New Jersey Governor kills bill that would have extended purse subsidies through 2029

Jeff Gural optimistic deal will still get done.

A bill that would have extended annual purse subsidy payments made to new Jersey's thoroughbred and standardbred tracks was vetoed Wednesday (Jan. 17) by Governor Phil Murphy. The bill called for the \$20 million annual subsidy, which is split between the two breeds, to continue through 2029.

The money has already been approved for 2024. The extension was to run from 2025 through 2029.

Murphy vetoed 12 bills in all, using what is called a pocket veto. That type of veto applies only to bills sent to the governor's desk in the final 10 days of a legislative session. If the governor does not sign such bills within seven days of the end of a session those bills are vetoed without being sent back to the Legislature.

Murphy's decision came as a major surprise since he has largely supported racing during his time in office and the bill had overwhelming support in the Senate and Assembly. It passed the Senate by a 35-1 margin and the Assembly by a 73-0 margin.

The purse subsidy is vital to Monmouth Park and to The Meadowlands and Freehold, whose purses would plummet without the extra money and make it difficult to compete with neighboring tracks.

"If we didn't get this money, it would be a disaster," said Dennis Drazin, the chairman and CEO of Darby Development, the management team that operates Monmouth. "We'd either have to cut days or purses."

Meadowlands owner Jeff Gural said he is "confident that it will all work out in the end."

"I believe the governor remains in favor of extending the subsidies," Gural said. "He just wants it done in a manner that is satisfactory to him."

Drazin admits he was alarmed when first hearing news of the veto and he immediately placed a call to Murphy. Drazin said Murphy called back within 15 minutes and reassured Drazin that future purse subsidies remain very much alive.

"I spoke with him and he wholeheartedly supports the industry, but he did not feel a bill like this should get passed through a lame-duck session," Drazin said. "He is committed to continue to work on and it get it done through the budget process. I take him at his word. He has been supportive of the industry ever since he's been in office and he says he will get it done, just not the way it was being handled. I trust this governor. He made a commitment and I am taking him at his word. If he had said, 'I'm vetoing it that's it,' we'd be having a different conversation."



Ken Middleton back with a fresh start in the new year

The veteran race caller returns after a six-month recovery from a training accident to begin his 25th year at Canada's top harness track.

On Jan. 15, a familiar voice returned to Woodbine Mohawk Park for the first time in many months. Regular announcer Ken Middleton was back to call the races, beginning his 25th year with Woodbine Entertainment in typical strong form.

He told HRU that his long absence from the track gave him a moment of hesitation when he arrived at Mohawk on Monday.

"When I first stepped out of my truck, it felt kind of odd, because I was just setting myself up for the fear of maybe something going wrong," he said. "As it turned out, it didn't. I just went in and did the [pre-game show] interview with [WMP racing analyst] Elissa [Blowe]... Our crew had it all mapped out perfectly, so it was just like having a conversation on the phone or sitting down with somebody at a table, having a coffee."

After the encouraging interview about his comeback, he said the rest came easy.

"When I got in the announcer's booth, it was like I was just there the day before," Middleton said. "The only real difference was there were some new horses that I hadn't called, obviously. Just that little bit of unfamiliarity. That was really it; everything else was very seamless."

Middleton's race-calling career began when he was just 16 years old, at Flamboro Downs. He left to join Woodbine Entertainment in 1998, when he was 28. He has been the regular Mohawk race-caller since 2006. When he was seriously injured in a training accident last year, the resulting absence from work was his longest ever.

“It was a long time away, for sure,” he said. “It was the end of June, so upwards of six months [away].”

Being behind the mic again was relatively simple for the accomplished announcer, who said he had no idea how many races he’s called over his career. It was getting back to training horses and everyday life that was the original challenge, as Middleton recovered from the accident and complications.

“The initial thing, obviously, was to get over dealing with pain, and healing,” he said. “But down the road, I think it’s about pain management and getting in the right frame of mind. So, what really, really helped me, the biggest improvement I saw, has come as the result of seeing a neurologist in late November for an EMG [electromyography] test, which tests your nerves. He got me on a radically different group of meds, and I started taking those just before Christmas... I was maybe 40 per cent; after taking the meds now, I’m probably looking at 70 or 80 per cent. That’s how much of an enormous jump I’ve made.”

Middleton also made the leap back into training horses again, after the removal of a PICC (peripherally-inserted central catheter) line which delivered intravenous antibiotics into his arm.



Middleton said, “It’s not going to hurt you to go and do certain things. You’ve got to regain your strength and mobility and flexibility. So, I’ve been coming to the barn for quite some time now. I’m getting stronger, but I realized I still have limitations.”

Middleton said he lives close to his horses and where they train, making his journey back to the barn a little easier.

“I have my own private house and farm,” he said. “It’s a small hobby farm, where I have my broodmares. It’s in Cambridge, ON. Basically, the training center that I’m at is two minutes down the road from where I live. It’s Shamrock Training Centre. I’m fortunate in that regard.”

He added that he was also fortunate to have friends like multiple O’Brien Trainer of the Year Richard Moreau, 2023 O’Brien Award of Horsemanship finalist Dr. Ian Moore, and other horsepeople who were able to do what he could not.

