# Justice comes too late for former Woodbine-Mohawk preferred horse Finish Line

Trainer Frederick Bourgault was arrested this week in New York State and charged with two felonies related to the death of the 11-year-old trotter.

Finish Line (5, 1:53.2s; \$342,050) took his mark at Woodbine Racetrack on March 6, 2017. The Yankee Glide—Calchips Finisher gelding would rise to the Mohawk and Woodbine preferred level that spring for former trainer Rene Allard.

On Oct. 13, 2023, Standardbred Canada (SC) canceled Allard's membership for by-law violations. He had last trained horses to race in Ontario in Dec. 2016, but had remained active until March 2020 in New York and Pennsylvania. Allard was sentenced to 27 months in prison by the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York on Nov. 15, 2022 for involvement in distributing adulterated and misbranded drugs used on racehorses.

On Oct. 16, 2023, another trainer's SC membership was canceled. He, too, had trained Finish Line, in early 2023.

Frederick Bourgault had previously (on Feb. 1, 2020) had conditions imposed on his license by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO), for abuse of a horse in the paddock of The Raceway at Western Fair. In 2021, Bourgault

relocated to New York State, where he continued training and driving, primarily at Monticello Raceway. His fines and suspensions for one-handed whipping, whipping horses after the finish, kicking, and excessive or indiscriminate use of the whip accumulated.

On July 17, 2023 at Pine Bush Training Facility, in Crawford, NY, the 11-year-old gelding allegedly stepped on Bourgault's foot. What happened next defies logic, but not words: Orange County District Attorney David Hoovler stated in a Jan. 30 release that Bourgault "struck the horse with a hard object causing a linear depressed skull fracture, which resulted in the horse having to be euthanized."

On March 9, 2022, his driver's license was downgraded from Provisional to Qualifying Fair, effective from March 10, 2022 through Sept. 5, 2022. The New York State Gaming Commission imposed conditions for his return: "It is further ordered that Mr. Bourgault provide proof of successful completion of an approved anger management course."

On Dec. 20, 2022, Bourgault qualified Finish Line for owner/ trainer Herman Swartzentruber at Monticello Raceway. On April 24, 2023 at Monticello, Finish Line went offstride early and ended up distanced, with Swartzentruber in the sulky. It would be the trotter's final race.

On July 17, 2023 at Pine Bush Training Facility, in Crawford, NY, the 11-year-old gelding allegedly stepped on Bourgault's foot. What happened next defies logic, but not words: Orange County District Attorney David Hoovler stated in a Jan. 30 release that Bourgault "struck the horse with a hard object causing a linear depressed skull fracture, which resulted in the horse having to be euthanized."

Finish Line was buried at Pine Bush Training Facility, and later exhumed in response to an anonymous complaint to police. A necropsy was conducted by Cornell University College of Veterinary Medicine.

Lee Park, deputy executive director of the NYS Gaming Commission, said via email that "any horse that dies on the grounds of a New York State racetrack [is] automatically sent for necropsy. The Gaming Commission does not regulate private training centers or farms, and therefore does not track equine fatalities or incidents that take place at such facilities."

Bourgault was arraigned in Orange County Court before County Court Judge Richard Guertin on Tuesday (Jan. 30). He was not eligible for bail to be set, due to changes to state bail reform legislation. The 26-year-old from Scott, QC was arrested that morning, after an investigation conducted by the New York State Gaming Commission, Orange County District Attorney, and New York State Police. He appeared in court that afternoon, charged with two felonies: Criminal Mischief in the Second Degree, and Interference with or Injury to Certain Domestic Animals. Bourgault's preliminary hearing is scheduled for Friday (Feb. 2). His passport was seized to prevent him from leaving the country.

The question of why animal rights group PETA (People for Ethical Treatment of Animals) became involved in the matter is less clear than the charges against Bourgault.

Bourgault was not banned from owning, training, or provisionally driving horses in New York State out of reciprocity with Ontario. But on Wednesday (Jan. 31), Park confirmed he was indeed banned, until at least March 7, 2025: "Mr. Bourgault is not able to participate in New York State horse racing."

A Jan. 30 release from the organization stated that "PETA was informed of the alleged beating [on Finish Line] by a whistleblower and immediately contacted the police." The release thanked the New York State Police for their efforts to apprehend Bourgault, while disparaging the New York State Gaming Commission "for allowing this man to keep racing" and asking, "why New Yorkers are forced to support the harness racing industry with \$100 million in subsidies every year."

Meanwhile, a Jan. 30 release from the Orange County District Attorney thanked both the commission and police for their help: "The New York State Gaming Commission provided expert witnesses and assisted in coordinating the arrest of Bourgault by the New York State Police." He could not comment on an unconfirmed report that the trainer



had been arrested at Monticello Raceway after spending time in Canada.

Reciprocity among racing jurisdictions prevented Bourgault from continuing to train or drive horses in Ontario. A Dec. 11 query to the AGCO confirmed that licensees suspended by "another province or state recognized by the Commission, or Standardbred Canada or the USTA" is "prohibited from participating in any racing activity in Ontario." The AGCO reciprocates SC suspensions, and individual racetracks make their own decisions about who can be on their private property. As the AGCO communications team email pointed out, sanctions from one racing jurisdiction do not automatically take effect elsewhere: "It is up to each province or state to decide whether or not they want to reciprocate AGCO suspensions."

Bourgault was not banned from owning, training, or provisionally driving horses in New York State out of reciprocity with Ontario. #### Lisa Lazarus to Andrew Cohen: HISA will customize regulations to fit standardbred industry

In the latest edition of Andrew Cohen's column **Keeping Pace** in the *Paulick Report*, the CEO of the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority told Cohen in unequivocal terms that should the harness racing industry one day be governed by HISA it would have unique rules and regulations and wouldn't be forced to follow those in place for the thoroughbred industry.

