The O'Brien Awards took place Saturday night (Feb. 3) in Charlottetown, PEI, honoring Canada's top harness racing performers of 2023. Both Keith Waples Driver of the Year finalists are regulars at Woodbine Mohawk Park: Louis-Philippe Roy (2018 and 2019 Driver of the Year) and James MacDonald, who would go on to win his third consecutive title.

People who traveled to Charlottetown for the O'Brien Awards banquet soon became aware that their return trips might be complicated by winter weather.

"We kind of knew pretty early," said MacDonald, speaking Wednesday (Feb. 7), after his return to Guelph, ON. "It was so nasty Saturday [Feb. 3], and into Sunday. I think everyone was

kind of talking: 'Well, this is probably not going to be a go for the flights tonight.' We were [booked] on the Sunday night flight; the Sunday morning flight got canceled first, and then the Sunday night one, and then they were rescheduling people. This led to numerous late driver changes on the card. Roy and MacDonald had been listed to drive horses in each of the 10 races; Jamieson had drives in five. In their absence, Chris Christoforou, Guy Gagnon, Tyler Jones, Jonathan Drury, Phil Hudon, Doug McNair, Austin Sorrie, Scott Young, Aaron Byron, Ed Hensley, Sylvain Filion, and Travis Cullen all picked up one or more catch drives.

Woodbine Mohawk Park regular Louis-Philippe Roy was also stranded in PEI for a few extra days.

Caliber of races aside, Monday night at Mohawk seemed evocative of the 2011 Breeders Crown at Woodbine Racetrack, when an October snowstorm prevented drivers Tim Tetrick, George Brennan, David Miller, Yannick Gingras, Jimmy Takter, and Trond Smedshammer from making it to Ontario from New Jersey.

"We missed the Monday races, but at the end of the day, I got a couple of extra days with my son and my family," said MacDonald. "There was a lot of us at the hotel, so the kids got to go swimming together. There was enough to keep us busy. There wasn't a lot open, but luckily our hotel [Delta Charlottetown] was set up nicely, so everyone could hang out. We played cards, and there's a restaurant there, and a bar."

Rivalry on the track did not prevent the two O'Brien Driver of the Year finalists from spending time together during the historic PEI snowstorm.

"Louis was just a floor down from us, in the same hotel, so we spent most of the time with Louis and his girlfriend Courtney, and my brother Curtis [of Cujo Entertainment, a 2023 O'Brien Media Excellence finalist for Outstanding Video, Film, or Broadcast]," said James. "Jody [Jamieson] was in the Holman Grand [hotel], but then he slipped over to my uncle 'Rabbit's' place and they had a nice dinner the one night. We kept in touch. Jody came over to our hotel one night... There was lots to do. We kept ourselves busy and entertained."

The storm did not diminish the euphoria of James' victory. He said that despite his best-ever season by earnings (\$7,785,404 U.S.), and leading all Canadian drivers by wins last year (430, tenth-best in North America), he didn't feel completely confident that he would repeat as Driver of the Year.

"But I was optimistic," James said. "I knew I had another solid year, but Louis [Roy] did as well. Louis won a lot of Grand Circuit races, and those big ones really add up. So, I was hoping to hear my name called."

The pressure was on, because a large contingent of MacDonald family members attended the awards banquet.

"I had a lot of my uncles and my mom and dad [Fred] there," James said. "My mom [Red Shores Charlottetown track photographer Gail MacDonald] was taking the pictures. It was a packed house for sure. I had my uncle Sandy, and my brother Bobby and his wife Patrice, and just a big crowd of us."

The thrill of winning his third straight O'Brien Award as Keith Waples Driver of the Year was the best ever, said James.



"There's not much better feeling in the world than that..." James said. "It adds to it for sure. Anytime you can be recognized as the top driver in your jurisdiction, or in Canada, it's special. A lot of hard work goes into it, you know: long nights, bad nights, good nights, and just trying to stay healthy. A lot goes into it, so for it to culminate at the end of the year into an award is really special."

The PEI native said that the moment of the announcement, in his home province, was an unforgettable highlight in his 16-year driving career.

"Having all my family there, and just seeing how excited they were when they heard my name called," he said. "You know, some of them aren't necessarily that into the harness racing aspect of horses, so it was cool for them to kind of get a night

out and see all my friends and family there, how excited they were. That was the best part... It's always fun when you get a crew of MacDonalds out together... It's just a lot of fun for a big group of people to get together and all be cheering for the same goal."

Missing out on his first scheduled drives after the O'Briens didn't faze James, who quipped that Monday at WMP "didn't look like a fun night to be that paddock judge or someone trying to organize all the drives." Finding catch drivers was doubly complicated by the absence of Bob McClure, currently sidelined with a broken leg.

Canada's 2023 Driver of the Year is already leading the 2024 Woodbine Mohawk Park standings, with 38 wins from 159 drives, an early advantage over second-place Doug McNair, who has 26 wins from 147 drives (as of Feb. 7).

"It's been a great start, and I'm just hoping for the same thing as every year," James said. "I can stay consistent and show up every night with a good attitude, and staying healthy is priority number one."

Ake Svanstedt moved by Trainer of the Year honor

Ten years after moving to the United States, the award is a strong indication that he has been approved by the North American harness racing industry.

Trainer Ake Svanstedt had an impressive resume prior to moving to the U.S. in 2014.

In his home country of Sweden, Svanstedt was honored five times as Trainer of the Year, three times as Driver of the Year, and in 2017, he was inducted into Sweden's Trotting Hall of Fame.

So, when the U.S. Harness Writers Association (USHWA) chose him as the 2023 Glen Garnsey Trainer of the Year, it could have been old hat, but according to his wife, Sarah, she saw on his face that this was not just another trophy for the mantle.

"He was actually sentimental," Sarah said of the moment her husband was contacted by USHWA.

Sarah has worked alongside Ake for 20 years — married for the last 14 — as his right-hand person and partner in the Svanstedt Stable.