“When I originally got hurt, [Moreau] had a truck and trailer here at Shamrock Training Center to pick up the racehorses that I had in training and that were currently racing,” Middleton said. “So, he helped me out, and guys like Ben Hollingsworth, Dale Spence, Ryan Desroche, have helped me out with driving and helping warm up, because we’re limited and can’t go out and warm up the horses on race night. So, they’ve been great.”

Middleton said he’s able to jog horses again, although he is currently careful about it.

“At first, it was just sort of overseeing everything [at the barn] and doing very limited stuff like making feeds,” he said. “I have started getting back [on the track]. The right type of horse, I’ll jog and stuff like that. You know, it’s got to be really quiet. I’m just very aware of that. I kind of had to just get it out of my mind. It’s what I enjoy, too. You can’t give up your whole life, fearful of things.”

He was rewarded with recent wins by trainees Dont Poke The Bear (p, 3, 1:55.3s; \$83,576) on Jan. 11 at Flamboro and Little

Missy May (p, 2, 1:55.2s; \$22,115) on Jan. 16 at The Raceway at Western Fair. He co-owns the horses with James Grant and Dave Walls, both of Sarnia, ON. Jane Watkins of Oshawa, ON shares ownership with them on Pretty Missy May, while Middleton’s niece Kendal Middleton also co-owns Dont Poke The Bear.

“It’s just a great sense of satisfaction, because they’re all homebreds,” said the WMP race-caller. “It makes my family feel good too, because they’re all here working hard, and it’s good for my owners; they’re all great guys. Nothing’s better than winning a race. You get to go out and buy donuts for everybody the next morning in the barn.”

To this day, Ken is unsure of what caused his life-altering accident. But he said he doesn’t want to name the horse involved, because it did not intend to hurt him.

“I don’t want people to get a feeling that the horse did something wrong,” he said. “He was the quietest, nicest horse... I’m not 100 per cent sure why the horse did what he did... I think he got scared of something... I got flipped basically right out of the jog cart, and when I hit the ground is when I suffered the injuries. When the horse spun real quick and I flipped out of the jog cart and hit the ground, that’s when I knew I was in trouble.”

His love for working hands-on with the horses has come back with full strength, even as his physical rehabilitation remains incomplete. Ken said his stable is growing, literally and figuratively.

“I have three broodmares, all in foal, some of which are owned by some of my owners,” he said. “I have four horses in training right now at Shamrock Training Center: Dont Poke The Bear, Pretty Missy May, Bob Loblaw (p, 3, 1:50.3s; \$202,744) is still here – he’s on the comeback trail – and a horse that’s qualified once and he’s almost ready to get back to racing. His name is Camealongway (p, 2, 1:52.2s; \$97,378). He’s 5.

“I just claimed a horse the other night and we gave him to Richard Moreau to train. My buddies and I and my brother chipped in and claimed a horse named Music To My Gears [p, 12, 1:52.2s; \$78,531]. He’s a stallion and he’s a Lasix horse, so it’s tough for our set-up to deal with something like that.”

Ken said resuming work with his horses was encouraging, and he experienced “a different flood of emotions” in his first night back at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

“You gain a bit more normalcy back in your life every day, so this is the next step, working again,” he said. “I needed to get back to work from a financial perspective... But also, internally as well. You have a certain group of friends and colleagues at work which you admire, and you respect their friendship and you miss them, too.”

The announcers who filled in for him when he was recovering earned a special round of compliments, as well.

“I have great admiration for all of them, and for my boss [Mark McKelvie] too, because he’s the one who had to assemble it all, like trying to round up rock bands for Live Aid,” Ken said. “I know it was a big deal for them, because WEG is a big deal... I was a young guy once, and I used to marvel at the thought of, ‘Man, it would be so cool to come here and call races someday!’

“You take that for granted a little bit, but in the back of your mind, you know when people like [Kawartha Downs’] Evan Loucks and [Rideau Carleton’s] John MacMillan, that aren’t [at WMP] all the time get a chance to come here and call, it’s a big deal, and it’s a big responsibility, and it’s a lot of fun. I felt good for those guys because they had a chance to enjoy that, and they all did marvelous jobs.”

Canada’s best-known current harness announcer called the barrage of well wishes from friends, fans, and horsepeople

“really humbling.” He said he would be back in the booth for the Thursday (Jan. 18) WMP card and onward, with other exciting plans soon to be announced.

“There’s been a lot of tough days, trust me; it seemed like there was a black cloud hovering over my barn and myself,” he said. “Maybe 2024 is telling us that it’s going to be a turnaround year where things are going to go our way.”

Diamond Creek's multi-award-winning year that was a decade in the making

When Maine native Adam Bowden founded Diamond Creek Farm less than 20 years ago, he could not have envisioned the success he had in 2023, although it was always the goal.

"I was a 24-year-old knucklehead who ended up going to the yearling sales," Bowden said of the origins of Diamond Creek. "I think I bought five race fillies and then I went to Harrisburg and bought 20 mares and that was 2005, the fall of 2005."

The U.S. Harness Writers Association named Bowden's Diamond Creek racing and breeding entities the 2023 Dan Patch Owner of the Year and Breeder of the Year, respectively, and their stallion, Sweet Lou, the inaugural Dan Patch Pacing Sire of the Year.

Diamond Creek acquired Sweet Lou 10 years ago, partly setting in motion the success currently being seen.