Lisa Lazarus is quoted as saying, "HISA is open to customizing federal regulations to acknowledge the differences between thoroughbred and standardbred racing. HISA will absolutely confer with the standardbred community prior to regulating standardbreds and engage in a consultation period to amend the rules so they are properly customized to standardbred racing."

The statement appears to address concerns by some in the standardbred industry that the harness racing industry under HISA would be saddled with the same regulations as the thoroughbred industry to a disastrous end.

HISA currently oversees the thoroughbred industry in the United States in an attempt to bring federal oversight and one set of rules to the entire industry.

Cohen wrote, "Harness people can now focus on gathering the facts and evidence they'll need to convince federal regulators that there are a few areas that justify breed-specific rules when the time comes for harness racing to fall under the new federal racing integrity law."

As **HRU previously noted**, the Hambletonian Society has established five committees to prepare for the *possibility* HISA will one day govern standardbred racing.



# MEADOWLANDS MATTERS

#### Jason Bartlett and Per Engblom are heating up the winter on both sides of the Hudson

The driver-trainer combo is topping the standings at both The Meadowlands and Yonkers Raceway.

As The Meadowlands winter meet continues to heat up, nothing has been hotter than the combination of driver Jason Bartlett and trainer Per Engblom.

The pair is coming off a successful 2023 Yonkers campaign that saw them take home year-end honors as top driver (Bartlett's 12<sup>th</sup> title) and trainer (Engblom's first), respectively. Bartlett had 500 wins at the New York half-mile oval, almost 200 more than George Brennan, while Engblom finished with 231 victories, almost 100 more than Ron Burke. At The Meadowlands in 2023, Bartlett finished 11<sup>th</sup> with 30 wins and Engblom finished third with 38.

It may be a new year, but the story is mostly the same, as the prosperous pair again sits atop the standings at the Hilltop Oval. However, this year there's an added bonus – they're also leading at The Meadowlands.

Bartlett, 42, who typically only drives at The Big M on Saturday nights – since Yonkers races a Monday-Friday schedule at this time of year – was surprised to hear he's leading the way at the winter meet.

"No, I didn't realize that," Bartlett said. "I've only been there one day a week. I thought I might be near the top of the list, but I didn't think I was No. 1. Anytime you can race at The Meadowlands, it's always a good time. If you win one race or two races during the weekend, every win just seems special under the lights. So, you know, I really enjoy going over there. Jason [Bartlett] is a good enough driver to get around any track. You know, obviously, Yonkers has been his home track for a long, long time now, but I've got no doubt in my mind he can drive with the best at any track on this continent.

"It's a little bit of a change of pace for me, you know, going from a half [at Yonkers] to a mile [at The Meadowlands] and it's just good to do something a little different on the weekends."

No matter the track size, Engblom is confident in Bartlett's abilities.

"Jason is a good enough driver to get around any track," Engblom said. "You know, obviously, Yonkers has been his home track for

a long, long time now, but I've got no doubt in my mind he can drive with the best at any track on this continent."

Engblom, 43, has been training his own stable since 2019, after his mentor and former boss, Hall of Fame conditioner Jimmy Takter, retired at the end of 2018.

Engblom hooked up with Bartlett a few years ago at Yonkers when the trainer was racing a couple of young stakes-caliber trotters.

"I wanted Jason to drive them because I think he's the best driver over there and he's a good fit for my horses and he did well with them," Engblom said. "And then, obviously, when I brought more horses over, I tried to get him as often as I could.

"It takes an aggressive driver to put them in position [at Yonkers] and, well, anywhere you race, basically. Nowadays, you have to put them in position and that's his game and I think he's just great at it. Plus, he's very, very knowledgeable about the horses in the races. He knows them all and tries to get them all in position to race as good as they can. And he knows the competition and I know he does his homework before he gets to the races and that's half the battle sometimes."

Bartlett said everyone is aware of his style of driving, and he owns it.

"You know what, I am who I am," Bartlett said. "I'm known to be a very aggressive driver, but I know the horses. I've driven around these horses enough and for me, I think, knowing the horses is probably the most important thing. Driving against them all the time and whether it's a half or a mile, you still got to know your competition and I believe that I'm very, very good at that.

"So, going over [to The Meadowlands], I'm aggressive, so I'm always going to try to put my horses in play."

Bartlett remembers meeting Engblom during his aforementioned Takter time and thinks the two trainers share the same kind of work ethic.

"At times, I've got to tell him to slow down; I'm like 'Per, do you ever sleep?" Bartlett said with a laugh. "He's so hard working. He's at the barn all day and then he's coming to the races to warm up... He's a hard worker and he deserves all the success that he's having right now because he does put his time in, that's for sure. And you know what, it's a great family thing, too. His brother [Petter] is there and his wife [Helene], which is great."

Spending over a decade on top at Yonkers has taught Bartlett a lot.

"At first when I heard George [Brennan] and Brian [Sears] were coming over [to race at Yonkers regularly], I was like, 'Ugh.' But I'll tell you what, the best thing that could ever happen to me was getting knocked down. I thought I could drive a horse until I drove against those two. I learned so much driving with those guys. It really changed my career for the better, for sure.

"You know, I thought I was a pretty good driver but I wasn't even close. Those guys were beating me every which way. It didn't matter if they were on the front, first over, they were just beating me every single night. And I'm like, 'Oh my Lord, I better

start studying and watching those guys.' I learned just so much going against those guys and, you know, to this day, I still learn from driving against George and Brian."

Prior to Yonkers opening up for the season on Jan. 22, Bartlett drove both Friday and Saturday night (Jan. 19-20) at The Meadowlands and it turned out to be his most productive weekend there ever. The Maine native scored nine wins — five on Friday, four on Saturday — in 21 attempts, for an incredible win percentage of 43, while hitting the board 76 per cent of the time. Five of those nine wins were for Engblom.

Despite how well Bartlett's done recently, and over the years, he continues to hone his craft.