"America has always been open for everyone but [receiving an award like this], you feel like you're approved, that you have done well, and people appreciate the result and the work and the effort," she said. "You feel like people like what you have done. So, it's nice because, I mean, it's a lot of work behind this."

When the Svanstedts moved here 10 years ago, their two boys were just babies and now Erik will be 13 in March, and Jonas just turned 11.

According to Sarah, their busy lifestyle, especially during Grand Circuit season, has not always been easy on their sons, but Erik and Jonas are at an age now where, at least they can understand why it's all happening.

"So, they're going to come with us to [the Dan Patch banquet] and I said, 'Now you're going to see why we are flying around every day in the summer and really not around too much and why we're doing it," Sarah said.

In 2023, as a trainer, Ake racked up the most wins (162) and money (\$9,854,369) of his career since moving to North America with a UTRS of .419. It was the same for him on the driving end with 92 wins, \$5,829,463 in earnings and a UDRS of .455.

President and chief executive officer of The Meadowlands, Jeff Gural, jumped on the Team Svanstedt bandwagon early and the bond between Gural and the Svanstedts started growing long before their filly named Bond won the 2023 Breeders Crown 3-year-old filly trot.

"Last year was an amazing year," Gural said. "Ten out of the, I think 12 or 13 horses that he trained, that I owned a piece of, were stakes winners, and I think nine of them won over \$100,000 and two of them won Breeders Crowns.

"Anyone who knows the yearling game knows having 10 stakes winners out of, maybe 13 horses, is almost impossible. On the other hand, maybe I'm his good luck charm."

Gural remembers meeting Ake at the sale in Lexington, because Ake bought a horse that Gural had bred.

"I told him, 'Gee, I appreciate you buying the horse, I'll take 25 per cent,' and that's how we met," Gural said.



According to Gural, both Per Eriksson and Jimmy Takter highly recommended Ake.

Gural said he felt like he was getting in on the ground floor with Ake, which was a big advantage, since most people in North America at that time didn't know what a great trainer Ake was.

"The perception I had [back then] was when you wanted to hook up with Takter or some of the other top trainers, you were at a disadvantage because the horses they were buying, they would offer to their regular clients first, then you would end up getting whatever is left over," Gural said. "So, having an opportunity to start over with someone who had no clients I thought was a good thing. And the two people I knew from Sweden recommended him."

In addition to racing horses, Gural and the Svanstedts are also partners in the breeding business.

"He's a great mentor, too," Sarah said of Gural. "I mean, he has so much experience with people and the business, so I really enjoy having him around."

In more than one post-race interview, Gural has taken the opportunity to praise both Ake and Sarah.

Among their many victories, the Svanstedt Stable won four Breeders Crowns – two with Gural: Bond and Warrawee Michelle – and 11 John Simpson, Sr. Memorial stakes races.

"So that's an amazing accomplishment that I don't think anyone's ever come close to where you have a stake for 2- and 3-year-olds and every horse you enter wins," said Gural about the Simpson stakes at Pocono. "That was pretty amazing. "I told Sarah, you know, it's going to be tough to duplicate the kind of year we had, but we'll see. We had some good 2-year-olds."

Sarah said she is proud of everything that their stable has accomplished since coming to U.S. and couldn't be prouder of the job her husband does.

"He is a tremendous horseman," she said. "Some people really have gifts and I really believe he has a gift with horses.

"He's easy to work with and I think he likes to teach what he's doing to others. He's a very talented man."

The Svanstedts style of training definitely reflects what they grew up with in Sweden and always puts the horse first. As a result, Sarah says the condition of the track, especially how much water is on it, is very important.

"Sarah is a lot of fun," Gural said. "I kid her that she drives everybody crazy with the watering of the track.

"So, she was constantly texting me, 'Get on the phone and tell your crew they've got to put more water on the track.' And then every once in a while, she'll say "Track was perfect.' So, I'll send [my crew] a message, 'The track is perfect.'"

In an effort to make sure there is enough water on the track, Sarah said that the Svanstedt Stable did a sponsorship putting their logo on the water truck hoping that it would encourage the crew to water when necessary. And although it's not exactly seen as a quid pro quo, Gural did say that Sarah made him a promise.

"Sarah promised me that she would find me a Hambletonian winner before I leave this world, so, I told her that she's not under any pressure because right now there's two great 2-yearold trotters [Karl and T C I], that I would expect would be tough to beat [this year].

"But luckily most of my good 2-year-olds are fillies, so I have a better chance of winning the Oaks, I think. But you never know what can happen. But she did promise that I'll win the Hambletonian before it's all said and done, so, in return, I make sure they put enough water on the track."

Hawthorne harness meet ending Monday

After that, standardbred racing won't return to Chicago until Oct. 19.

If Chicago racegoers miss the Sunday afternoon (Feb. 11) and Monday night programs at Hawthorne Race Course they will have to wait more than eight months before they get another opportunity to see the harness horses in action.

The meeting began on Sept. 9 with Friday, Saturday and Sunday racing through December followed by Sunday and Monday racing in January and February. Three programs were cancelled because of bad weather.

Since 2022, Hawthorne has been the only racetrack in the metropolitan area and the harness horses and thoroughbreds have had a time-share arrangement.

The thoroughbreds will return on March 23 and race 78 programs through Oct. 13.

Then, the standardbreds will be back on Oct. 19 for a 48-program meeting that will extend through Dec. 31 (although the Illinois Racing Board is expected to approve extending the meeting into next year as it did this year).

In deference to the Super Bowl telecast, Sunday's program will begin at 2 p.m. On Monday, the card that concludes the meeting will get underway at the usual 7:10 p.m.

There will be 11 races with 88 contestants on Sunday and 11 with 85 on Monday. The only race with a double-digit purse is the second on Monday, an \$11,100 open trot. On the low end are a pair of \$4,000 races on Sunday and another on Monday.

Going into the final two programs, Terry Leonard has reclaimed the title of champion driver that he held for six-straight years before Kyle Wilfong succeeded him in 2022 by gaining top honors at two meetings when the harness and thoroughbred schedules were split into two segments each.

