Anthony Beaton's training license reinstated following appeal hearing

The trainer had originally faced a two-year suspension for a case of alleged cruelty while breaking a yearling. Lawyer Jean-Marc MacKenzie said the complaints against Beaton were "highly exaggerated."

On Wednesday (Feb. 14), the Ontario Horse Racing Appeals Panel (HRAP) released its lengthy decision to reinstate trainer Anthony Beaton.

His lawyer, Jean-Marc MacKenzie, told HRU via text on Thursday (Feb. 15) that it was more than merely a victory for the trainer.

"We are pleased with the issuance of the ruling that Anthony was immediately and fully reinstated as a trainer; undoubtedly the best outcome, allowing him to promptly resume his work," MacKenzie said. "They obviously can't give back what he lost. The dismissal of the AGCO's (Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario) cruelty charges against Anthony is not merely a victory; it's a validation of the absence of any evidence supporting those allegations. The panel's ruling emphatically underscores Anthony's standing as a highly-successful standardbred trainer, portraying him as a professional of unwavering good character and exceptional horsemanship."

Dave Landrv Trainer Anthony Beaton has won his appeal in Ontario.

2024 Breeders Crown Foreign Stallion Nomination Form





Up to 15 North American Foals of 2025 by Foreign Stallions may be made eligible to the Breeders Crown with a payment by **March 15, 2024** of a Foreign Stallion Nomination Fee equal to the amount of the North American advertised service fee for a 2024 breeding. (\$500 U.S. funds minimum)

Additionally, any foals that are **foaled & registered in North America which are produced from mares bred outside of North America** may also be made eligible by a payment of the advertised stud fee in the country where the stallion stands. This payment provides Breeders Crown eligibility for a North American crop of up to 15 foals.



If the Foreign Stallion's **North American Crop is 15 foals or less**, that payment is the total amount due for these North American foals to be eligible to make the 2026 Yearling payment and maintain eligibility by the future payments to the Breeders Crown. Any additional amount ("surcharge") or refund of this nomination fee will be determined by the number of 2025 foals ("North American Crop") by these stallions standing outside North America ("Foreign Stallions") and foaled and registered in North America (either with the U.S. Trotting Assoc. or Standardbred Canada) as of August 15, 2025. All foals which are nominated as yearlings must be registered in North America at the time of nomination.

The case dates back to Oct. 12, 2023, when anonymous texts were submitted to AGCO judge David Stewart concerning Beaton's actions towards Wait In The Truck, a colt the trainer was breaking at Classy Lane Training Center in Puslinch, ON. All Beaton trainees were subsequently scratched right before the Oct. 13, 2023 races at Woodbine Mohawk Park. Beaton was immediately suspended for "using force causing injury to a horse and compromising equine safety and/or welfare."

On Dec. 28, the HRAP had rejected the Waterdown, ON trainer's request for a stay, on the grounds that allowing it would be

He was a brilliant two-year-old in 2021 winning eight out of his eleven starts, (seven in a row) His victories were all major stakes wins, including triumphs over the likes of Hambletonian champion Cool Papa Bell, Rebuff and Temporal Hanover.

As a three-year-old, he won the \$400,000 Kentucky Sires Stakes Final and stakes placed in an elimination of the Breeders Crown, the Empire Breeder's Classic, and Stanley Dancer Memorial.

"damaging to the public confidence in the administration of justice" in cases concerning equine welfare.

On Jan. 19, Beaton's appeal hearing began. It concluded on Feb. 1, after unusually-lengthy proceedings remarked upon by HRAP chair Stanley Sadinsky: "Counsel have given us a mountain of evidence to go over. We've heard from 22 witnesses; 19 exhibits have been filed. I think this is day 10 of the hearing, and... my suspicion is that we are close to a thousand pages of transcript."

Beaton himself testified on Jan. 24. He had worked for trainer Casie Coleman "for 10-plus years" before leaving to start his own stable in late 2016. He stated that he had never had a positive test, nor any "behavior or conduct issues."