"I don't think you can ever master this," he said. "You always have to be pivoting... I'm always trying to learn and critiquing myself every single night, every single race, trying to get myself better and not be complacent with winning five races a night because the next night you could get shut out."

To keep his mind and his body in proper shape, Bartlett and his wife, Kristen, do CrossFit every day. And as if his schedule wasn't packed enough with driving six nights a week, on Saturday mornings, he and his wife both coach youth basketball in their hometown of Goshen, NY.

Engblom, who currently has about 100 horses in his barn, hopes to strike a good balance this year between stakes and overnight races.

"The last two years, I haven't had much stakes power, but my overnight horses have been racing so good, so, I'm just hoping that we build off of that," Engblom said. "We bought in on a



couple of really nice 4-year-olds and we've got a few more 3-year-olds. The dream is, of course, that we're going to be competitive way more on the Grand Circuit than what we've been the last couple of years and I sure hope that Jason is going to be a part of it.

"I feel very confident when Jason drives my horses. So that's really part of the game, too, that I feel confident with him and that he feels confident when he goes out with my horses on the track. If you go out there and you don't feel confident and you feel like, 'Oh, I'm chasing a check here,' well, then you're chasing a check and it's going to be hard to win the race."

#### Epic night expected in Melton with Just Believe and Leap To Fame sharing spotlight

The Inter Dominion is Australia's most iconic race meeting, but Hunter Cup Night is now its best.

As great a show as hot and steamy Albion Park turned on for the Inter Dominion finals just six weeks ago, Melton will be epic on Saturday night (Feb. 3). The biggest stars of Albion Park – trotter Just Believe and pacer Leap To Fame – are back in action for the first time on the same stage.

But Saturday night's Hunter Cup card has so much more, especially with Australia's biggest trotting race the Great Southern Star being added to the menu this year.

There is the \$100,000 4YO Bonanza, a race which has helped launch the careers of superstars like Lazarus (2017) and Lochinvar Art (2020) in recent years.

It's a springboard to Australia's biggest 4YO feature, the \$250,000 Chariots of Fire at Sydney's Menangle track on March 2.

Saturday night's Bonanza doesn't have a standout, but that's the beauty of it.

Will a standout emerge? Which of this even and talented batch of 3-year-olds from last season will progress best at 4?

Premier trainer Emma Stewart holds the key with Perfect Class from the pole, but the man who trained and drove Lochinvar Art to win has a huge opinion of his latest stable star, Captain Hammerhead (post 3).

Then there is Australia's most impactful trainer Jason Grimson, the man who won two of the past three Inter Dominion pacing finals (Boncel Benjamin, 2022 and I Cast No Shadow, 2023) and finished third last year with Swayzee.



Perfect Class (4, Luke McCarthy) will be the likely favorite in Saturday night's Bonanza.

Grimson is telling those close to him he's got something special in former Queensland pacer Frankie Ferocious, who will start from the inside back row (gate 8) and likely follow leader and favorite Perfect Class everywhere.

Grimson also has talented former Kiwi pacer Lous Dream from post 5.

And you have to respect Brad Hewitt's Captain's Knock, who boasts 11 wins from 20 starts and almost \$300,000 in earnings. He's got some star flavor with part-owner Jarrod Croker being the recently retired captain of big Aussie rugby league team Canberra Raiders.

The support races go deeper than the Bonanza with fans getting their first proper glimpse at some of the best 3-year-old fillies in the Gold Chalice (race 5).

It's a crucial race with the first classic of the season, the NSW Oaks, just around the corner at Menangle.

Stewart, who has dominated juvenile ranks for so many years, has three runners, including heavily backed favorite Uniquely Ideal, a lightly raced daughter of American Ideal.

There's also a quirky spectacle with the final of the 1,200m series, the Mercury80 (race 9), which is little more than a lap of the 1,000m Melton track.

But ultimately, all that is the icing on the cake.

It's the Hunter Cup and Great Southern Star at the heart of it.

And that's why the meeting will be televised live on free-to-air across Australia on the Racing.com channel.

The Hunter Cup gives Down Under's standout pacer Leap To Fame a chance to score a win even more important and significant than the Inter Dominion back on Dec. 16. Training in Queensland, which isn't as big as Victoria and NSW, means you rarely get a chance to train a horse good enough to beat the best in the land, or Australasia for that matter. But [Leap To Fame] has come along and changed all that for me... he's a once in a lifetime horse.

As much as we'd love [Just Believe] to win every time, it's the big races that matter. We've got him as well as he's ever been and we're heading there with plenty of confidence. He's just an amazing horse and a privilege to train.

"It's hard to say this would mean more than the Inter Dominion because so many of my family and friends were at Albion Park to share that with me, but it would be a bigger achievement I think," Dixon said. "Training in Queensland, which isn't as big as Victoria and NSW, means you rarely get a chance to train a horse good enough to beat the best in the land, or Australasia for that matter. But this horse has come along and changed all that for me... he's a once in a lifetime horse.

"I grew up watching races like the Hunter Cup and Miracle Mile and all the stars who won them. To think [we have] a big chance of winning one is pretty special."

Leap To Fame, who boasts 30 wins from just 40 starts, is more than a chance to win. He dominates betting at \$1.30 (for a \$1 bet) after drawing post 6. He will move into 5 if first reserve Cantfindabettorman doesn't get into the field from post 1.

"It's a much better draw than he's had in so many of the big races over the past year or so," Dixon said. "Maybe our luck's changing. It's pretty much ideal. We'll keep working forward and will be a big chance of getting to the front from there."

While pacing is "king" over trotting in Australia, the stunning rise and dominance of our best trotter Just Believe has the 8-year-old seriously challenging Leap To Fame for top billing on Saturday night.

The story is well documented that Just Believe was a star on the rise before he had a daunting three-race campaign in Sweden through the middle of last year.

He's come back and gone to another level with seven wins from as many starts, including winning all three heats and final of that Brisbane Inter Dominion.