Leonard has 95 winners in 496 outings, while second place Brandon Bates has won 74 of his 358 races. Wilfong, who now uses Hoosier Park as his primary base, is sixth with 43 triumphs to show for 259 starts.

The competition for the leading trainer title is much closer with the 1-2 finishers in the fall of 2022, Amy Husted and Erv Miller, again engaged in a duel.

Defending champion Husted has taken 36 of 185 starts, while Miller has captured 34 of 97.

The current meeting marked the end of the brilliant career of Annas Lucky Star, the 10-year-old trotting mare bred and owned by Danny Graham. In 2023 she was voted the outstanding member of her Illinois-bred age group for the eighth straight year in the voting conducted by the Illinois Harness Horsemen's Association.

She had a 22-race resume consisting of seven wins, three places and five shows for earnings of \$57,831 in 2023 and then was out of the mutuel money in two starts in January before her retirement.

She concluded her 155-race career with win, place and show vital statistics of 63-29-16 and a bankroll of \$688,694. Her best time was 1:53.1 in 2018 at Springfield.

Graham said he has moved Annas Lucky Star to Shawnee Run Farm in Kentucky and she will begin her broodmare career with a booking with Rebuff, Muscle Hill's fastest son and a winner of the Breeders Crown trot for 2-year-old colts and geldings.

"Rebuff is from the Cantab Hall line and I kind of wanted to go that way once and see what happens," said Graham, who resides in Salem, IL. "We'll try out of state for a couple of years, trying to make her [foals] to be Indiana and Kentucky eligible.

"Then, if it all eventually works out in Illinois, we'll bring her home."

To make up for the shrinkage in opportunities that the status quo since 2022 has created, non-betting races at the State Fairgrounds in Springfield and DuQuoin will be held again this summer. Purse money comes from the Hawthorne account and Hawthorne also is covering operating expenses.

This year there will be 28 programs in June, July, August, September and October, an increase from last year when 14 were held at Springfield and two at DuQuoin (where there was one rainout).

In addition, there will be the usual pari-mutuel races at the State Fairs in Springfield and DuQuoin in August.

The October start at Hawthorne is more than a month later than that of the current meeting.

Members of the Illinois harness racing community are hoping that by the time they come back the long-awaited state-of-theart \$400 million casino project at Hawthorne will be nearing completion.

A 2019 Illinois gambling law permitted six new casinos in the state (some of which are already operating at temporary locations) and a new harness track/casino in one of seven south suburban Chicago locations.

The law enabled existing racetracks to add casino gambling with a portion of the gross revenue earmarked for purses, culminating from years of lobbying for approval.

But, then after being in the forefront of the drive for casinos at racetracks, the state's premier thoroughbred track, the palatial

Arlington International Racecourse, did an abrupt about-face and took a pass on a racino. Then, the world-renowned racing showcase was put up for sale by its corporate owner Churchill Downs, Inc. with the stipulation that there would be no racing or casino gambling at the track.

Although the CDI management team has never admitted it, the obvious reason was to eliminate a racing and gambling competitor for nearby Rivers Casino, the state's most profitable casino, in which it purchased a 62 per cent interest for \$407 million in March, 2019.

The Chicago Bears bought Arlington with the intention of putting a new stadium and entertainment complex on the property and tore down the track. But school boards and other local jurisdictions have come out in opposition to giving the NFL team tax break incentives to embark on the project and it is in limbo.

Meanwhile, Hawthorne began demolishing a portion of its grandstand and clubhouse in 2020.

However, reconstruction for the racino has been stalled because of larger than expected costs caused by COVID-19 complications that produced supply chain issues, inflation and high interest rates compounded by restructuring of the Carey-family-owned business – which has about 160 shareholders – to meet Illinois Gaming Board requirements.

Even though the building has been partially demolished racing has continued.

When the racino is up and running, in addition to pumping money into the purse accounts its inception will end the dreaded recapture clause in the Illinois Racing Act that has plagued harness and thoroughbred horse people for nearly 30 years.

Recapture was a by-product of the 1995 law legalizing fullcard simulcasting in the state. It allows racetracks to recoup losses on live handle that are a consequence of taking bets on races simulcast from other states. The recapture amount is two per-cent of the decrease of Illinois handle on Illinois races since 1994 and is deducted from purse accounts. Over the years multi-millions of dollars have been deducted.

While Hawthorne is attempting to make a racino a reality a new harness track in the south suburbs remains up in the air.

The Racing Board approved a Dec. 6-29, 2020 meeting at a site in Tinley Park that video gaming operator Rick Heidner and Hawthorne president Tim Carey announced they were partnering to construct only to have Gov. J.B. Pritzker deny the racing dates and racino license.

The reason for the denial was a Chicago Tribune story linking some of Heidner's business projects to a banking family with organized crime connections. Heidner was later exonerated by the Gaming Board but he chose not to resuscitate the Tinley Park project.

Last March the possibility of a new harness track was back on the horizon when the Greenway Entertainment Group announced it wanted to build on an 80-acre site in Richton Park with the blessings of the village government.

But there was a problem; the proposed site is within 35 miles of Hawthorne and state law prohibits putting a racino inside the 35-mile boundary, giving Hawthorne the right to veto construction.

Hawthorne hasn't given its approval and the Illinois legislature hasn't responded to lobbying to eliminate the statutory roadblock.

Carey has said he plans to push for a second track with a casino but it won't be until after Hawthorne has completed its casino project.

Callmethebreeze upsets Just Believe in Great Southern Star

Just before Christmas, trainer Anton Golino feared the huge Yabby Dams team may have wasted their money on **Callmethebreeze**.

But now the French-bred European import is the toast of Down Under trotting.

Callmethebreeze, a 6-year-old son of Trixton, upstaged Aussie champion Just Believe to win in last Saturday night's (Feb. 3) \$300,000 Group 1 Great Southern Star final in race and track record time.

"I worked him and he seemed more like an old stallion interested in other things," Golino said. "Pat [Driscoll, owner of Yabby Dams] watched his work and I said he might have been 'had. But I changed a few things, got him behind a galloping pacemaker and everything changed.