In Feb. 1 closing statements, MacKenzie described "highlyexaggerated complaints" made against the trainer, who was alleged to have abused Wait In The Truck with a training whip when the colt repeatedly went down in a busy area at Classy Lane on Oct. 12. MacKenzie asked the panel to dismiss the charges against his client, on the grounds that evidence did not support allegations that Beaton had acted maliciously and/or harmed the horse.

"This was a training incident where they [Beaton and his barn staff] tried to respond appropriately," MacKenzie said.

MacKenzie argued that the AGCO's imposition of a two-year suspension was "clearly unjustified" because there were "no physical injuries to the horse" and no cruel intentions. He



said that observers who reported Beaton did not know what was actually happening, nor were they aware that whip marks visible in photos "were gone the next day" when a veterinarian examined the colt.

"A photo's not necessarily a photo if you don't understand the context of the situation," MacKenzie said.


In his final remarks, MacKenzie asked that his client's training license be immediately reinstated.

"Mr. Beaton has already served 111 days for what took place that day... which has gone well beyond the cases of actual cruelty that have been found by this panel," he said.

He also said Beaton had "suffered financial harm" and lost opportunities for himself and his stable when his trainees were scratched from Ontario Sires Stakes Gold Super Finals and he was personally unable to participate in the 2023 Breeders Crown.

Counsel for the registrar Faye Kidman argued in support of a two-year suspension of Beaton's license. She pointed out that "there are no maximum or minimum penalty guidelines for the [specific] violations," and recommended that Beaton serve the suspension concurrently for cruelty and conduct prejudicial to the best interest of racing.

Kidman added that Beaton's "fairly clean regulatory history" served as a "mitigating factor" against recommending more severe penalties, while noting that Beaton's actions toward Wait In The Truck went "to the very heart of regulating and

sustaining horse racing." She cited AGCO senior manager of racing adjudication Tyler Durand, who testified as a policy witness that "cruelty towards horses is seen as very serious misconduct... on par or more serious than positive tests" and negatively affecting "social license in standardbred racing."

Kidman stressed that public and government support for racing hinge on the perception of proportional punishment for rule violations, which has changed in recent times.

"We are living in a different social environment now than 10 or 20 years ago," she said, noting the general need for "significant deference to animal welfare, with stronger penalties than have been previously imposed."

She said a two-year suspension was an "appropriate penalty" for Beaton from the registrar's perspective, but also introduced the suggestion to "increase this penalty further, to serve the purposes of specific and general deterrence, and to denounce this conduct" and "vindicate against the culture of intimidation for speaking up in the racing industry."

The two themes came up repeatedly throughout the hearing: What are acceptable practices in breaking standardbred yearlings, today? And under what circumstances is it appropriate to report a situation to regulators?

Coleman, Beaton's former employer and co-owner of horses under his care, told the panel that the case against him created shockwaves across the harness racing industry.

"Everybody in the horse business was basically talking about it,"



Coleman said. "Nothing like this has ever really happened, that I can recall, ever in our business."

MacKenzie told HRU, "We were also pleased by the Panel's clear messaging to the AGCO on the need to conduct their own investigation when faced with anonymous complaints. This admonition gains particular significance in this instance, where the complaints were revealed to be grossly exaggerated and moreover the AGCO possessed this knowledge when they still opted to immediately suspend Anthony and scratch his horses in the OSS Super Finals. The panel's poignant question, 'We are puzzled why they (AGCO) scratched the horses', serves as a powerful call for transparency and accountability in their decision-making process. This scrutiny is imperative, considering the profound repercussions not only on Anthony, but on his employees, owners, and the entire industry."

MacKenzie confirmed there is no fine imposed on Beaton, nor any conditions on his AGCO training license.

"When they issued the ruling at 1:23 p.m. yesterday [Feb. 14], he was fully reinstated," said MacKenzie.

At the 2023 O'Brien Awards banquet on Feb. 3, Legendary Hanover was named Canada's 2-year-old male pacer of the year. He was trained by Beaton until last Oct. 13.