But his biggest test comes in the Great Southern Star on Saturday night, which consists of two heats early in the night (races 2 and 3) and then the final a couple of hours later (race 8).

Just Believe was beaten in his heat last year, but atoned to dominate the final.

That's a fact not lost on trainer Jess Tubbs with Just Believe drawing poorly in by far the stronger of the two Great Southern Star heats.


"It's not the draw we wanted [post 9, back row], especially over the short [1,720m] trip," she said. "I'm sure he'll still be hard to beat, but don't forget he was beaten in his heat last year and won the final.

That's when Tubbs, driver Greg Sugars and Just Believe's owners are set to publicly declare their hand; will they return for another crack at the famed Elitloppet in Sweden or stay closer to home and target the inaugural \$650,000 TAB Trot at Cambridge on April 12.

It's even possible to do both should they dare to try it.

Especially considering there was a point in time when Lecourt felt the trotter might not make it to the races.

"When we broke him, we didn't think that he would get there because his conformation isn't that great," she said. "We didn't think he would be a racehorse, but he trained down very well, and he showed he had some speed. We shut him down in his 2-year-old season, in August. I was very patient with him. We gave him some time off and we made some adjustments going into his 3-year-old season.

#### Breeder, owner, trainer Cassandra Lecourt has a lot of emotion for her horses

What's in a horse's name? For Cassandra Lecourt, a perfect one to start the New Year on a winning note.

As the field of six trotters began to pick up speed in the 10th race on Jan. 11 at The Meadows, Lecourt wasn't anticipating a walk over to the winner's circle.

She was, however, confident of a competitive performance from the 4-year-old bay gelding whom she bred, owns and trains.

"I didn't expect that win," Lecourt said. "I knew that he could finish kind of close, but I didn't expect him to win because he had been off three weeks."

Getting away fourth, The Great Emotion, a son of Lookslikeachpndale—Apogee, was a halflength in front at the stretch call with Aaron Merriman at the controls, before pulling away for a comfortable 1 ½-length score in 1:55.2.

It was the fifth lifetime score from 27 races for the horses who made the first 21 starts of his career at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

The Great Emotion rewarded his backers with a healthy \$33.60 win payout.

"At the three-quarter mark, he was still going strong and with him, if he is in front, he doesn't like to be passed by other horses," Lecourt said. "So, I thought he was in a good position to win. It was very nice to see him perform so well."

"You can drive him any way as well. He will come from off the pace or be happy wherever you put him in the race. No matter where I put him, Grassroots or Gold, or anywhere else, he always tries and competes."

Eleven days later, that grit was on display again, this time at Miami Valley.

In rein to Jeremey Smith, The Great Emotion, at 4-5, notched a 1 ¼-length victory in 1:56.1, for his sixth lifetime triumph.

"He is a funny guy," Lecourt said. "He is always willing to do anything. We put the saddle on him, and he is fine. He is a 'yes man."

The wins, however, were bittersweet.

His dam, Apogee, passed away days after the victory at The Meadows.

Lecourt owned the daughter of Kadabra, who went winless in seven starts before moving on to the breeding shed.

"I don't know where I will be without that mare in a few years, but we will keep going forward the best we can," she said. "I have a couple of The Great Emotion's siblings, so hopefully, it will work out well for them."

The passing of Apogee served as a reminder of the ups and downs horsepeople are faced with throughout their careers.

"My first couple of years, we had a horse Esprit Dequipe, and she raced very well," Lecourt said. "She was always there at the finish, so you think, 'Wow, this is great.' And when you have a tough stretch or bad year, you think, 'Wow, this is awful.'

"Sometimes it is bad luck and sometimes unexpected things come up in this sport. You never know what can happen. Sometimes, you think a horse will be great and things don't work out and other times, a horse you don't think will do well ends up doing better than you expected."

The hard times haven't dampened Lecourt's enthusiasm for the sport.

She launched her training career in 2016, a year in which she posted a trio of thirds from eight starts.

The following campaign, she earned her first victory, the milestone courtesy of Art De Gagnee, a now-retired daughter of Shadow Play—Eclatante.

Driven by Pierre Luc Roy, the chestnut, who was bred in Quebec

by Guy Corbeil, bested her closest rival by three-quarters of a length in 1:58.1 at Hippodrome 3R on Aug. 29, 2017.

Since then, Lecourt has trained a modest number of starters each year.

Lecourt's best season, win-wise, came in 2019 when she won 13 of 42 starts. In 2022, her horses recorded a career-best \$123,093 in purse earnings.

Last year was a difficult campaign, one which yielded three wins from 43 starts.

"We thought that The Great Emotion would perform better than he did, so it was a tough 2023," she said. "I have a pacer, Revolt, who was racing in the open level at Mohawk, but then he had some tough results. Now he is back and just set his lifetime mark [1:49.4, at The Meadowland on Dec. 9]. Thankfully, the year ended well and 2024 has started well."

Lecourt, who has five horses in her barn, has ample reason for optimism beyond The Great Emotion, including a 2-year-old trotting daughter of Muscle Mass—Apogee.

Massive Emotion, whom she bred and owns, is being prepared for her rookie campaign.

"For this year — my horses are all staked in Canada — I will probably race them in Quebec," she said. "Massive Emotion has shown great aptitude. Maybe she will compete in the Gold Series at Mohawk."

Winning a Gold event sits atop Lecourt's wish list.

"I have had horses in Gold Series races for a couple of years, but we haven't won it yet," Lecourt said. "Those would be the races I would like to win. Maybe this filly, Massive Emotion, will be the one to do it."

The bay filly won't be lacking in support, through the good times and bad.

"I have a connection with all my horses," she said. "I was there when The Great Emotion was delivered. I enjoy having a bond with my horses, watching them grow and develop, and then go on to the races. It gives me a lot of joy."





