1. The Rising Star Award won by Braxten Boyd, the *same* year he captured the Meadowlands Pace, is completely consistent with recent honorees. Marcus Miller put his first Breeders Crown on his bio in his award-winning season of 2016. Scott Zeron (2012) won his first Triple Crown event with Michaels Power in the Jug. Nancy Takter had the Horse of the Year (HOY) the same year she won it in 2014. Montrell Teague drove the HOY Wiggle It Jiggle It in 2015 and was so honored. Bob McClure

doubled up in 2019 with Hambletonian winner Forbidden Trade. Lucas Wallin got on the Trotting Triple Crown board in 2022 with Kentucky Futurity winner Rebuff which propelled him to the award platform. Tim Tetrick went so far as to rewrite the record books when he was recognized in 2007.

2. Here's something odd: Super Chapter easily won 3-Year-Old Male Trotter, but did not get a single HOY vote. His trainer 33-year-old Marcus Melander won half the divisional hardware on the trotting side.

3. It's been 27 years now since the last HOY repeater: Moni Maker (1998-99). A combined 38 starts, 26 of which were not made in North America. Funny, I can't recall a single person/voter having a moment's issue with territorial this or territorial that.

4. Chris Ryder did something unusual, he got HOY votes the year after having the HOY with a *different* horse. Miki And Minnie finished third with 21. Twin B Joe Fresh also had a pair.

5. Beau Jangles did what Camtastic (1987) and Captaintreacherous (2012) fell short of doing, be Pacer of the Year at age 2 and HOY. "Beau" has a leg up on the rest in 2026 if history matters. All three male freshman named HOY all repeated at 3, in a romp: Bret Hanover (1965), Nevele Pride (1968), and Niatross (1980).

6. As Owner and Breeder of the Year, Team Burke joined 3 Brothers Stable (2014) and George Segal's Brittany Farms (2006) becoming the third to do so.

7. Jason Bartlett captured his initial Driver of the Year Award at age 44. He's seven months older than Tim Tetrick, both born in 1981. Bartlett is No. 9 and Tetrick No. 3, the two youngest members of the top 20 \$\$ earners club.

8. Ron Burke is the seventh consecutive different Glen Garnsey Trainer of the Year. The record is 13 from 2000-12.

9. The USHWA President's Award had zero ladies among its first 25 winners, but Janet Terhune made it now nine of the past 30.

10. USHWA and HOY both began in 1947, but, the first several years of HOY ballots were filled out by sports editors and radio commentators.

11. Chapter Seven has been HOY and Sire of the Year. Now, we have to wait and see if he can combine the two and possibly become the first ever to do all three with a son or daughter as HOY.

12. Wally Hennessey has always been a Good Guy. Some who watched him get his award might not know *he* was the driver of the last HOY repeater Moni Maker (1998-99).

Dan Patch weekend draws iconic crowd and historic memories

It was an honor just to attend the Dan Patch Awards ceremonies last weekend as the “who’s who” in harness racing were there to celebrate our grand sport.

HRU’s chief Dave Briggs and associate editor Debbie Little were there covering the scene and the ceremony, led by Dave Little, Jason Settlemoir, and the “Rajah,” himself, Roger Huston.

The whole shebang was presented by Caesars Entertainment with an accompanying outstanding journal, primarily because of the USHWA journalists contributing their best with great photographers like Hugh Ducey, Dean Gillette, Chris Gooden, Mark Hall, and Kim Rinker, among others, putting icing on the festivities.

The journalists in back of their cameras are mentioned because many of them have contributed, indelibly, to the grand history of our sport for over 50 years but their humble ways are always avoiding the spotlight, as they are on the wrong side of the camera unselfishly ceding fame to others.

Many of our all-time greats were there such as Bill O’Donnell and John Campbell.

The youthful side of our sport was represented by Braxten Boyd, whose talent and humility, hopefully, bode well for harness racing’s future.

Of course, having become one of our sports’ “senior citizens” since my inaugural trip to Sportsman’s Park on Aug. 22, 1959 and subsequent first writing in the Feb. 4, 1964 edition of *The Horseman and Fair World*, several conversations over the weekend traveled back in time with the breed transforming to one of pure, unadulterated speed.

That’s the beauty of our sport as modern records can, now, only slowly be eclipsed, a fifth of a second at a time, leaving much of our two century plus history intact.

