”

“Our team has consistently reviewed the format each year and we feel the changes being made for 2024 are appropriate to the current landscape of the industry and should drive slot sales.”

The 2024 Mohawk Million will take place on Saturday (Sept. 21) at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The deadline to purchase a slot for the Mohawk Million is Feb. 15 with \$25,000 due on that date. The remaining \$25,000 of the slot fee must be paid by June 3. Should more than 10 parties submit to purchase a slot, a draw will be held to determine the 10 slot owners.

Each slot is an entity that may be sold, traded or leased. Slot owners must declare a horse to race in their slot by Monday (Sept. 19) at noon.

METRO PACE RETURNS TO \$1 MILLION PURSE FOR 2024

Woodbine Entertainment announced on Thursday (Jan. 11) that the 2024 Metro Pace for 2-year-old pacers will have a guaranteed purse of \$1 million.

Established in 1988, the Metro Pace is annually harness racing's premier race for 2-year-old pacers. The list of past Metro Pace winners includes Hall of Famers Artsplace, Presidential Ball, Rocknroll Hanover, Somebeachsomewhere and Captaintreacherous.

The 2024 Metro Pace, to be held on Saturday (Sept. 21) at Woodbine Mohawk Park, will be the 13th edition to have a purse of \$1 million and the first since 2012.

"The Metro Pace has a rich history and is supported strongly each year in nominations," said Bill McLinchey, vice-president of standardbred racing. "We've been able to get the purse of the Metro back up towards seven-figures in recent years, including a \$970,000 purse in 2023.

"We're proud of our elite stakes program and it's very exciting to offer to our racing participants and fans three million-dollar races in 2024."

The Metro Pace joins the Pepsi North America Cup and Mohawk Million as Canada's only million-dollar standardbred races.

Nominations for this year's Metro Pace close on Feb. 15.

The full 2024 standardbred stakes schedule for Woodbine Mohawk Park will be released next week.

To race or not to race? It's often a tough call.



Behind the decision to cancel racing at The Meadowlands

The track canceled live racing last Saturday due to an abundance of caution and explains that a lot more goes into the decision than you might think.

When The Meadowlands decided to cancel the race card on Saturday (Jan. 6) out of an abundance of caution due to an impending winter storm, some took to social media to question the decision. After all, when all was said and done, the snow

accumulation at the track's home in East Rutherford, NJ was maybe an inch or two. However, those people aren't seeing the forest for the trees, because The Meadowlands did not need to receive the full brunt of the storm for a cancellation to be necessary.

Even on the U.S. Trotting Association (USTA) website, the headline put on the cancellation story, "Meadowlands abandons Saturday live racing, remains open for simulcast and sports betting," certainly set a tone considering the original headline sent out by the track was "Meadowlands live racing cancelled, track remains open for simulcasting & sports betting."

"It was a poor choice of a title that the USTA decided to use," said Jason Settlemyer, chief operating officer/general manager of The Meadowlands. "But it seems like there might be an inside agenda."

Mark Ford, president of the Standardbred Breeders and Owners Association of New Jersey, has been in this business long enough to know that decisions rarely get 100 per cent approval and dissenters love to post their views.

"I know we caught a little bit of flack, but not much, that South Jersey was fine, but there would have been 50 horses probably scratched," Ford said. "And not only that, but the people that did try to come, how are they going to get home? It started snowing at four o'clock and if you get stuck, you've got horses to worry about. So, you've got to think about the animals. [Racing] is not a life and death situation, it's entertainment, so you have to put common sense into play, too."

According to Ford, discussions start as soon as the weather reports come out early in the week, keeping in mind that cancelling, especially in the winter, throws off a horse’s schedule.

“Everybody wants to race, but after you’ve been through it a few times, you’ve got to use the common-sense factor.

“It’s unbelievable how much the weather changes 50 miles to the north, the west or the south. The last couple of years we’ve been very spoiled because we haven’t gotten [a lot of accumulating snow].”

According to local forecasters, the storm, which moved in from the west, was expected to drop 3-to-6 inches at The Meadowlands, 6-to-10 about 10 miles north and west, and possibly a foot or more further north, west or northwest about 50 or more miles from The Big M. An hour or more south of the track, where several farms are located in Central New Jersey, they were only going to get rain.

Ford’s training center is located 67 miles north of The Meadowlands housing 28 horses scheduled to race that night at The Meadowlands.

“Up by us, in Goshen, [NY], we literally had 16 inches of snow where there is none 50 miles south, but we knew it was coming and we were pretty much ready for it,” Ford said.

Ford reached out to horsepeople at his training center and at neighboring farms to get a general consensus as the week progressed.

“We do everything we possibly can to make it happen [and race],” he said. “But they said, ‘We just can’t go and we’re not going,’ and you cannot force people to put themselves in danger.”

The decision to cancel is complicated and involves many factors, the most important of which is the safety of the humans and equines involved.

“I knew to the north of us, to the northwest and to the west, the weather was going to probably be terrible,” Settlemoir said. “At the end of the day, the right decision was made, because they received several inches of snow in upstate New York and also north of us and northwest of us as the meteorologists had pinpointed.

“So rather than putting people’s lives in jeopardy, first of all, and horses’ lives in jeopardy, I always err on the side of caution. If the horsemen say they want to cancel, I cancel now. The last thing that I want to do is have somebody come to the racetrack with horses and get killed or get horses killed. I want to be able to put my head on my pillow at night and be able to rest easy knowing that the right decisions are being made to protect the horsemen and horsewomen and the horses.”

Settlemoir talked with his staff throughout the week and had multiple procedures in place depending on what track the storm took.

“We had a plan for racing, we had a plan for not racing, and we had a plan for not racing and remaining open with the sports book and simulcasting, the latter of which we ultimately did,” Settlemoir said.