"It's kind of a true rags-to-riches story," owner Mark Weaver said of Sweet Lou.

Weaver, of Weaver Bruscelli with partners Burke Racing, Larry Carr and Phil Collura, owned the son of Yankee Cruiser—Sweet Future prior to the formation of the Sweet Lou Syndicate in January of 2015. Bowden is their syndicate manager.

"Adam was very interested in standing him and we were able to work something out," Weaver said. "He went after him pretty hard... Luckily for us, we didn't finalize the deal until after that 5-year-old season and we got paid quite a bit more."

Weaver, who represents the Burke Brigade when it comes to standing their stallions, admits that 10 years ago when they syndicated Sweet Lou, he didn't know a lot about that side of the business, but he always had a lot of faith in his stallion, although some others did not.

"[Sweet Lou and Captaintreacherous] went to stud the same year," Weaver said. "Lou went after his 5-year-old year and Captain after his 4-year-old year, and Lou's first year, his 2-year-olds averaged more than Captaintreacherous' did."

"But [Sweet Lou] didn't get the recognition and, honestly, it irked me. People were talking — the connections in particular of Captaintreacherous — as if he was the greatest stallion ever and here our stallion's 2-year-olds averaged more than Captaintreacherous."

That initial lack of respect didn't give Lou the best mares. However, he still produced on the track.

"So, that first crop had Warrawee Ubeaut, who was phenomenal, and won the Breeders Crown at 2 and 3," Weaver said. "It was because of that first crop success that we got quality mares."

"Those quality mares [produced] Confederate, Cannibal and It's My Show. That's the year that was in reaction to Lou's first year. We always felt what he was able to do with just okay mares, once he got the good ones that they would dominate and that's exactly what's happened."

Bowden remembers sitting down with Weaver after Warrawee Ubeaut's 2-year-old season.

"We were like, all right, we're going to raise his fee and we're also going to hand pick mares and Diamond Creek is going to breed a bunch of what we think are good young mares, and Burke Racing was going to breed a bunch of good mares," Bowden said. "We sold breedings for upfront, no guarantees that were higher than the stud fee. And it was a massive risk on our part and Mark was willing to buy into it."

"And it was really his idea that if Sweet Lou was ever going to have a chance to showcase and shine that it was going to come on the backs of this group of mares and he was right. We were right. It was amazing."

"Mark and us always felt if Sweet Lou got a comparable book of mares to Captaintreacherous that he would outperform him, and he got an equal book, maybe even slightly better, and he absolutely crushed him. And I think that was our goal, to show the world that Sweet Lou deserved this kind of accolades and respect, and it ended up working out. Now he stands for \$20,000, does a full book of mares and we're oversubscribed."

Some have referred to 2023 as the "Year of Lou," due to the accomplishments of the 15-year-old stallion's offspring, especially in the "glamour boy" division, but that's not the phrase Weaver prefers.

"I don't know who started it and I kind of don't like the slogan because it kind of implies that it's just this year," Weaver said. "This is 10 straight years of [his book] being full and that's more like the 'Decade of Lou.' Nobody knows about a stallion. I'm not going to act like I knew he would be this good."

But he's such a good outcross to so many different mares."

Weaver loves to be as hands on as possible when it comes to the management of Sweet Lou, except when it comes to giving the acceptance speech, which he'll leave to Bowden.

"With Diamond Creek, they're in charge but I'm probably, I would assume, more involved in the process than most of the other owners and, to be honest, I'm involved as much as they'll let me

be," Weaver said. "My favorite day of the year, every year is when his book is announced full and closed and I'm usually anxious for it to happen... To me it's just such a sense of satisfaction to know that the people have supported him again."

"I have two kids and a dog and he's like my fourth. It's almost like having a kid. It feels good for him to get the support and then be able to show it on the track. It's way better than any experience with racing. It's a whole other level of satisfaction."

According to the U.S. Trotting Association's 2023 sire statistics for 3-year-old pacers, Sweet Lou led the way in earnings with \$6,846,031, followed by four sons of Somebeachsomewhere: Captaintreacherous (\$5,258,526), Downbytheseaside (\$5,099,352), Stay Hungry (\$4,786,762) and Huntsville (\$4,748,151).

Weaver mentioned that the Somebeachsomewhere line is strong and that Lou and his sons are a good breeding choice for 'Somebeach' mares.

"If it weren't for Lou, who would all those [Somebeachsomewhere mares] breed to?" Weaver said. "So, you've got Lou, who's a great option, and now Confederate and [Lou's] other son, Lou's Pearlman, and his other son, Cannibal."

"Lou has kind of been, I think, a godsend for the industry... I think it's only going to make him that much better. Yeah, he's in a great spot."

Three of Sweet Lou's offspring combined to win seven races worth over \$300,000 in the 3-year-old male pacing division alone. Presumptive Horse of the Year, Confederate, won the

Meadowlands Pace (\$668,000), Breeders Crown (\$600,000), Kentucky Sires Stakes Championship (\$400,000) and Cane Pace (\$315,700), It's My Show won the Little Brown Jug (\$850,000) and North America Cup (\$760,000) and Cannibal won the Adios (\$350,000).

“Bob Heyden might be the one to ask if it's ever been done like this where [one sire] kind of dominated just about every major 3-year-old [male] race,” Bowden said. “But then you add in all the 2-year-olds and the fillies and it was crazy.”