The infancy of our sport, beginning, as we know it, from 1788, was the development of a breed of durability with the proof of that leaving many records untouchable forever as our breed now is one of pure, unadulterated speed.

Our history enjoys a richness unlike many other sports and that is exactly why the renaming of our Nat Ray Memorial Trot was so upsetting to me as we should be continually enhancing our history, not erasing it.

At our USHWA yearly meetings, Moira Fanning offered a book to USHWA members in attendance, a brand-new publication by Cheryl Eriksen on the iconic and immortal “Grey Ghost,” Greyhound.

Greyhound, you might say, inspired a nation beginning in the early-to-mid 1930s through his grand racing career and afterwards in public appearances before his passing in 1965.

It’s an all-inclusive, 300 plus pages of history that is priceless.

The pacer Dan Patch did the same thing for harness racing in the early 1900s, drawing crowds as high as 100,000 as Dan Patch fever swept the nation with sewing machines, washing machines, tobacco, dances, cigars, playing cards, and whiskey bottles among items named in his honor.

In conversation over the Dan Patch weekend, we reminisced about many other standardbred horses whose names have been historically buried with records that will never be eclipsed, and that is a shame.

Yes, the standardbred is now a breed of speed, instead of durability.

That’s not a bad thing; it adds a new, exciting chapter to harness racing.

But HRU is not about to let history dissolve into the ages and this Mane Attraction puts a spotlight on some of the more interesting occurrences, before they are lost with the passing of the last brigade of those who still care.

First, let’s travel back to Chicago, IL, on Sept. 14, 1893.

The World’s Fair was being held in the “Windy City” with the \$15,000 Columbian Free-For-All Trot the headliner.

Actually, the Fair began on Sept. 5 of that year and even had time trials during the festivities, as well.

But the “mane attraction” was the Columbian Free-For-All Trot and some considered this race the greatest in history, clearly defining the standardbred as one of unquestioned durability.

With a winner decided only after winning three heats, this epic duel lasted nine heats over three days with the grand mare Alix (Patronage) conquering her nine rivals by taking the first heat and the fourth heat on Sept. 14 and, finally, after being unable to win any of her four heats the next day, won her third and deciding heat on Sept. 16, in 2:09 3/4.

Her summary read 1-6-8-1-6-2-2-3-2-1 in defeating the mare Pixley, with Alix’ first heat win timed in 2:07 3/4, a world record.

There were also marathon events in “neigh”boring Detroit over their oval and with as many as 16 starters, those marathons also stretched to nine heats.

Back in 1891, Independence, IA was a town known for its affection for horses and was known as the “Lexington, KY of the North.”

There were two “mane” events that year, one for the pacers and one for trotters that stretched out to 12 heats before a winner was crowned.

The race was so long that some drivers said that they entered the race as young men and were ready for retirement when it was all over.

There were 11 pacers in that side wheeling event with high wheeled sulkies with the winner, Dandy O, having the right strategy as he finished back in the pack nine times before winning the final three heats over his completely exhausted foes.

Dandy O won \$200 that day, and \$200 went a long, long way back then.

The trotting event went two days with Red Baron, the winner after those 12 heats in a 20-horse field.

But, probably, the most outrageous event proving the durability of the standardbred was set by Martin Delaney’s mare, who, for a purse of \$200, was sent out to trot 200 miles in 18 hours.

There were no sulkies in this one. Delaney was on horseback in a two-day event covering the 200 miles in 15 hours.

By the way, she averaged between six and seven miles per hour and had three hours to spare at the end of the journey.

Delaney said it was the easiest \$200 he ever made.

(HRU is wondering if the mare thought, “That’s a fine how-do-you-do. I did all the work and HE got all the money.”)

Back in that grand era, with the crowds, in many cases, standing room only, there were events contested in harness, in time trials, to wagon, under saddle, team-to-pole, and triplicate teams.

While, on occasion, we still have races at an extended distance of 1½ or two miles, there are records on our books for distances substantially longer than that, some three miles, four miles, or five miles, and even six miles.

The iron horse Controllor has the world record for 10 miles, *in races*, accomplished in 1878 at 27:23 1/4 and also owns the record for 20 miles, *to wagon*, at 58:57.

Also of note is that the sire of Controllor, Gen. Taylor, holds the record for 30 miles as this grey stallion established his record in 1857, covering the distance in 1 hour, 47 minutes and 59 seconds.

There are durability records for 50 miles, as well, that go back to 1835 as Black Joke took 3 hours and 57 minutes flat to cover that distance.