"We've never had a horse like this, an older horse with a great record, so it's different. We make most of our horses from a young age. It's such a thrill to see him come out and do this."

Golino, who boasts stints with Noel Daley, Jean-Pierre Dubois and Timo Nurmos, is underselling his role in Callmethebreeze's stunning and almost immediate impact in Australia.

Callmethebreeze raced very well, but did a few things wrong when a solid second to Just Believe in his Aussie debut in the Group 2 Knight Pistol Trot at Ballarat on Jan. 20.

"There were plenty of positives to take from the [race], especially given he didn't handle the home bend at all, but picked himself up again and still made some ground on Just Believe late," driver Nathan Jack said. "Then Anton showed his genius. He's some sort of trainer. He changed a few things and I got a text early last

week saying he was really happy with the horse. When Anton sounds excited, and that's pretty rare, then I start to get excited."

Like the Little Brown Jug and Elitloppet, the Great Southern Star consists of heats and a final on the same race card.

Jack's excitement grew even more after Callmethebreeze made the most of an ideal draw and his early speed to lead easily and thrash his rivals in the first and weakest heat of the Great Southern Star.

He looked to win with plenty in the tank by 18.4m in a 1:53.4 mile.

It was a statement.

Jack surprised many when at the barrier draw for the final, when it came his time to pick an alley, he went for the second row (post 10) rather than wide on the front (six and seven were still available).

"Even though that left Just Believe to likely get one of those front row draws, I preferred to take 10 where I didn't have to be part of the early burn and hoped I could settle midfield in the running line," Jack said. "It played out pretty much as I hoped. Just Believe had to do a bit of work to get outside the leader and rather than let it become a sprint home, I got going early to put some pressure on [Just Believe].

"I couldn't let him dictate because he [raced] home in :54.7 in his heat, I had to make it a staying test. When Greg [Sugars, driver] went for Just Believe on the home bend and didn't kick away on me, I thought I was right in it and my bloke just kept coming, he was so strong. It was a mighty win and given all the circumstances, it's one of the biggest and most enjoyable wins of my career."

Callmethebreeze, who had won over \$1.5 million and two Group 1's in Europe, won Down Under's biggest trotting race by a neck in a blazing 1:53.1 mile rate for 1,720m.

And he'd shown he was the complete package by leading throughout in the heat and coming wide from the speed in the final.

"It's a huge thrill," Driscoll said. "It shows what you can do if you spend a bit of money on the right sort of horse from over there [in Europe].

"We took a bit of a punt, especially going into a big race like that with one trial and one lead-up race and against Just Believe, but it paid off. It was very satisfying."

Ironically, Driscoll said the deal was started as he sat at Solvalla watching Just Believe on Elitloppet Day last May. Adding to that, Driscoll also bred Just Believe.

But Callmethebreeze won't be returning to Europe.

The breeding barn beckons given his huge value as a stallion, but there's more feature racing to come Down Under yet.

"Barring injury, the plan is for another two years racing at the top level," Driscoll said.

Golino said the next major target would likely be the \$100,000 Hammerhead Mile at Menangle on March 9.

That's the race former star mare Maori Time set the Australasian record 1:51.5 record a few years back with Toddy McCarthy in the bike.

Given how much quicker the 1,400m Menangle track is compared to the 1000m Melton circuit, that Australasian record will be under serious threat if, as expected, Callmethebreeze and Just Believe clash again in the Hammerhead.

"You'd think if Callmethebreeze and/or Just Believe draw well and it is a warm night, they'll really test that record," Driscoll said.

Just Believe certainly lost no admirers after sitting parked throughout in record time and fighting all the way down the straight for his narrow defeat.

The huge Melton crowd gave him a hero's reception coming off the track despite tasting his first defeat in eight starts since returning from his three-race Swedish campaign in the middle of last year.

After the Hammerhead comes what looms as the strongest trotting race Down Under has seen in 10, maybe 20 or more, years.

The inaugural \$575,000 TAB Trot – a slot race – is at Cambridge in New Zealand on April 12.

Callmethebreeze will race in the Yabby Dams slot, Just Believe and star trotting mare Queen Elida are locked in, too.

Then there are the Kiwi stars headed by Oscar Bonavena, Muscle Mountain and Bolt For Brilliance.

Katie Toska puts her horses first, even on awards nights

If Katie Toska happens to be a no-show at dinnertime or on an awards night, there is a good reason for her absence.

When her name was called at the Michigan Harness Horseman's Association banquet two years ago, Toska wasn't there to accept her Caretaker of the Year award (Carlee Evans was the other recipient).

What was it that kept her away from the festivities?

In this instance, it wasn't what, but rather who.

"I had work to do in the barn and with the horses, so I wasn't able to go," Toska said. "It was as simple as that. We had to race the next day, so I needed to have the horses ready. A lot of people reached out to me wondering where I was, and I told them why I wasn't there. For me, the horses always come first."

This, fittingly, was one of the reasons she was selected for the caretaker honor.

In the life of the long-time horsewoman, horses have been and will be the top priority.

Toska, the granddaughter of trainer Jerry Toska, has been in the business for over 20 years.

Her adoration for horses, specifically, standardbreds, dates back to her childhood days in the American Midwest.

"My aunt came to live with us in my mom's house in Toledo and I always knew my grandpa had a barn, but I never had a chance to go there," Katie said. "One day, my aunt asked me if I wanted to go with her and clean stalls, so that's what I did. I thought I would do it for a weekend."

After two days of being around the horses, Katie was smitten.

A certain horse happened to catch her attention early on in her caretaking career.

"The first horse that I ever got to touch and talk to every day was a pacer called JL Bgs Image," she said. "He had a great personality. I loved him and I wanted to keep him forever. He was the one who taught me the first lessons of the business."

There have been other horses she has bonded with over the years, but for Katie, simply being around the horses every day is reason enough to keep her coming back each morning.

Helpful advice on how to tend to the pacers and trotters has been plentiful.

"I learned a lot from so many people, but I remember my grandfather telling me, 'Take care of the horses and they will take care of you," she said. "And it is true."