Settlemoir even got a call from The Big M’s racing secretary, Scott Warren, with concern for the competitors if they did end up racing.

“On Friday night (Jan. 5), Scott Warren had asked me if he could put out a text for people that wanted to stay over at The Meadowlands on Saturday night with their horses if that was possible,” Settlemoir said. “I said absolutely because I knew the weather was going to more than likely be okay in East Rutherford.”

Another consideration with cancellations is timing.

“I tell everybody that unless it’s something freakish, if we’re going to cancel, you’ll know by noon,” Settlemoir said. “Unless there’s qualifiers in the morning. If there’s qualifiers in the morning and the weather looks dicey, then they’ll know the day before or possibly even the day before that.

“I knew I was going to lose between 40 and 50 horses and racing would have potentially put the horsemen and horsewomen and the horses and their vehicles and trailers in jeopardy.”

According to Ford, if they make this decision 10 times, they’re going to make mistakes, but this was not one of those times.

“I know we got a couple of hate mails from gamblers asking, ‘Why aren’t you racing?’ But this doesn’t start at seven o’clock [at night],” Ford said. “It starts at 10 o’clock in the morning when people have to get packed up and ready to go. You have to be there four hours out for Lasix, plus it’s another two-hour trip to get there.

“Everybody wants to wait until the very, very last minute, which is understandable, but sometimes you just can’t do that. It’s really, really, really tough to ask people to go and race all night and then fight the elements all the way home and get home in the wee hours of the morning. The storm could not have hit at a worse time, but I think we absolutely made the right call. It’s better to err on the side of caution than to get somebody killed.”

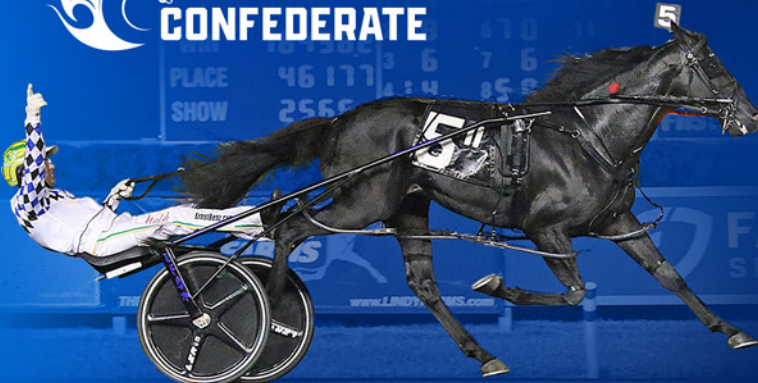

James MacDonald is bringing it home

The top Mohawk reinsman returns to PEI in hopes of third consecutive O'Brien Awards Driver of the Year title.

James MacDonald continues to surprise with the consistency of his dominance in Canada's top driving colony and Canada's national driving statistics. The 37-year-old reinsman remained on top of the 2023 Woodbine Mohawk Park and Canadian standings, recording 431 driving wins from 2,046 starts. He finished 10th overall in North American driving wins last year, just ahead of WMP newcomer Tyler Borth (413 wins from 2,440 drives).

MacDonald reached several new milestones last year, and told HRU Wednesday (Jan. 10) that one stood out.

"Probably going over \$10-million [Cdn. in purse winnings] for the year," he said. "I'd never done it before. Last year [2022], I got to \$9.9-million, but came up just short. It's a big number and I'm pretty proud of that."

He reached the seasonal earnings mark on Dec. 9 at WMP, a rare night when he had just one win, driving Saulsbrook Ian to victory in a Valedictory Series division.

In 2022, MacDonald became the fifth driver in Woodbine-Mohawk harness history to drive 400 winners in one year. He repeated the improbable feat last year, building on a family legacy: Mark MacDonald, his older brother, was previously the most recent driver to achieve that status, driving 404 winners on the WEG circuit in 2006.

There were many other options on James' highlight reel for 2023, including his third consecutive Lampman Cup as top driver in the Ontario Sires Stakes (47 wins, 518 points), and accepting his second consecutive Keith Waples Driver of the Year title at the 2022 O'Brien Awards.

"Yeah, the third Lampman Cup is amazing," said the Guelph, ON-based horseman. "I can honestly say I would have never been

able to imagine winning one, let alone three straight. Canada has so many great drivers so it's truly an honor. It just speaks to the great owners and trainers I drive for."

On Dec. 19, James was also named a finalist for the 2023 Keith Waples Driver of the Year, facing off against regular WMP rival Louis-Philippe Roy, who was voted the Canadian champion driver in 2018 and 2019. The final result will be announced at the 2023 O'Brien Awards banquet, slated for Saturday (Feb. 3, 2024) at the Delta Hotels by Marriott Prince Edward Island in Charlottetown, PEI.

"The O'Brien nomination is special because it was always the ultimate goal for me," said the reigning title-holder. "It's the most prestigious award a driver can win in Canada and I'm really grateful to be nominated again."

The fact that the gala will be held in the province where he grew up adds to the excitement for James.

"Yes, it is definitely more special, the awards being at home," he said. "I have talked to a ton of family and friends that are attending. The MacDonald clan will be huge, cheering on my brother Curtis, our horse Hasty Bid and myself! It's going to be a really great night."

His parents, Fred and Gail MacDonald, are editor of the *Atlantic Post Calls* regional harness racing newspaper and Red Shores Charlottetown track photographer, respectively.

Wednesday (Jan. 10), Cujo Entertainment was named a finalist in the O'Brien Media Excellence Awards' Outstanding Video, Film, or Broadcast category for its independent coverage of the 98th Hambletonian from The Meadowlands. Producer Curtis MacDonald founded the Guelph, ON, audiovisual company in 2014 and produces the Ontario Twos in Training videos for HRU each spring.