Finally, in terms of distance, Fanny Jenks established the record for 100 miles – yes, 100 miles – at 9 hours, 38 minutes and 36 seconds in 1945, only to be out-done by the gelding Conqueror in 1853 of 8 hours, 55 minutes and 53 seconds.

Durability can also be defined within the confines of age.

Quite possibly, the most famous of all records concerns

the amazing Goldsmith Maid, a mare HRU covered in our “Thanksgiving is Thanks-living” Mane Attraction just a few months ago.

As a 17-year-old, Goldsmith Maid trotted a mile in 2:14, the fastest ever at that age.

As an 18-year-old, her mark was 2:14 1/2, followed by 2:14 at the age of 19, and 2:14 1/2 as a 20-year-old in 1877.

We’ll wrap this up with yet another definition of the durability of the standardbred, as late as the early 1950s, there were several horses that raced competitively into their 20s.

Abax was 26 years old in competition, Baldwin was 24, and Ada Symbol 23, and all earned a few dollars.

One last thing concerning durability, we’ll never see the likes of Tonymite again, he was the author of 107 starts in 1953, with 45 wins and 79 1-2-3 finishes earning \$2,296.93, \$21.26 per start.

The 14-year-old Tru Single G was just a “ns” behind in starts – 106 with 30 wins and earnings of \$22,875.36, \$27.12 per start.

The greatness and durability of the standardbred was, indeed, the breed of durability.

Australia's Tasmyn Potter is temporarily trading in one Garden State for another

The winner of Victoria's Young Gun Series is getting the opportunity to drive at The Meadowlands.

When Tasmyn Potter won the Young Guns Series on New Year's Eve 2025 at Australia's Melton Park, she earned bragging rights over her competition and the priceless opportunity to compete at The Meadowlands in an International Women's Day (IWD) race on March 7, 2026.

"We all knew that if we were to win the Young Guns Series, the prize was a trip to America, which made the night very competitive," Potter said. "It was quite nerve-racking going into

the last race at the top of the leaderboard but still needing to finish in the top couple to hold my position."

The Australian-born husband-and-wife team of Shane and Lauren Tritton are sponsors of the race and offered the potential driving experience, which, if won by a woman, would hopefully include a chance to compete in The Meadowlands' IWD event.

Potter, 23, has never met the Trittons, but is excited to make the most of what's being presented to her.

"I had heard a lot about them and remember them being great trainers when they were based in Sydney," Potter said. "I've seen a

few of their horses race over there [in the U.S.] and keep an eye on their Facebook page out of interest. I can't thank Shane and Lauren enough for the opportunity they've opened up for me." Lauren said she remembers what it was like to compete in Australian competitions similar to Young Guns when she was a young driver before she and Shane moved to the U.S. in 2020. "Yes, I did [compete in competitions for younger drivers] with a far less prize to the winner," Lauren said. "I certainly wish something like this was available when I was coming through the ranks.

"Australia does such a great job helping the young talent improve and become professionals. They have many events like the Young Guns Series that showcase the best young talent. We had no hesitation in sponsoring this series to give back to a sport that has given so much to us. We wish the U.S. would do more to develop the young talent as I'm sure there are many young participants out there that could rise to the occasion if given the chance."

The Young Guns Series for up-and-coming drivers under the age of 25, took place in southeastern Australia in Victoria, which is known as "The Garden State." The difference between there and New Jersey's Garden State is pretty drastic as Down Under is currently nearing the end of summer with temperatures in the 80s, while the area near The Meadowlands is digging out from over two feet of snow.

Although the Trittons have never met Potter, they did race against her family in Australia before relocating to the States.

“Tasmyn came onto the scene after we moved to the U.S., but we have kept an eye on the rising talent in Australia and Tasmyn has made a name for herself in her relatively short career so far,” Lauren said. “We are excited to be able to show Tasmyn the differences in the U.S. compared to Australia and I’m sure it will open her eyes to new experiences.

“Not to mention that almost everyone in Australia has never sat behind a horse when it’s snowing, and the way things look at the moment, she may just get that opportunity.”

Potter said she never wanted to do anything but be involved in harness racing.

“I grew up with my dad being a trainer my whole life, and he first got involved through some close friends,” she said. “I always wanted to be involved, much to my parents’ disgust, although probably not to the extent I am now. I finished school and started university doing equine studies, then decided to defer and take a gap year.