Special Strides is a perfect example of that approach.

"We bought him for 500 dollars," said Katie of the son of Camotion—Belize. "The guy told us there were no guarantees with the horse. He had a lot of issues, but Grandpa told me to put cold water on him and work on his legs every day; just take care of him. So that is what we did. I did a lot of research on what we could do to help him. Whether he raced or not wasn't the priority; getting him well was."

Months after his rehabilitation began, Special Strides was back on track.

"We paid \$500 for him, and he made us about \$10,000," Katie said. "We just took the time and didn't rush things. Everybody loved him when he raced because he tried so hard, and they knew he had a lot of hurdles to overcome. We still have him. He is a great reminder that horses are very resilient and that if you are willing to put in the time and have patience good things can happen."

Currently, there are seven horses – five racehorses, and two retirees – under Toska's care.

One in particular, Summer Lovesginger, has become a favorite.

"I like to call her my problem child," said Katie of the 5-year-old daughter of Fred and Ginger—Bolero Toki. "She wasn't halterbroke, so I went over to the owner's place and walked three of their horses. She was probably the worst one of the bunch. She didn't want anyone touching her, or looking at her; she was a pain in the butt.

"She ended up becoming a good racehorse, but no one wanted her because she was such a handful. She would rear up and she didn't want the harness on her. She went to the Amish to get broke and the man who was looking after her said, 'If you can get her to go in a straight line, she will be alright."

This January, at Northville Downs, the bay mare was better than alright.

In rein to Justin Irvine, Summer Lovesginger pulled off a 20-1 upset, crossing the line a 1 ³/₄-length winner in a time of 1:56.2.

"We just kept on working with her," Katie said. "Other trainers gave me some advice on what we could do to help her along. People would tell me not to give up and we didn't." I learned a lot from so many people, but I remember my grandfather telling me, 'Take care of the horses and they will take care of you.' And it is true.'

Does this mean Katie has the magic touch with the so-called problem horses?

"I don't know if I do or not," she said. "But I do get the nice, wellbehaved ones every now and again."

Whether they are hard-headed or open-minded is of no matter to Katie.

Simply having the opportunity to work with the horses is her biggest reward.

"Seeing them every morning and knowing they are happy is the biggest thing for me," she said. "I love to take care of them, and I want them to look good so that they are shining."

When she isn't tending to their needs, Katie can be found, time permitting, creating works of art.

No need to ask what the subject matter is for her creations.

"I have a little artsy side to me," she said. "I love to draw and paint horses. I always give them away. It is relaxing for me, and I enjoy it a lot. Sometimes you need that time just to exhale and enjoy the quiet. But I love being with the horses."

It is why, on occasion, Katie might be a little late at the dinner table or miss out on a special evening.

She will always have a legitimate reason why.

"If work needs to be done at the barn, that's where I will be," she said.

The best trotters gather again at Vincennes

Vincennes' winter meeting continues with the \$420,000 Prix de France over 2,100 meters on Sunday (Feb. 11) and the best of the best among top trotters in Europe will battle on the black track in Paris.

Prix d'Amérique winner Idao de Tillard will try to defend his position as grand prix winner and last year's dominant horse in the Prix de France and Prix de Paris. Ampia Mede Sm is just one out of many strong contenders in Sunday's event at Vincennes.

The shorter distance, compared to the Prix d'Amérique (2,700 meters), makes the Prix de France more like a mile race. The car will leave the field shortly before the downhill part of the track, so when the horses seek their respective positions, the speed normally reaches high levels.

Hokkaido Jiel and Joviality, runner up and third behind Idao de Tillard in the Prix d'Amerique two weeks ago, both entered the Prix de France, but unfortunately for Joviality, she will start far outside behind the gate, from post 9, while Hokkaido Jiel will begin in second line as number 17.

During the same day, Jean-Michel Bazire has engaged his new star Jushua Tree in the \$125,000 Prix Ovide Moulinet, where he'll be the big favorite to win.



'Chip' remains mighty at Monticello

Gary Messenger describes Chip Chip Conway as "one tough little horse," and it is easy to understand why.

After being sidelined five months because of emergency intestinal surgery in 2022, the then 6-year-old male trotter returned to action in mid-October of that year at Monticello Raceway and won the open. He closed out that season by hitting the board six more times in eight starts, winning three.

But that was just a warmup for 2023. Last year, Chip Chip Conway posted 14 victories to finish tied for the most wins among all older trotters in North America. In fact, only 3-year-old Goomster had more, with 16.

As a result, Chip Chip Conway was named Monticello's Trotter of the Year for the second time in his career. He captured his first title in 2021.

"He's just the star of the stable," said Messenger, who bred and owns Chip Chip Conway with Ken Weckstein, in addition to training the gelding. "Everybody loves him."

What's not to love? Chip Chip Conway, an 8-year-old son of Conway Hall—Get Chipped, has won 43 of 149 career races and earned \$340,431. A winner in the New York Sire Stakes series as a 2-year-old, he has collected a paycheck 121 times. "He tries a hundred per cent every week," Messenger said. "He's one tough little horse. He had surgery two years ago and he's got a little hitch to him, but knock on wood, he doesn't go off stride; he stays at it. He just keeps trying."

Messenger trained Chip Chip Conway's mother, Get Chipped, who was purchased by Weckstein and a partner as a 3-yearold. Messenger became a co-owner three years later. The mare finished her seven-year racing career with 27 wins and \$415,424 in purses.

Chip Chip Conway was Get Chipped's first foal.

"She was a real nice mare," Messenger said. "She got an infection in her foot. We turned her out and bred her."

Messenger and Weckstein were honored with the Cradle of the Trotter Breeders Award by the Monticello-Goshen chapter of the U.S. Harness Writers Association at its annual awards banquet in December. In addition to Chip Chip Conway, the two enjoyed success with homebred 2-year-old male pacer Spectacular Plus, who won four preliminary rounds of the NYSS Excelsior Series and finished second in the final.

"It's a very nice award," Messenger said. "We don't breed a whole lot, so to get that award was very unexpected."