#### Hot Mess Express to make final start tonight

Hot Mess Express has been a big part of owner Sam Bowie's life for more than three years. Tonight (Feb. 2), he will watch his 6-year-old female pacer compete for the final time before she embarks on the next chapter of her career as a broodmare.

A multiple winner on the Grand Circuit and Indiana Sire Stakes champion with nearly \$950,000 in the bank, Hot Mess Express will race in tonight's \$17,000 conditioned pace for mares at The Meadowlands. She will start from post 9 in a field of nine with Anibal Borjas driving for trainer Tony Alagna. She is the 3-1 morning-line favorite.

Hot Mess Express has been purchased by a group that includes Stephanie and Myron Bell's Riverview Breeding and Hunterton Farm's Cindy and Steve Stewart. She will be retired following the race. "What a ride she has taken us on," said Bowie, the former University of Kentucky basketball star who had a 10-season NBA career. "It's been a beautiful ride. Me being an athlete and looking at the standardbred horse as an athlete as well, knowing the work that she's put in, and having Tony Alagna and [his mom] Donna Lee do the job that they've done with her, it's been a wonderful thing to witness.

"I know all owners are biased, but I've always thought she was a gorgeous looking mare. She's been a big part of my life the last three or four years. Now she deserves to start creating her own offspring."

Bowie purchased Hot Mess Express privately early in her 2-yearold season from a group that included trainer Jamaica Patton. She remained with Patton for the remainder of the year and was the runner-up in the Indiana Sire Stakes final.

At age 3, Hot Mess Express moved to Alagna's stable and posted five victories on the Grand Circuit in addition to going undefeated in the Indiana Sire Stakes series, culminating with her championship triumph.

Her top wins that season came in the Mistletoe Shalee at The Meadowlands and Nadia Lobell at Harrah's Hoosier Park. She missed by a neck in the Fan Hanover and ended her sophomore campaign with 13 wins and a second in 16 starts.

For her career, the daughter of Panther Hanover—My Heart Was True has won 28 of 67 races and earned \$940,784.

"From a trainer's standpoint, and a driver's, they always told me she was great gaited and would do whatever you wanted her to do on the track," Bowie said. "She could always leave the gate, she could come off a helmet, she sat in a hole with two fingers. I guess her mannerisms and smarts would probably be her biggest assets.

"She raced on the Grand Circuit against some of the best mares that were looking through a bridle during her time. I can't really pick out a particular race that stands out. I've always been proud of her regardless of the outcome of a race. Anytime you're racing against Grand Circuit-type mares in today's game, you have to have a good animal. To say she was a good animal would be an understatement.

"I would like to give everyone credit except myself for the job that she's done."

Hot Mess Express is one of several recent purchases by the Stewarts and their partners. Others include millionaire Boudoir Hanover, Breeders Crown champion Max Contract, and Grand Circuit winners Bellisima Hanover and Dont Fence Me In.

Riverview Breeding bred Dont Fence Me In and was among the breeders of Boudoir Hanover (with Visionary Breeders) and Bellisima Hanover (with Visionary Breeders and Hanover Shoe Farms). The Bells' Riverview Racing was among the owners of all three horses during their racing careers.

Five-year-old Boudoir Hanover and 4-year-old Bellisima Hanover are full sisters, by Captaintreacherous out of milliondollar-earner Bedroomconfessions. Boudoir Hanover was a two-time champion in the Kentucky Sire Stakes program as well as a multiple winner on the Grand Circuit. Bellisima Hanover was a 2022 Kindergarten Classic Series champ.

Dont Fence Me In, a 5-year-old daughter of Captaintreacherous – Mystery Game, also garnered two Kentucky titles and was a multiple Grand Circuit winner. She retired this past May and is in foal to Bulldog Hanover.

"I'm very proud of them," Myron Bell said of the three mares. He has been involved with their maternal families for three generations. "They've been great on the racetrack and they're going to be, I believe, just as good in the breeding shed."

Steve Stewart said Hot Mess Express would be bred to Captaintreacherous, Boudoir Hanover to Confederate, Bellisima Hanover to Bulldog Hanover, and Dont Fence Me In to Sweet Lou.

"It's kind of a smorgasbord of stallions that works out really well," Stewart said.

In the past decade, Stewart has been the breeder or co-breeder of five Dan Patch Award-winning trotters: Tactical Approach, Venerable, Forbidden Trade, Venerate, and Mission Brief. Venerable, Forbidden Trade, and Mission Brief also were O'Brien Award recipients, with Forbidden Trade being named Canada's 2019 Horse of the Year.

"We have pretty much been focusing on trotting mares," Stewart said. "This is kind of the first time that Hunterton and partners have really spent a lot of money on pacing broodmares. Over the years, we've bought some like Put On A Show and have got a lot of nice ones, but this is a little more of a larger group of [pacing] broodmares than we've purchased in the past.

"It's an honor to have these great mares on the farm and it's an honor to take care of them. The success we've had has allowed us to have more success in being able to acquire Breeders Crown champions and million-dollar winners. It's a wonderful situation that we find ourselves in. We're very excited about the acquisitions. The beat goes on, that's the fun part."

#### World champion American Ideal dies

World champion racehorse and sire American Ideal, a dual hemisphere stallion, died Sunday (Jan. 28) at the age of 22. He stood since the beginning of his career at Blue Chip Farms in the U.S. and had stood in Australia at Llowalong Farms in conjunction with Woodlands Stud of New Zealand.

While quarantined in Australia awaiting shipping back to the U.S., the horse developed severe colic. During emergency surgery numerous cancerous masses were revealed, which resulted in the horse being humanely euthanized.

"It's a sad day, as American Ideal was a longtime member of the Brittany family, and also endeared himself to everyone at Blue Chip Farms," said Art Zubrod, manager of Brittany Farms and Brittany Stallion Management. "He was a sire who was an easy breeder with intelligence and a great personality. "I like to say he never had a 'down year,' as since his first crop stepped on the track, he has produced champions or prominent stakes winners every single year."