“I began working for Andy and Kate Gath, and Andy was probably the one who pushed me the most to start my driving career. I never made it back to [university] and so far, I haven’t looked back. Although my parents weren’t so keen at the beginning, they’ve been great supporters ever since.”

Andy Gath said, “Tasmyn is just a natural around horses, and a fantastic rider, too. She rode our great trotter Tornado Valley around the place and broke him into saddle. She’s grown up around horses and has a terrific pair of hands.

“Horses would just run for her. I was at her and at her for ages to give driving a go. She was reluctant but finally did. She’s had terrific success already and is just starting her career.

“After she won the Young Guns Series, I got one of the best texts ever from her mother thanking me for encouraging Tasmyn to give driving a go.”

Although Potter’s trip to the U.S. was delayed by a few days due to the bomb cyclone that hit the Tri-State area (Feb. 22-23) and dropped tons of snow on New York, New Jersey, and Connecticut, she was finally due to arrive in the States on Thursday (Feb. 26).

“I’ve never been to the U.S. before,” Potter said the week before her trip. “Now that it’s getting so close, I’m a little nervous because it’s out of my comfort zone, but I’m really looking forward to it and have no doubt I’ll have the best time.

“I’m really looking forward to learning new things over there. So many people have told me how different the training and driving styles are and how much I’ll learn, so I’m excited to experience it myself. Honestly, I’m looking forward to the whole trip; it’s a once-in-a-lifetime experience for me.”

Illinois champions will be honored on Saturday night

It's the Year of the Horse and in Illinois his name is **Cash Money Twenty**.

By virtue of his accomplishments in 2025, Cash Money Twenty will officially begin his second straight 12-month reign as Illinois Horse of the Year on Saturday night (Feb. 28) when he is crowned at the Illinois Standardbred Banquet at Poe's Catering in Springfield.

"He was as good as he was as a 2-year-old," said trainer Mike Brink, looking back on a 3-year-old campaign in which the gelded son of Stevensville—Hostess Lisa, by Sagebrush recorded nine triumphs and four seconds in 14 starts versus 11 wins and one place in 12 outings in 2024. "He's kind of a handful — not an easy horse to race. He got beat a few times but when it counted, he was there [in the winner's circle]."

In addition to repeating as Illinois-bred Horse of the Year, Cash Money Twenty is being honored as the state champion 3-year-old male pacer.

William and Sherrie Bycroft of Des Moines, IA (whose stable is known as Heart and Soul Racing) are the principal owners of Cash Money Twenty, while his driver, Casey Leonard, also has an ownership share.

"In his last two starts [5¼-length conquests at Hawthorne Race Course in both the Cardinal and the Robert F. Carey Memorial on the Night of Champions] he proved he was the best horse in Illinois," Leonard said.

Cash Money Twenty began his career in Minnesota at Running Aces and, according to Brink, he will be returning there this summer to race for another trainer.

Leonard also was the driver of another repeater as a state champion, the 3-year-old filly trotter **Lou's My Number**.

The daughter of Lou's Legacy—Ants Iner Pants, by Band's Gold Cup returned to Hawthorne in November toting the baggage of a slump at Springfield but she responded to the change of scene by winning a Night of Champions qualifier by 4¼ lengths and then rallying to capture the Beulah Dygert Memorial by three-quarters-of-a-length.

A winner of six of her 16 starts in 2025 she ended the year by extending her winning streak to three races.

Trainer Steve Searle is the co-breeder of Lou's My Number in partnership with Thomas Wisniewski and owns her in in partnership with Chris Paloma, Mike Paloma, and Mike Buzzard.

"Steve had some issues with her and we fooled around with her equipment in the Springfield races," Leonard said. "He did a great job. She has a great last quarter and she was outstanding when it counted."

Whiskey Lou's coronation as the 4-year-old and up mare trotter will mark the third year in a row she is being honored at the Illinois Standardbred Banquet after she reigned as the 2-year-old distaff champion in 2023 and the 3-year-old titlist in 2024. The daughter of Lou's Legacy is owned by her breeder Randy Wilt and is trained by Curt Grummel.

The nomadic **Niko Man** is the repeat champion older horse/gelding trotter. Now a 6-year-old, he repeatedly raced in open company outside Illinois last year and his 25-race resume showed five wins, seven places, and one show.