Messenger, a native of Monticello, got started in harness racing in the early 1970s, working with Clint Galbraith, before starting his own stable in 1976. Over the years, he has been a leading driver and trainer at the Mighty M.

"Nobody in my family ever worked with horses," he said. "When I got out of high school, I met a guy that had a couple horses, and he took me to the track. I helped him a little bit with his horses; that's pretty much how I got started.

"I'm going to be 70 this year and I still get up every morning and feed the horses. Everybody tells me to retire, but I don't want to retire. What am I going to do? I just love the animals

and I love the business."

Chip Chip Conway made his fourth start of this year on Wednesday (Feb. 7) at Monticello, where he finished third.

"He's been racing pretty solid," Messenger said. "He's not maybe as sharp as he could be, but he's been racing good. He's doing well. He won last week. He's always assigned the outside, so it's tough for him."

As for the horse's future, it is pretty simple.

"We'll just keep racing him," Messenger said. "When he retires, I'll retire him here at my farm. He'll be here for as long as I'm here."

Hall of Fame trainer Jerry Silverman, 88, dies

Hall of Fame trainer Jerry Silverman, who at the age of 31 won the 1966 Pacing Triple Crown with Romeo Hanover and remained a success on the Grand Circuit for five decades, has died. Silverman's son Richie announced the news Monday evening on his Facebook page. Jerry was 88.

"It is with great sadness and a heavy heart that we share the passing of our dad, Jerry Silverman," Richie posted. "It's beyond words how much he was loved and will be missed."

Jerry, a kid from the Bronx who spent time in his younger days trying to find ways to sneak into Yonkers Raceway, was working for his cousin's real estate agency when he decided to change careers. Jerry was driving through Maryland to check on a property when he came across the farm of well-known horseman Alan Myer. He stopped, introduced himself, and told Myer of his interest in horses.

"That was the start of the thrills in my life," Jerry said in a 2019 story in Hoof Beats. He began working for Myer, ignoring advice from his cousin that he should stick to real estate.

Jerry burst on the scene with Romeo Hanover, an \$8,500 yearling purchase who was hailed by writers of the day as the sport's grandest star next to three-time Horse of the Year Award winner Bret Hanover. Romeo Hanover won 13 of 16 races at age 2 and 18 of 19 at 3, taking divisional honors both years.

Over the ensuing years, Jerry's stable produced numerous top performers. He won the 1982 Meadowlands Pace with Hilarion and Breeders Crown trophies with 3-year-old colt pacer Masquerade (1986) and 4-year-old mare pacer Glowing Report (2005). Die Laughing was a \$2-million-earner, as was Glowing Report, making him the first trainer with male and female pacers to reach that level in purses.

Other stakes winners for Jerry included Fame, Hit Parade, Must See, Peachbottom, Perfect Union, Rodine Hanover, Saccharum, Summer Child, and Vintner.

In 2018, Jerry was elected to the Harness Racing Hall of Fame. He was inducted the following year. "I just got lucky, that's all," Jerry said in 2019. "All I can say is that I tried my best, did what I could. I was a little Bronx boy that had no experience, and luckily, I had the right people with me. That's basically it in a nutshell."

Jerry is survived by his sons, Richie (Beth) and Brian; daughters, Brittany and Melissa (Mark) Beckwith; grandchildren, Cori, Sara, Carly, Brett, Jaiden, Rylee, Brielle, Emery, and Karmelo; and brother, Ron.

Graceful Touch, 24, dies

Graceful Touch, a stakes-winning filly who made a mark in trotting bloodlines, has died at the age of 24 at Hunterton Farm in Paris, KY.

Graceful Touch was of royal trotting parentage, a daughter of world champion Pine Chip and Act Of Grace, a filly who took on the colts in the Hambletonian for Hall of Famer Stanley Dancer. The maternal family includes several stakes-winning fillies and Graceful Touch's third dam, Peridot, produced the great Green Speed, the 1977 Horse of the Year.

Trained by Chuck Sylvester and frequently driven by John Campbell, Graceful Touch took a record of 1:56.1 at age 2 and earned \$161,893. Her 2-year-old season was her best as she won four of eight starts and finished second in an elimination for the Breeders Crown.

During her racing career, Graceful Touch was owned by Perretti Farms, which naturally added her to its broodmare band when she was retired from the track. She produced 13 foals, among them her first-born, Muscle Mass 2, 1:53.4 (\$229,000), and her third, Hambletonian champion Muscle Massive 3, 1:51 (\$1,239,138). In addition to their racing accomplishments, both also became successful sires. She also produced six daughters which include the Merrie Annabelle winner Thatsnotmyname 2, 1:55 (\$340,730). Today several major breeders, including Hunterton, have her daughters and/or granddaughters in their broodmare bands to carry on her maternal lineage.

Hunterton Farm's Steve Stewart, Black Creek Farm and Maumee River Stables purchased Graceful Touch in 2014. She was buried on Hunterton Farm.

I thank the community for its continued support and as Tioga Downs grows in success, I plan to continue sharing such success with the community; as an example, we've recently increased our support to the local non-profits to \$2 million a year."

Callie Davies-Gooch named to the Hall of Fame screening committee

Callie Davies-Gooch, whose harness racing involvement spans over 50 years in a variety of areas, has been named to the Hall of Fame screening committee, it was announced by U.S. Harness Writers Association president Barry Lefkowitz. The screening committee takes the Hall of Fame nominations from USHWA chapters, discusses them with a panel of representatives from the Hall of Fame, and then decides who will go on the summer ballot for Hall of Fame election. They also select a veteran to go into the Hall of Fame.

Although coming from a farming family in California, it wasn't until Callie accompanied her mother to Phoenix Trotting Park in the mid-1960s at the age of 14 that she caught the harness racing bug. After Phoenix, the family returned to California to race at Hollywood Park, Santa Anita, and Bay Meadows.

She married Brent Davies, who, along with her mother, Jackie, operated a successful stable on the Ontario Jockey Club circuit for many years.