Hasty Bid (3, 1:52.3s; \$391,737) is an O'Brien finalist for 3-Year-Old Trotting Colt of the Year. The double OSS Gold leg winner is trained and co-owned by Paige Austin, James MacDonald's fiancée. He was in the sulky for all four of the My MVP—Sunshinenlollipops gelding's wins to date.

While MacDonald enjoyed success with O'Brien Award divisional finalists Adare Castle (older trotting mare), Righteous Resolve (3-year-old trotting filly), Willys Home Run (2-year-old trotting filly), Legendary Hanover (2-year-old pacing colt), Its a Love Thing (2-year-old pacing filly), and So Much More (older pacing mare) last year, he said Hasty Bid was "definitely" the standout, from a personal point of view.

"We broke him, trained him down, and raced and owned him at 2 and 3," James said. "He is the first horse Paige has ever trained, and now being nominated for an O'Brien Award for 3-Year-Old

Trotting Colt of the Year is unbelievable. He's been a very special horse for us both, for sure."

James began the 2024 season with no loss of momentum, winning six of 10 races last Thursday (Jan. 4) at Mohawk. He said that despite his success, his perspective remained unchanged from previous meets.

"As far as goals for 2024, they will stay the same as they have for the last number of years for me: Try to show up to the track every night with a good attitude and be as consistent as possible," he said. "If I do those things, I should have another great year. Also, always try and win big races. That's what means the most to every driver."

While always competitive on the track, James said he was happy to witness the rise of Tyler Borth in the WMP driving ranks last year, Borth's first full year dedicated to driving at the Campbellville, ON track instead of The Raceway at Western Fair.

"Tyler is an amazing driver who has been steadily improving year after year," James said. "Someone told me, when I was starting to do well, it's always better to gradually improve and slowly gain success because it will make you want it so much more. I wasn't surprised at all to see him rack up the wins. He has been dominating at the [Ontario] 'B' tracks the last few seasons and now he is getting more and more great horses to drive at Mohawk. You can see his confidence growing every day. He's going to be a hard guy to beat for a lot of years to come."

New generations impress at Vincennes

French harness racing is stronger than ever and the breeding in France has developed to a level where top trotters are widely born.

At Vincennes on Saturday (Jan. 6) in the \$125,000 Prix Maurice de Gheest for 3-year-old horses, **Luciano Menuet** (Feliciano) showed great ability in a safe wire-to-wire win in a stakes record time of 2:00 over 1.3 miles.

Without a doubt, Luciano Menuet belongs in the top of the French L-crop and the meeting in Paris where fans have a new “crack” (super trotter) to cheer for during the remaining weeks of high-quality racing at Vincennes.

The significantly older trotter **Face Time** (Coktail Jet) hit the lead in Sunday's (Jan. 7) \$100,000 Prix de Lille and Matthieu Abrivard's 9-year-old gelding claimed his fourth consecutive win at Vincennes in a mile rate of 1:54.2 over 1.3 miles.

Four-year-old trotters battled in the \$125,000 Prix Charles Tiercelin the same day and William Bignon trained **Kyrielle** (Enino du Pommereux) upset more merited horses after a third over trip.

Favorite Kotel du Dain had the advantage in the race as the field turned for home, but Kyrielle finished rapidly three wide in the stretch and the 4-year-old mare put her nose first at the wire, in a mile rate of 1:58.4 over 1.6 miles.

Bignon had a nice day at work on Sunday. Benjamin Rochard was entrusted behind Bignon's 3-year-old **Lousiane de Bomo** (Ready Cash) in the \$125,000 Prix Gelinotte for fillies and the duo found space between horses in mid-stretch, which resulted in the win in a mile rate of 1:58.1 over 1.3 miles.

NO SAN MOTEUR IN PDA

Björn Goop's San Moteur, who won the B-race Prix du Bourbonnais in December, will not enter the Prix d'Amérique on Jan. 28 due to a fracture in a splint bone. This was announced by the Goop stable on Tuesday (Jan. 9) at noon.

The last chance to capture a spot in Prix d'Amérique by qualifying races will take place on Sunday (Jan. 14), in the \$125,000 Prix de Belgique.

On Wednesday night, many top horses were still in the Sunday race, but the definitive entries list was not ready on Thursday afternoon so there could have been some changes regarding horses entering the Prix de Belgique.

Jushua Tree, Just A Gigolo and Just Love You are some of the strongest opponents to Joviality, who most probably will be aimed towards the Prix Bold Eagle on the weekend of the Prix d'Amérique.





Many marquee moments are celebrating milestone anniversaries in 2024

Plus, a look back at the 2023 Hambletonian and harness racing's youth movement.

This year marks many momentous milestone anniversaries.

- It's the 100th anniversary of the start of the Hambletonian. In April 1924, nomination ads for a stake with the estimated value of \$50,000 first appeared.
- It's the 70th anniversary of 1954 Horse of the Year (HOY) Stenographer who lived to be a HOY record 35. The filly just did edge out Scott Frost, then 2, for the honors. Otherwise, he would have been the first three-time HOY easily capturing it in 1955-56.
- It's the 60th anniversary of the very first 2-year-old to win HOY, Bret Hanover, who in 1964 went 24-for-24. It was also the first time that the sport had back-to-back Triple Crown winners with Speedy Scot (1963) and then Ayres in 1964.
- It's the 55th anniversary of Nevele Pride winning in world record time twice in a six-day period. She went 1:54.4 and 1:56.4 on a mile and half-mile tracks, respectively, locking up her third HOY title.
- It's the 50th anniversary of the only HOY to win fewer than half of his/her starts. Delmonica Hanover was 5-for-17 in 1974.
- It's the 45th anniversary of Sonsam winning the Meadowlands Pace in 1979 in dynamic fashion from post 10 in a world record 1:53.2. It was the biggest purse, \$750,000, at that time. He was three-, four-, and five-wide from past the half. Maybe the greatest effort ever! It was also the year of the first of 16 Meadowlands driving titles and national earnings titles for John Campbell.
- It's the 40th anniversary of the richest race, Nihilator in the \$2,161,000 Woodrow Wilson on 8/16/84.
- It's the 35th anniversary of the 1989 Hambletonian dead heat. The only race in The Meadowlands history where the track lost

money. It was win wagering only and both Park Avenue Joe and Probe won paying \$2.10.