Sweet Lou is also the sire of standout pacing fillies Geocentric and My Girl EJ.

Diamond Creek Farm bred three of the 12 Dan Patch division champions: Bond, Confederate, and the aforementioned Geocentric. Diamond Creek is also the Grand Circuit Owner of the Year.

“I think it was always in the back of our mind that it was a possibility,” Bowden said. “Like the stars seemed aligned heading into the year for certain things to happen. Now, I wouldn't have told you Bond would have been 3-year-old champion just because I figured Special Way was head and shoulders above everybody else. And I think she was before her setback in the middle of the year...”

“I think it was always Marcus [Johansson's] plan that if we were ever going to win Owner of the Year, it was going to be this year. And then, we'd set stuff up years before this and it was like a culmination of a whole lot of hard work and good fortune. You know, horses have to stay healthy and sound and everything needs to kind of fall into place, but it did.”

Even though it's his name or that of his farm on the awards, Bowden is quick to point out Diamond Creek is a team effort and he has many to thank.

“All of those awards are a testament to all of the people at Diamond Creek, almost as much as it is me or maybe more so,” Bowden said. “They are the ones that put in the countless hours and, you know, at night, during the day when it's raining out, when it's cold. Marcus sits behind the horses no matter what temperature or weather it is. And the girls at the farm or the guys at the farm that are foaling these horses out or raising

them and caring for them when they are sick and injured, they deserve a tremendous amount of credit and they never get it.

“Shaun Laungani (vice president), Gina Dailey (director of operations), Emily Pursell (PA farm manager/sales coordinator), Caroline Vazquez (director of marketing and syndications), Sam Herrington (office manager), Marcus Johansson (racing manager), Mikala Cecola, Aubree Cramer, Cameryn Oswald, Aracely Marin, Katherine Wyman, Rolando and Israel Santos, Bud Emmons, Dave Kilgore and James Dailey... the list could go on and on. Without this group of unsung heroes, Diamond Creek Farm would not have the ability to achieve the success it has this year and hopefully into the future.”

Bowden, who turns 43 in less than two weeks, expects to have a large group attending the Dan Patch awards hoping it will culminate in Confederate being honored as Horse of the Year.

“This is one of those deals where you can have an incredible career in this sport and never get all of these [awards] in one year, let alone just one of them,” Bowden said. “We could go another 20, 30, 40 years and not win Horse of the Year and still have a great career. So, we’re very, very thrilled to be here at this point in our career and, obviously, hope to do it again because it was one hell of a ride.”

Dedrick “Dee” Sanders has a long road ahead but is enjoying every minute of the drive

Dedrick “Dee” Sanders has no idea where his racing future might lie, but he appreciates where it has already taken him.

The young man from Walnut Grove, MS, marvels at the journey that has led him nearly 800 miles from home, and farther than he had imagined.

“It was a rollercoaster,” Sanders said. “I didn’t even know if I was going to do this or if I was even going to get the opportunity. I came in and started working with the horses in [trainer] Todd Luther’s barn. I figured I was going to be a groom, but it all just fell into place. It still doesn’t seem real. I didn’t think I would make it this far.”

Yet, Sanders certainly has, through equal parts hard work and the support of many.

Growing up, he would often tag along with his uncle, Adrian Fortune, when the latter tended to the standardbreds that he owned.

Day by day, Sanders’ fondness for the pacers and trotters grew stronger.

“My uncle had a horse called Alabama Howard who he used to race, and it kind of started from there,” Sanders said. “My uncle was the one who taught me how to jog the horses. I just fell in love with horses and racing.”

Sanders’ mother, Amanda Fortune, saw her son’s burgeoning interest in standardbred racing and was eager to help in any way she could.

She reached out to the Harness Horse Youth Foundation (HHYF), which offers camps in Goshen, NY, and the opportunity to race alongside a driver at The Meadowlands on Hambletonian Day.

After finding out more about the HHYF, Amanda saved enough money to fly Sanders to New York City. She and her other three children made the 18-hour drive from Walnut Grove, MS., to pick up Sanders at the airport and take him to Goshen.

“The HHYF was a great experience,” Sanders said. “From there, I went to The Meadowlands. I got to drive with Tim Tetrick and then I really fell in love with everything. That was in 2019.”

Sanders remembers some of it as if it were yesterday.

“I remember Tim told me that he was going to win the first race,” Sanders said. “We went out before the card started and he had a horse called Backstreet Shadow

and he said that he was going to win. And he went out there and won in [1]:47. There were so many people and so many great horses that day. It was unbelievable.”

Sanders, who attended college in Kentucky with the hopes of becoming an equine veterinarian, soon realized that pursuit was not for him.

“It just didn’t work out,” he said. “It wasn’t right for me.”

Horse racing, however, was where his heart and head were.

Sanders created a resume and put it on social media, a post that caught the eye of Luther.

Last January, Sanders joined the Luther stable at Virgil Morgan, Jr.’s Winner Circle Training Center, where he has been ever since.

“It has been great to work with Todd and everyone on the team,” Sanders said. “Todd and Greg have changed my life, and I am very grateful for that. It really is a family environment at the barn. Everyone has been a big cheerleader for me.”

They all had something to shout about on June 17, 2023.