American Ideal p,3,1:47.4 (\$786,055), by Western Ideal—Lifetime Success, was bred and raised by Brittany Farms and sold as a Tattersalls yearling. He raced from 2004 through 2006 for Mac Nichol, who partnered with Brittany during the colt's sophomore season.

American Ideal's most prominent victories included the Bluegrass Stakes in a then-world record 1:47.4, the Tattersalls Pace, Confederation Cup and Provincial Cup.

With a stallion career managed by Brittany Stallion Management, from 2009 to the present day, American Ideal had sired the winners of more than \$163-million in North America and \$18.6-million in Australia. He had sired 18 worldwide millionaires and produced a career total of 70 yearlings that have sold for \$100,000 or more.

His progeny is led by such greats as 2- and 3-year-old world champion American Jewel p,3,1:48.2 (\$1,840,656), world champion and Meadowlands Pace winner He's Watching p,3,1:46.4 (\$1,16,450), Heston Blue Chip p,3,1:48f (\$1,781,881) and American History p,3,1:47 (\$1,561,817). One of his newest millionaires, Copy That, captured the \$1,000,000 Race By Grins FFA Pace in New Zealand last year.

American Ideal is the all-time leading money-winning pacing sire in the New York Sire Stakes program. Last year alone his 2- and 3-year-olds earned almost \$2-million in NYSS competition and included NYSS 2YO Filly Pace Champion Peace Talks p,2,1:55.4h (\$225,569).

Later that week, Woodbine Mohawk Park will play host to the Gold Series opener with a star-studded Saturday, May 25 card that will feature the 3-year-old pacing colts and fillies and 3-year-old trotting colts.

debut, along with his stablemates in the Dr. Ian Moore barn, 3-year-old pacing fillies Odds On Platinum (Bettors Delight– American Jewel) and Ann (Hes Watching–Addicted To Love). Moore, who is a nominee for Trainer of the Year at this weekend's O'Brien Awards, also has nine 2-year-old pacers prepping for the OSS, six colts and three fillies.

"In general, and I've said it many times before, I feel the OSS is one of the best programs out there," said Cambridge, ON resident Moore. "Most of mine this year are Ontario Breds, so hopefully they pan out for us come July, or whenever, and we get to participate in the OSS, because I do enjoy the program quite a bit. It's been good to us; we've had a lot of success over the last few years with the program."

The Gold Series will have a new format in 2024, with two legs followed by a \$150,000 Mid-Season Final and \$40,000 Consolation, then two more legs followed by the \$300,000 Super Final. Horses will accumulate points in each of the four legs to earn a berth in their respective Final or Consolation. Dates and locations for the Mid-Season events vary by age, sex and gait category, while the Super Finals will serve as the finale for the 50th anniversary celebrations on Saturday, Oct. 12 at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

In 2024, the top 10 Grassroots point earners will advance directly to their respective \$75,000 Championship on Saturday, Sept. 28, with the next 10 competing in a \$25,000 Consolation on Friday, Sept. 27, both at Woodbine Mohawk Park.

A unique twist for the 50th anniversary season will see Grassroots Championship winners have an opportunity to enter and draw into their respective Super Final if it does not fill with Gold Series point-earners.

The Prospect Series will once again offer eight racing opportunities across five legs with the top point earners advancing to a \$15,000 Final. The 3-year-old Prospect Series Finals will be hosted by Grand River Raceway on Friday, Sept. 27 and the 2-year-olds finalists will head to The Raceway at the Western Fair District on Friday, Oct. 11.

Although Home Market Area (HMA) wagering fell seven per cent in 2023, resulting in a \$1 million dollar reduction in the Standardbred Improvement Program (SIP) revenue generated through the associated Pari-mutuel Tax Reduction (PMTR), purses will remain stable in the Gold, Grassroots and Prospect Series. The Gold Series legs will see \$190,000 split between divisions, or \$140,000 allocated to a single division, the Grassroots Series divisions will be worth \$20,000 and the Prospect Series divisions \$8,000. To make up for the shortfall in PMTR revenue, starting fees will be included in the guaranteed purse amount, not added on to the purse as they have been in past years.

"For a variety of reasons — all the online sports wagering available, rising interest rates — Home Market Area wagering took a hit this year, and revenue from that wagering makes up about 65 per cent of the OSS purses," said SIP Committee member and Ontario Racing board member Ian Fleming. "The SIP committee had to find a way to balance the budget, and incorporating starting fees into the guaranteed purses was the best way to do that."

#### The power of the Pick-6 at The Big M

On a night-to-night basis, the 50-cent Pick-4 and 20-cent Pick-5 are the most popular multi-leg bets offered at The Meadowlands, but when it comes to a wager where carryovers create big-time excitement among Big M players, the 20-cent Pick-6 rules the roost.

Last Friday (Feb. 26), how the large P6 pool was created was somewhat ordinary, but after the six legs were contested, the results were extraordinary.

Before Friday, the last time the Pick-6 was hit was on Jan. 13, when one winning ticket returned \$6,221.50. Not bad at all. But as it turned out, peanuts compared with what was to come.

On Jan. 19, the Pick-6 failed to yield a winning ticket, creating a carryover of \$4,532. The next night (Jan. 20), once again, no winners, upping the carryover to \$14,531. Now, bettors had the motivation they needed to jump into the pool, which totaled over \$54,000 after more than \$40,000 in "new money" was funneled in the pot.

"The 20-cent Pick-6 figured to attract a lot of attention last Friday night," said track chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemoir. "And it certainly did. When the Pick-6 concluded after race 13, there was one winner that successfully navigated the complex puzzle."

After a sequence that saw winner's odds of 7-5, 20-1, 6-5, 8-1, 5-1 and 9-1, that shrewd handicapper walked away with \$48,579.92.