Matty Athearn is a natural on and off the track

During the winter months, young drivers have been heating things up at The Meadowlands, and many of them have been featured on the track's "In The Sulky" segment.

Last month Matty Athearn, 25, took his turn on set next to Meadowlands' TV host Dave Little, and was a big hit.

Little was impressed with how comfortable Athearn was on camera (seen here).

Having spoken with Athearn by phone prior to doing the show, Little said the young reinsman was guiet and reserved but, on the set, "he blossomed and was very personable."


According to Little, you never know how someone, even a seasoned vet of the game, will do once that red light comes on, but he was pleasantly surprised with Athearn.

"You assume that someone his age, racing on the circuits he's been racing on, hasn't had the kind of exposure and experience to sound as good as he did," Little said." There's a lot to remember on set. You have to hold the microphone the right way, you have to look at the host but you also have to remember to look at the camera. Athearn grew up in harness racing in Cumberland, ME, the son of trainers Gretchen and Mark Athearn and grandson of Ed "Bamps" Rohr III.

"I was at the fairs every single day when I wasn't in school," Matty said. "I would be at the fairs and I was usually with my grandfather. He got my mom into the business and my aunt, Heidi Rohr, now Nickerson [married to trainer Jimmy Nickerson].

"[My grandfather] got them started in the business and that's where my mom met my dad. As soon as I could walk, I was at the barn."

Matty credits his parents and grandfather for giving him a great foundation.

He also wants to thank his uncle, Jimmy Nickerson, the top trainer at Plainridge Park, and every other trainer that contributed to his career year in 2023 where he proved himself to be ultraconsistent when it came to hitting the board, going 256-275-263 for 1,855 starts, good for earnings of \$3,264,384.

In 2023, the Maine native recorded his 1,000th-career win. All 25 of his victories for \$25,000 or more came at Plainridge Park

where he banked over \$2 million and finished second in wins to Bruce Ranger (152-148). Matty and Ranger are the only two drivers to earn \$2 million or more in a single year in the history of Plainridge. They both passed that plateau last year, while Ranger also did it in 2021.


"[Matty's] a great kid, from a solid family, who will go far in this business," said Communicators Hall of Famer and standardbred owner Tim Bojarski. "He's been driving for me for two years now and although I could have had Dexter [Dunn] on Spirit Day last year, I never even thought of making that change because I feel Matty is that good of a driver. He's driving for me at Saratoga right now and we just won our last three starts."

After making four winner's circle visits at The Big M in December of 2023, Matty finally notched his first win at the East Rutherford oval in 2024 last Friday (Feb. 9) with the Per Engblom-trainee Chake.

"It was unbelievable," Matty said. "I mean, I feel like there's been a monkey on my back for the last couple of weeks and it feels like it didn't matter how I drove, whether it was good or bad, so it felt good to get that one off my back.

"I had a lot of good seconds, thirds, even fourths, just getting beat by a length... And sometimes you wonder, 'Could I have done this better to win the race?"

According to Matty, his success in 2023 has taught him to be patient, present and appreciative.

"Last year, I really struggled with letting races go and flipping the page and then these last probably six months or so, I've kind of gotten a lot better at learning that if I stay in the past and dwell on it, it's just going to keep bothering me and keep hindering my performance later on," he said. "The first couple of weekends I was [at The Big M in December], I was driving in every race and it wasn't the greatest of power, but it was just great to be in every race. And now these last two Fridays, I've gotten to drive a lot for Per and it's been unbelievable to sit behind those horses. They are just a different caliber and it definitely helps having a trainer like Per or, a Nifty Norman or just a bigger trainer, get behind you and help you out."

Matty recognizes that success at The Meadowlands can open doors in the future and he hopes his driving will make that happen.

"I'm not really somebody that calls the trainers every day and tries to almost bully myself into getting drives," said Matty, adding with a laugh. "I kind of let my driving do more of the talking than my actual mouth.

"I'd like the trainers to pick me for being a good driver, not for just being a chatty person that works their way into drives by




talking. It's easier if you drive and make yourself look good and then you talk instead of talking and you don't drive good and look bad."

