# Some tweaking needed in new Lucky7 wager at The Meadows

*The Pick-7 wager, with a 15 per cent takeout, will debut on March 6.*

This week, The Meadows announced a new wager that on its face is an idea worth trying. Beginning on March 6, the track will debut a Pick-7, branded as the Lucky7, with a low 15 per cent takeout. Recent columns here have talked about the massive success of Pick-7 wagers abroad, so there is nothing wrong at all with trying one here, if under the right conditions.

The Meadows, and Scott Lishia specifically as director of racing, has been innovative these past couple of years in trying new things at the track. This ranges from attempts to reduce post-drag, a cross-breed Pick-4 from last year and tinkering with takeout rates, all of which should be commended.

But there appears to be two different issues with the way the Lucky7 is structured that could hinder its ability to thrive and be successful.

First, is the base wager amount of \$1. The minimum base of \$1 is far too high for the number of horse combinations needed to have a realistic chance to win seven races with fields of nine and sometimes maybe even 10 horses. Selecting just two horses in each of the seven legs would come out to a ticket cost of \$128 for the \$1 base amount.

From that example, a \$128 ticket in itself wouldn't necessarily be a major issue if the potential winning payoff were high

enough. Especially with carryovers where unusually large pools are produced; wagers far in excess of that amount are common. But based on pool sizes from comparable tracks that have offered similar wagers through the years, I'd say it's likely that early on the Lucky7 wager may not handle more than a couple of thousand dollars in new money each day.

The irony in having a base amount too high for this wager is that in most other wagers throughout harness racing, the base amount is too low.

Superfecta increments of just \$0.10 have become the norm, and some tracks offer Pick-3's in increments of \$0.50. While there's definitely a following who play wagers at those low denominations, the wagers are also prone to produce pitifully low payouts of \$1.26 for dime Superfectas and \$5.50 Pick 3's. But if there ever was a wager that did require a low \$0.10 or \$0.20 base wager, it would be the Lucky7.

A fair comparison to Lucky7 wager would be either the Pick-6 or the Pick-8 from The Meadowlands. Like the Lucky7, both of

those Meadowlands' wagers are thankfully of the non-jackpot variety. The key difference though is that The Meadowlands offers those wagers with a base increment amount of \$0.20.

For multi-leg wagers that go six, seven or eight races deep, \$0.20 is all you need to make the wagers hittable yet still bring with it the likelihood of multiple card carryovers. Just a few weeks ago The Meadowlands Pick-6 was hit after going a couple of cards un-hit to the tune of over \$48,000. Even the wildly popular Pick-4 at The Meadowlands is offered for \$0.50, half of the base amount needed for The Meadows wager which is nearly double in number of races.

The other flaw in the Lucky7 wager is that if there are no winners – which most days will be the case – there is no payout to anyone who had the greatest number of winners. Rather, 100 per cent of the pool will carry over to the next card.

With no consolation payout combined with small pools in the early going, where is the incentive for anyone to substantially wager into it? You'd be largely playing against yourself in an all-or-nothing, seven-for-seven, proposition.

Again, going back to The Meadowlands, there is a blueprint for what seems to be fairly successful. In The Meadowlands Pick-6 and Pick-8 – and even Pick-4 for that matter – if the wager isn't hit, then 25 per cent of the money from that night is still

returned back to the bettors, with 75 per cent carrying over. This way, you don't have to win every single race – just more than anyone else – to still see a return on your investment.

Another bet that comes to mind that was a compromise of sorts between The Meadows and The Meadowlands wagers was what Scioto Downs did in 2022. There, they had a Pick-8 wager. It had a \$1 base, just like The Meadows is proposing, but where it differed is that it had a 50 per cent consolation payout every card. So, while the carryover wouldn't build as fast as it could with a smaller or no consolation at all, a 50 per cent return to the bettors is what helped fuel the wager card after card.

The other thing that Scioto did at the start of that wager was guarantee a payout of \$25,000. A similar guarantee may be what is needed to drive bettors to attack the new Meadows' Lucky7 wager.

If it's not too late, I hope The Meadows sees this and retools the Lucky7. It has potential, but at minimum either needs to be adjusted to a lower base wager, or have a material portion of the pool paid out each day as a consolation.

### Dr. John Cummins is one of a kind

*His outside-the-box approach for diagnostics is second to none.*

"He's the best there is," said Casie Coleman regarding equine veterinarian Dr. John Cummins. "He's very, very sharp. He is very good at spotting lameness issues, and treating and correcting them. He's an animal lover and wants to fix your horse even more than you want it fixed, even if he doesn't own it.