Perennial Hawthorne driving champion **Leonard**, and long-time trainer stalwarts **Brink** and **Searle** also will be honored at the banquet for being inducted into the Illinois Harness Horsemen's Hall of Fame earlier this year. Leonard joins his father, trainer Terry Leonard, who was inducted last year.

One of the three retired horses being honored is **Fox Valley Gemini**, who was trained by Terry and driven by Casey when he was a winner on the Night of Champions for six years in a row from 2017-22 and Illinois Horse of the Year in 2018 and 2019.

The other Hall of Fame inductees being honored in recognition of either their exemplary racing or breeding careers are **Lou's Legacy**, whose nine-year reign as the top Illinois trotting sire ended in 2025, and **Fox Valley Topaz**, 2008 Dan Patch Award winner as the top 2-year-old pacing filly in North America and 2008 Illinois Horse of the Year.

Dr. Richard Flacco, patriarch of Flacco Family Farms, who brought Lou's Legacy to Illinois and made him the state's most dominant trotting sire, is joining his pride and joy as a Hall of Fame honoree.

Also being honored at the banquet for their Hall of Fame induction are **Ed Teefey**, who has long been one of the most distinguished standardbred leaders, owners and breeders in the state, and the late trainer **Robert Phillips**, whose horses won 1,123 races and earned \$7.6 million before his death in 2022.

Track announcer **Peter Galassi** and starter **Mike Titus** will receive Lifetime Achievement Awards at the banquet in recognition of their dedication to Illinois racing.

Galassi began calling races in 1979 at (now-defunct) Quad City Downs and has gone on to an outstanding career at (now-defunct) Balmoral Park, Hawthorne, and the State Fair at Springfield. He was at the microphone for some of the sport's greatest moments during the past quarter century on Super Night at Balmoral and Hawthorne's Night of Champions.

Titus has been a part of Illinois harness racing since he was a child and has gone on to become one of the Midwest's finest starters.

Miranda Shedron enjoys getting jackpots from ‘Casino’

It was a third-place result that very much felt like Miranda Shedron had hit the jackpot.

As the field turned for home in the first race at Northfield Park on Feb. 17, there was little doubt who the winner would be in the pace dash with a \$5,300 purse.

But for Shedron, her eyes remained fixated on Casino Director, the 75-1 longest shot on the board in the field of nine.

With her fiancé Angus Lake in the race bike, the 12-year-old son of Art Director out of the Village Jove mare Casino Bus, who had been fifth at the three-quarter mark, marched home in :30.0 to take third spot, 7¼ lengths behind the winner, Dancethewayare.

Shedron, who also owns Casino Director, was unapologetically proud of the veteran campaigner’s gritty showing.

“He’s getting older, but he’s still a competitor,” Shedron said. “It’s not even on the program when he got his last check. I was just so appreciative of that result. It felt so good.”

Seven races later, Shedron sent out fellow pacer, 4-year-old Gorgeous Jet, to a third in the \$8,600 dash.

“He was outside almost the whole mile and finished up awesome, like a beast,” she said. “In this sport, there is always next week – better times are coming. So, when you do experience those good times, it makes it that much more rewarding.”

Shedron, who hails from Dundee, OH, was destined to find a life in harness racing.

Growing up in the Buckeye State, she saw, first-hand, the joy her father, Ralph Miller, derived from the pacers and trotters who were under his tutelage.

“I grew up on a farm and we had our own track, so I felt a connection to racing at a very young age,” she said. “I was probably around 6 years old when I knew I was going to be in racing one day.”

In 2019, Shedron launched her training career, winning two races and posting seven top-three finishes from 19 starts.

Fittingly, it was Casino Director – her heart horse – who delivered the first victory.

Shedron’s superlatives for the horse are seemingly endless.

“He is amazing,” she said. “I have had him since 2019, and we have been through a lot together. My first win as a trainer was at our fair, Wayne County. It was a Tri-County pace – only people who train in that area could enter – and it wasn’t much money, but it was a great moment, one I will never forget. It is a race he has won five out of seven years, four of them consecutively.”

Casino Director’s on-track prowess is matched by a colorful off-track personality.

“He loves bananas,” Shedron said. “He’ll eat them frozen, peel, and everything. He is just a fun little horse. He has a lot of quirks. For about four years, I couldn’t sit on his back. Now, I can go out and ride him bareback and hang out together. When it is time to race, there are moments when he doesn’t want to come out of his stall or he won’t come out when he has his Murphy Blind on or won’t let me catch him in his stall.