Driver Jason Bartlett, who is first call for Engblom at The Meadowlands, is also from Maine and is proud of how Matty is representing their home state.

"Matty Athearn is putting his time in," Bartlett said. "He's another Mainer. I'm really, really happy to see that he came down here [to The Meadowlands] and is having the success that he's having. He's putting the work in so he's going to get his opportunities to make it."

Mary Ratchford, 19, records first training win

It is a win Mary Ratchford will gladly take, even though it was most unexpected.

In search of her first training win and just three starts into her career, the 19-year-old Ontario horsewoman knew it was simply a matter of time before she recorded her milestone victory.

That it would come with Shay Seelster had never crossed her mind.

"She has been a project from day one," Ratchford said. "My brother [driver, trainer and owner, Todd] bought her from the sale in 2021 and she was good training down – just awesome. Then she got a little sore on us, so we gave her some [time off] and turned her out. We brought her back and she got a little sore again, so we gave her some more time.

"We qualified her, and she kept making breaks. There were no lameness issues, but it was all in her head."

Yet there she was, with Todd in the race bike, powering away from her rivals in the stretch drive at Flamboro Downs on the night of Jan. 27.

A 4-year-old daughter of Sunshine Beach—She Butterfly, Shay Seelster crafted a 1 ¾-length score in 2:03 over a track listed as good.

The bay mare, 0-for-28 heading into the race, was now a first-time winner, just like her trainer.

"This is one horse that I don't think anyone would have expected to win a race," Mary said. "But she finally figured it out." As for who was more excited at the victory, her or Todd [he owns and once trained Shay Seelster], Mary would label it a dead heat.

"We were both thrilled," she said. "I didn't know if she was going to be the first one to get me that first win, but with all the work that went into her, it made the moment even sweeter."

As did the deluge of texts and phone calls that came in seconds after the race was over.

"I appreciate it all," Mary said. "Everybody works so hard in this sport, so when you see someone do well, it's important

to acknowledge that. I felt very lucky to have so many people reach out. It's so hard to get to the winner's circle, so when you do, there is no better feeling."

With her career in the opening-quarter phase, so to speak, Mary has a lot to look forward to.

But she took a quick moment to reflect on the journey that has brought her to the training ranks.

"I would always come to the barn during my high school days, but when COVID hit and all the classes went online, I was really able to go to the barn more often," she said. "I got into it more then — I was very hands-on — and last March, I trained my first one. I was hooked right at that moment.

"I had jogged horses but training them was a whole different ballgame. I thought, 'You know what? I want to have some more say in the barn'. So, I applied for my trainer's license. Todd would drive and I would be the trainer. And that's how it all came to be."

Mary currently has nine horses in her barn, a number she sees as ideal, at least for the foreseeable future.

Several of them are getting ready to launch their 2024 campaigns, including Buttinski, a son of Lookslikeachpndale—Dance Hall Wendy whom she co-owns.

"Nine horses are a pretty good number for us," she said. "We had 10, but one horse makes a lot of difference. You might not think one would, but it really does. Nine is good for now. The days are long, but that's okay; it keeps us busy.

"Buttinski, the first horse I trained, who was 2, now 3, is the one I have the most expectations for. He is one of my favorites. I am pretty high on him, and I think he could be something special. He's pretty solid. He has a good attitude and a good gait. He's got it all and now he just needs to put it together."

Whether it's horses like Budinski or her career, Mary isn't interested in rushing the process.

Forbearance has proved to be a winning approach.

"I'm new, so I am trying to soak up everything from everyone I meet," she said. "I think patience is the one thing I have learned

about myself, that I have more than I thought. You have to chill out and just take a step back sometimes. You have to listen to the horses. They are going to tell you how they feel."

Perhaps the biggest challenge to date for Mary is turning her thoughts away from the horses when she isn't at the barn.

For now, it can be termed a work in progress.

"My whole life revolves around horses," she said with a laugh. "The best thing and the worst thing about this sport is that you are always thinking about it, 24/7. It gets bad when you are overthinking – you wake up in the middle of the night and your mind is on that one horse you can't seem to get right – but you learn to trust yourself and do what you feel is best."