Then, in 1972, Davies-Gooch moved from the backstretch to racing administration, first with the Canadian Trotting Association (now Standardbred Canada) as a field representative inputting race results and other administration duties. After a stint with Times: In Harness, a leading harness racing publication, as marketing manager, she took a long-lasting job with the Hambletonian Society as staking manager.

Part of her duties with the Hambletonian Society was traveling to various host tracks for the Breeders Crown (and of course, the Hambletonian), not only being the "advance person" at these facilities, but also helping facilitate the events on race days, ensuring everything would run smoothly.

In addition to her work with the Hambletonian Society, Davies-Gooch was and still is involved in volunteering her time to many harness racing endeavors, including a 14-year stint as president of the Harness Horse Youth Foundation. She currently underwrites the January Davies Humanitarian Award, which is given annually at the U.S. Harness Writers Association Dan Patch Awards Banquet.

"Callie's well-rounded experience in the sport will certainly be an asset to the Hall of Fame screening committee," said Lefkowitz in making the appointment and announcement.

Davie-Gooch, a member and director of the New Jersey chapter of USHWA, joins returning committee members Steve Wolf, Gordon Waterstone, Leon Zimmerman, and Thomas Hicks.

The U.S. Harness Writers Association is the leading group of communicators about the standardbred horse. USHWA conducts the official annual balloting for the sport's most prestigious honors: induction to the Hall of Fame and Communicators Hall of Fame, along with the selection of the Horse of the Year, Trotter and Pacer of the Year, and the leading divisional horses of each season.

Miami Valley sets new handle record

The 2024 meet has been a successful one so far for Miami Valley. The entry box is strong, field size is averaging nine-plus, 14 races a day and the handle is up.

Bettors have been tuning in as MVG's handle is currently up \$3.3 million over 22 cards compared to 2023, which was the strongest year in MVG's short history.

Just a short while ago, back on Jan. 17, a new all-time handle was achieved, reaching \$870,833. Now, just two weeks later, after flirting with the handle record again last Thursday, a warm Sunday afternoon (Feb. 4) set the stage for a truly exciting accomplishment, the first million-dollar night at MVG in its

10-year history. A grand total of \$1,087,501 was wagered on the 14-race card.

The Sunday card saw plenty of value as only three betting favorites came home winners. It's a common theme at MVG, as only 40 per cent of the betting favorites win. Solid horses and a very talented driver colony, one that has its top four drivers separated by only two wins, lead to very competitive races.

The Big M is the place for big handles

After wagering \$3,276,820 last Friday (Feb. 2), the total action on Saturday (Feb. 3) was \$3,631,898, meaning handle came just \$92,000 short of reaching the \$7-million mark for the weekend.

The last time the \$7-million hurdle was cleared was Hambletonian weekend (Aug. 4-5).

The last two Saturdays produced the two biggest nights of business thus far this year. On Jan. 27, handle was a 2024-best \$3,779,096.

Multi-race wagering remains extremely popular at the mile oval, as the "Big 3" — comprising the 20-cent Pick-5 and the two 50-cent Pick-4s — got big play last Saturday.

The Pick 5 took in \$71,296, while the early and late P4s saw \$95,895 and \$93,557 pushed through the windows, respectively.

PICK-8 CARRYOVER: Speaking of multi-leg bets, tonight, 20-cent Pick-8 players will be shooting for some free green, as the wager's pool will start out with a carryover of \$5,913.

The Pick-8 is offered on races 4 through 11, and players are reminded that past performances for every race of every Meadowlands card are offered free of charge at playmeadowlands.com.

WHO ARE YOU CALLING AN AMATEUR? The Meadowlands Amateur Driving Club returned last Friday, and the response from bettors was vigorous. In fact, betting on the first race (the first of two MADC dashes on the card), took in \$364,050, the biggest single-race handle in United States harness racing in 2024.

After the second MADC dash took in over \$200,000, total handle on the amateur events was \$565,835, an average of \$282,917. For perspective, if \$282,917 was the average for a 14-race program, the handle would total \$3.96 million.

"The MADC returned with super results," said Meadowlands chief operating officer/ general manager Jason Settlemoir. "Those races provide some of the most competitive and popular events in the nation." **CHECK OUT THE SHOW:** Join The Meadowlands' TV team of Jessica Otten and Dave Little this weekend as they will be on the Sam McKee Memorial Broadcast Set with The Big M's live "Racing from The Meadowlands" pregame show.

Nadia Lobell and Moni Maker move to Scioto

Eldorado Scioto Downs will host two new \$120,000 events during the 2024 racing season. Both the Nadia Lobell, for 3-year-old pacing fillies, and the Moni Maker, for 3-year-old trotting fillies, will move to Scioto and be held on Saturday (July 6).

"I was looking for a couple races we could host on our Next Generation night, and these fit the bill really well," said Jason Roth, Scioto's director of racing. "After talking with Connie [Hochstetler from Red Mile] down at the race secretary's meeting, we're looking forward to hosting these historic Grand Circuit races."

The \$750 nomination is due March 15 for both the events, payable to Red Mile. The \$1,000 sustaining payment will be due on April 15. The declaration fee will be \$2,000.

Ten horses will start in each event, with the top 10 highest lifetime money earners who enter that are eligible and qualified to start. Full conditions are available on the USTA website **here**.

The Nadia Lobell was first held in 1990, just two years after the world champion pacing filly raced her last start. By No Nukes out of the Albatross mare Norah Bell, Nadia Lobell earned just over \$1 million on the track and took a lifetime mark of 1:53.4 at Pompano Park at the age of 3.

Nadia Lobell, the race, was first won by Crafty Caper and Howard Parker in 1:53.4. The race, which boasts such great mare winners as She's A Great Lady, Ohyouprettything, Cathedra Dot Com, Rainbow Blue, Cabrini Hanover, Western Gallie, Little Miss Dragon, Tug River Princess, Put On A Show, Shebestingin and others was then held at Garden State Park, The Meadowlands, Red Mile, The Meadows and most recently Harrah's Hoosier Park.