- It's the 30th anniversary of Cam's Card Shark being named HOY. That was the last time any sire had two different male winners of the award. Cam Fella, won it previously with Precious Bunny in 1991. Speedy Crown won it twice with Moni Maker since then, but no sire has had two boys win it. Art Major's come closest with JK She'salady in 2014 and another lass Test Of Faith in 2021.

- It's the 25th anniversary of the 1:51.3 record Hambletonian by Self Possessed with Ron Gurfein and Mike Lachance. He was a son of Victory Dream for the same connections, from his first crop. That mile was the fastest trotting race mile of 20th century.

- It's the 20th anniversary of the last trainer/driver to win a Triple Crown. Trond Smedshammer won it with Windsong's Legacy.

- It's the 15th anniversary of Enough Talk breaking the 1:50 barrier on the trotting side with a 1:49.3 score at Colonial Downs.

Note: We are 19 months from the 100th Hambletonian and 31 months from the 50th anniversary of the opening of The Meadowlands.

UNBELIEVABLE HAMBLETONIAN DAY 2023

It was incredible. Stuff happened you won't see again for the next 50 or 100 years. Let's take a look back.

- Post 10 won in both The Hambletonian Oaks (Heaven Hanover) and the Hambletonian (Tactical Approach). It was the second straight year it happened in the Oaks, and Iteration was second from the far outside post at 45-1 the year before that.
- It was the first post 10 winner in a Meadowlands Hambletonian.
- Prior to Tactical Approach in 2023, the record for post 10 in the Hambletonian was 40 0-1-3 with 14 checks (not counting the 1981 and 1984 race-offs). Only Chocolatier got a second-place check from the outside starting point, while three horses garnered third: Piggvar (1986), Make It Happen (2008), and Bye Tsem (1994).
- Prior to 2020 in the Hambletonian Oaks, discounting the race-off years, 32 0-1-1 with 11 checks total. In 1986, Chickadee Newton was second and Sassy Syrinx was third in 2012.
- Even rarer is coming from last the first quarter to then win either the Hambletonian or the Oaks. Both winners did so in 2023! It should be noted that It's Academic was also last early and won in the Cashman which was sandwiched in between the two features.
- New Jersey has had 72 Hambletonian/Oaks finals combined not counting either race-offs or non-10-horse finals. Zero times, prior to 2023, in those 72 had any winner been last at the quarter. Glidemaster in 2006 and Cool Papa Bell in 2022 were both eighth at the first call of the Hambletonian and then won and that is the furthest back for the race. No Oaks winner was ever farther back than sixth at the first quarter.

YOUTH RETURN?

Are the younger guys making some kind of statement, knocking on the door and the same time trying to kick it open? Has it been too long since we heard from them; really heard from them. Well, take a look at the next to last weekend at The Meadowlands and put this particular weekend in your memory bank.

On Dec. 22, 12 of 14 races in East Rutherford were won by a driver not yet 30.

On Dec. 23, 11 of 14 races were won by that same group.

There were 28 races, 23 won by 20-somethings. That would be 82.1 per cent.

In 1997, at The Meadowlands, the entire meet, only 10 of 1810 races, or .06 per cent won all the races. That's not a typo. One out of every 180 races to a sub-30 driver.

Some names you might want to jot down are Jonathan Ahle 26, Brett Beckwith 21, Barton Dalious 25, Marvin Luna 22, and Tyler Miller 27.

BY THE WAY, DID YOU REALIZE...

- That the only driver to make both the 1981 Hambletonian and Hambletonian Oaks final in Year 1 at The Meadowlands was Carl Allen? Pams Key was second by a neck as the favorite in the Oaks and Olaf was third in the three-horse Shiaway St Pat raceoff.
- That Berndt Lindstedt never did win the Hambletonian in 17 tries, but one of his drives did sire a Hambletonian winner? Yankee Glide, last in 1998, had Glidemaster, 2006 Hambletonian champ.

- That you could have gotten long odds last Jan. 1 predicting that the fastest trotter of 2023 would be driven by Andy Miller? On Aug. 20, 2023, Just For Trix went 1:49.4 and the fastest 3YOCT, French Wine, went 1:50 winning by a half-length over Tactical Approach on Aug. 27 at Lexington's Red Mile.

- That Goren in the mid-1970s was the largest horse to ever race at The Meadowlands, 18 hands?

- That Confederate could be joining Cam Fella, Precious Bunny, Moni Maker, Gallo Blue Chip, Shartin N, Artsplace, Keystone Ore, Always B Miki and Fancy Crown as HOY winners who started out elsewhere?

- That three of the four 2-Year-Olds voted HOY went undefeated, and the one that did not, won 26 times? Nevele Pride in 1967 was 26-for-29. JK She'salady went 12-for-12, Niatross went 13-for-13 and Bret Hanover went 24-for-24 prior.

- That had Karl won that nose at Red Mile, he might be getting a fair amount of HOY votes?