Hanging out with her friends has been a welcome tonic for relaxation and recharging.

Finding a time that works for everyone, however, does present its challenges.

"I am always looking for something to do," Mary said. "All my friends who are my age are in school, so their schedules don't align very well with my 24/7 schedule. But I try to get out as much as I can to keep my sanity."

Even in the most stressful of moments, the sights and sounds of the barn, especially in the early morning hours, are always treasured ones for Mary.

As to who is happiest once the greetings commence, Mary or her flock of nine, the young conditioner hasn't figured out the answer yet.

And that suits her just fine.

"I walk in and they are all hollering," she said. "I don't know if they are excited for me or food. I would say we are both happy; call it a dead heat."

Idao de Tillard dominates the Prix de France

Thierry Duvaldestin trained **Idao de Tillard** (Severino) proved best, again, when the \$420,000 Prix de France was held at Vincennes on Sunday (Feb. 11) afternoon.

Idao de Tillard got perfect cover three wide on the backstretch while the pace was kept at a high level by leader Joviality, who more or less seemed to escape from her own harness as she came to the half mile in :53.4. Joviality was, after that pace, beaten in the last turn and Vivid Wise As could overtake the lead when horses three wide approached at the same moment.

Vivid Wise As was disarmed by a splendid Idao de Tillard, who got the order to attack by his driver Clement Duvaldestin at the top of the stretch and the Prix d'Amérique winner is simply the best horse in Europe right now. He sprinted to a safe win in a stakes record of 1:51.3 over 1.3 miles and Idao de Tillard became the 13th trotter to claim both the Prix d'Amérique and

Prix de France. American bred Moni Maker succeeded twice in Paris in 1999, while the last horse, prior to Idao de Tillard, to claim the two Grand Prix races was Bold Eagle (2016 and 2017).

Go On Boy finished strongly as runner up from a tough position and title defender Ampia Mede Sm was third in the 2024 Prix de France.

Jean-Michel Bazire's star Jushua Tree was the heavy favorite in Sunday's \$125,000 Prix Ovide Moulinet for 5-year-olds, but an early break spoiled his chances, even though he returned in the field before making another break in midstretch.

Instead, driver Yoann Lebourgeois won the race behind Jean Rémi Deliaux trained **Justin Bold** (Bold Eagle) in a mile rate of 1:56.2 over 1.6 miles.

The winter meeting in Paris ends on March 2 with some high staked races, amongst them the \$250,000 Prix de Selection for 4-, 5-, and 6-year-olds, where the youngest trotters will have a 25 meters advantage over 2,175 meters.

Idao de Tillard will most likely show up in that event while Jean-Michel Bazire has announced that a showdown between Jushua Tree and Idao de Tillard will take place during the 2024-25 meeting.

Next up at Vincennes is Sunday's (Feb. 18) \$220,000 Criterium des Jeunes for 3-year-olds and for the elite, the \$420,000 Prix de Paris over 4,150 meters, is the next big objective.

A healthy Down Under harness industry needs a Trans-Tasman rivalry

For the first time since the pandemic, Mark and Barry Purdon will once again face off in Australia.

Down Under harness racing feels whole again.

The last lingering damage of the pandemic has subsided and the biggest names in New Zealand harness racing – two Hall

of Famers – Mark and Barry Purdon have crossed the ditch to Australia to chase feature race riches.

In the modern era, the Purdon family has driven the Trans-Tasman rivalry.

And, for many, stirred some of the great rivalries and races in recent memory.

Long ago, Mark and Barry trained together, alongside their late, great father, Roy.

But over the past couple of decades, they have been rivals as such in so many major races across Australia and NZ.

Mark's had megastars like Lazarus, Il Vicolo, Pride Of Petite, Smolda, I Can Doosit, Adore Me, Amazing Dream and others.

Barry's best includes champions like Chokin, Holmes DG, Christopher Vance, Luxury Liner and Diamond Field, to name just a few.