Sanders, in rein to Luther trainee Blazen River N, took to the track at Circleville, a half-mile Ohio oval, for the eighth race on the card.

He put the pacing son of Courage Under Fire—River Belle on the front end in the three-horse race. The pair padded their lead at every pole and cruised home 8 ¼-lengths clear of their closest rival.

Very impressive, even more so considering it was Sanders’ first-ever start.

“I almost broke the track record,” said Sanders, of the 1:57.1 mile. “When I came back, I saw my mom and you could see how happy she was. All I wanted to do was make my mom proud, so it was a great feeling. Todd couldn’t be there that day, but Greg [Luther’s brother, and horse owner] was there, and he is a big cheerleader for me. My family was there, my girlfriend was there; it was a great moment. I have a big winner’s circle picture hanging in my house.”

Having his mother be part of that moment and in the winning photo made the triumph a picture-perfect one.

“When I saw my mom after the race, she said, ‘You did it!’” Sanders said. “I was so happy to see how happy she was. She drove me all over the place, across the country. She takes care of me, she motivates me, and she keeps me going. She does it all. She would do anything for me. She would go through a wall for me. I don’t know anyone like her. I would do anything for her, and I know I would not be here if it wasn’t for her.”

By the end of 2023, Sanders posted three wins, two seconds and a third in seven starts. He posted all his wins and seconds in Ohio’s Terry Holton Youth Driving Series – open to drivers between the ages of 16-21 who hold a Q/F license – and teamed with Larry Karr to take the final at Hollywood Dayton Raceway.

“It’s really up in the air as to what I will do in this industry,” Sanders said. “I still don’t know exactly what that will be. I need to start looking ahead. I want to get my ‘P’ license, but I need to get more qualifiers. I only have one.”

That doesn’t mean he won’t enjoy the drive to an unknown destination, especially when Sanders talks about the equine athletes he gets to work with.

“Somewhere in Verona... I got to qualify him,” he said. “I got to sit behind Ants Marching. Christchurch is in the barn. I love being around great horses. Young guys like me don’t get to be around this caliber of horses.

“I have never been around this many horses. We would have around four or five horses back home and here, there are 50 to 60 right now. They all have their different ways, but they are all so talented.”

The barn has provided Sanders with the ideal learning environment, a rich source of educational lessons.

He’s thankful to those who are guiding him along in his racing journey.

“Virgil [Morgan, Jr.] told me that if I want to be a driver, people have to see my name,” Sanders said. He has given me good advice on how to do it. He tells me that I remind him of himself. Todd said it looks as though I have been driving for years, which is nice to hear. He has been great to me too. I learn something new every day. I don’t know it all, for sure. I listen and observe.”

Sanders likes what he sees.

“In my mind, I am not taking anything for granted because I know this might be my last day,” Sanders said. “There are so many great horses in Ohio that I get to see every morning. Today, I was jogging right beside [multiple stakes winner and earner of nearly \$1.9 million] Grace Hill. How great is that?”

As for off-track pursuits and hobbies, Sanders, outside of playing videogames on his PS5, dedicates a fair portion of his free time to pacers and trotters.

It’s his way of horsing around, so to speak.

“Most of the time, I am looking at breeding information; even when I’m away from the racetrack,” he said with a laugh. “It’s all about horses for me. When I go back home to Mississippi, I have the racing on. I look at programs or replays, and then I will look at onGait every two days. I love observing the horses. But when I go home, I do like being around my friends and spending time with all my friends.”

Life, whatever direction it happens to steer him in, is certainly good these days, offered Sanders.

He doesn’t expect that to change any time soon.

“I know I have a long road ahead of me, but I can’t wait to see what it has in store for me,” he said.

Allaire's "I-trotter" best in Belgique

Philippe Allaire-trained **Izoard Vedaquais** (Bird Parker) had already secured his spot in the Prix d'Amérique when Sunday's (Jan. 14) \$125,000 Prix de Belgique was held at Vincennes, but that fact didn't stop the talented horse from winning the last B-race before the big event later this month.

Benjamin Rochard sent Izoard Vedaquais to the front with three-quarters-of-a-mile to go in the 2,850 meters-long race and the storming challengers far outside in the stretch were all too late in their attempt capturing the trophy.

Izoard Vedaquais was an early talent in the French I-crop, but the previous season was not his best and horses like Idao de Tillard, Italiano Vero and Inmarosa were more successful in the bigger races. And Inmarosa was one of the horses in the Prix de Belgique that secured a place in the Prix d'Amérique on Jan. 28. The Laurent-Claude Abrivard trained mare finished strongly and hit the wire at the exact same point as Go On Boy, who punched a well-deserved ticket to the Prix d'Amérique via the dead heat silver place.

Over 1.7 miles, it was a mile rate of 1:57.2 for the winner Izoard Vedaquais.

The remaining horses that will enter the Prix d'Amérique are the ones with the most earnings in their careers, respectively and the following horses showed interest when the declaration was opened earlier this week.

It was also announced that French harness racing's biggest name, Jean-Michel Bazire, not will drive in the race this year. His Hooker Berry will be driven by Nicolas Bazire, which means that Jean-Michel will watch the Prix d'Amérique from off the track for the first time since 1998. Bazire claimed his first Prix d'Amérique win the year after, in 1999 when he steered Jimmy Takter's Moni Maker to triumph in Paris.