"He will fly in and look over all my horses about once a month. He will then keep in touch to make sure the horses are better. He really cares."

Sam Bowie, prominent owner and former Kentucky and NBA Star, said, "First and foremost, I'm honored to call him my friend. I've been honored to ride with John and observe him and the way he interacts with horses. I'd refer to him as almost being half horse himself. I haven't been around all that many vets, but from what I've observed with John, he is an incredible diagnostician. He just looks at a horse and almost immediately can determine why and where it is lame. Of course, from the 'why' and 'where' he can often come up with the 'how' to treat the lameness and develop a road to making it sound."

work on several breeds and understand their needs within their particular breed. John is highly respected in the American saddlebred, morgan horse and the thoroughbred industry as well as our own. He is an asset to his profession. I am proud to call him my friend.”

Dr. Cummins is not only a practicing vet in three branches of equine competition, but is also involved as a participant in harness racing, thoroughbred racing and with saddlebreds.

“I’ve been involved with horses all of my life, initially and almost entirely with standardbreds. However, in recent years mostly with saddlebreds,” Cummins said. “In the interim, I’ve occasionally also dabbled with thoroughbreds.

“I’m actually involved with all three, although mostly from a breeding perspective.”

***You own standardbreds, thoroughbreds and saddlebreds. To what degree are you active in all three branches?***

“In terms of numbers, I own roughly a dozen standardbreds, five thoroughbred mares and their foals, and 19 saddlebreds. My equine practice is divided in roughly the same proportion. About 80 per cent relates to saddlebreds, 15 per cent to standardbreds and the remaining five or so per cent to thoroughbreds. All of my mares, whatever the breed, go to the best stallions to which I can get access and the stud fees I can afford. With the thoroughbreds right now I’m breeding yearlings which I hopefully will be able to sell in Book 2 at Keeneland. I haven’t as yet reached Book 1 status, but that is somewhere I hope to get to one day.”

*Let’s concentrate on your standardbreds. You describe yourself as both a market breeder and as one who also dabbles in racing.*

“I consider myself as mostly being a breeder. However, when I breed a yearling who I believe might not realize what I might consider its true value at the sales, I might put that horse into training. I now have two horses in training with Nick DeVita in New York. I have the homebred 3-year-old filly Dame Good Time, a Chapter Seven who earned \$147,810 last year. She finished second in the Kentucky Sire Stakes final at 2 last season. I have her 2-year-old brother in training with Nick as well. I’m really looking forward to this year’s racing.”

*You have five standardbred broodmares. Which stallions are they going to this breeding season?*

“They are booked to Confederate, Sweet Lou, Gimpanzee and King Of The North.”

*Those are horses that most would consider to be among the very best that the breed has to offer.*

“My view of the breed is that there are only a limited number of stallions by who you can generate a high enough price to make the costs of breeding and raising a yearling economically worthwhile. Those horses are among them.”

"Hopefully more of the same. Just about every day of my life has included horses. I hardly envision that ever changing."

## Margosgotthecargo and Andrew Moore logged many miles en route to Blizzard Series final

The Blizzard Series for 3- and 4-year-old female pacers concluded with the Friday (Feb. 16) final at Woodbine Mohawk Park and victory for the undefeated Margosgotthecargo (p, 3, 1:54s; \$36,242). The hard-closing filly hunted down game leader Angostura Hanover in the stretch, pulling ahead by a neck at the wire. The 1:54 win was a new mark for “Margo,” driven by 2023 O’Brien Driver of the Year James MacDonald and trained by her owner/breeder Andrew Moore. The daughter of Big Jim—Maplelea is currently the fastest 3-year-old pacing filly in North America.

With only five career starts to date, Margosgotthecargo appears to be making up for lost time. She even, ironically, missed the Feb. 1 Blizzard Series opening leg due to the weather, which is always a factor in her commutes from Hamstan Farm, in Russell, ON.

“Margo was ready to go first of August [2023], but sustained a cut to her hock,” said Andrew Moore of Osgoode, ON, who raised her. “I had two fillies I trained down, both nice fillies, Always B Merry and Margo. Then Anthony Haughan and Meg Crone were finishing them off for me [at Classy Lane Stables Training Centre, in Puslinch, ON].”

Margosgotthecargo’s injury was serious, so Haughan immediately sought veterinary attention for the then 2-year-old, said Moore.

“He rushed her over to Dr. Joe Malone and got her stable,” Moore said. “Dr. Malone called me and recommended sending her to Guelph [home of the Ontario Veterinary College’s Large Animal Hospital]. Dr. Nathalie Côté flushed the cut and stitched her up, and kept her there for a period of time. I had high hopes for her, and thought, best keep her there.”