- That Ron Gurfein is the last trainer to win the Hambletonian more than once with the same catch driver? Gurfein partnered with Mike Lachance to win in 1994 (Victory Dream), 1996 (Continentalvictory), and 1999 (Self Possessed). All four of Takter's Hambletonian wins were with different drivers.

Driver Chris Alford looks for a milestone win, while trainer Mark Purdon hopes to sizzle in stakes

The two Down Under Hall of Famers are searching for summer glory in Melbourne.

Down Under harness racing will get the chance to celebrate two of its all-time greats during Melbourne's Summer of Glory carnival over the next three weeks.

Hall of Famers Chris Alford and Mark Purdon will be key players, albeit in different ways.

The Victorian-based Alford, 55, is nearing yet another milestone record with his 8,000th driving win just around the corner. At the time of this writing, he was on 7,984 wins.

While Purdon, 59, is returning to Victoria – the scene of some of his greatest moments and best memories – with two of his best pacers for the first time since 2020.

Let's go local first and reflect on the enormity of the feat Alford is about to achieve.

As he nears 40 years as a driver, Alford has broken just about every record and won almost all major races in Australia.

To give context to the 8,000-win milestone, the best by a Down Under driver is 6,303 wins by the late great Gavin Lang, Alford's fiercest but most respected rival.

Alford has been Australia's leading driver a staggering 15 times.

And the 456 wins he posted in season 2017-18 is still clearly an Australian record. He finished eighth on the 2023 premiership table, but still with an impressive 185 wins.

"The wins aren't coming as quickly as they used to, but I'm still enjoying it as much as ever," Alford said.

"I think it's because I'm so competitive. Whatever sport it is, I've always been competitive and really want to win."

That flows into a lovely anecdote about his 13-year-old son, Sam.

"He still can't beat me shed cricket... because I won't give an inch," Chris said with a laugh.

One of the highlights of 2023 for Chris was a brief trip to the U.S. to drive Aldebaran Zeus in the Yonkers International Trot.

It gave him a chance to catch-up with friends like Tim Tetrack and ponder what might have been.

"I do look at the likes of Dexter [Dunn] and Toddy [McCarthy] and think about what it would have been to try my luck in the U.S. when I was younger," Chris said. "The reality is it was a different time back then. I was driving more than 100 winners a year for the top [Victorian] stable with Noel [Alexander] and Jayne [Davies] and no sooner did they scale back when I picked up a lot of the driving for Emma [Stewart] and Clayton [Tonkin]. I had great opportunities and a family and I would've had to give up so much here.

"But I can certainly understand why people like Dexter, Toddy and Andy [McCarthy] have made the move because it's a tough grind over here and a lot harder than when I first started driving all those years ago.

I'd expect more young Aussie drivers to give [the U.S.] a go in coming years."

Chris has driven some of the greats of the sport, starting with Golden Reign. They combined to win a string of major races,

including the first of Chris’ two Inter Dominion pacing finals in Christchurch, New Zealand way back in 1995.

He had to wait 20 years to add a second Inter Dominion pacing final when he teamed with another of his favorites, Lennytheshark, in Perth in 2015.

“They’re probably the two best pacers I’ve driven, with Tailmade Lombo right up there, too,” Chris said.

“Golden Reign was the first really good horse I drove and he took me everywhere. It probably makes him the most special, but Lennytheshark had plenty of quirks and an incredible will-to-win. We just got along really well.”

Chris will be hoping to add to his Group 1 haul in coming weeks, largely with the best horse he currently drives, star trotting mare Queen Elida.

Purdon said he hoped to be back in Victoria when Alford reached his 8000th win.

“Chris has been one of the greats for so long now,” Purdon said. “We’re a similar age and it feels like we’ve competed in many of the same big races for so long. I remember that win with Golden Reign all those years ago. He beat a great field that year and to do it at Addington really made people stand up and take notice of Chris and Golden Reign.

“Eight thousand wins is incredible when you think about it and he’s still as respected a rival now as he has been for 35 years.”

For all his remarkable success in New Zealand, many think Purdon’s greatest achievements have come crossing the Tasman to win so many mega Australian races with stars like Pride Of Petite, Lazarus, Sharp And Telford, Buster Hanover, Auckland Reactor, Young Rufus, Adore Me and so many others.

Purdon admits to a special liking for Victoria.

“I was having dinner with a few of my staff before Christmas and was telling them how much I’m looking forward to going back to Victoria,” Purdon said. “I always look back on those Moonee Valley days [in the 1990s and 2000s] as the best era and most enjoyable times I’ve had in the game. The racing was great,

there was a real buzz and I made so many great friends in all those trips to Melbourne.

“I feel like I haven’t been in so long. I’m looking forward to catching up with lots of people as much as I am the racing.”

Purdon is bringing his two best pacers – Akuta and Don’t Stop Dreaming – and will launch the raid at Melton on Jan. 27.

Akuta, clearly NZ’s best pacer, will progress to Victoria’s biggest race, the \$450,000 Hunter Cup on Feb. 3 at Melton.

Don’t Stop Dreaming will race on the same night, but in the \$100,000 4YO Bonanza to try and book a spot in the Group 1 Chariots Of Fire – Australia’s biggest 4-year-old race – at Menangle in NSW on March 2.

In contrast to many of his previous Aussie raids, Purdon says he is more hopeful than confident of success.

“I really like my two horses, but I’ve also got huge respect for the Aussie horses,” he said. “Akuta will need to step-up to win a race like the Hunter Cup, but I’m sure he’ll be very competitive and I think the trip will be good for him.

“The gap has closed between our best horses, especially the young ones, and the Aussies.”

Purdon, who now trains in partnership with his son, Nathan, recently expanded into thoroughbred training after buying some yearlings last year.