Roy driven to keep things rolling in 2024

Louis-Philippe Roy has plenty of reasons, five, specifically, to be excited about the upcoming O'Brien Awards.

When the names of the finalists are read aloud on the evening that recognizes Canadian excellence in standardbred racing, Roy will have a close association with four of the nominees.

The 34-year-old will also be in the spotlight himself, going up against James MacDonald for Driver of the Year honors.

"It was great to find out that I was a finalist," said Roy. "Every time you are recognized for what you do is a nice feeling.

"Personally, it felt like it was my best year so far. I know I was a little bit in the shadow of James, but I am pretty proud overall of what I was able to do all through 2023. I was lucky enough to drive very good horses, especially more of them on the Grand Circuit."

Win or lose, Roy, who won the Driver of the Year award in 2018 and 2019, will look back on his most recent campaign as one of his most memorable.

In 2023, Roy set a career-high in earnings, with just under \$7.6 million. His win total (311) on Canadian ovals was third best in the nation.

A testament to his talents in the race bike came in the form of the quality pacers and trotters he sat behind, namely, fellow O'Brien short-listers Drawn Impression, Fashion Frenzie, HP Mama B, and Tattoo Artist.

Drawn Impression, up against Willys Home Run in the Two-Year-Old Trotting Filly category, made an impactful first impression in her rookie campaign. The bay, bred and owned by Determination, won four times in six starts. The daughter of Muscle Hill earned \$308,900 for trainer Luc Blais.

She was at the top of her game in the \$425,000 Peaceful Way, when she humbled her rivals to the tune of a 4 ³/₄-length triumph in a personal-best 1:54.2.

Roy has driven the daughter of Muscle Hill in all her starts.

"She has a lot of talent," he said. "When you ask her for her best, she will give you that. She had a great year."

Fashion Frenzie, a two-time O'Brien Award winner, was stylish in victory six times from 12 races in 2023. The 6-year-old son of Archangel, trained by Richard Moreau, has been a force at

the free for all/open ranks at Woodbine Mohawk Park, with all six victories coming at that level.

Highlights include taking the Earl Rowe for the second consecutive year and being selected as Canada's representative in the Yonkers International Trot.

"He is another very good one," said Roy, of the gelding who bankrolled \$204,256 for his connections in 2023. "He is very consistent, but if he does have an off night, you know he will always come back strong the next time."

Logan Park, also another son of Archangel, is the other finalist in the Older Trotting Horse division.

Trained by Ben Baillargeon, HP Mama B is an O'Brien Award finalist in the Older Trotting Mare category for the second time. The hard-knocking daughter of Royalty For Life tested her mettle against the boys at the preferred level and came out with a winner's circle photo on four occasions.

Her richest paydays in 2023 came courtesy of a third-place finish in the Breeders Crown final and a third-place performance in the Dayton Oaks.

"I like the way she never gives up," said Roy. "She faced a lot of tough competition last year and she always gave her best."

Adare Castle is the other finalist.

Roy partnered with venerable campaigner Tattoo Artist to claim victory in the Canadian Pacing Derby, Jim Ewart Memorial and Dayton Pacing Derby.

An Ontario-bred and sired son of Hes Watching, Tattoo Artist has stamped himself as a finalist in the category for the second consecutive year. Last season, the 6-year-old won nine races and reached the \$1 million mark in earnings for the second straight year.

Of those nine wins, seven of them came in Canada, where he was under the tutelage of trainer Dr. Ian Moore. His highest profile score came at Woodbine Mohawk Park, where he won the Canadian Pacing Derby.

Tattoo Artist will face off against Emmetts Buddy for the Older Pacing Horse trophy.

"We won seven straight races together," said Roy. "His record speaks for itself. He has over \$3 million in earnings and has won some big, big races. You can win with him coming from off the pace or on the front – just a very nice horse."

Seeing all four recognized by O'Brien voters is a huge thrill for Roy.

"Every time you race, you want to win, but when you drive those quality horses in the big races, it's a great feeling," he said.

Did Roy, who is drawing closer to 2,500 career wins, expect to have the season he did?

"Even if you are the best driver, you need to have good horses year after year," he said. "I didn't have any goals coming into last year, but I am very pleased with how things went. This past year, I feel as though I was a more accomplished driver than I was in 2018 [the year he won a career-best 416 races]."

As for what he believes his best skill is in the sulky, Roy took a quick pause, accompanied by a laugh, before he gave his answer.

"Five years ago, I could get speed out of the horses, but maybe I didn't quite measure that speed enough at times, especially young horses," he said. "Now, if I was a trainer, I would feel confident in letting me drive their young horses, knowing I can give them a winning drive. That's my goal every time I line up behind the gate."

Roy, whose horses have eclipsed the \$44-million mark in earnings, isn't going to tinker with the approach to his craft in 2024.

It certainly makes sense considering what he was able to accomplish last year.

"You try to keep yourself at the top, so trainers and owners see you and want to have you drive their horses," he said. "The more you are recognized, the better it is for your future. I am excited for what 2024 can be."

The winners will be announced on Saturday (Feb. 3, 2024), at the O'Brien Awards Gala, which will take place at the Delta Hotels by Marriott Prince Edward in Charlottetown, PEI.