Margosgotthecargo recovered well.

“I got the call she was ready to be picked up a week later, so I drove up that night from Ottawa, loaded her at Guelph, and drove right back by myself,” said Moore.

Driving five hours each way was no deterrent. Once home again, Margosgotthecargo was cared for by Moore’s wife Dr. Tiffany Richards, who changed the filly’s bandages throughout her recovery.

“She’s the one that made Margo,” said Moore, adding that Dr. Morgan MacKay did the acupuncture and chiropractic work that helped get Margo racetrack ready.

The PEI native told HRU the reason he sent Margosgotthecargo and stablemate Always B Merry to Haughan and Crone at Classy Lane was to be “fair for the fillies” while he travelled to his home province with Tiffany and young daughters Clara and Hannah for a family vacation last August. He spoke highly of the driver-trainer couple.

“Margo can be a little challenging at times,” Moore said. “Why I selected Anthony and Meg is because they have patience and Anthony still drives.”

Margosgotthecargo shares many qualities with dam Maplelea (p. 4, 1:50.4s; \$195,167), also known for being a challenge on the track and behind the scenes.

“Maple’ and Margo both had their quirks; feisty females!” said Moore with a laugh. “Ironically, Maple injured her hind left leg at [age] 2; she got caught in a gate. [Rideau Carleton horseman] Drew Smyth was there for Maple to get her leg out of the gate. Maple had four months off, Margo had six weeks. Both injured their left hind leg.”

Smyth was back to help on a happier occasion Dec. 17, 2023 at Rideau Carleton, the night Margosgotthecargo won going away in her first career start, over a sloppy surface rated five-seconds off. He caught Margo for her winners’ circle photo in the heavy rain, and paddocked her for her first Woodbine Mohawk Park start — and win — Dec. 28.

“I was very, very lucky to have him help, as he is good with a horse and strong,” said Moore, who drove the filly to her maiden win. “I knew Margo to be a handful at the track. The last few times, a good friend of mine, Steve Bray, has helped out. I needed someone with experience and maybe some size.”

In addition to being feisty like Maplelea, Margosgotthecargo inherited her gait and personality, described by Moore as “desire and heart to win, and a ‘don’t mess with me’ attitude.” Maplelea won 14 of 62 career starts for owner-trainer Moore, taking her 1:51.4s lifetime mark at Mohawk in 2015. She retired from racing two years later, and has had four foals so far, led by firstborn Bootlegger Charlie (p, 3, 1:54.3f; \$84,342) and Margosgotthecargo. Maplelea’s most recent foal is a yearling full brother to Bootlegger Charlie, named William Of Bristol after Billy Russell of Bristol View Farms, in QC, said Moore. The mare is expecting a full brother to Margo this April.

Margosgotthecargo’s distinctive name is a nod to a Canadian country music legend from PEI.

“A colorful character on the Rideau Carleton backstretch, Emil Toth, asked Dr. Morgan MacKay to do vet work,” Moore said. “He kept calling Morgan Margo. So fast forward to when Maplelea’s foal alert went off. My wife, Dr. Tiffany Richards, was on her way to the barn to help foal her out. Dr. Morgan MacKay also came to help if needed. When the filly was born, right away you need a barn name and I called her Margo. When it came time to registering her, I needed more than Margo... I thought of home in PEI, and then it dawned on me, Stompin’ Tom Connors’ song ‘Margo’s Cargo,’ with the lyrics ‘Margos got the cargo.’ So, I submitted it.”

Two other PEI legends are also important to the developing story of Moore and Margosgotthecargo.

Growing up, his father Allan, an accountant, and neighbor Ralph Frizzell of Blu Meadow Farm, in Winsloe, PEI both owned racehorses.

“Then we moved to Charlottetown when I was 9 or 10,” Moore said. “We would go visit Ralph and Eva Frizzell fairly regular. Eventually, as I got older and got my license, I would go out there and jog a few, and got more involved with horses. Sadly, Ralph passed away [on Nov. 20, 2023]; he was 91. In all five of

Margo’s wins, the Blizzard final too, the cooler she wore was from Tartan Downs [1996] Atlantic Sires Stakes ‘B’ Division. It was won by Ralph and Blu Meadow Link [p,3, 2:00.2h; \$18.628].”

He also credited the late PEI Sports Hall of Famer Earl Smith with teaching him how to train young horses.