“He knows when the vet pulls up and he won’t let you catch him in his stall. I have to catch him before the vet pulls in.”

One particular evening, Shedron had to work overtime to corral Casino Director in a far different scenario.

The drive home from the racetrack went from calm to chaotic in a split-second.

“We were coming home from Northfield Park and I got him on the trailer,” she said. “We started driving and the trailer flipped.

He was running down I-71 and when I got to him, there was no halter – nothing. I screamed his name and he came back to me. A lady gave me a set of jumper cables, and I walked him back to where he was safe. This is the middle of I-71. Tractor-trailers are screaming by and there is so much going on. But he waited for me. He had paced in :52 that night, but he was probably going :49 down the highway.”

With that moment gone from the rear-view mirror, Shedron, who produced her best season, by purse earnings (\$105,012), in 2025, will continue to maintain the looking ahead approach she had established long ago.

It is the simple things that help push her forward.

“When I walk into the barn and they pop their heads out and talk to me, it is such a wonderful feeling,” she said. “And when I feed them and you hear them munching on their food – as long as I know they are okay, then I am okay. It is a great thing to walk into the barn and feel as though they need me and want me there.

“I just love that each one has their own little personality – nothing is the same from horse to horse. I like the challenge of working with horses and bringing out the best in them.”

Shedron also appreciates the times when her small stable can outpace larger-scale operations on the racetrack.

“The biggest challenge is going up against the bigger stables,” she said. “You look at entries and see who you are racing against and figure you have no shot. And the announcers make their picks and you feel again as though you have no shot. But when you win that race, it makes it much more special.”

When they do, a beaming Shedron is there to greet them.

“I will tell them, ‘Good boy, or good girl,’” she said. “I love those times.”

Away from the racetrack, Shedron is content to shut off the racing world for a while – with one caveat.

“I will look at the video of the barn and make sure all my horses are okay,” she said. “All I know is the barn and home. I live next door to my parents. My dad is in a nursing home now, but I can just pop in any time and check on my mom.”

At the barn, Lake and Shedron work in lockstep to keep things running smoothly.

“The ups and downs can be really tough, but we are on the same page with our horses,” she said.

A group that includes a pair of young prospects.

“We also own half of two babies,” Shedron said. “We are training those two down and we have high hopes for them.”

An opportunity to dream big and, perhaps, to hit another jackpot.

Harness racing is coded in Ryan Steward's DNA

No matter which direction a young Ryan Steward turned his head, there was almost always a horseman on the other end of his sight.

"My dad [Randy] was in it, my grandfather [Larry Fitzsimmons] was in it, my uncles [Rick and Rod] were in it, my stepfather's [Ray Bunn] in it, my brother [Nick] drives – everybody's in," he told HRU.

With the racing bug already coded in his DNA, it was only natural that Ryan would follow his family into a life at the racetrack.

"When you're brought up in it, it's in your blood – it's a part of you," he said. "You love the animal, and you love to compete. It just feels normal."

A regular on the Ontario circuit after obtaining his trainer's license in 2014, Ryan spent his childhood gaining knowledge and first-hand experience from those who raised him in the sport.

Through his uncle Rick Steward, who spent 10-plus years working under Hall of Famer Bob McIntosh after running his own stable, a young Ryan relished opportunities to tour the renowned horseman's operation.

The eye-opening, and "very cool" encounters were balanced with other core memories stemming from days with his grandfather, Larry Fitzsimmons and stepfather, Ray Bunn.

"The memories have come from all over," Ryan said. "My grandfather's got over 1,000 wins [1,144]. Just going with him to the races or the barn at a young age, being, and working around horses, really stands out.

"As I grew up, working with my stepdad brought a lot of good memories. We had a fairly big stable at one point when I was a kid. We had some nice success, too."

The racing memory at, or at least near, the very top of Ryan's fondest with Bunn came on May 2, 2014, at The Raceway at Western Fair.

The moment – Ryan's first career training win, courtesy of then 9-year-old pacer Keystone Samurai – was a full-circle special for the Steward-Bunn clan.

"She was a horse that me, my stepdad, and a couple other people actually bought as a yearling," Ryan said. "We had her and won a few [Ontario Sires Stakes] Grassroots races with her [2007-08], and then, unfortunately, we had to sell her.

"I kept track of her over the years, and ended up buying her back, and she was who I got my first win with."

Sent off at 45-1, the longest price in the field of eight, the bay daughter of Camluck–Keystone Skyline registered the strongest final quarter (:30.3) in the octet to reach the wire a half-length clear.