Jersey move working well for Herschberger

Mark Herschberger began working with horses at an early age, but it's only been in the past several years that the Illinois native – and nephew of trainer Erv Miller and driver Andy Miller – started pursuing his own everyday career in harness racing.

The 28-year-old Herschberger, who spent parts of the previous six seasons assisting with Erv Miller's stables in Pennsylvania and Indiana, as well as working for trainer Joe Putnam in Indiana, relocated to New Jersey with his fiancée Brittany Jessop late last summer. He is working for trainer Andrew Harris at Gaitway Farm while looking to further his career as a driver. He also helps with horses at a training center run by Paul Jessop and Laurie Molnar.

Herschberger got his first win in 2022 at the Elkhart County Fairgrounds in Indiana and added 27 victories last year. Driving primarily at Freehold Raceway since his move to NJ, Herschberger has two wins so far this season.

"I love it," Herschberger said. "I love my job and being around the horses on a daily basis. Growing up as a young kid, I would go to my grandpa's house, he had a 40-to-50 horse breeding farm, and I would help him break yearlings and jog horses. [Driving] is always something I wanted to do. I guess I just never had the push to go out and try it until about six years ago when Erv kind of took me under his wing.

"Once you're in it, it's in your blood. Then you're hooked. If you do what you love every day, you don't work a day in your life. That's the way it's been for me. Days fly by and weeks roll together when you're racing. I wouldn't want to spend my time doing anything else."

Herschberger's triumphs in 2023 featured eight on the Indiana Sired Fair Circuit, including two \$10,000 Governor's Cup Series consolations, and five in the Kentucky Proud Series. He began driving at Freehold on Sept. 1 and ranked 10th in victories at the Central Jersey half-mile oval over the final four months of the year. He also was among the four drivers who represented Freehold in the Rosecroft-Freehold Driving Challenge in December.

"The move has worked out well for me since I've been out here," Herschberger said. "I enjoy getting out and going behind

the gate. That's where I want to point my career. Being in the driver challenge, I think that helped me a little bit in getting my name out there a little more. That was a lot of fun.

"For this year, I'd like to double my starts from last year. If I could get 600 to 700 starts this year, that's kind of my goal. Wherever I can get listed, I'll make the drive to go. Obviously, we want to take home a few more wins, but the main thing is to keep learning from every drive."

Herschberger knows he is a bit of a latecomer to the driving ranks, where many of his peers launched their careers in their teens or early 20s, but he is willing to take his time working his way up.

"[My age] was something Joe Putnam always told me would be going against me as far as starting out," Herschberger said. "But he always said I had some talent and if I wanted to pursue it, he would back me. I've been fortunate to have people put me forward. It's a tough ladder to climb. You need to climb it right, do it right on the way up, so you can build that trust with trainers and owners.

"I've still got a long way to go as far as being out there as a driver. You've got to react and make decisions and stand by them, and also be able to turn the page from there to get to the next drive. I just want to keep moving forward."

For the first time in nearly 30 years, Ohio's reigning Horse of the Year has won the honor in back-to-back years. Bythemissal, Ohio's 3-Year-Old Pacing Colt of the Year, has been named the 2023 Ohio Horse of the Year.

Bythemissal who was named the 2023 Dan Patch Older Male Pacer of the Year, hit the board in 14 of his 16 starts. Owned by Burke Racing Stable, Eric Good, Rich Lombardo Racing, and Weaver Bruscelli and bred by Stephen Dey III, Bythemissal earned \$984,666 in 2023. The son of Downbytheseaside won the Breeders Crown, Sam McKee Memorial, Myron Charna President's Pace at MGM Northfield Park, Aria Invitational Pace, Allera Open Pace, and Potomac Pace International.

"This is the best horse I have trained since Sweet Lou," said trainer Ron Burke. "As a 3-year-old, he was outstanding, as a 4-year-old he was great. I honestly think as a 5-year-old he'll be the best horse in America. This is a great horse."

The last horse to earn back-to-back Ohio Horse of the Year honors was Crisp Sahlbra in 1995 and 1996.

Meadowlands 2024 stakes to approach \$25 million

Harness Racing's Greatest Day, the \$3.5 million Hambletonian Day card on Saturday (Aug. 3) will include the Hambletonian Oaks, Cane Pace and Shady Daisy, the John Cashman and Dr. John Steele Memorials for older trotters, Sam McKee Memorial and

Lady Liberty for older pacers and the NJSS for freshman trotters, providing an unmatched line up of stakes in support of the \$1 million Hambletonian final.

The 3-year-old stakes are led by the track's signature race, the \$700,000 Meadowlands Pace on Saturday (July 15). The "Biggest Party in Harness Racing" offers \$2.5 million in purses and includes an imposing slate of supporting Grand Circuit stakes including the Mistletoe Shalee, Hambletonian Maturity, W.R. Haughton and Dorothy Haughton Memorials and coveted Hambletonian preps the Del Miller and Stanley Dancer Memorials.

The Breeders Crown brings its powerful year-end series, worth over \$7 million in purses, back to New Jersey with the finals set for the weekend of Oct. 25 and 26 with eliminations the previous weekend.

The 27th Arthur Cutler Memorial FFA trot will retain its customary position kicking off the Big M stakes season on Saturday (May 18). The Championship Meet hits turbo on Saturday (June 29) when the Dave Brower Memorial, Perfect Sting, Crawford Farms and Six Pack stakes for older horses set the table for six great weeks of Grand Circuit racing.