Aussie majors like the Miracle Mile, Hunter Cup and Chariots Of Fire were the "Purdon's Playground" for so long.

Then along came the pandemic and, around the same time, a major reshaping of the racing calendar across Australia and NZ.

Sadly, the two countries drifted apart.

But a healthy Down Under harness industry wants – no, absolutely needs – the intermingling. The Trans-Tasman rivalry.

It adds intrigue, adds tremendous and much-needed depth to our biggest races and stirs wonderful memories of great rivalries of years gone by.

And now it's back.

It's happening again and it feels like this is just beginning.

Mark was part of Melbourne's big Nights Of Glory carnival recently. It's the first time he has personally competed at that Melton carnival since 2020.

And, to the surprise of nobody, he almost weaved his magic and won the \$500,000 Group 1 Hunter Cup with what looks to potentially be his next pacing superstar, 4-year-old Don't Stop Dreaming.

Just a few weeks before the Hunter Cup, Don't Stop Dreaming wasn't even going to contest the race. His goal was the lesser 4YO Bonanza on the same night.

But an untimely and potentially career-ending injury to Mark's top pacer Akuta, changed his plans.

"When Akuta didn't go across, I thought it was worth putting Don't Stop Dreaming in the big one and he went so close," Mark said. "It was so good to be back in Victoria. It's been such a big part of my career and some of the best times I've had in the sport have been across in Melbourne, going back to those Moonee Valley days [at the old Melbourne track].

"I've met so many great people over the years and hadn't seen them for so long. I loved it."

Don't Stop Dreaming then headed straight to Sydney to chase more Group 1 glory.

Just seven days after the fantastic Hunter Cup second, he blitzed his rivals to win the Hondo Grattan Stakes at Menangle, which guaranteed him a spot in Australia's biggest 4-year-old race, the \$250,000 Group 1 Chariots Of Fire at Menangle on March 2.

Mark will further bolster his Sydney raid when 3-year-old We Walk By Faith heads across to chase the Group 1 NSW Derby, which starts with qualifying heats at Menangle on March 2.

But back to the Chariots Of Fire and, ironically, Mark's biggest danger in the Chariots looks to be his fellow Kiwi, Merlin, who is trained by Barry, in partnership with Scott Phelan.

Merlin is booked on a flight from Auckland to Sydney on Sunday morning. He will try and book his spot in the Chariots Of Fire via the Paleface Adios Stakes at Menangle on Saturday (Feb. 24). Barry has a confirmed Chariots competitor with his secondstringer, Sooner The Bettor, racing a terrific fourth to Don't Stop Dreaming in the Hondo Grattan.

Merlin and Don't Stop Dreaming already built a fascinating and spirited rivalry in NZ and will carry that to Menangle.

"It's been a good rivalry and it's still got some chapters to come," Barry said. "It's been great to see Don't Stop Dreaming go over and do so well, especially getting so close to Leap To Fame, who is the benchmark horse. It shows the form stacks up and points to a good future for both young horses.

"I think Merlin has the qualities to take that step from being a top young horse to open-class. He won [at Auckland's Alexandra Park] last Friday and needed the [race] too. He should be very, very close to his top by the time he lines up at Menangle."

Barry is looking forward to crossing the ditch.

"It's nice to be back on the circuit... we went through a stage where we had to send the right horses across to other trainers rather than take them ourselves," he said. "[Going to the big Australian races] was such a big part of my life for so long."

If Merlin and/or Don't Stop Dreaming win or race extra well in the Chariots, one or both could get invites to Australia's premier speed test, the \$1mil Miracle Mile at Menangle on March 9.

And that would truly mark the return of the Purdon clan to the biggest Aussie stage.

Barry has won five Miracle Miles: Christopher Vance (1991), Chokin (1993 and '94) and Holmes DG (1999 and 2000).

Mark won his first Miracle Mile with Have Faith In Me in 2016.

Could it be an omen that Have Faith In Me was a 4-year-old when he won it, just as Don't Stop Dreaming is now?