The spirited showing remains eternally etched in Ryan's mind.

"She was second in her first start for me and just about won [March 17, 2014]," he said. "She missed a few checks after that and then she had the 7-hole and won my first start.

"That one was, and still is, quite special."

In the years that followed, Ryan patiently built his brand at raceways all over Ontario.

The Lucan-based conditioner saw his stock reach unprecedented heights in 2022, when on the strength of a 12-14-23 line (114 starts), he celebrated his first season above \$100,000 in purse earnings.

The breakout campaign served as a launchpad for Ryan's most potent season yet, which came in 2023, and featured what still holds as his most exhilarating victory.

With the end of the calendar year in sight, Ryan, and then 3-year-old pacer Leave It To Luther, saved their best for last in the Ontario Harvest Series.

"Going into it, I thought he was a fringe player," Ryan said. "But after he won the first two legs, I thought if he drew well in the final, he might have a shot. Then he drew the 9-hole. It was a great feeling winning a race going for \$50,000."

Working with James MacDonald, who in January earned an unprecedented fifth straight Driver of the Year title at the O'Brien Awards, the Betterthancheddar bay stopped the clock in 1:53.1 – three-quarters-of-a-length safe.

The signature score lifted Ryan's season earnings total to a career-best \$183,967 across 177 starts (24-22-25).

He has since eclipsed the \$100,000 mark twice more, bringing his active streak above that threshold to four straight seasons.

Keeping consistent, though, is not a one-trick pony.

"There's a lot of luck and racing the horses where they can go and make the most money," Ryan said. "You try not to race them over their heads and place them wherever they fit in the best."

"There's obviously a lot of hard work involved in getting them ready to race, because you have to execute too, but you have to have some good fortune as well."

Classifying horses "correctly," as Ryan put it, is one of those seemingly simple measures that can become overly complicated in a hurry if not handled judiciously.

"It does nobody any good if you race them over their heads, you risk them losing their confidence," he said. "That's maybe been one of my downfalls. I like the horses too much and I don't really want to see them get claimed but the next point is that it's a business and you have to try to race somewhere they can make money."

In times of classifying confusion, Ryan returns to the words of his stepfather, Bunn, for answers.

"He told me, 'If you're racing claimers and you leave home, worrying about them getting claimed, then you have them in the right class,'" Ryan said.

The steadiest presence in the race bike for Ryan's trainees has been none other than his brother, driver Nick Steward.

At one point, and still to this day, to a degree, Ryan himself imagined a career in the sulky, but once Nick obtained his license, the need dissipated.

Ryan has employed Nick's services almost exclusively since joining his younger brother on the Ontario tour in 2014.

They may butt heads on occasion, like brothers do, but Ryan wouldn't have it any other way.

"[My stepfather Ray Bunn] told me, 'If you're racing claimers and you leave home, worrying about them getting claimed, then you have them in the right class.'"

"It's been good," Ryan said, adding with a laugh. "We don't always see eye to eye, but it's more of that brotherly bond. I get madder at him than I do anybody else just because he's my brother. That's just the family dynamic. I'm six years older than him too, so it's just one of those things... I hate the guy, but I love him at the same time."

"But no, Nick can really do it all. He'll listen to me, and if it's a young horse and the horse needs a trip, he'll do exactly what you say as best he can, and if it's one that you like to see get off the wings, he can do that too."

With his family by his side, Ryan has shown no signs of slowing down in 2026 – his 12th year on the job.

The now veteran conditioner is responsible for 11 horses, a list headlined by 8-year-old pacing mare, Shady Memories.

"She's an eight-claimer, but she won 11 races last year for a horse that was brought in from the Amish," Ryan said. "She made \$42,000 last year. She did really well."

Also, on Ryan's roster of racehorses is pacing mare Odds On Selenium, veteran gelding Silver Spirit, and a pair of 3-year-olds in J M Ooh Lala and J M Mazingan, who won by eight lengths on Feb. 4 at Western Fair.

For Ryan, "priority number one" is ensuring his horses are healthy, fit, and ready to race.

While easier said than done, the kid with harness racing in his blood always has somewhere to turn.

"It's growing up in the business, branching out, and working for different people, seeing how they do things, taking what you can and trying to apply to your craft and seeing where it goes," he said. "Along the way, I've been fortunate to be around the right people."