The New Jersey Sires Stakes (NJSS) open in May with the 3-year-olds racing two \$30,000 legs and \$240,000 finals. Beginning in mid-July, a third leg has been added for the 2-year-olds with the purses set at \$25,000 and \$240,000 for the finals.

The New Jersey Classic Series (NJCS) for 2- and 3-year-olds is back with the same format of eliminations and finals with consolations. Trotting finals remain at \$275,000 with the pacers at \$150,000.

The Graduate Series for 4-year-olds returns with the first \$75,000 leg at Woodbine Mohawk Park on Saturday (June 1) followed by two more at The Meadowlands, leading into the July 6 \$250,000 finals. Older trotting mares will have access to the Miss Versatility for six legs before the \$100,000 final on Jug Day in Delaware, OH.

The 2-year-olds will have five \$20,000 Kindergarten Series preliminary legs with the Nov. 9 finals estimated at \$1 million. Kindergarten final winners will again be awarded a "Win & You're In" bonus into the Freshman Fall Final Four. Those winners will move directly to the final and draw for posts with any elimination winners toward the rich finals. (See stakes conditions. Horses must be eligible to the Freshman Fall Final Four).

The \$1 million FanDuel Championships will try to maintain the lofty perch realized in 2023 and again be paired up with the \$1.6 million Freshman Fall Final Four on a blockbuster Nov. 30 card to bring the curtain down on stakes season.

Northville Downs to close at current location

Northville Downs, the last horse racing track in Michigan, will soon cease operations at its current location at 301 S. Center St. in Northville after 80 years of providing excitement and entertainment to avid horse racing enthusiasts. The final race is scheduled to take place on Saturday (Feb. 3, 2024).

Despite the physical racetrack closing, horse racing patrons will continue to be able to place mobile bets anytime, and uninterrupted — including on races such as the Kentucky Derby — via advance deposit wagering (ADW) through authorized providers Churchill Downs/TwinSpires, NYRA Bets, Xpressbet, and FanDuel Racing (TVG). Due to Northville Downs' scheduled closure, patrons should be aware that they will no longer be able to place simulcast wagers in person at the track beginning

Monday (Feb. 5). However, Northville Downs will announce the return of simulcast wagering as soon as possible after it reopens at its new location.

Opened in 1944, the racetrack has been slated for a **\$250 million redevelopment project under a 2018 sale agreement with a real estate developer**. Northville Downs has purchased 128 acres of land near the corner of Five Mile and Ridge roads in Plymouth Township to build a new harness racing facility, pending approval of the township board.

“The Michigan Gaming Control Board expresses our deepest gratitude to all of the Northville Downs patrons who have made each race day memorable and thrilling,” MGCBC executive director Henry Williams said. “We appreciate the support of those who have kept Northville Downs going for 80 years and look forward to the next chapter of horse racing in Michigan at a new location.”

In light of the racetrack’s upcoming closing, all patrons should be aware that Saturday (Feb. 10) will be the last day to cash in any winning wagers at Northville Downs. After this date, or if patrons are unable to make it to the track, they can mail winning tickets to: Northville Downs, 47526 Clipper St., PO Box 701220, Plymouth, MI 48170. All winning pari-mutuel tickets may be presented for payment within 60 days after the last day of the race meeting.

Buffalo Raceway and Saratoga Casino Hotel will be implementing stricter whipping guidelines

Buffalo Raceway and Saratoga Casino Hotel will be implementing stricter whipping guidelines for the 2024 racing season. Both tracks have worked together to expand whipping rules in an effort to better racing for all involved.

In addition to the current New York State Gaming Commission regulations, both tracks have restricted whipping “... to wrist

action only, and the whipping arm shall not be raised above the driver's shoulder." Additionally, the use of the whip will be restricted to use "...above and between the shafts only. Whipping below the shaft in the stifle area will be in violation."

Drivers will be subject to penalties set down by track management.

While this is the first rule of its kind in New York State, a similar rule is currently enforced by the New Jersey Gaming Commission, Indiana Horse Racing Commission, and Ontario Racing Commission.

Buffalo Raceway is on grounds owned by the Erie County Agricultural Society which hosts many animal-related events including the Erie County Fair in August.

"Our racing operation is in line with the Erie County Agricultural Society's mission statement that the welfare of all animals on the grounds is a top priority," said general manager, Jon Cramer.

"Saratoga Casino Hotel wants to ensure that the well-being of the equine athletes is protected in every way possible," said John Matarazzo, director of racing. "The rule changes reflect this objective."

Buffalo Raceway and Saratoga Casino Hotel have worked together to expand the whipping rule in efforts to better racing for all involved; both the horses and its' participants.

A \$32,000 winners-over \$30,000 in their last five starts pacing event is the feature on Monday night and is led by Covered Bridge (post 8, Jordan Stratton listed to drive for trainer Jeff Gillis). Covered Bridge is coming off a victory in the preferred at Woodbine Mohawk Park in his last start, and he earned over \$528,000 in 2023.

the week of Sept. 2 has action on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday and on the week of Thanksgiving (Nov. 25), the oval will only operate on Monday and Tuesday. Closing day for 2024 is Friday (Dec. 20).