“It’s something I’ve thought about for a long time and people have asked me to give it a try,” Mark said. “I love watching the races at home on a Saturday.”

But, for now, his focus is back on harness racing.

“Getting back over [to Victoria] will be great and it’d be even better if we could pick up a win or two while we’re there,” he said.

Punters bet \$421,221 as Batavia Downs sets new record handle

Batavia Downs opened their 2024 winter meet last Thursday (Jan. 4) and celebrated with a new all-source handle record of \$390,922. Now only four days later on Monday (Jan. 8), the second session of racing for this early season has again recorded a new high after \$421,221 was wagered on the afternoon card. The increase is the latest jump in this upward handle trend at The Downs that began last winter and has continued ever since.

"It's good to see the interest our product has continued to draw over this long period of time," said Don Hoover, director of live racing at Batavia Downs. "We have picked up new customers this past year and clearly, they have been supporting us through the windows. We are currently on a great trajectory and we certainly hope it continues."

Bettable races and quality horses have been key and Monday's feature race was just one example. The \$15,000 open I handicap pace for fillies and mares was won by Australian expat **Magical Maya A**, who notched her second North American victory in only her fourth attempt after she cruised gate-to-wire at The Downs.

It was the 10th lifetime win for the 6-year-old Magical Maya A (\$7.60) who is owned and trained by her driver, Larry Stalbaum.

After winning the eighth race on Monday, the 12-year-old **Santana Beach** (Jim Morrill, Jr.) hit a career milestone by notching his 50th lifetime win. Trained by Andrew Torre, who co-owns with Kristen Torre, Santana Beach has now earned \$333,569 from his efforts in 297 career starts.

John Cummings, Jr. was the driving leader on Monday as he registered four winners during the afternoon. "Junior" won with **BJ Lorado** (2:00.1, \$3.40), **Shadow One** (1:57.2, \$3.50), **So Amazing** (1:57.2, \$3.40) and **Jumpinthejailhouse** (2:01, \$7.00). Trainer Brianne Sinclair sent Cummings first two winners to post before adding her third win of the day with **Windemere Ryan** (1:57.4, \$7.60) who was driven by Drew Monti. Sinclair ended up batting 1,000 as she only had three horses entered on Monday.

Big M chock full of things to do this weekend

Talk about a great time to be a fan of both racing and sports.

As the National Football League applied the final brush strokes to their who's-in-the-playoffs easel, the 2024 calendar year got off to a rousing start at The Meadowlands as did the track's popular Winter Meet Survival Challenge.

A total of \$3,228,728 was pushed through the windows on Friday's (Jan. 5) 14-race program, good for an average per race of \$230,623.

Saturday's (Jan. 6) card was canceled due to inclement weather.

"The Big M continues to offer some of the most challenging and competitive racing in the industry," said track chief operating officer and general manager Jason Settlemyer. "When you combine that with the largest pools, low takeouts, a mile track and a wagering menu that allows bankrolls both big and small the ability to make scores, you can see why The Meadowlands continues to be one of the most desirable wagering destinations in racing.

"As far as Saturday is concerned, we simply took into consideration the welfare of our horsemen, patrons and employees. We wanted to keep them safe, and given how far some people travel to the races for business or pleasure, we felt that was the correct move."

This weekend, when racing will be conducted on the usual Friday (Jan. 12)-Saturday (Jan. 13) basis with 14-race programs that will begin at 6:20 p.m., once again, it'll be a big-fields bonanza.

In fact, both programs will have one field with eight horses and another with nine. The other 12 races are all slated to head to the gate with 10 noses behind the starter car. Thus, over the 28-race weekend, there will be 274 (if there are no scratches) horses who will start, an average field-size of 9.78 per race.

"When it comes to racing at The Meadowlands, it's all about full fields," said Settlemyer. "And when we can provide them like we will this weekend, it gives our customers something they go for in a big way. The big fields make for less-predictable outcomes. That's what the people want."

SURVIVE AND ADVANCE: Last Friday also marked the first day of the track's Winter Survival Challenge.

The WSC, which is powered by 123Racing, offers cash prizes and Meadowlands swag in the free competition.

The winner is determined by the highest total bankroll at the end of the Challenge based on a \$2 across-the-board wager on selections for three designated races on each program.

The grand prize is \$750, while \$500 and \$250 go to the second- and third-place finishers, respectively.

CIRCLE THE DATE: After three postponements, it's finally time to save the date.

On Saturday (Jan. 13), The Big M's calendar giveaway, likely the most popular freebie The Big M offers, will take place.

The first 500 guests will receive a 2024 commemorative calendar, filled with images of the sport's greatest horses and drivers in action from the 2023 racing season.

The beauty of these types of wagers is that with a 20-cent minimum, bankrolls do not deplete quickly, allowing the player to stay in action.

The 20-cent Pick-6 will start out with \$3,699 in the hat after no winning tickets were sold. Those with five winning selections were exchanged for \$1,233.30.

The potential for negative takeouts is always on the table. Tonight, were the Pick-8 to attract \$4,000 in “new money,” that would mean players would be betting into a pool that totals approximately \$8,400. The significance for value players? Wicked Character, McSeaside, Jet Hill and Rose Run Yolanda named top sophomores for 2023 in Ohio

In a year with no dominant sophomore colt pacer in Ohio, Wicked Character's win in the \$300,000 Ohio Sires Stakes Championship was the difference on his way to being named the Ohio 3-Year-Old Pacing Colt of the Year.

Owned by Winterwood Farms, Timothy Sullivan, Robert Jackson, and Tom Wilson, and trained by Ron Burke, Wicked Character won five of his 17 starts and earned \$230,320.

Mark Adams of Winterwood Farms said the credit goes to Ron Burke and the Burke Brigade.