“He always said the horse has to have a great bottom in them if they are going to succeed,” Moore said. “My father had some horses there [with Smith] over the years, and when we were going to school, we would go there on Saturday mornings... In 2003 was my first time trying a yearling by myself. My father went to Harrisburg and purchased two yearlings from Hanover Shoe Farms with Earl Smith’s help. When they got home to PEI, Earl offered to help me get them going.”

With considerably more size than her dam, Margosgotthecargo has been going strong so far and holds big potential this season.

“There’s always pressure to win and keep the streak alive,” Moore said. “But the filly comes first. I’m racing my homebred. I know I will get beat and I’m okay with it. ### TUESDAY

My probation requires I attend at least four NA meetings each week, but my case worker suggests going every night. Meetings are easy to find on your phone. This one is in the activity room of a church. The meeting opened like they all do but ended in a way I can't get my mind around.

We always start with the serenity prayer and then a quick roll call where we go around the room. When it was my turn, this meeting was packed, well over 40 people of every size, shape, and color.

My name is Bridgette, and I am an addict.

The group chants back, "Hi, Bridgette."

I am nine days sober.

They clap.

Since this is my first meeting here, thank you for welcoming me. I am powerless over my addictions, but I am clean today, and I will...

A chant from the group finishes everyone's sentence at this point; keep coming back.

I won't write down personal details of what goes on in the meetings. The wreckage of our lives should remain inside the group, our last names remain private, and this NA group is closed, which means only people with a substance use disorder can attend.

Sometimes, when an NA group has too many people, the group divides into smaller, more personal groups. A woman named Anna asked us to count off by threes and then asked the ones to stay in this room. The twos went to the basement room, and the threes took a folding chair with them and went to the space in front of the church altar. I was in the basement group.

When we were a much more intimate group, an obese, bearded guy in his 50s took leadership and said My name is Paul, so we all said, "Hi Paul" again.

He said again, I am five years and 10 days sober.

We applauded.

Paul read the tract and asked if anyone wanted to share. As I said, I'm not going to repeat anything in this journal, but the first person to share was a lady who used 10 hours ago, and tears fell. It was unusual when the guy beside her hugged her, and we did the same in a sort of group hug.

When we settled back in our seats, Paul nodded at me.

My name is Bridgette. As I said, I am at nine days. Physically, I am in a better place. I lean on my mom and parole officer. I was in an equine therapy group earlier this year, which was fantastic. The place had a hundred horses called harness horses; they pulled buggies around a racetrack. I messed up, but I will never forget the people and the horses. It was a perfect opportunity for me. God, I loved the horses. My screwup of that program is at the top of my mountain of regrets. The other members asked me a few questions about the horse farm, and I answered as best I could.

After the meeting, we returned our folding chairs to a rack in the meeting room and headed for the parking lot. I was walking towards my mom, who sat in her idling car, when Paul tapped me on the shoulder. I was a little rattled because he is a big guy, and it was dark.

He said that it was nice to meet me. A little less nervous, I thanked him and added that this meeting was close so he would see more of me.

He seemed to be having an internal debate because he paused and said he spent most of his life in harness racing. The bad news is that he got kicked out of the sport 10 years ago. He

understood the pull of the horses and said that drugs led him to some serious problems.

I was surprised and said his five years of sobriety is impressive.

What's your best, Bridgette?

Four months.

Paul looked at me and then spoke the most unusual sentence anyone had ever said to me.

If you need a mentor, I'm available, and if you make six months, no, let's rephrase that, WHEN you make six months, I will get you back to working with harness horses. Then he walked away.

How random was that?

### WEDNESDAY

During the NA meeting tonight, we split up again, and this time, I was not in the same small group as Paul. A young girl named Gayle sat beside me and asked if I would join her for coffee after the meeting. I wanted to talk to Paul, but Gail seemed like she needed an ear and a shoulder to lean on, so we sat in a corner, and I listened.

### THURSDAY

Before today's meeting, I tapped Paul on his big forearm and said, almost whispered, that I could not stop thinking about his harness horse comment and asked him if he was serious. He said 100 per cent. Then he said that in six months, we will both have more sobriety, and he plans on being 30 pounds lighter. The horses will be waiting. Tell you what, you are now at what, 10 days sober?

Twelve.

Great, okay, let's leave this as a mystery for now. Just keep with the program and keep racking up the days. At two months sober, 60 days, we will meet before a meeting, and I will answer your horse dreams.

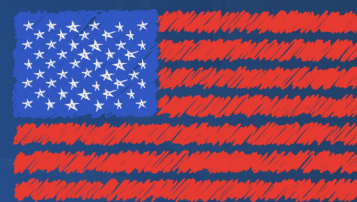