Bruce Aldrich, Jr. gets win number 9,000

On Wednesday (Feb. 25), the aptly named **Win And Dream** gave Bruce Aldrich, Jr. his 9,000th win. The winner is trained and owned by Steven Ray of New Berlin, NY, the 8-year-old gelding won in 2:01.3 - \$17.80.

Born into a family of rich New England harness racing heritage, his father Basil Aldrich has been competing long before the USTA even began record keeping. With Bruce being indoctrinated at an early age, it didn't take long before Bruce got the harness racing itch and started his own career.

His first year of racing was 1985, finishing third in his only start, gradually from there he continued his journey. In a short span of 5 years, he had 189 wins and earnings of \$172,803. Bruce has been a mainstay at Monticello Raceway for decades, where the 57-year-old is a six-time leading dash winning driver. In his career he has been behind the starting gate 53,666 times, with 7,993 place finishes and 7,179 times finishing third, and career earnings of \$37,250,000. He has earned over a million per year in purses an amazing 17 times thus far in his career. His best year was 2015 with 663 wins and \$3,361,218 in purse earnings.

In his 41-year career, Bruce has driven many horses, one that sticks outs for him was Royal Heart, who set a world record at Saratoga that was broken by Wiggle It Jiggleit. Royal Heart also paced one of the fastest miles ever at Monticello Raceway of 1:51.4.

Following the epic win, Bruce was greeted in the winner's circle by friends and drivers, Bruce wasted no time in his quest for his 10,000 win, scoring with **Kenobi**, just two races later.

Harness writers conduct successful meetings in Orlando

The United States Harness Writers Association (USHWA) held its annual meetings this past Saturday and Sunday (Feb. 21-22), returning to the Rosen Shingle Creek Resort in this central Florida city. The Dan Patch Awards banquet, presented by Caesars Entertainment, on Sunday evening again provided the highlights of the weekend; the honors accorded Horse of the Year Beau Jangles and the other stars of the sport, both human and equine (mainly for 2025 accomplishments but in some cases recognizing career achievement), have already been written up and disseminated in the trade media.

27 USHWA directors, including officers, active past presidents / life members, and at-large / chapter directors, worked on Saturday morning into the afternoon to examine and plan a framework for the Association’s operations in 2026 and for years beyond.

Both old and new business were brought before the directors, suggested by various segments of the membership, and were

explained to and examined by the group. (A piece of old business was a decision by specially-appointed committees on two items “tabled” during the 2025 meeting.) Preliminary routes to accomplish such ends as met favor in the often-spirited discussion were established.

The Writers made updates and refinements into its operating bylaws and rules and regulations, with the large number of suggested modifications often accompanied by wide-ranging discussion, leading towards voting on both sides of the proposals at hand. These topics included a re-adoption of a Veterans/Immortals section of the Communicators Hall of Fame (a committee will be formed to put together the underlying structure), and an examination of the eligibility of USHWA members to receive certain awards.

The directors also voted to place Kim Rinker and the late Barry Lefkowitz, both with longtime distinguished accomplishments in their respective sections of harness racing, onto the summer ballot for possible election into the Communicators Hall of Fame (there has already been a separate release on these choices sent out).

53 members of the organization, including the directors, attended a Sunday morning meeting designed for the general membership of the Association. The highlights of the major activities occurring during Saturday’s gathering, especially the proposals of change to the Association’s bylaws and rules and regulations along with the actions directors took on said proposals, were recounted and were a topic of continued conversation.

Reports from both all of the committees that oversee major areas of USHWA activity and from the officers of the Association were delivered. Any questions the membership had on any aspect of USHWA were encouraged and answered.

Elected by the membership as USHWA president was Heather Vitale, moving up from the first vice-president’s chair. Derick Giwner and Heather Wilder were elected to the first and second vice-president spots, respectively; voted to retain their jobs were Bill MacDonald as treasurer and Jerry Connors as secretary. Michael Carter, now the immediate past president of the Association, is via the bylaws the chairman of the board, and also has attained lifetime USHWA member status and a gold USHWA membership pin.

USHWA lost a net 13 active members from last year’s meeting to this one, not unexpected given the installation of a mandatory \$15 annual dues from retired members. On the other hand, there are seven communicators currently working through the USHWA joining process.

This mixture of “core group” and “young blood” will allow USHWA to carry on hosting its annual acclaimed Dan Patch Awards banquets and continue to knowledgeably vote to recognize the best and brightest in harness racing, both human and equine.