He then added a second Miracle Mile victory with Spankem in 2019 when training in partnership with Natalie Rasmussen.

Adding a third on March 9 would be extra special now that he trains in partnership with son, Nathan, who looks destined to take over the stable in the coming years.

Bravo for Primo Uomo

After getting time to grow into his role, Primo Uomo is hitting all the right notes.

Raced just twice at age 2, Primo Uomo returned last season to win 16 times – the third-best total among all 3-year-old pacers in North America – and bank \$114,867 for owners Dale Lawton and Chris Lawton. His earnings ranked second to only Grand Circuit-winner Racine Bell, who makes her 2024 debut tonight at The Meadowlands, in the Lawtons' stable.

Primo Uomo made 19 of his 33 starts last year at Saratoga, where he won 12 races and hit the board in an additional three. He was named the 3-year-old Pacer of the Year by the Saratoga Harness Horseperson's Association.

"He's a nice horse," Dale said about the David Dewhurst-trained gelding. "You can always count on him. If he has a bad race, it's because he's sick. He's very dependable. You just can't get enough of those kinds of horses."

The Lawtons purchased Primo Uomo as a yearling in June 2021. The son of Heston Blue Chip—Primadonna qualified twice for Dale in the summer of 2022 before being turned out in July. He returned to action in late fall with Dewhurst and made two starts in November, posting a win and a second.

"We knew he was a nice horse when we started out," Dale said. "He had a lot of ability, and a great attitude; he wanted to go forward. He didn't really like to take a backseat.

"His stakes were over before he was ready, so we turned him out in mid-July. Then we gave him to Dave to bring him back and see what he thought of him. Dave said he was a nice colt. From there he went. He didn't really get started until October. We just raced him a little bit and kind of waited on the 3-year-old year. "You've got to give them a little time to grow. He grew a lot just in the couple of months he was turned out. He needed time just to mature. It worked out."

Last year, Primo Uomo opened his campaign with five consecutive wins in conditioned races at Saratoga. He later captured the Dr. Richard Frank Memorial Pacing Series at the track, then began taking on older rivals in the opens at Vernon Downs and Saratoga.

"Every time we thought that was all he had, Dave told us, no, he's got a lot more," Dale said. "And he did. Dave has done a real good job for us."

So far this season, Primo Uomo has a win in three starts in the open at Batavia Downs. He returned to that level Thursday, starting from post 7 with Brett Beckwith in the sulky.

"He's kind of a half-mile specialist," Dale said about Primo Uomo, who has won 18 of 38 career races and earned \$128,717. "He can go on a big track, but he can get around a half. That's basically where we race most of the time in New York. We'll see what happens with him as the year unfolds."

As for Racine Bell, the 7-year-old millionaire will make her seasonal debut in tonight's \$27,500 featured pace for fillies and mares at The Meadowlands as she prepares for next month's start of the Blue Chip Matchmaker Series at MGM Yonkers Raceway.

The Lawtons considered retiring and breeding Racine Bell but changed their minds after she finished 2023 with four wins in her final five starts.

For her career, the daughter of So Surreal—Ty's Artist has won 37 of 95 races, hit the board another 39 times, and earned \$1.16 million. Her top victory came in the 2022 Perfect Sting at the Big M, where she defeated Test Of Faith, and she missed by just a nose in the Matchmaker final that same year.

Last season, she hit the board in 19 of 25 starts, winning nine. She earned \$211,353 and has never banked less than \$140,000 in her five years of competing.

"She had a good year," Dale said. "She kind of slacked off in the middle of it and we were thinking that she might be done, but then she turned it around. She just hates to lose. She finished the year good and strong, so we're going to give her another year and see what happens."

The eight-win night brings Merriman's total to 45 wins on the year, leading Billy Davis, Jr. (31) and Chris Lems (21).

The top purse of the day, \$16,500, is offered twice, in races 3 and 10. The first feature will be a starter allowance for claiming pacers, with some eyeing upcoming competition in the Game Of Claims Series, which begins on Saturday (March 2). (The Game Of Claims is the reason Pocono offers starter allowances the first two weeks, so that owners who bore the expense of laying off a horse during the winter do not lose their fresh horse right away after their vacation investment).