The Moni Maker was first held in 2005 at Red Mile, and won by Coulantine and Charlie Norris in 1:55.3, before it moved to The Meadows, The Meadowlands and most recently Harrah's Hoosier Park. Other notable winners over the years have included Passionate Glide, Maven, Bee A Magician, Shake It Cerry, Mission Brief and Manchego.

Needing no introduction, Moni Maker, by Speedy Crown out of the Bonefish mare Nan's Catch, earned a staggering \$5.5 million, nearly half earned overseas, and set the world record for Racing Under Saddle at the age of 7 in 2000 with Julie Krone riding. She was named the Dan Patch Older Trotting Mare of the Year four times (1997-2000), the Dan Patch Trotter of the Year three times (1998-2000), Dan Patch Horse of the Year two times (1998-99), the Nova Older Trotter of the Year three times (1998-2000) and the O'Brien Older Trotting Mare of the Year twice (1999-2000). She was inducted into the Harness Racing Hall of Fame in 2006. Moni Maker died 10 years ago in 2014 at the age of 21.

"We're excited to bring these races to Ohio and add to the rich history these mares and these races have offered fans throughout the years," Roth said. "It will be a big weekend of racing and we have some special promotions we are working on to bring everyone to Columbus."

The 90-day 2024 Eldorado Scioto Downs race meet will open on Thursday (May 9) and conclude on Saturday (Sept. 14). Races will be held Tuesday-Saturday with special holiday cards on Memorial Day and Labor Day taking place instead of the Tuesday card that week. First post will be 5:45 p.m. each day except for Friday (Sept. 13) which will have a 6:45 p.m. post to help accommodate horsemen attending the Ohio Selected Yearling Sale.

The 2023 Minnesota older divisional award winners announced

The 2023 Minnesota harness racing divisional award winners are being announced this week, as the MHRI annual meeting and awards banquet approaches. The celebration of the 2023 season will take place on Saturday (Feb. 17) at Running Aces Casino, Hotel and Racetrack in Columbus.

The Minnesota divisional awards are made up of the top two performers by earnings in each age and gender group in the Minnesota-sired restricted events at Running Aces.

The 2023 older divisional champions are: Susie's Sister, Bringoverthemoney, Cruzin Coco, and Handsome Harvey.

The 2023 older divisional runner-up award winners are: Wilamar Spark, Al-Mar Spicey Talk, Kitty Wampus and Alilthundadownunda.

Susie's Sister is a daughter of Claudius Augustus out of the S J's Photo mare Sue's Photo. She posted three wins, four seconds and one third from 16 Running Aces starts in 2023 during her 6-year-old campaign to capture the divisional champion award.

Susie's Sister closed out her year with a total of four wins and 13 top-three finishes from 24 starts and total earnings of \$78,776 for owner Lynchris, LLC. Her fastest seasonal win time of 1:55.3 came at Running Aces on June 18, and she repeated that clocking again on July 2. She was bred by A Piece Of The Action, LLC and was trained during her Minnesota campaign by Jenni King.

The older trotting mare runner-up award winner is Wilamar Spark, a daughter of Southwind Flash who is owned by her breeder Jeanne Marquis in partnership with Jay De Long and is trained by Justin Anfinson.

The older male trotting division champion is Bringoverthemoney, a son of Money Talks out of the Overcomer mare Bringitover who posted yet another very impressive campaign in his 8-year-old season.

Bringoverthemoney was competitive throughout the year at the top open handicap level and recorded three wins, two seconds

and five thirds from 19 Aces starts, posting his fastest win of the season in 1:54.3 on Night of Champions.

Bringoverthemoney ended his 2023 campaign with an overall summary of 28 6-2-5 and total earnings of \$78,114 for owner Joshua Horvat. His career earnings now stand at \$366,025 which makes him the richest Minnesota-sired trotter to date. Katie Horvat is the breeder and trainer for Bringoverthemoney and his 2023 drivers included Jacob Cutting, Dean Magee and Mooney Svendsen.

The older trotting runner-up award winner is Al-Mar Spicey Talk, also a son of Money Talks and also owned by Joshua Horvat and trained by Katie Horvat.

The 2023 champion older pacing mare is Cruzin Coco, a daughter of Voracious Hanover out of the Big Towner mare Towners Love Dove.

Cruzin Coco posted six wins, one second and two thirds from 13 starts at Running Aces during her 10-year-old season, she posted her fastest winning mile of 2023 (1:52.4) at The Meadowlands on April 14. She closed out her season with a final overall summary of 24 8-0-3 while earning a total of \$48,411. Her career totals after 2023 show 47 wins and earnings of \$366,764.

Cruzin Coco was bred by Ron Emerson and was owned during her 2023 Minnesota campaign by Ashley Sluggett and was trained by Darryl Cutting and later by Michael Meza. Her main drivers included Jacob Cutting and James Lackey. She was retired from racing at the end of the Running Aces season and sold to Van Otterloo Stables to begin a new career as a broodmare.

The runner-up older pacing mare award went to Kitty Wampus, a daughter of It's That Time who is owned by Heart & Soul Racing and Craig Rhodes. Brett Ballinger was the trainer at Running Aces for Kitty Wampus and she was bred by Van Otterloo Stables.

The older male pacing divisional champion award went to Handsome Harvey, a son of Special Forces who had six wins and two seconds from 14 starts at Running Aces during his 4-year-old season. He worked his way all the way up to the open handicap level and was able to beat some of the best older male pacers at the top level in the process.

Handsome Harvey took his career mark of 1:51.3 at Aces on July 3. He showed an overall summary of 29 12-6-4 for the year with total earnings of \$89,848 for owners Dave Haness and Luke Plano, who also trains and drives. Timothy Lems was the breeder for Handsome Harvey.

The runner-up older male pacer award winner for 2023 is Alilthundadownunda, a son of Malak Uswaad N. The 2022 Minnesota Harness Horse of the Year is owned by his breeder Set The Pace Racing, LLC and is trained and driven by Nick Roland.

As per tradition, the overall 2023 Minnesota Harness Horse of the Year award will have open nominations and a live vote at the (Feb. 17) banquet at Running Aces.