"There is a new catch phrase at The Meadowlands," said Settlemoir. "Which is creating a lot of interest not only in the racing world, but the gambling world as well. The term 'negative takeout' is when you pay out more money than the amount wagered. The Big M offers these what-used-to-be-rare opportunities frequently, where the combination of low takeout and a carryover create enormous mathematical advantages for the horseplayer."

Last Friday, the total pool exceeded the new money by \$4,000, so the winning bettor was in a pool that returned 111 per cent to him or her.

"Pick-6 fans will have another shot at a carryover [tonight] (Feb. 2)," said Settlemoir. "There is a 20-cent minimum bet and a low 15 per cent takeout. The Pick-6 starts on race 8, with a carryover of \$5,938, and our fans should always keep in mind that we offer free past performances for all Meadowlands programs at playmeadowlands.com."

**HANDLE CLEARS HIGH BAR:** Last Saturday's (Jan. 27) all-source handle of \$3,779,096 represented a 2024 Big M best, exceeding the previous high by more than a half-million dollars (\$3.2 million on Jan. 5).

"The Meadowlands rolls into February off our biggest handle of the year," said Settlemoir. "Saturday night, a perfect storm created giant pools all night, which helped us average almost \$270,000 per race.

"We got an enormous boost from Gulfstream Park's Pegasus World Cup, as the \$3-million event was the last race on the card at approximately 5:45 p.m. The lead-in audience from Gulfstream got us off to a huge start and the handle remained stellar throughout the entire evening. Big 10-horse fields continue to create big pools."

The "Big 3" signature wagers got their usual excellent response on Saturday, as the 20-cent Pick-5 took in \$72,509, while the Early and Late 50-cent Pick-4s saw \$81,399 and \$76,865 pushed through the windows, respectively.

"The Meadowlands offers eight wagers every night with a low 15 per cent takeout," said Settlemoir. "When those wagers have carryovers, the negative takeout scenario presents itself, offering our players more value and a higher return on their wagering dollar."

**THE GREAT EIGHT:** The Meadowlands provides eight opportunities for the player to make a score trying their luck betting in pools with a low 15 per cent takeout. The lineup of The Big M's "Great Eight" is as follows (all wagers – with the exception of the Pick-7 – are carryover eligible):

The Minnesota divisional awards are made up of the top two performers by earnings in each age and gender group in the Minnesota-sired restricted events at Running Aces.

#### First up are the freshman divisions:

The 2023 Minnesota harness racing freshman divisional champions are Baby Flash, Insurrectionist, Apple Juice and El Parrandero Q.

The 2023 freshman divisional runner-up award winners are Banker's Grace, Banker's Quest, Deja Vu Babyboo and Fast Larry.

The Minnesota champion freshman filly trotter award goes to Baby Flash, a daughter of Southwind Flash. She dominated her division, storming into Running Aces on July 11 after ripping off four wins at the Iowa fairs to start her career. She won five of her seven starts at Running Aces and overall, she won 13 of 15 races for the year and earned a total of \$92,474 while taking her freshman mark of 2:01.2 at Aces on Sept. 16.

Baby Flash was bred by Dennis Bontrager and is owned by trainer Rick Huffman in partnership with Keith Wilson and Brenda Lovetinsky. Her regular pilot is Chad Svendsen.

The runner-up freshman filly trotter award winner is Banker's Grace, a daughter of Banker Volo who was bred by her owner Kennedy Roland and is trained by Dan Roland. Nick Roland and Rick Magee were go-to drivers for Banker's Grace.

The freshman colt champion trotter award goes to Insurrectionist, a son of Banker Volo out of Lindy's On Fire. He took a mark of 2:00.3 on Aug. 15 while completing a three-race win streak at Running Aces. He won a total of \$68,907 with five wins on his card from 12 starts and was never off the board during his freshman campaign.

Insurrectionist is owned by his breeder Jeralene Roland and is trained by Dan Roland. He was regularly driven by Luke Plano.

The runner-up freshman colt trotter award winner is Banker's Quest, another son of Banker Volo who is also owned by breeder Jeralene Roland and trained by Dan Roland.

The 2023 freshman filly champion pacer award winner is Apple Juice, a daughter of Fancy Schmansy out of Computer Art who is a homebred for owner/trainer/breeder Scott Banitt. Apple Juice was part of a huge rivalry amongst the top two fillies in her division, trading wins throughout the season with the division runner-up. Apple Juice was able to capture the championship award by posting five wins in her last seven Aces starts.

Apple Juice took a mark of 1:54.2 on Aug. 24 and finished her freshman campaign with an overall total of eight wins and four seconds from 13 starts and total earnings of \$103,117. Jacob Cutting was the first-call driver for Apple Juice.

The runner-up freshman filly pacer award winner is Deja Vu Babyboo, a daughter of Karpathian Kid out of Whatitdo Babyboo, owned by her breeder Van Otterloo Stables and trained by Robert Lems. Her regular pilot was Dean Magee.

The champion freshman colt pacer award goes to El Parrandero Q, a son of Wind Me Up out of Lil Miss Knuckles, a homebred for breeder Fabiola Quevedo and owner Triple Q Stables.

El Parrandero Q dominated the division early in the season, and racked up enough earnings to be uncatchable going into the final weeks of the season. He won five races from 12 Aces starts and took a mark of 1:56.1 on Aug. 17. He posted total earnings of \$57,710 for the year. Edwin Quevedo is the trainer for El Parrandero Q and his regular pilot was Jacob Cutting.

The runner-up freshman colt pacer award winner is Fast Larry, a son of Art's Chip owned by Gary Carlson. He was prepped for the season by Rick Lancaster and then trained and driven by Brady Jenson thereafter.

#### The 2023 Minnesota Harness Racing sophomore divisional champions are:

Wisco Tootsie, Iron Sharpens Iron, Gotubydashorthairs and I'm A Skoldier.

The sophomore divisional runner-up award winners are: Caronamar, BP's Lucky Star, Quite The Flirt and King Of Aces.