The 10th race is a high-level conditioned pace for a field of eight, with the inside five invading from Yonkers. Billy Clyde, who won in 1:48 last year at The Meadowlands and who took his mark of 1:47.3 at that Jersey oval, faces a bit easier competition than he did in Gotham and should be very competitive for trainer Ray Schnittker and driver Mark MacDonald from post 2.

Monday also marked the first qualifying session of the year at Pocono, with Mach Doro A, who was entered right back in for the Saturday opening card, showing his current sharpness by winning in 1:54, fastest time of the day, for driver Jim Pantaleano and trainer Darren Taneyhill. Ridge Warren guided home three winners during the a.m. session, including two for trainer Gilbert Garcia-Herrera, who was the only conditioner to see two charges report home first.

On Tuesday, the second card of the year, to be raced Monday (Feb. 19) at 1 p.m., will be drawn. The Saturday-Monday opening schedule will be joined by racing on Tuesday at 1 p.m. in March, with Sunday evening racing at 6 p.m. starting in May and bringing Pocono to its basic four-cards-a-week schedule.

Stallion Restriction Condition notes

The Stallion Restriction Condition (SRC) aka the "Gural Rule" precludes all foals from the first crop only of any sire who does not meet the condition from being made eligible to any stakes/early closing races that include the SRC within the stakes' conditions.

The list of non-compliant stallions and the races from which they are excluded may be found **here** on The Meadowlands website.

The language within the SRC, Article 2, identifies the responsibility of the stallion handlers to notify potential breeders of the horse's status.

Saturdays have been super at The Big M

The extraordinary has now become commonplace at the world's No. 1 destination for harness racing, as once again, Saturday (Feb. 10) night business at The Meadowlands was over the top, leaving no reason to believe that the string of super Saturdays won't continue this weekend, when racing is conducted tonight (Feb. 16) and on Saturday (Feb. 17) with a first-race post time of 6:20 p.m.

"The Big M has been lighting it up in a big way lately," said track chief operating officer/general manager Jason Settlemoir. "The last three Saturday nights of racing have seen the cumulative handle exceed \$10 million."

In fact, the total was quite close to \$11 million.

On Jan. 27, \$3,779,096 – the 2024 Big M high – was pushed through the windows, before \$3,631,898 and \$3,456,865, was wagered on Feb. 3 and 10, respectively. Over the last three Saturday programs, a total of \$10,867,859 has been pushed through the windows, good for an average of \$3,622,619 per card.

"The popularity of The Big M signal has certainly exceeded expectations in recent weeks," said Settlemoir. "The sport's flagship track is known for its large competitive fields and extraordinary wagering opportunities.

"The Meadowlands will offer two carryovers [tonight] to kick off another exciting weekend of racing. Carryovers attract a lot of attention here and these popular wagers have additional player friendly features."

To begin with, the popular puzzles offer a low takeout of 15 per cent with a low minimum of 20 cents that allow small players to swim in the same pool as the powerhouse punters. In addition, these carryovers lead — in many cases — to a pool that offers a negative takeout, meaning that players with winning tickets will actually get more money back than what was pushed through the windows that night.

The 20-cent Pick-8 failed to yield a winning ticket for a sixth straight card last Saturday, upping the carryover to \$13,550 for tonight.

In addition, the 20-cent Pick-6 also went unhit, and that carryover stands at \$4,641.

The Pick-8 is offered on races 4 through 11 while the Pick-6 spans races 8 through 13. Big M fans are reminded that past performances for every race for every Meadowlands card are available by going to **playmeadowlands.com**.

CHECK OUT THE SHOW: Join The Meadowlands' TV team of Jessica Otten and Dave Little this weekend as they will be on the Sam McKee Memorial Broadcast Set with The Big M's live "Racing from The Meadowlands" pregame show.

Live racing takes place every Friday and Saturday with a first-race post time of 6:20 p.m.