“They did a tremendous job and should get all the credit,” he said.

Adams said Wicked Character showed amazing resilience and is a tough animal with a big heart.

For the third time in five years, the defending freshman filly pacer of the year has stepped up to repeat as a sophomore. In 2023 McSeaside followed the path of Sea Silk (2022) and Queen Of The Pride (2019) to be named Ohio's 3-Year-Old Pacing Filly of the Year.

McSeaside started her 3-year-old campaign by winning the James Hackett Memorial. She added wins in four legs of the Ohio Sires Stakes, the finals of the Ohio State Fair Stakes, and the Ohio Breeders Championship.

“Absolutely one of the nicest horses; truly a pleasure to train,” said trainer Burke.

McSeaside started 20 races, winning seven and adding two second and two third-place finishes. She earned \$299,887 in 2023.

McSeaside was owned by Burke Racing Stable LLC, Beastly LLC, J&T Silva Stables LLC, and Knox Services Inc. She was sold to Sergeant Stables at the end of last year who partnered with Andray Farm to produce the Downbytheseaside filly.

Lightly raced as a 2-year-old, Jet Hill rocketed on the scene in 2023, winning two-thirds of his starts on his way to being named Ohio's 3-Year-Old Trotting Colt of the Year.

Owned by Serenity Racing Stables and trained by Edward Miller, Jet Hill hit the board in 13 of 15 starts, winning 10 and earning \$393,400.

The son of What The Hill won the James K. Hackett Memorial at Miami Valley Raceway, three legs of the Ohio Sires Stakes, the Ohio Fair Stakes, and the Ohio Breeders Championship.

The highlight of the year was a world record performance in June at MGM Northfield Park when he won a leg of the Ohio Sires Stakes in 1:52.2 to become the fastest 3-year-old trotting gelding on a half-mile track.

"We knew he was going to be a nice horse, but didn't know how good," said Ian Yoder of Serenity Racing Stable. "He is a very special horse that makes you smile."

Rose Run Yolanda followed up her freshman campaign dominating the ranks of sophomore filly trotters on her way to being named the Ohio 3-Year-Old Filly Trotter of the Year.

It was the third time in the last five years that the 2-year-old champion repeated as a 3-year-old. Gabbys C Note did it in 2022 and 2023 and Only Take Cash accomplished the feat in 2018 and 2019.

Owned by Greg Luther Racing and bred by Rose Run Farm, Rose Run Yolanda won seven of her 18 starts, finished second in five other races, and third place twice. She earned \$449,280. Her wins included three legs of the Ohio Sires Stakes, the Ohio State Fair Stakes, and the Ohio Sires Stakes Scarlet Championship.

Trainer Todd Luther said Rose Run Yolanda was easy to train because of her desire.

"She loves to chase horses and once she learned how to do it at 2 it was all her from there," Luther said.

It's Academic, Bythemissal named Ohio's 2023 Older Trotter and Pacer

Like a fine wine, It's Academic continues to get better with age. In 2023 It's Academic won the most races of his career and earned more money than any other year on his way to being named the 2023 Ohio Older Trotter of the Year.

The son of Uncle Peter hit the board in 16 of his 18 starts, winning half and earning \$951,911.

It's Academic won five races in a row during one stretch which included the Crawford Farms Trot, the Spirit of Massachusetts Trot, the John Cashman Memorial, and the Tom Aldrich President's Trot at MGM Northfield Park. He also finished second in the Breeders Crown Open Trot.

"He far exceeded what we thought he would be," said trainer Ron Burke. "He is a push-button horse that can be raced from the back or the front. He'll do anything you want him to."

Owned by Bradley Grant and bred by GBW Breeding Farm, It's Academic has earned over \$2.3 million in his career.

Bythemissal, Ohio's 2022 Horse of the Year turned in another dominating season, winning the Breeders Crown on his way to being named Ohio's 2023 Older Pacer of the Year.

Owned by Burke Racing Stable, Eric Good, Rich Lombardo Racing, and Weaver Brusceri and bred by Stephen Dey III, Bythemissal hit the board in 14 of his 16 starts, winning 11. In addition to winning the Breeders Crown, Bythemissal won the Sam McKee Memorial, the Myron Charna President's Pace at MGM Northfield Park, the Aria Invitational Pace, the Allerage Open Pace, and the Potomac Pace International. He earned \$984,666 in 2023.

"I know I am biased, but I think he is the best Ohio-sired horse ever," said trainer Ron Burke. "He just has a different way to him. He can do things that other horses can't."

It marks the third year in a row that Ohio's sophomore pacing champion repeated as the older pacer of the year. Ocean Rock repeated in 2020-21 and Charlie May in 2021-22.

OHHA outstanding contribution awards announced

The Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association will honor the late Robert and Paulann Sidley with the Association's prestigious Maynard and Stella Hagemeyer Significant Contribution Award, Tim Harless with the Association's Dick Brandt, Sr. Extra Effort Award, Gina DiMatteo with the Outstanding Groom Award, and former race secretary Gregg Keidel, longtime veterinarian Dr. Robert Schwartz, harness racing supporter and clerk Lisa Schwartz, and the connections of Breeders Crown champion

Tactical Approach with Special Recognition Awards at the Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association Annual Awards Banquet on Saturday (Jan. 13).

The Sidleys were pillars of Ohio's standardbred industry. Robert is a member of both the Ohio Harness Racing Hall of Fame and the Northfield Park Wall of Fame. He served on the United States Trotting Association board of directors, where he was the organization's treasurer from 1993 to 2008, and is a past president of both Harness Horsemen International and the Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association.