Wisco Tootsie (Southwind Flash) put together a very impressive sophomore campaign to be a clear division leader amongst the filly trotters, solidifying her dominance with three-straight Aces wins in August, including her career best win in 2:00.1 on Aug. 20. She was a perfect four-for-four during that month including a win at the Saint Peter fair.

Wisco Tootsie closed out her season with a total of 8 wins and 4 seconds from 21 starts and total earnings of \$93,473 for her owners, The Sandstone Social Club, and trainer Dan Roland. She was bred by Harlan Nolt. Rick Magee was the regular driver for Wisco Tootsie.

The runner-up sophomore filly trotter award winner is Caronamar, a daughter of Southwind Cobra who is owned by Jeanne Marquis and Jay De Long. Justin Anfinson does the training and Todd Warren was her regular pilot.

Iron Sharpens Iron captured the 2023 sophomore colt trotter Champion award with another very impressive season. The defending 2022 Minnesota Harness Horse of the Year won 8 of 11 starts at Running Aces while never off the board. He won 10 races overall in 2023, and earned a total of \$123,389 for the year. He took his sophomore mark of 1:55 at Aces on Aug. 20.

Iron Sharpens Iron is a son of Banker Volo out of Lindy's On Fire. He is owned by trainer Dan Roland, and was also owned during his summer campaign by his breeder Jeralene Roland as well as Devon Arp, and the late Alfredo Villarreal. Luke Plano is the regular driver for Iron Sharpens Iron.

The runner-up sophomore colt trotter award winner is BP's Lucky Star (For You Almostfree) who is owned by his trainer Rick Huffman, in partnership with Brenda Lovetinsky and Penny Lundell. Mooney Svendsen was his regular pilot.

The sophomore filly pacer champion is Gotubydashorthairs, a daughter of Wind Me Up who absolutely dominated her division in 2023. She posted nine wins from 12 Aces starts including a four-race win streak to close out her season, all while flaunting her signature and dramatic come-from-behind racing style. She accumulated total earnings of \$126,087 and took a mark of 1:53.3 on June 29.

Gotubydashorthairs is owned by her breeder Mark Anderson and trained by Gordon Graham. Nick Roland was her regular driver.

The runner-up sophomore pacing filly award goes to Quite The Flirt, also a daughter of Wind Me Up. During her 2023 Minnesota

campaign, Quite The Flirt was owned by her breeder Van Otterloo Stables and trained by Robert Lems.

The sophomore colt pacer champion award winner is I'm A Skoldier, a son of Wind Me Up who dominated the division early in 2023 and recorded five wins, three seconds and three thirds from 13 Aces starts.

I'm A Skoldier took a sophomore mark of 1:52.3 on June 8. He closed out his year with an overall summary of 8-3-5 from 24 starts and total earnings of \$98,488. He was owned during his 2023 Minnesota campaign by his breeder Van Otterloo Stables and was trained by Robert Lems. Mooney Svendsen was his regular pilot at Running Aces.

The runner-up sophomore colt pacer award winner is King Of Aces, a son of Three Of Clubs out of Poorlittlerichgirl who is a homebred for breeder/trainer Williams Hernandez and owner Maria Alvarez. Luke Plano was the regular Aces pilot for King Of Aces.

As per tradition, the overall 2023 Minnesota Harness Horse of the Year award will have open nominations and a live vote at the (Feb. 17) banquet at Running Aces.

#### Batavia hits new handle heights as longshots rule Monday

For the fourth time in only six days of live racing in 2024, Batavia Downs set a new one-day, all-source record handle while under the ownership of Western Regional Off-Track Betting on Monday (Jan. 29). Bettors pushed \$515,078 through the windows to top the short-lived old record of \$509,180 which was set only one week ago.

The handle reflects that Batavia's loyal wagering patrons turned out in force again to bet the second round of the Western New York TrackMaster Series that had evenly matched fields and yielded outcomes many didn't anticipate, with price horses giving chalk bettors agita while sending speculators home with a jovial disposition.

The top class, \$9,000 TrackMaster 79 division produced two large payouts after come-from-behind efforts were put in by both.

First, **Dogfight** (Kevin Cummings) got away sixth at 25-1 and remained there to the half that was cut by Remember The Beach

(lim Morrill, Jr.). At that station, Cummings pulled Dogfight thirdover with cover and then swung three-deep into the last turn. At the top of the stretch, Lana's Desire (Dave McNeight, III) took the lead from Remember The Beach, but Dogfight quickly supplanted Lana's Desire in deep stretch to win by 1-1/4 lengths in 1:57.1.

It was the first win of the year for Dogfight (\$52.00) who is owned by Mike Torcello and trained by Sam Smith.

Then later, **I'll Take The Bet** (Drew Monti) also got away sixth as Sleeping Single (Jim McNeight, Jr.) and Carrythetorchman (Dave McNeight, III) traded blows and leads from the half to the top of the stretch. It was there that Monti steered I'll Take The Bet into the passing lane, found clear road and bolted to the line to win by a neck in 1:57.4.

Similarly, it was the first win of the year for I'll Take The Bet (\$38.80) and owner Justina Ohol. Mike Ohol conditions the winner.

Other upsets on the card included **Rockn'With T** (1:59.1, \$49.90), **Always A Fiji** (2:00.1, \$31.40), **Odds On Cheddar** (1:58.1, \$25.00) and **Jimmy CR** (1:59.1, \$18.40).

Nine of the night's participating horsemen scored doubles during the proceedings. Drivers Brett Beckwith, Drew Monti, Jim Morrill, Jr., Kevin Cummings and Kyle Cummings joined trainers Sam Smith, Jim Rothfuss, Shawn McDonough and Chris Petrelli in claiming two wins each on Monday.

#### Stake Your Claim Series action ahead at MGM Yonkers Raceway

If any of the "Stake Your Claim" events fail to get enough horses for two divisions these series will not be contested. Point totals for each series will follow the purse distribution percentages -50, 25, 12, 8 and 5 - to decide who makes the final.