The Sidleys owned R.W. Sidley Inc., a construction supply firm founded by Robert's father, Robert W. Sidley, as a mining and manufacturing company in 1933. The couple bred or raced more than 1,000 horses. They took great pride in the harness racing program at their home fair, the Lake County Fair located in Painesville, OH. Their first-class hospitality of the harness racing participants made the fair a must-race event for numerous horsemen for decades.

The Maynard and Stella Hagemeyer Significant Contribution Award is awarded for significant life-long contributions to Ohio harness racing. The recipient must possess a passion and advocacy for Ohio harness racing. The award is based on the importance of educating and involving local and state legislators in the importance of the harness racing industry.

Harless has been involved with racing for over 40 years and is associated with the Darke County Fair in Greenville, OH. In 2023, the fair offered four evenings of racing featuring nearly \$275,000 in purses.

"There is no Darke County Fair horse racing at the current quality without Tim Harless," said Ohio trainer Dalton Walls who nominated Harless. "He is vital to the program and his impact is immeasurable."

Harless serves as the fair's director of racing, race secretary, track director, horsemen's representative on the fair board, and raises funds through sponsorships for the fair's marque events, the Gene Riegle Memorial and Arnie Almahurst Trot.

The award is named for Dick Brandt, Sr., who served as president of the Ohio Harness Horsemen's Association in 1984 and 1985. He was a past chairman of the Ohio Harness Horsemen's health and retirement fund and treasurer of P.A.C.E.R. (Political Action Committee for Equine Racing). He also served as a member of the United States Trotting Association's board of directors and treasurer.

The Dick Brandt, Sr. Extra Effort Award is awarded to an individual, local horsemen's associations, and matinee clubs who have made a commitment to county fair racing. The award is based on involvement with their local fair board, local matinees, community involvement, improvements to racing and barn areas, and assistance with racing programs during the fair week.

Northfield, OH, resident DiMatteo works for and was nominated by trainer Bill Rhoades.

Rhoades said DiMatteo is selfless when it comes to the needs of the horses.

"She tends to every horse's needs that she is in contact with on an individual basis," said Rhoades. "If every trainer was lucky enough to have someone half as hard-working, caring, and dedicated as Gina, this business would be a whole lot easier."

DiMatteo says the best part of her job is being around the horses.

"It is work, but it is relaxing," she said. "The horses bring a smile to my face every day with the things they do."

DiMatteo has been a groom for about 37 years and says the horses are addicting.

"They get into your blood, and you're done," she said.

Keidel has held many different roles in the harness racing industry. He worked as the publicist at Northfield Park before becoming race secretary and director of racing, positions he held for 26 years. Keidel also worked at Running Aces and Pompano Park before returning to Ohio to be the director of racing at both Dayton Raceway and Miami Valley. He remained at both Ohio locations for a decade. Keidel estimates that throughout his career he assembled 6,650 racing programs, consisting of 93,100 races and 791,350 starters.

Dr. Schwartz began his career in 1971 working for Ohio Harness Racing Hall of Famer Dr. Don Mossbarger. Mossbarger started Midland Acres where Dr. Schwartz has been a veterinarian since the farm's inception. Dr. Schwartz is a former chairman of the Ohio Standardbred Development Fund and served on the board of directors at Scioto Downs. He currently serves as president of both the Ohio Colt Racing Association and the Fayette County Fair Board.

Dr. Schwarz's wife Lisa is also being recognized for her contributions to Ohio harness racing. She helped merge the Western Ohio Colt Racing Association and the Ohio Colt Racing Association. Lisa became the secretary/treasurer of Ohio's Signature Series in 2017 and has grown the series from 14 to 34 fairs. In 2023, Lisa worked at 18 county fairs as the clerk, charter, or both, including the historic Delaware County Fair.

Ohioans Joe Sbrocco and R. Kevin Greenfield are being recognized for their part in the extensive success of the 3-year-old trotter Tactical Approach. Sbrocco is part owner and Greenfield is the syndicate manager for sire Tactical Landing. Tactical Approach hit the board in 17 of 19 races, winning 10 including the Hambletonian and the Breeders Crown. He was named the 2023 3-Year-Old Colt Trotter of the Year by the U.S. Harness Writers Association.

New roadster series announced

The U.S. Trotting Association is excited to announce a new series of roadster events for the 2024 show season. Created for horses that either raced or were bred for the intention to race, the series is to promote roadster events as a suitable second career for standardbreds.

"I think it is important to promote the second careers available for off-the-track standardbreds," said Duncan Hyler, an amateur competitor and inaugural winner of the Roadster Division of the Standardbred Incentive Program, who came up with the idea for the series. "Many horses are now being bred specifically for the show ring, but off-track horses are just as suitable."

For the series, the Eastern portion of the U.S. will be broken up into three regions, with each region having four shows. Points are accumulated from competing in the shows and the top three horses in each region will be invited to a final.

Northeast — New England states (VT, NH, MA, CT, RI), New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania

Southeast — Florida, North Carolina, Georgia, Alabama, South Carolina, Virginia, Louisiana, Mississippi

Midwest — Kentucky, Ohio, Illinois, Indiana, Missouri, Tennessee, Michigan, Wisconsin, West Virginia

A committee is being formed with representatives from each region, plus the USTA and the American Road Horse and Pony Association (ARHPA), to establish the shows in the series and will aim to have the schedule established by the end of January.

To be eligible for the series, there will be a nomination fee due. Horses must have had electronic eligibilities ordered (U.S. or Canadian) or sold at a commercial yearling sale, including:

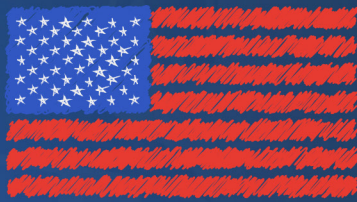
